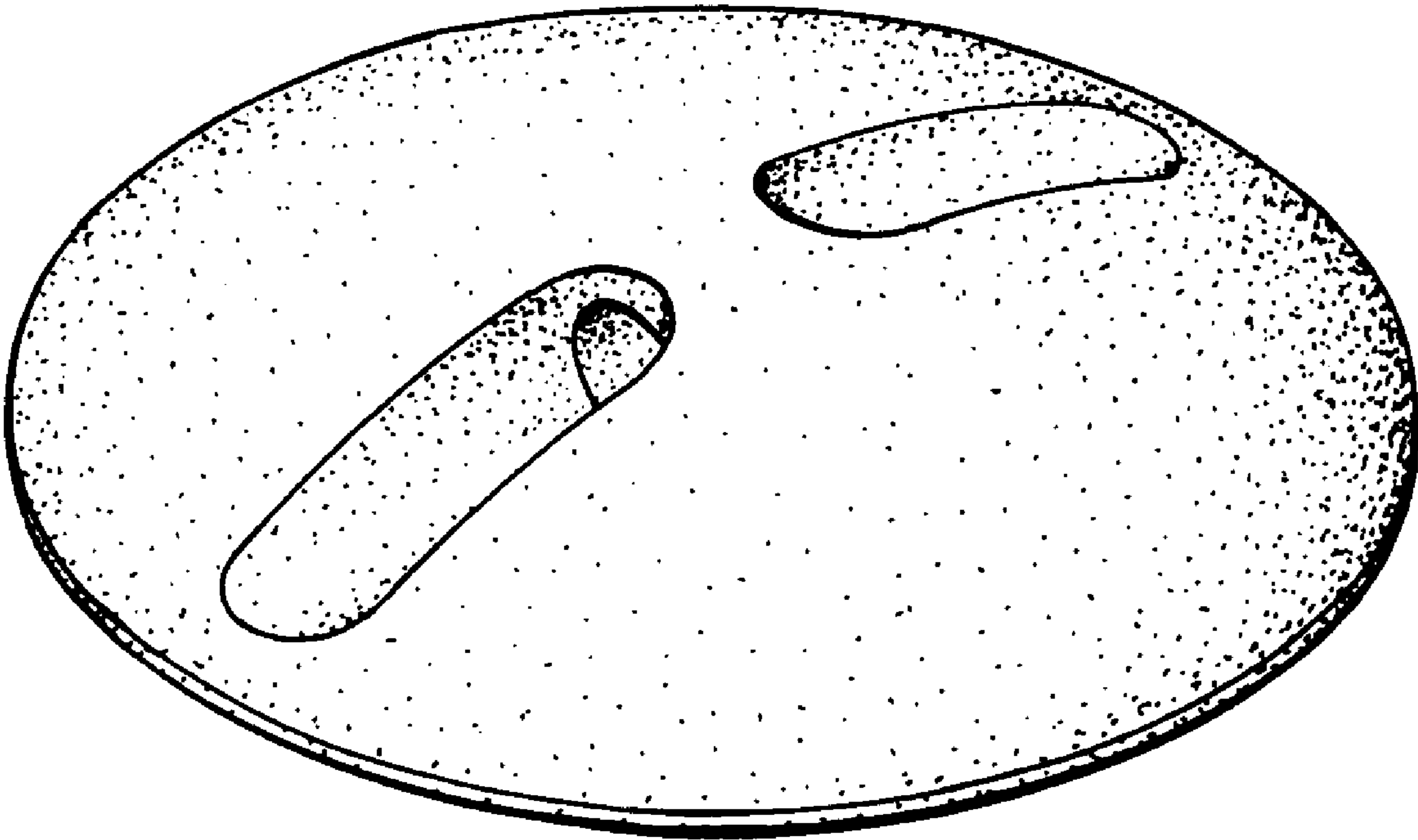

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a security puck showing our new design;

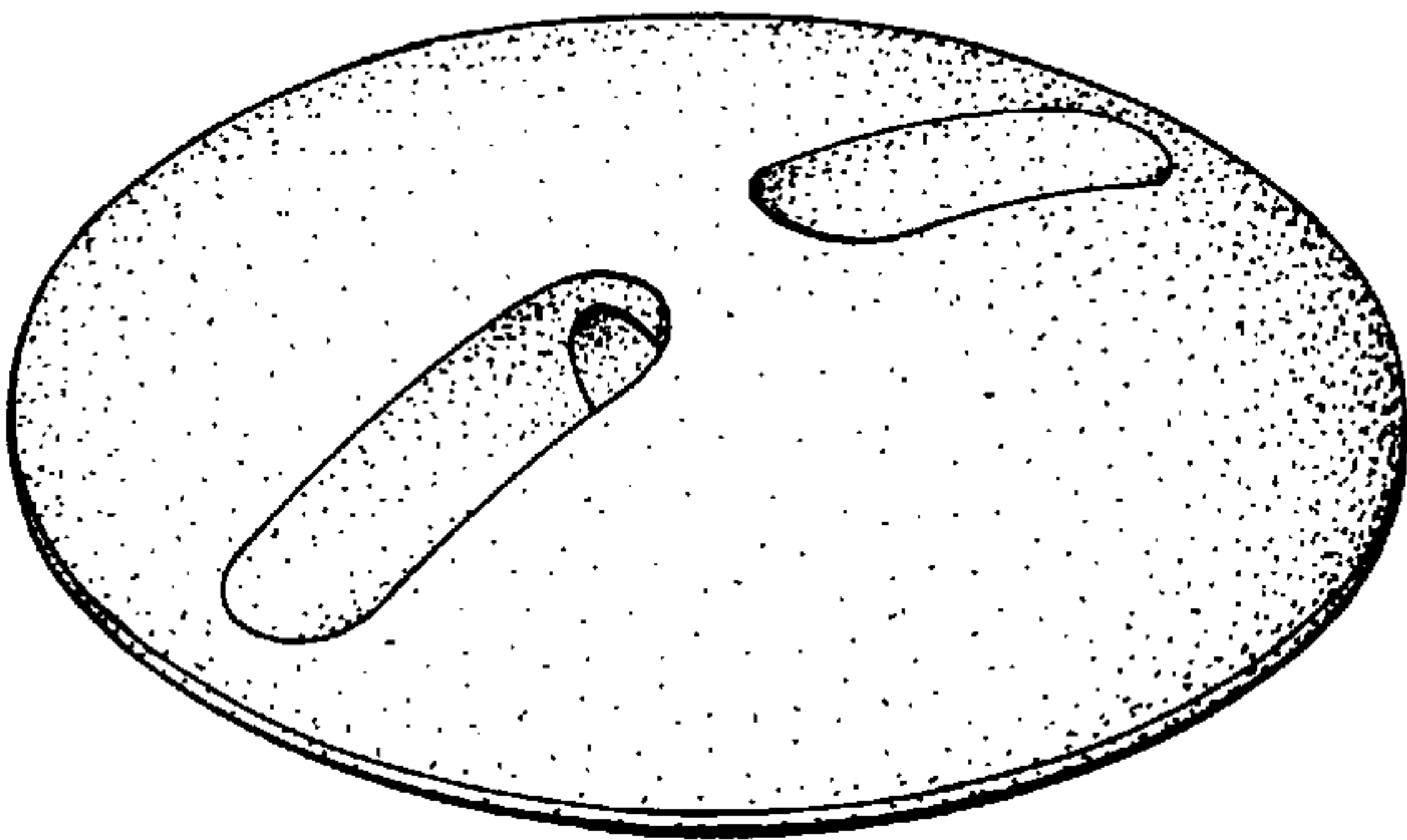

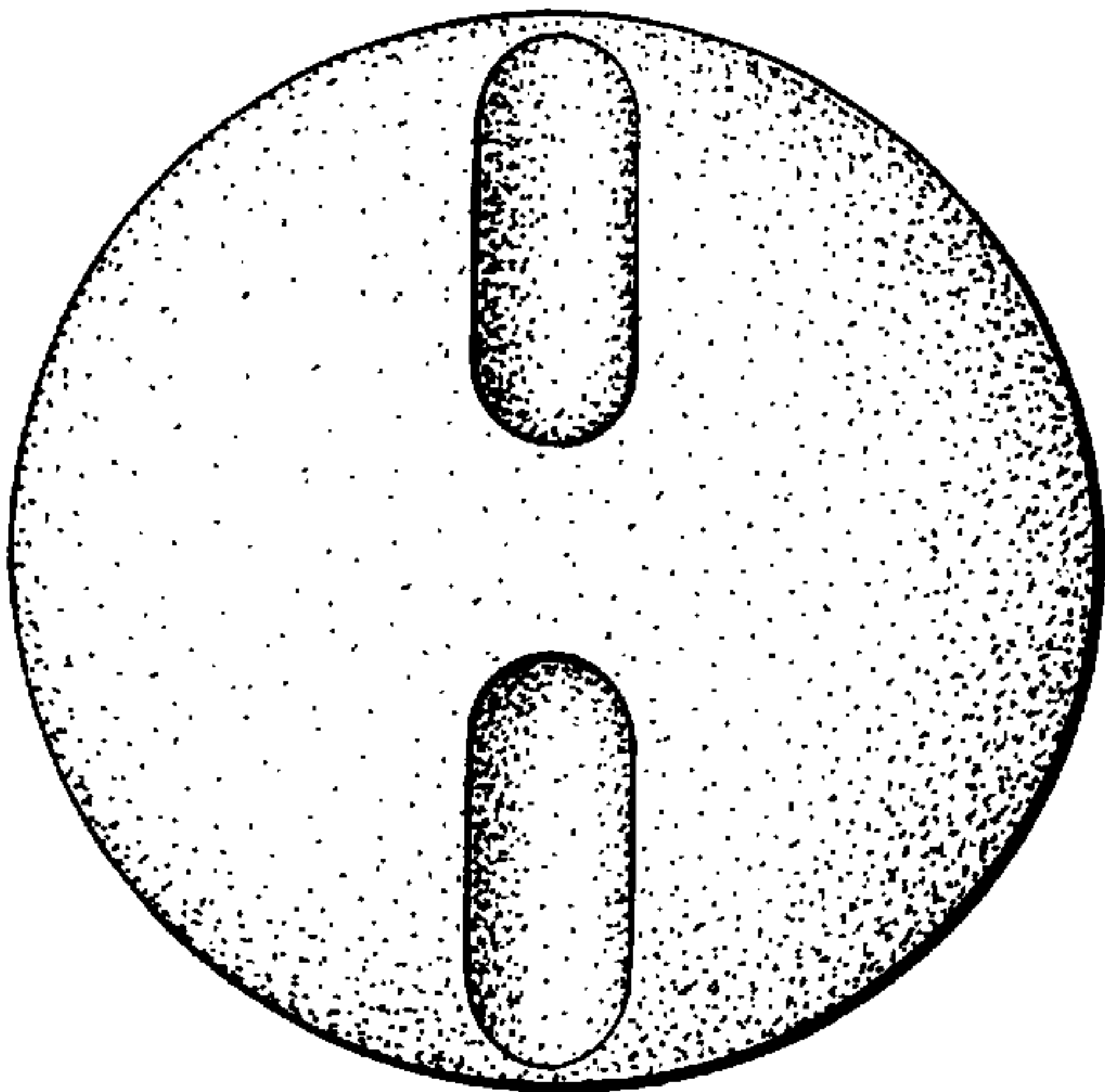

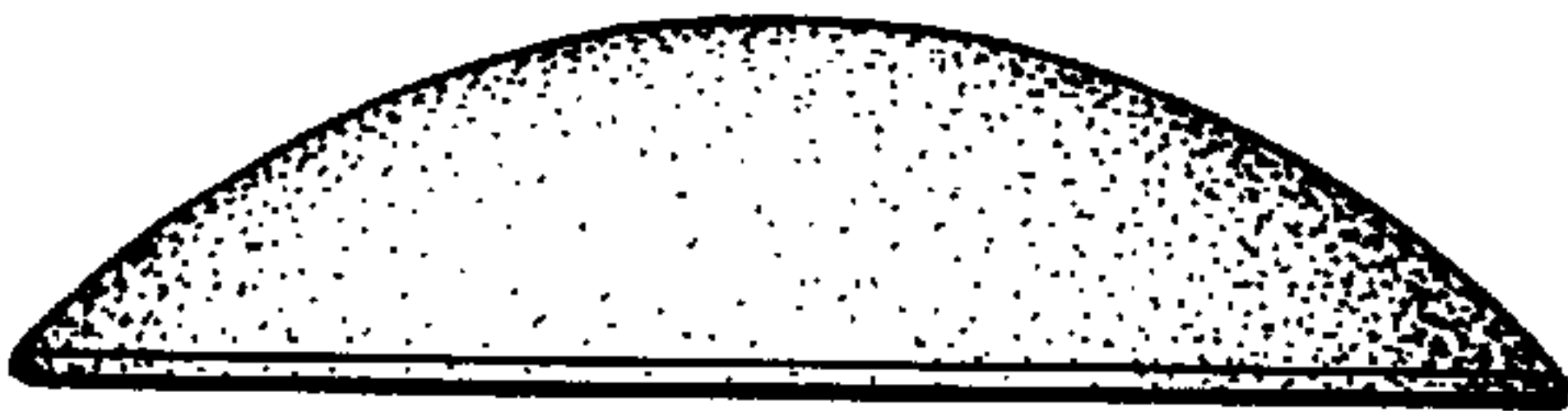

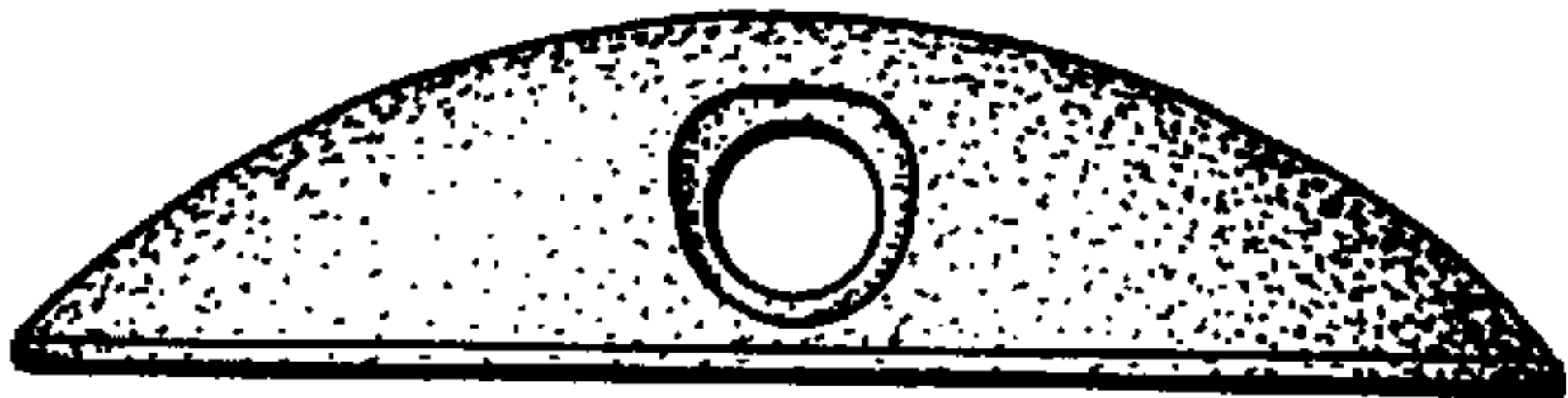

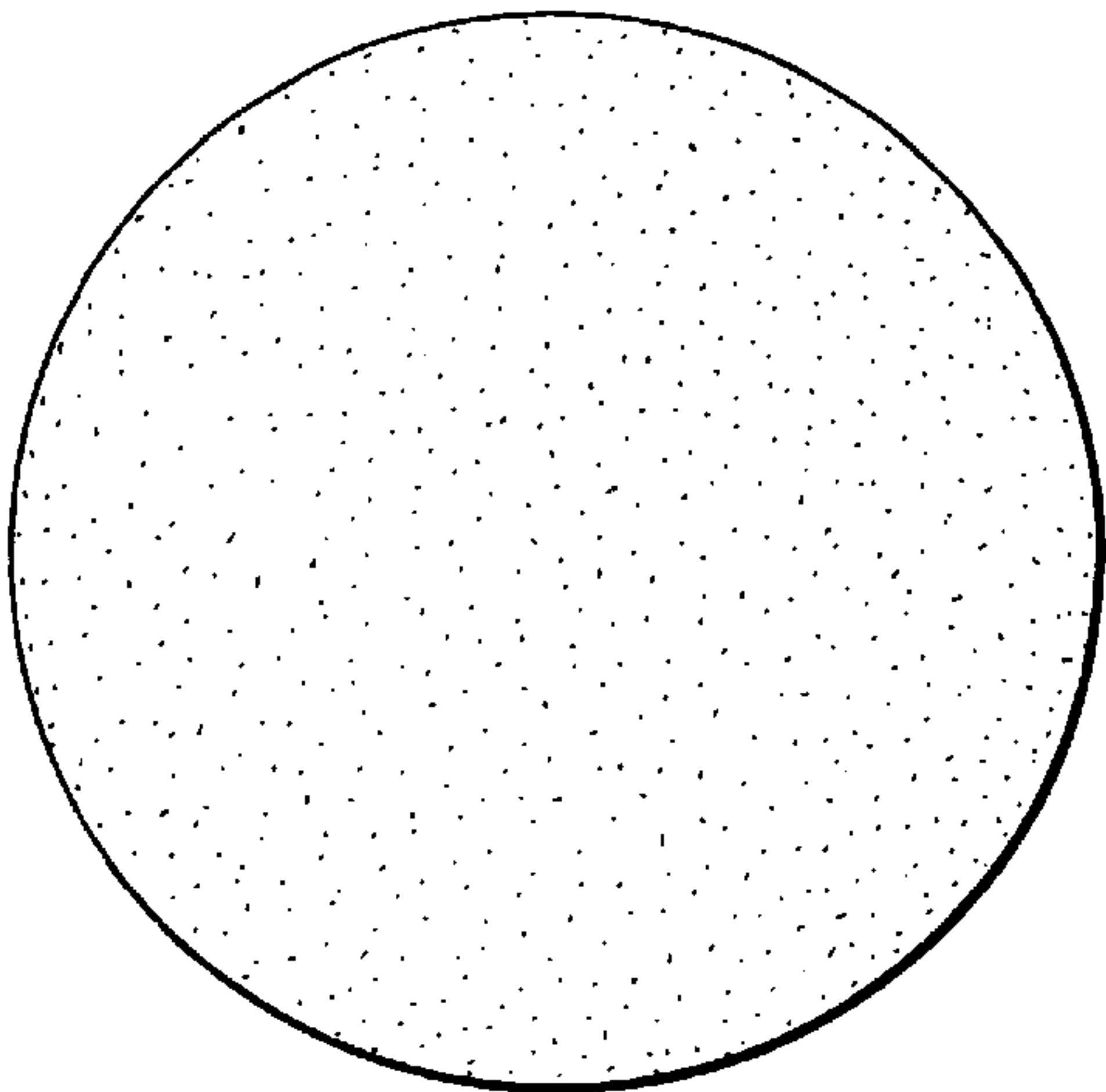
