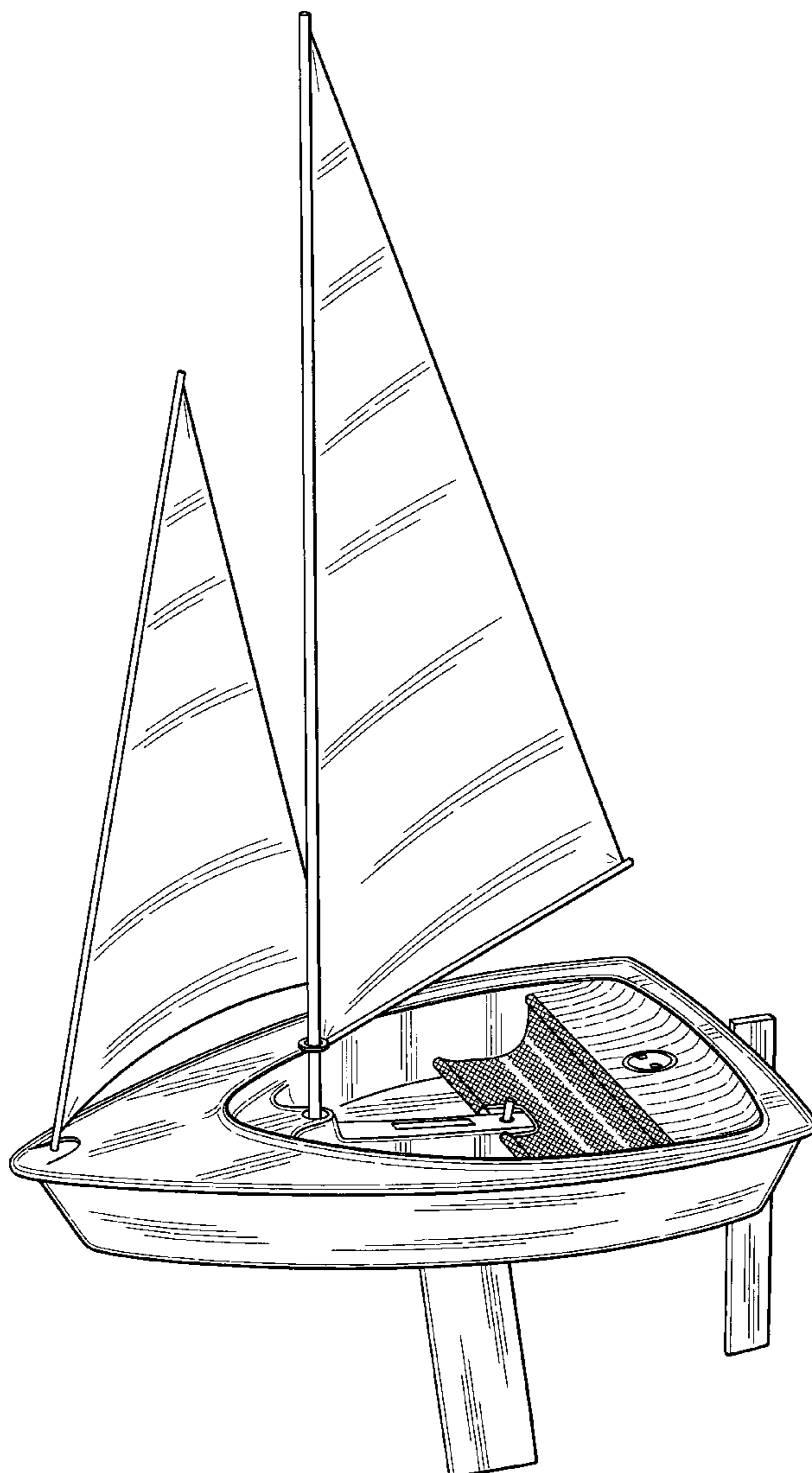
The ornamental design for a “accessible sailing dinghy”, as shown and described.

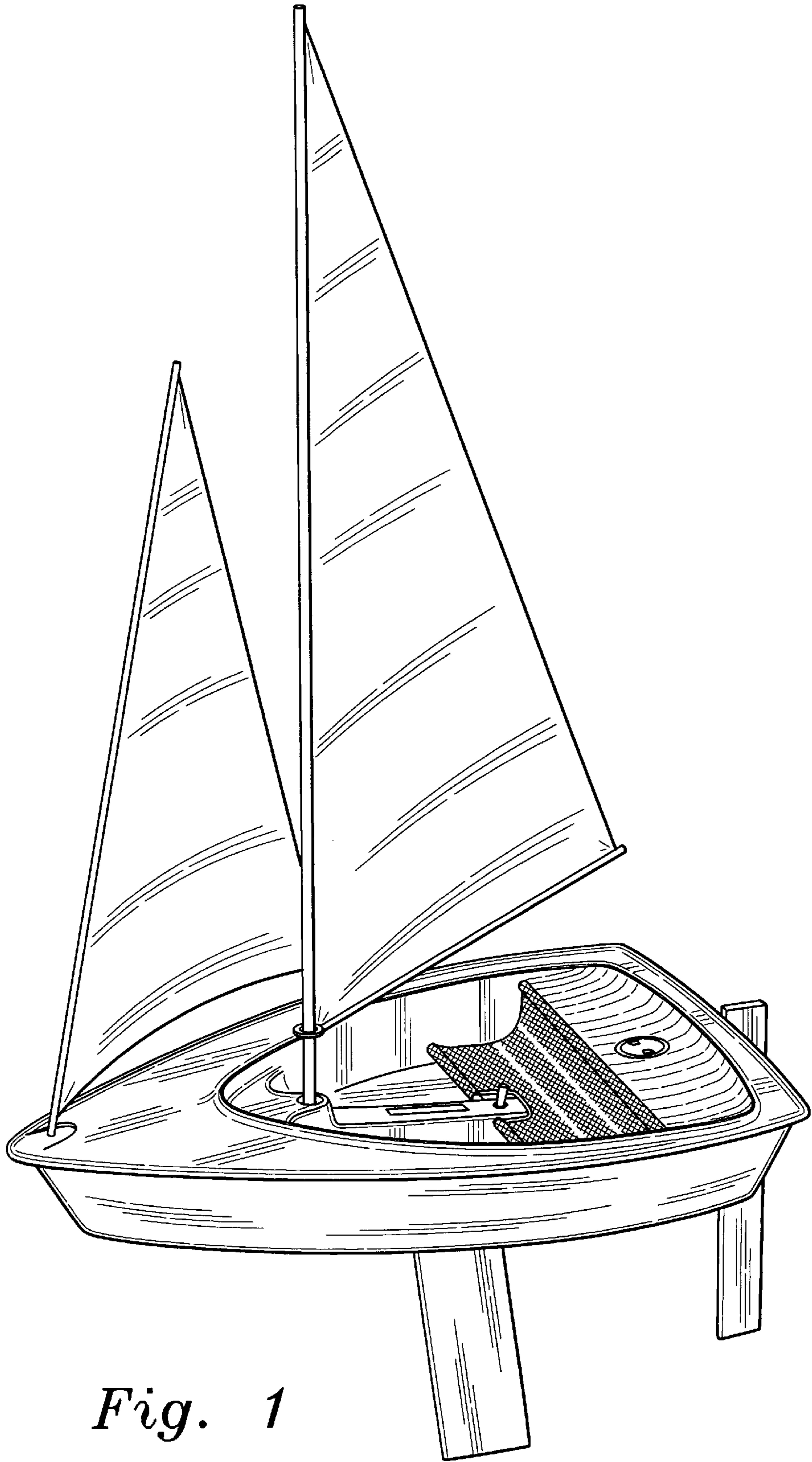

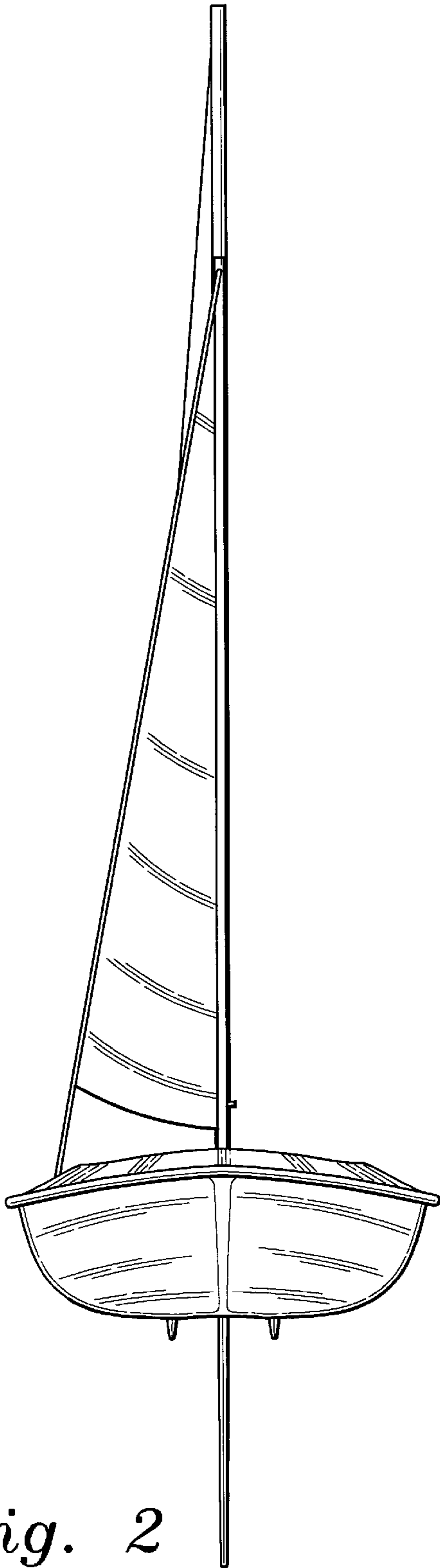

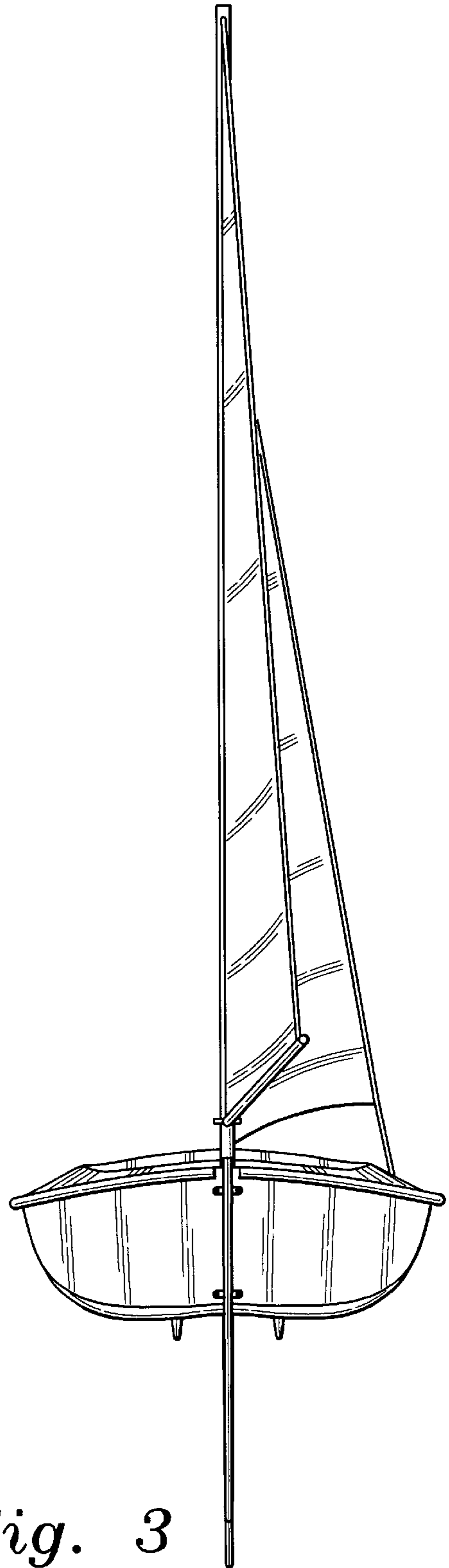

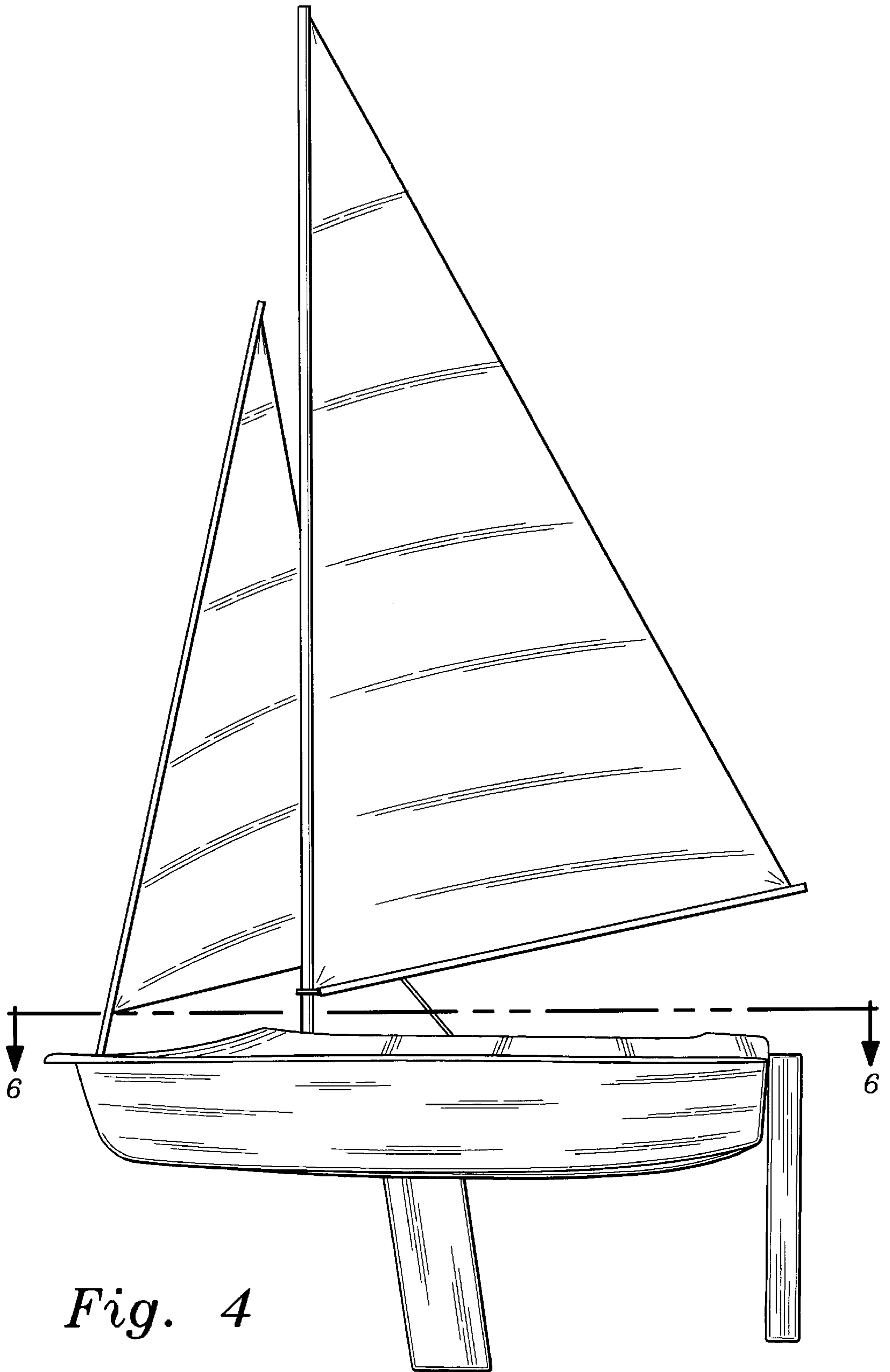

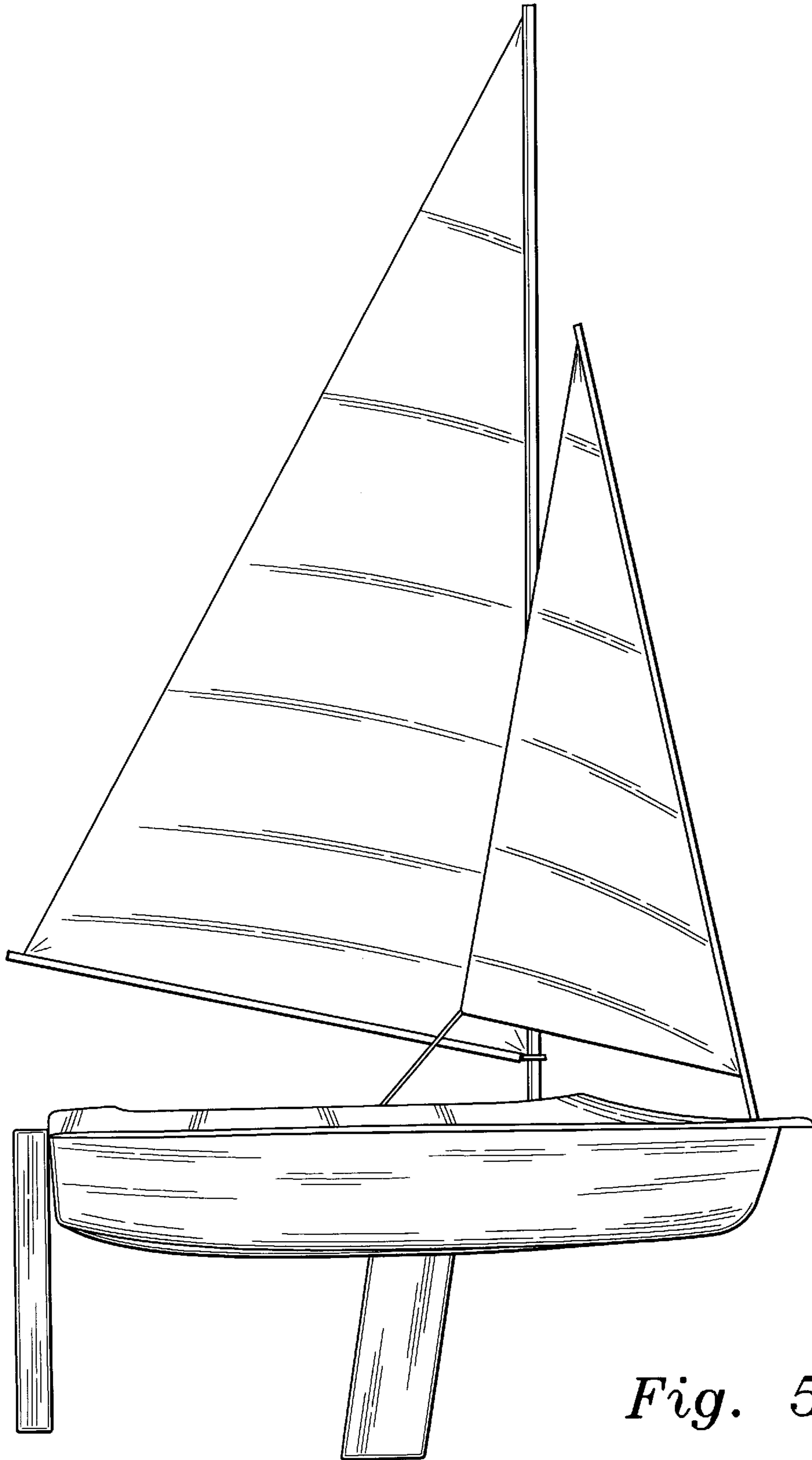

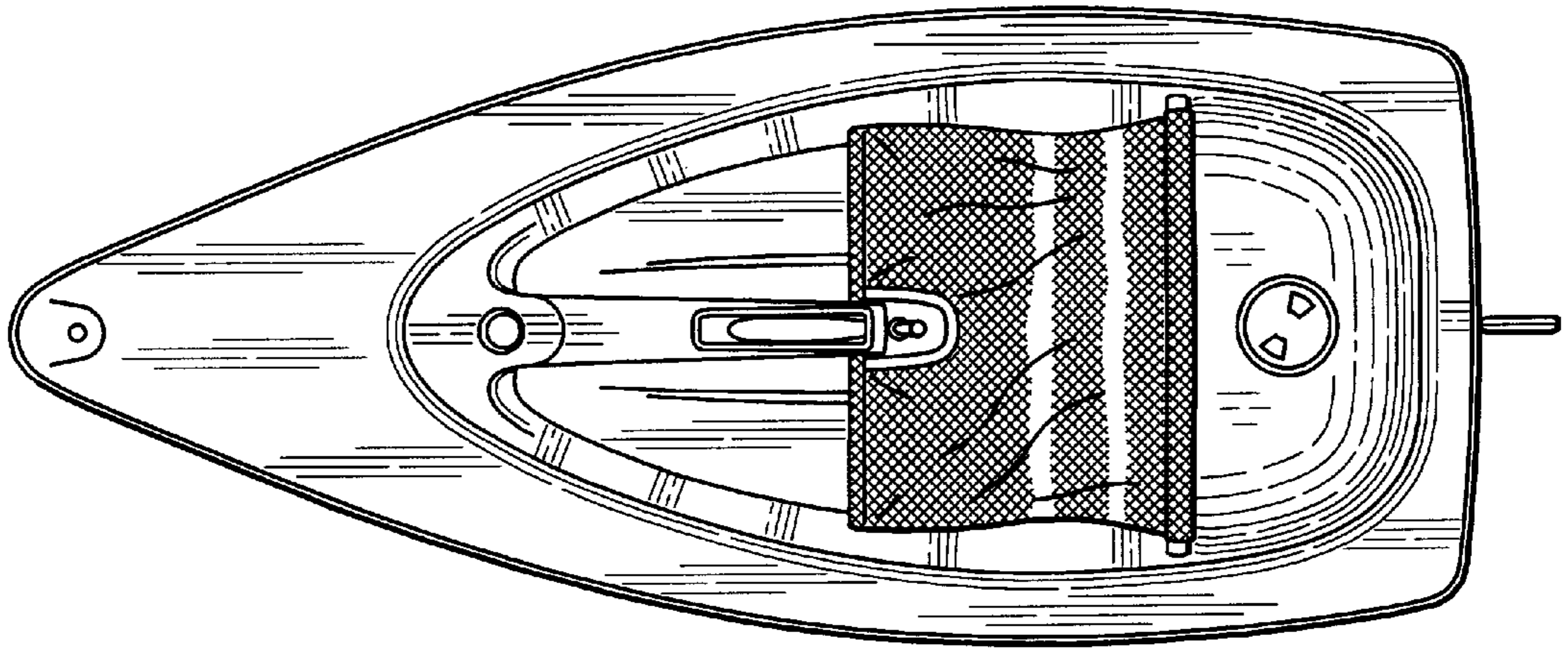

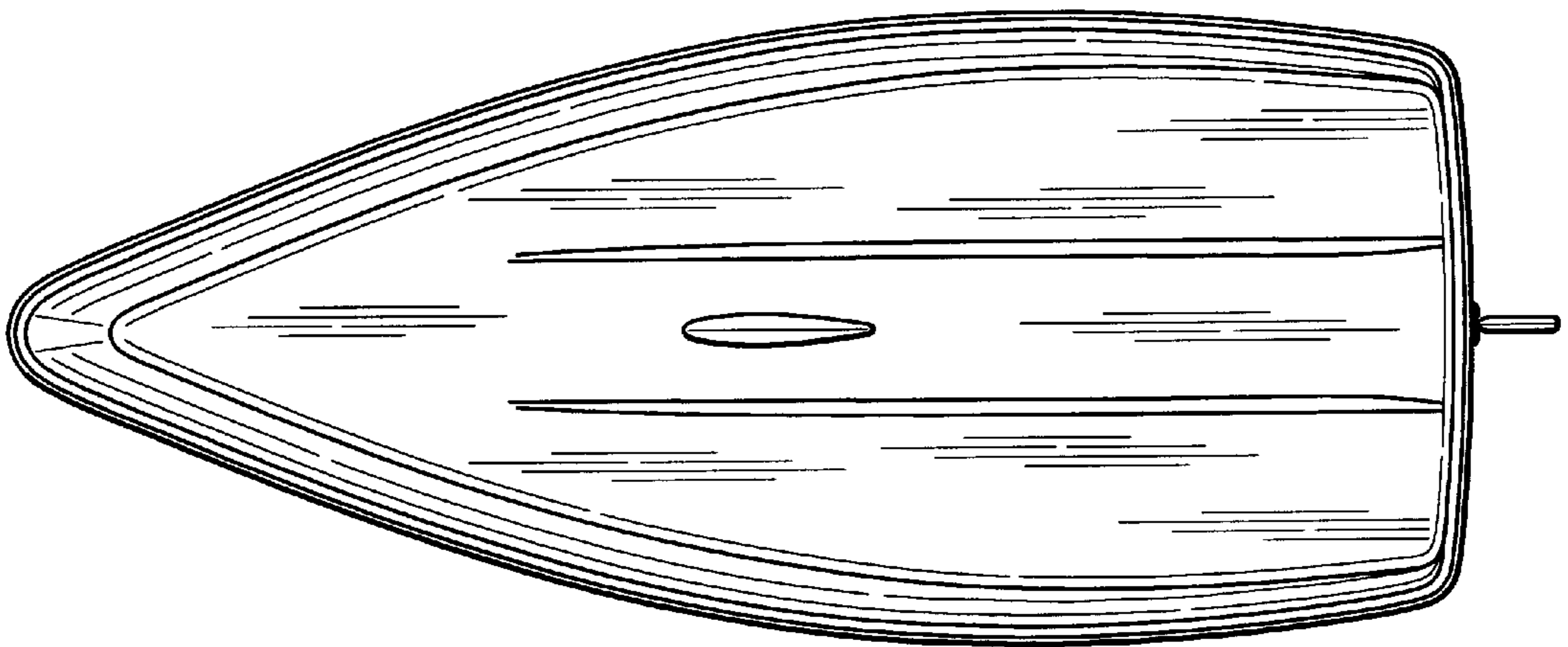
