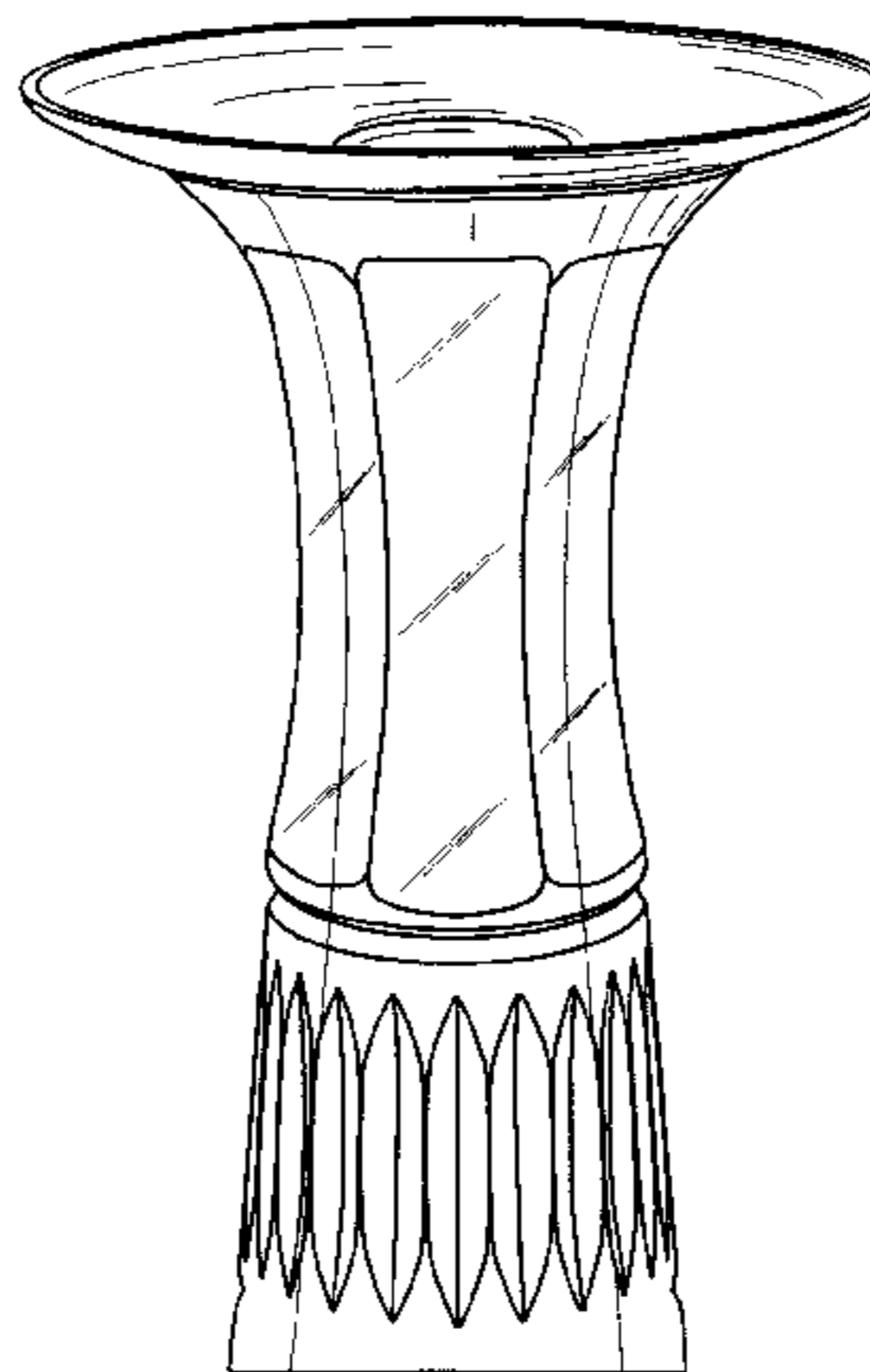
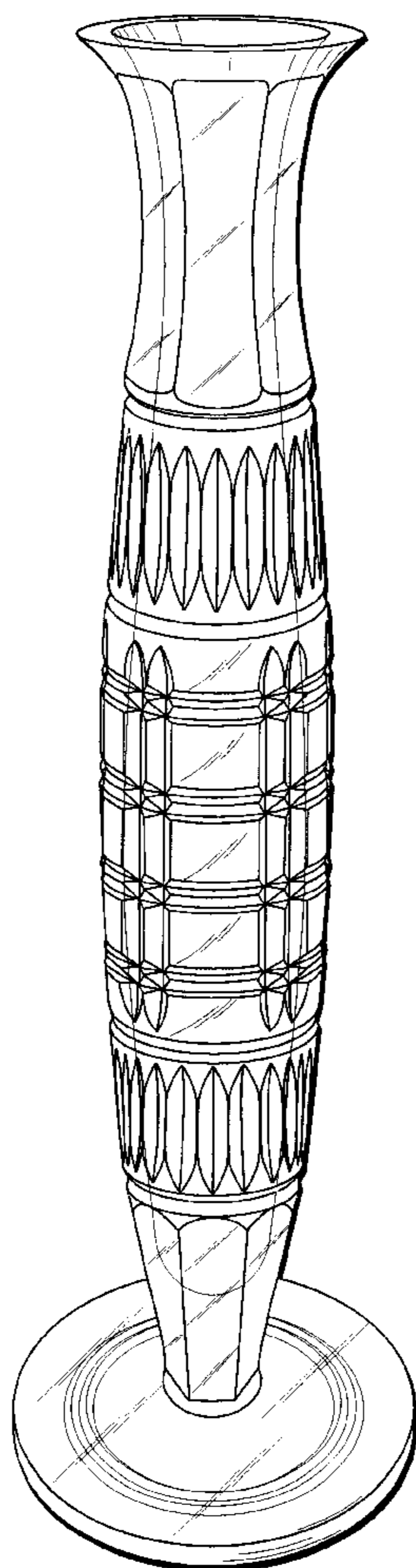
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a flower vase with candle holder adapter, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of my new flower vase with candle holder adapter, shown with the candle holder adapter removed for clarity of illustration; FIG. 2 is an enlarged front view thereof, the rear view being a mirror image; FIG. 3 is a right side view of FIG. 2, the left side being a mirror image; FIG. 4 is a top view of FIG. 2; FIG. 5 is a bottom view of FIG. 2; FIG. 6 is an enlarged fragmentary perspective view of the upper end thereof, with the candle-holder adapter in place; and FIG. 7 is a front view as in FIG. 6, with the side and rear views thereof being identical; and, FIG. 8 is a top view as in FIG. 6.

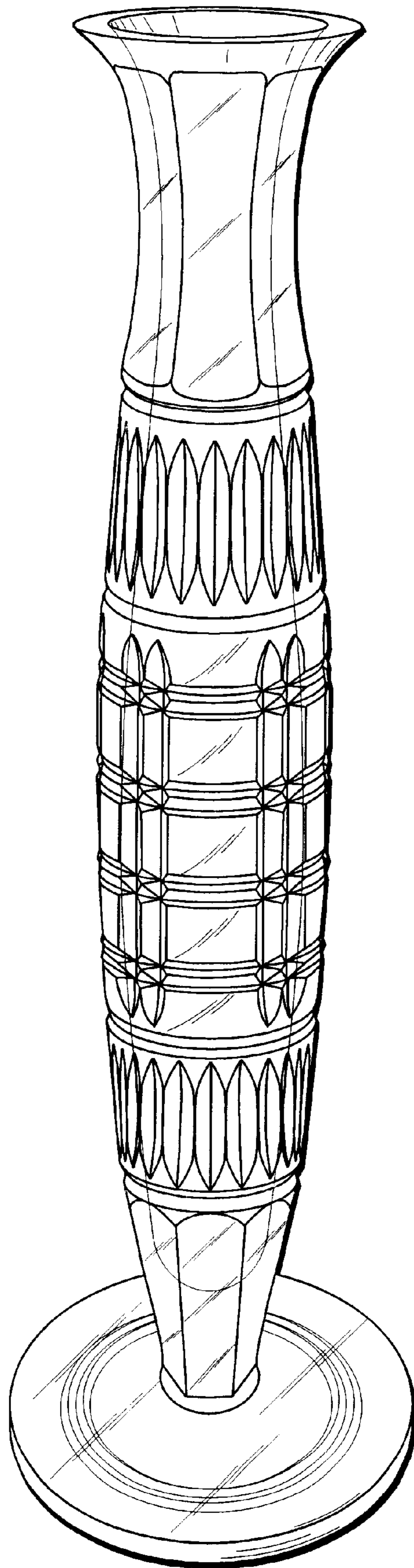

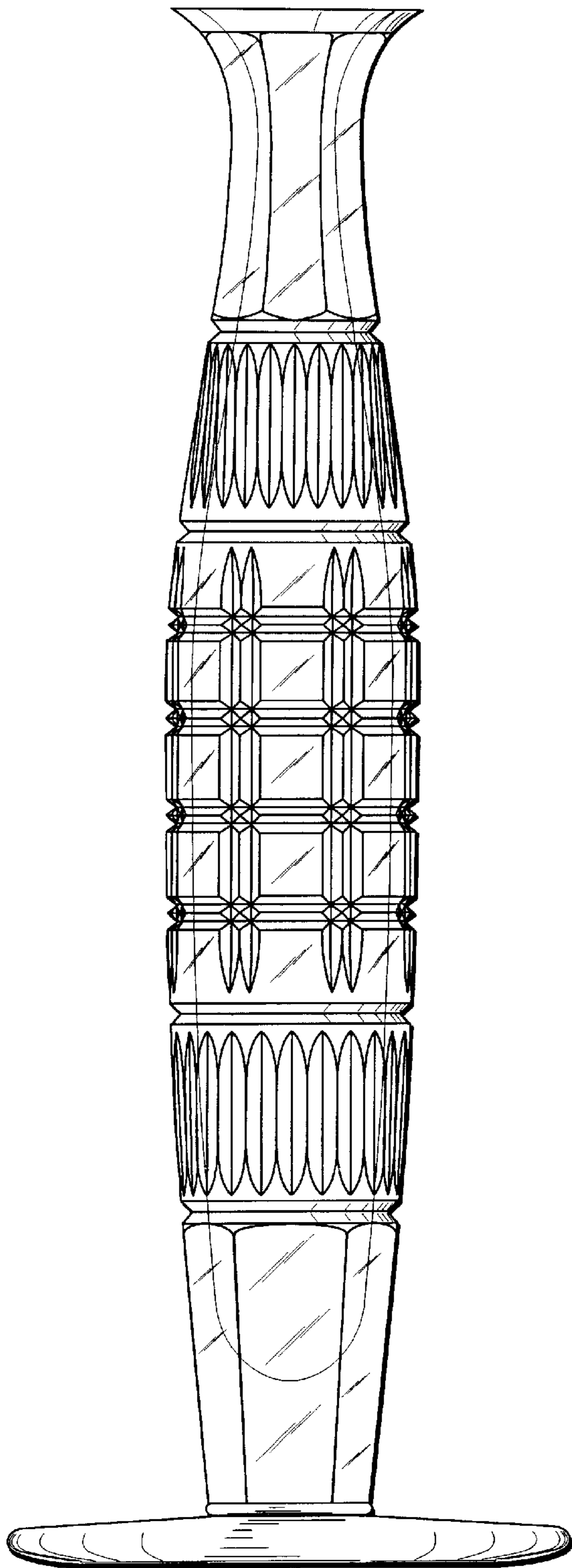

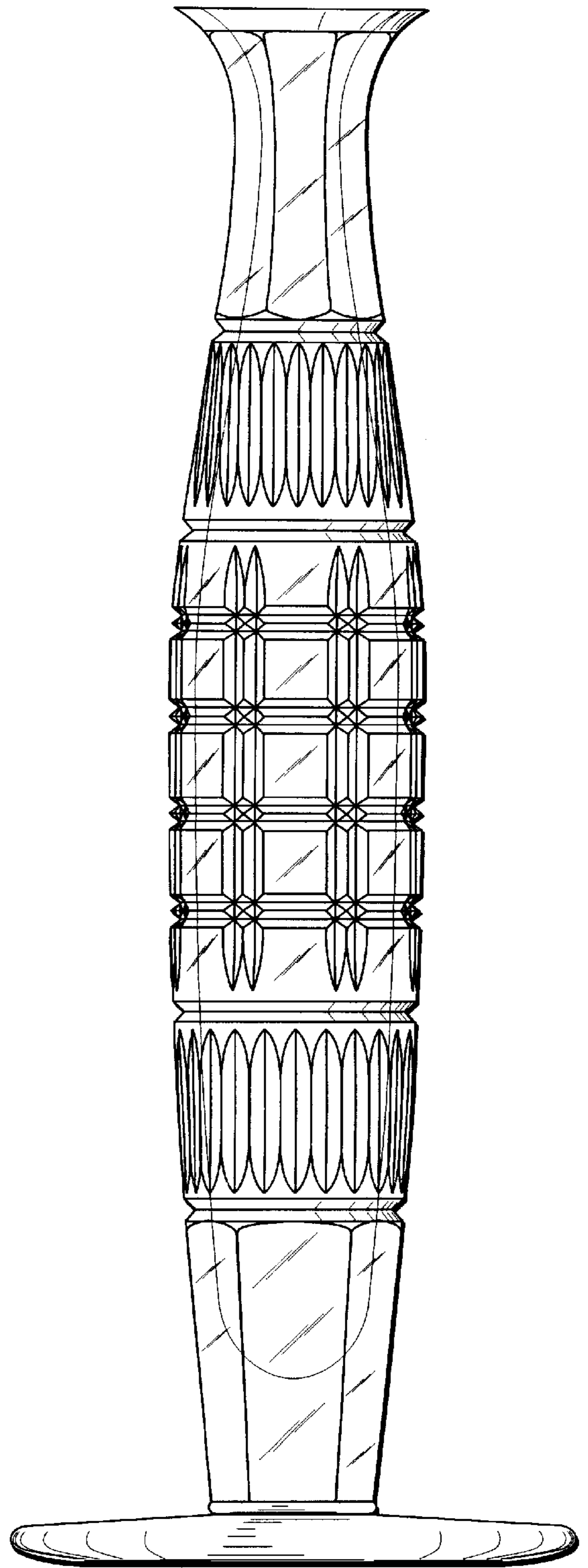

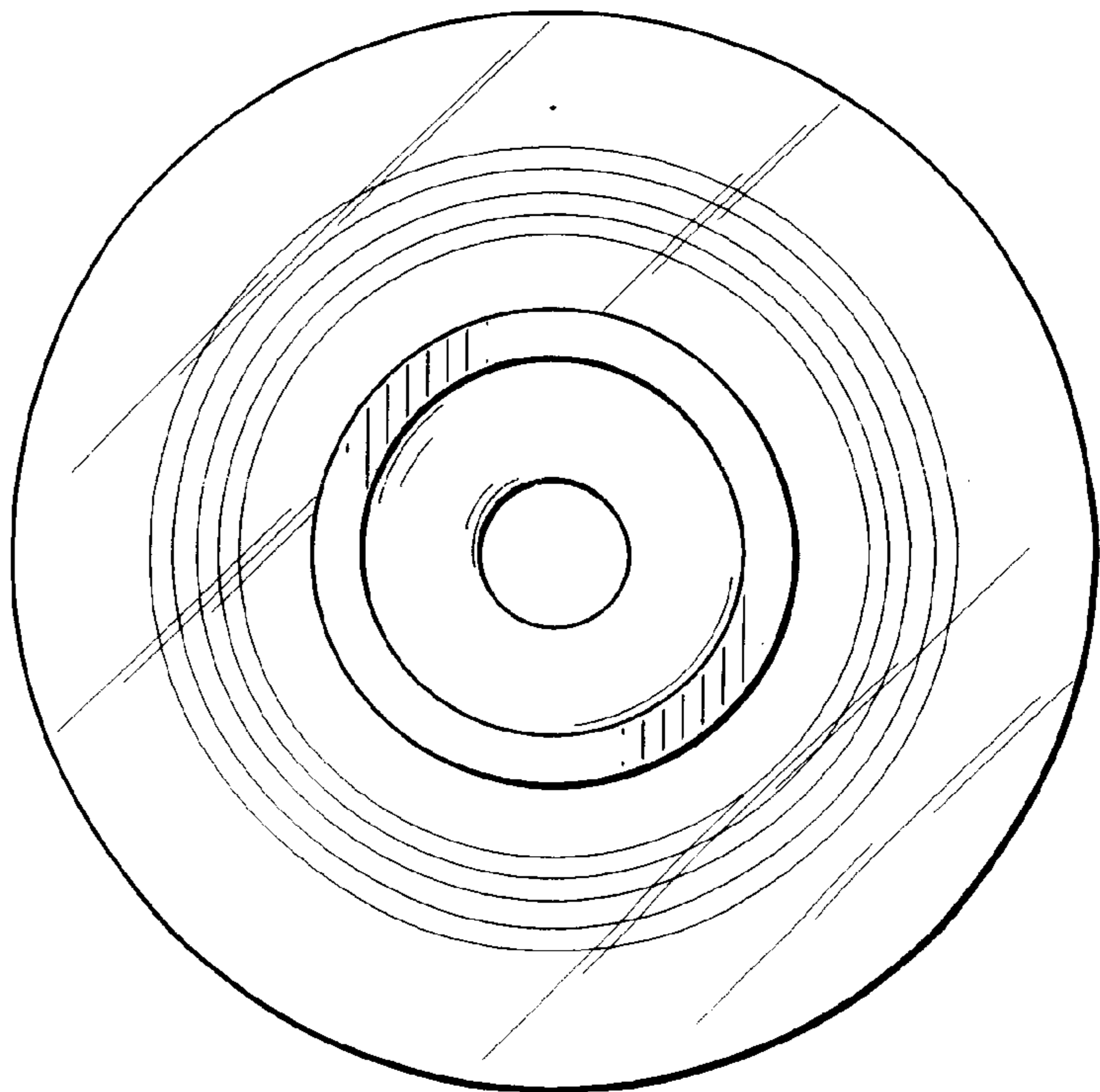
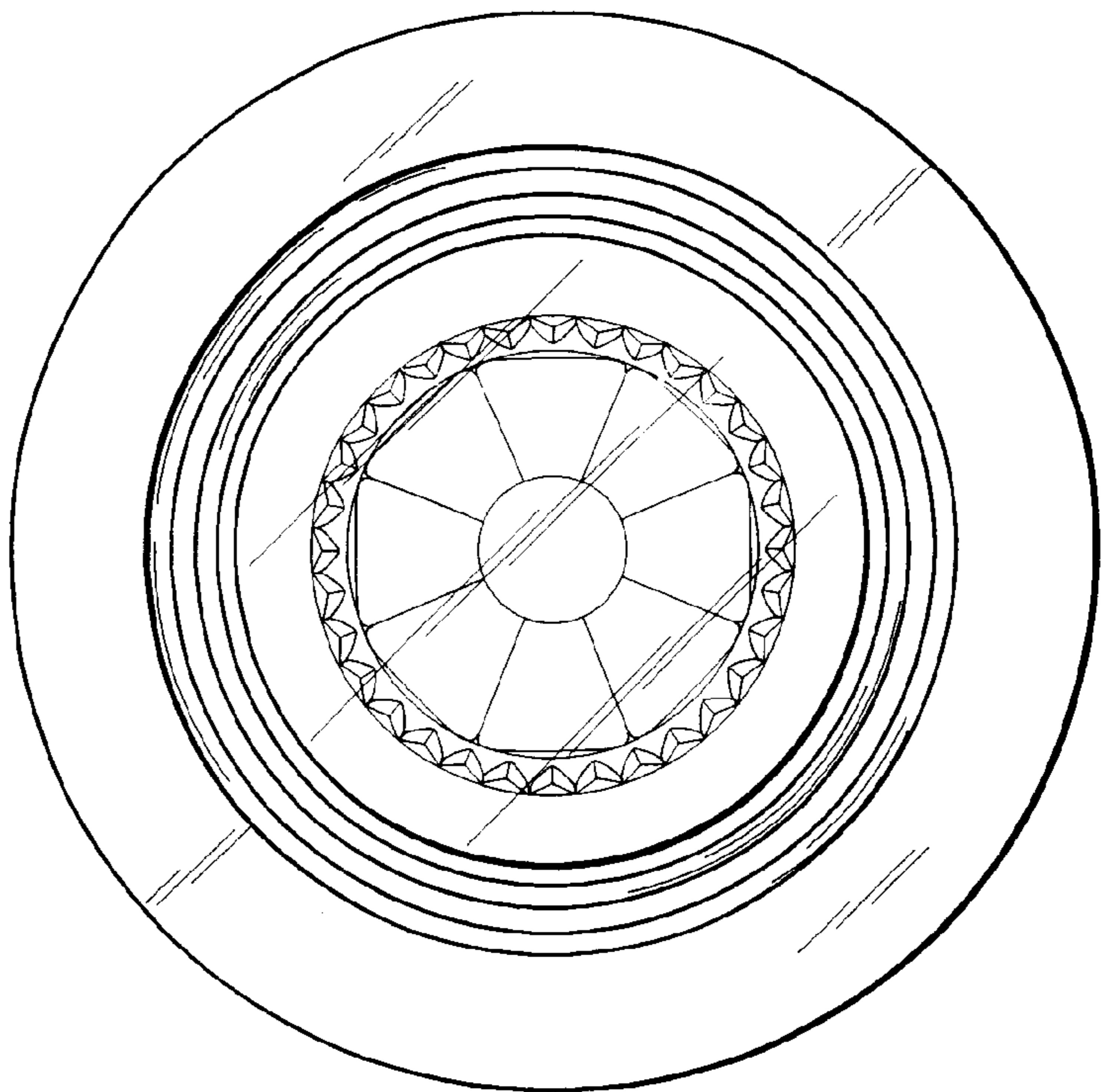

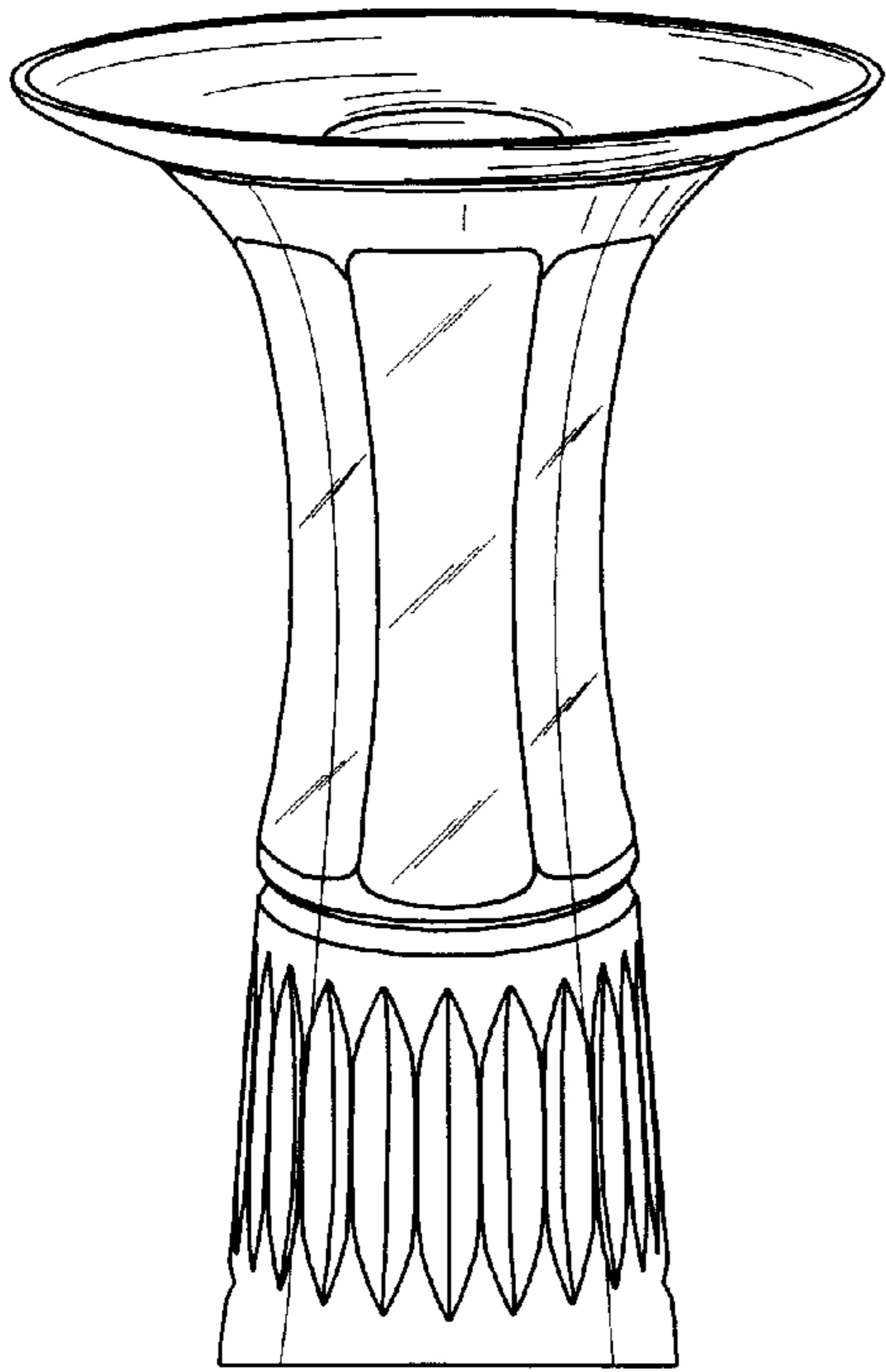

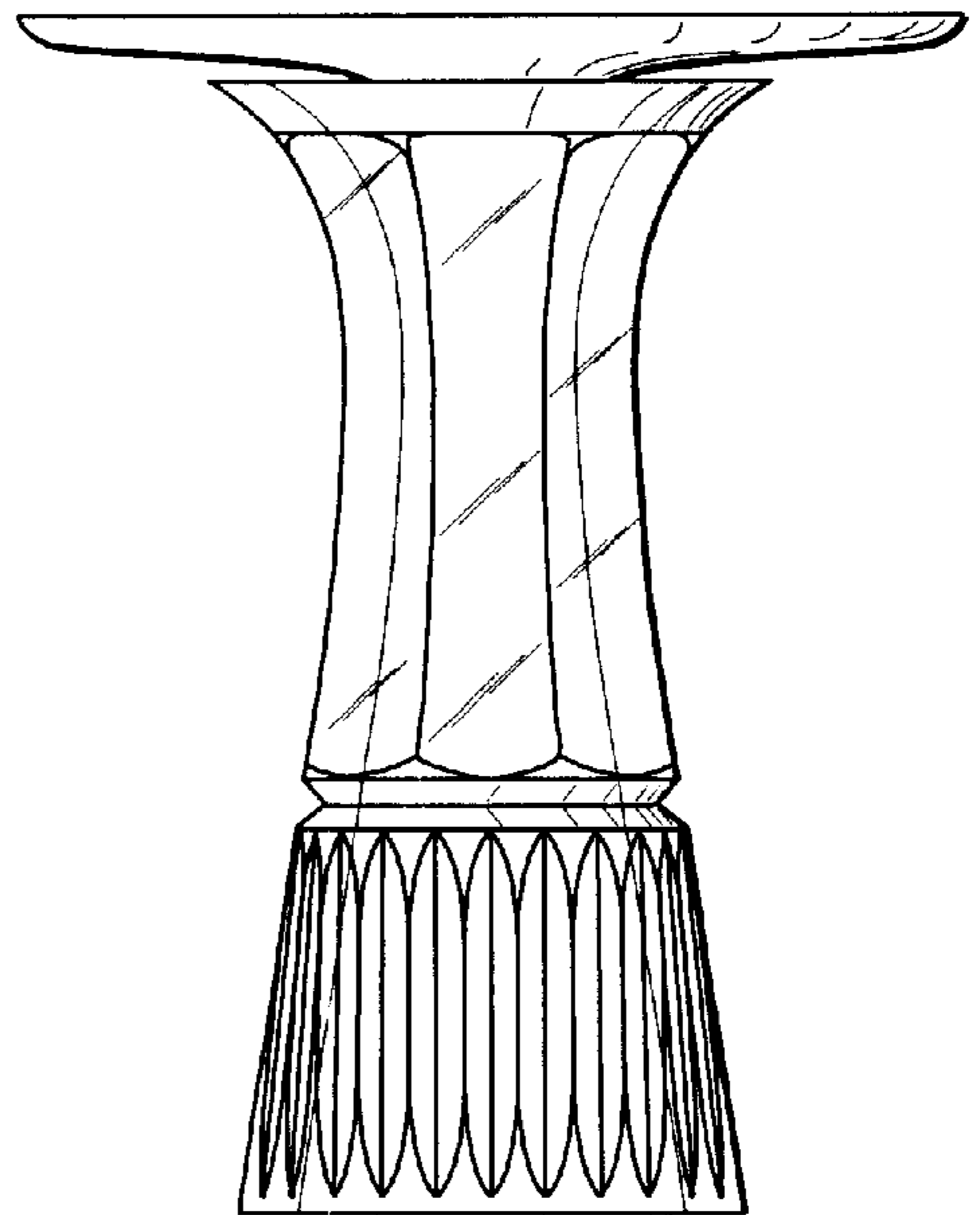

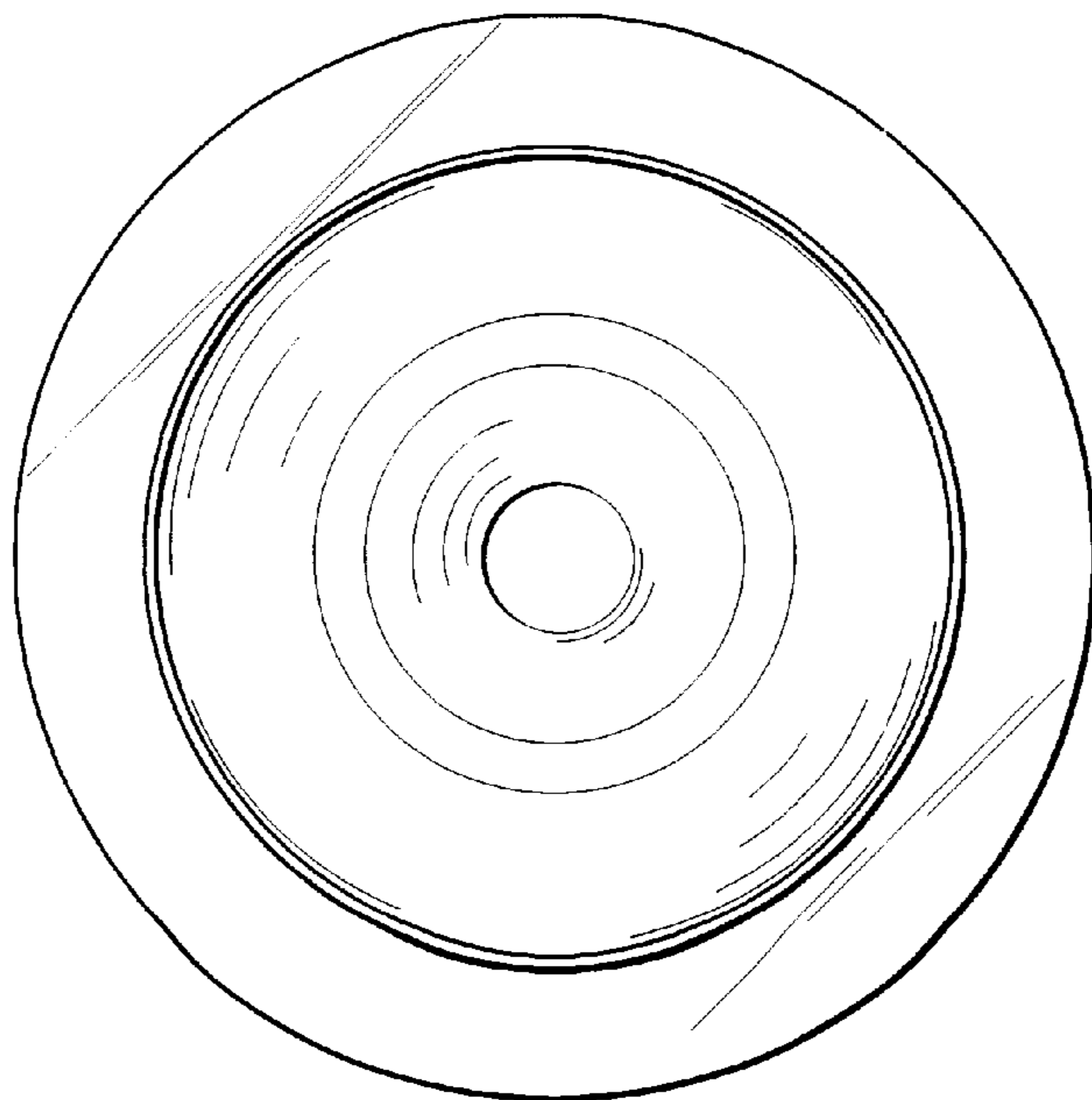
