FIG. 3 is a left side view thereof.

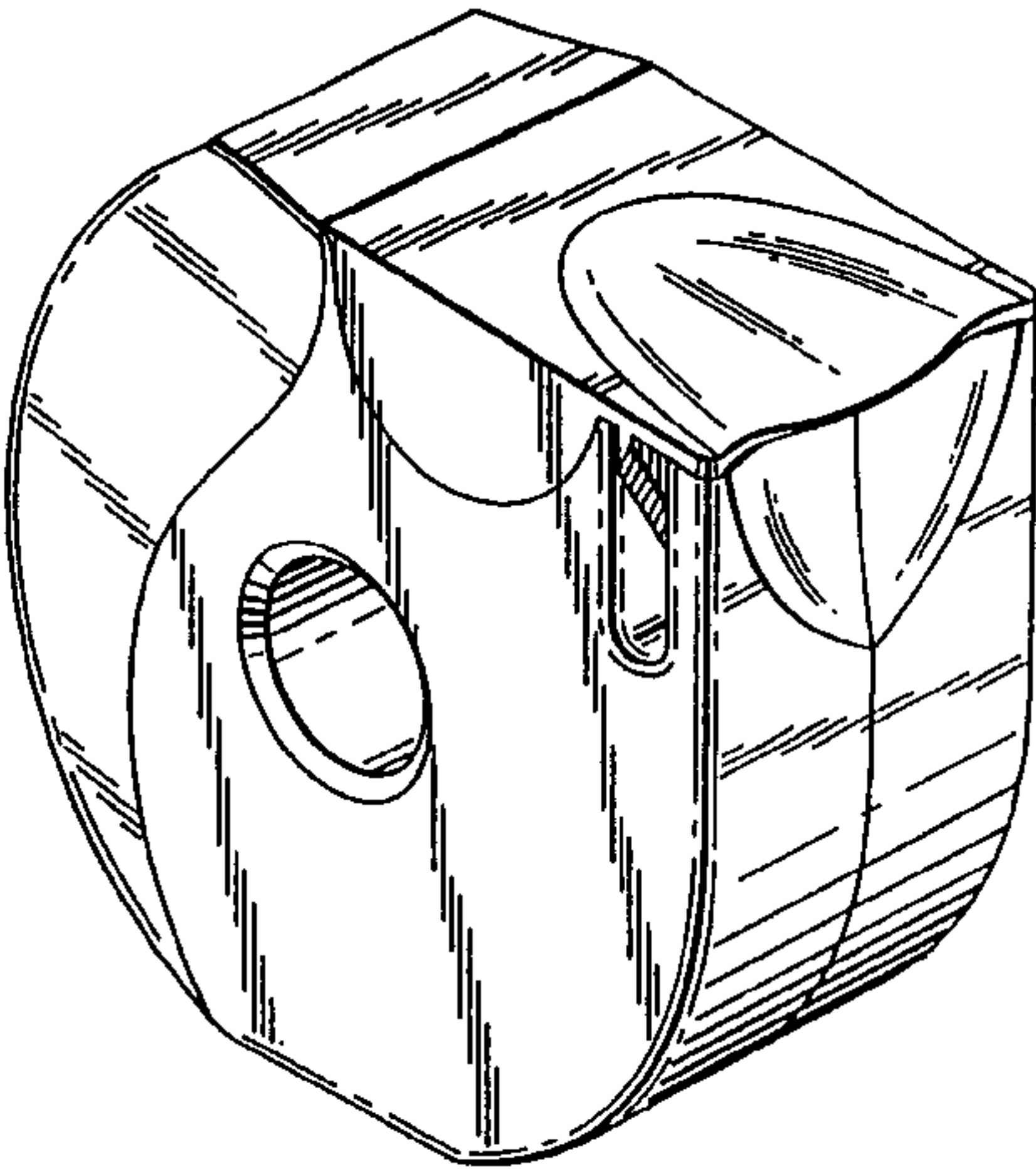


FIG. 4 is a top view thereof.

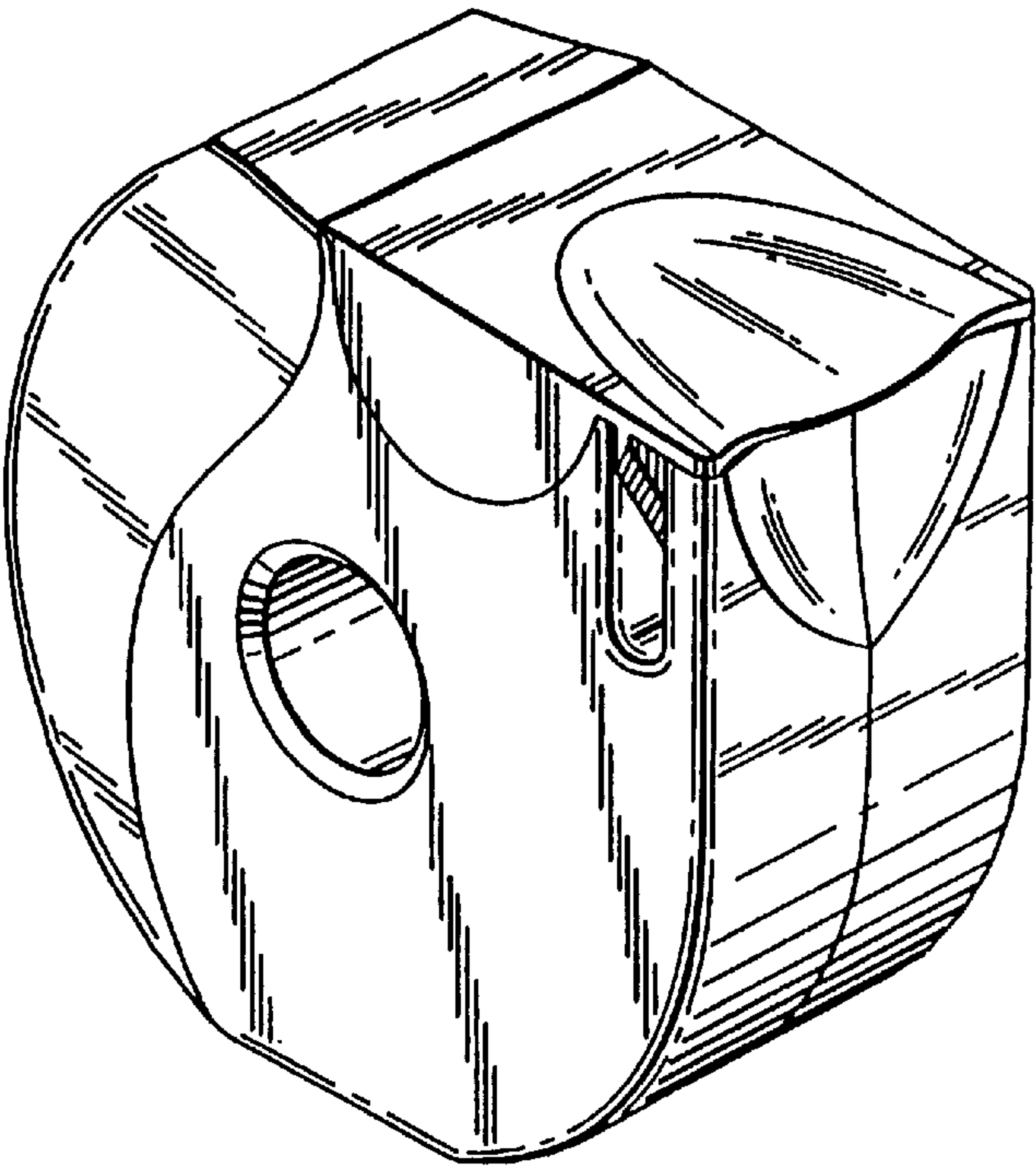

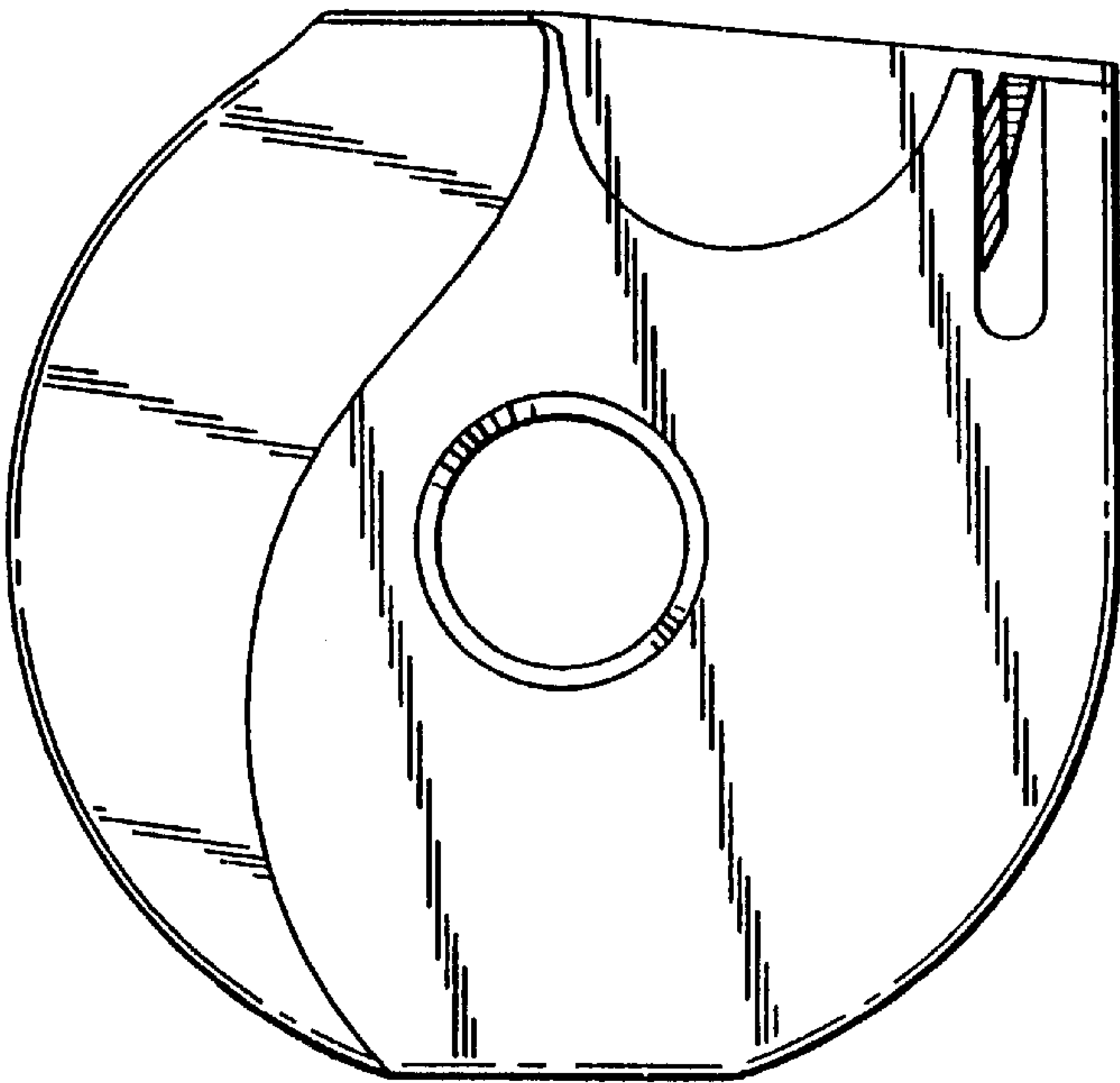

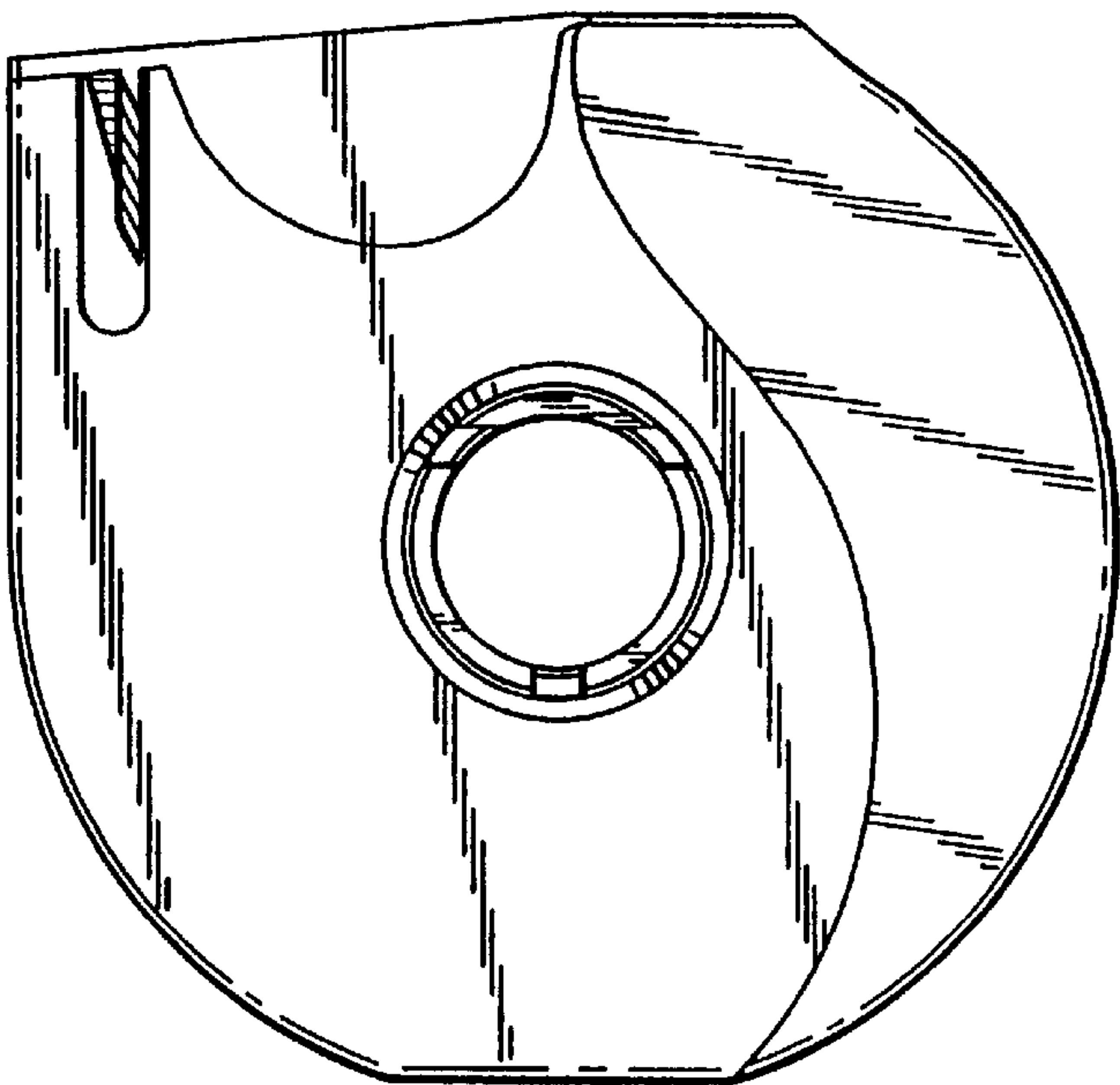

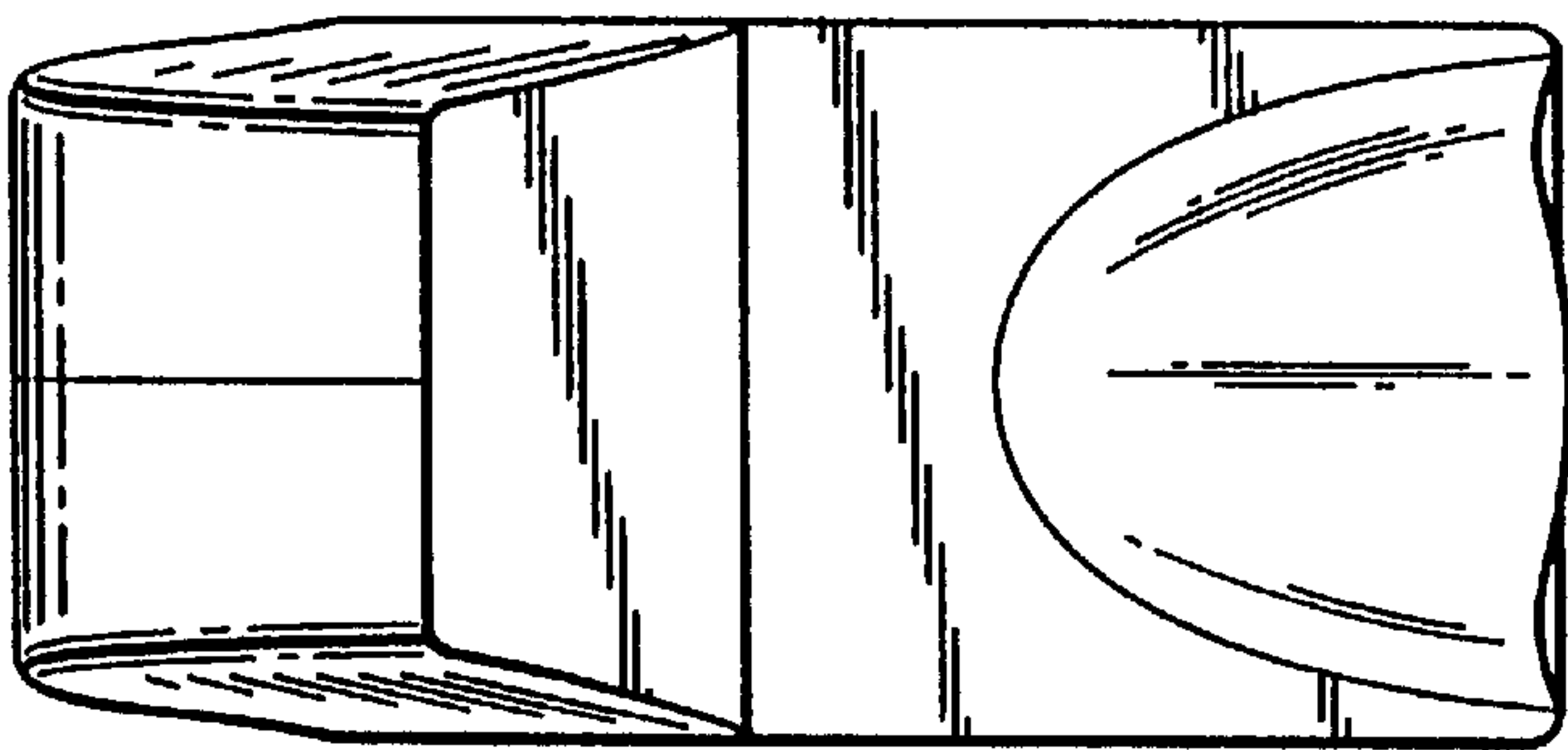

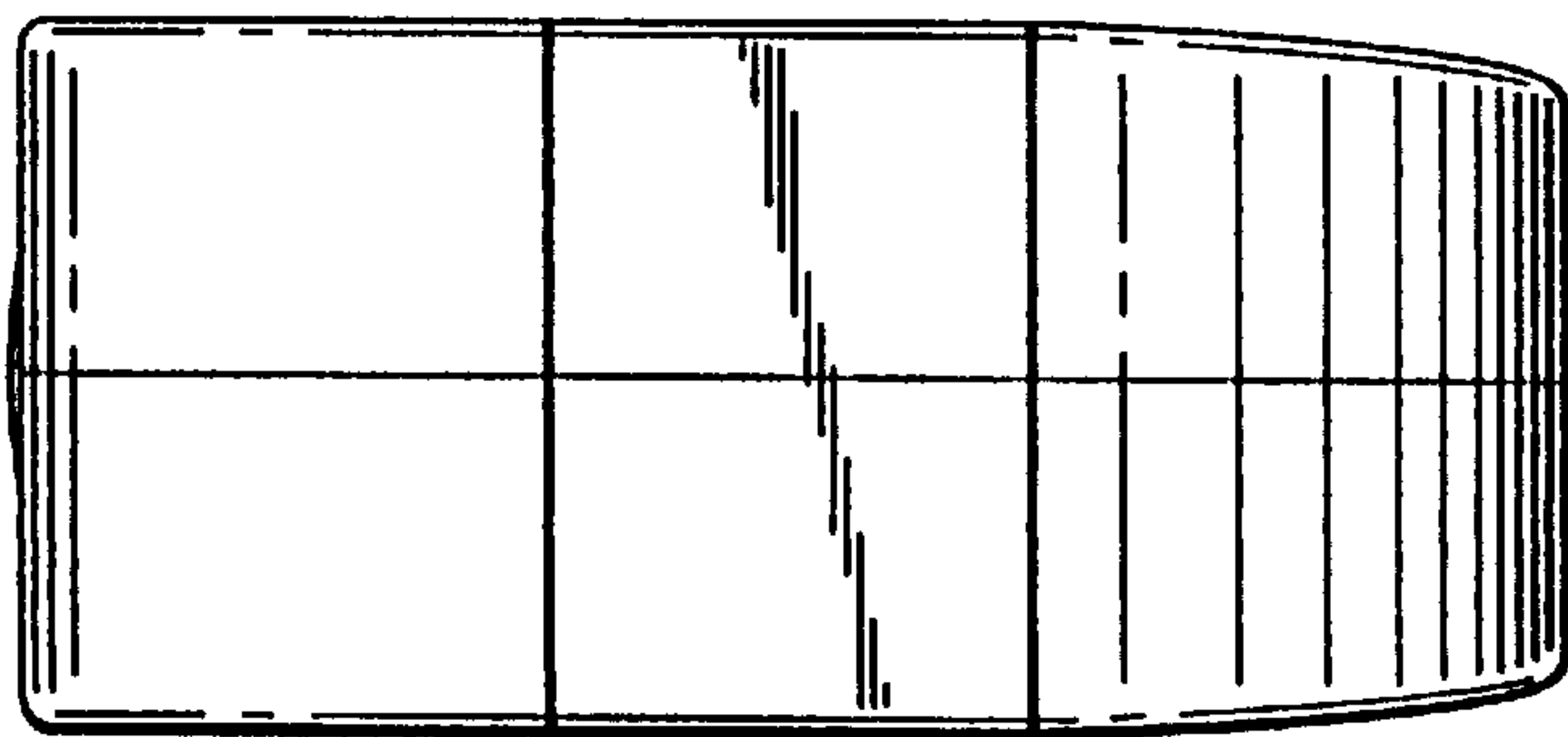

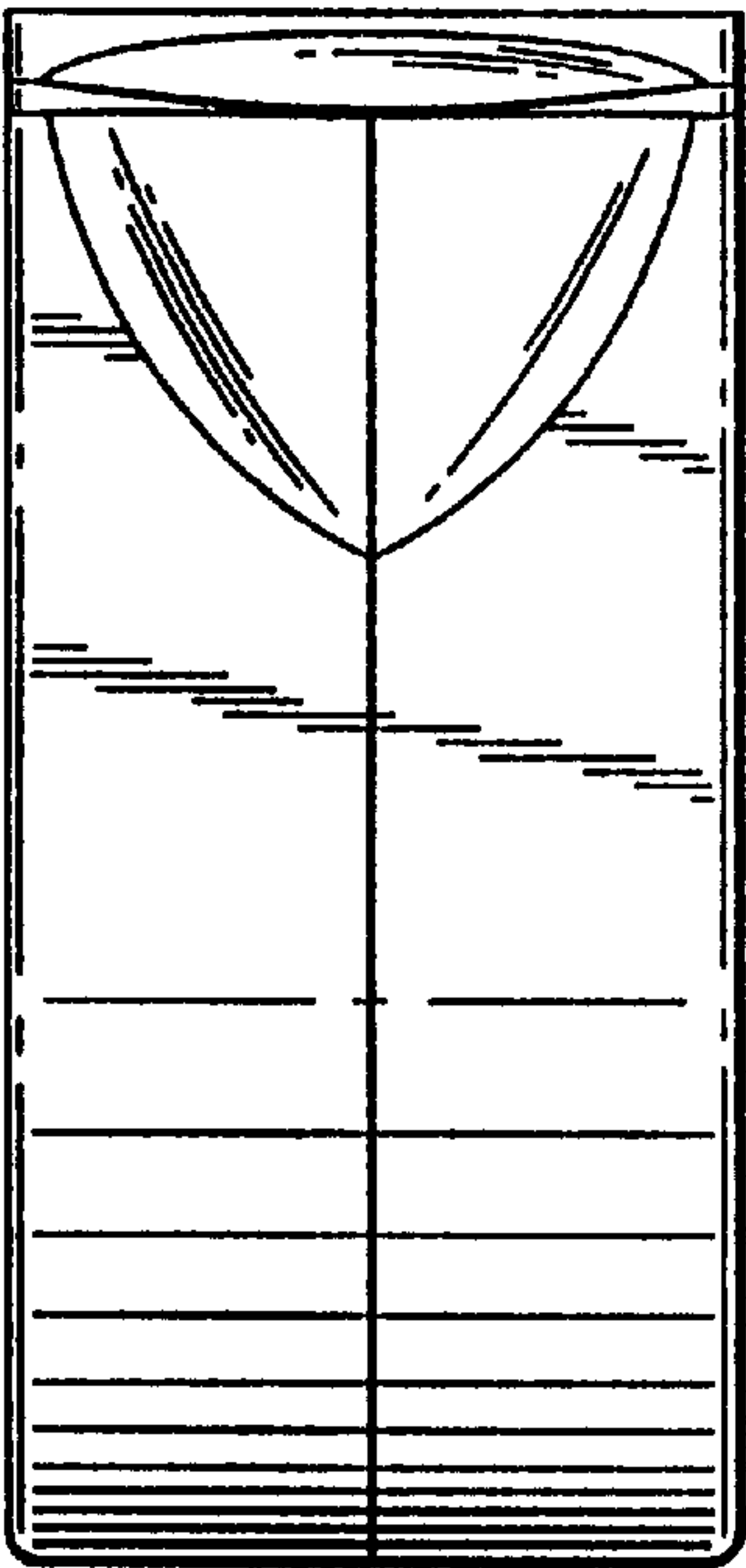

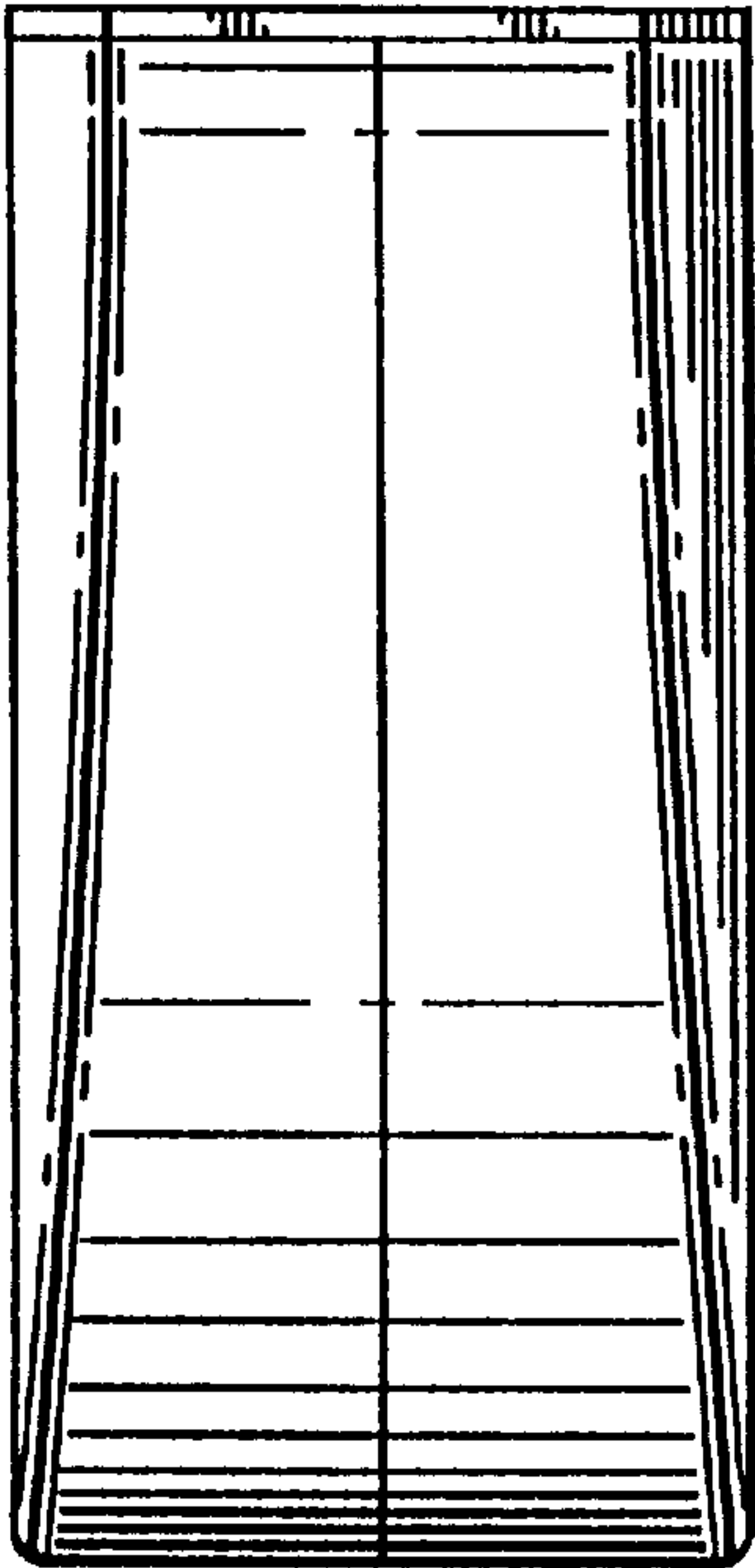
