FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof;

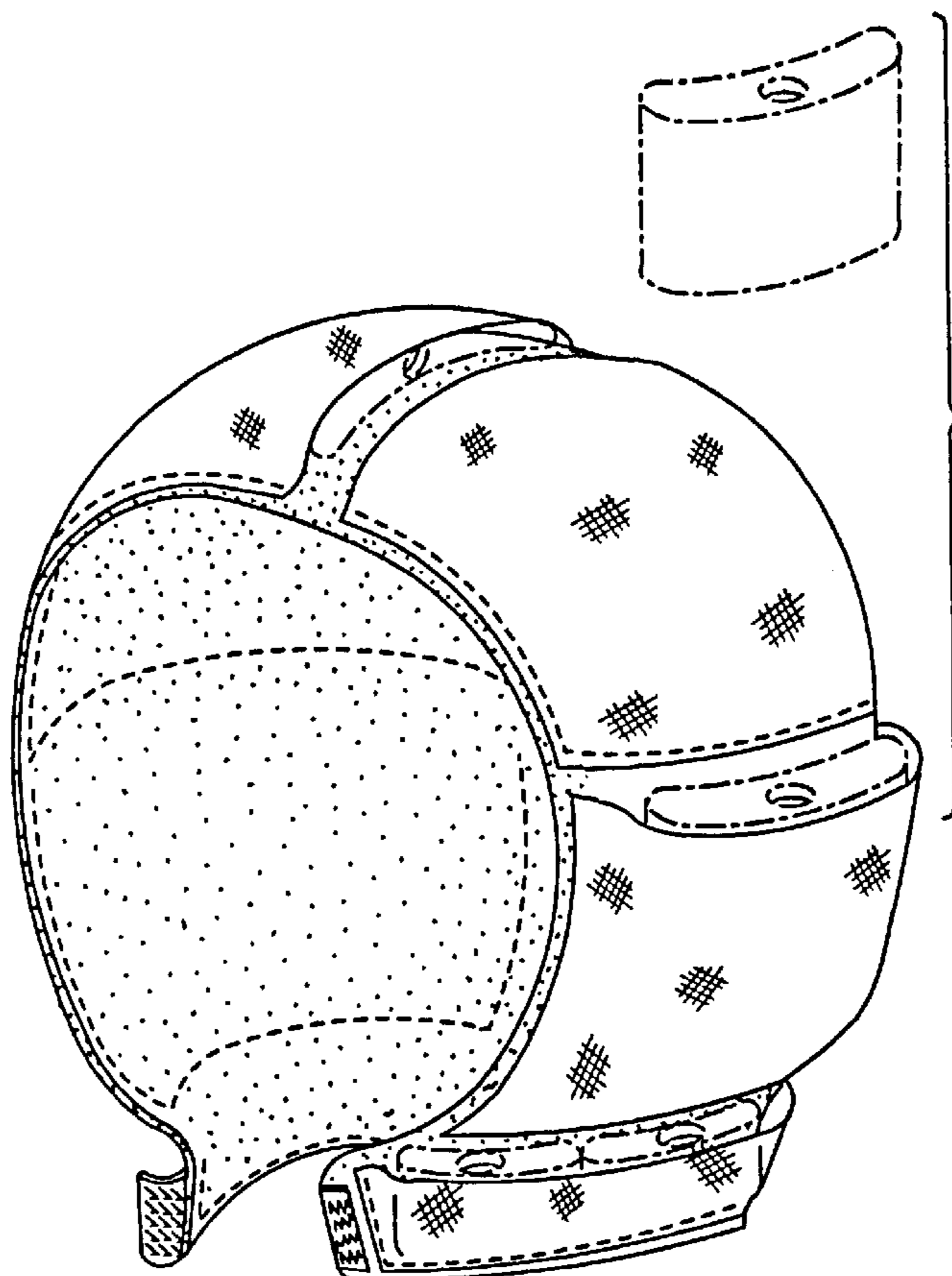
FIG. 7 shows the embodiment in a flat condition; and,

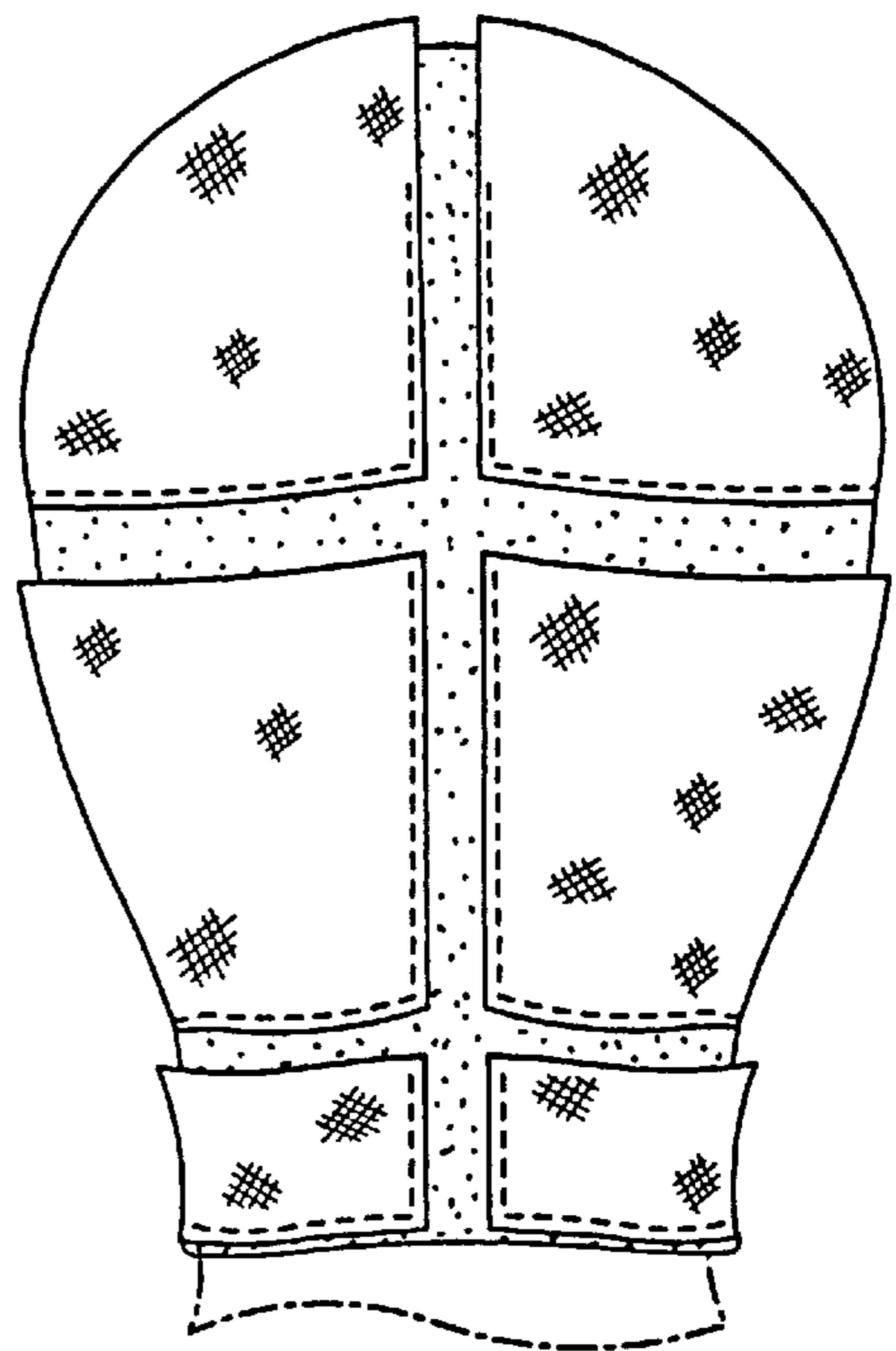
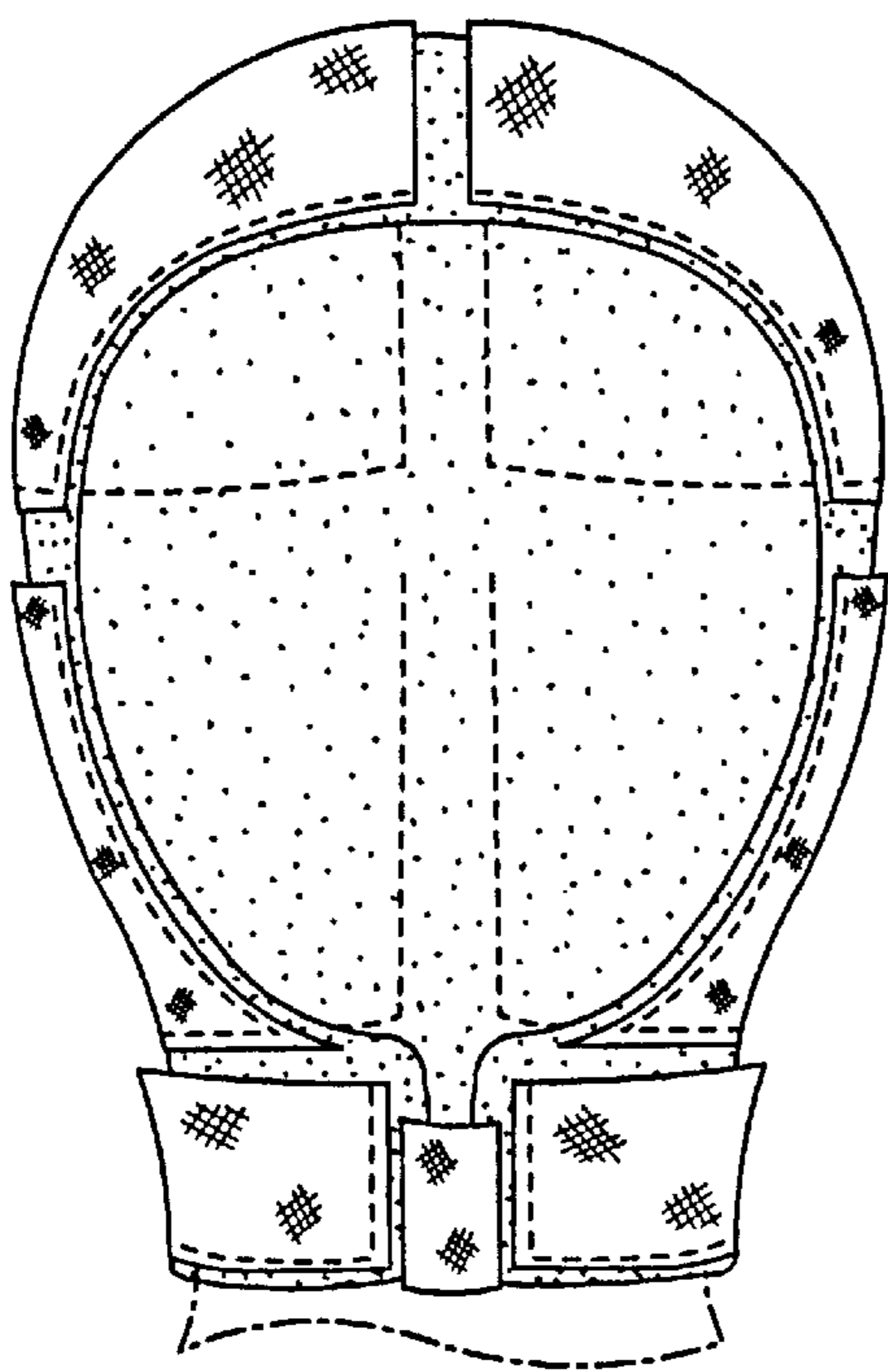
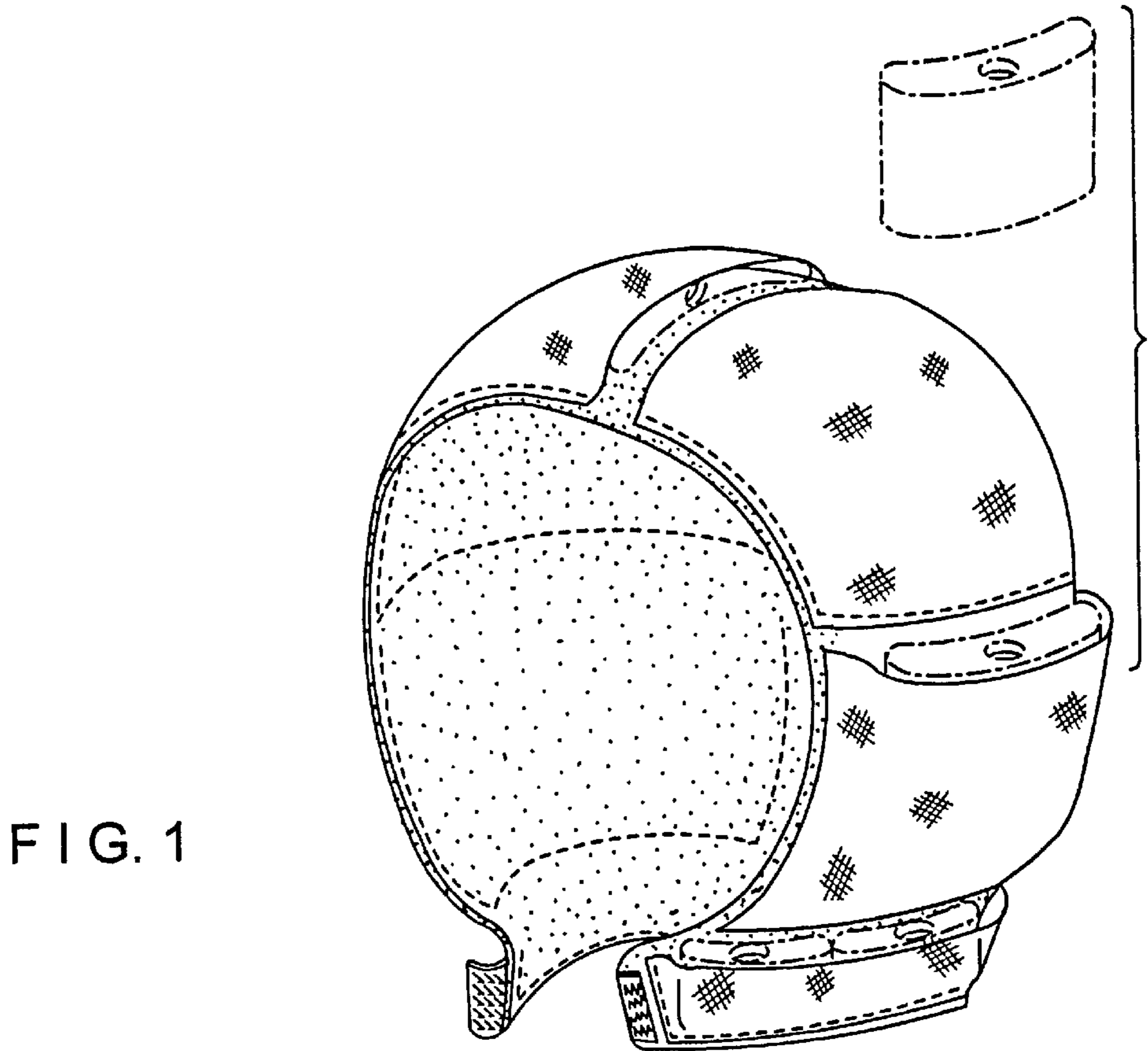
FIG. 8 is a side elevational view of FIG. 7.

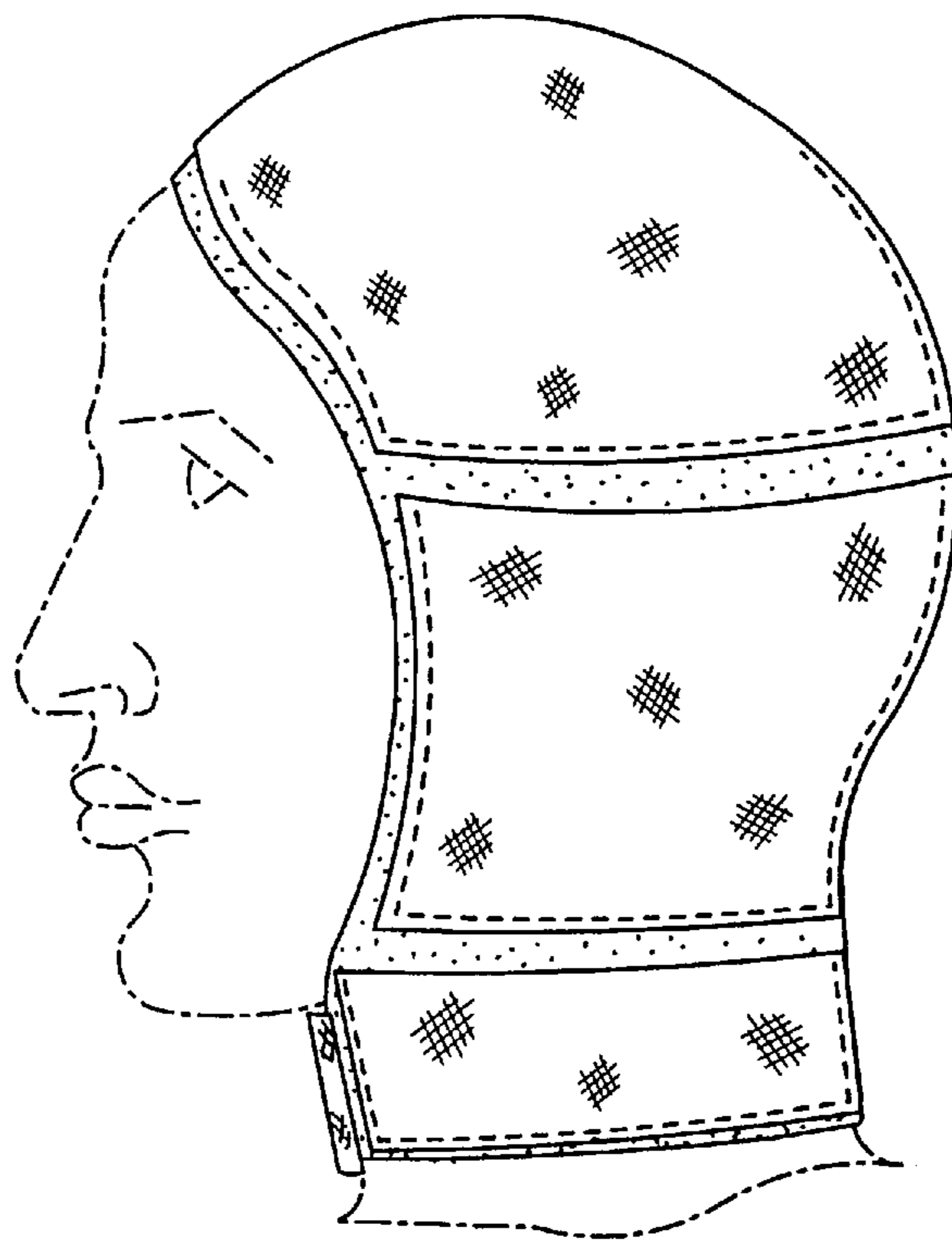

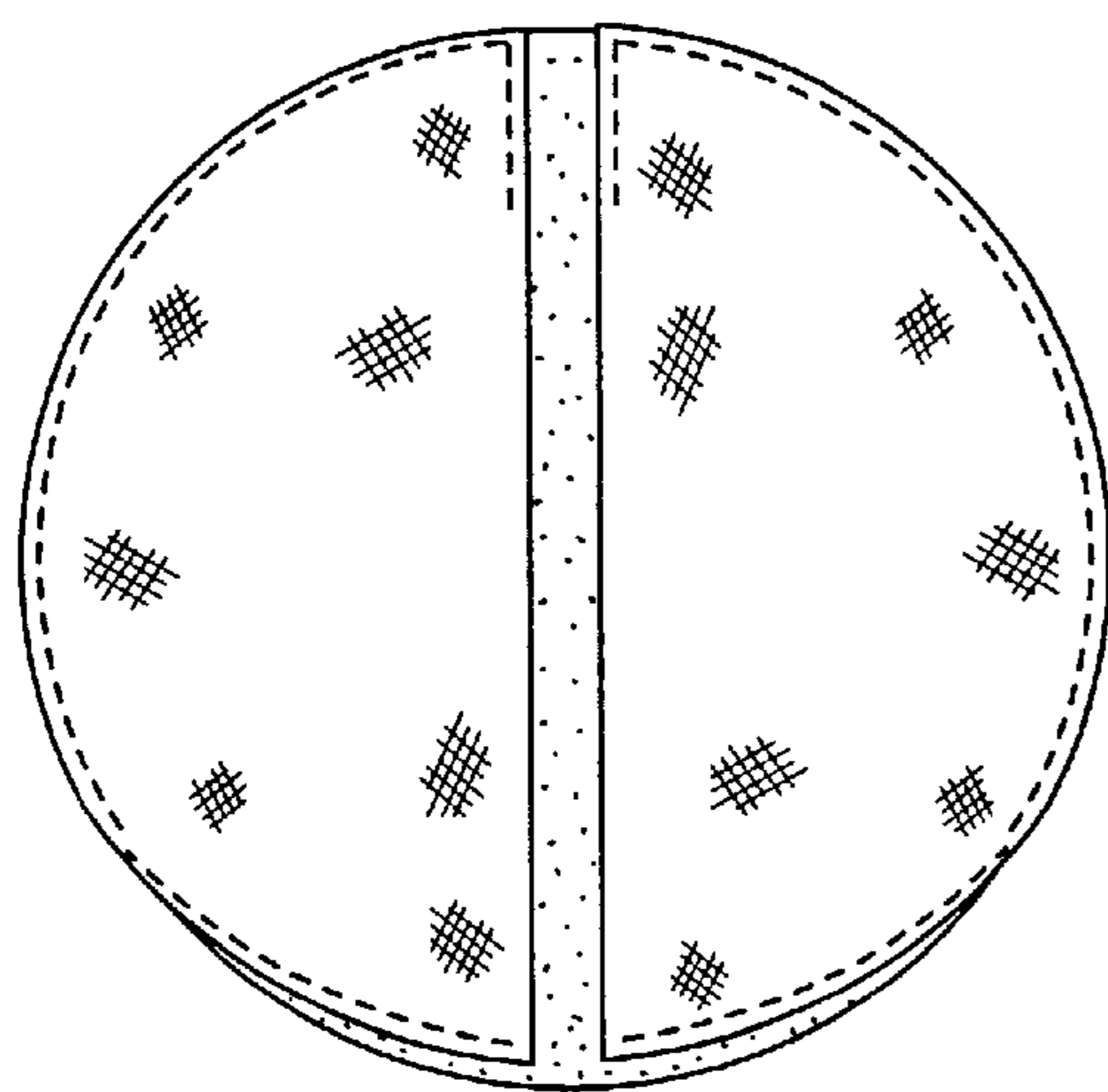

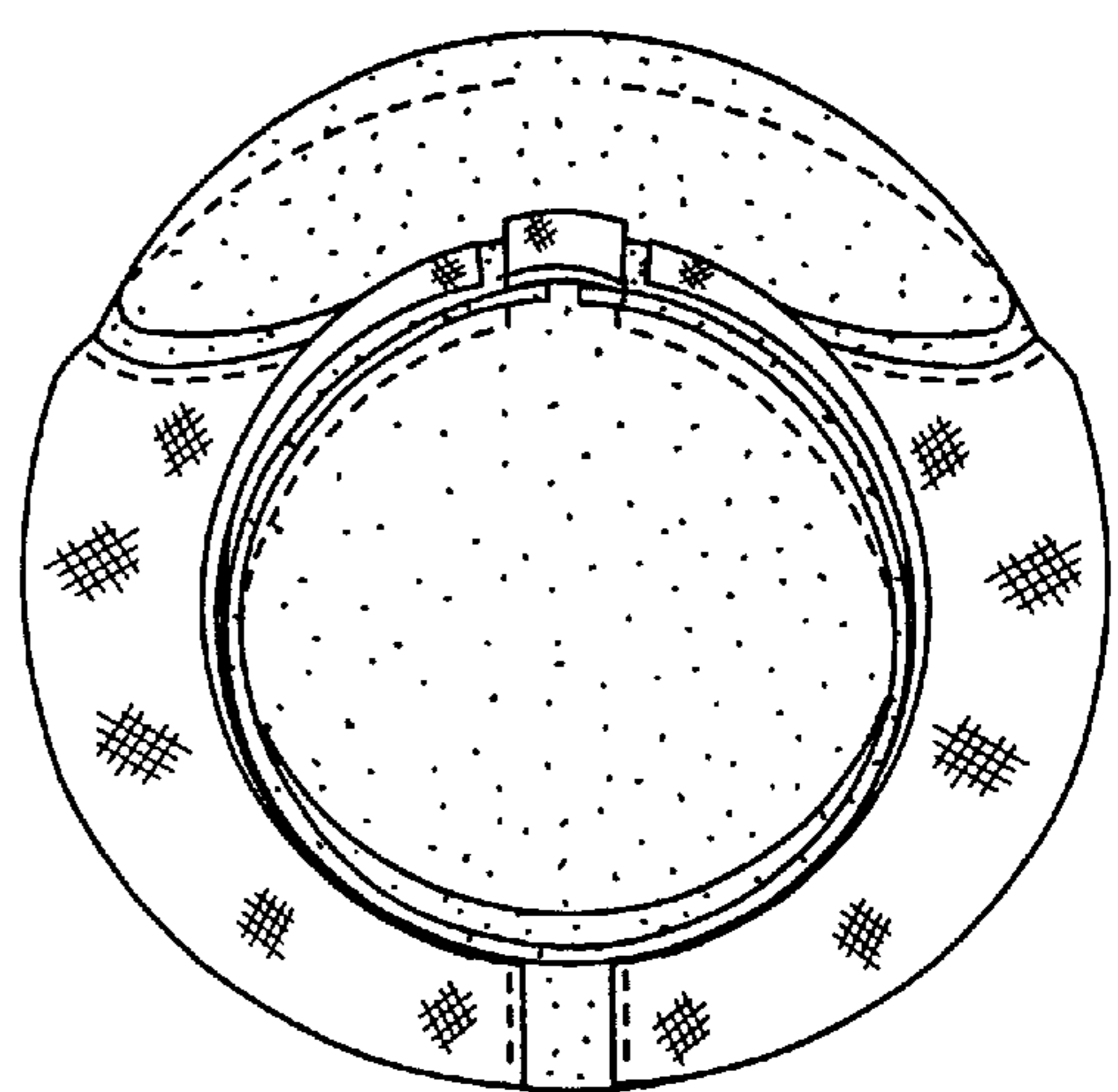

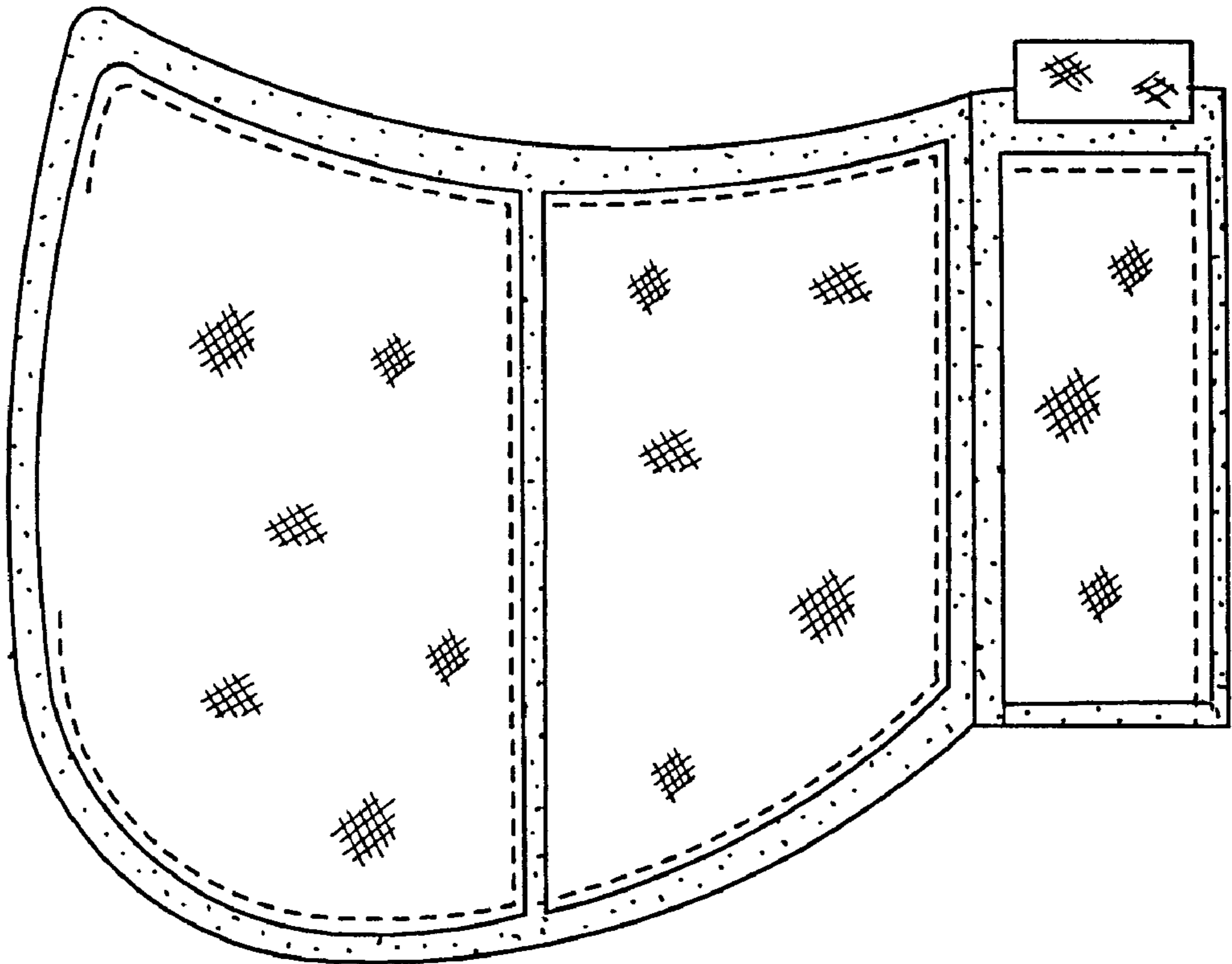

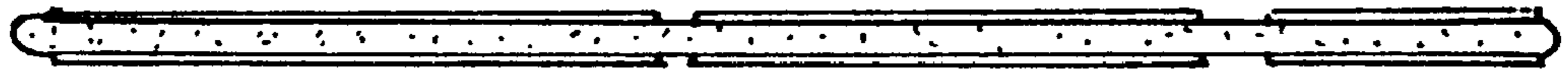
