DESCRIPTION

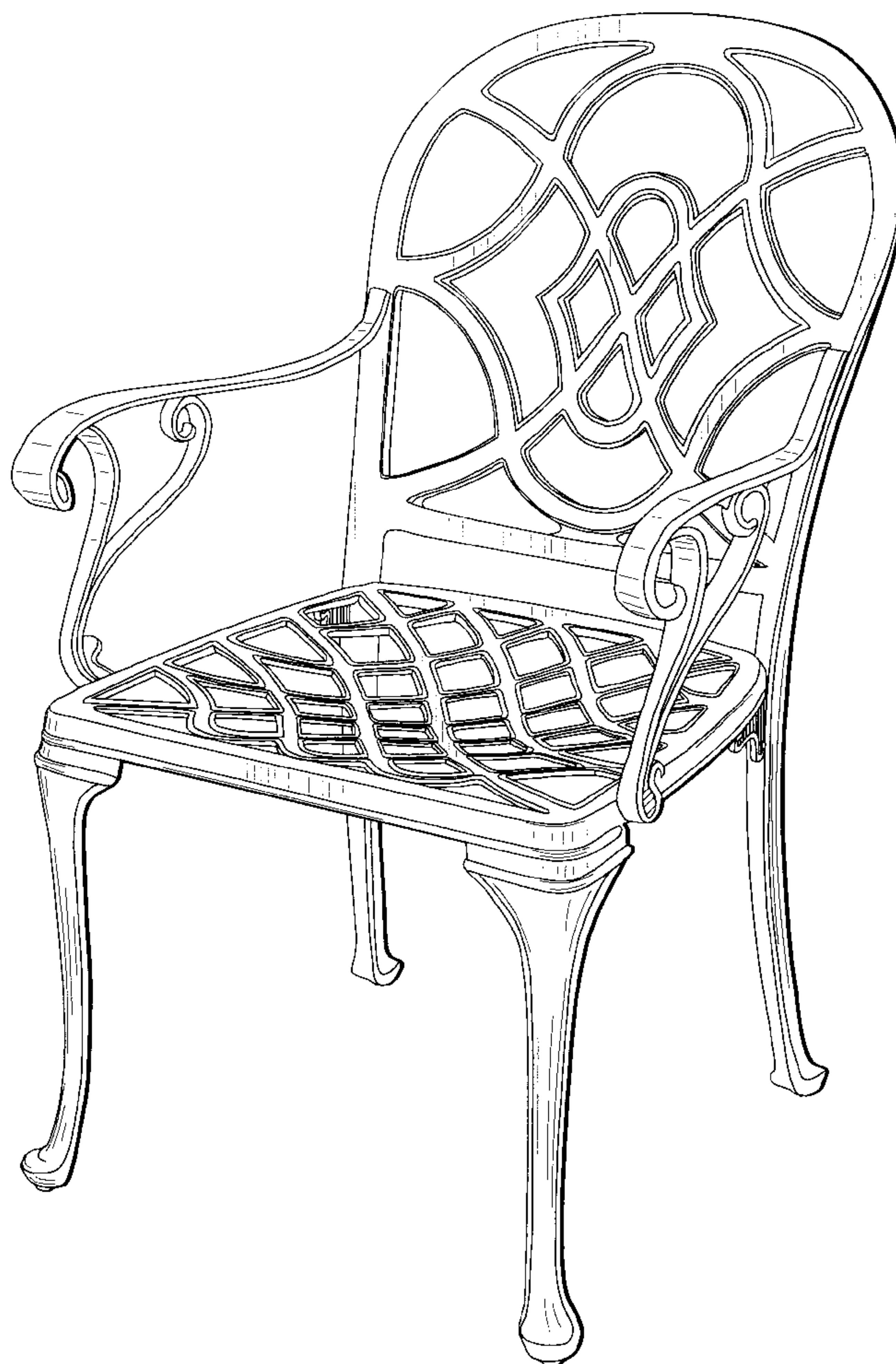
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of our new design for a chair as seen from a point above and to one side of the design.

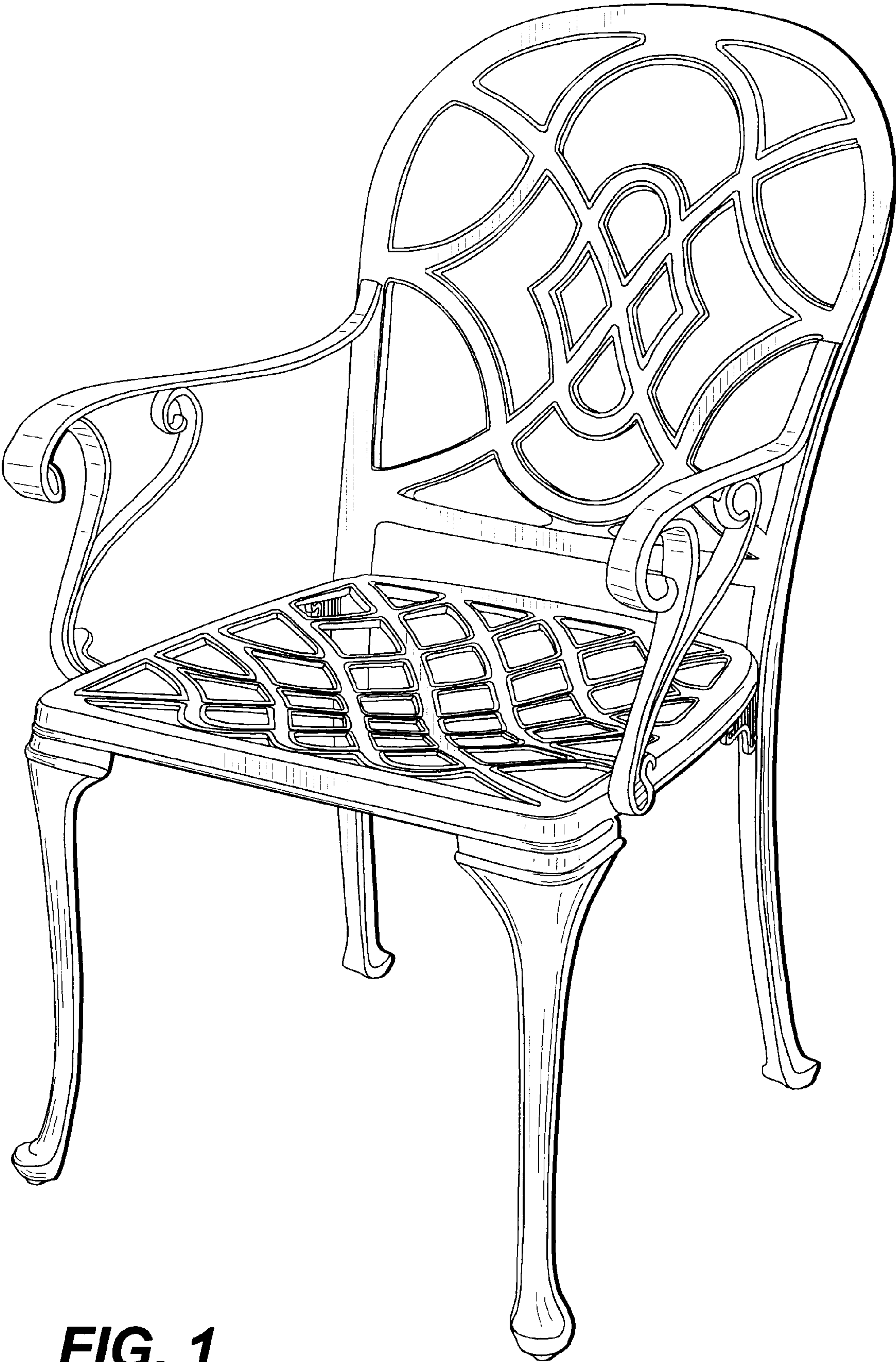

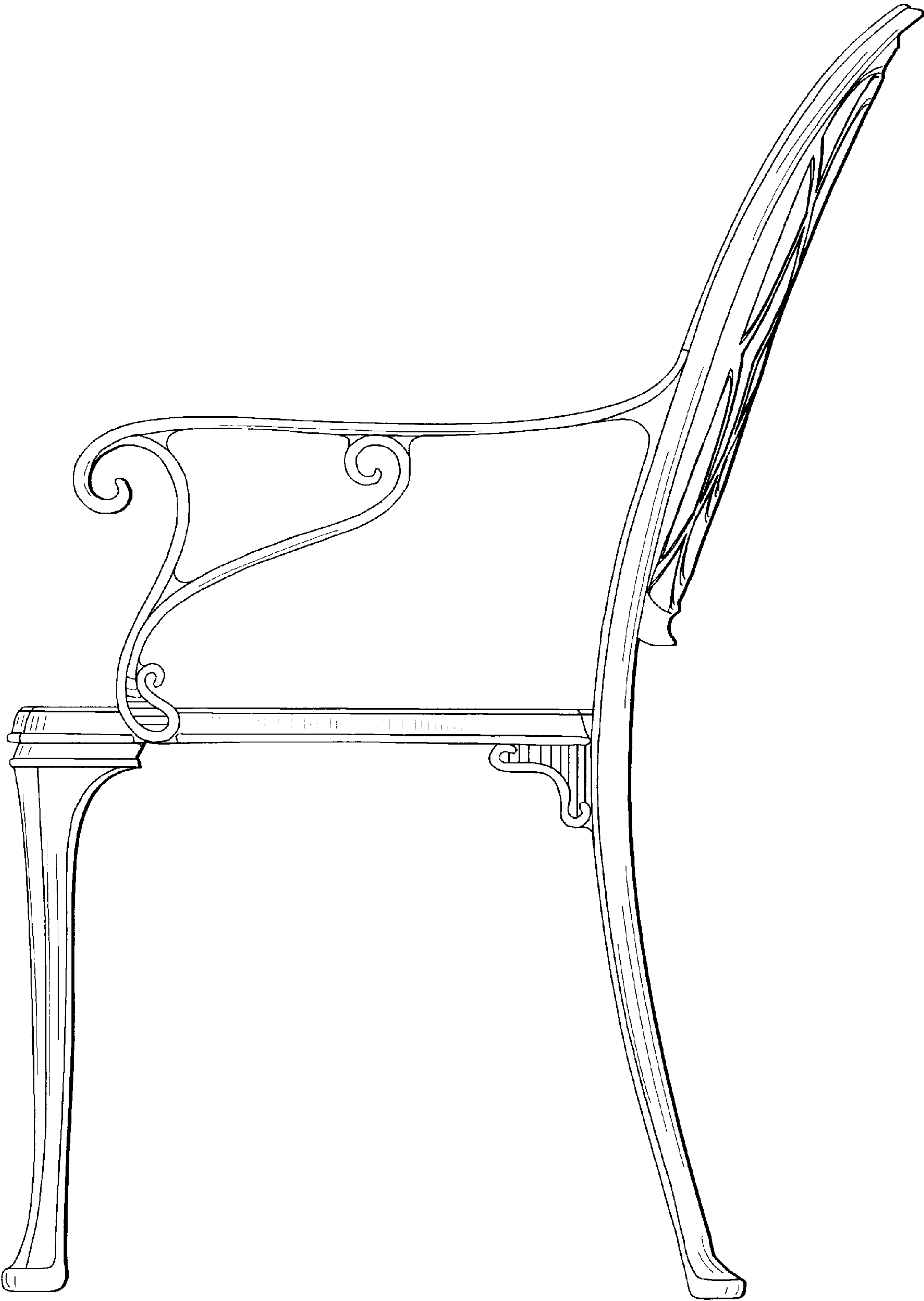

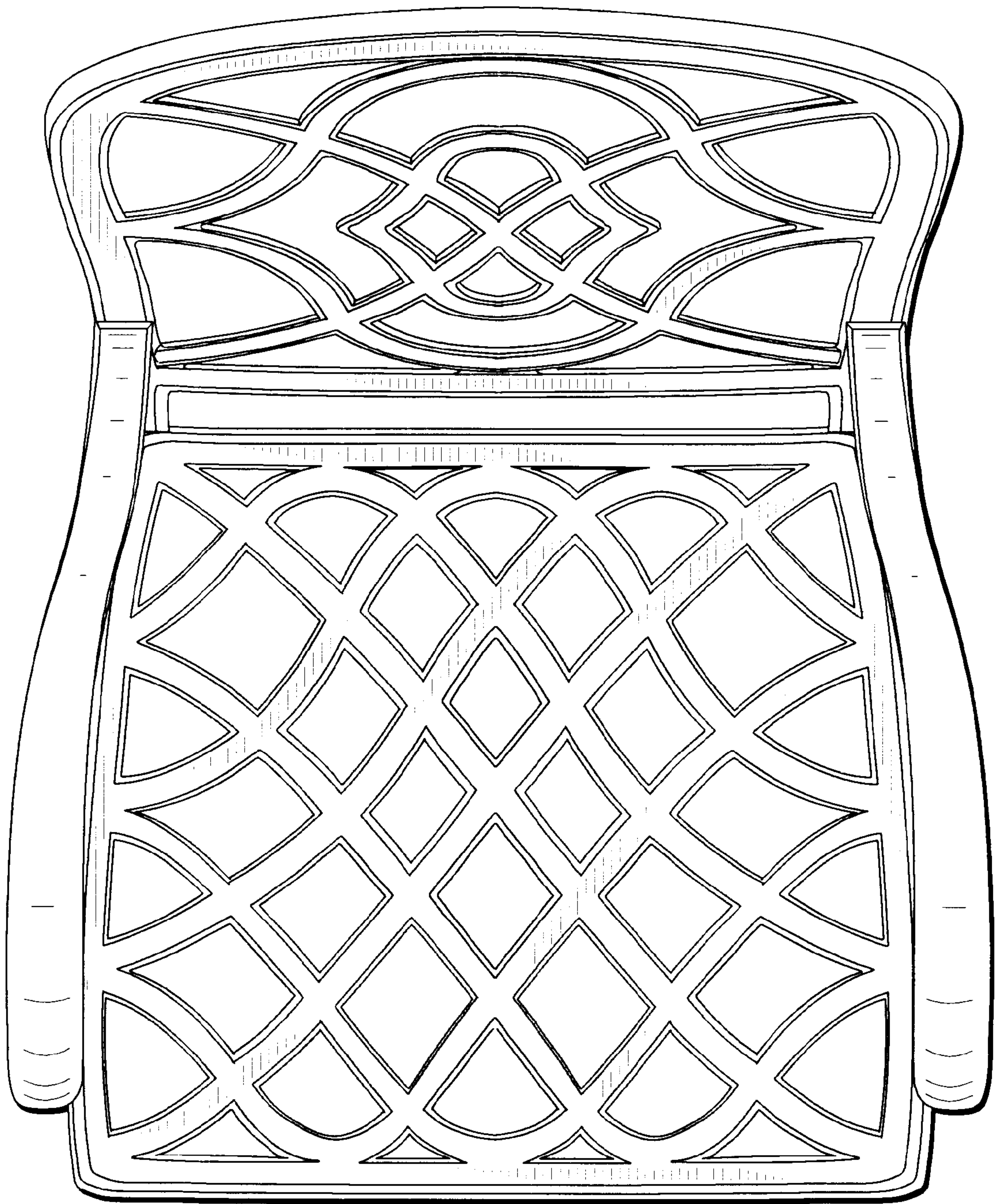
