[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a temperature monitoring transmitter and receiver, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of the temperature monitoring transmitter and receiver of the present invention; FIG. 2 is a back elevational view of the temperature monitoring transmitter and receiver of FIG. 1; FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view of the temperature monitoring transmitter and receiver of FIG. 1; FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view of the temperature monitoring transmitter and receiver of FIG. 1; FIG. 5 is a top plan view of the temperature monitoring transmitter and receiver of FIG. 1; and, FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of the temperature monitoring transmitter and receiver of FIG. 1. The broken lines shown on FIG. 2 are indicative of back-stitching.

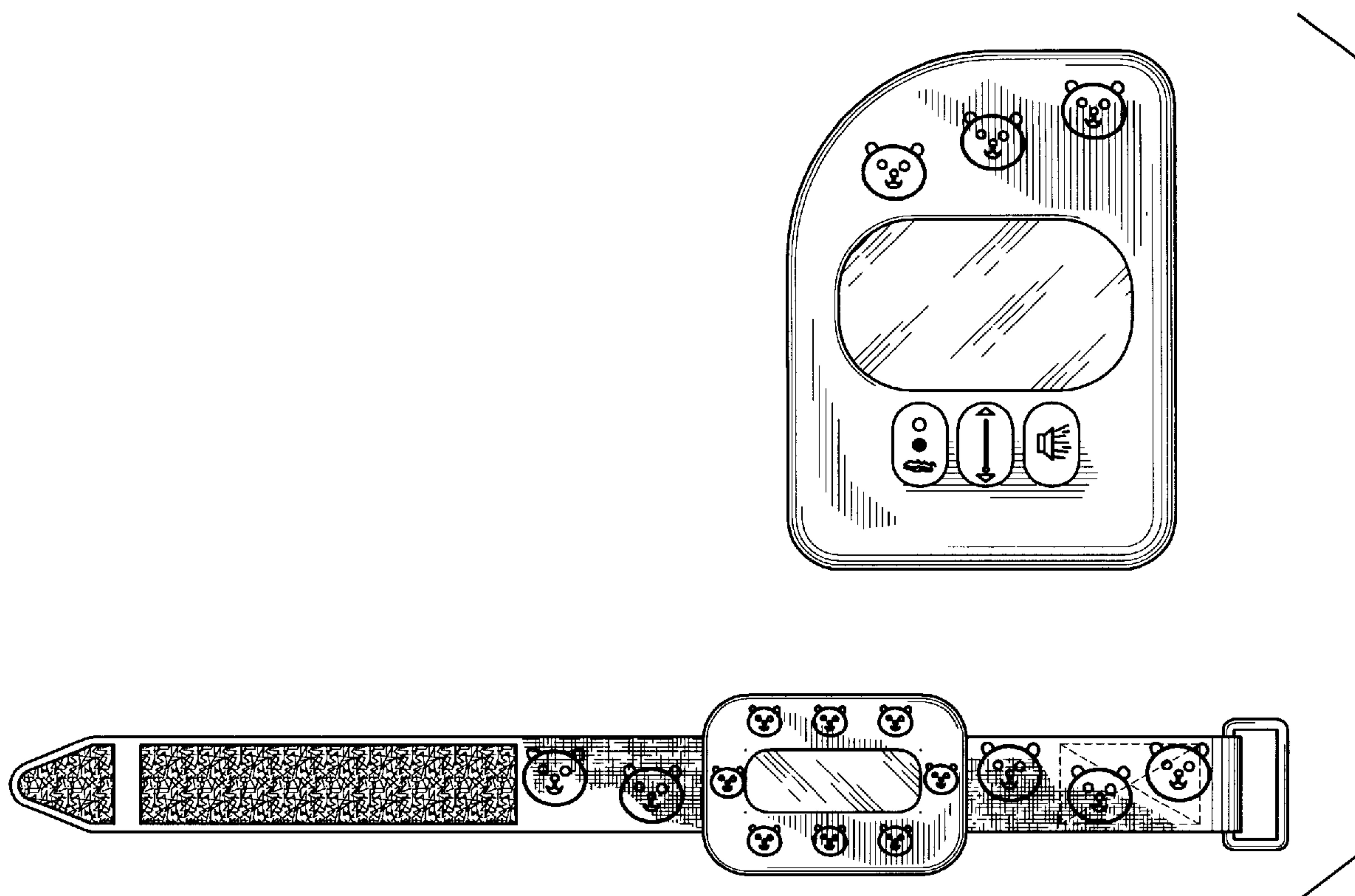

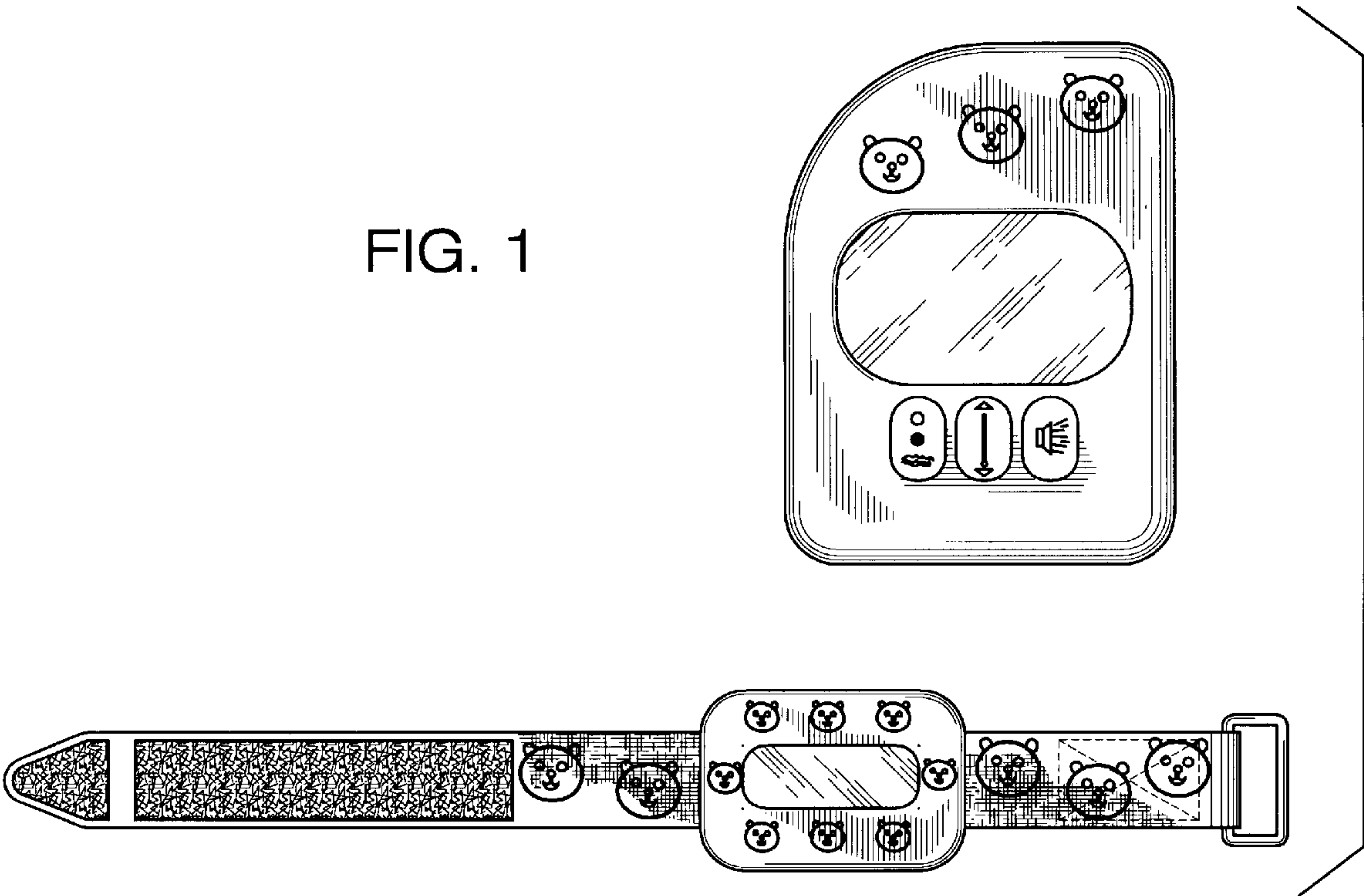

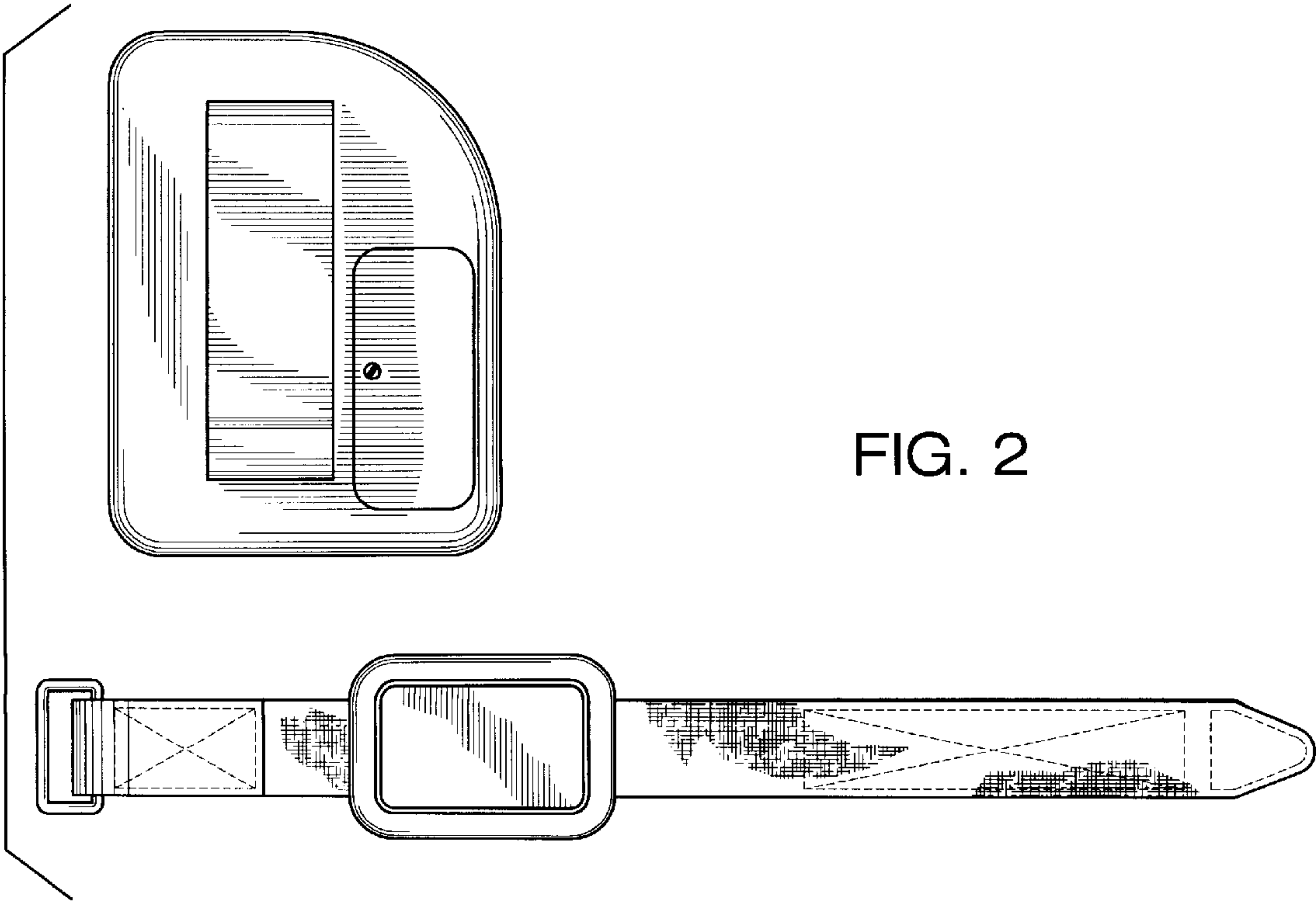

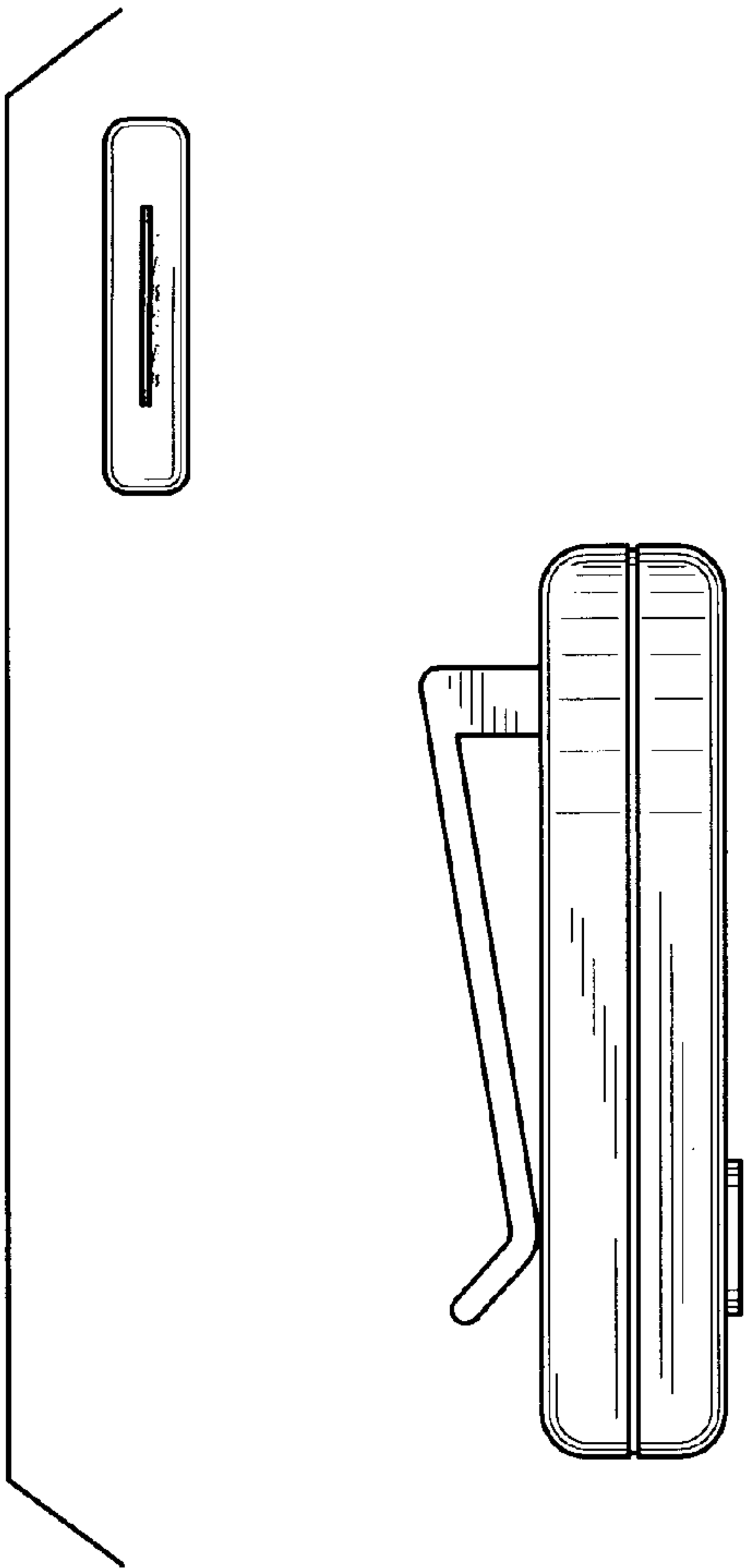

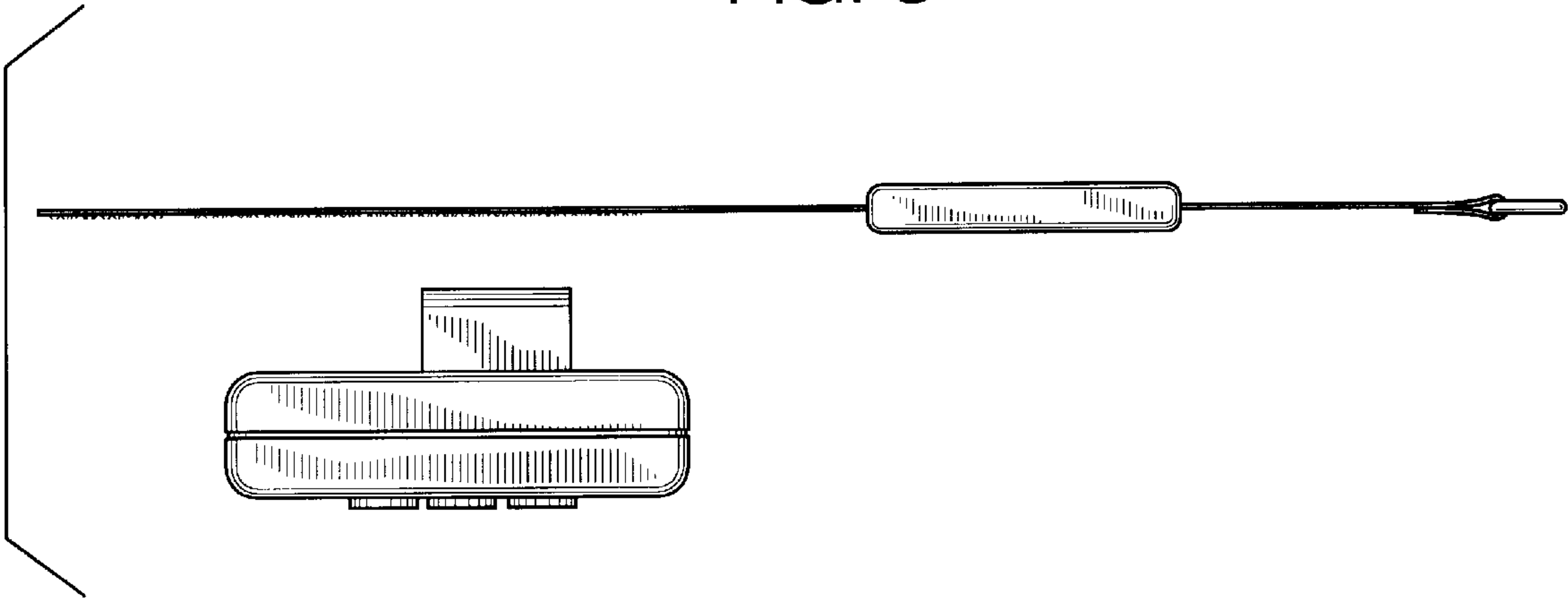
