[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a blade iron for a ceiling fan, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a blade iron for a ceiling fan showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is an enlarged perspective view illustrating the blade iron shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is an enlarged front view thereof;

FIG. 4 is an enlarged right-side view thereof;

FIG. 5 is an enlarged rear view thereof;

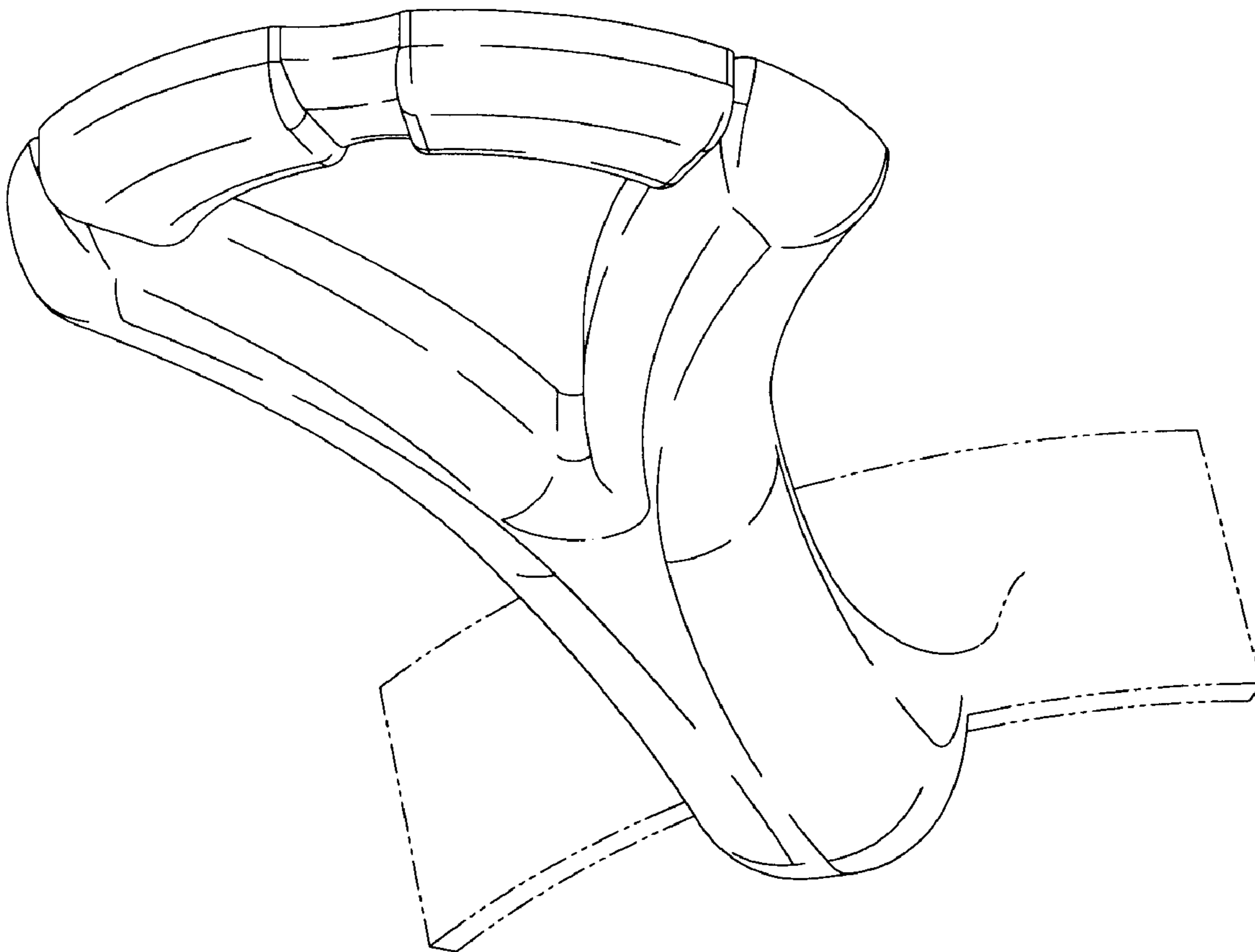
FIG. 6 is an enlarged left-side view thereof;

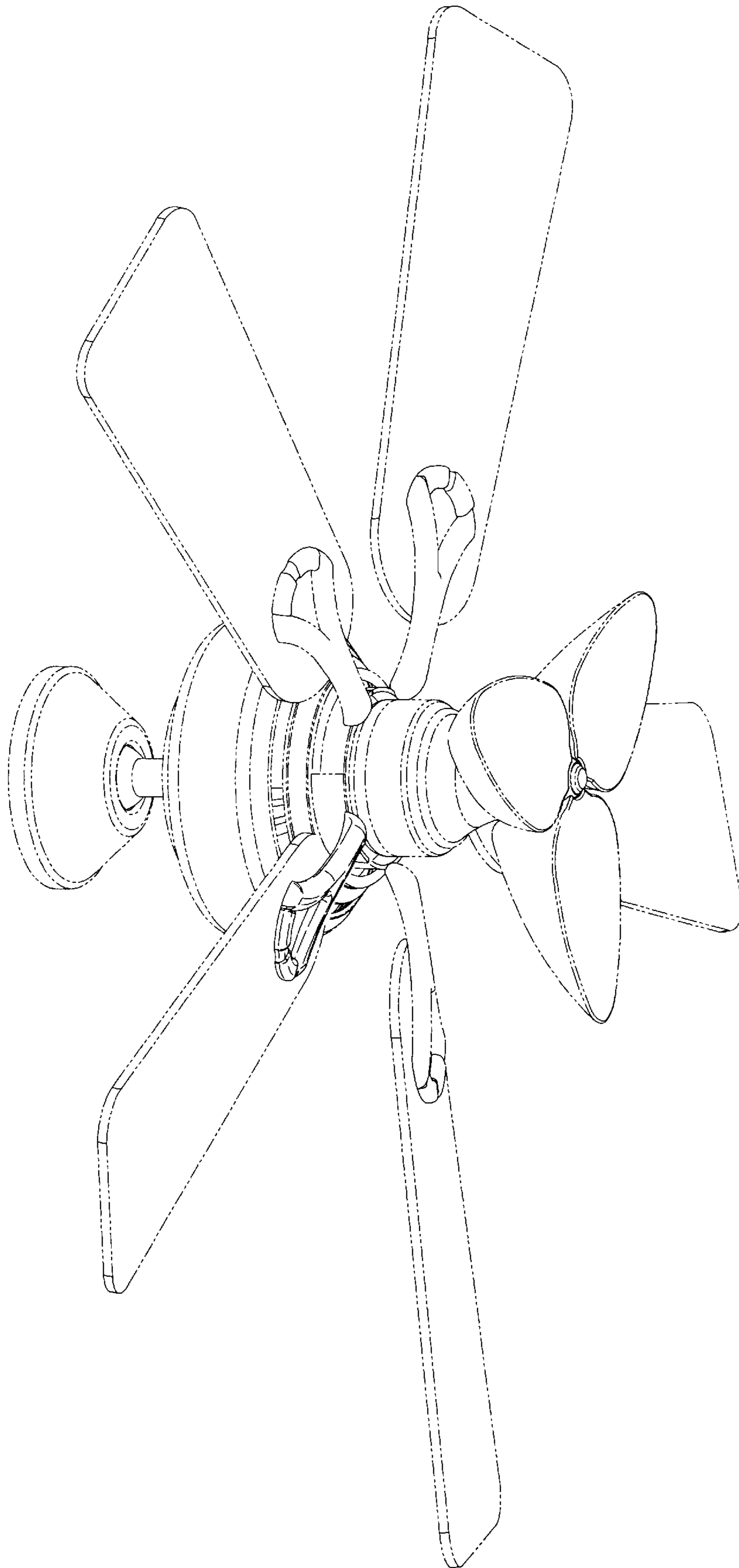

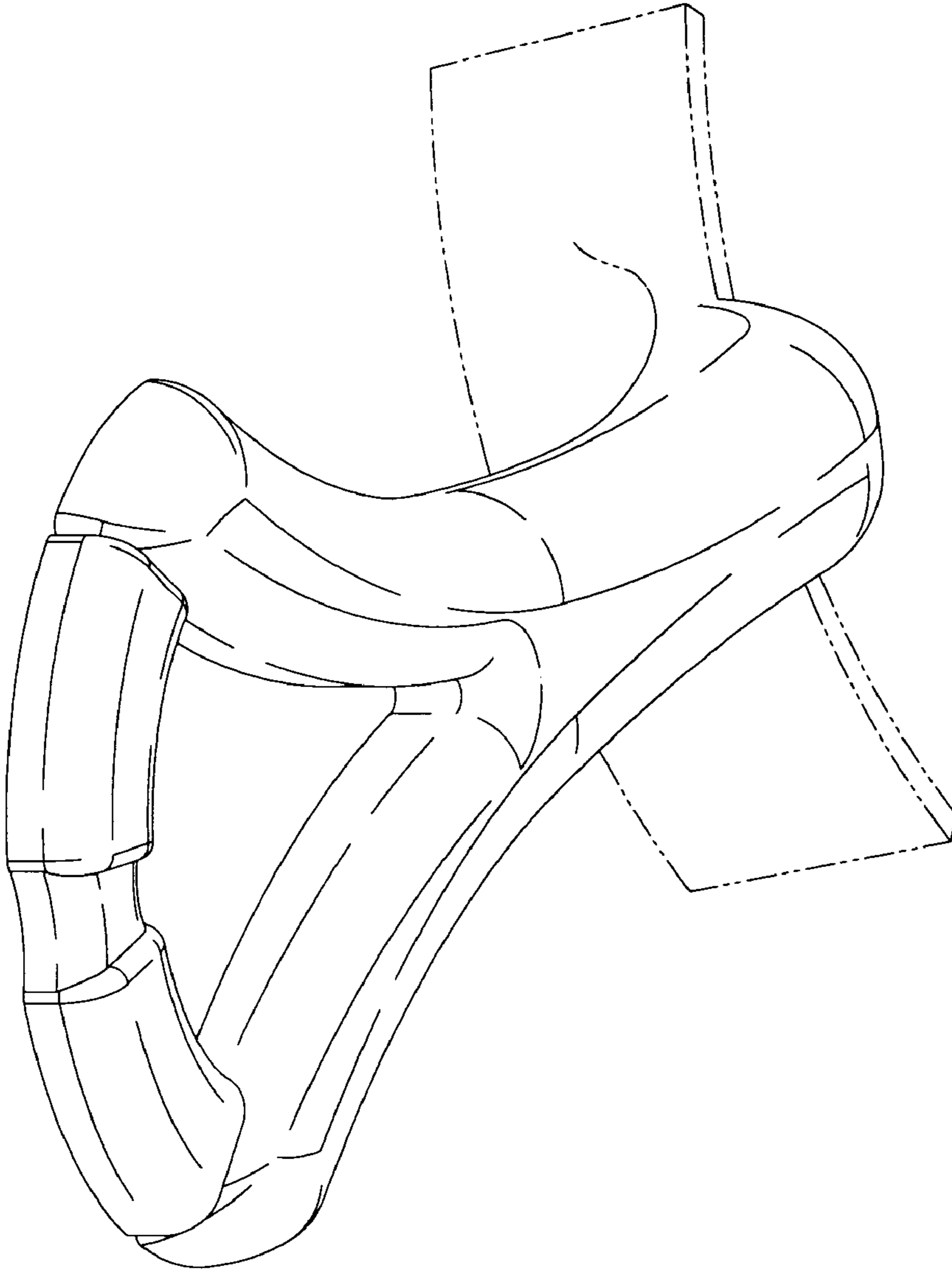

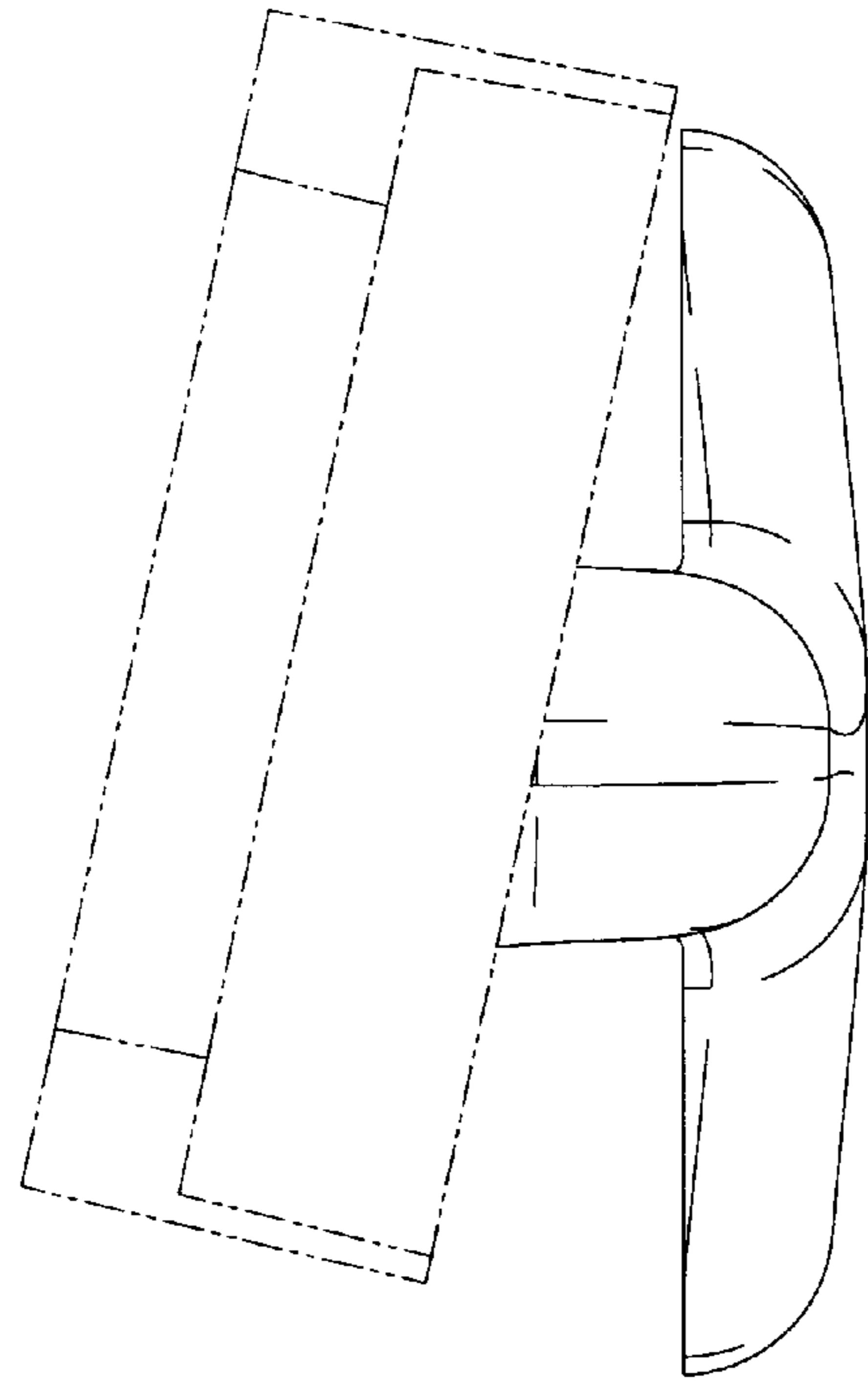

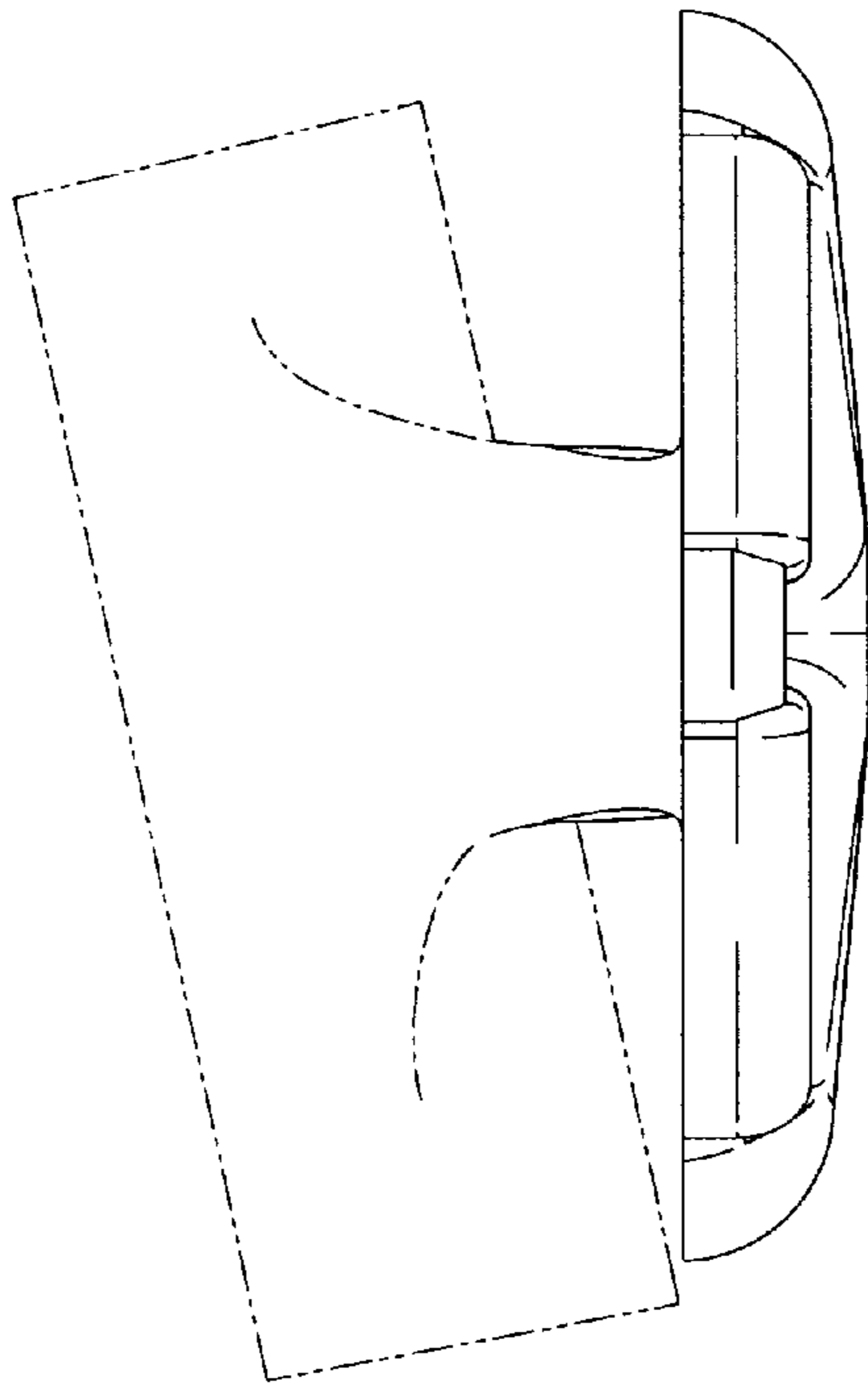

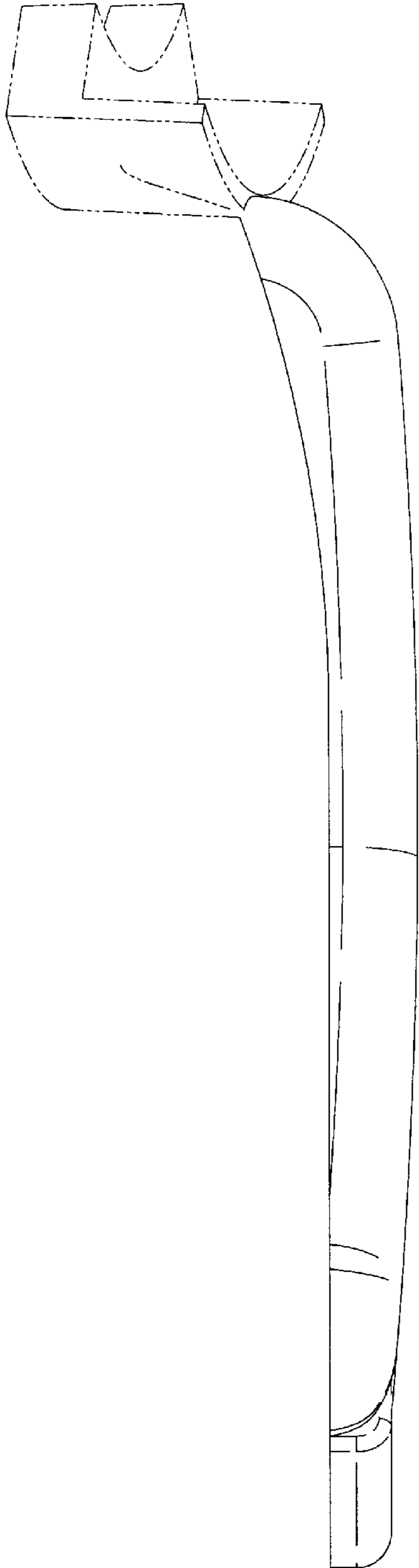

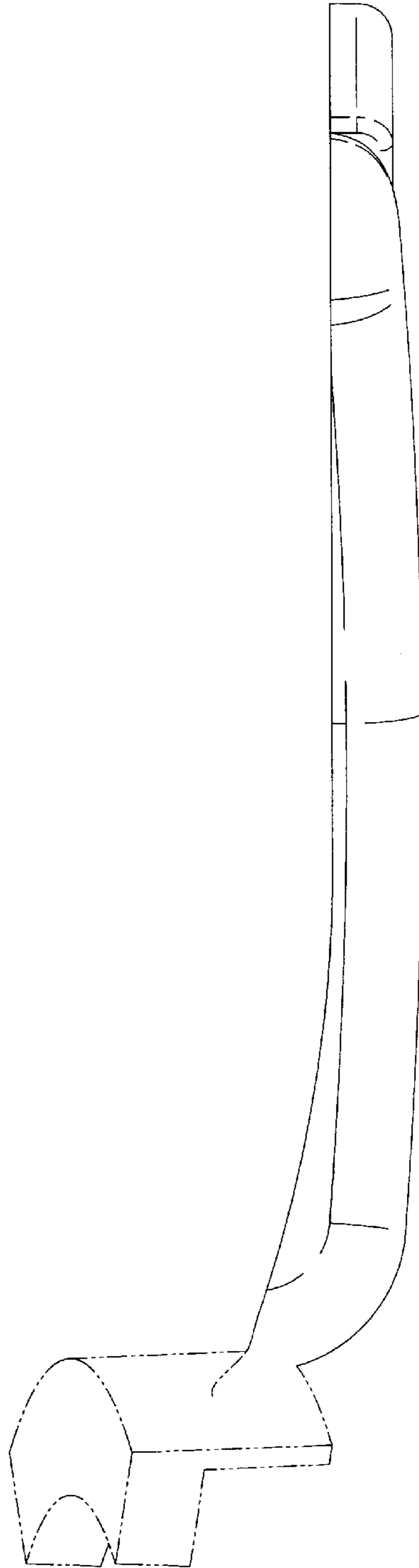

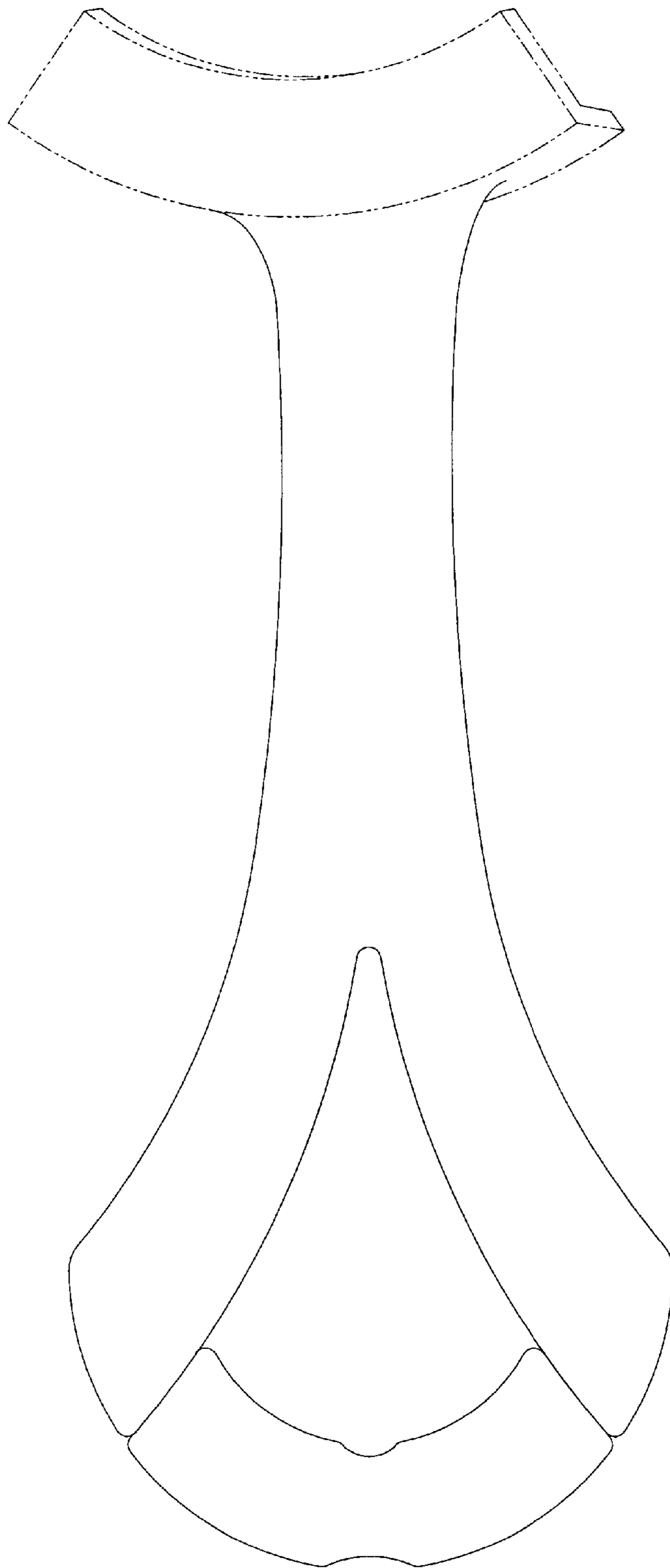

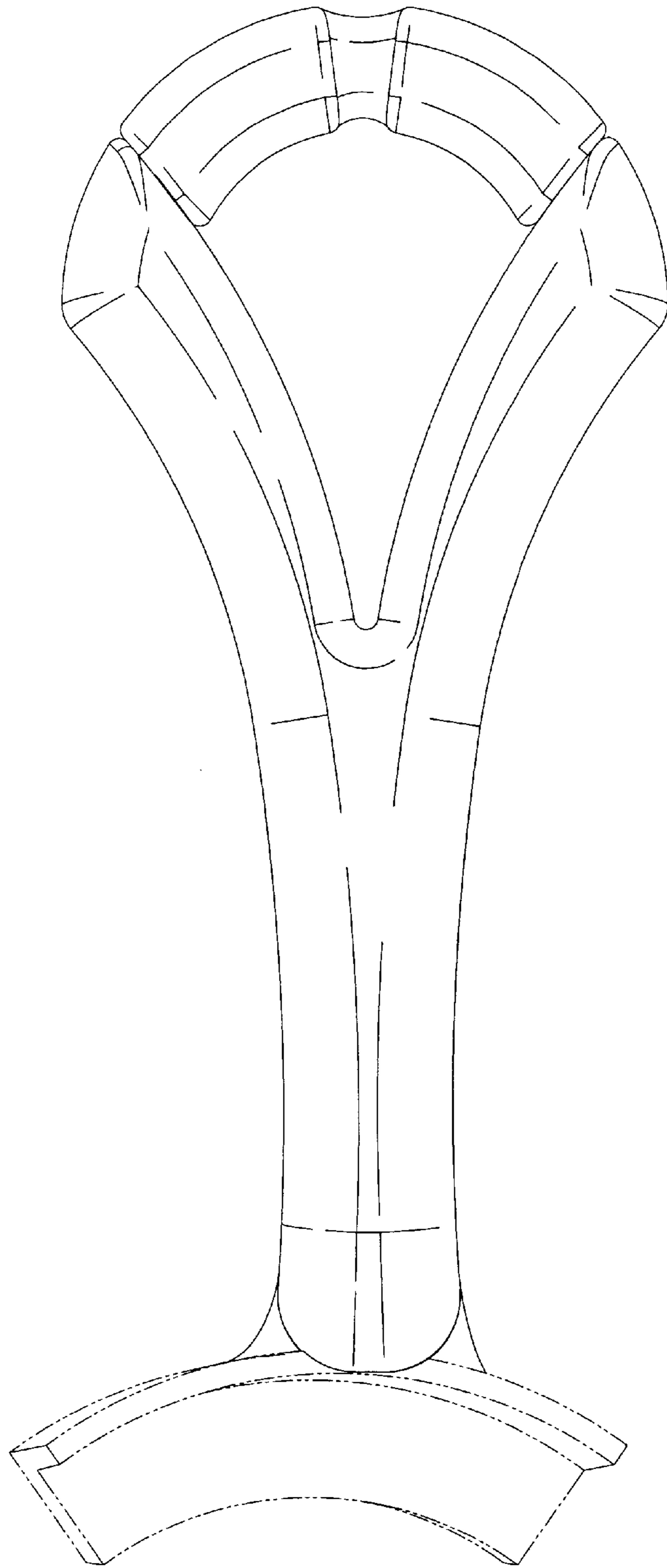
