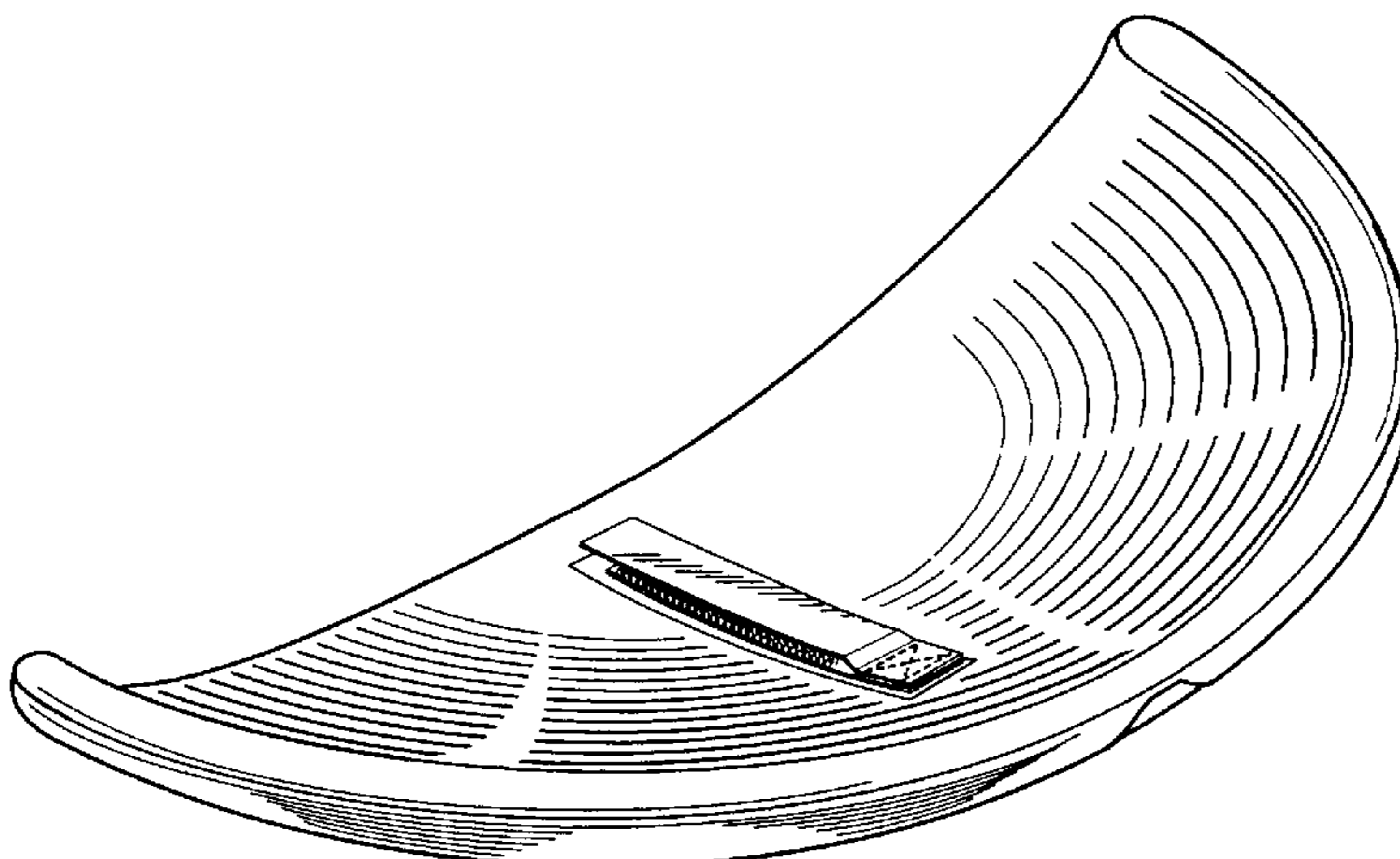
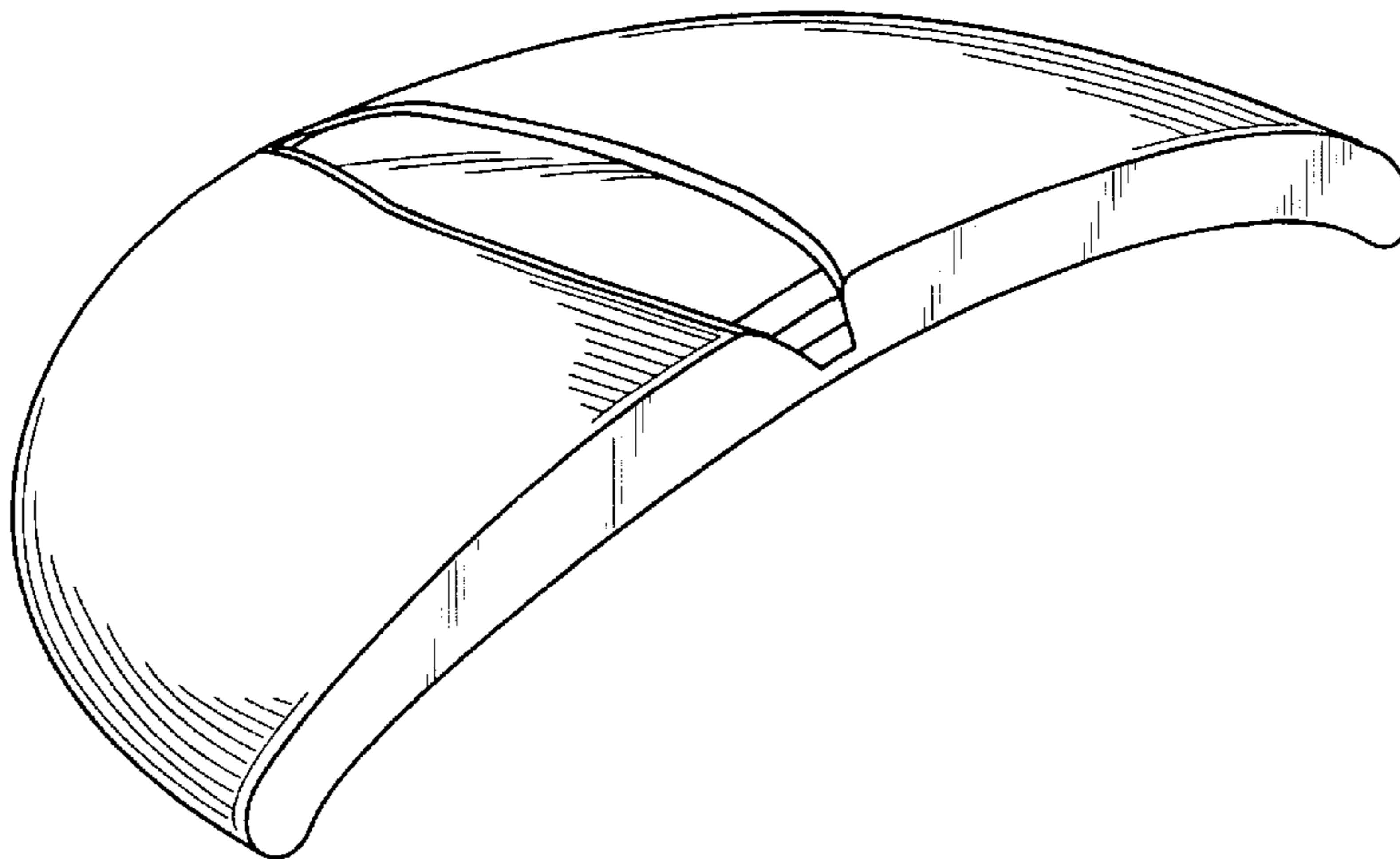
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a shoulder pad, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a shoulder pad showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a bottom perspective view thereof, the broken lines being understood to represent stitching;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side being a mirror image;
FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof; and,
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.

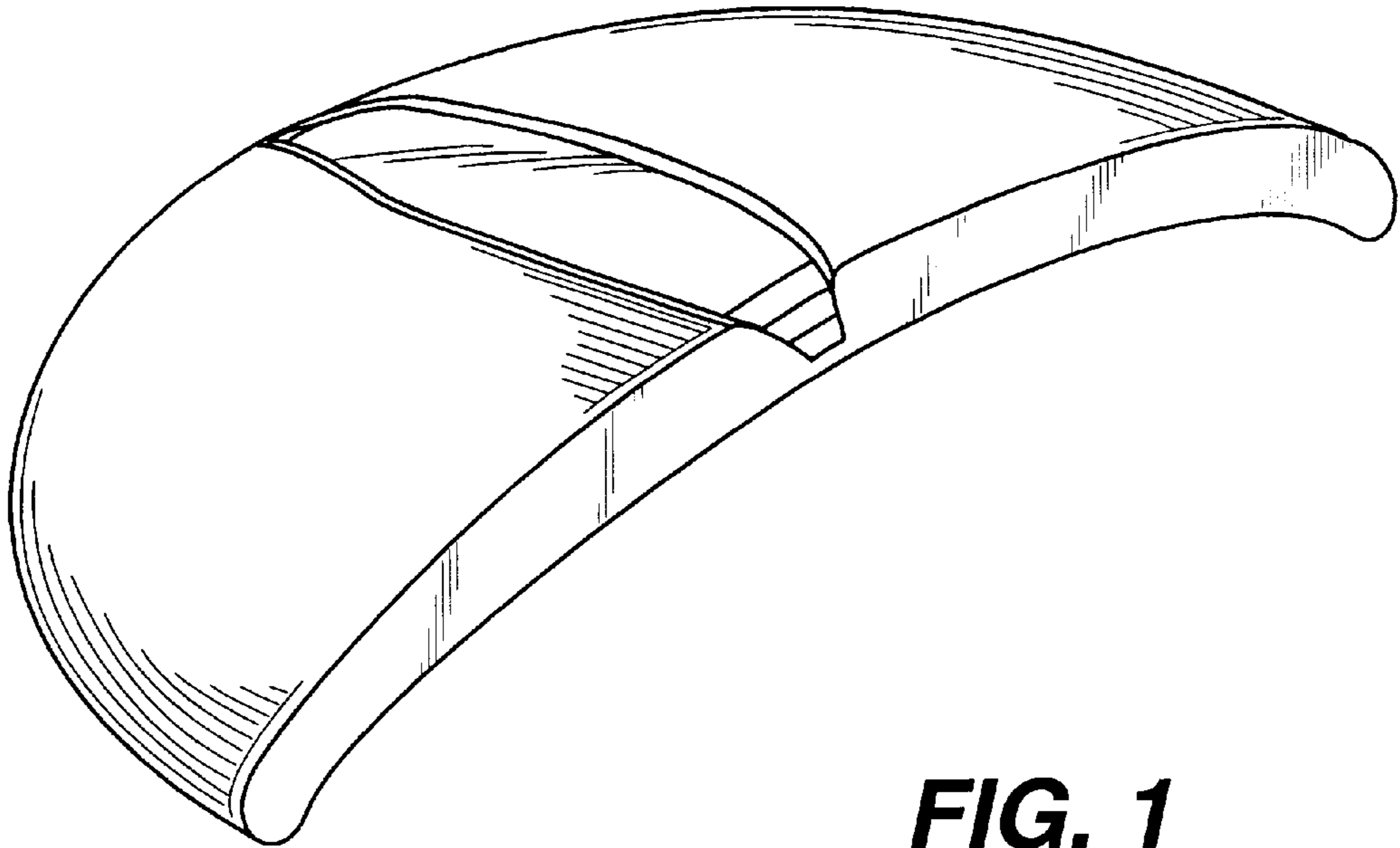

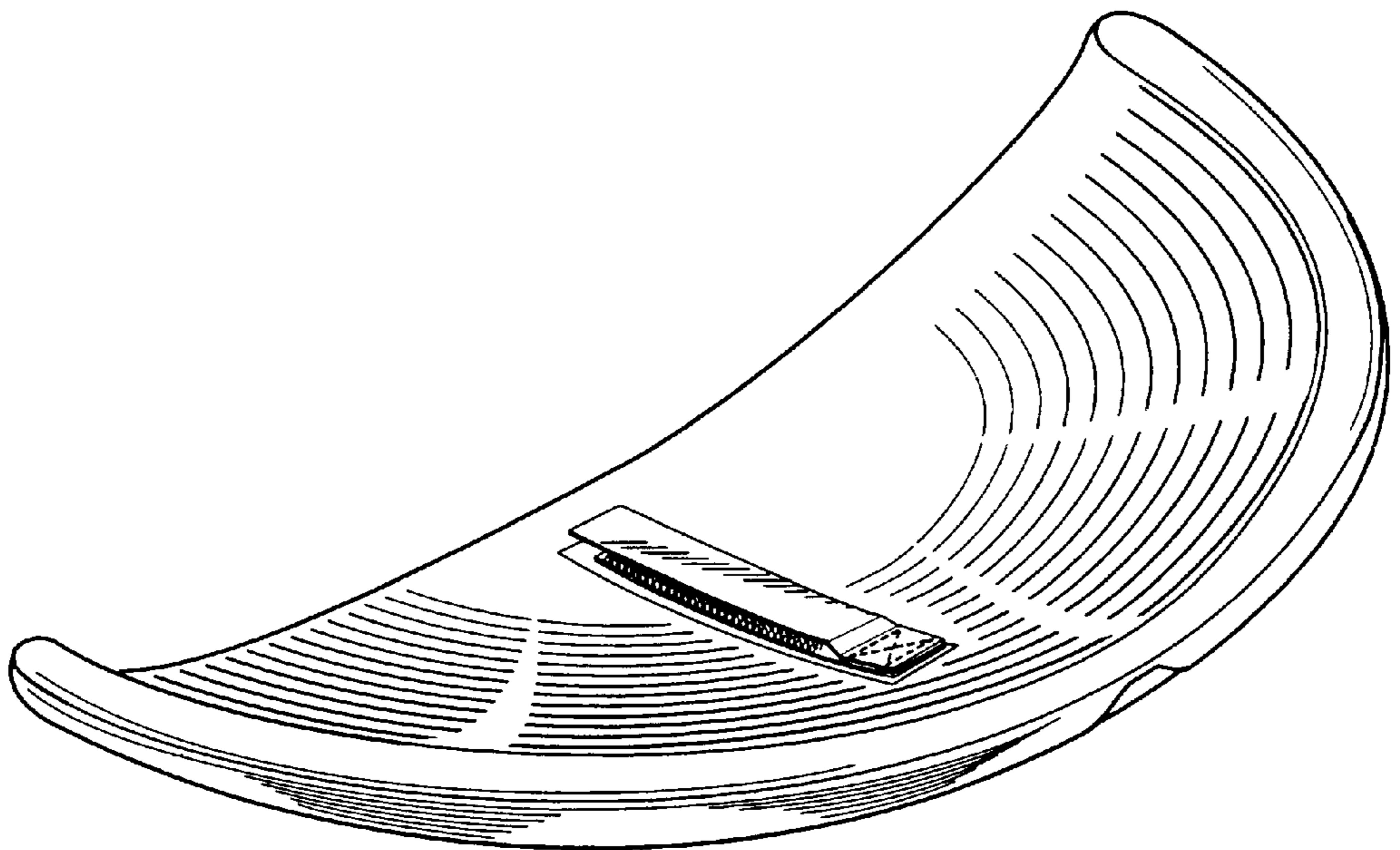

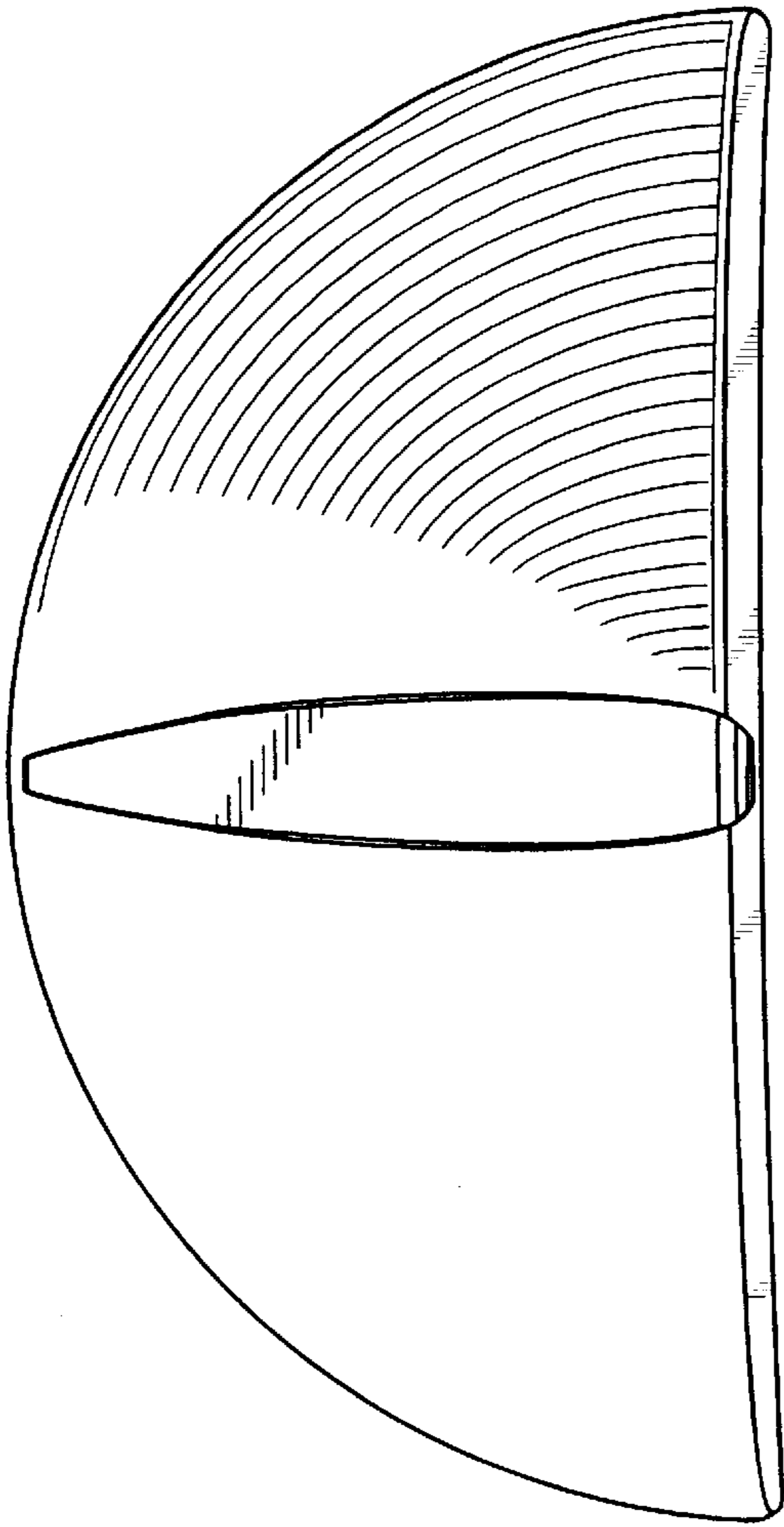

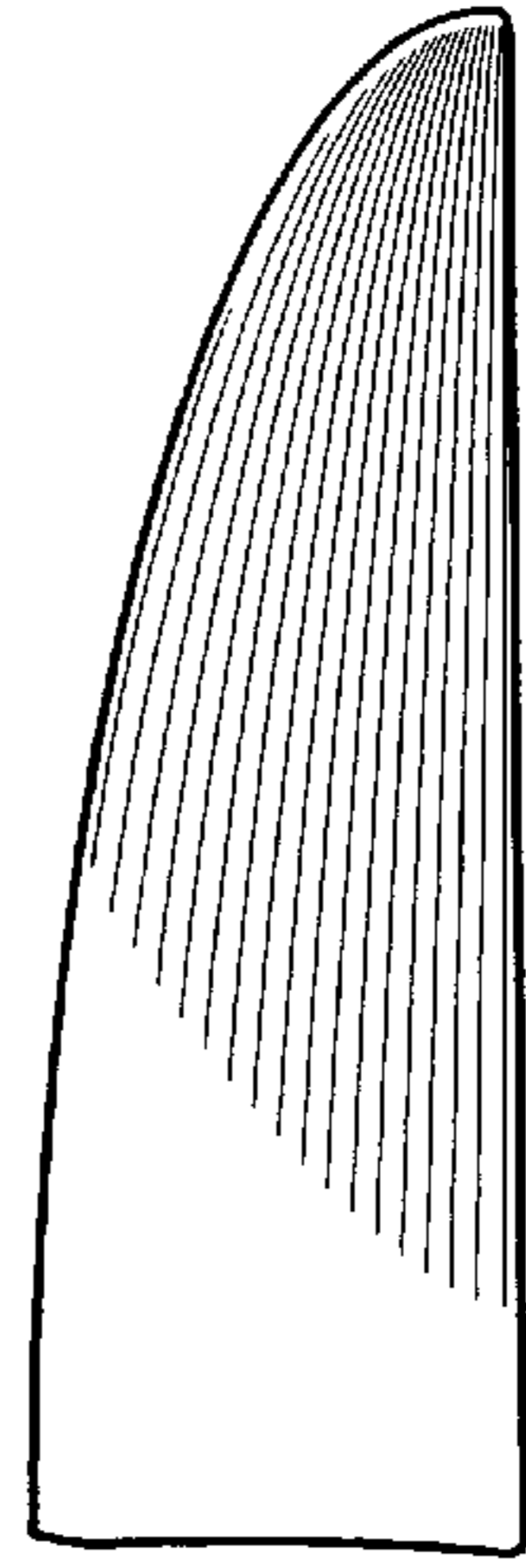

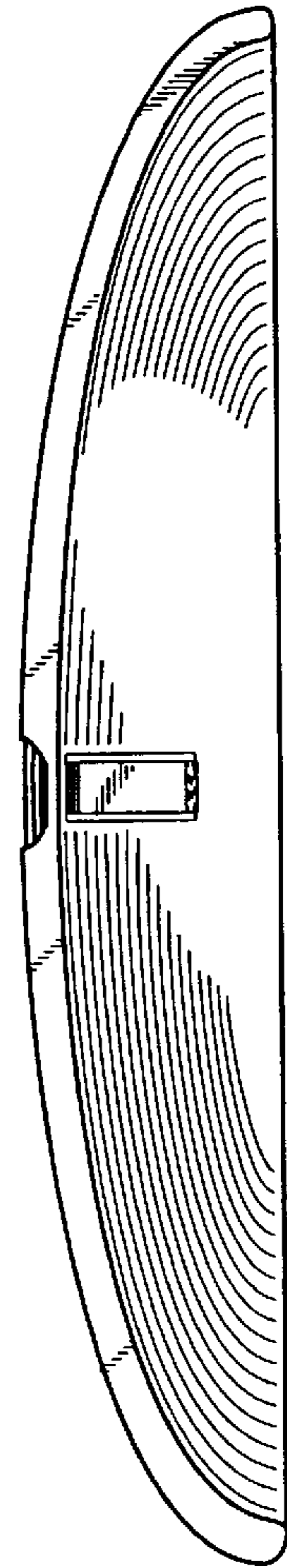

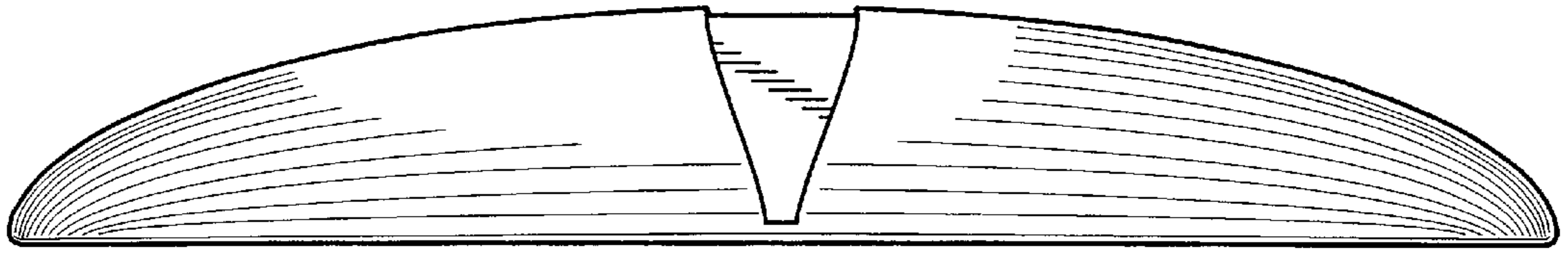

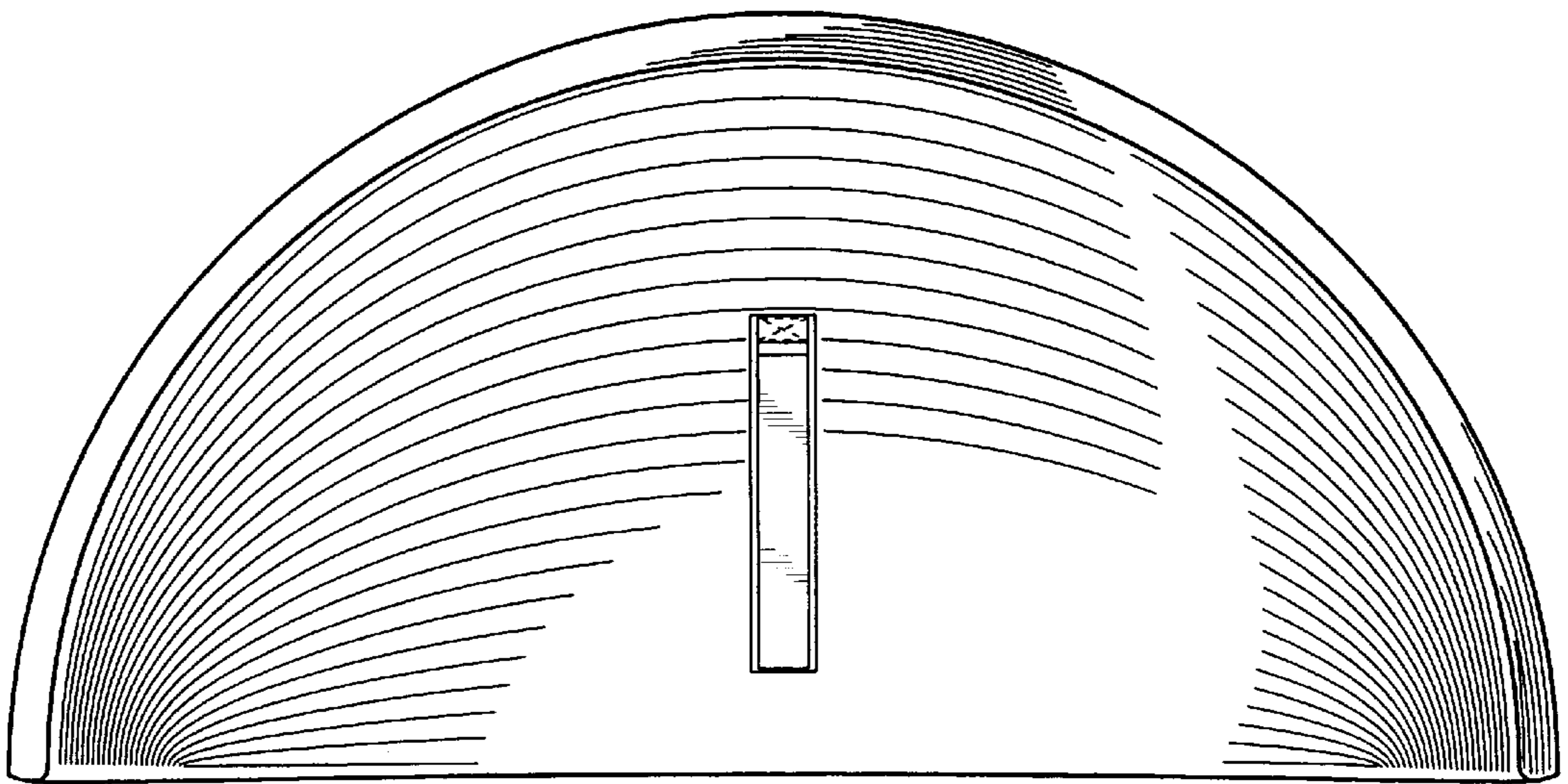
