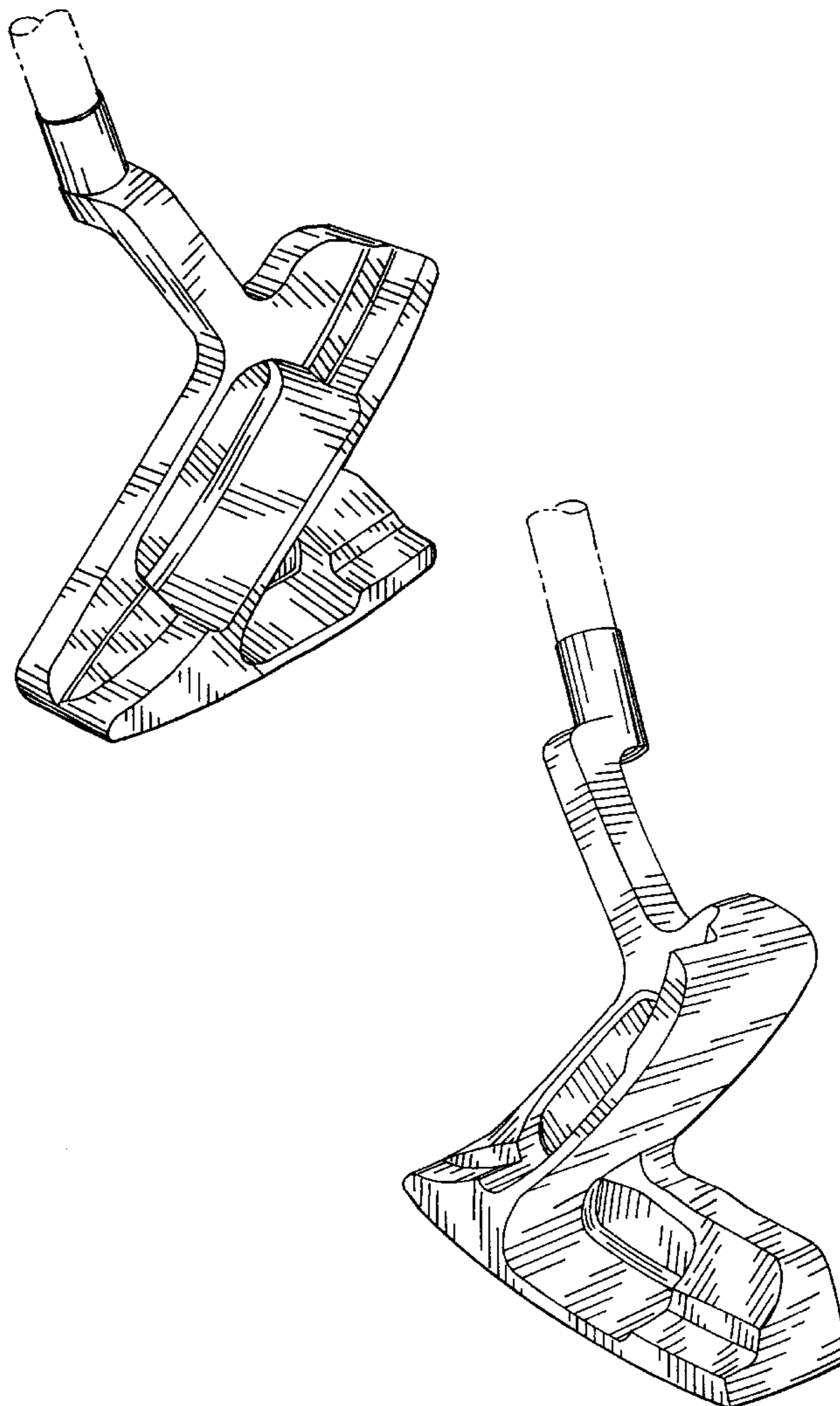
[57] **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a rear, right side perspective view of my new golf club head;

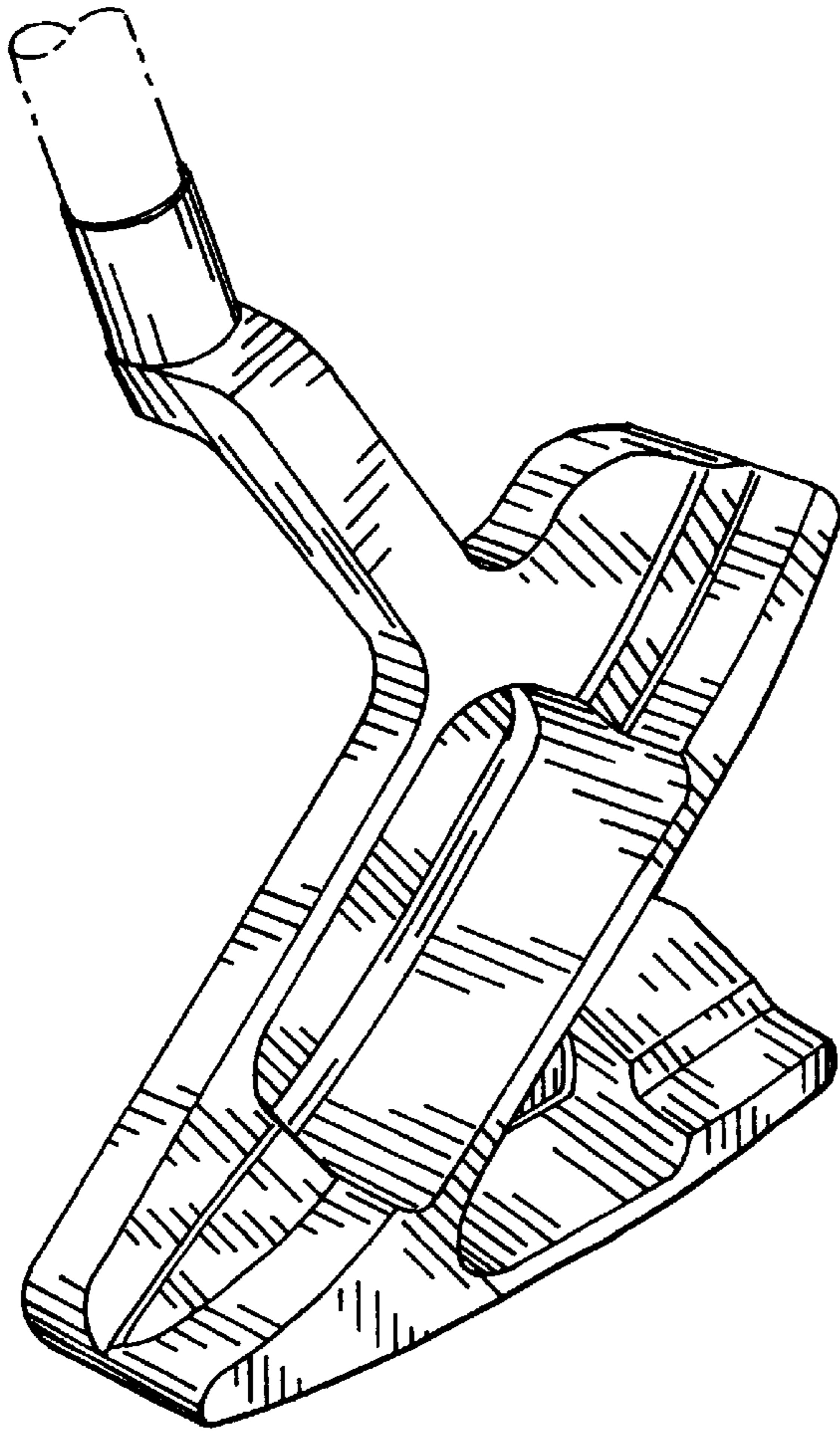

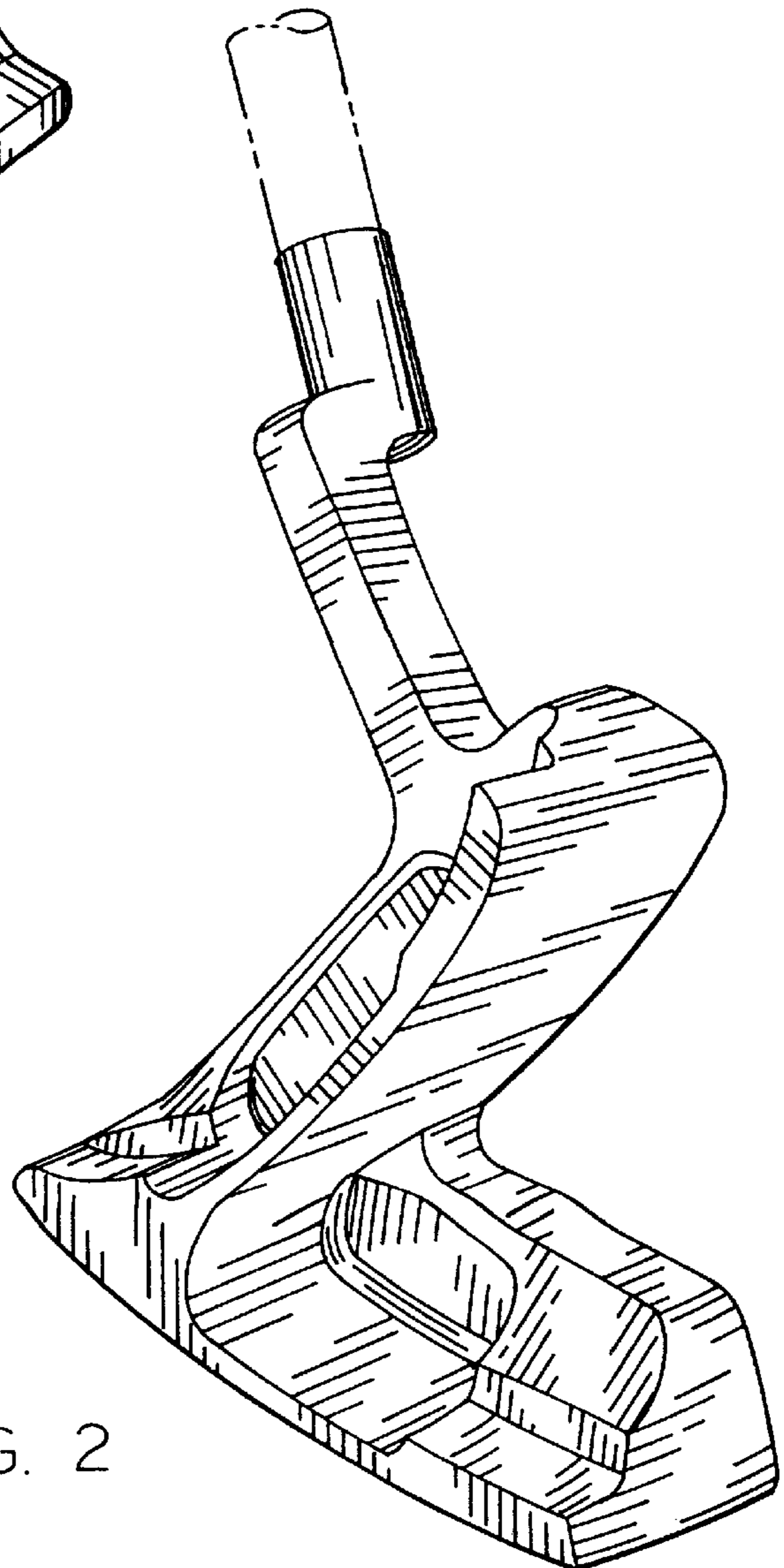

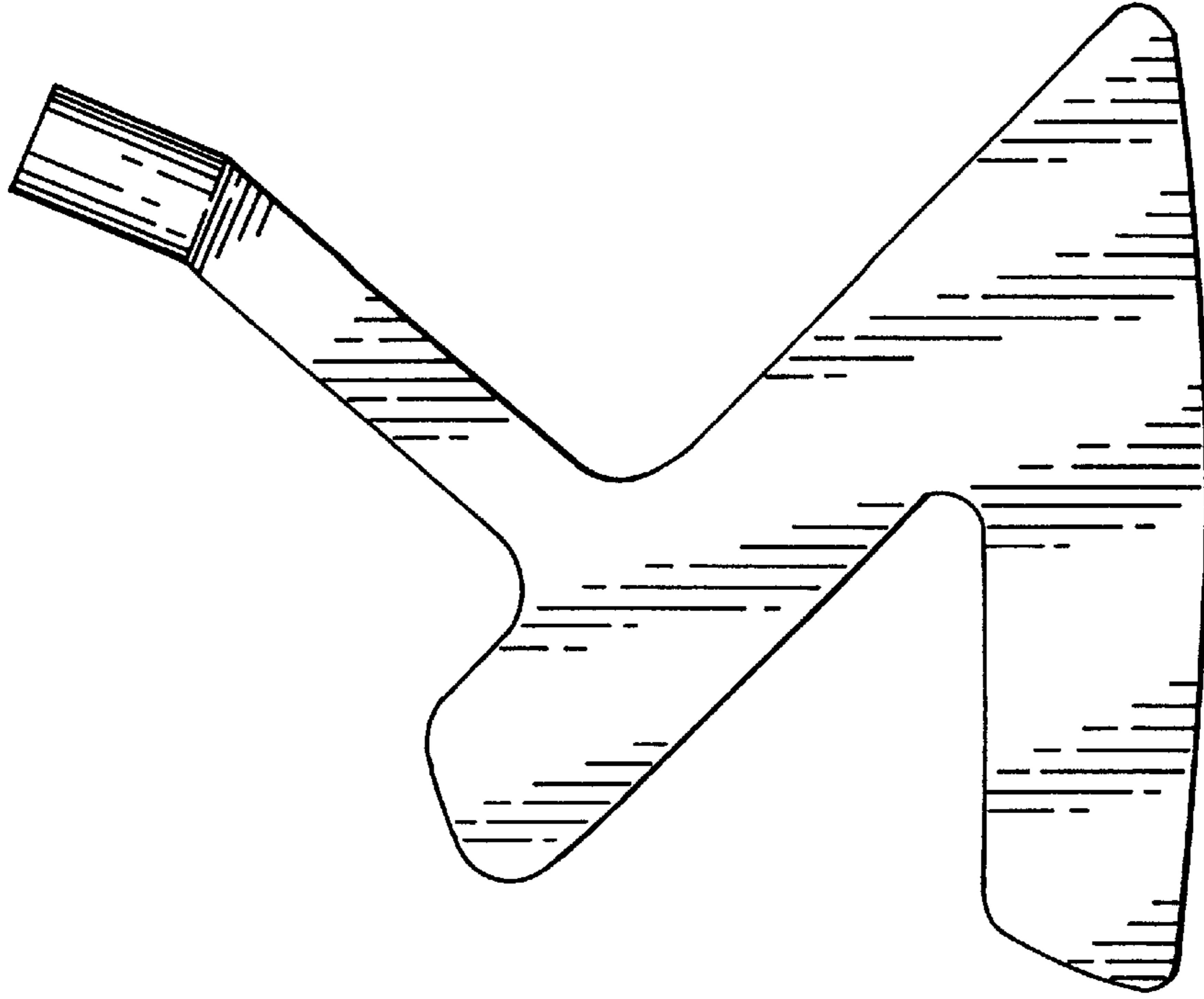

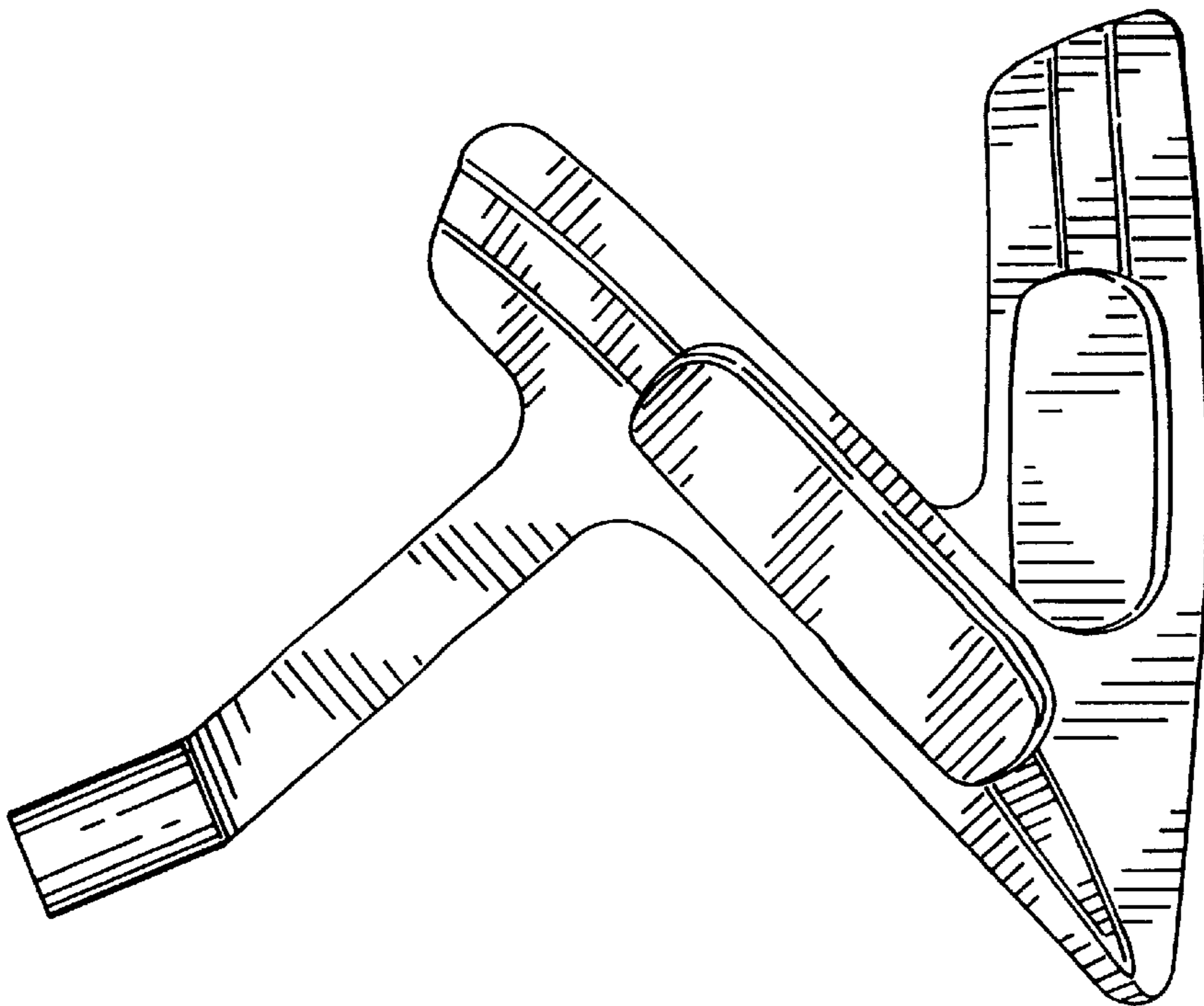

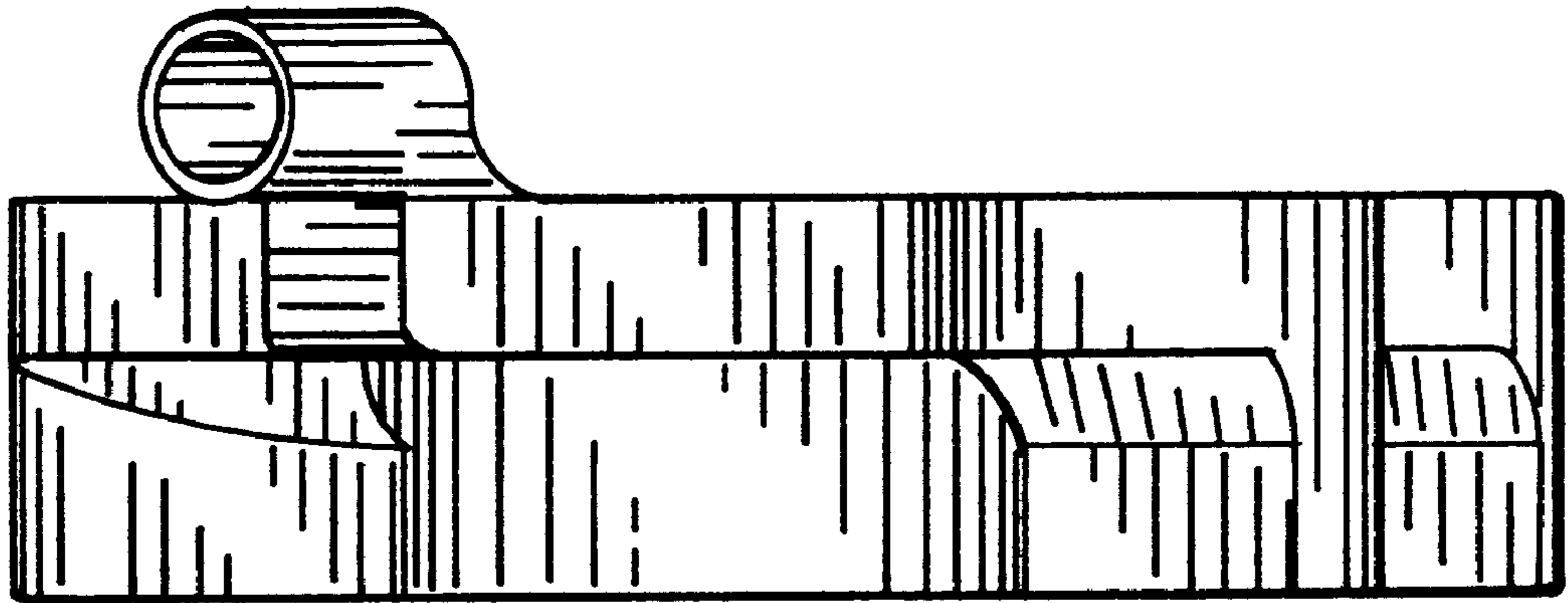

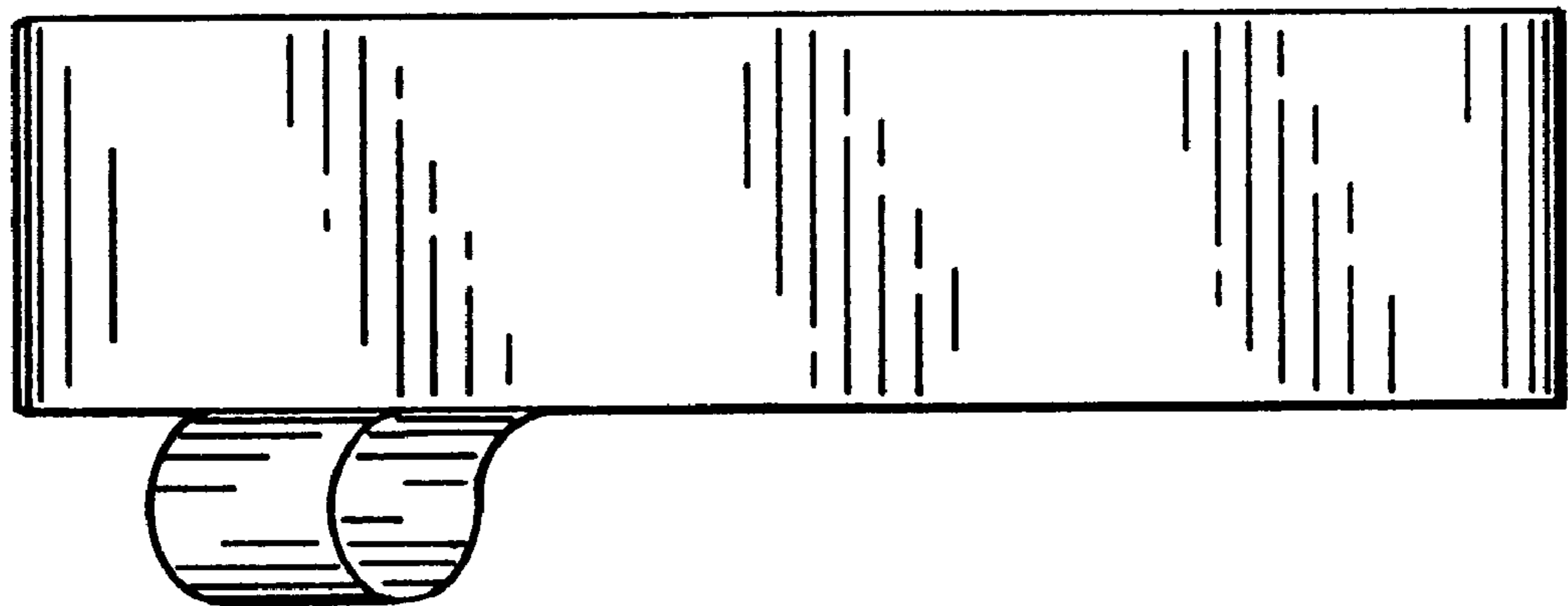

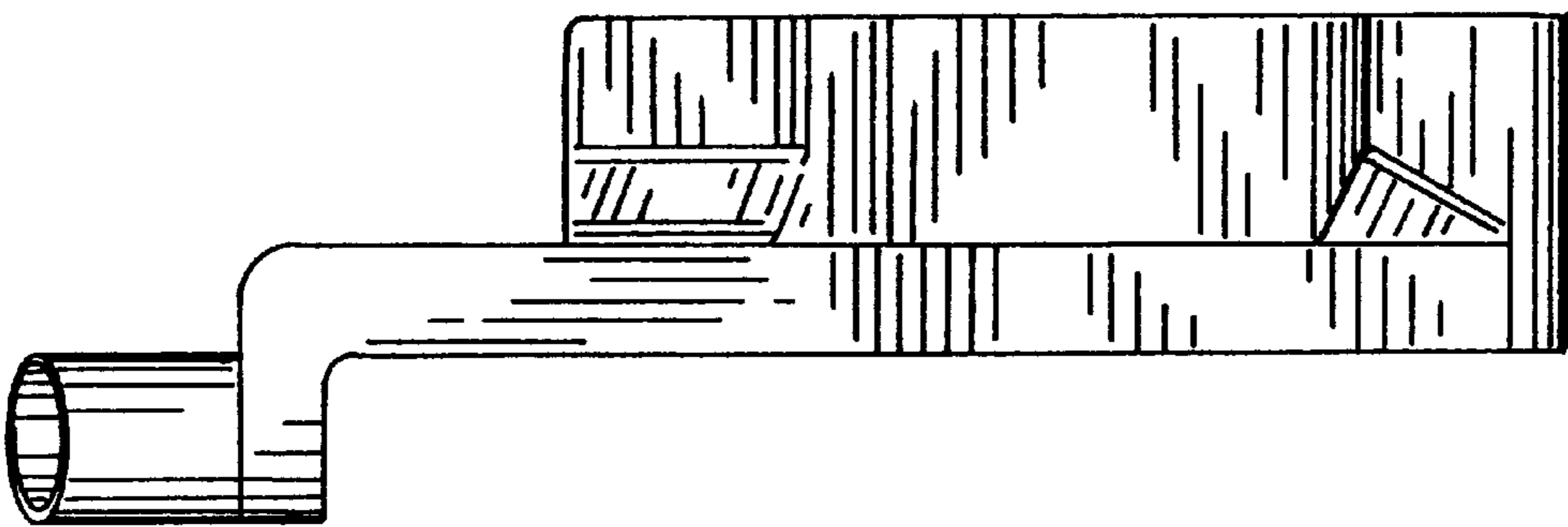
