## DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view from above and one side of a lantern in accordance with my new design illustrating;

FIG. 2 is a front view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a bottom view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a front perspective view from above and an opposite side thereof;

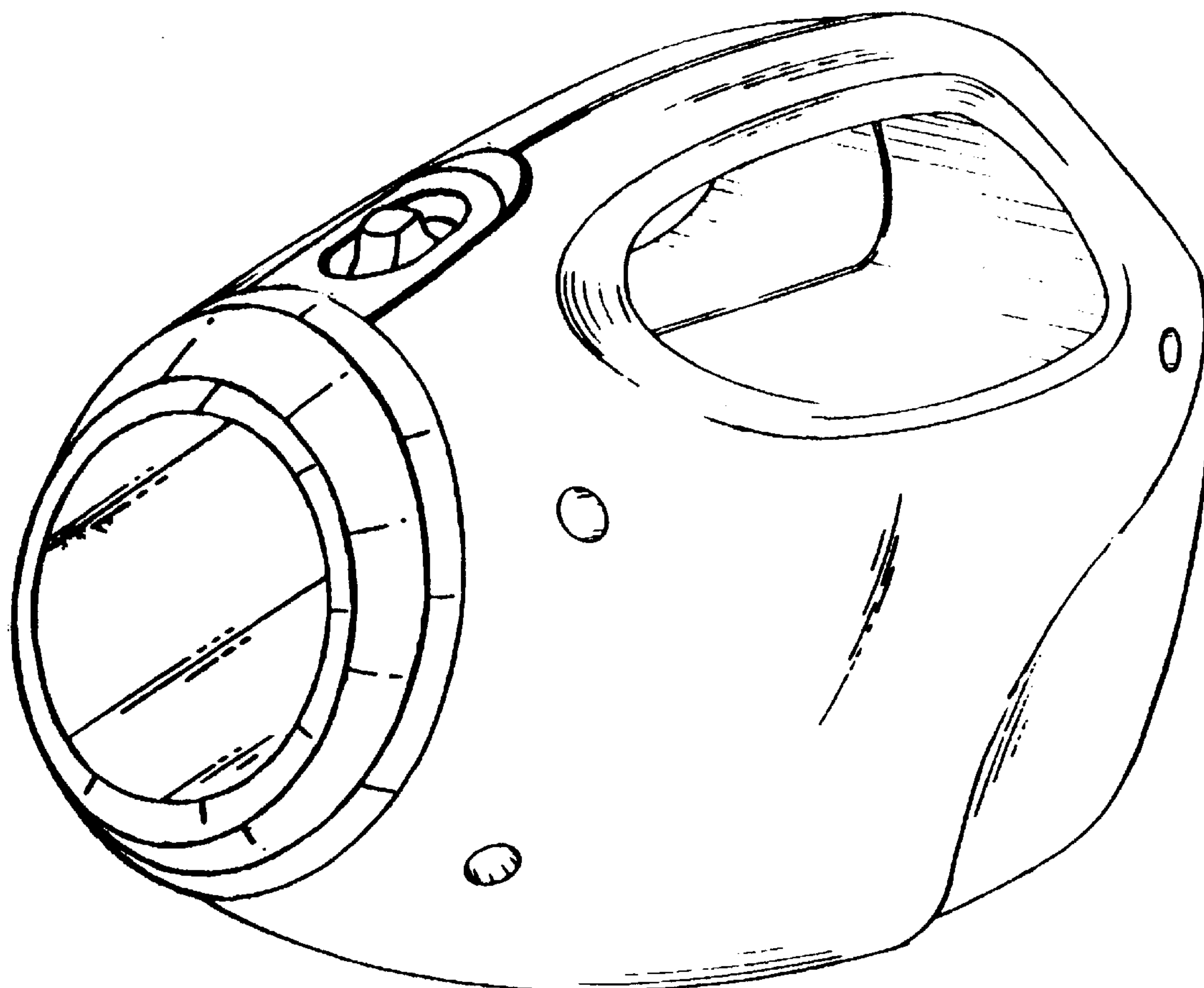
FIG. 5 is a rear perspective view from above and the opposite side thereof; and,

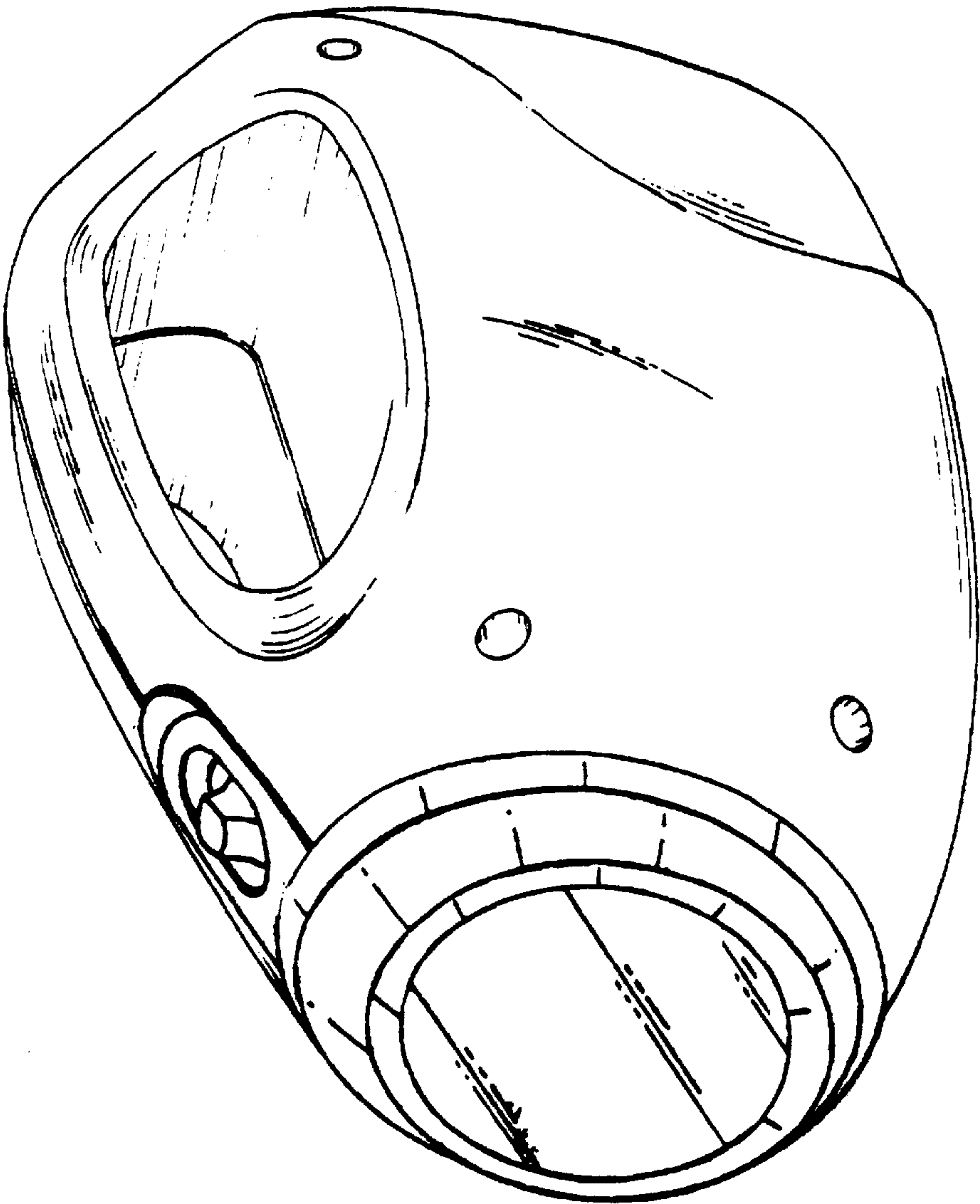
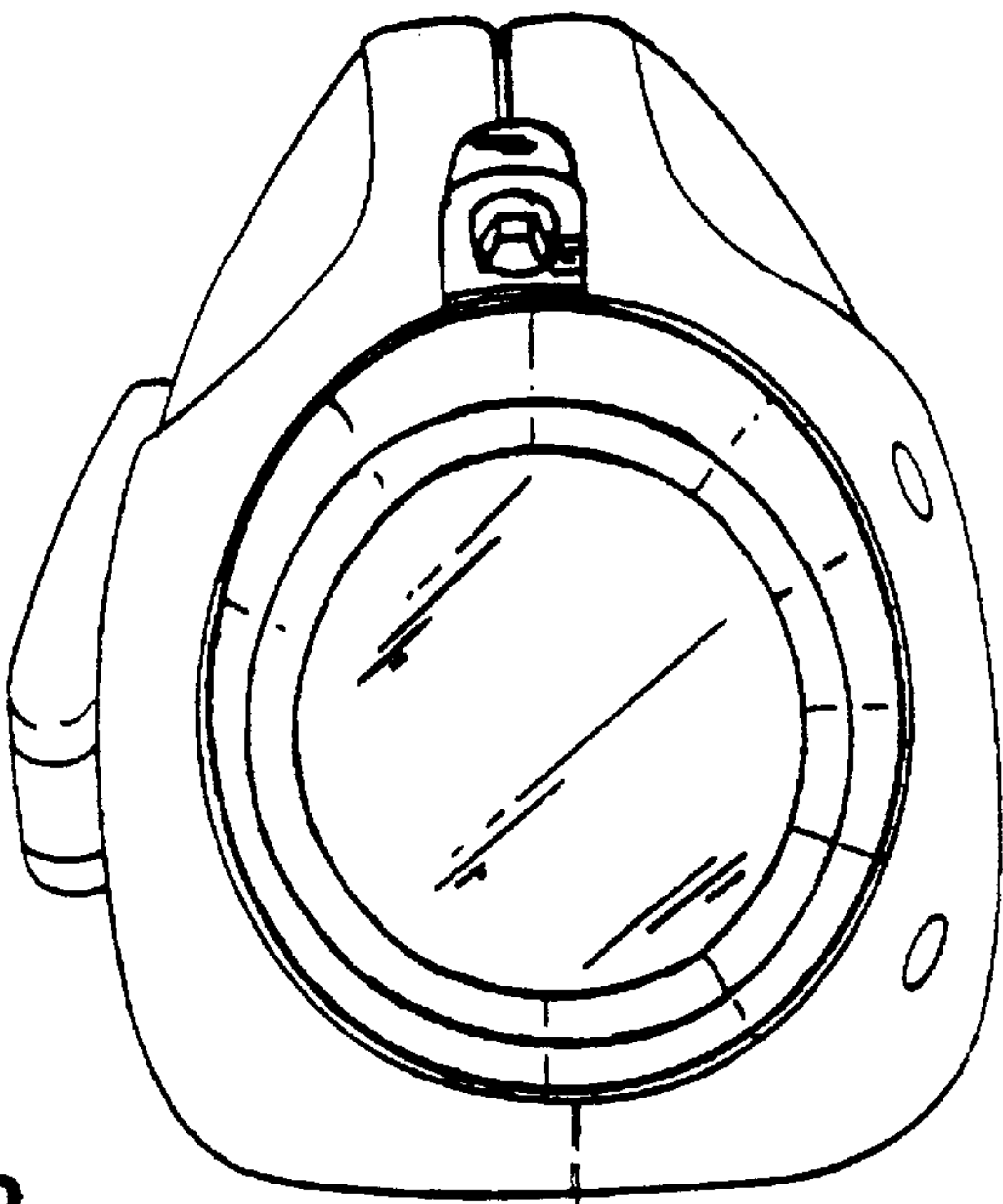
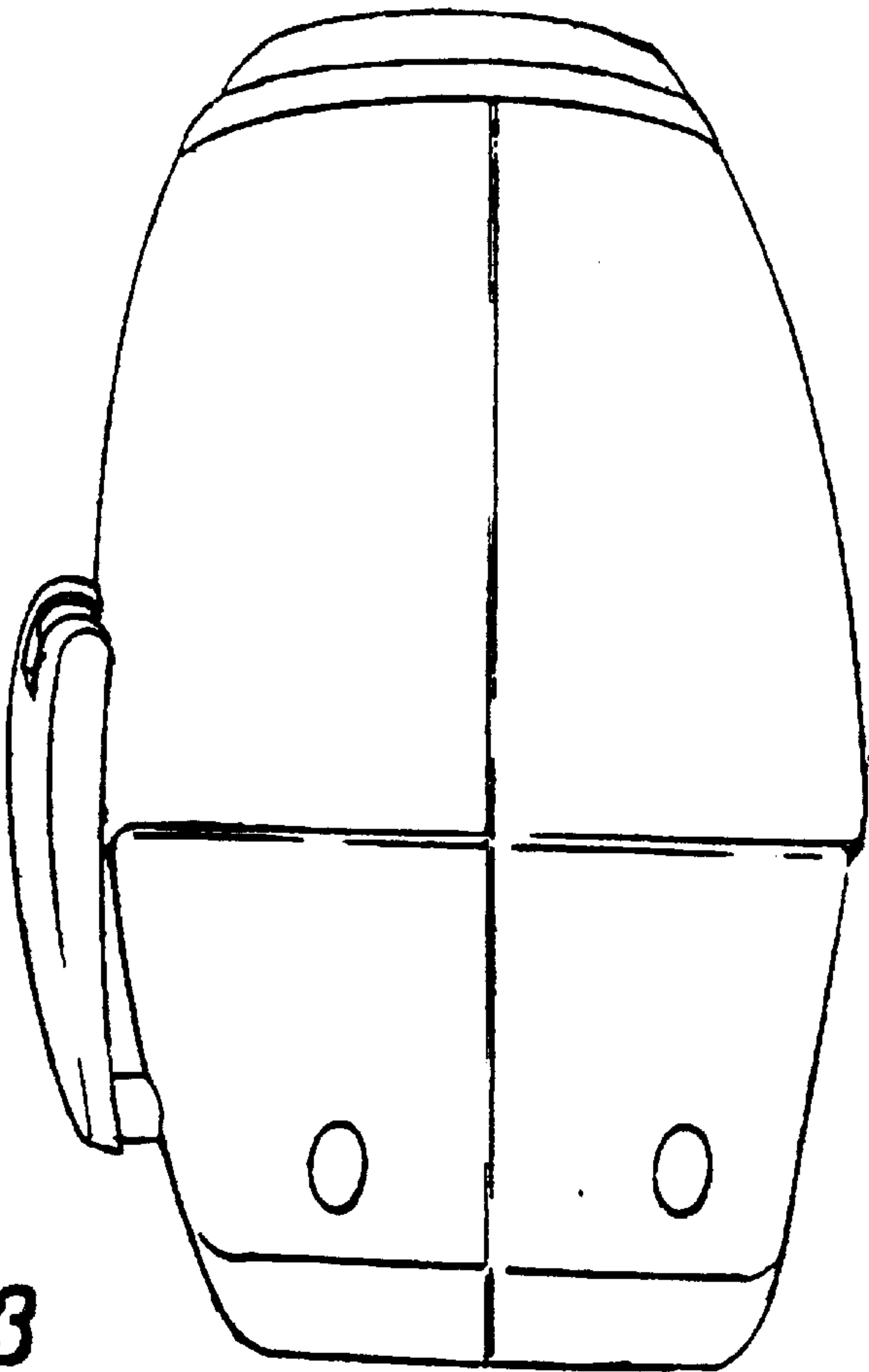

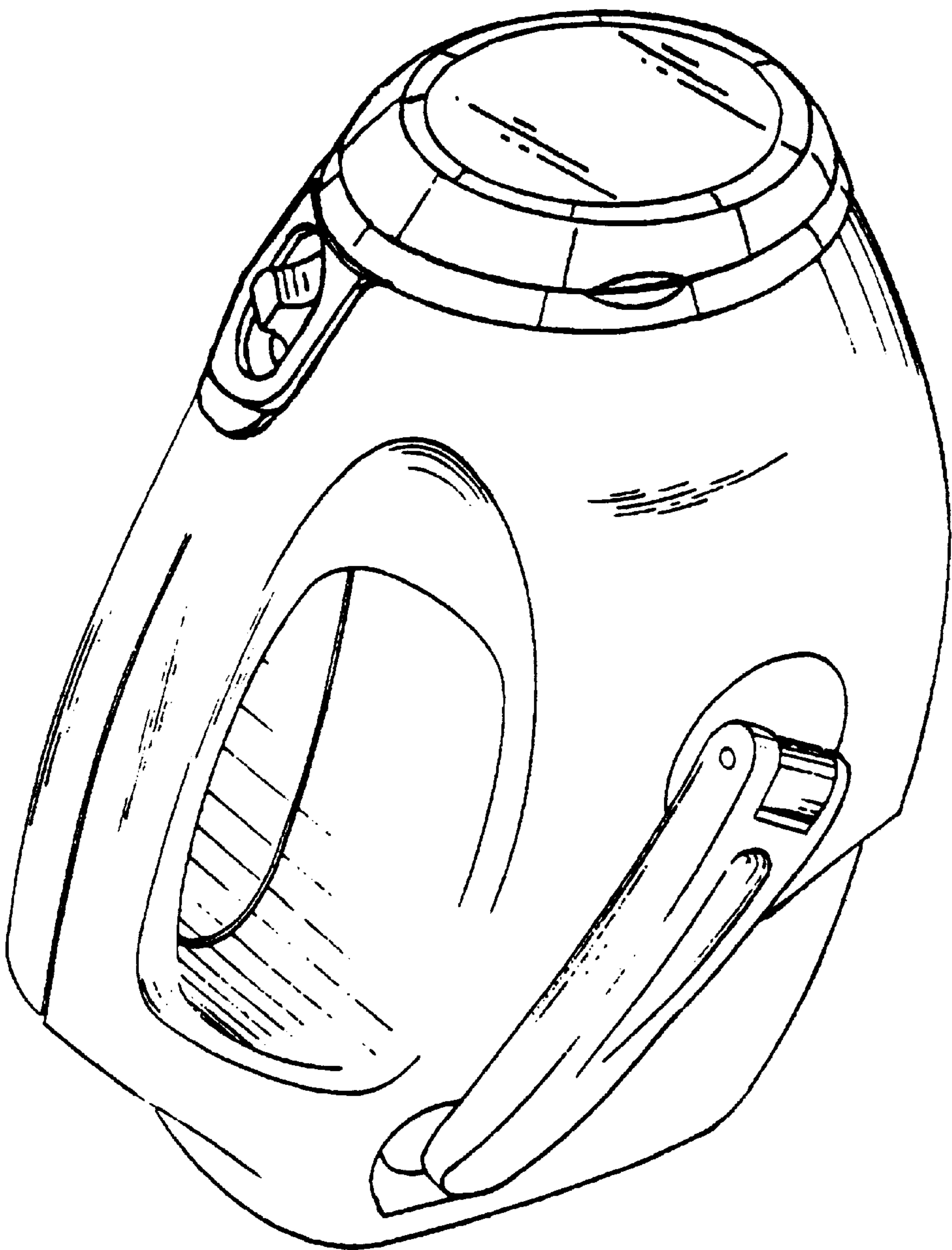

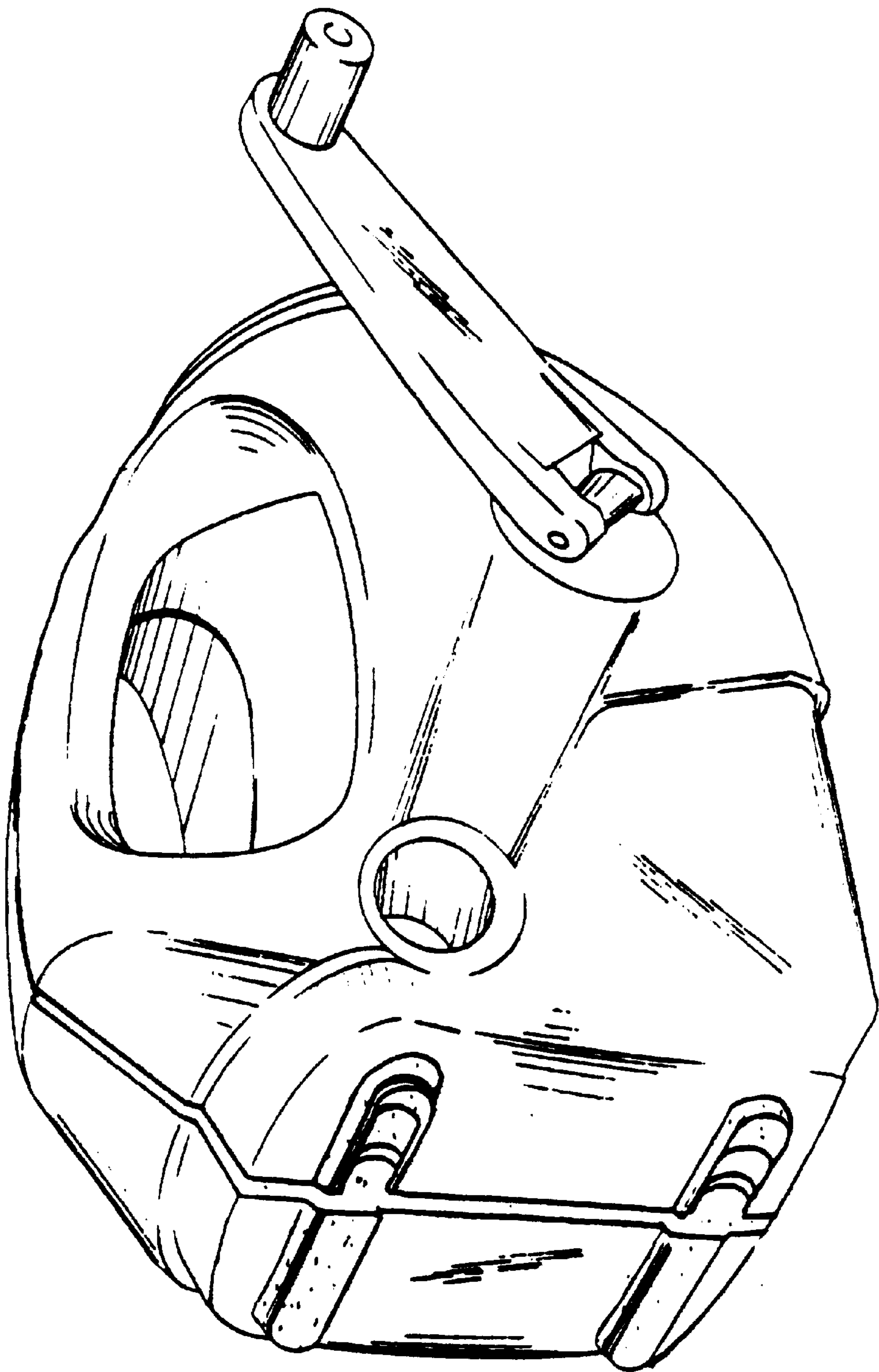

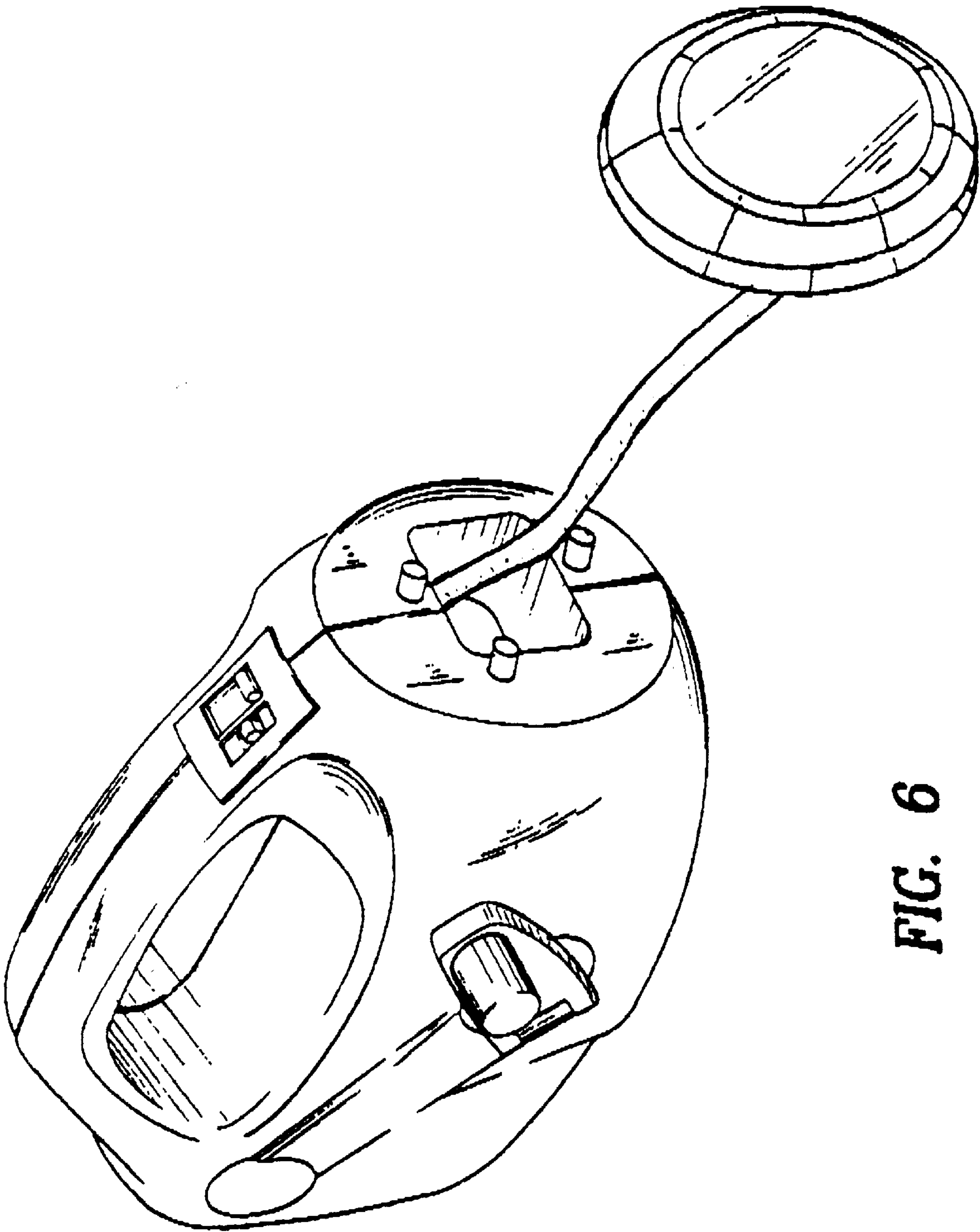
