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[57] CLAIM

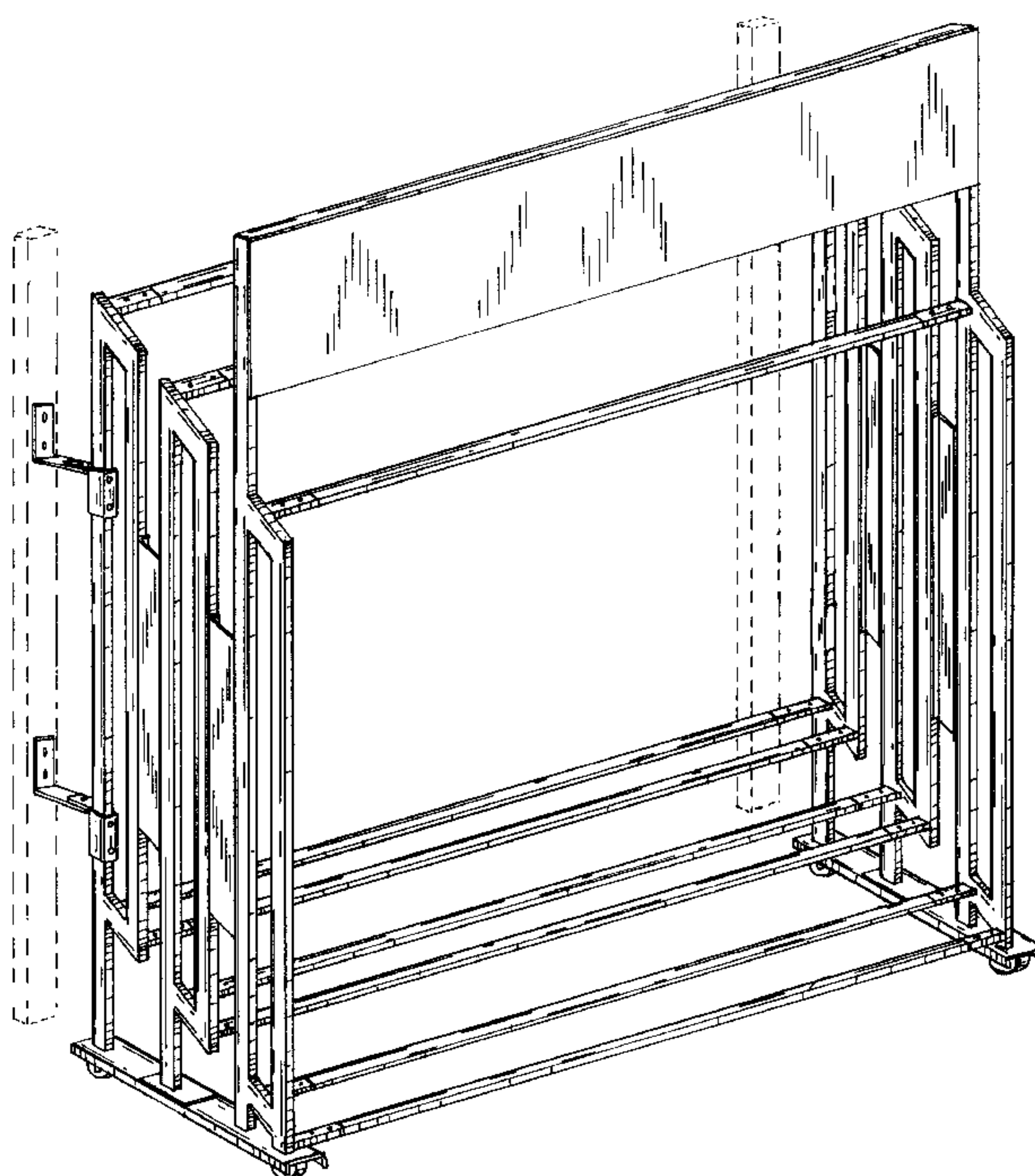
The ornamental design for a merchandising display unit for doors, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the merchandising display unit for doors showing the new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof; and,

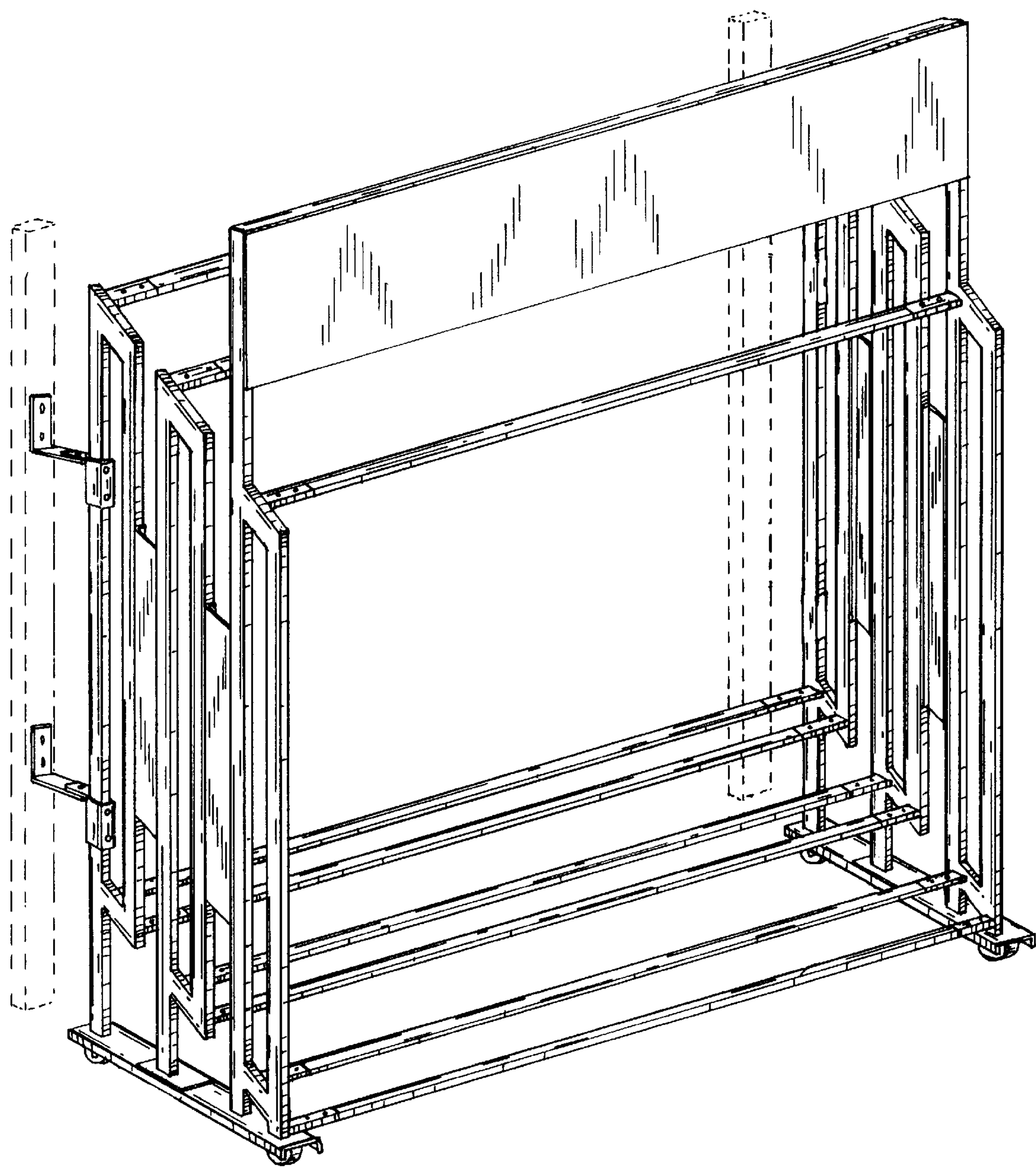

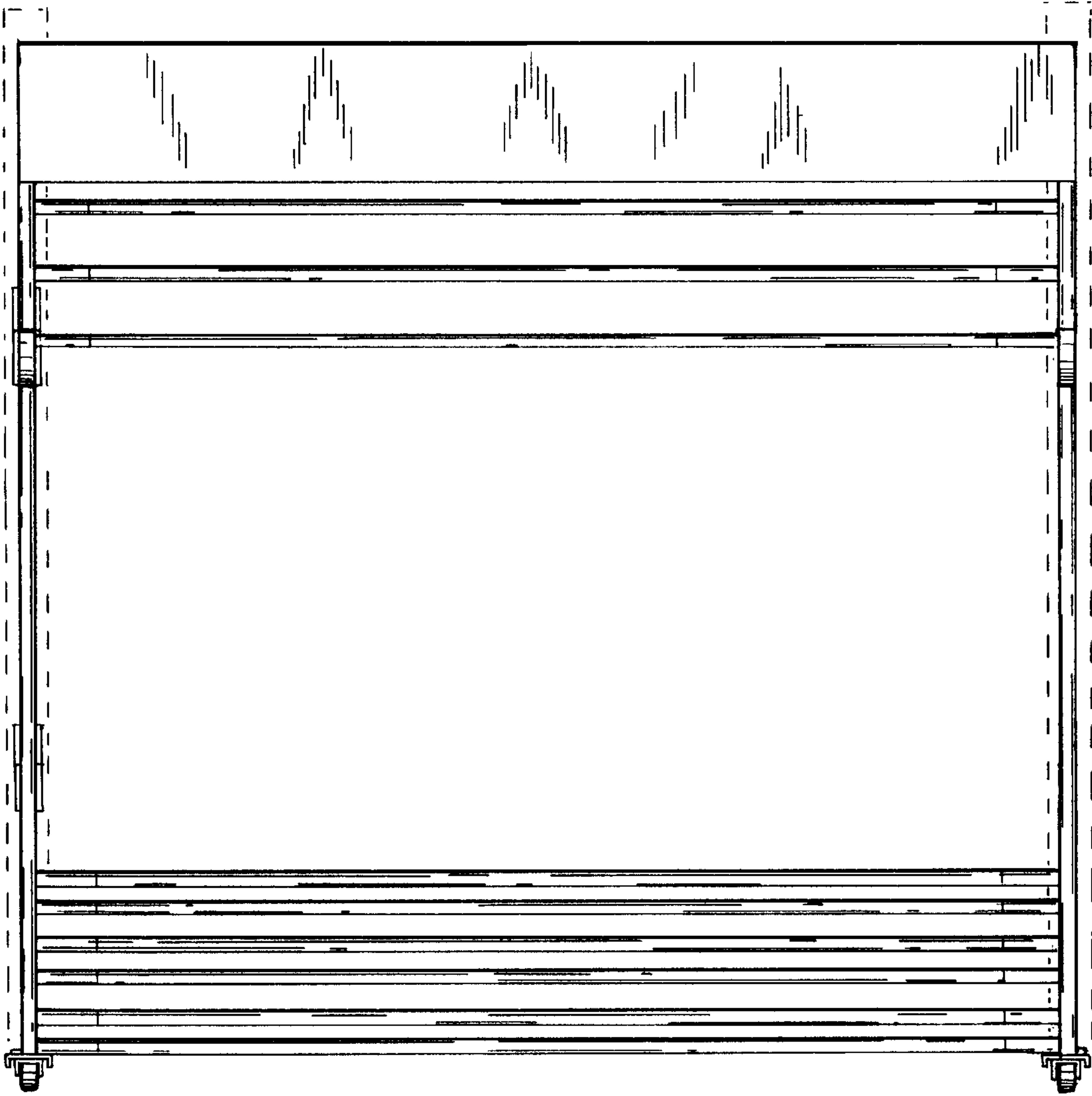

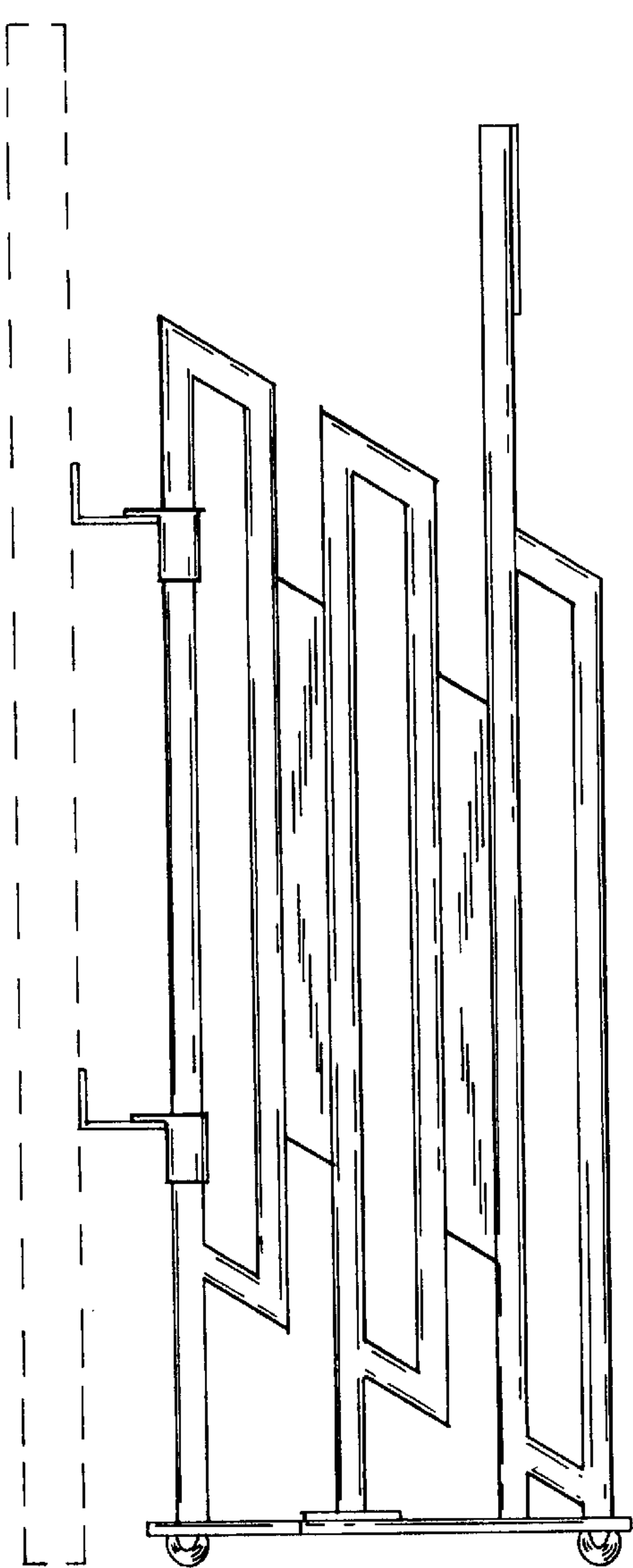

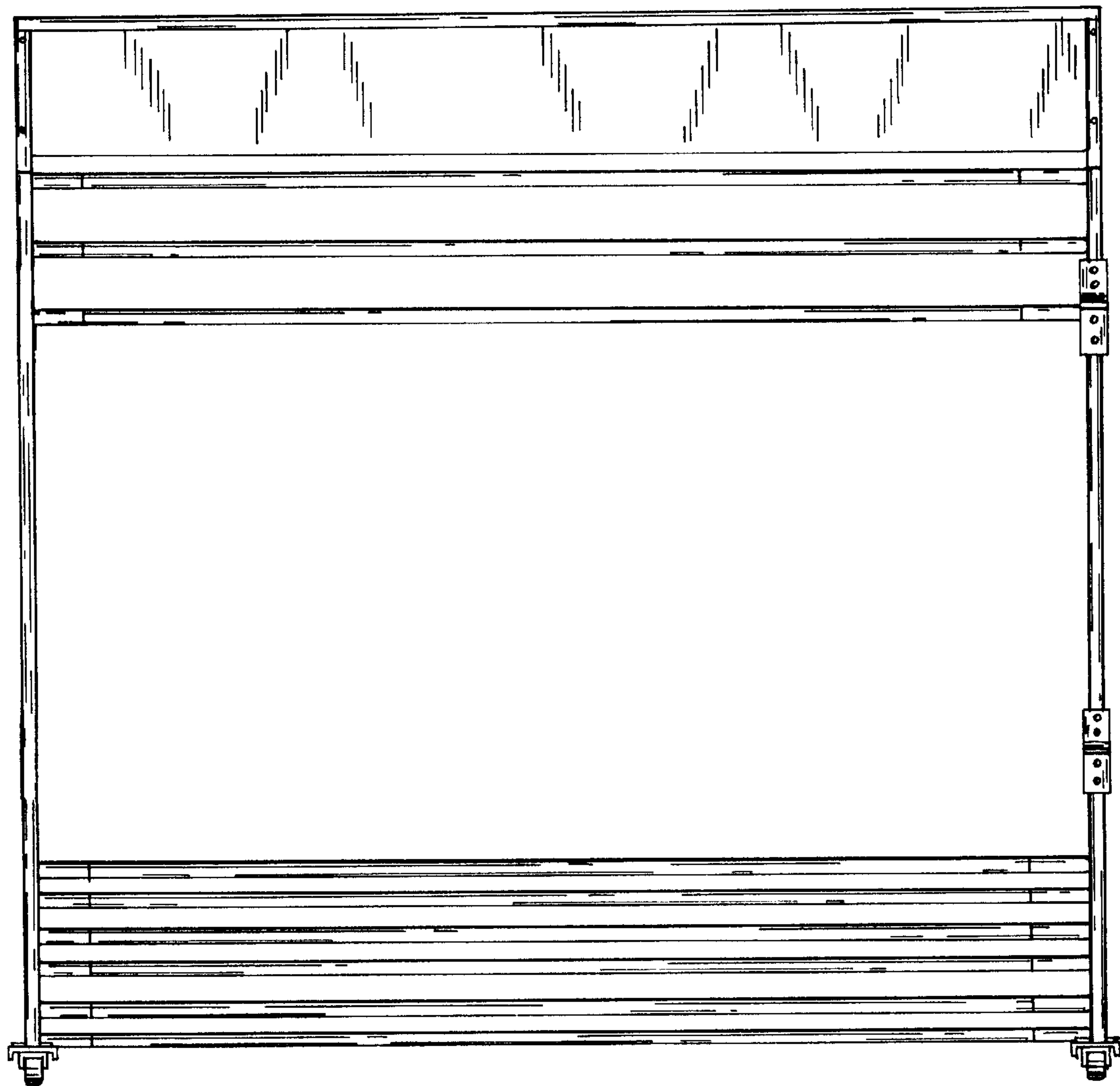

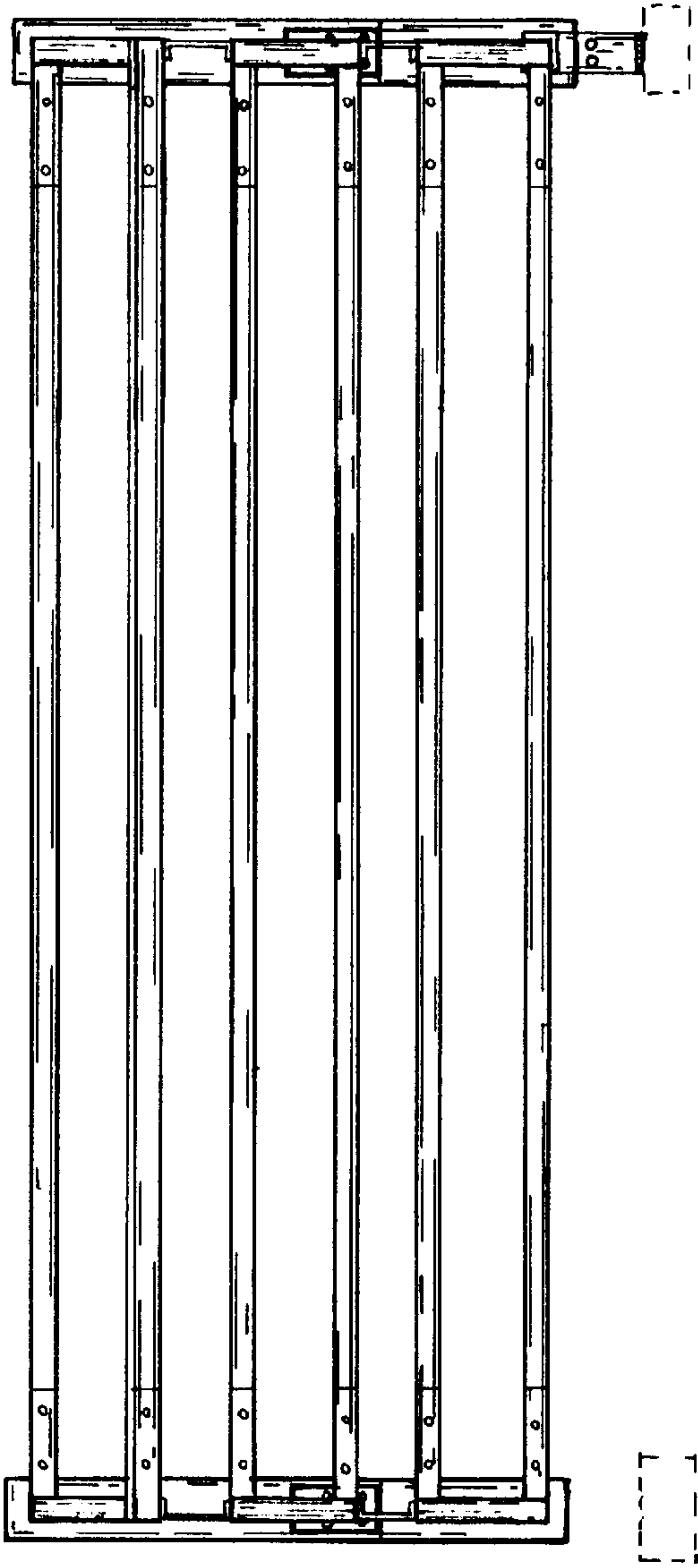

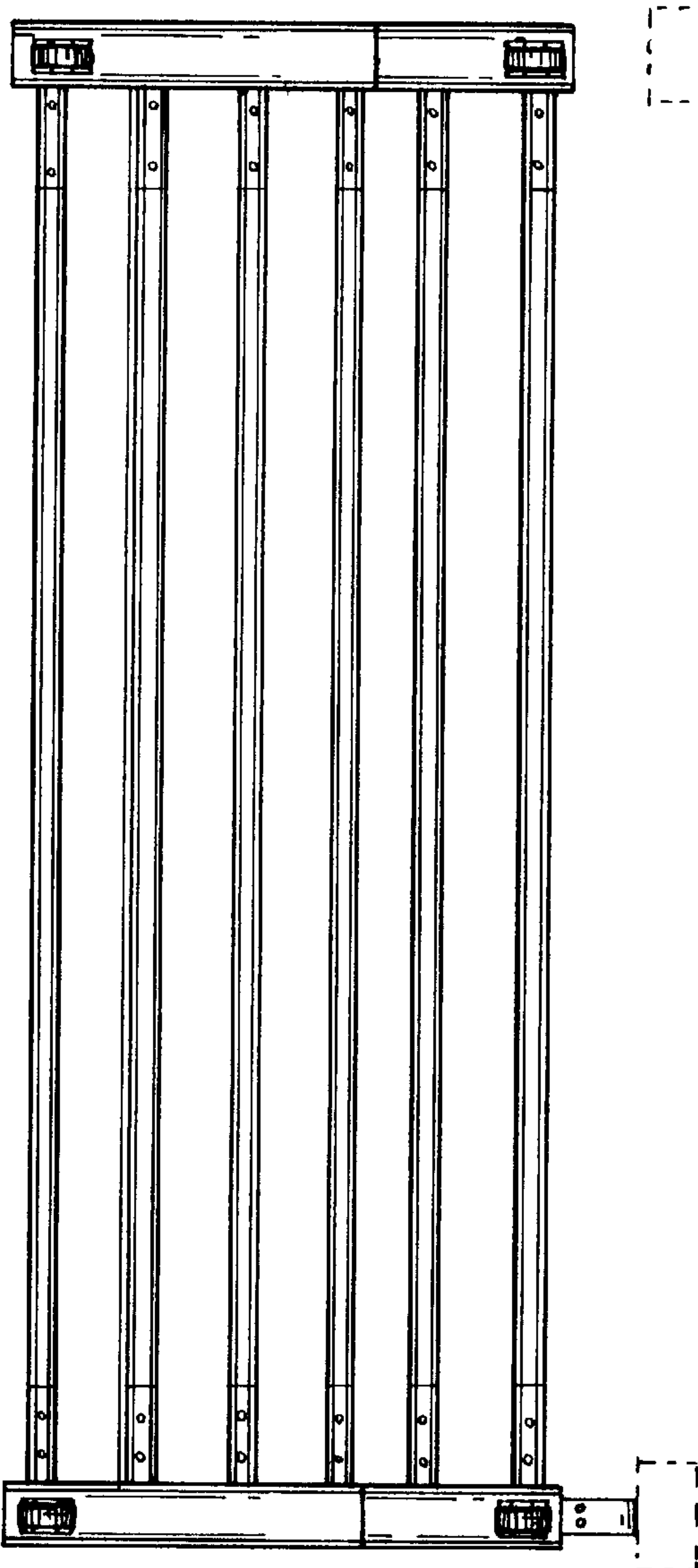
