The ornamental design for a pillow, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a first embodiment of a pillow according to the invention;

FIG. 2 is a plan view thereof from above (the inverted plan view being the same);

FIG. 3 is a front view thereof (the rear view being the same);

FIG. 4 is a right side view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a left side view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a perspective view of a second embodiment of the present invention;

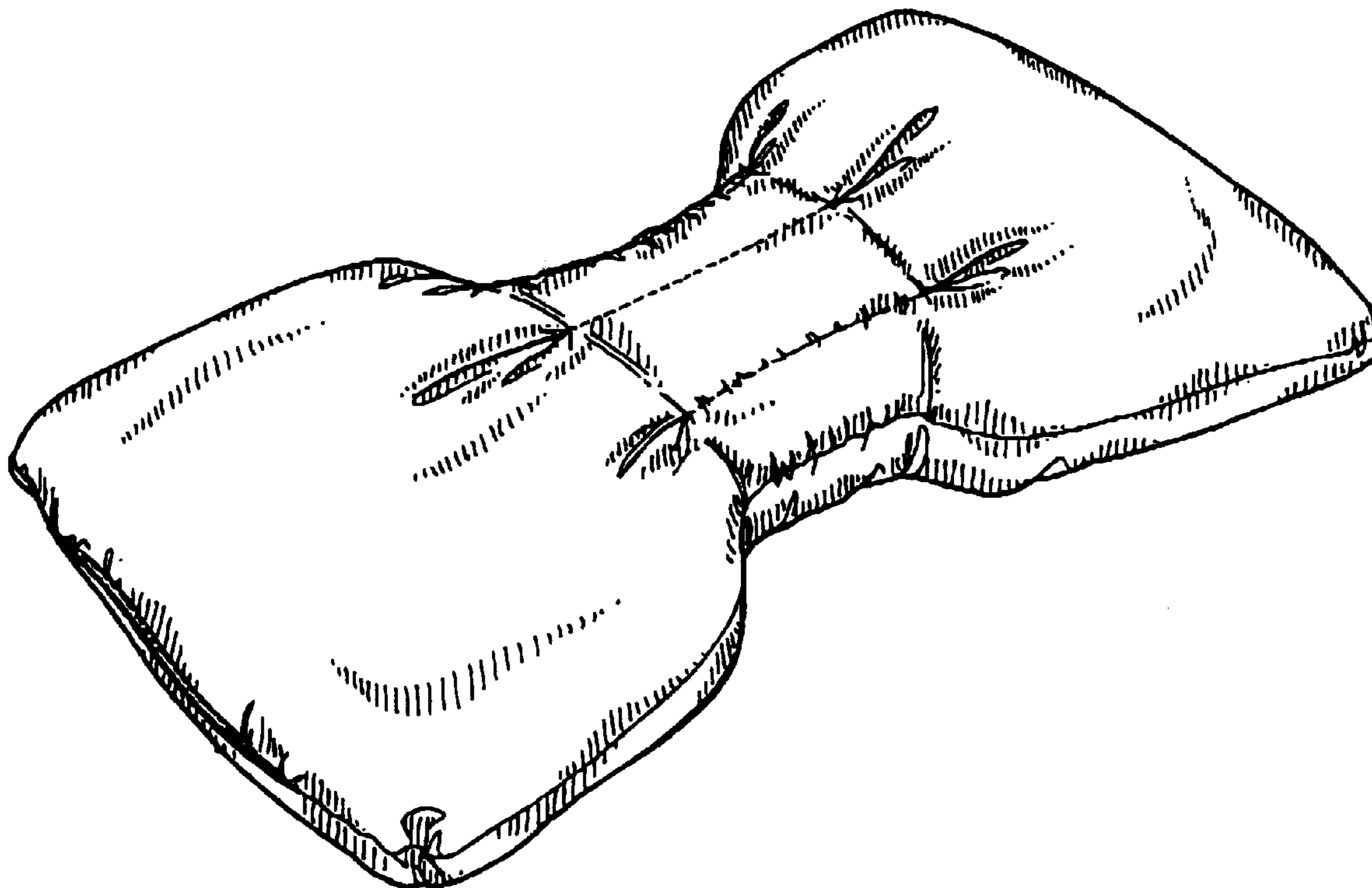
FIG. 7 is a plan view from above of the second embodiment of the present invention (the inverted plan view being the same);

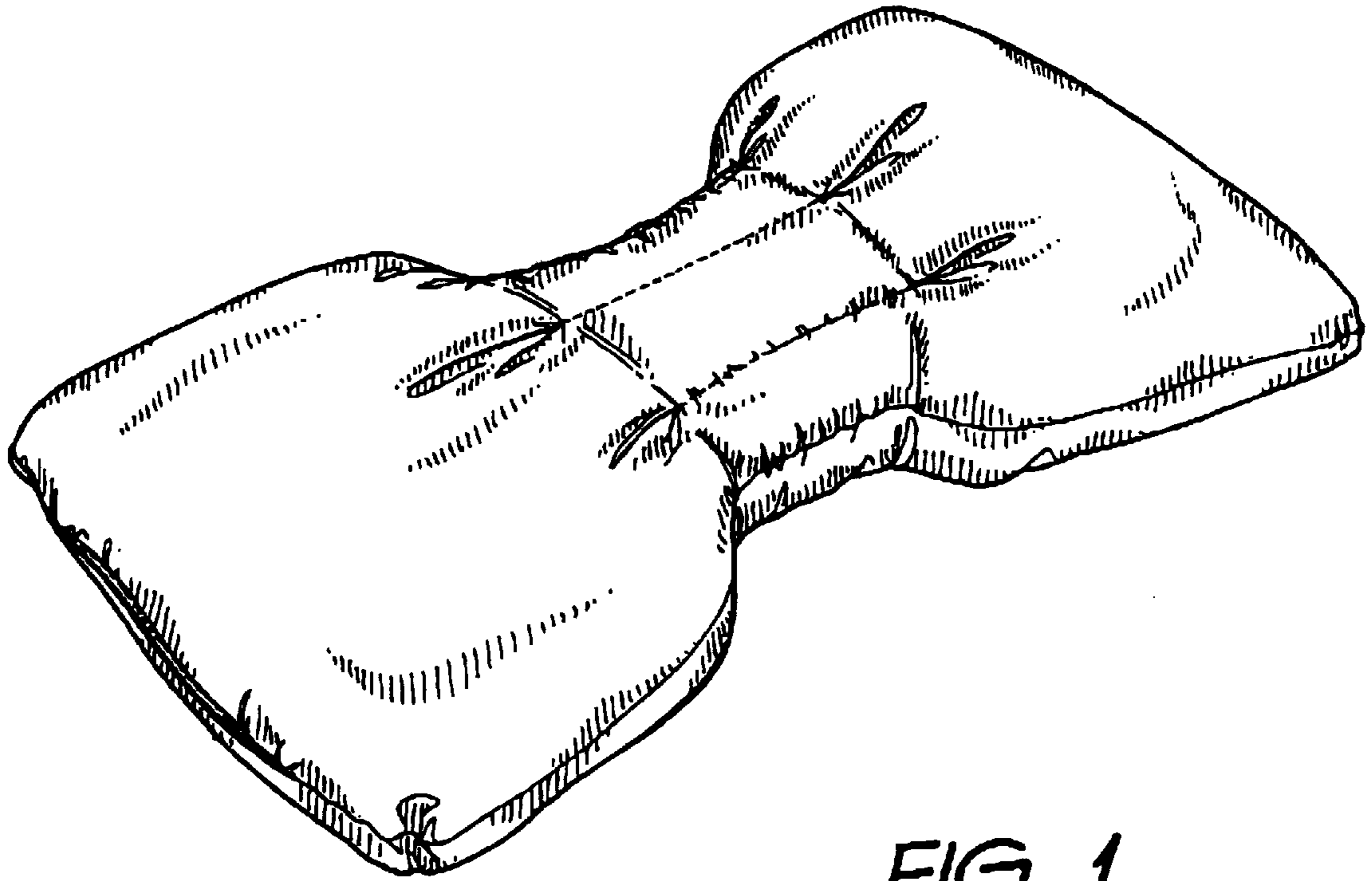

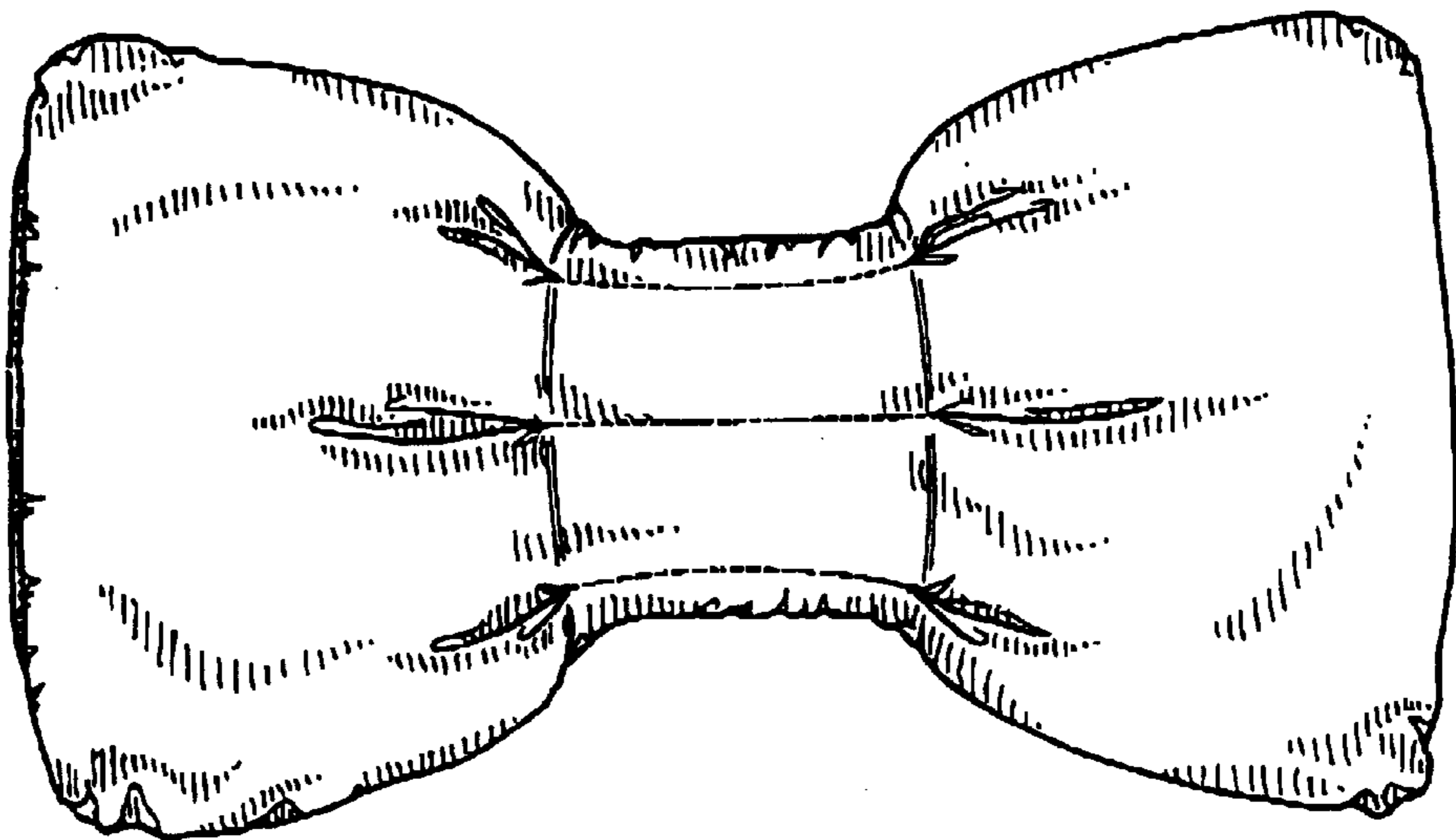

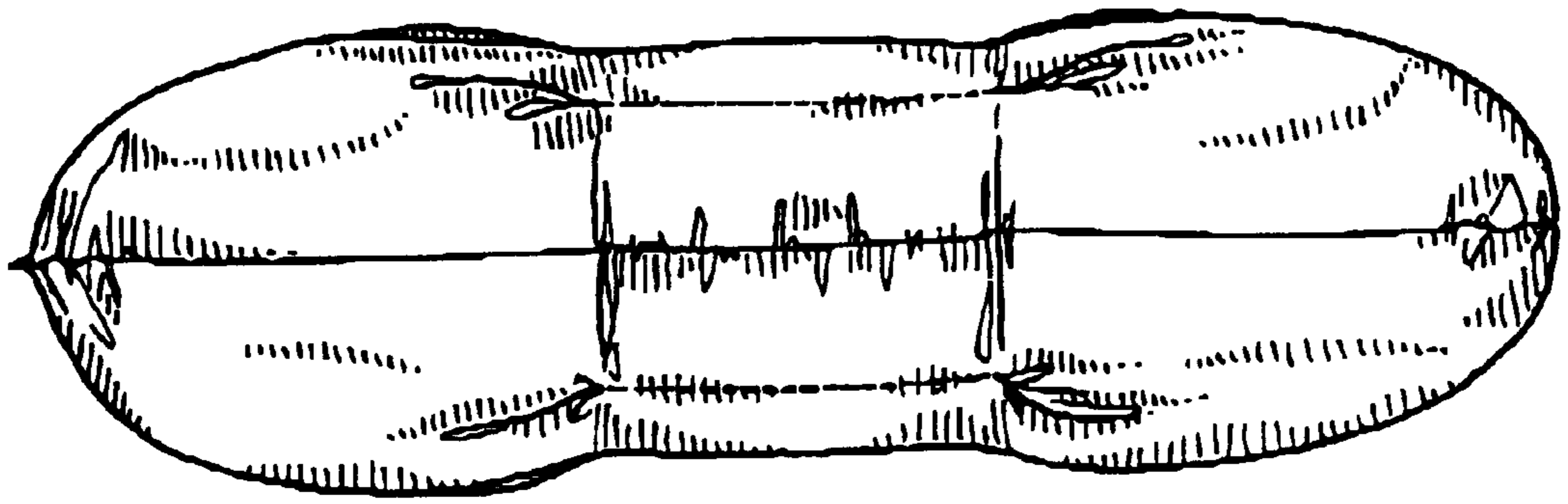

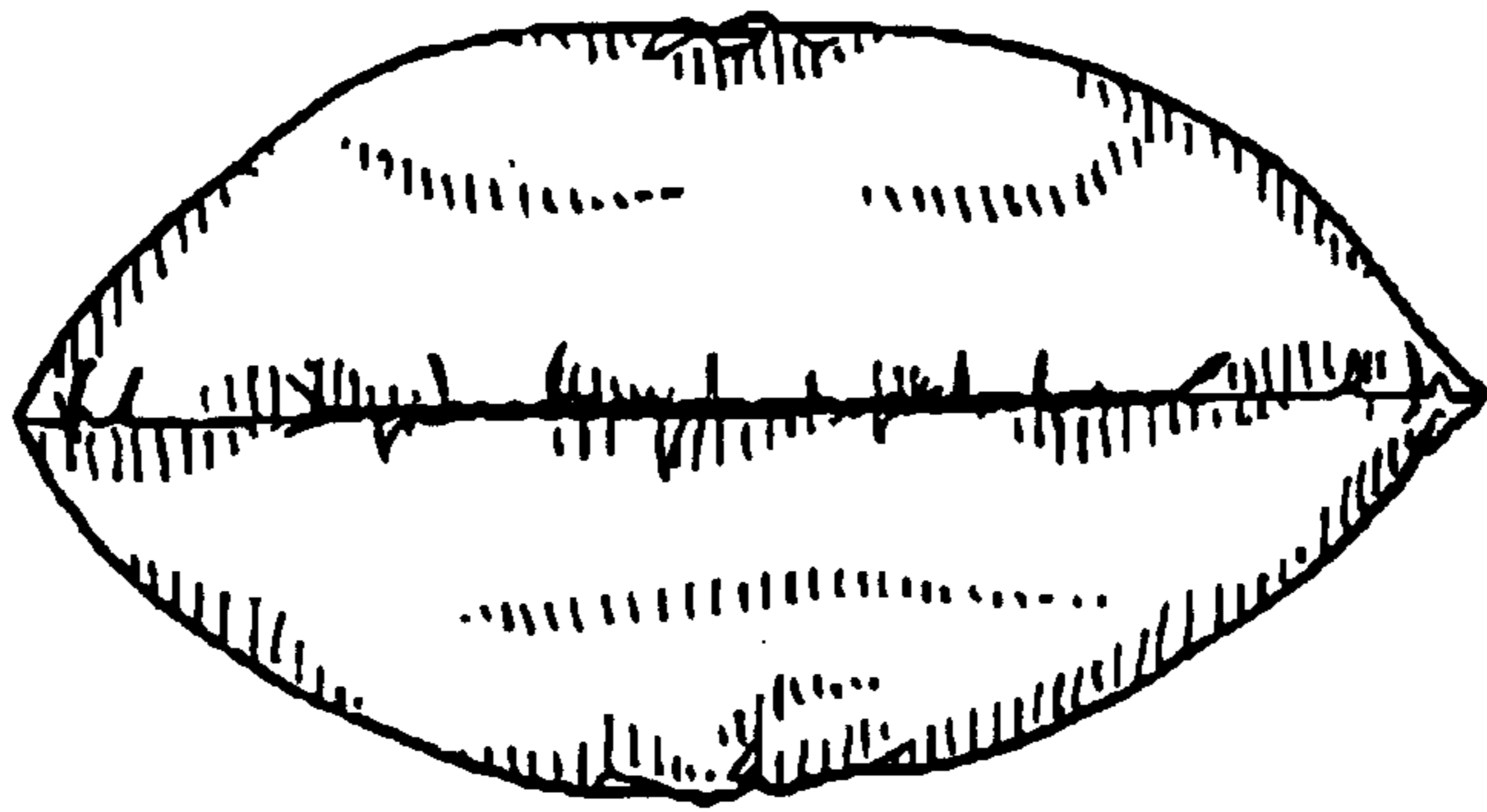

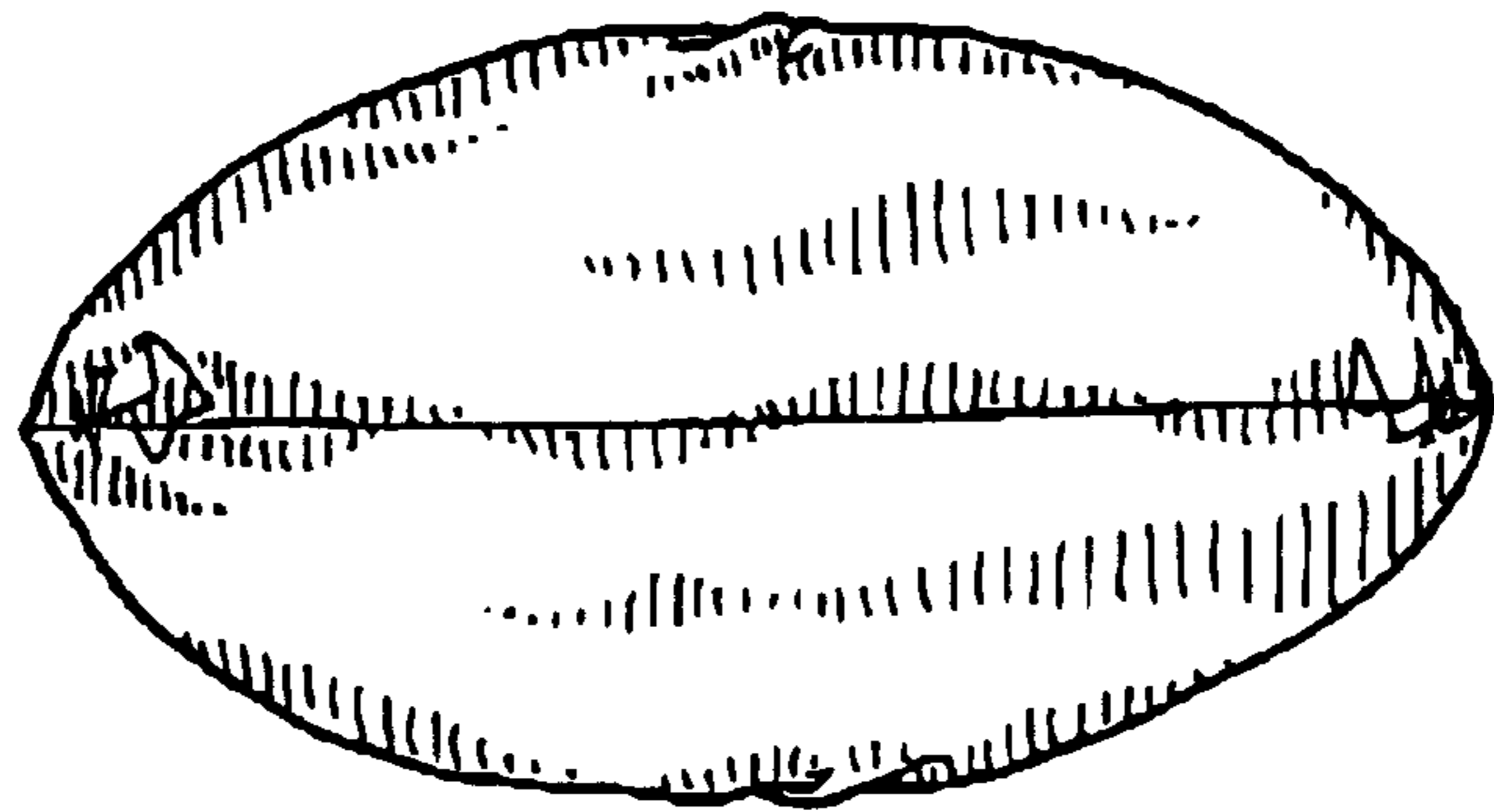

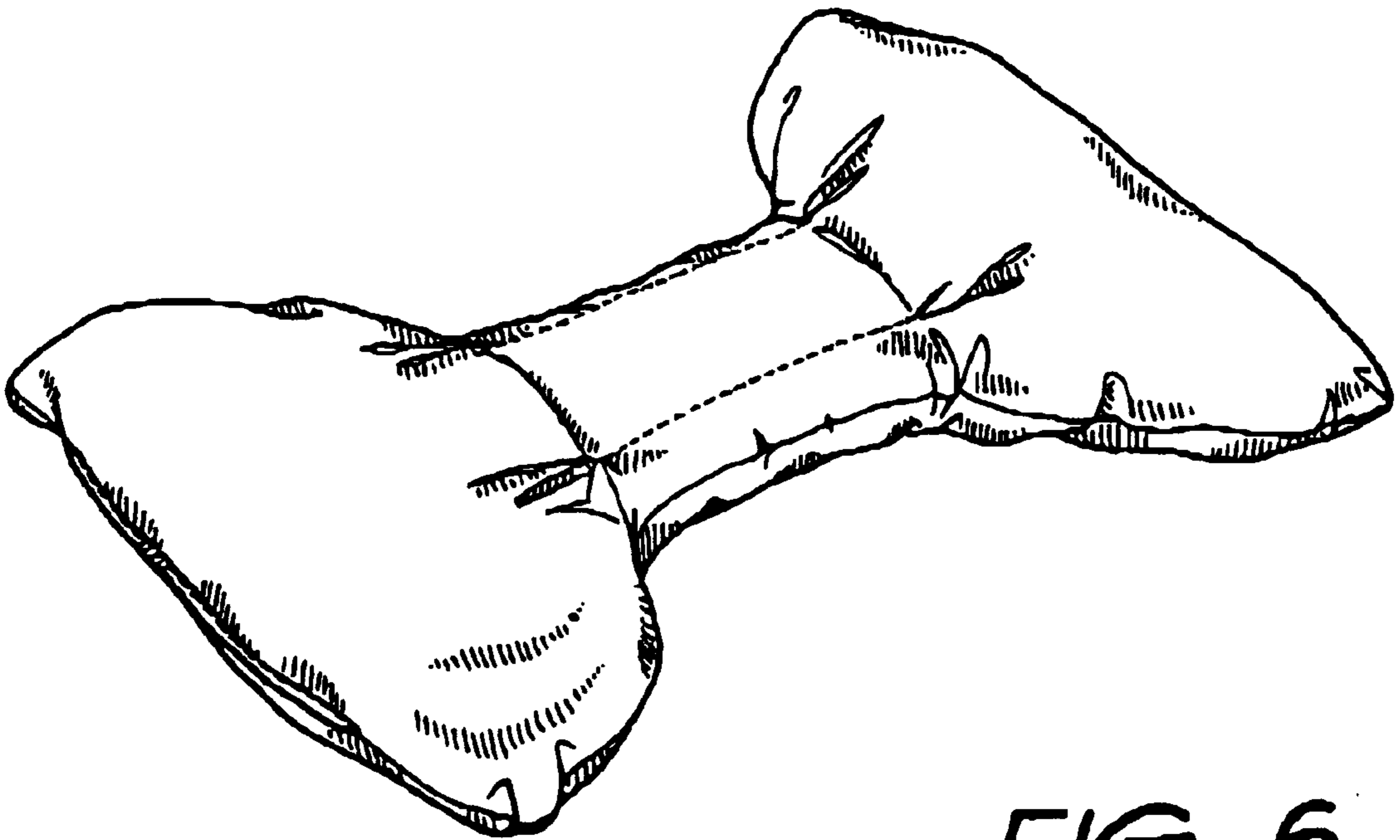

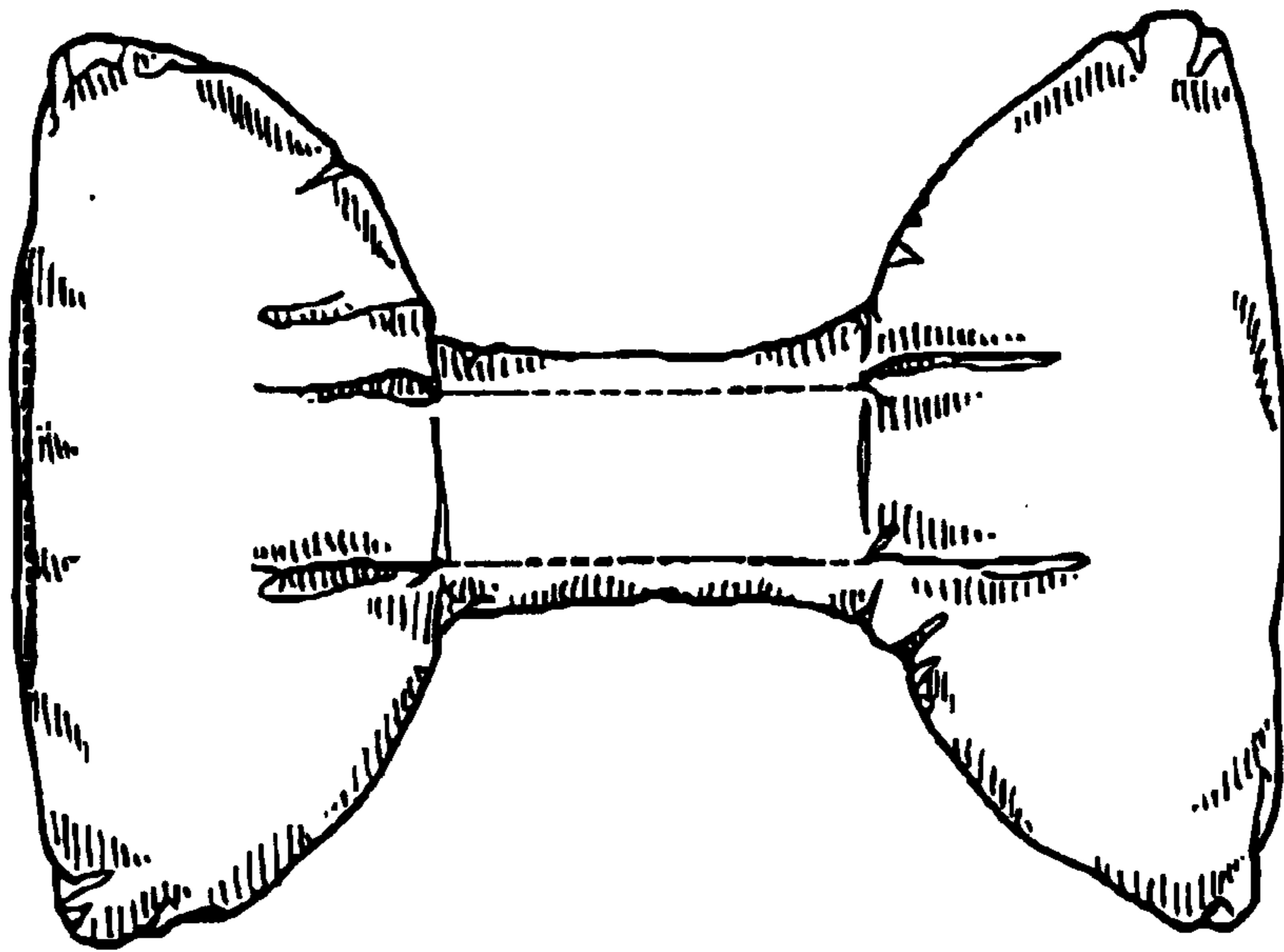

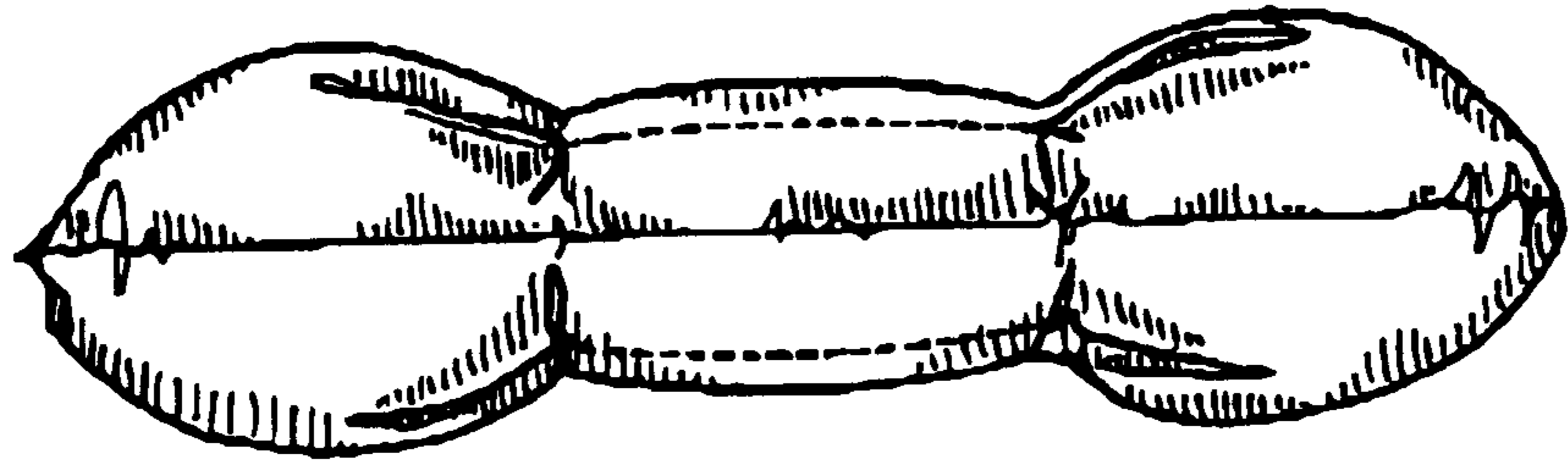

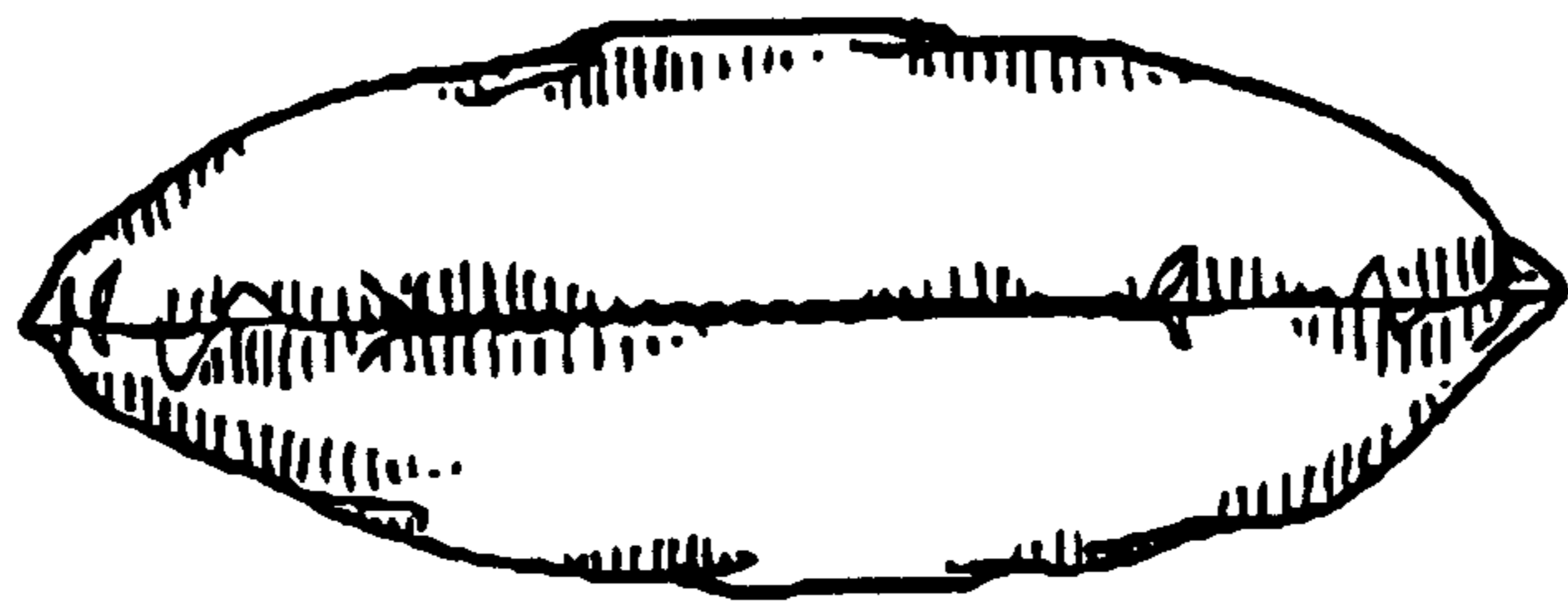

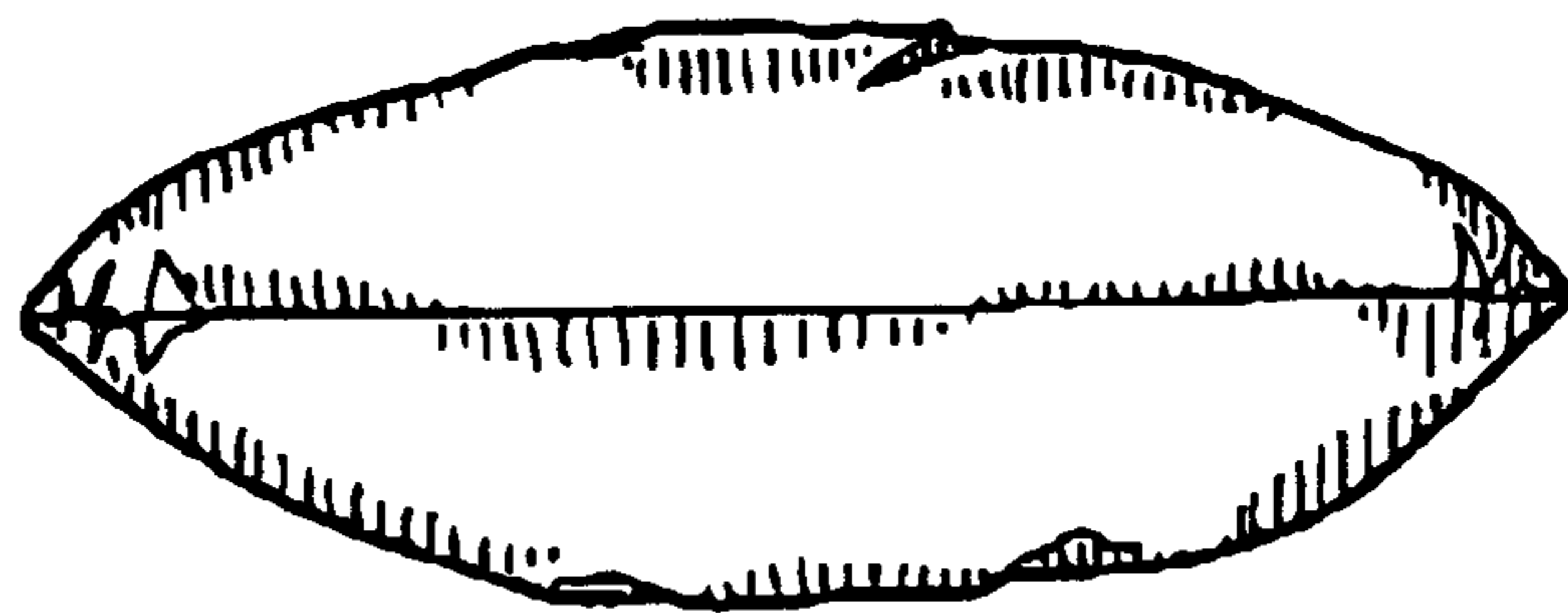
