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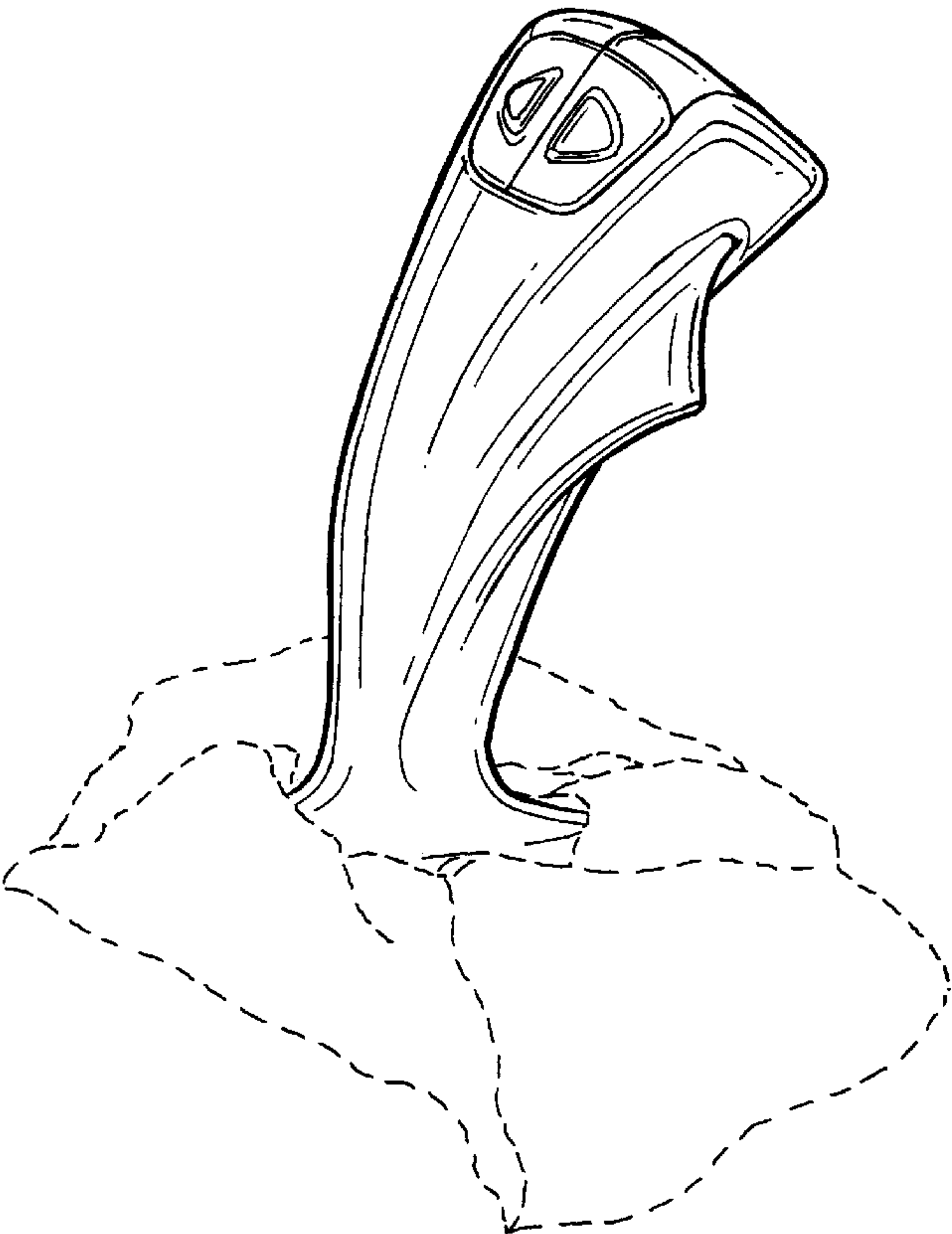

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front view of a right side embodiment of a configuration of a lever according to our novel design, the left side embodiment being mirror symmetrical;
FIG. 2 is a left side view of a right side embodiment of a configuration of a lever according to our novel design, the left side embodiment being mirror symmetrical;
FIG. 3 is a right side view of a right side embodiment of a configuration of a lever according to our novel design, the left side embodiment being mirror symmetrical;
FIG. 4 is a rear view of a right side embodiment of a configuration of a lever according to our novel design, the left side embodiment being mirror symmetrical;
FIG. 5 is a top view of a right side embodiment of a configuration of a lever according to our novel design, the left side embodiment being mirror symmetrical;
FIG. 6 is a perspective view from the front side of a right side embodiment of a configuration of a lever according to our novel design, the left side embodiment being mirror symmetrical; and,
FIG. 7 is a perspective view from the front side of a left side embodiment of a configuration of a lever according to our novel design, the right side embodiment being mirror symmetrical.

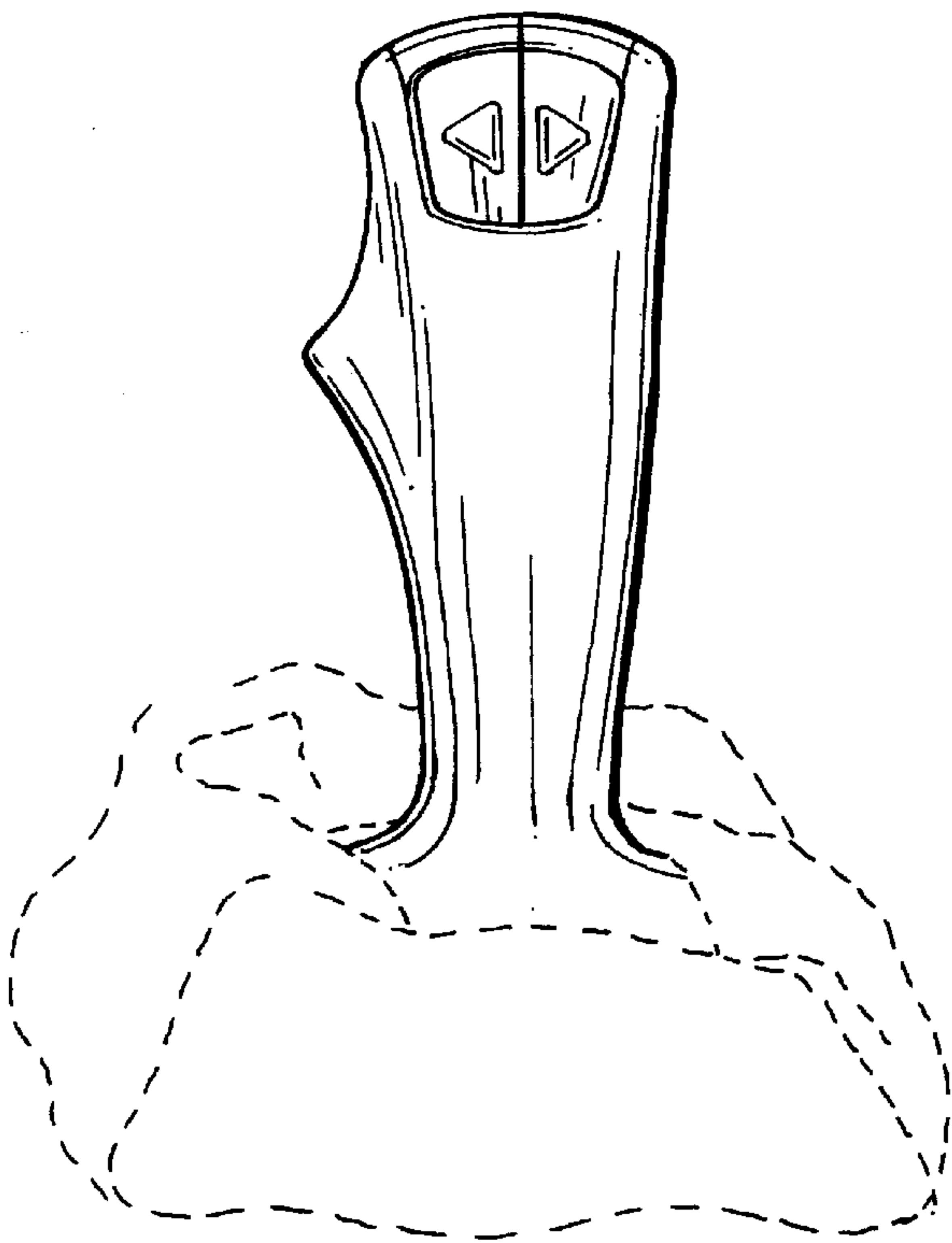

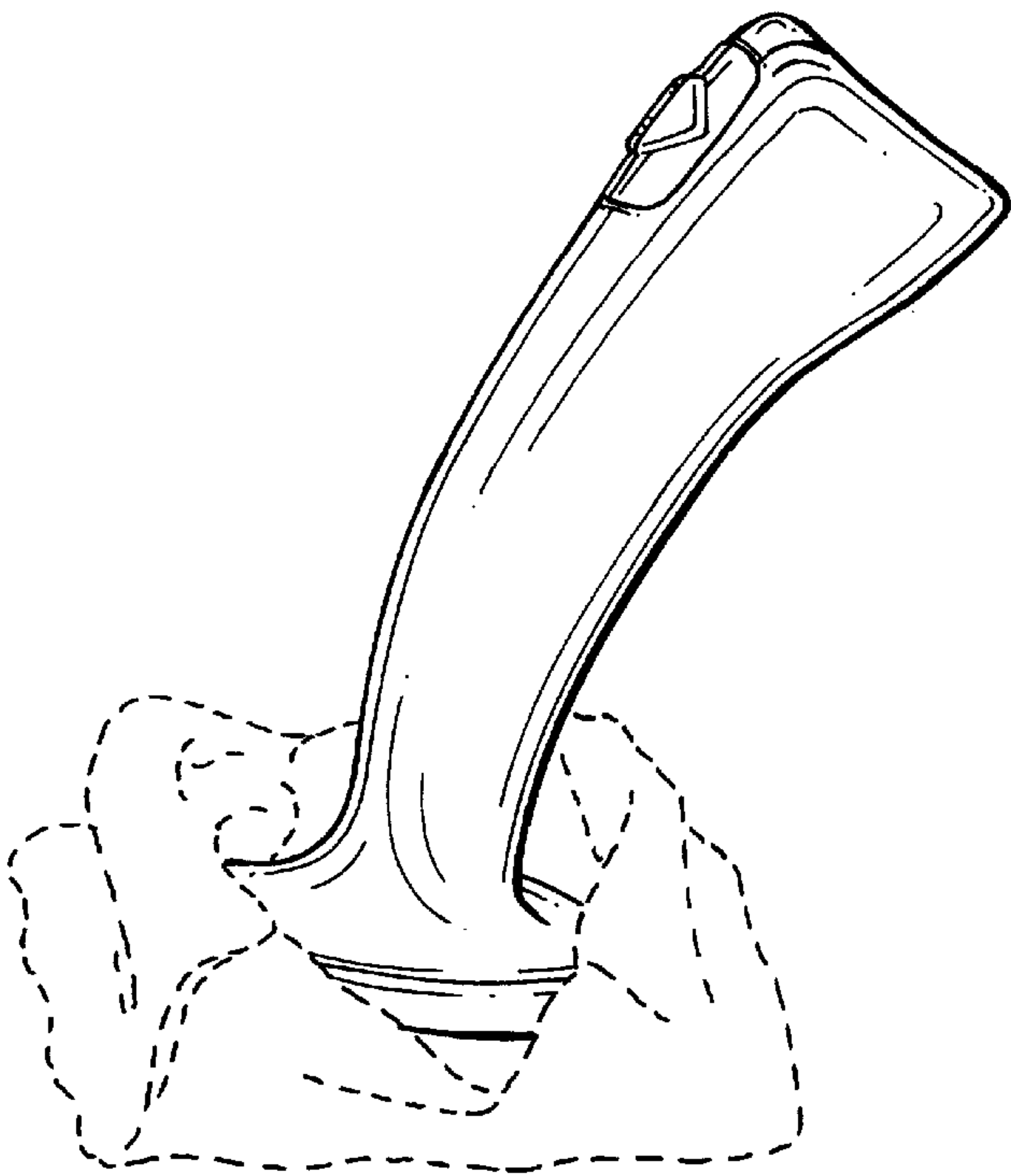

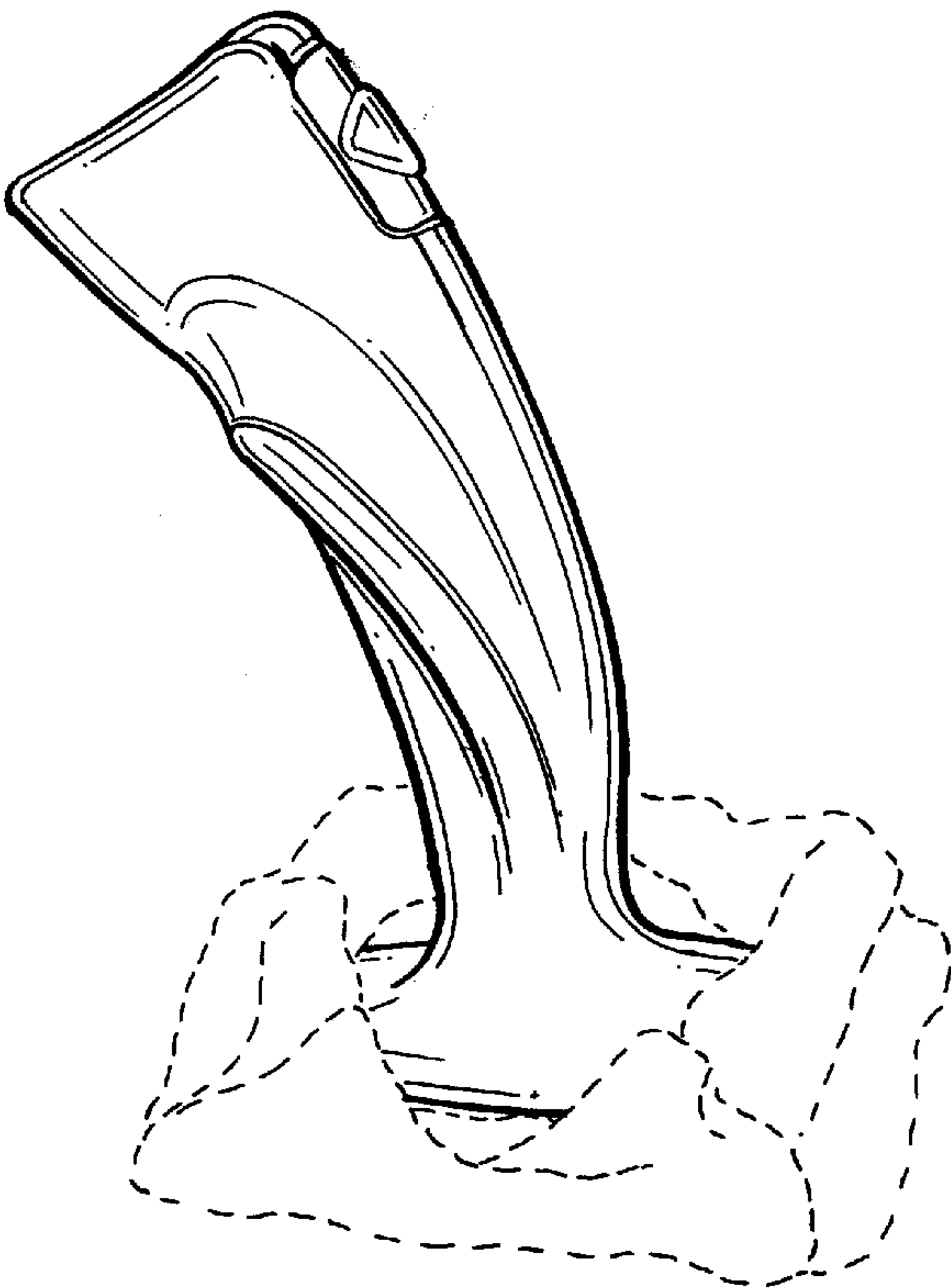

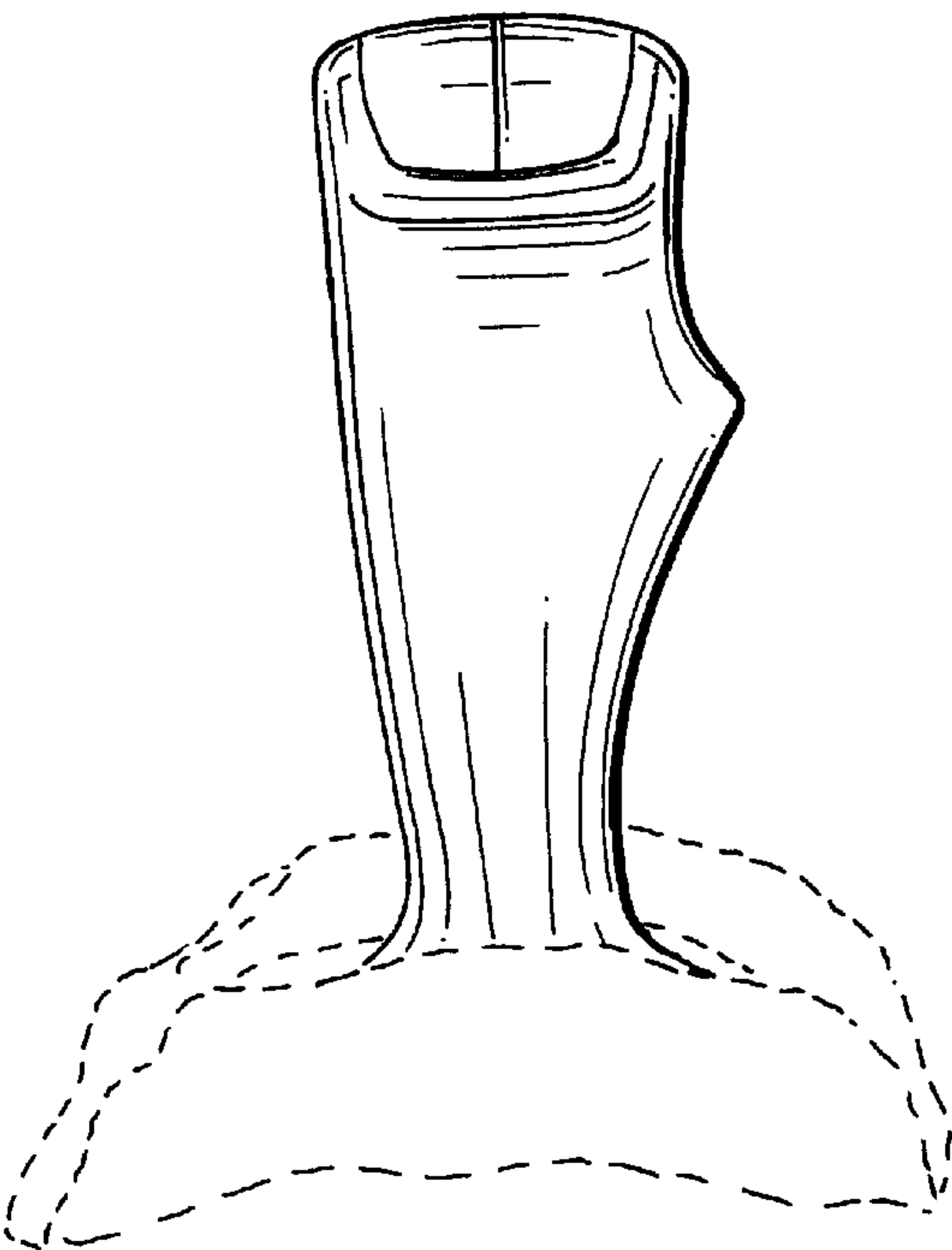

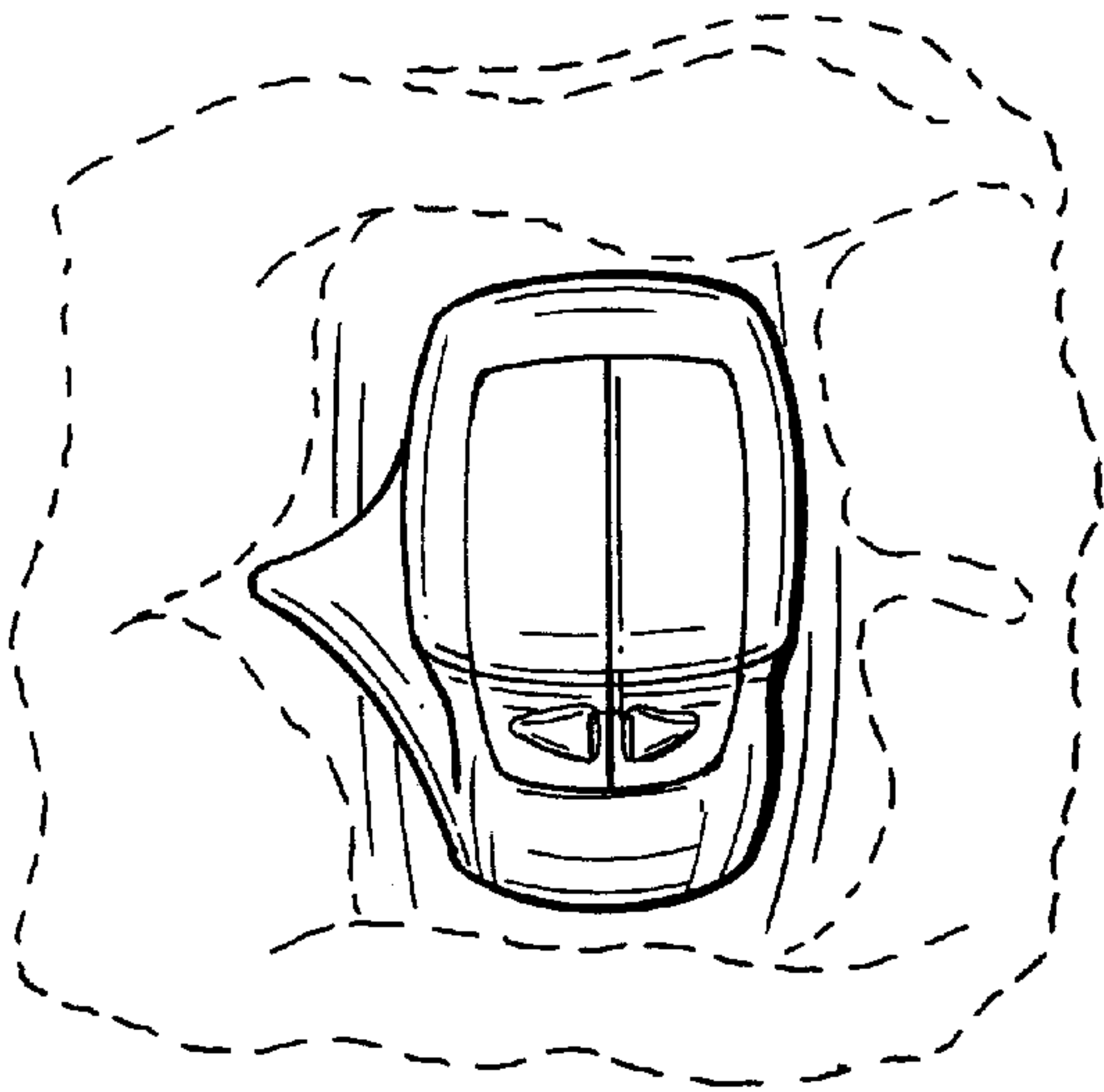

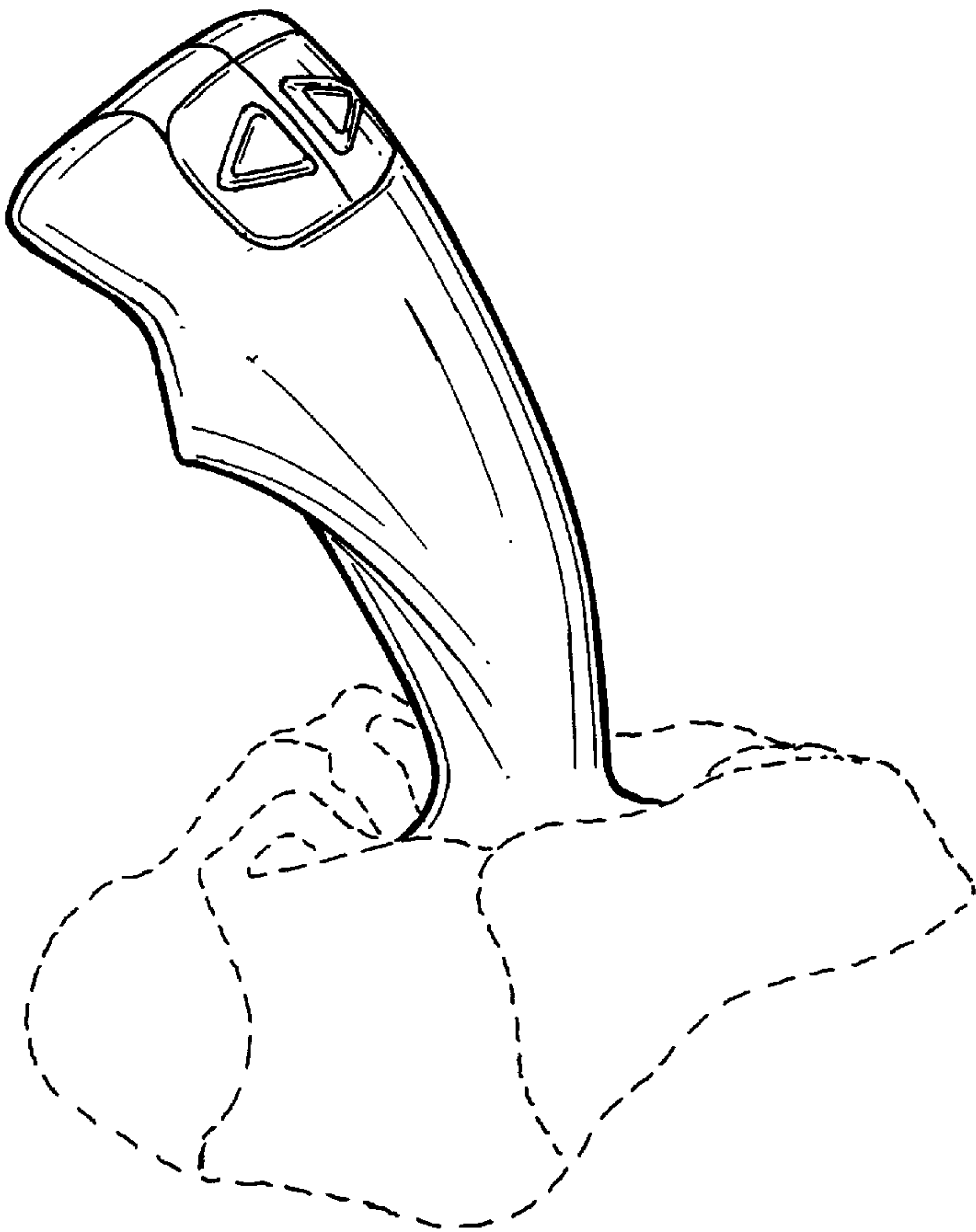

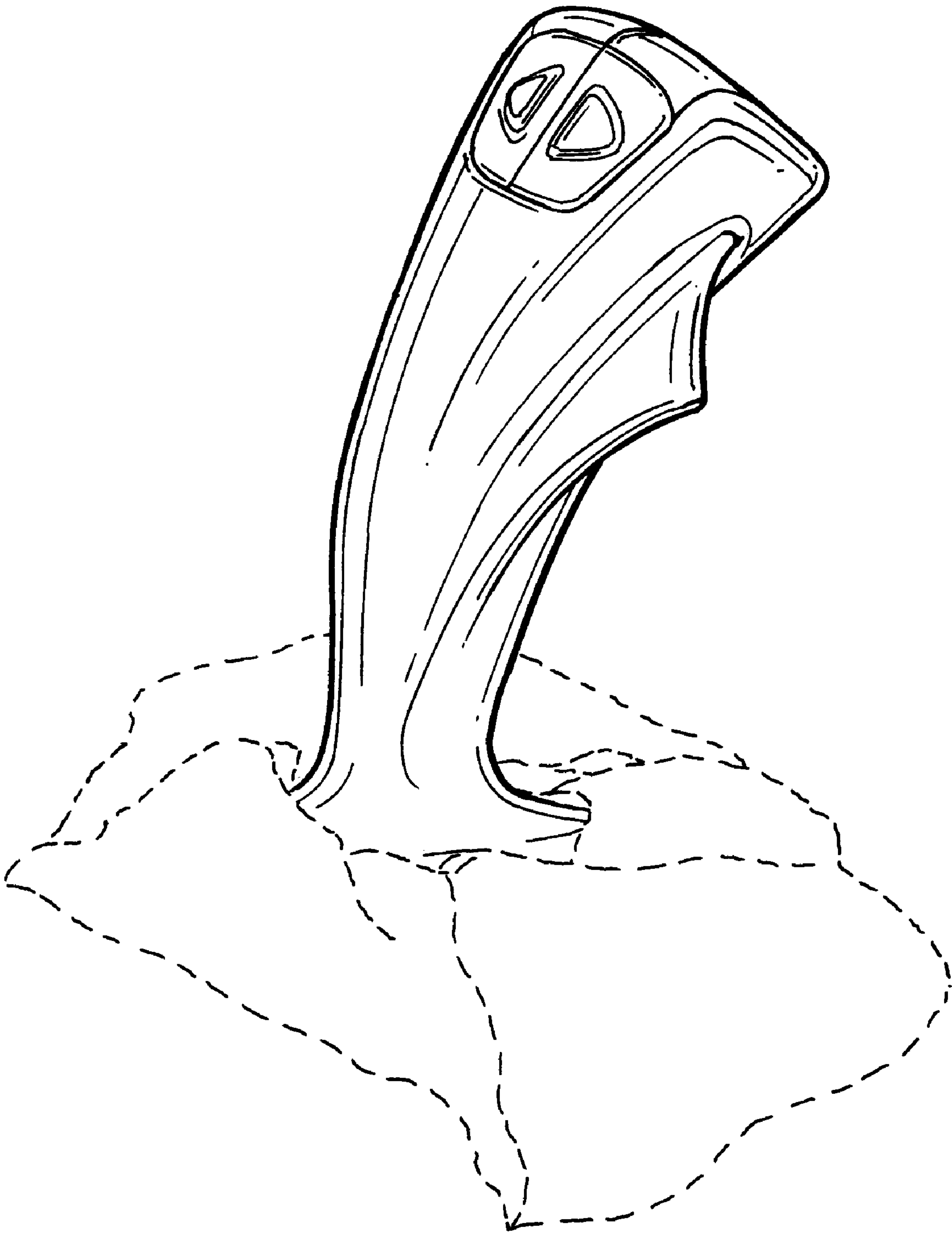
