DESCRIPTION

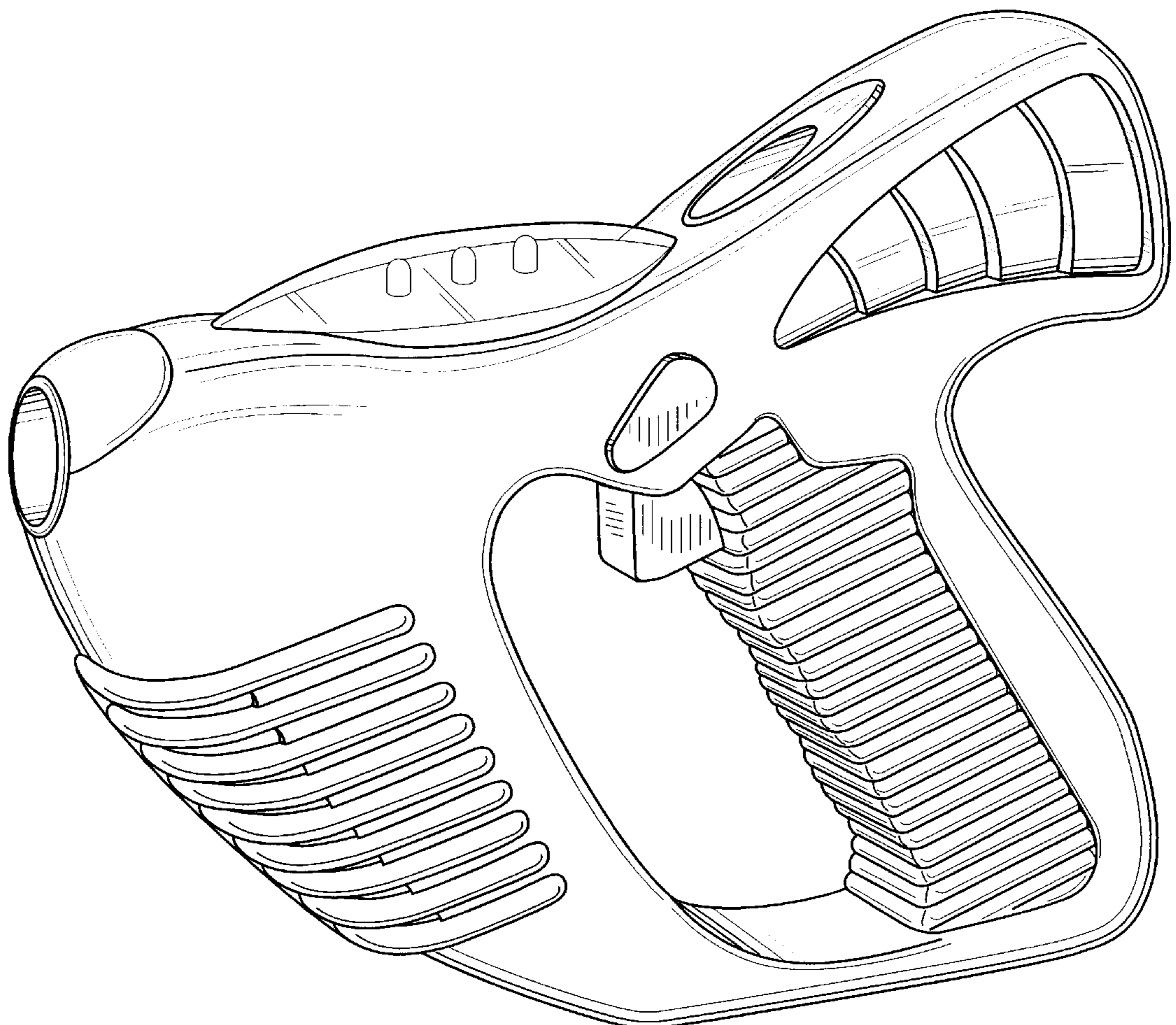
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a toy gun showing our new design;

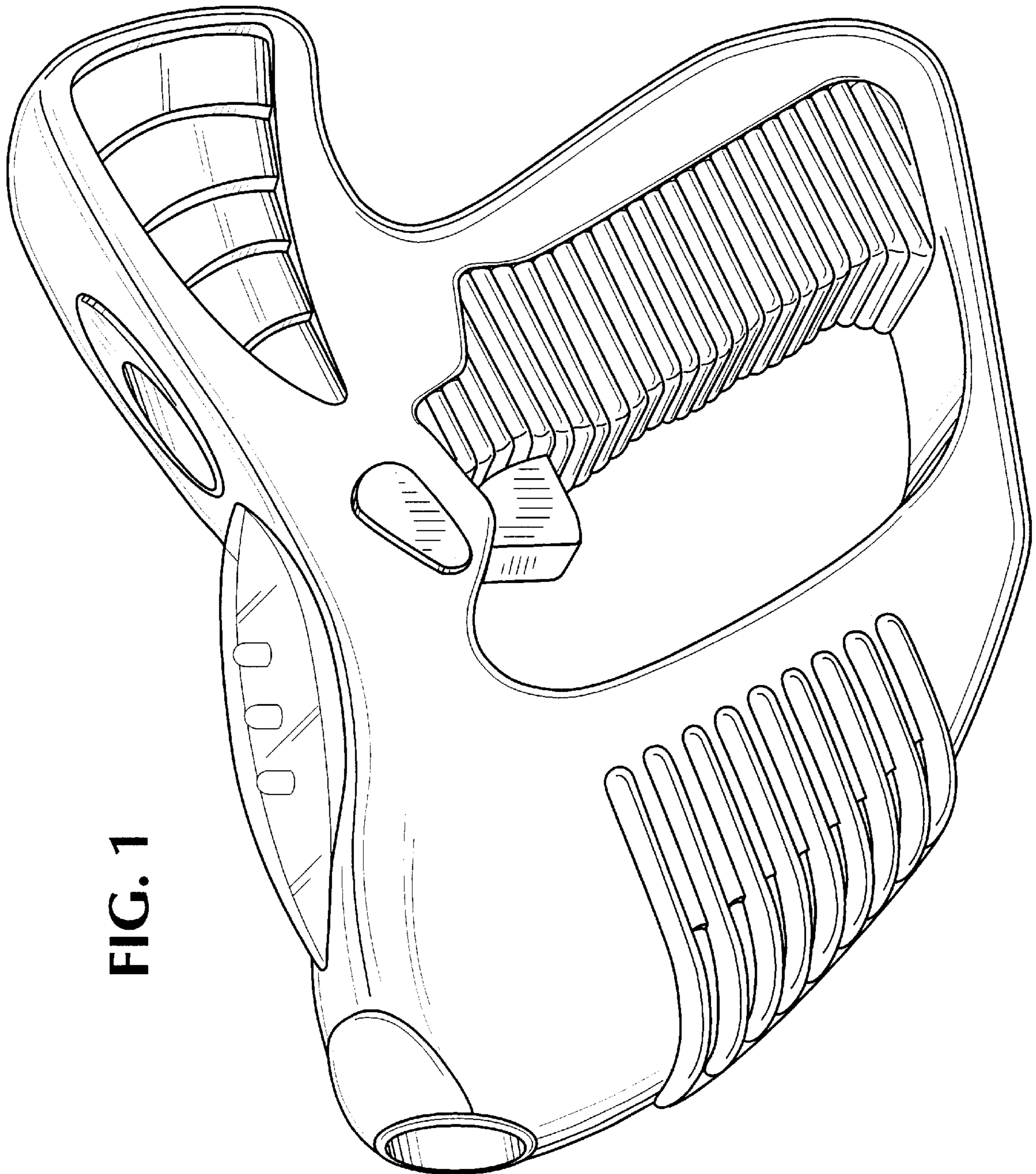

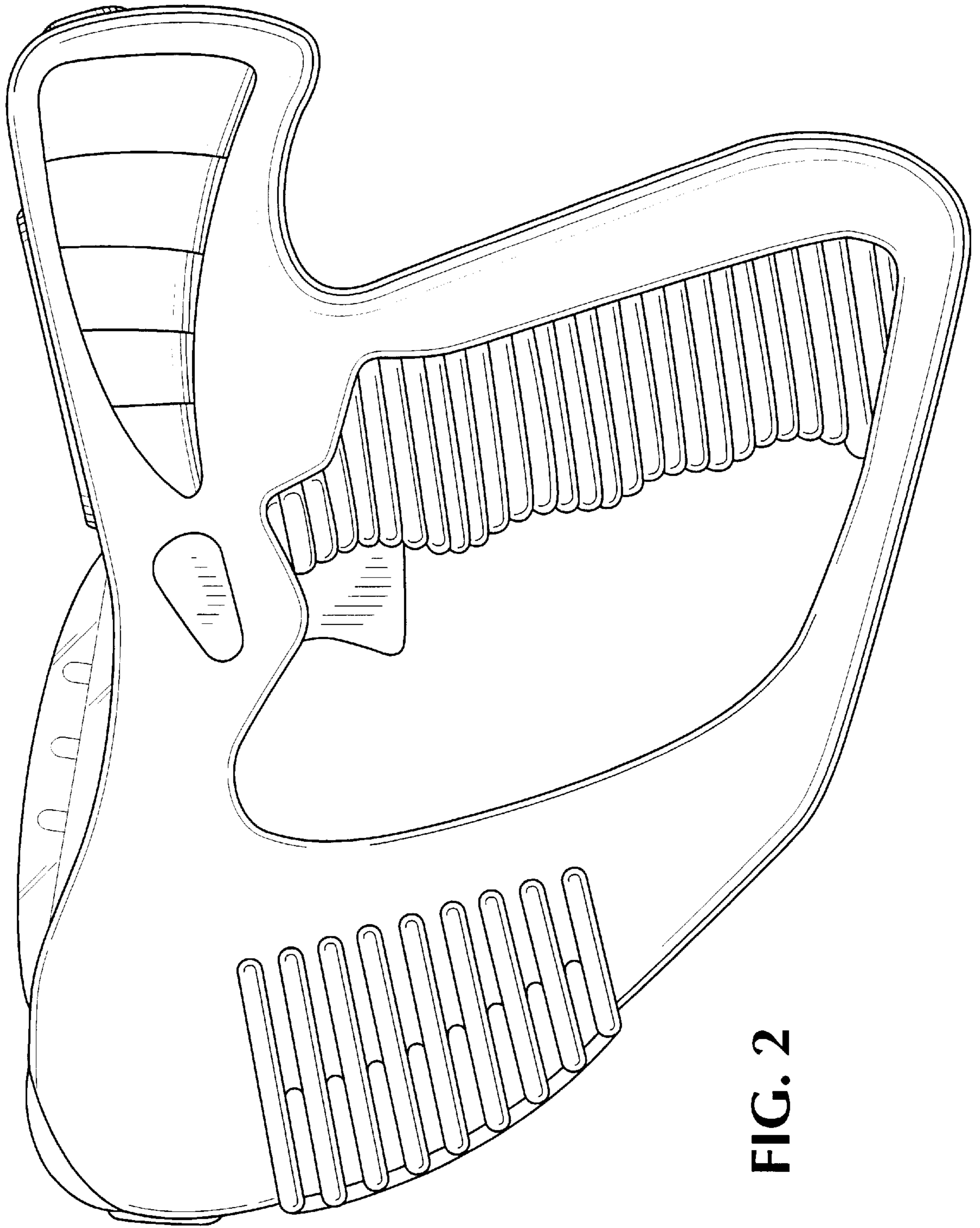

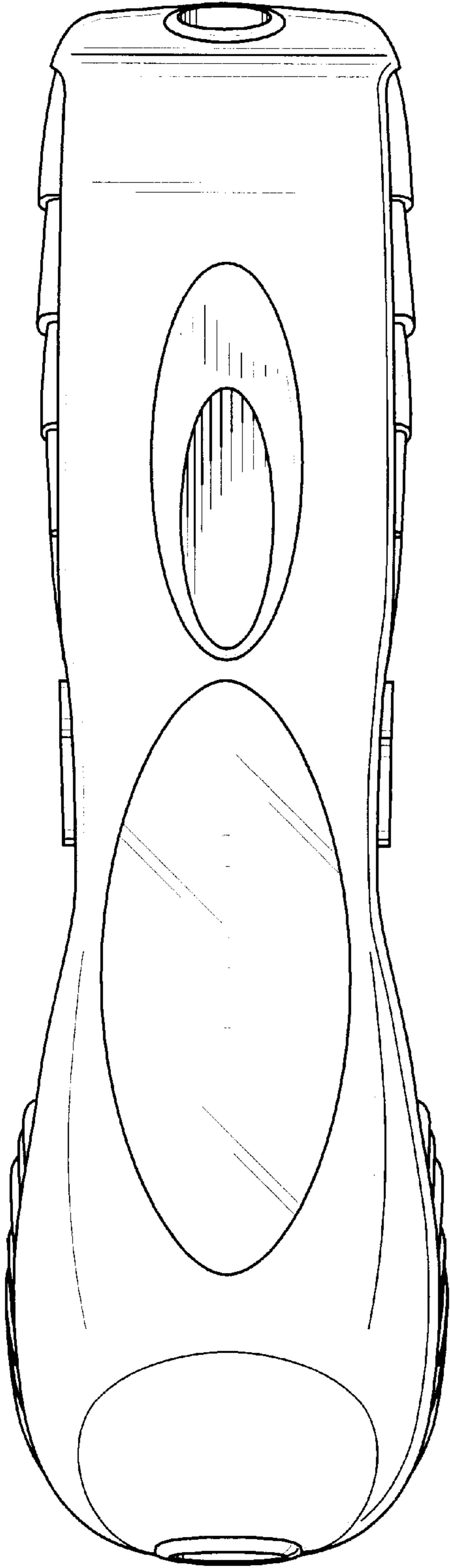
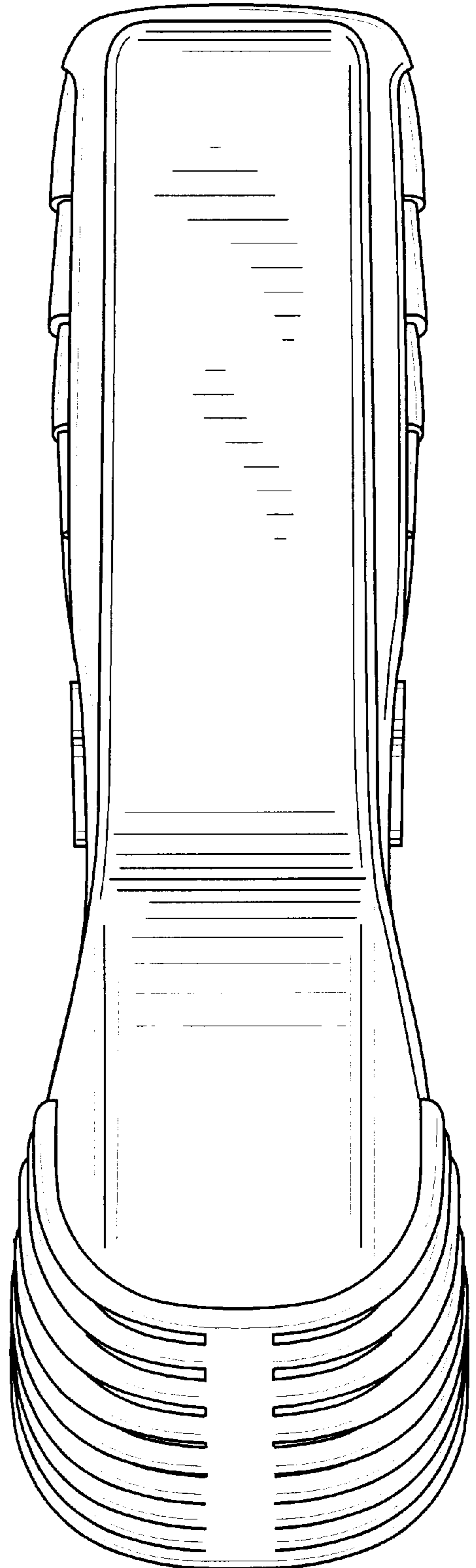

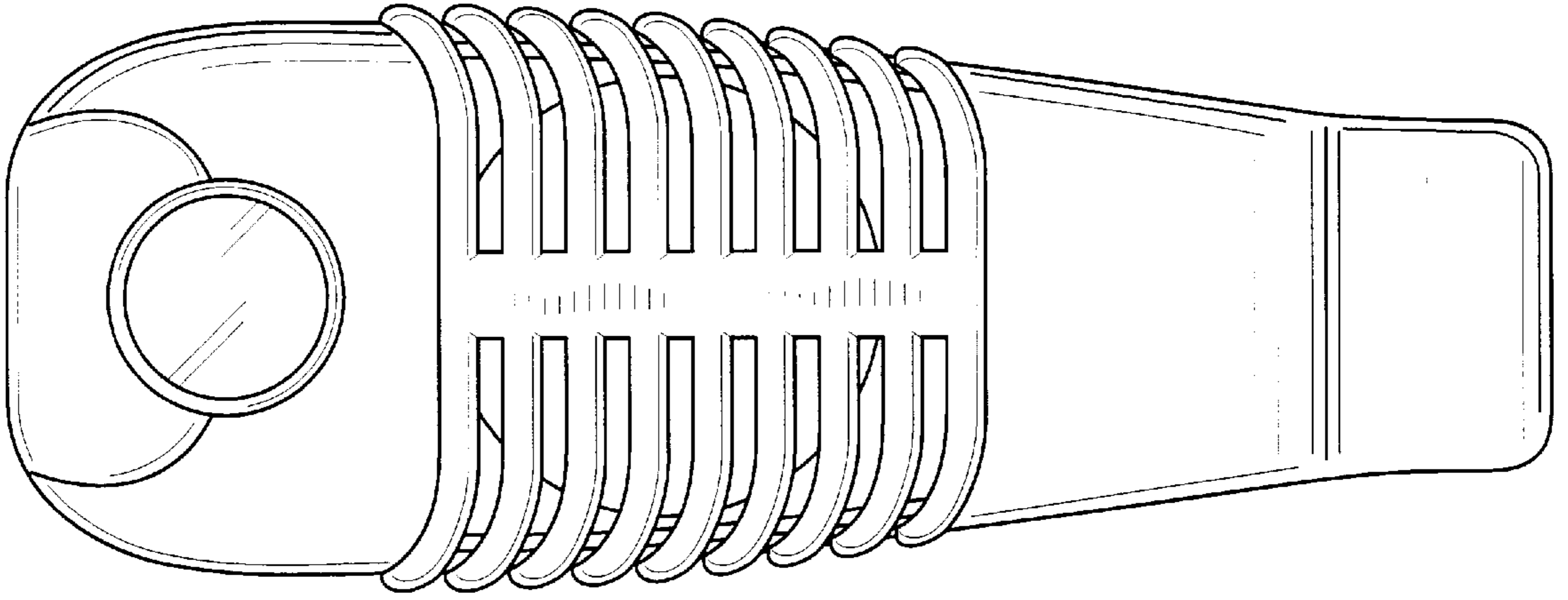

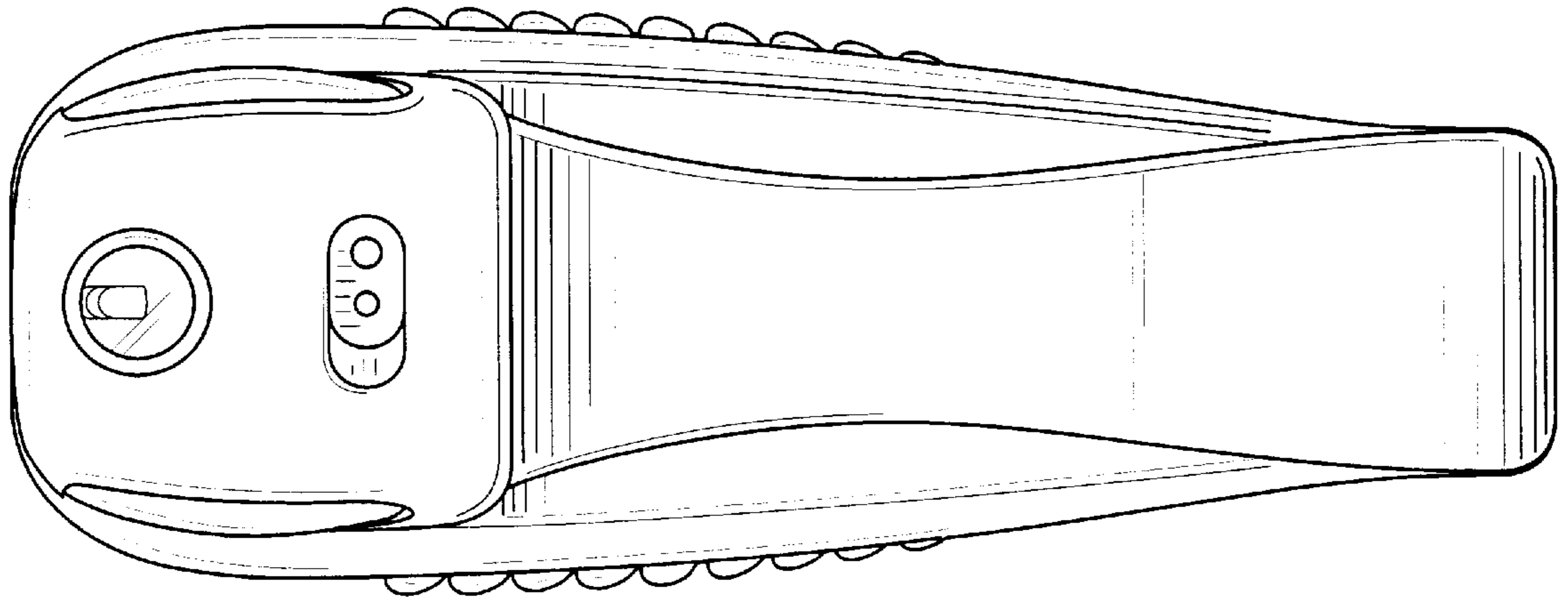
