FIG. 2 is a front view thereof; the rear view is a mirror image.


FIG. 3 is a side view thereof; the opposite side view is a mirror image.

FIG. 4 is a top view thereof; and,


FIG. 5 is a bottom view thereof.

The broken lines are shown in FIG. 4 for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.






