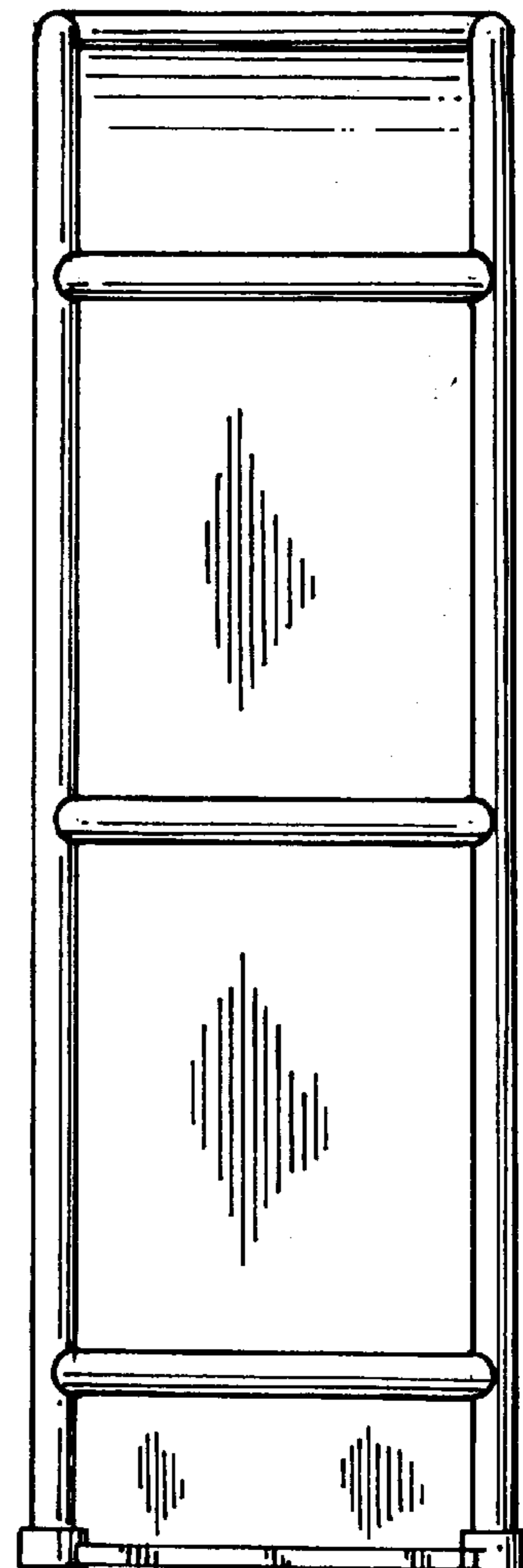
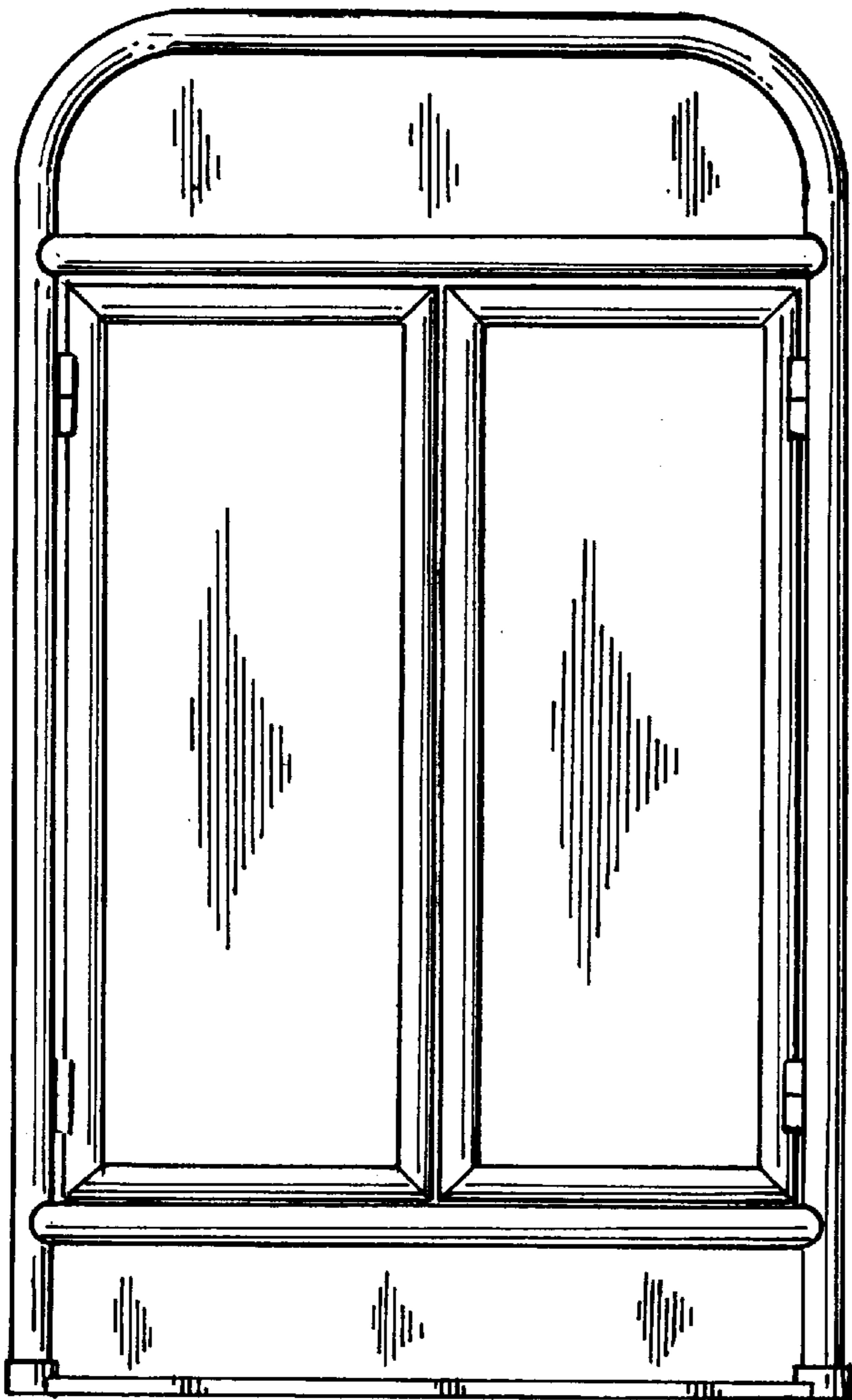
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a protective cabinet for persons and possessions, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a protective cabinet for persons and possessions showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view, the left side being identical thereto; FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof; and, FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof.

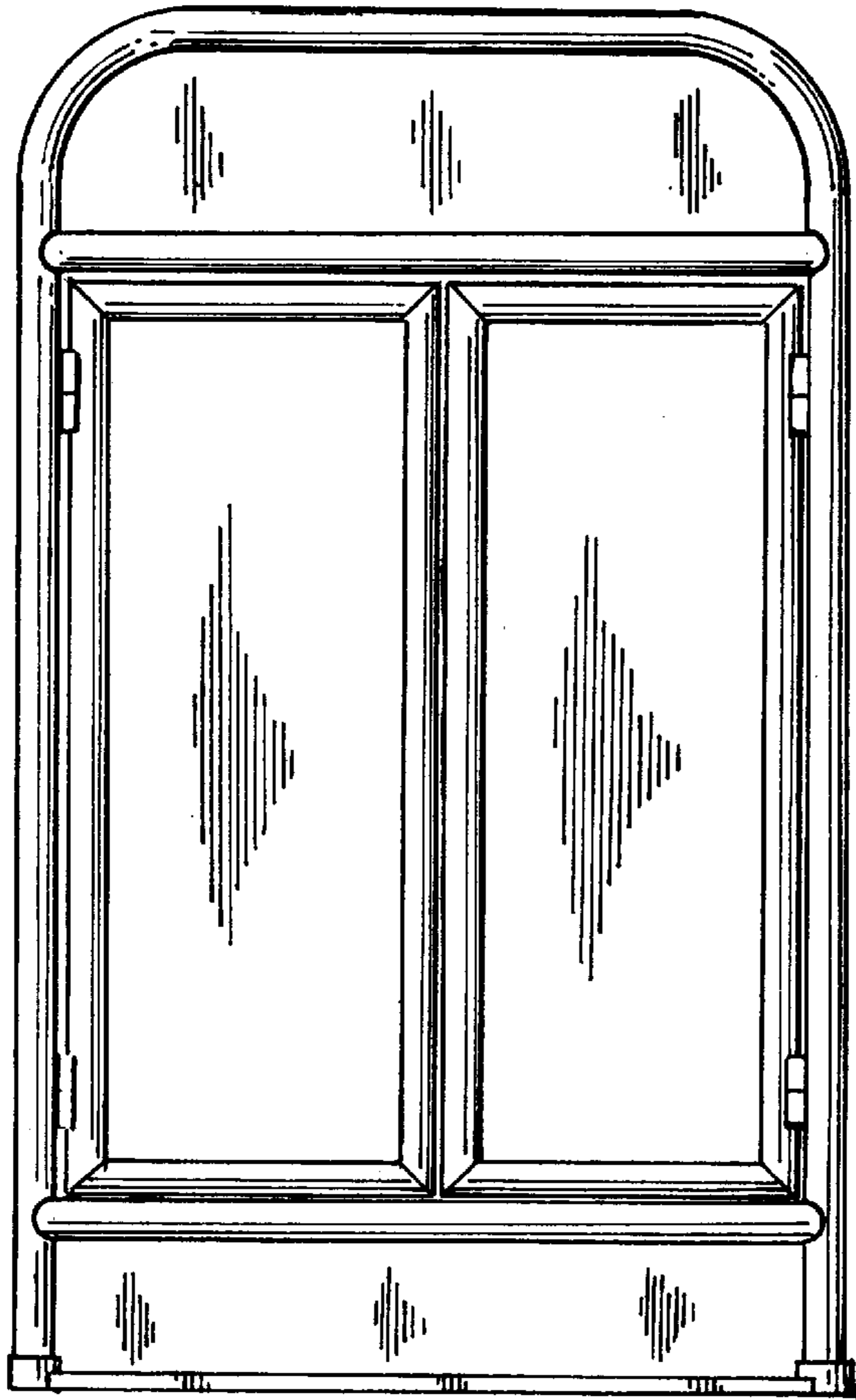

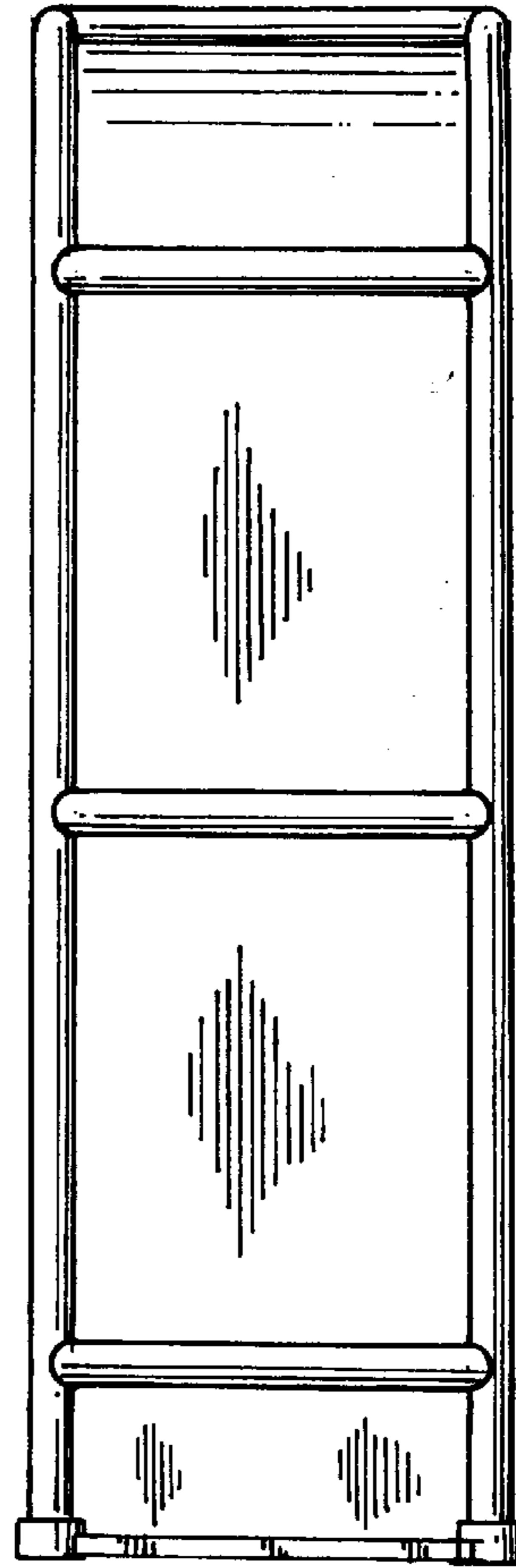

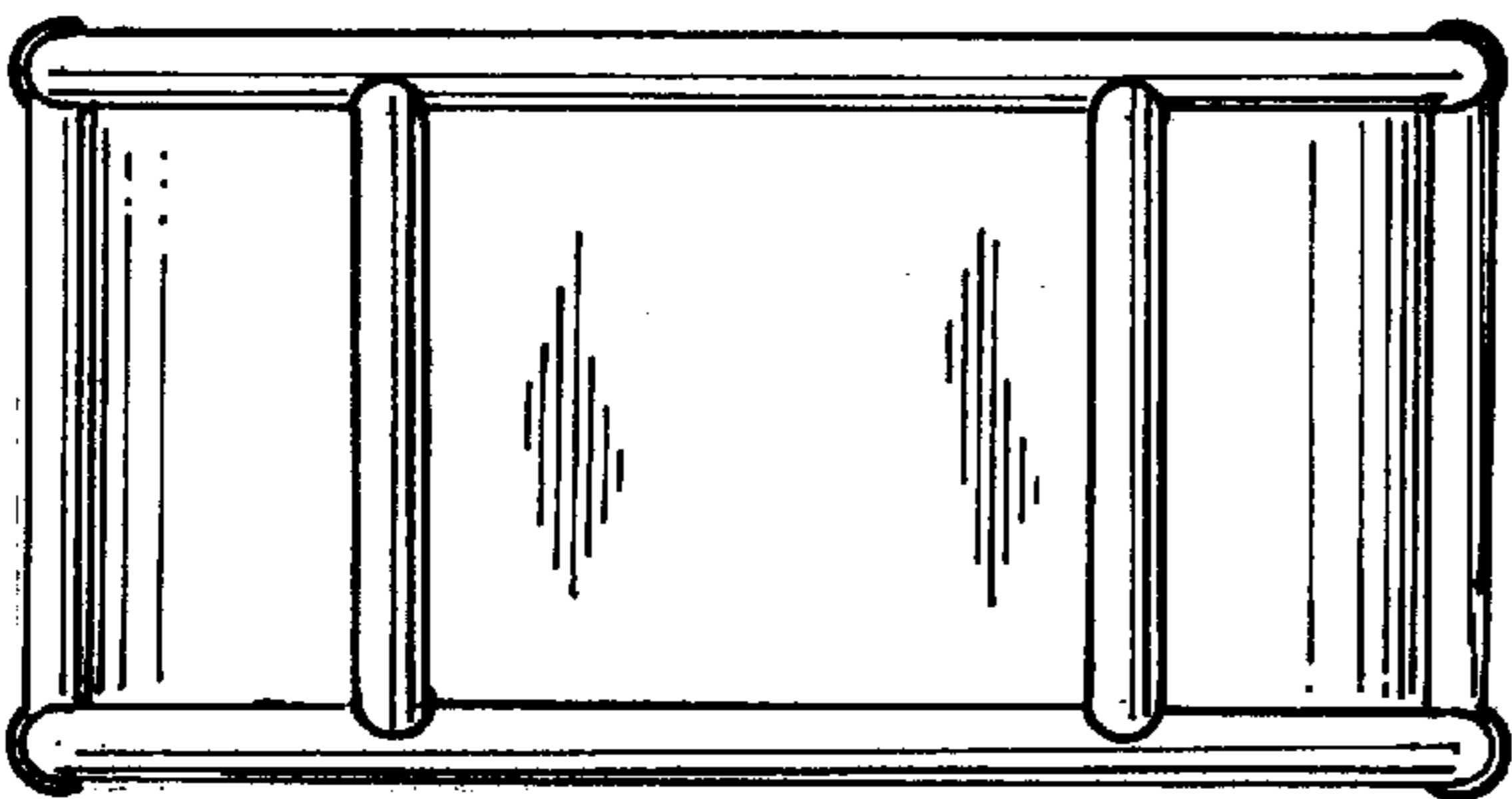

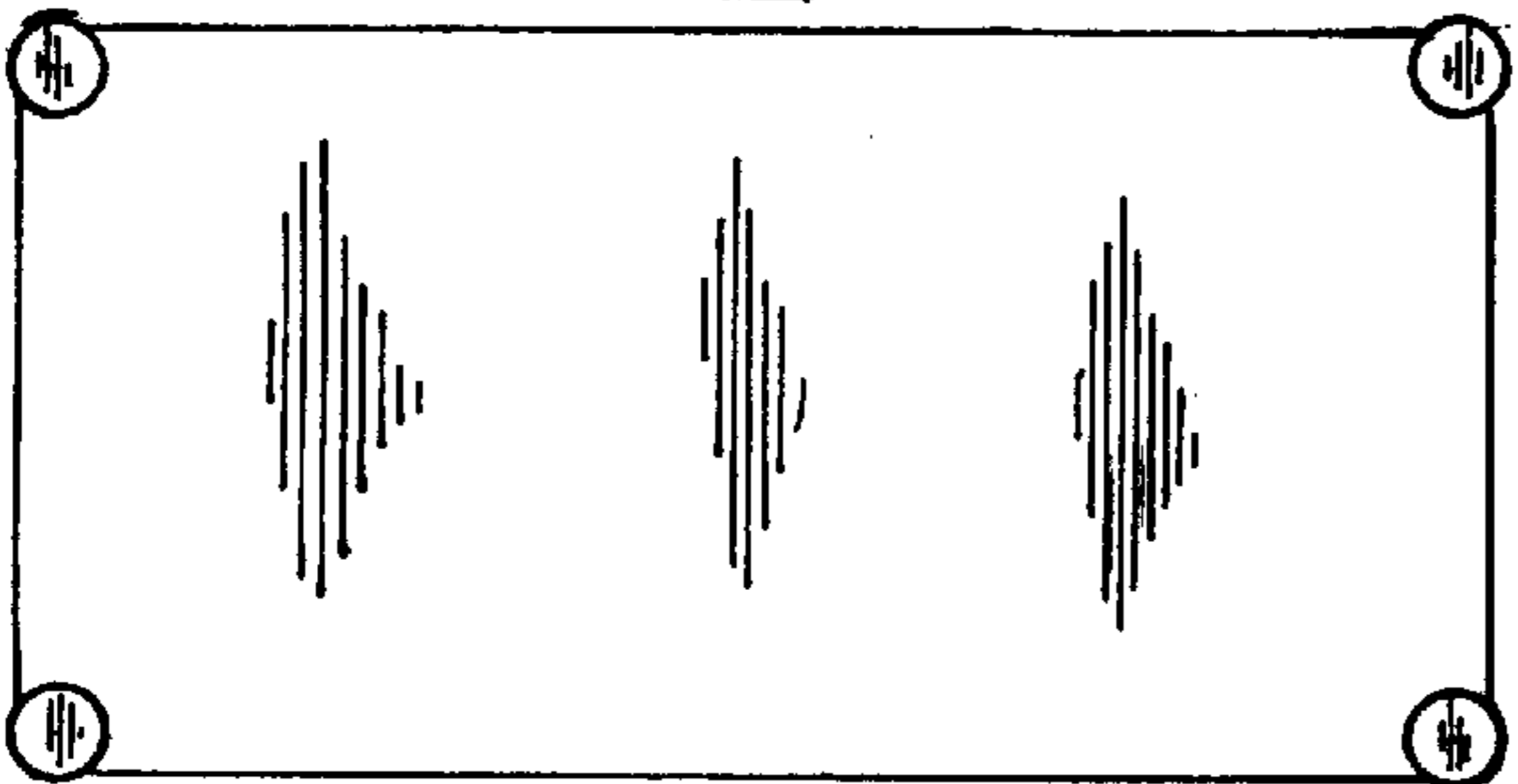
