FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a combined cabinet door, drawer, and frame panel showing my new design; FIG. 2 is an enlarged sectional view taken along line 2—2 of FIG. 1, the panel shown broken away for convenience of illustration and the broken lines indicate continuity of panel; FIG. 3 is an enlarged sectional view taken along line 3—3 of FIG. 1; FIG. 4 is an enlarged sectional view taken along line 4—4 of FIG. 1; FIG. 5 is an enlarged sectional view taken along line 5—5 of FIG. 1; and, FIG. 6 is an enlarged fragmentary sectional view of the top left corner.

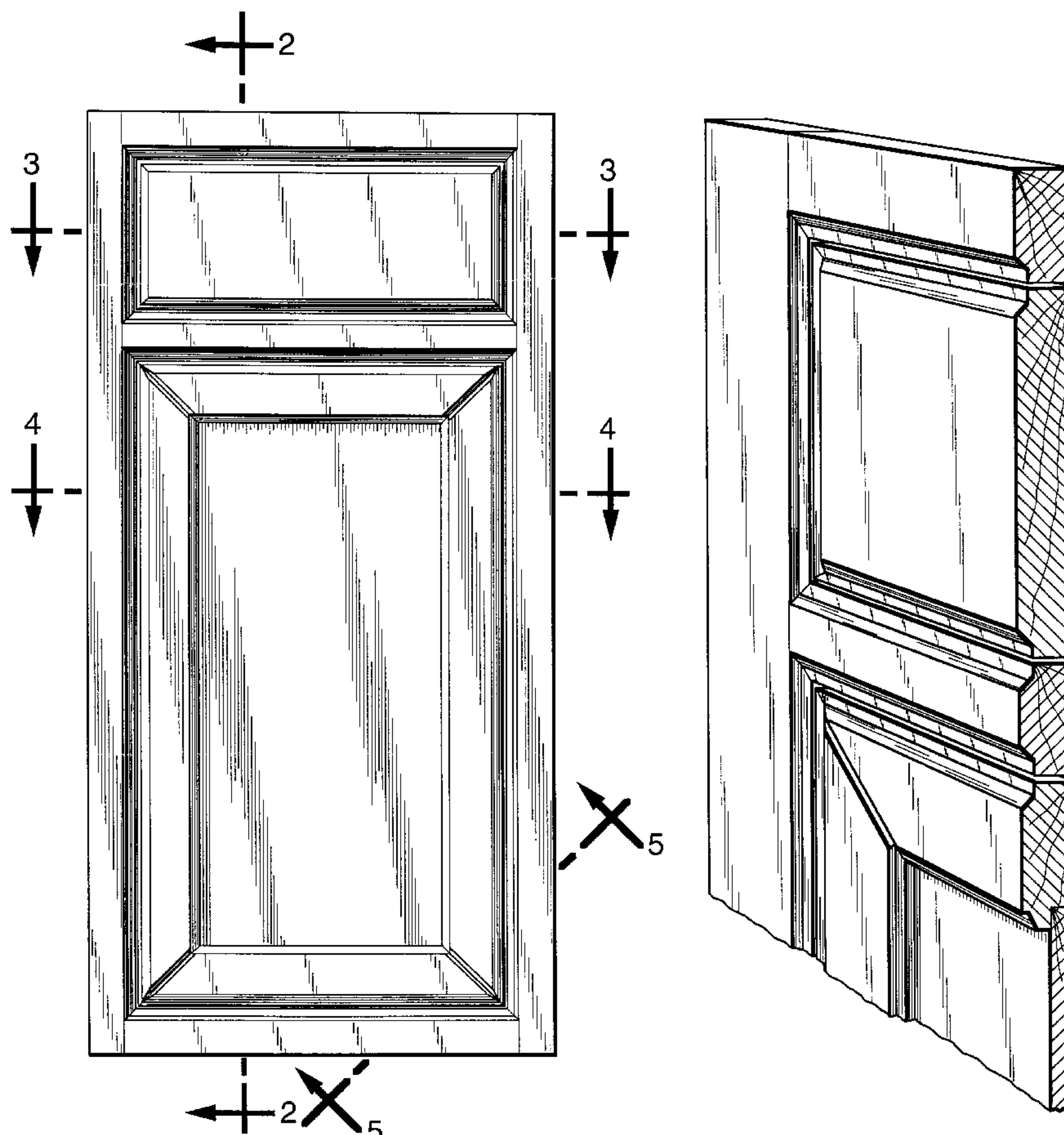

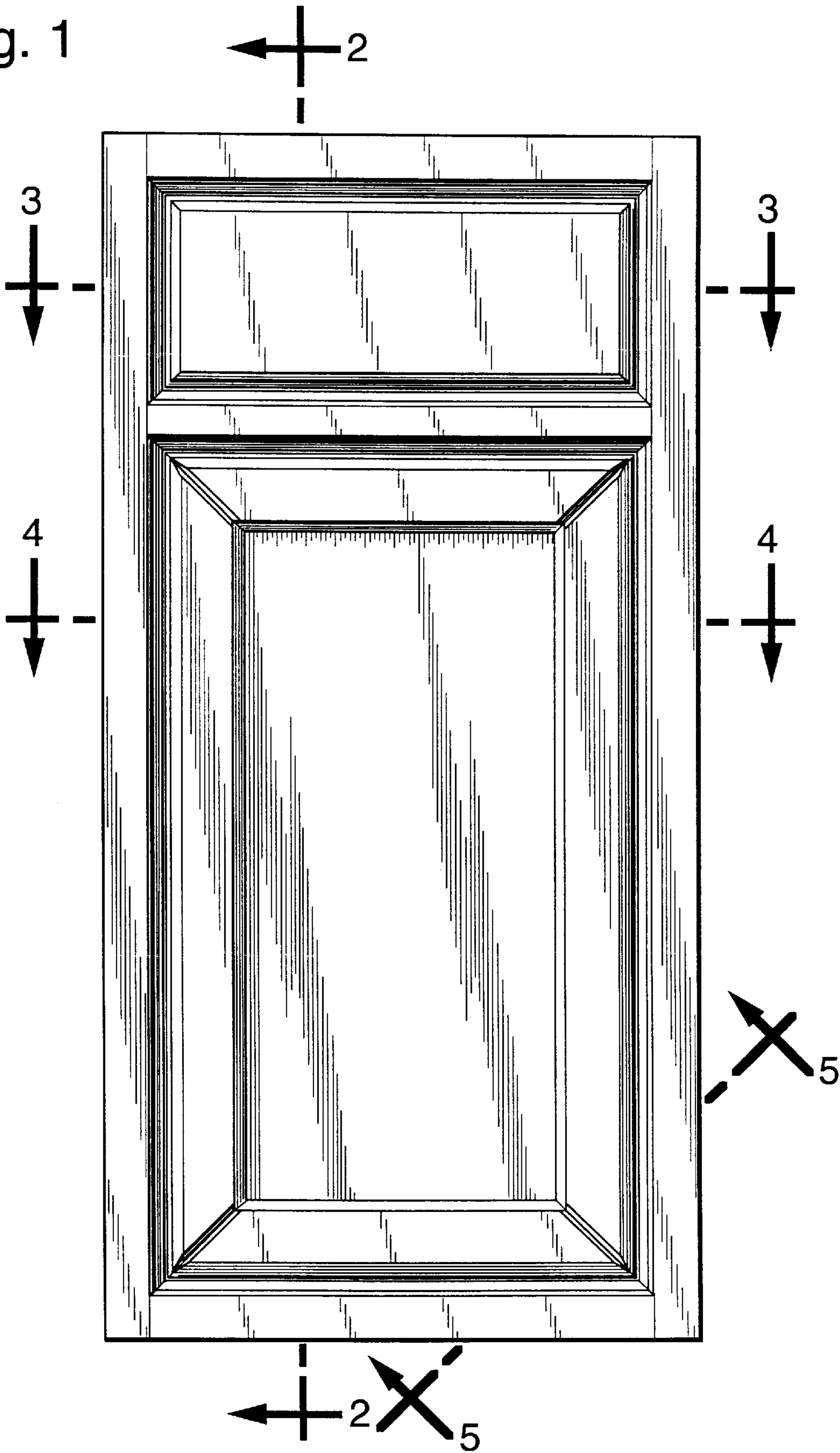

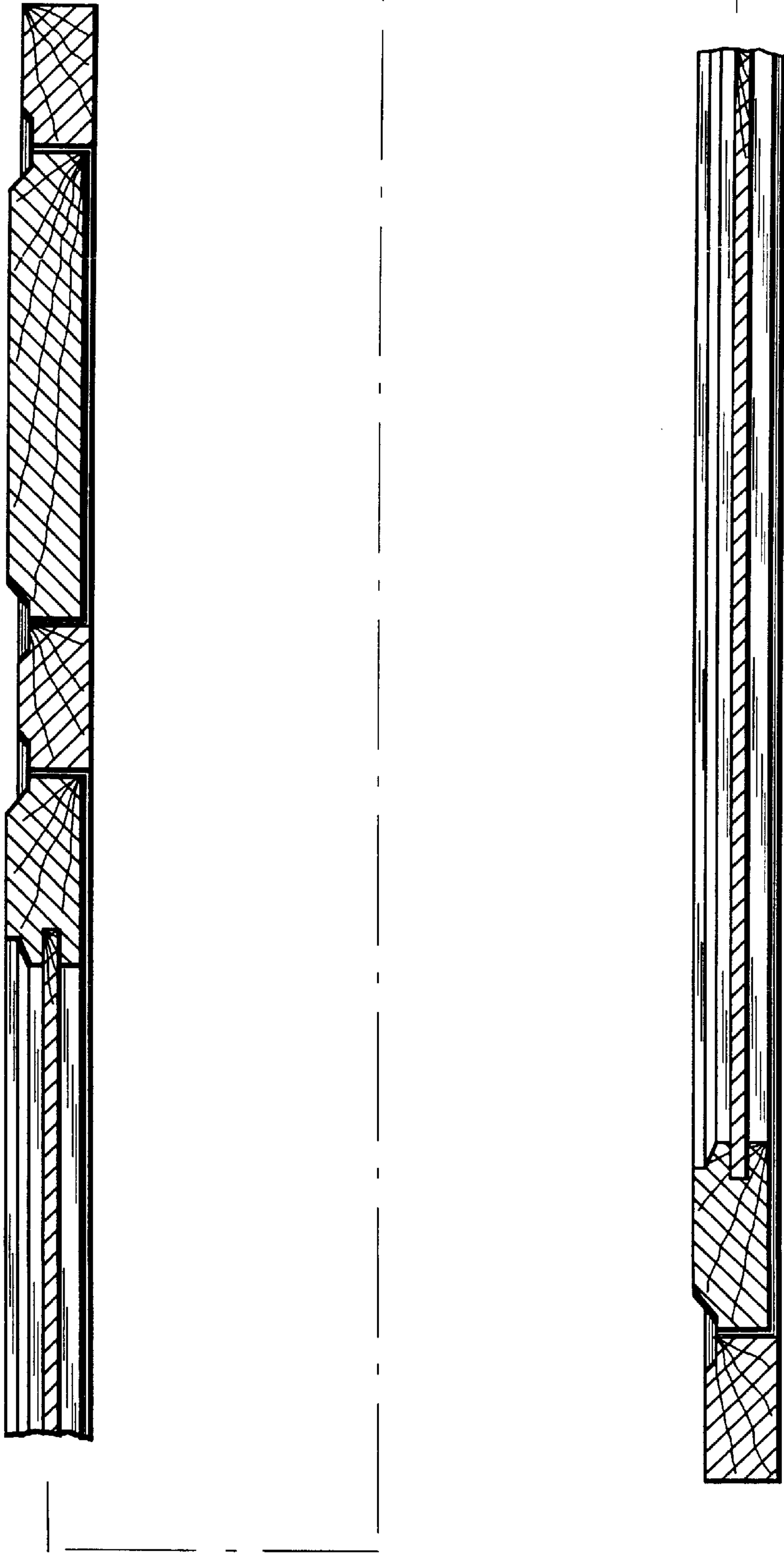

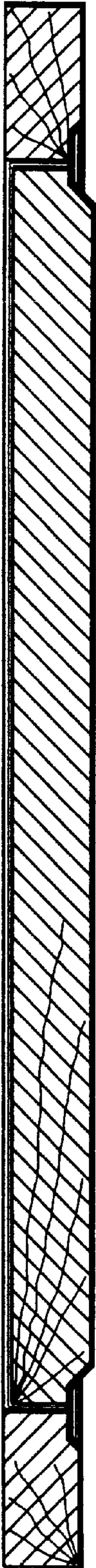

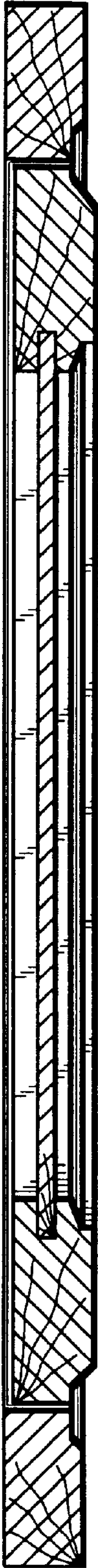
