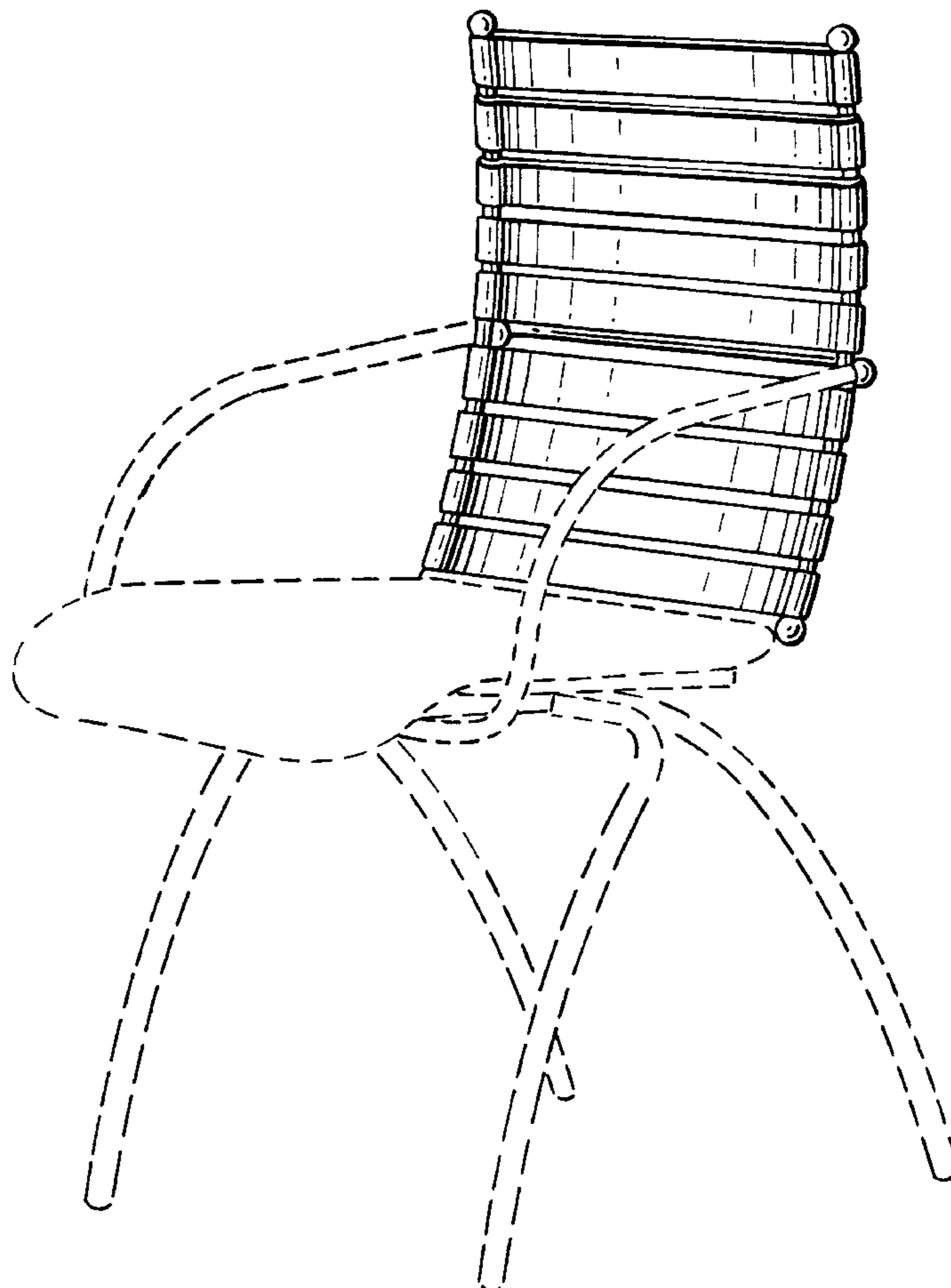
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;

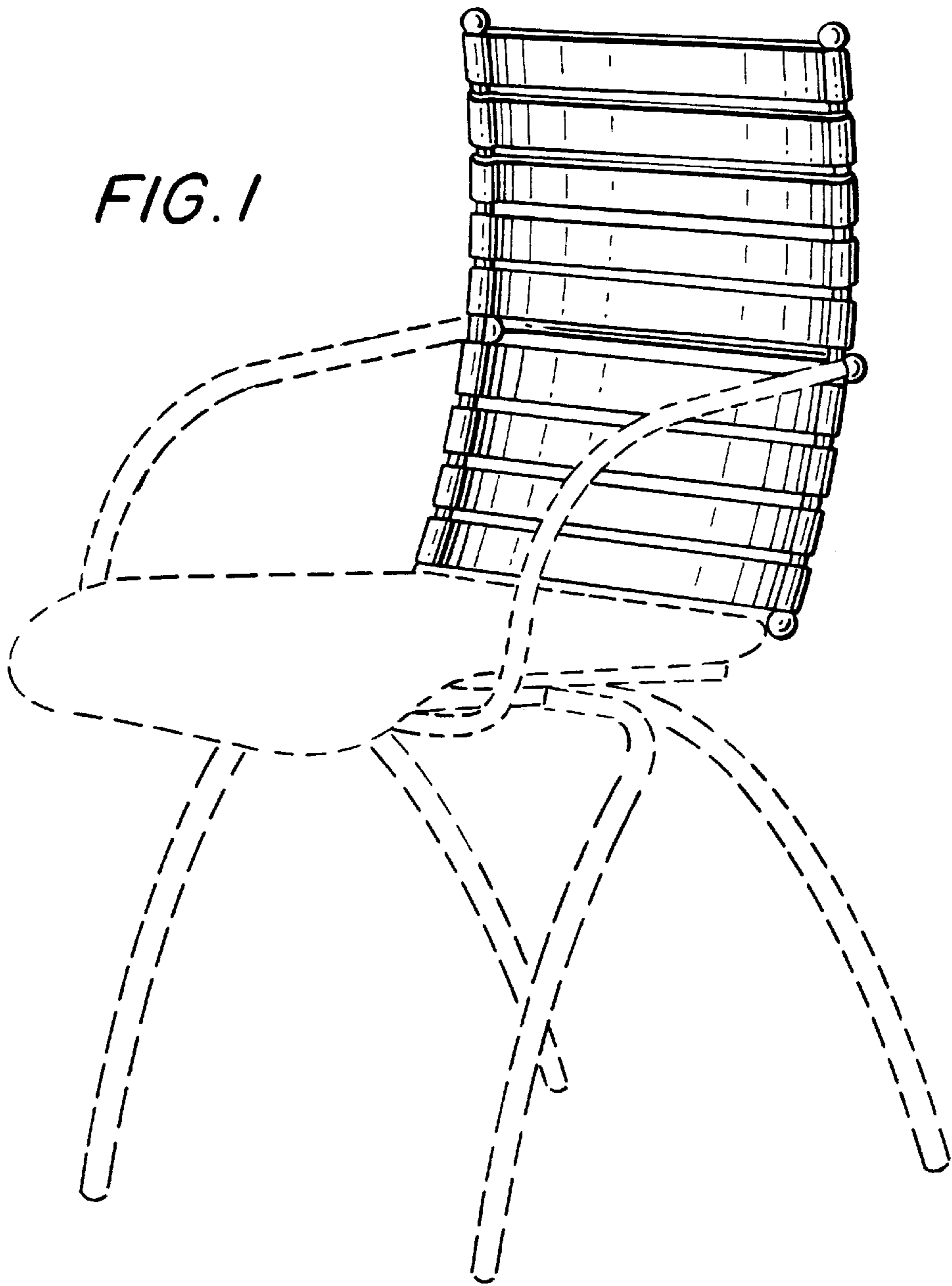
FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side

FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof.

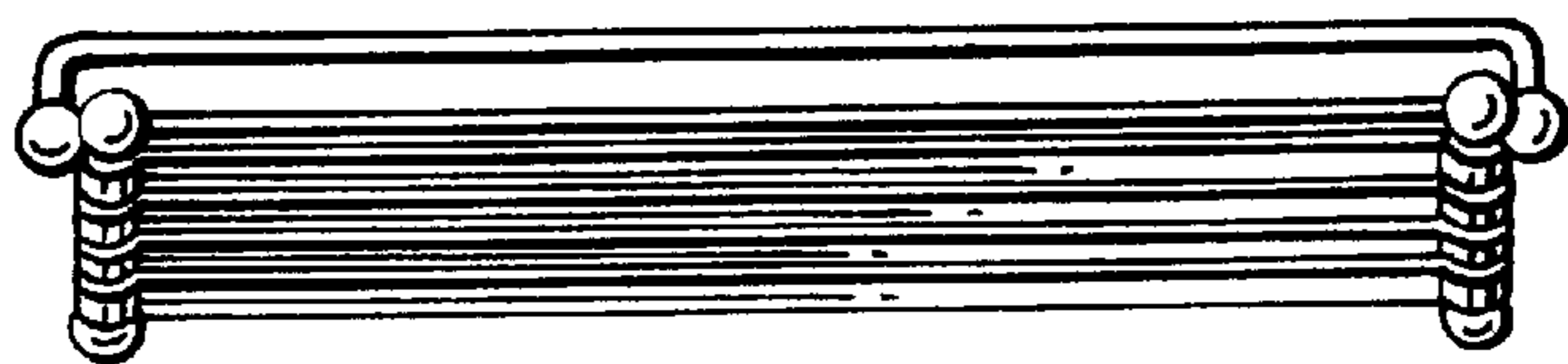

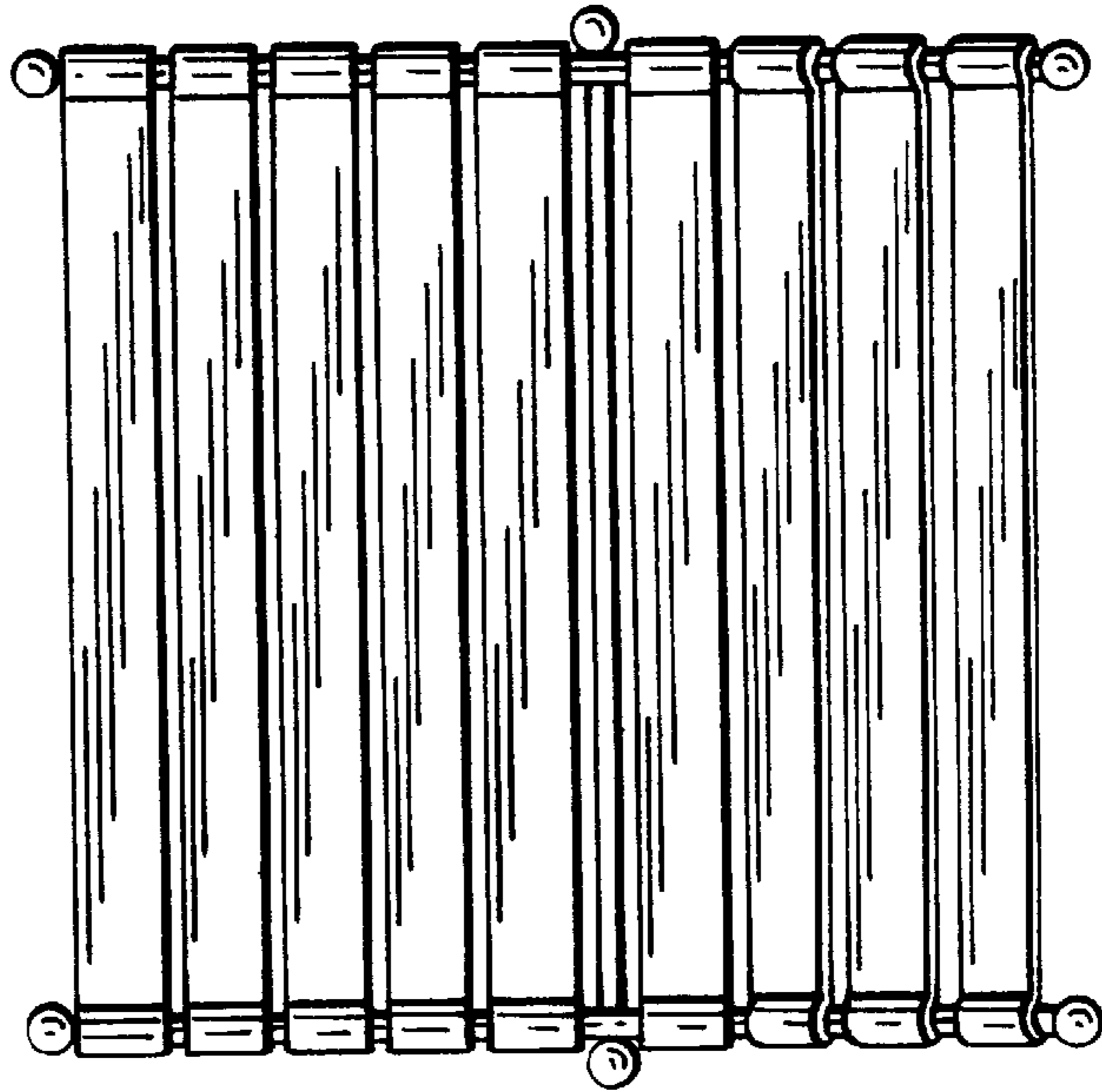
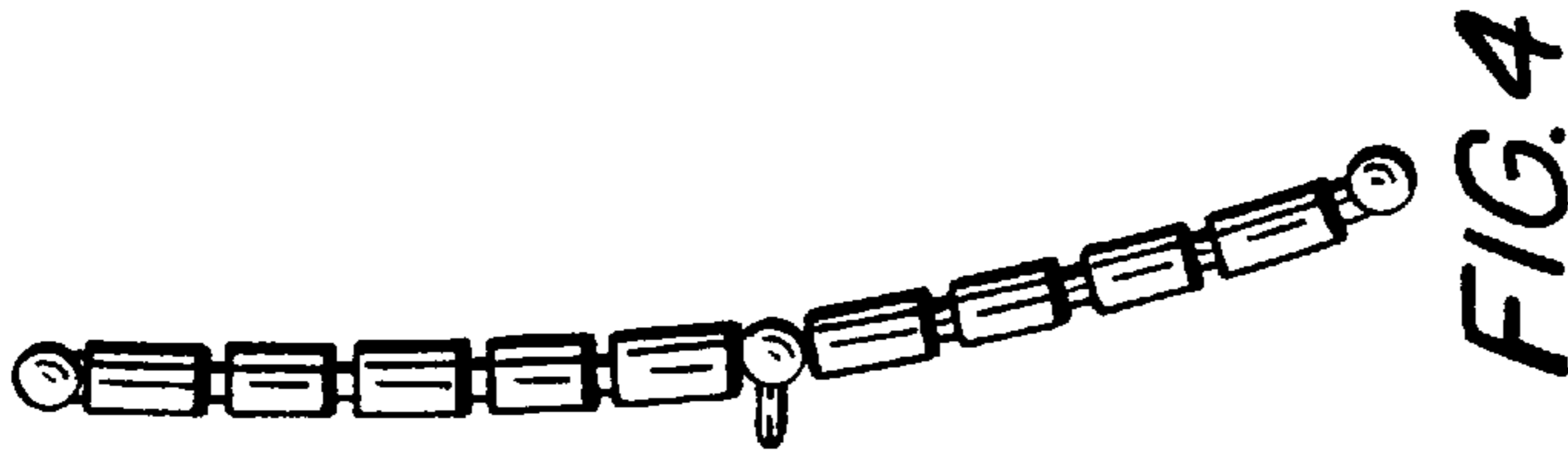
