DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front view of a computer/generated image;

FIG. 2 is a front view of a second embodiment thereof, the computer generated image is shown separately for clarity of illustration; and,

FIG. 3 is a front perspective view of a third embodiment thereof.

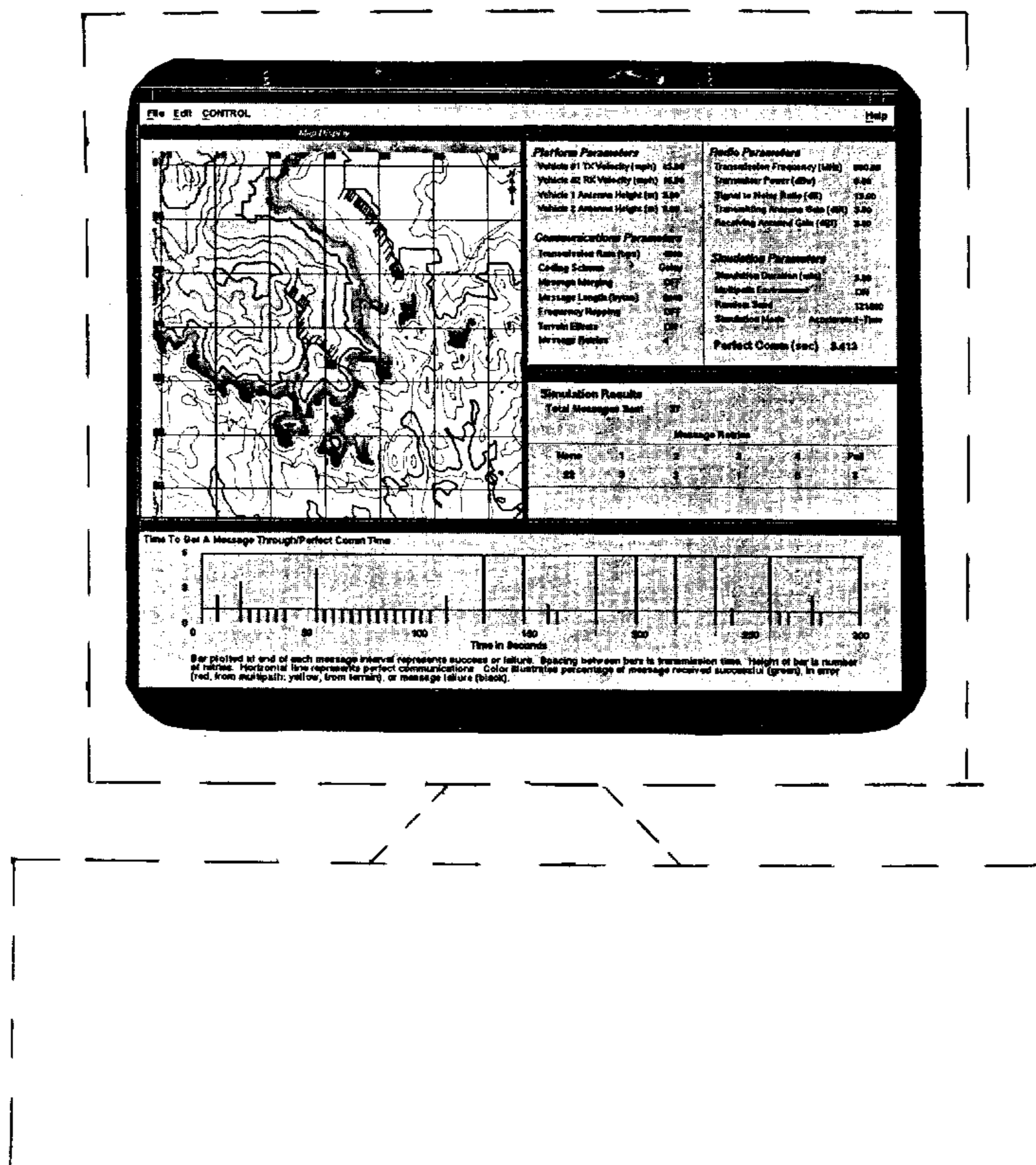

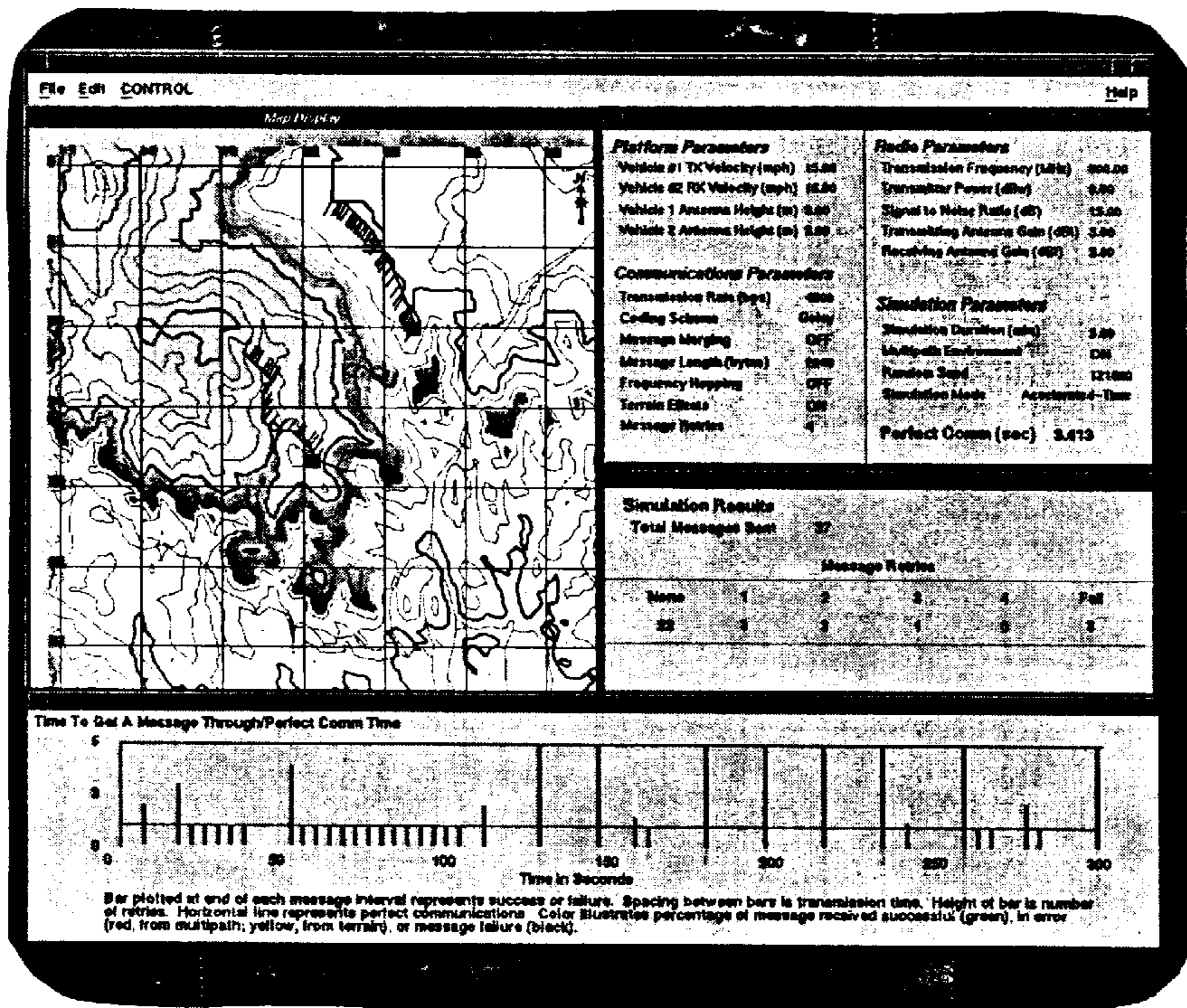

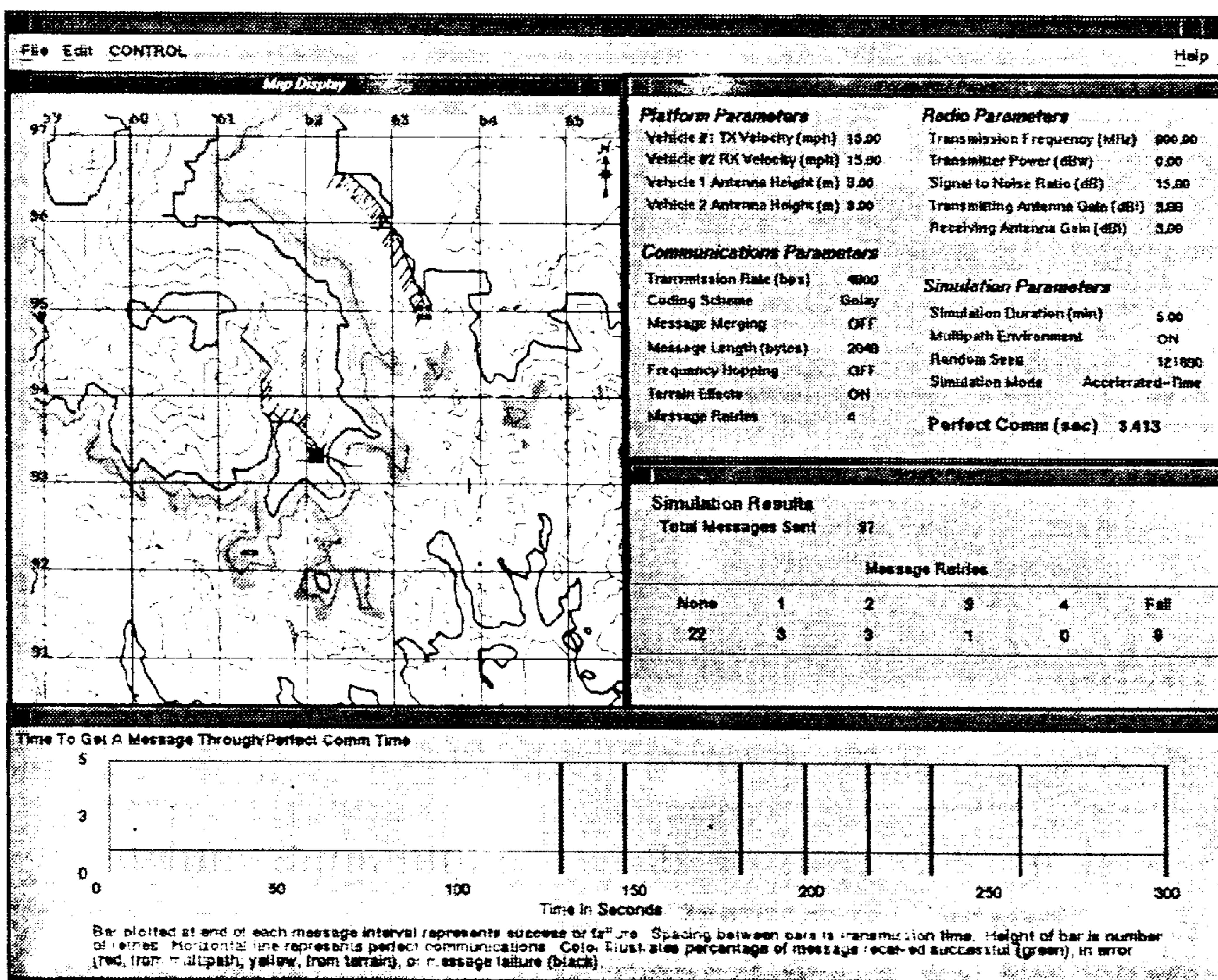

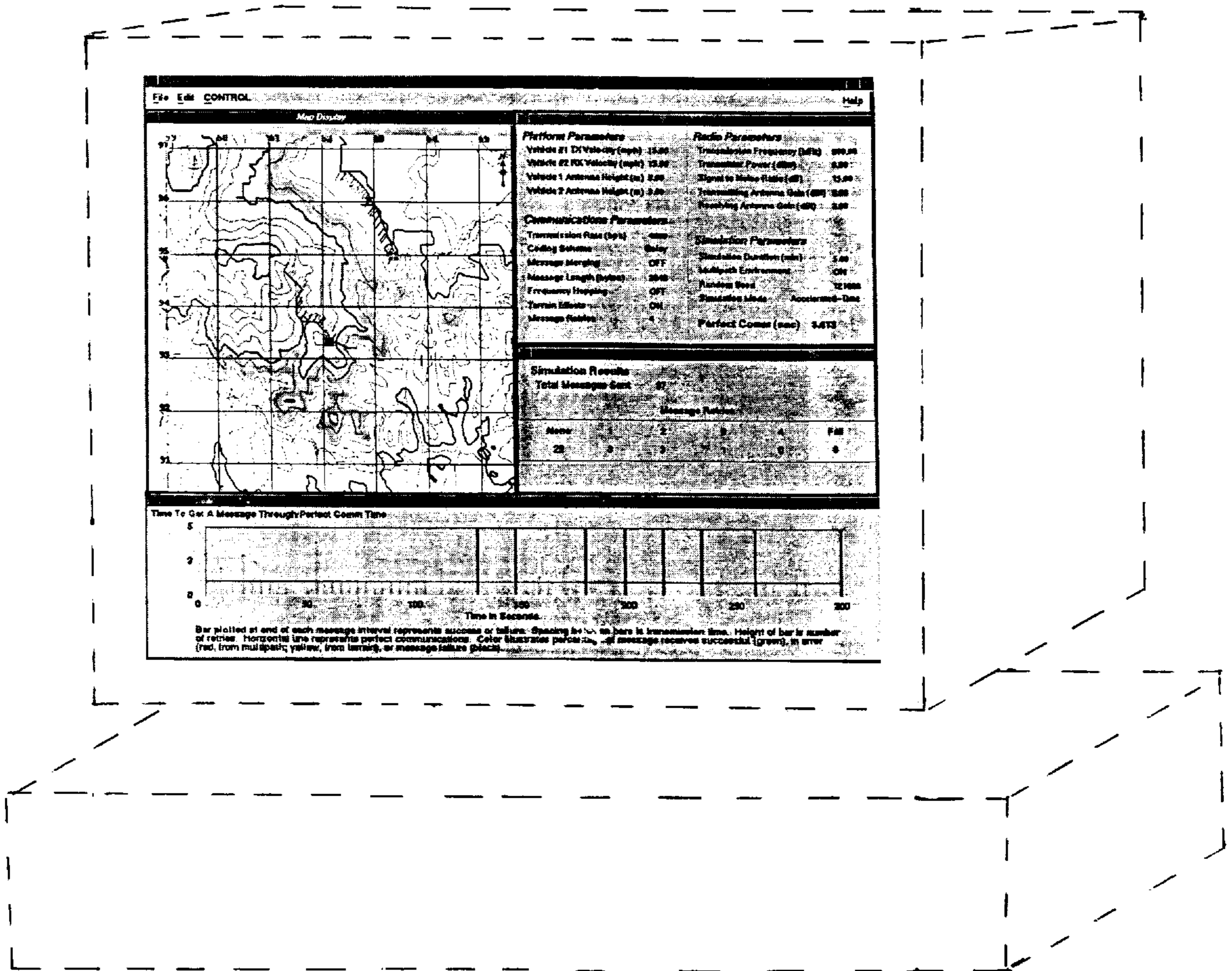
