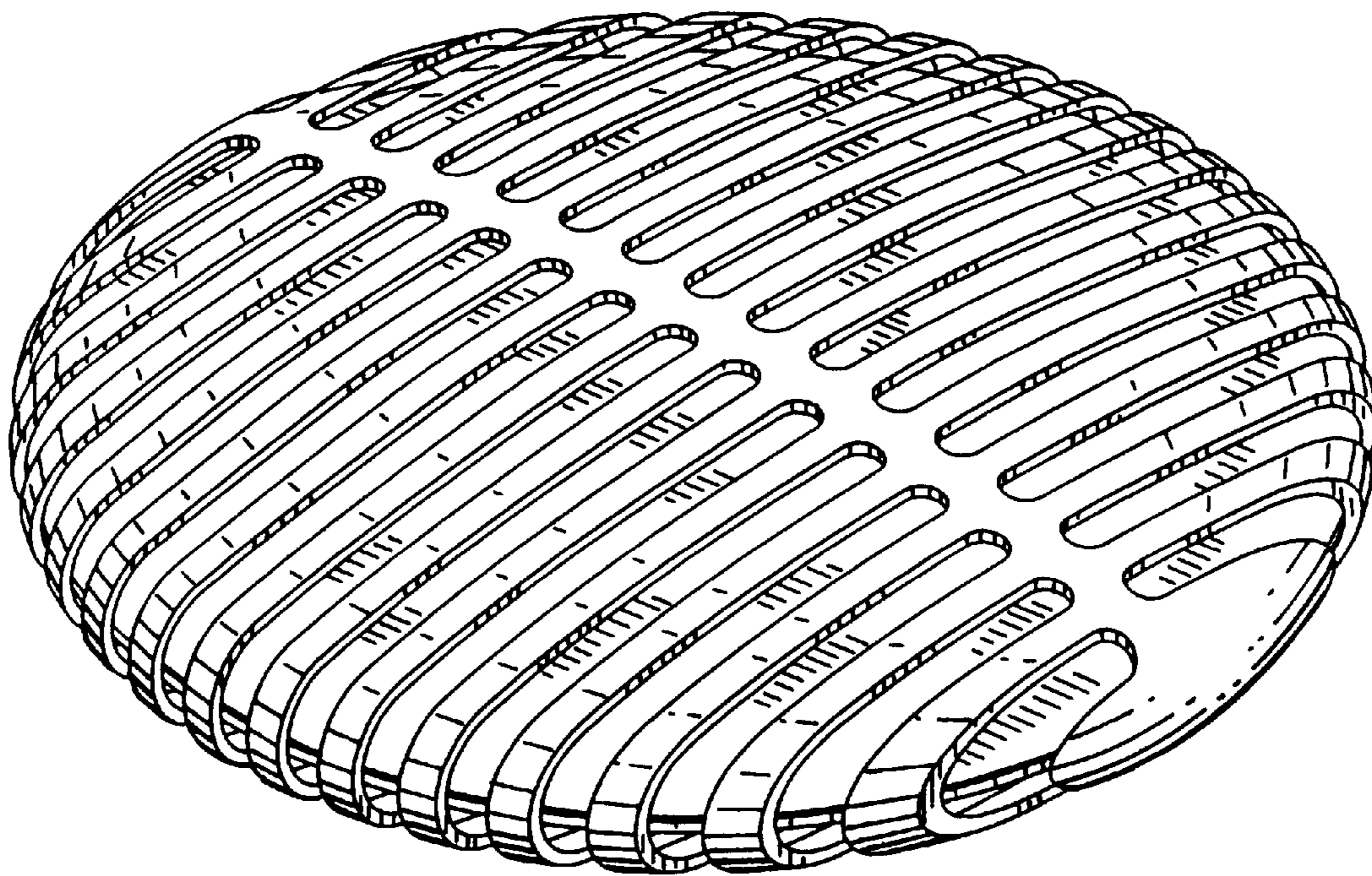
FIG. 4 is a front elevational viewing thereof, the rear elevational view being a mirror-image thereof.

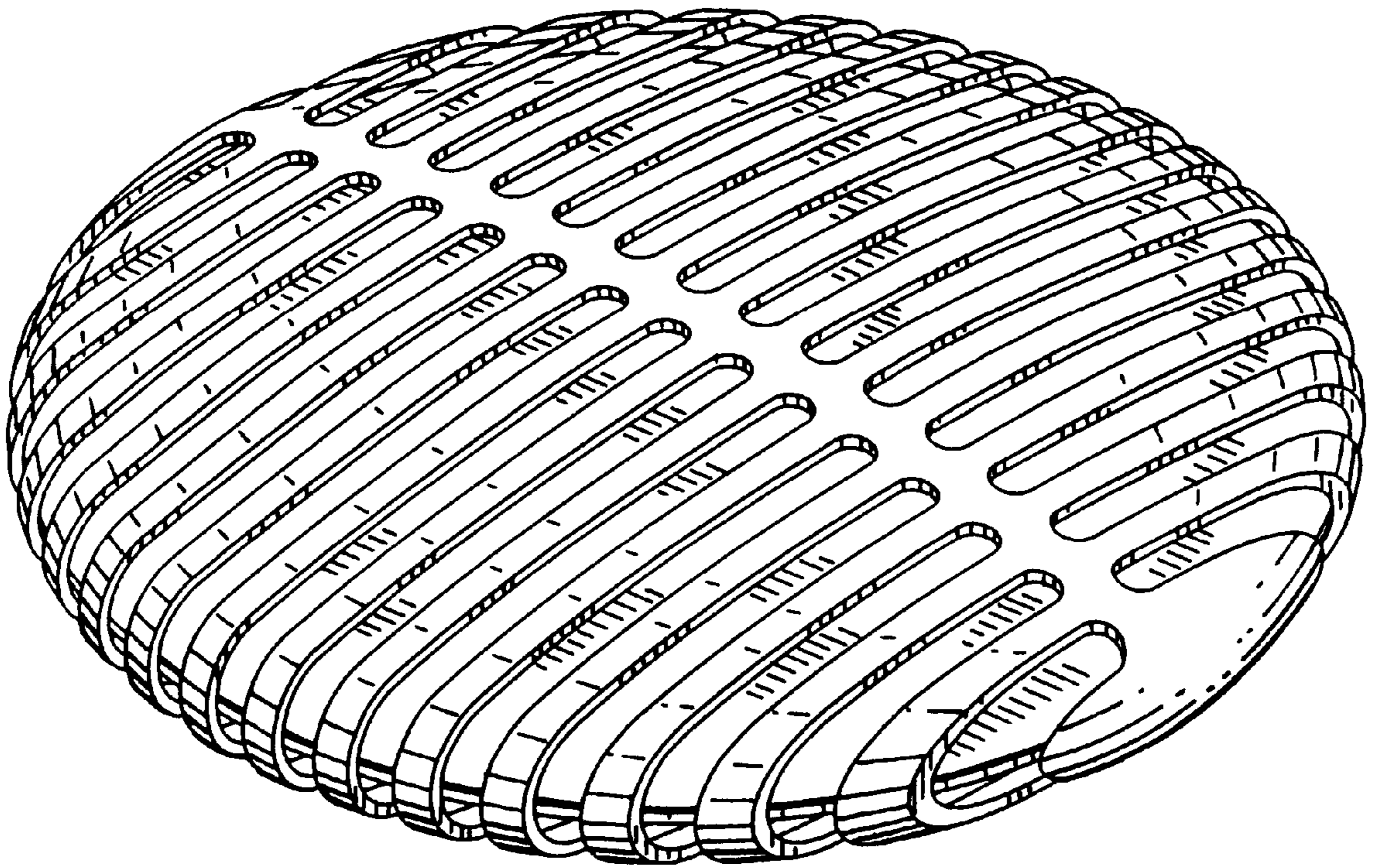

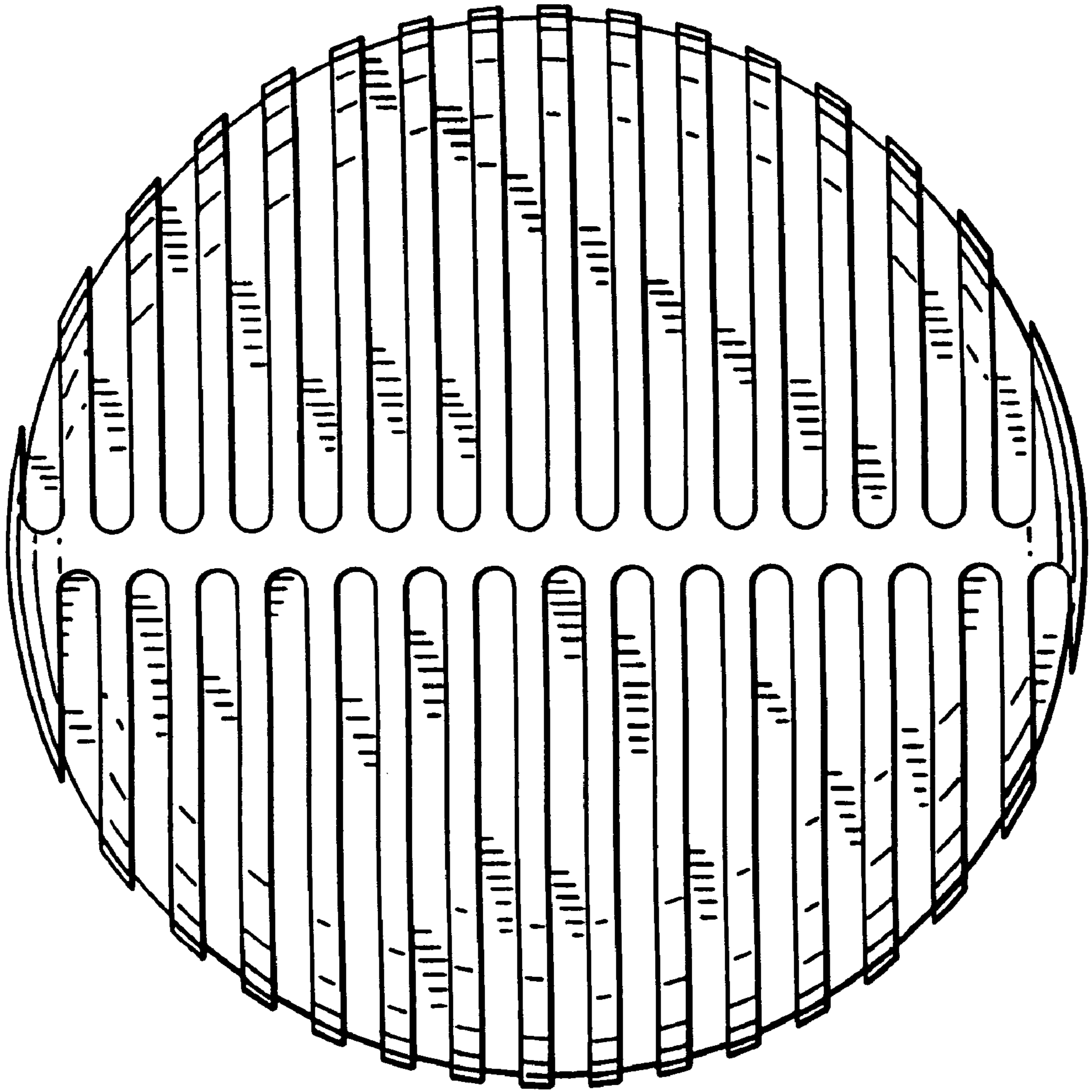

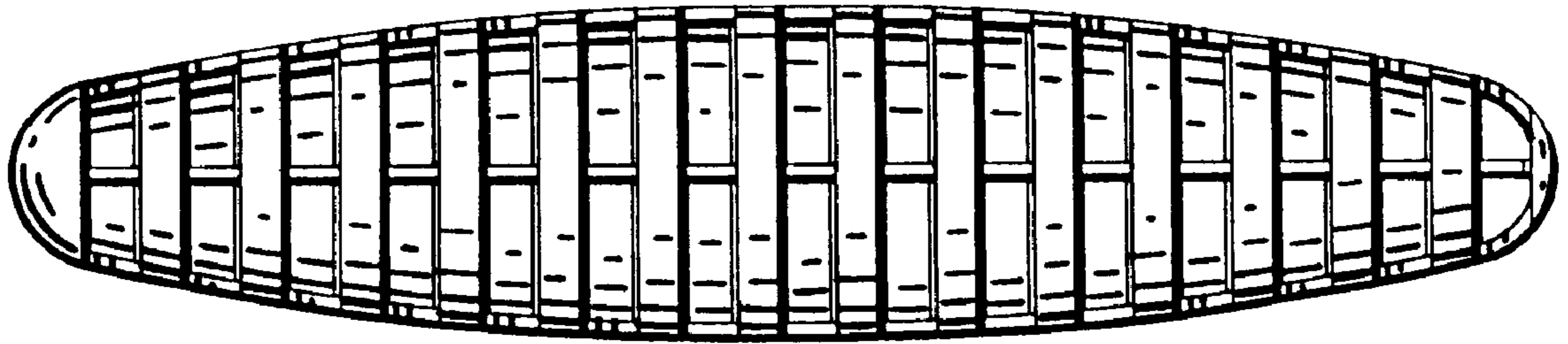

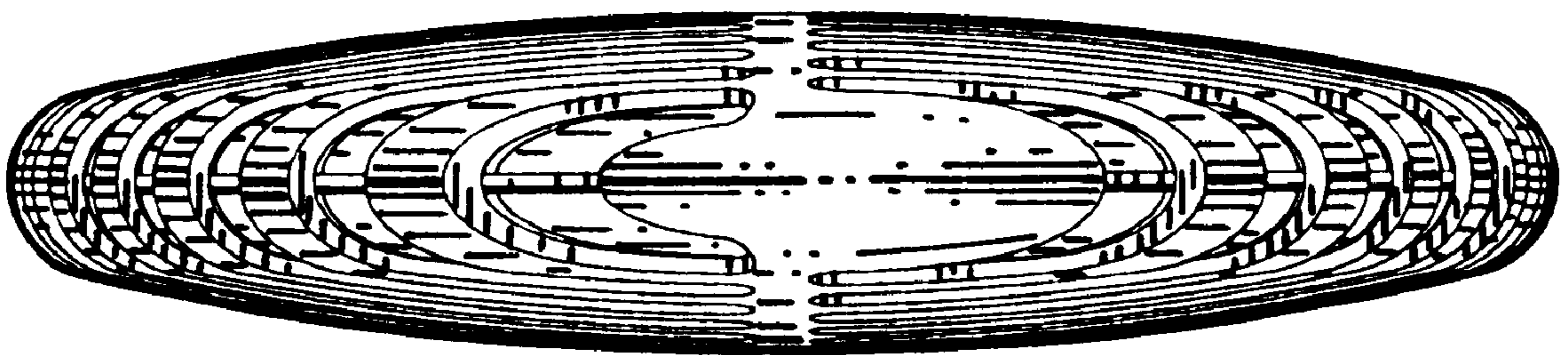
