FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a chair showing our new design in the form of a sofa;




FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;


FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view, the left side being a mirror image thereof; and,


FIG. 5 is a rear perspective view thereof.

The broken lines shown herein are for illustrative puproses only and form no part of the claimed design.





