The ornamental design for a chair, as shown and described.

## **DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a chair showing our new design in the form of a sofa;

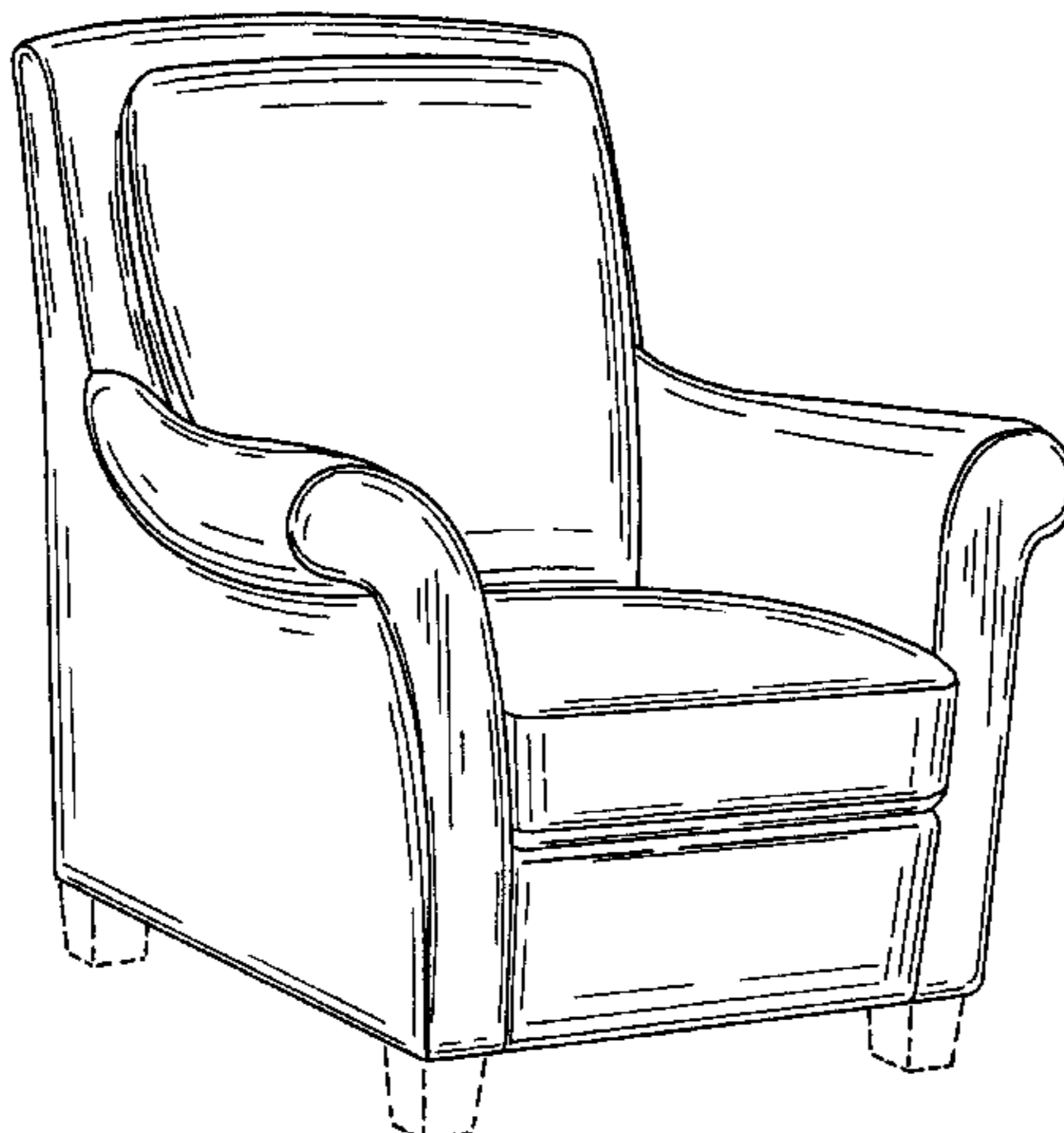


FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view, the left side being a mirror image thereof; and,  
FIG. 5 is a rear perspective view thereof.

Figures 2 and 3 have been shown on a smaller scale with respect to Figure 1, Figure 4 has been shown larger than Figure 1 and Figure 5 has been shown on a smaller scale with respect to Figure 1 through 4.

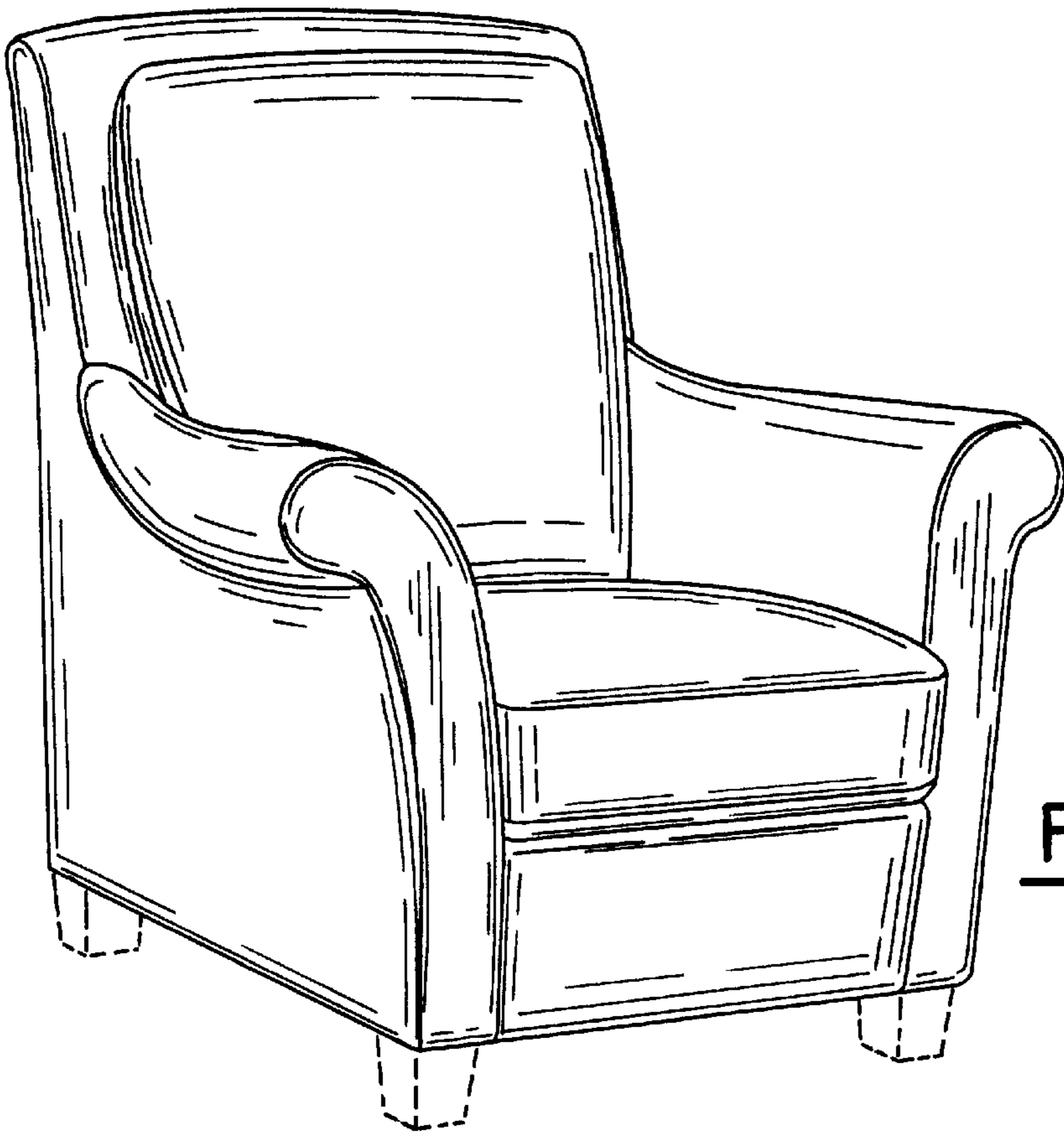

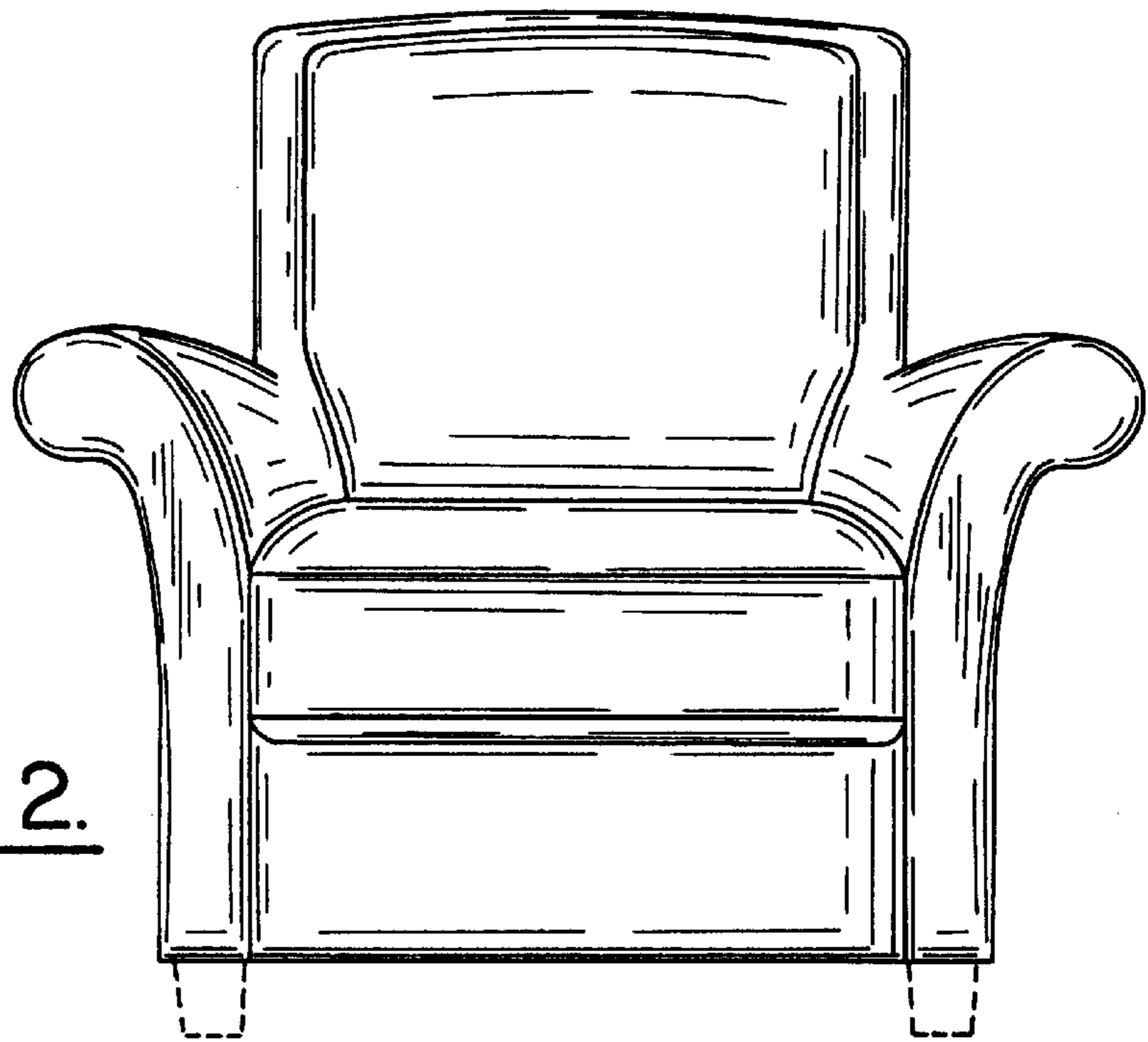

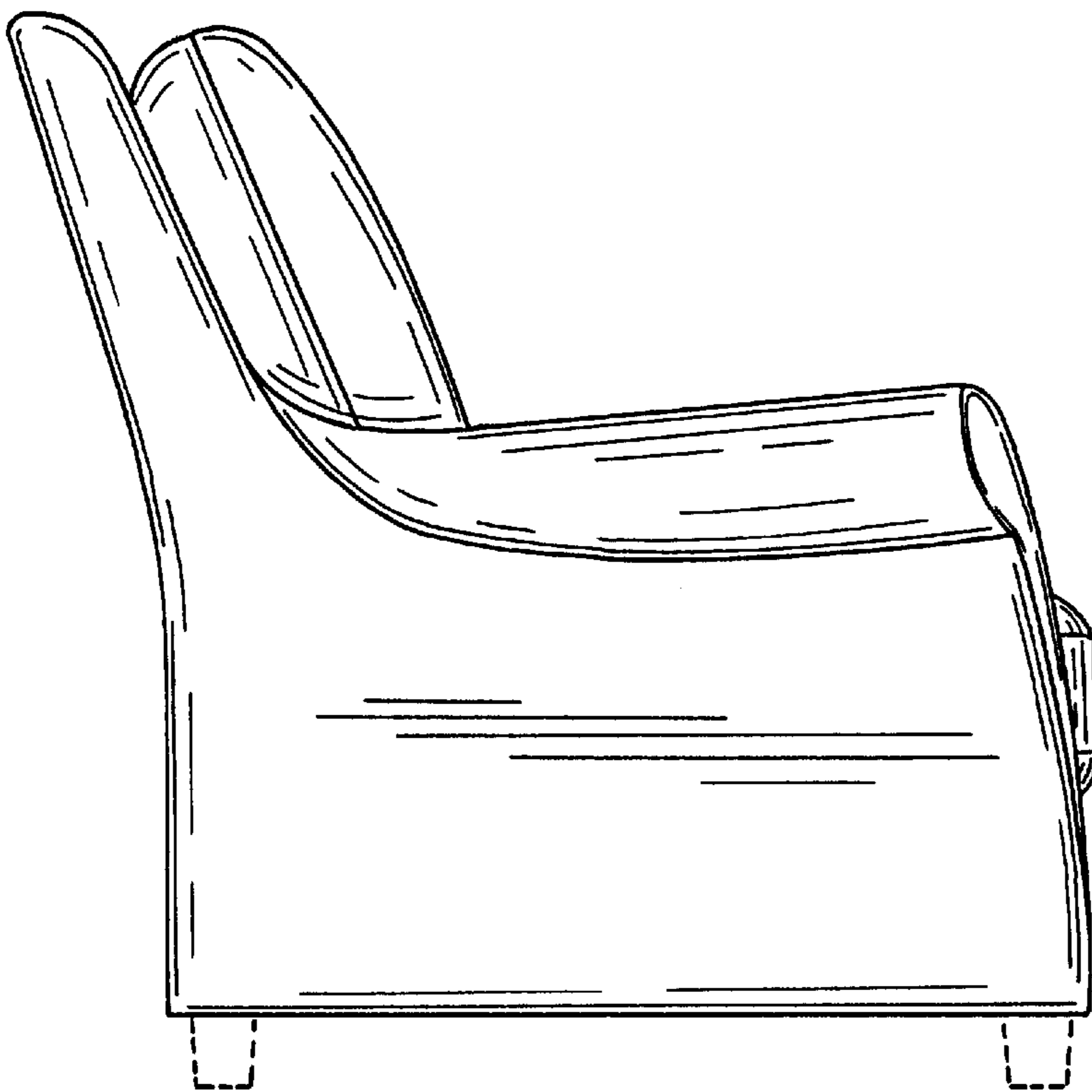
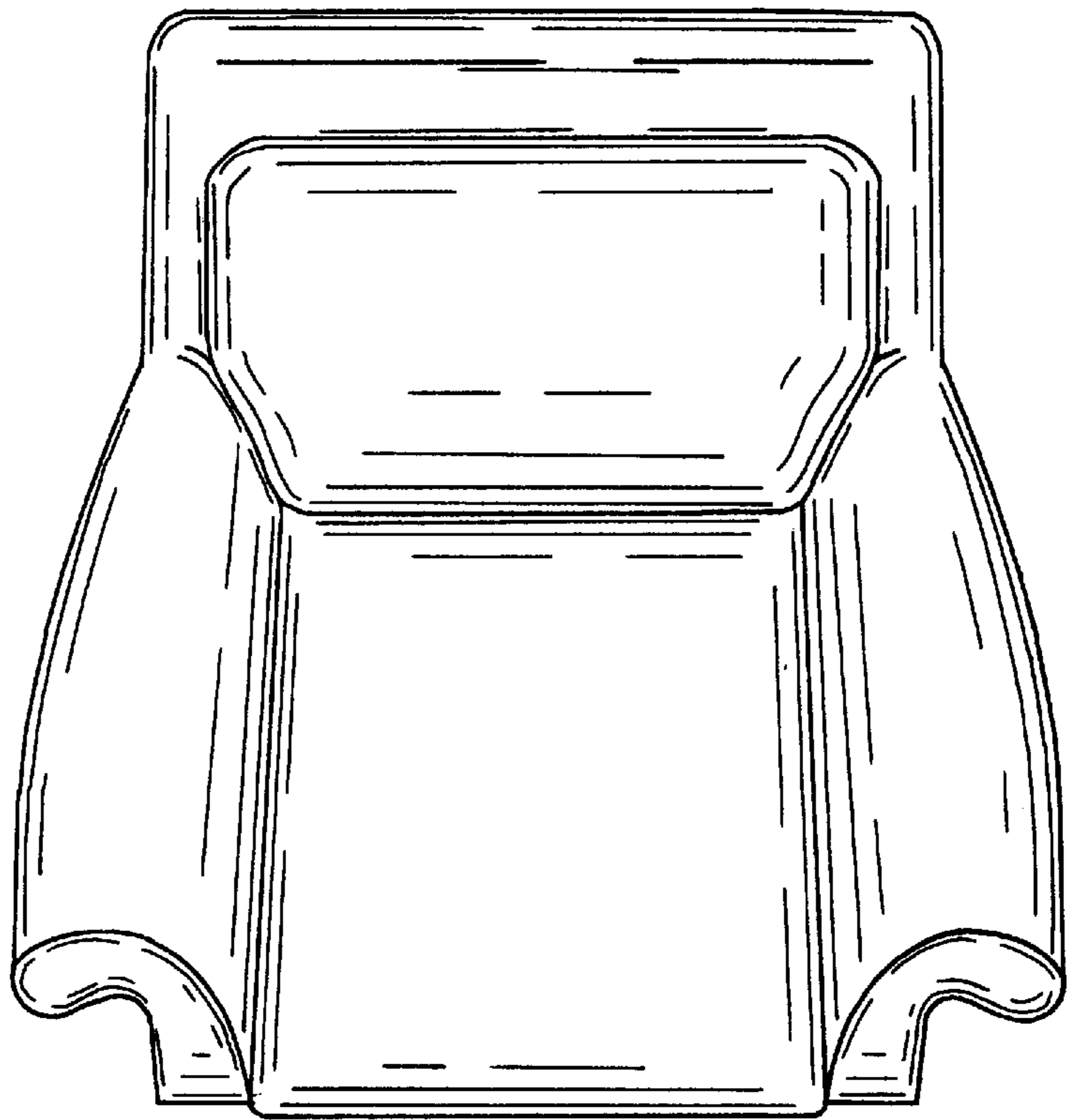
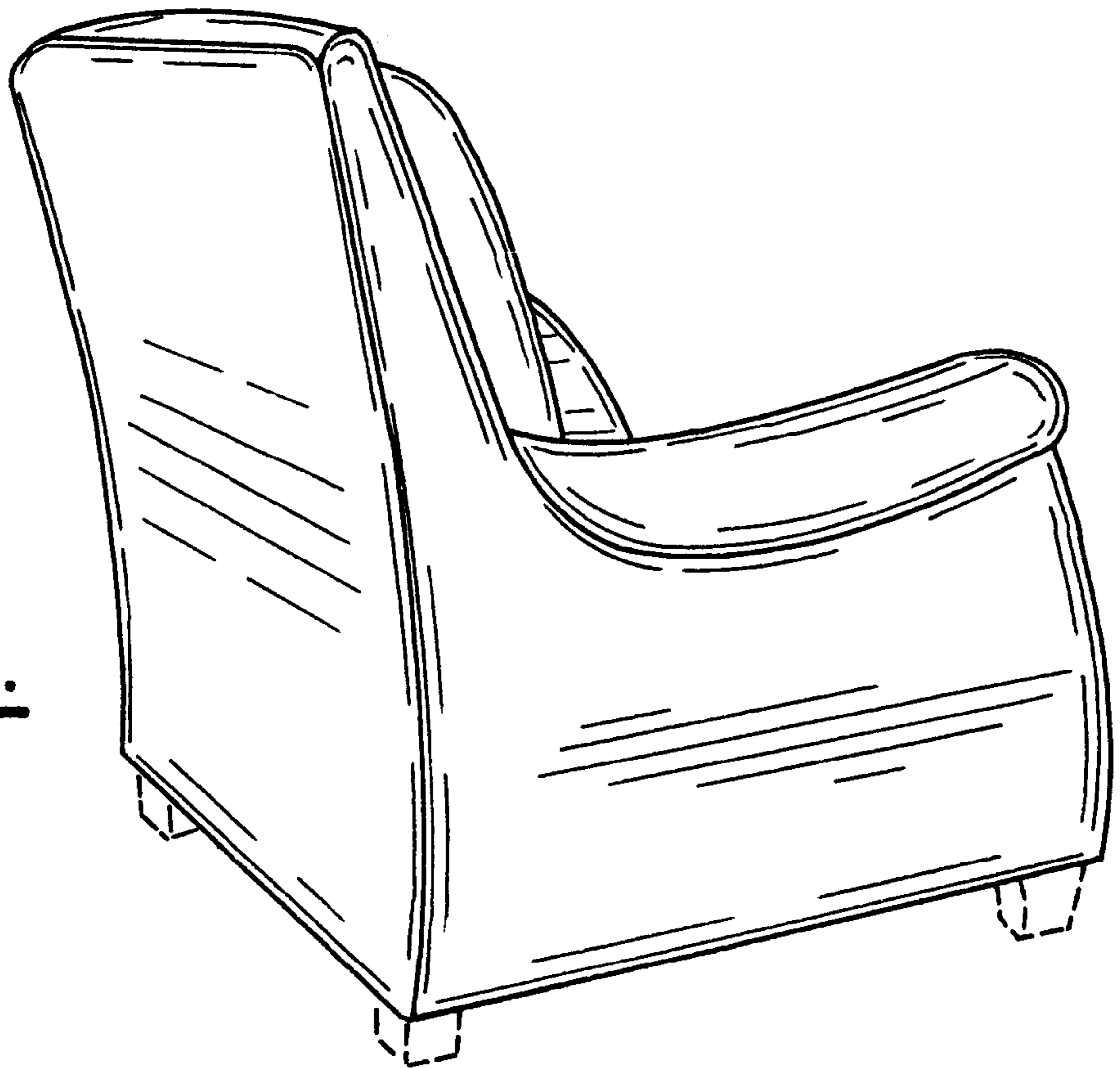
