The ornamental design for a bottle, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view our new design for a bottle as seen from the top, front and right sides;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof; and,
FIG. 8 is a perspective view of a second embodiment of the bottle, the second embodiment differs from the first embodiment only in that it is transparent.

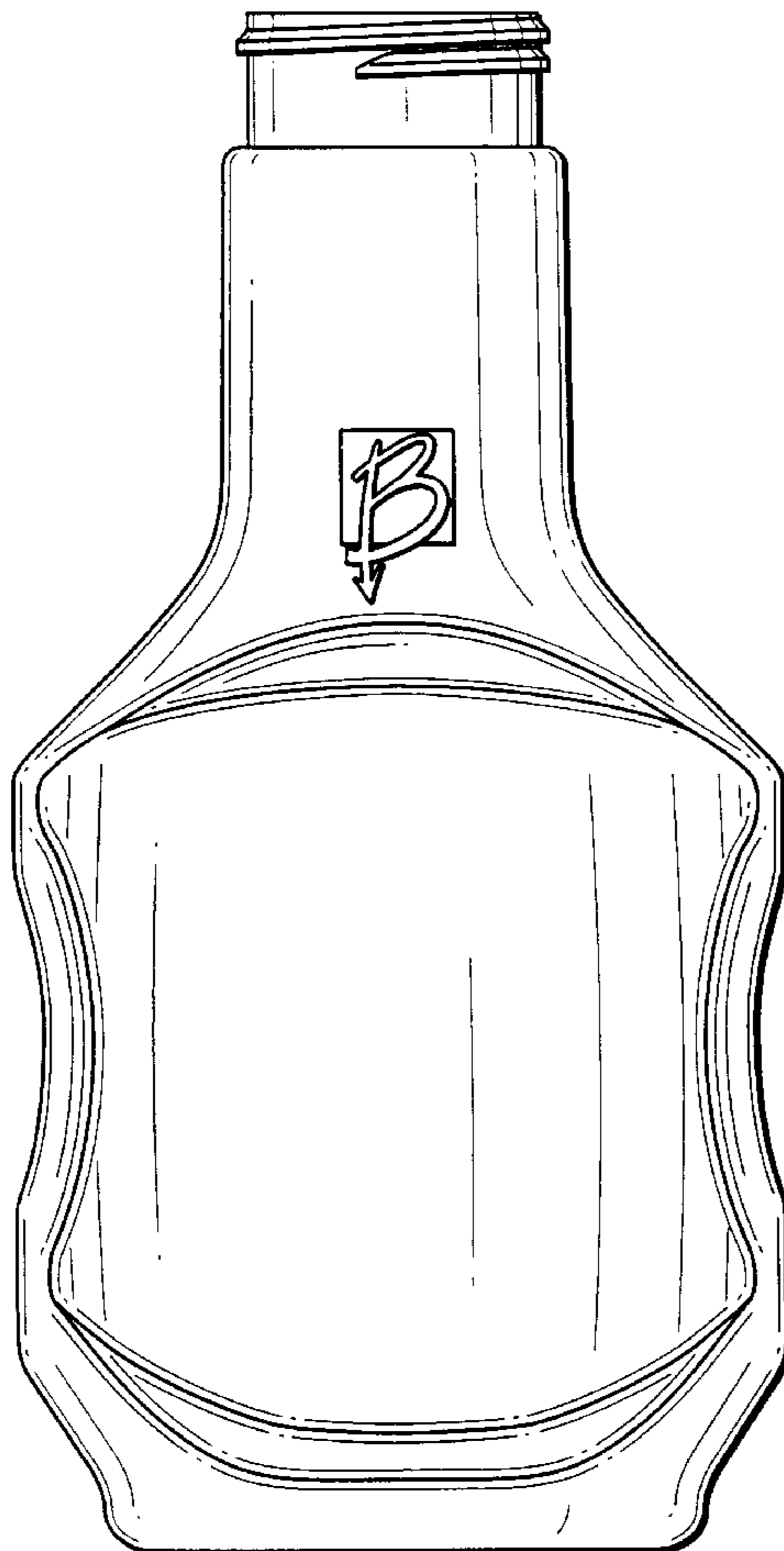

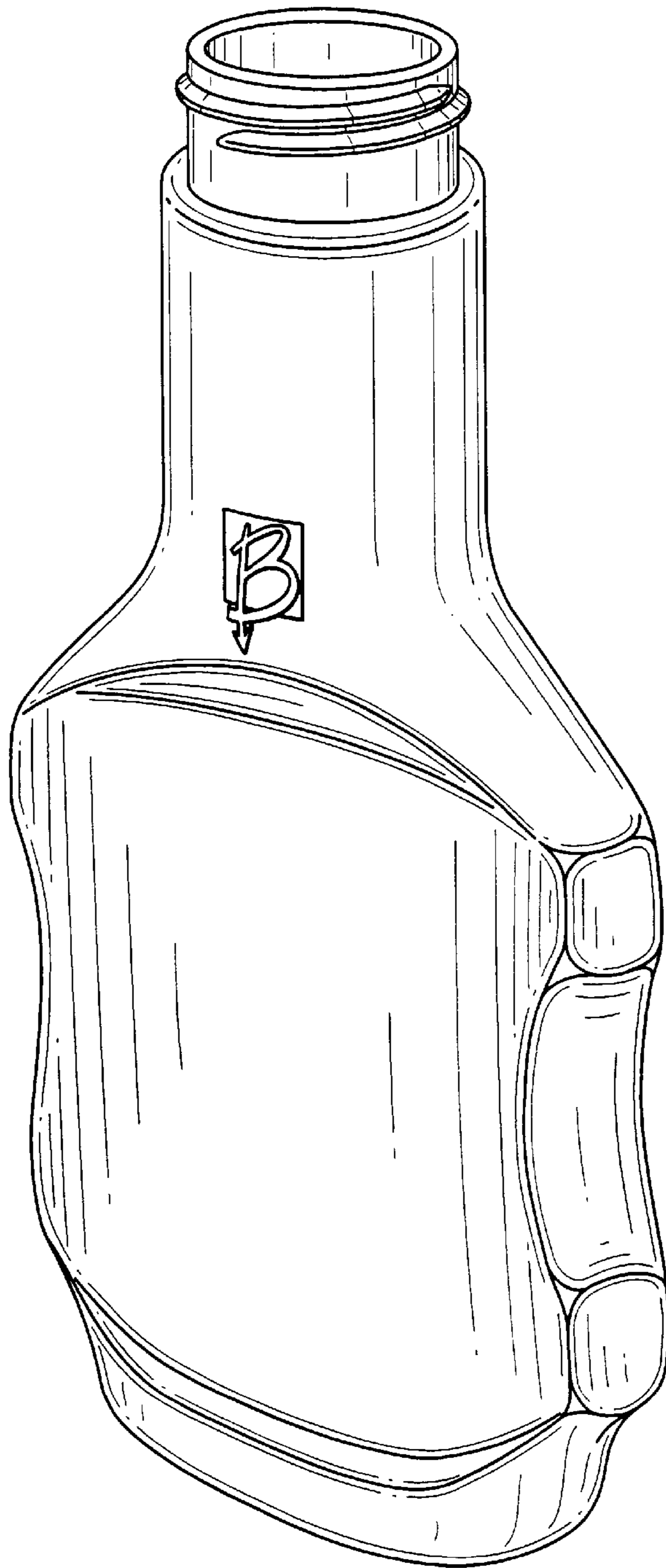

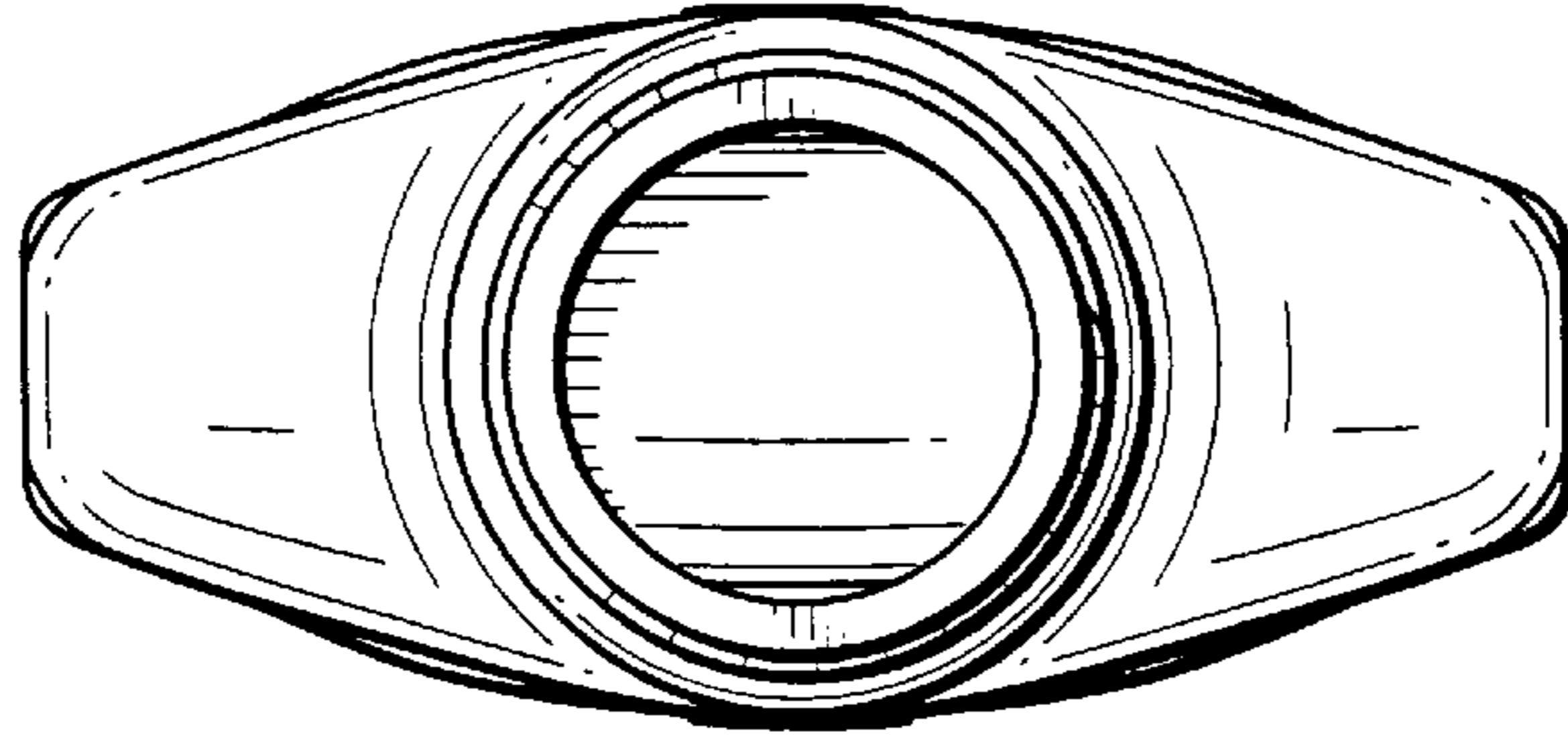

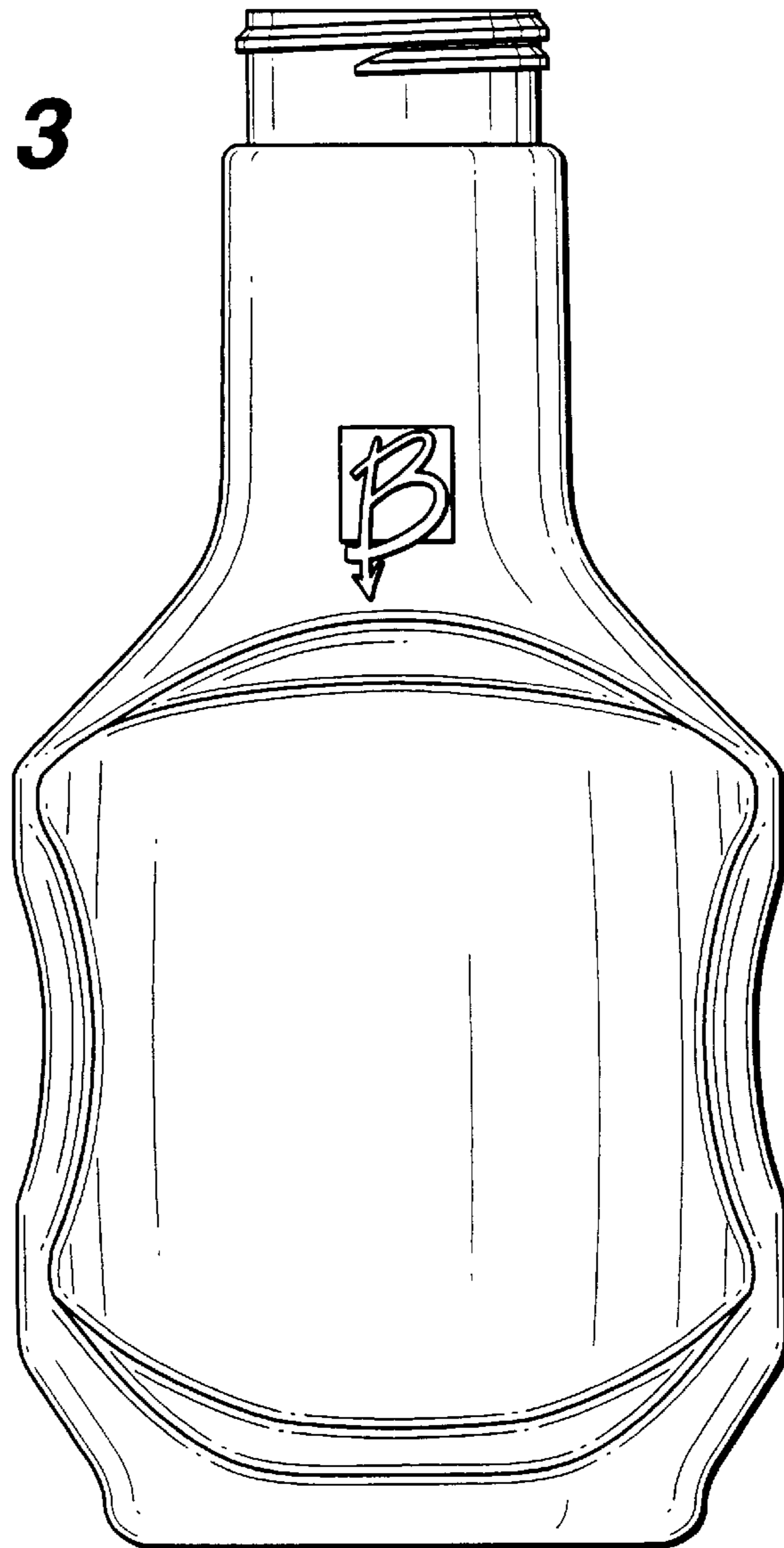

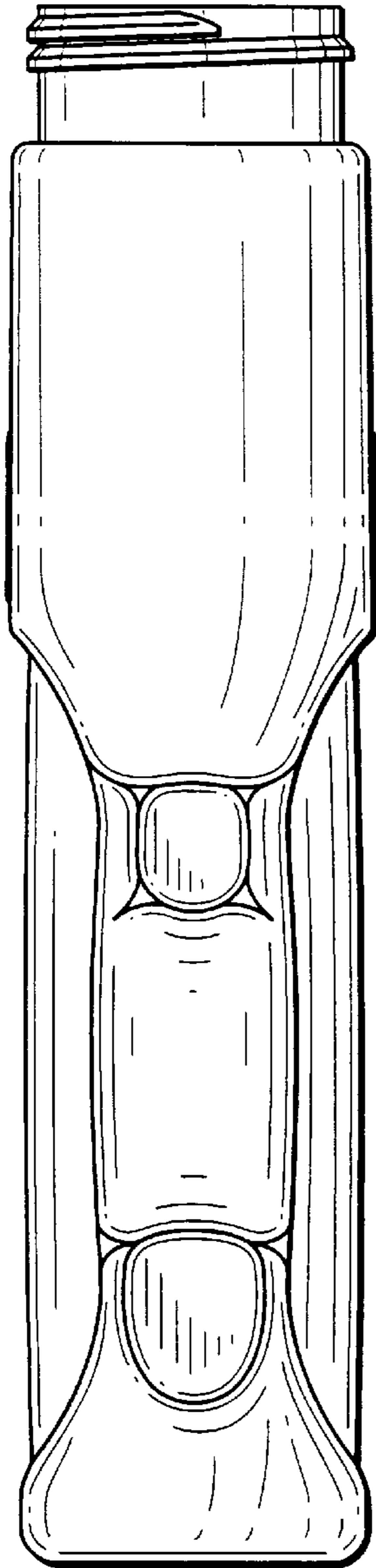

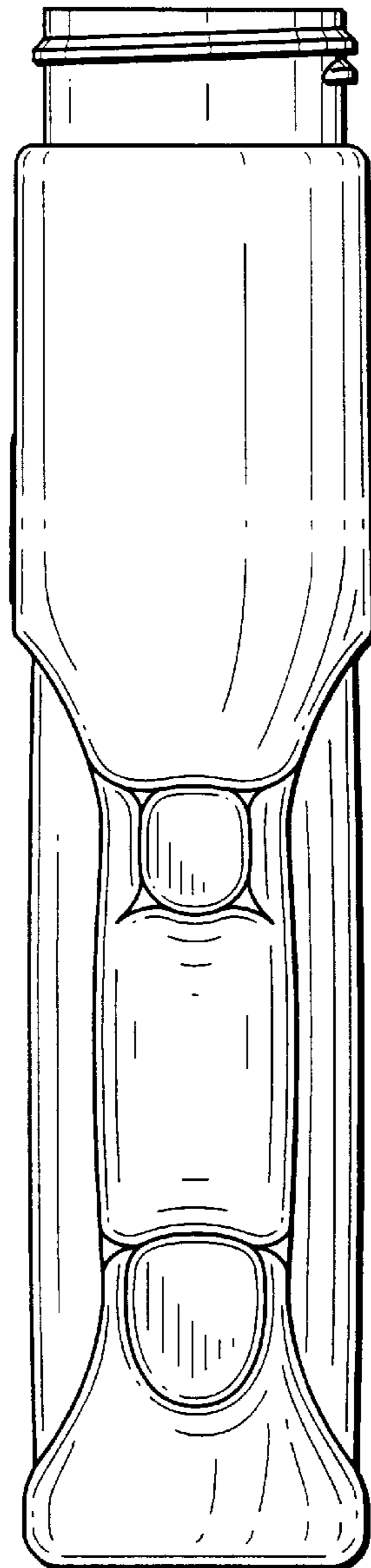

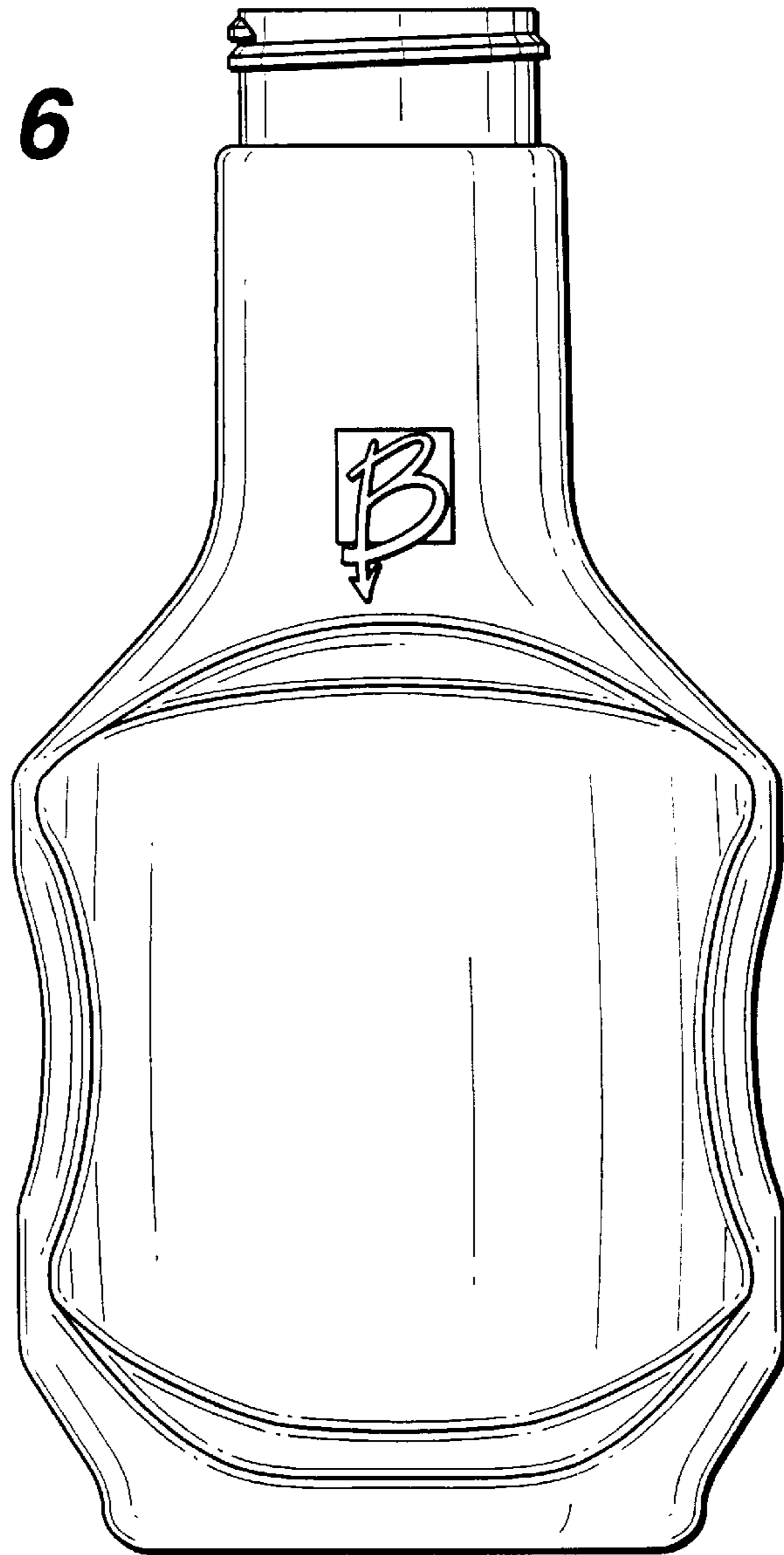

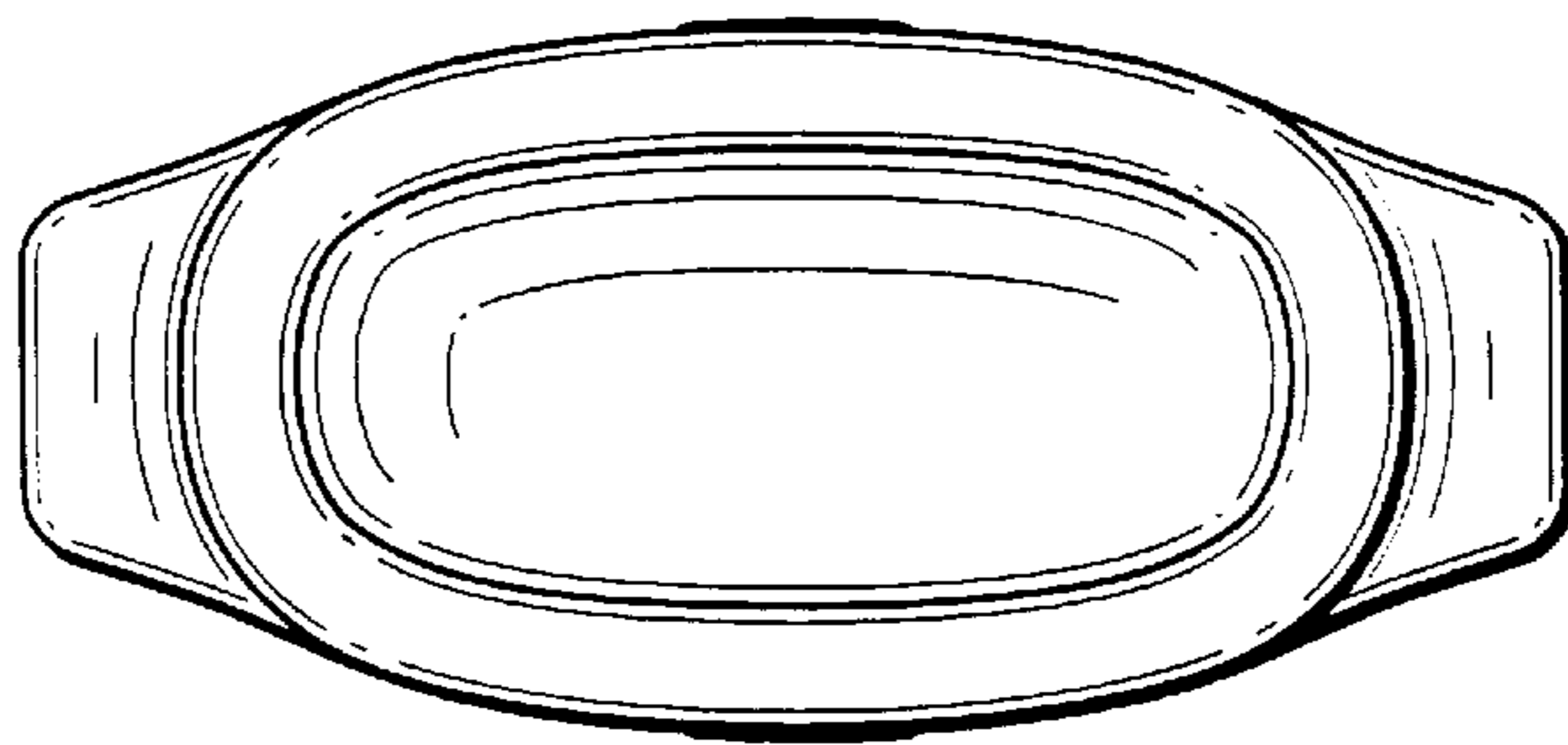
