[57] **CLAIM**

I claim the ornamental design for a gem cut, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a bottom view of a preferred embodiment of the invention comprising a gem cut;
FIG. 2 is a top view of the gem cut invention shown in FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a right side view of the gem cut invention shown in FIGS. 1-2, with the left side being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 4 is a front view of the gem cut invention shown in FIGS. 1-3, with the back view being identical thereof; and,
FIG. 5 is a perspective view of the gem cut invention shown in FIGS. 1-4.

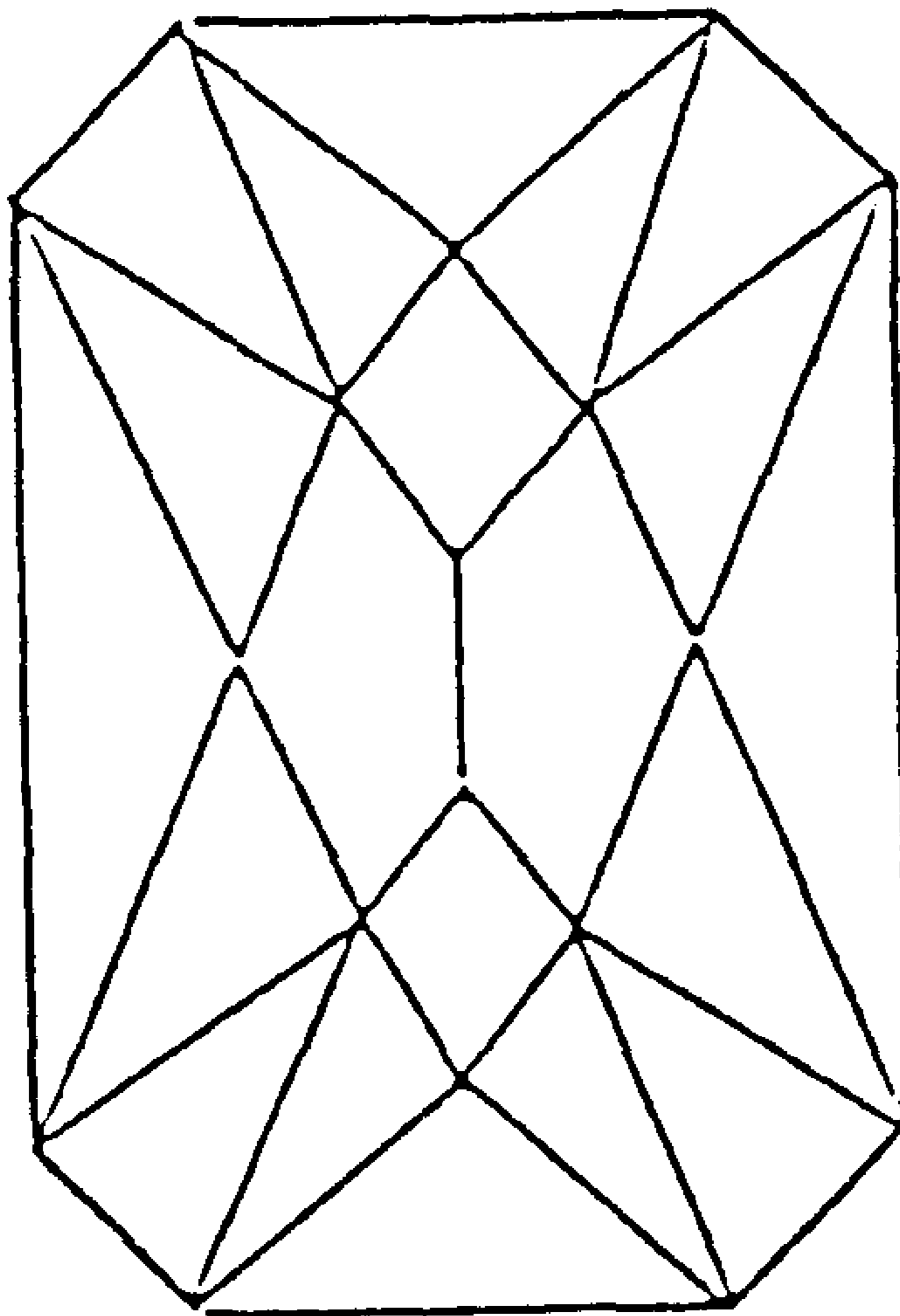

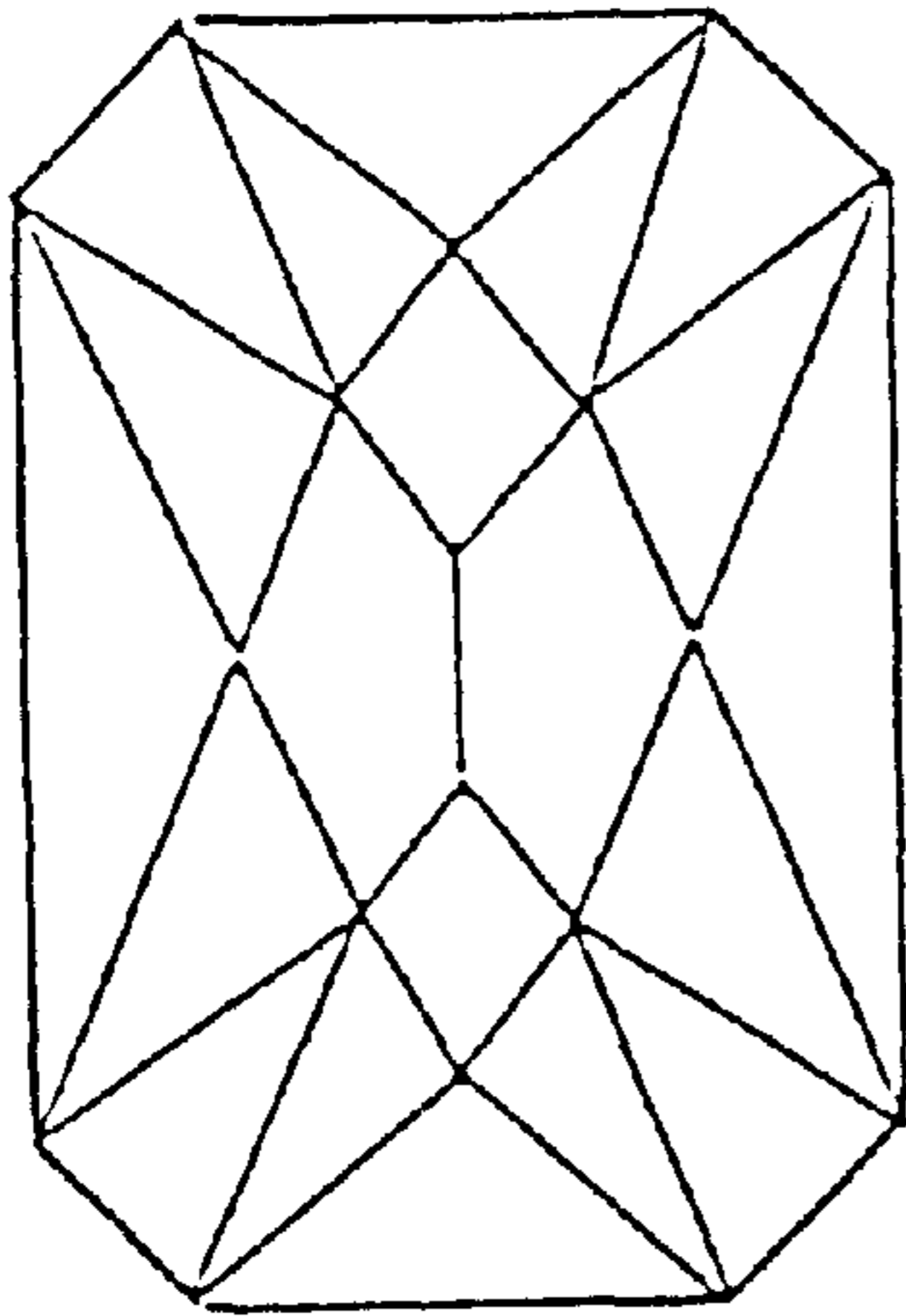

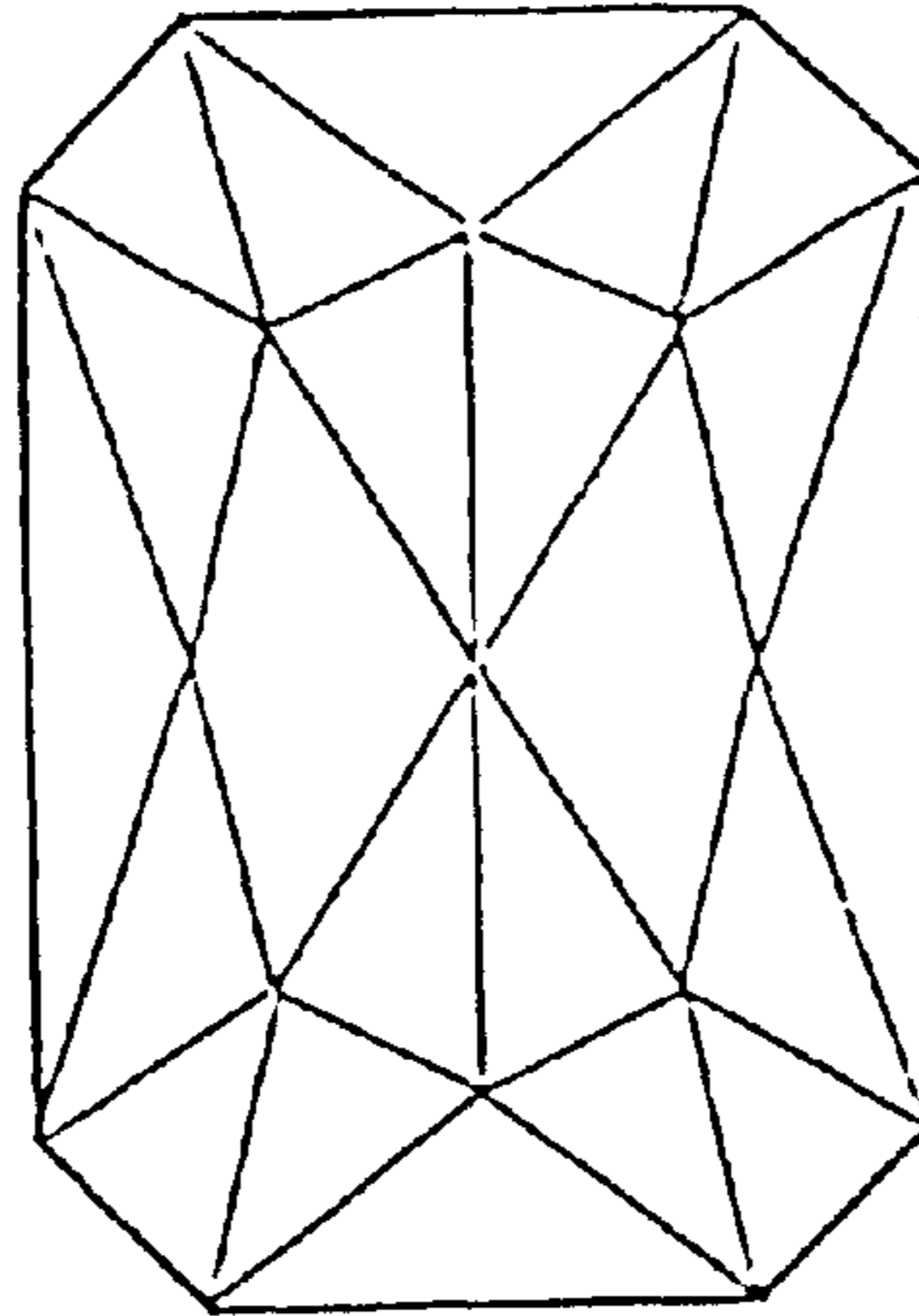

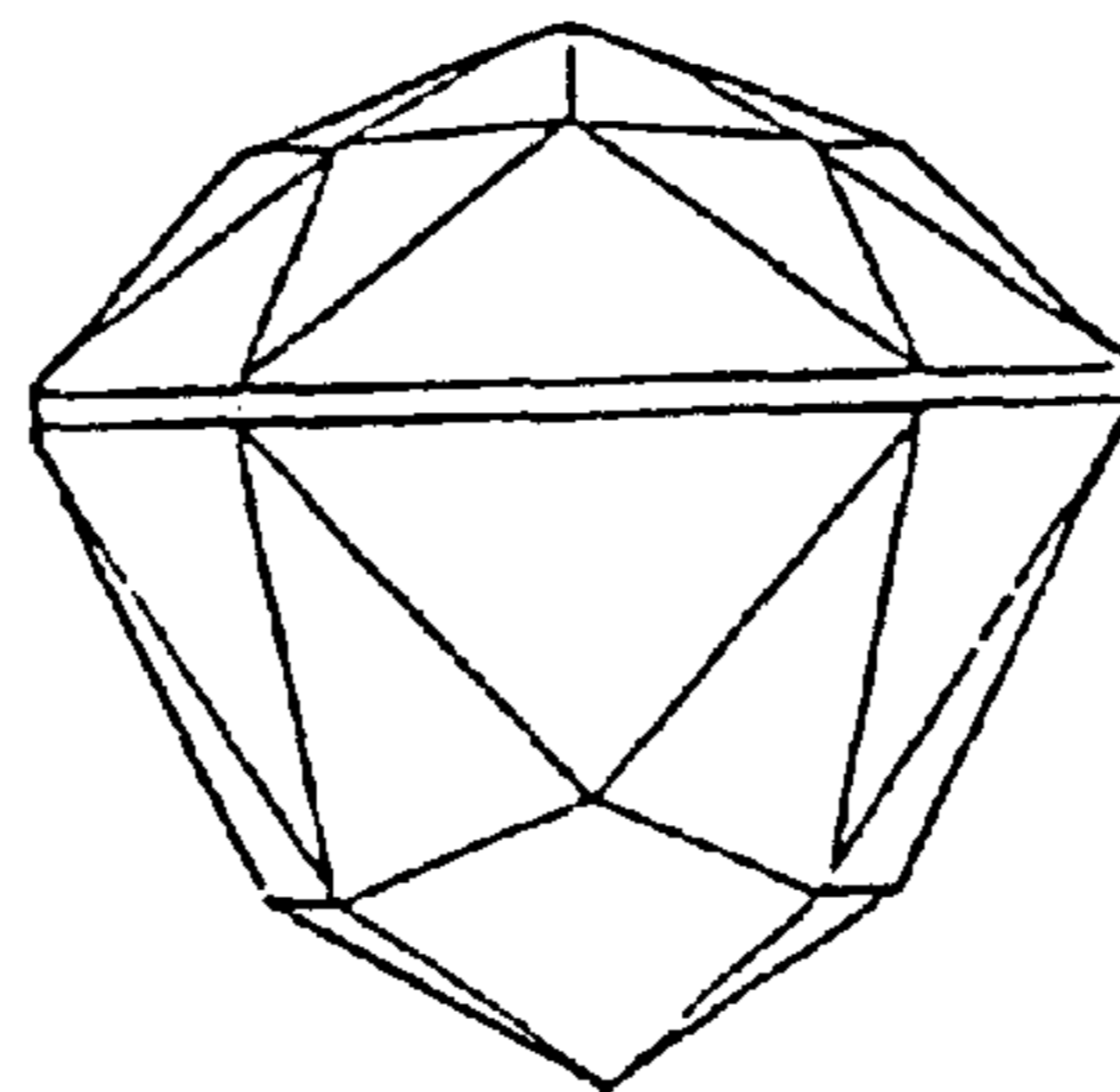
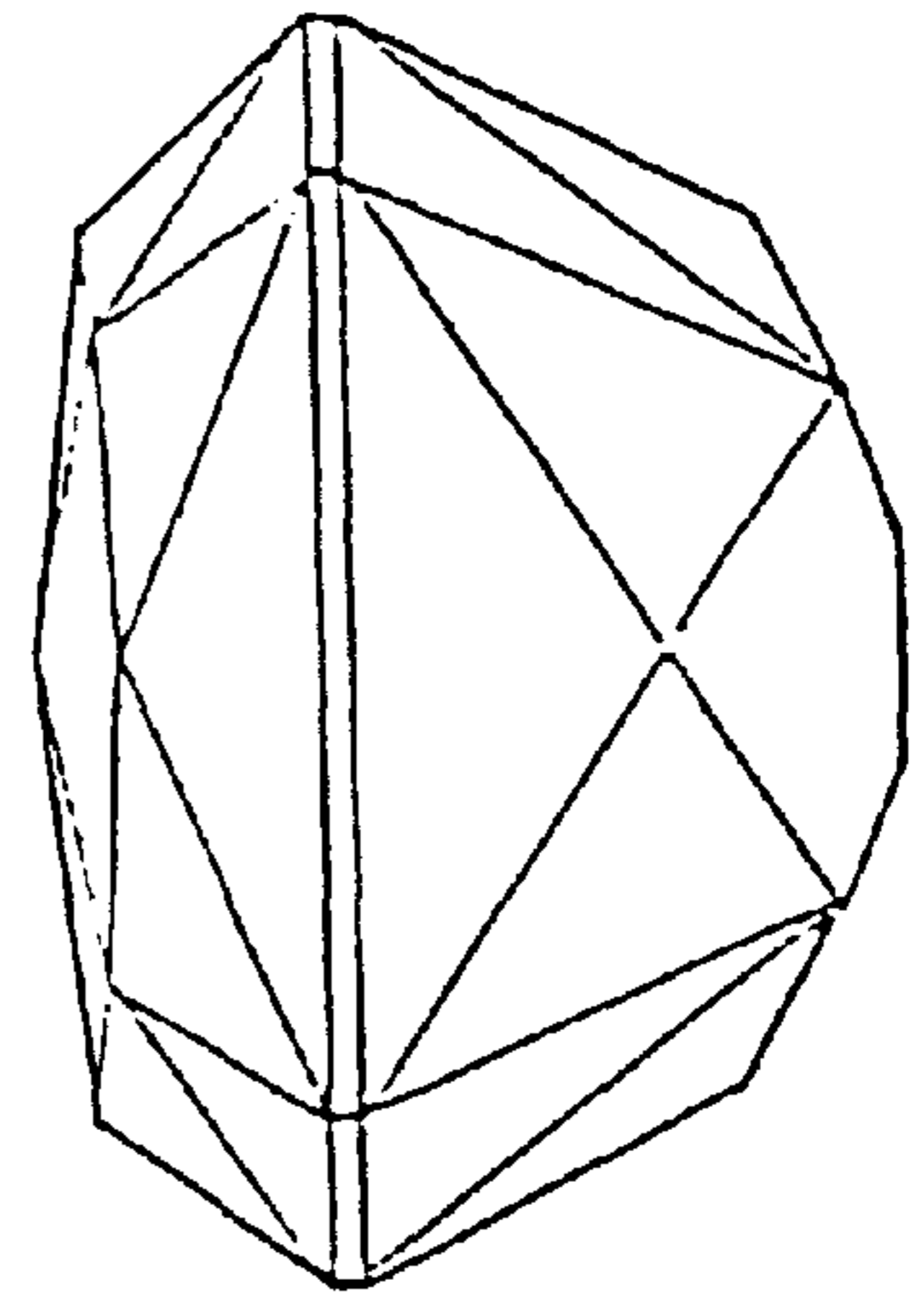

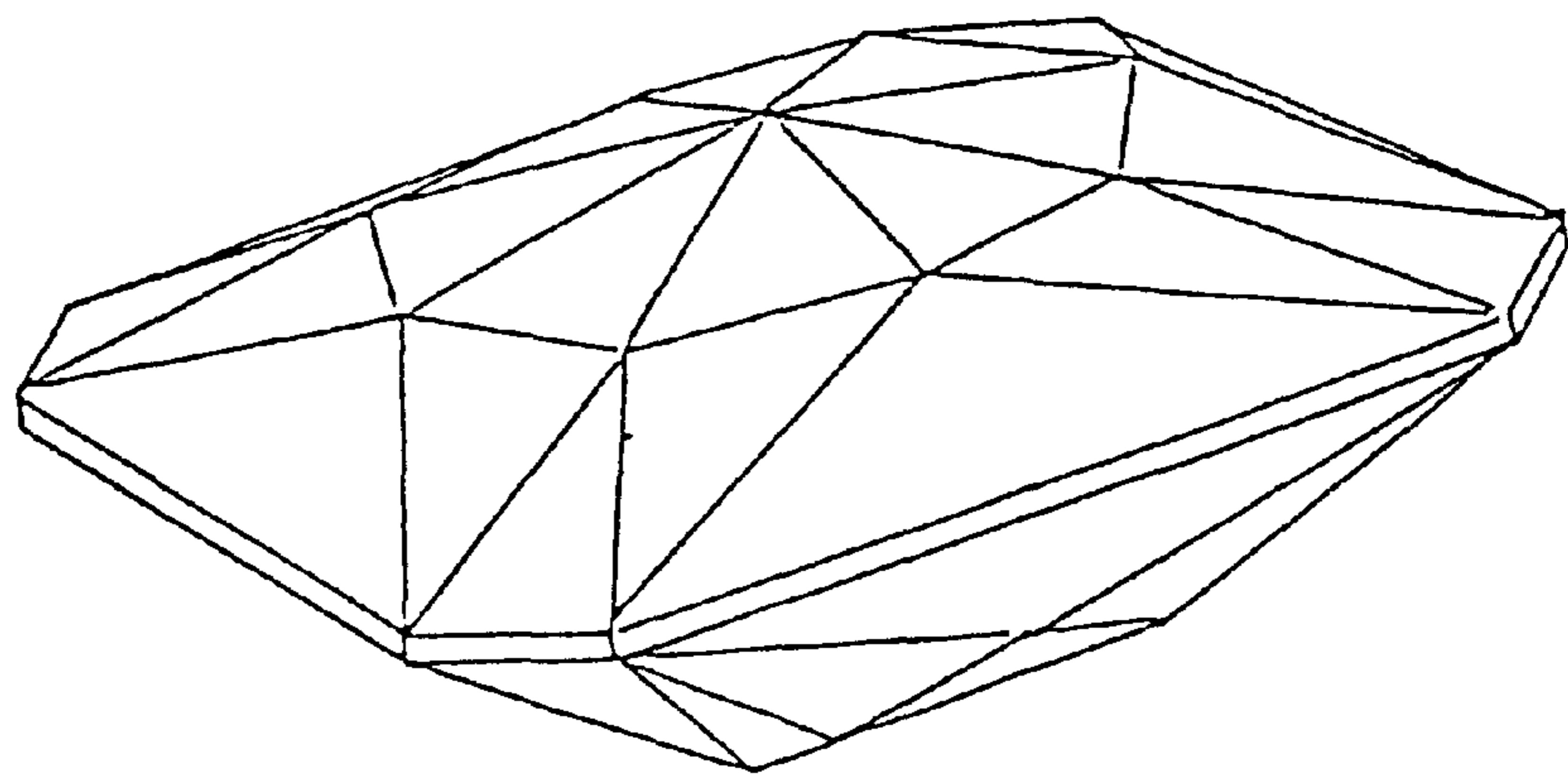
