[57] **CLAIM**

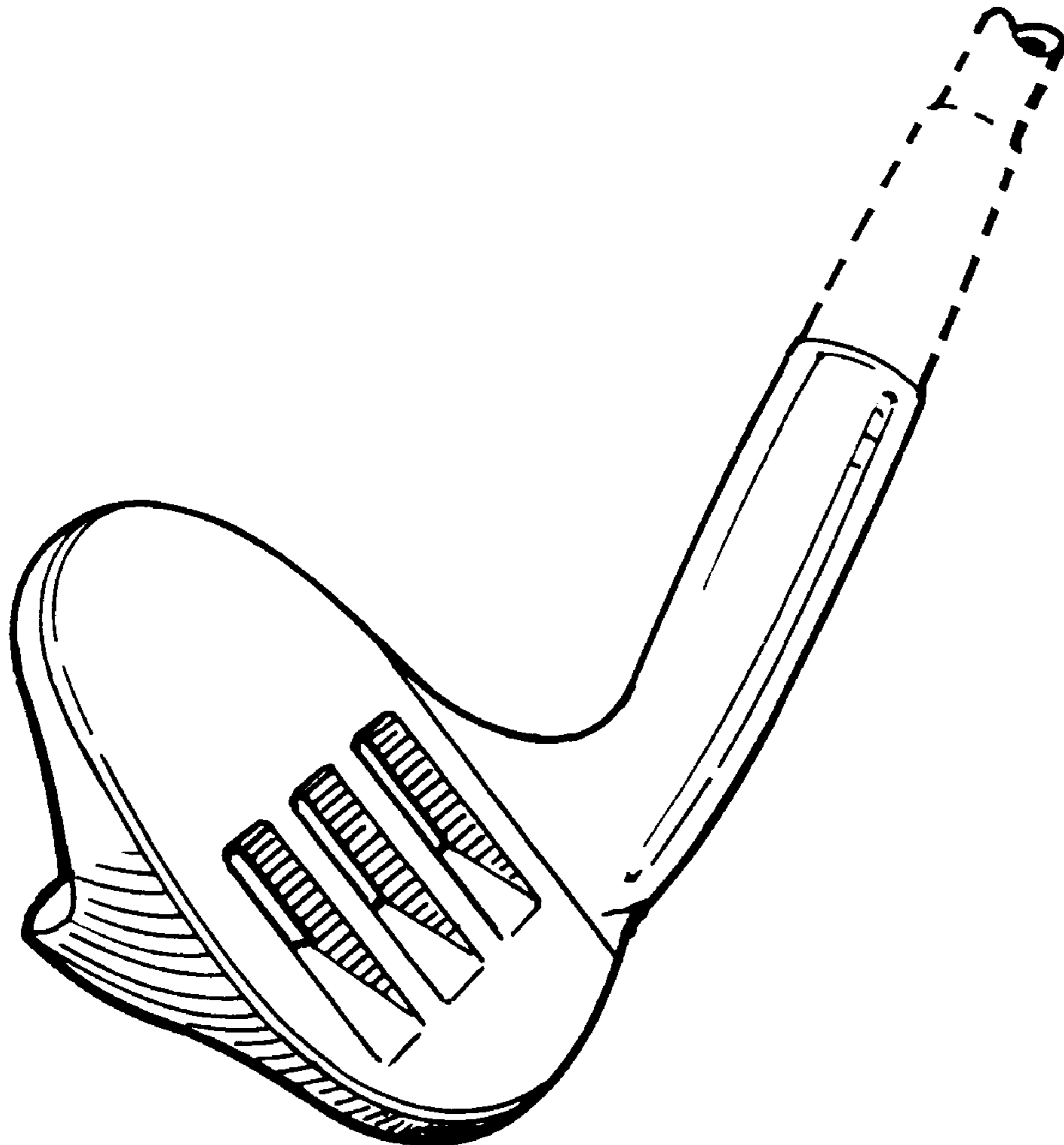
The ornamental design for a golf club head with a perforated face and cavity back, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a golf club head with a perforated face and cavity back;
FIG. 2 is a front elevation view of the golf club of FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevation view of the golf club of FIG. 1;
FIG. 4 is a right side elevation view of the golf club head of FIG. 1;
FIG. 5 is a left side view of the golf club head of FIG. 1;
FIG. 6 is a top plan view of the golf club head of FIG. 1;
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view of the golf club head of FIG. 1.

The broken lines showing a fragmented hosel connector and shaft are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.

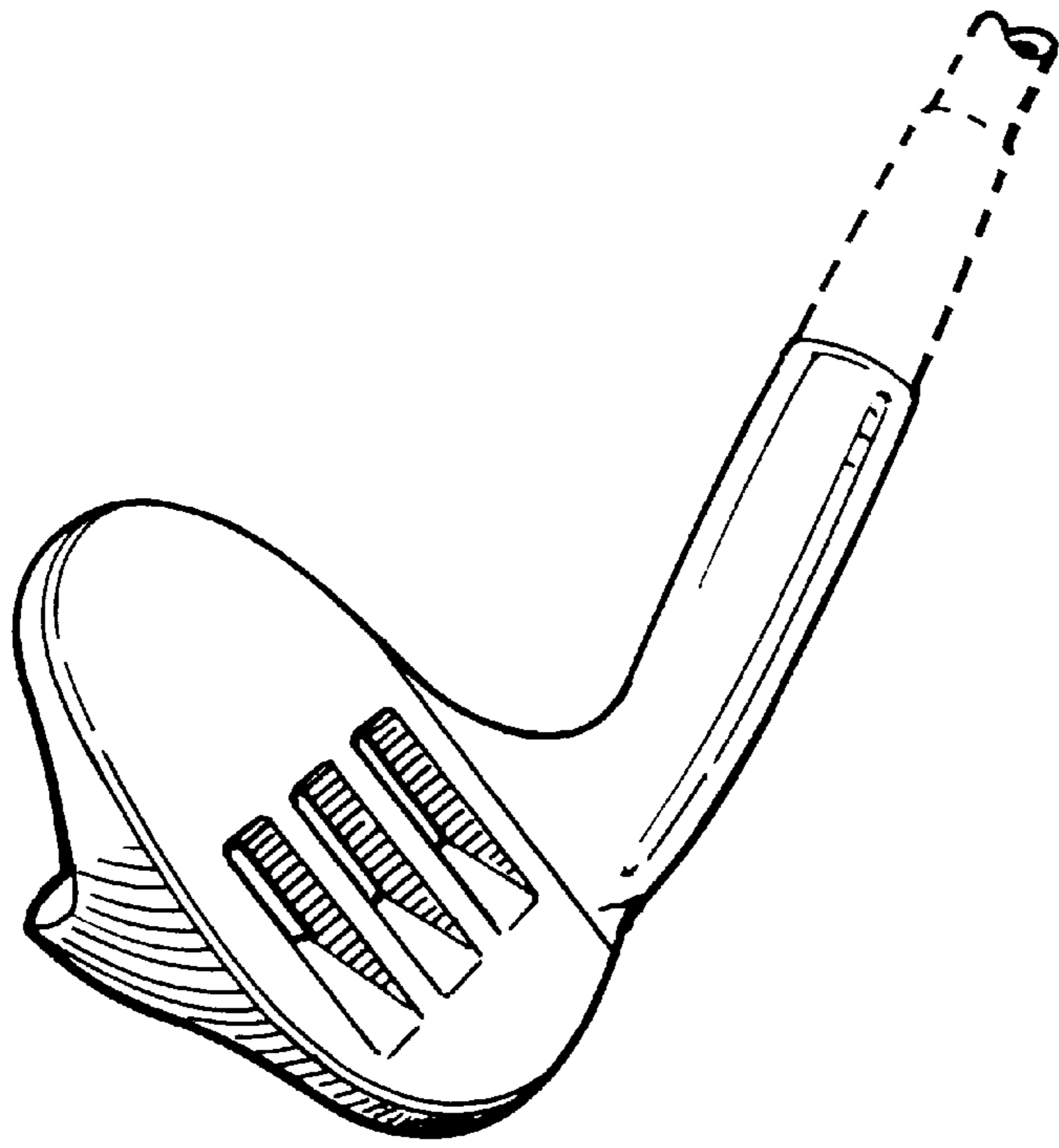

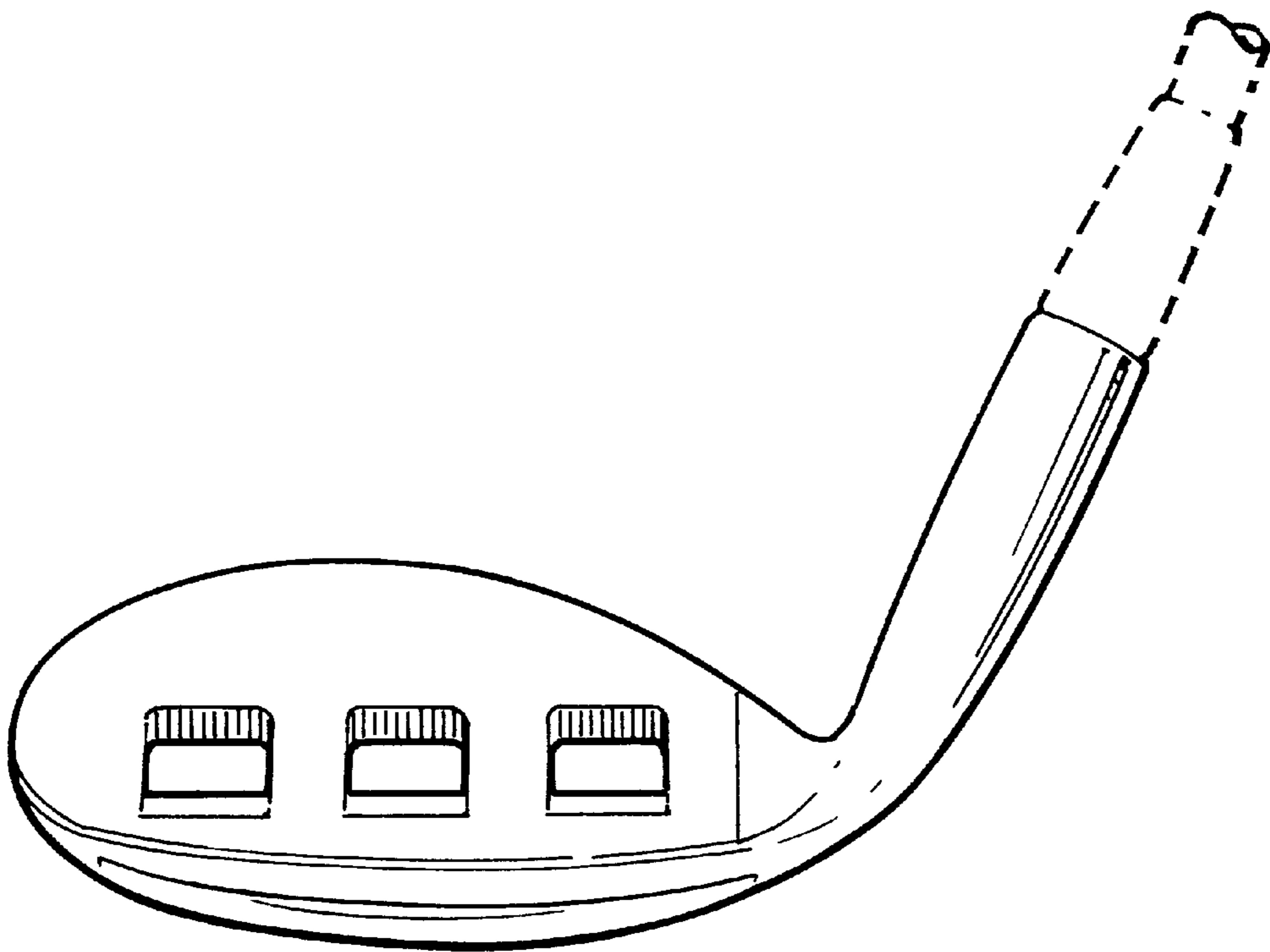

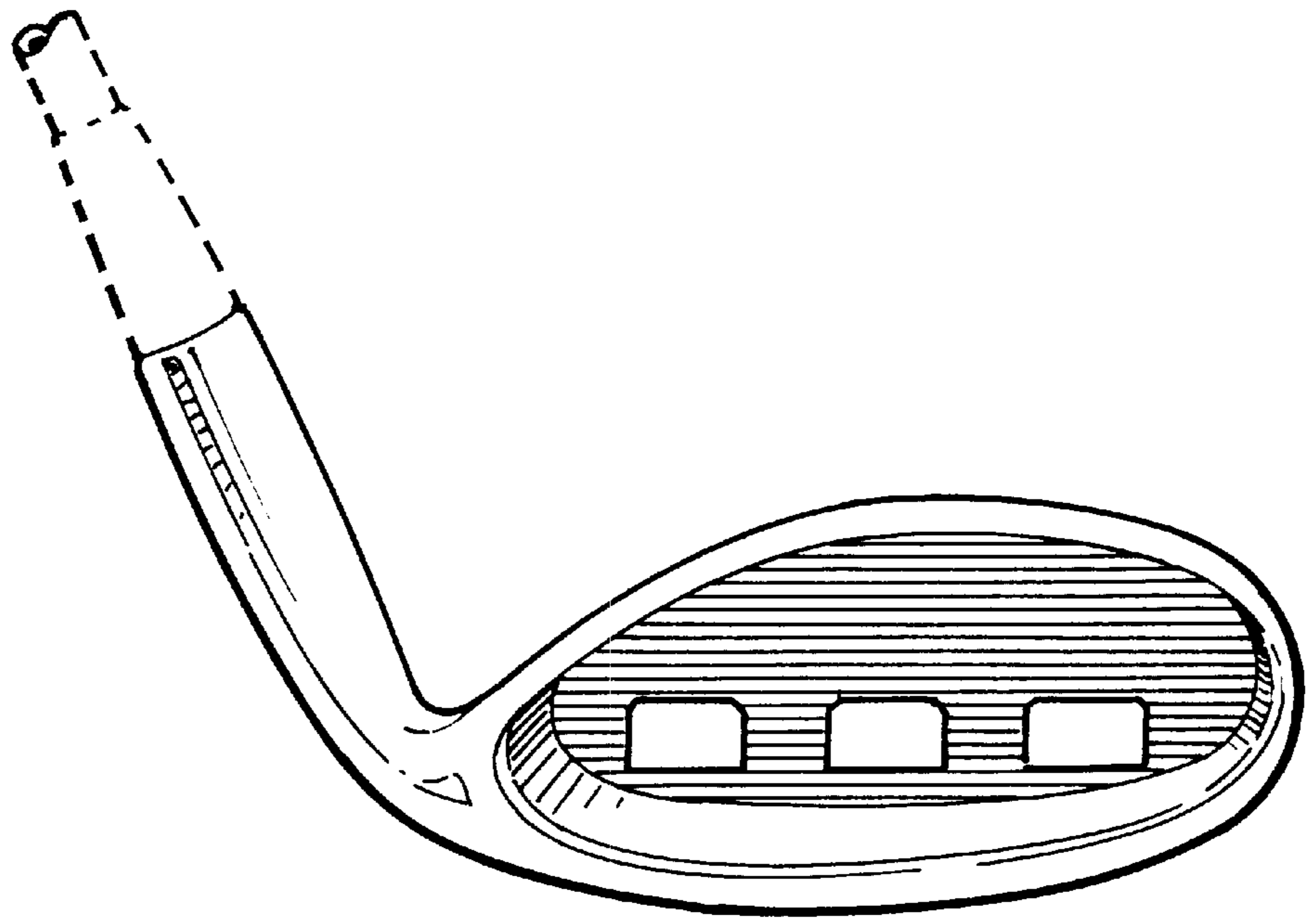

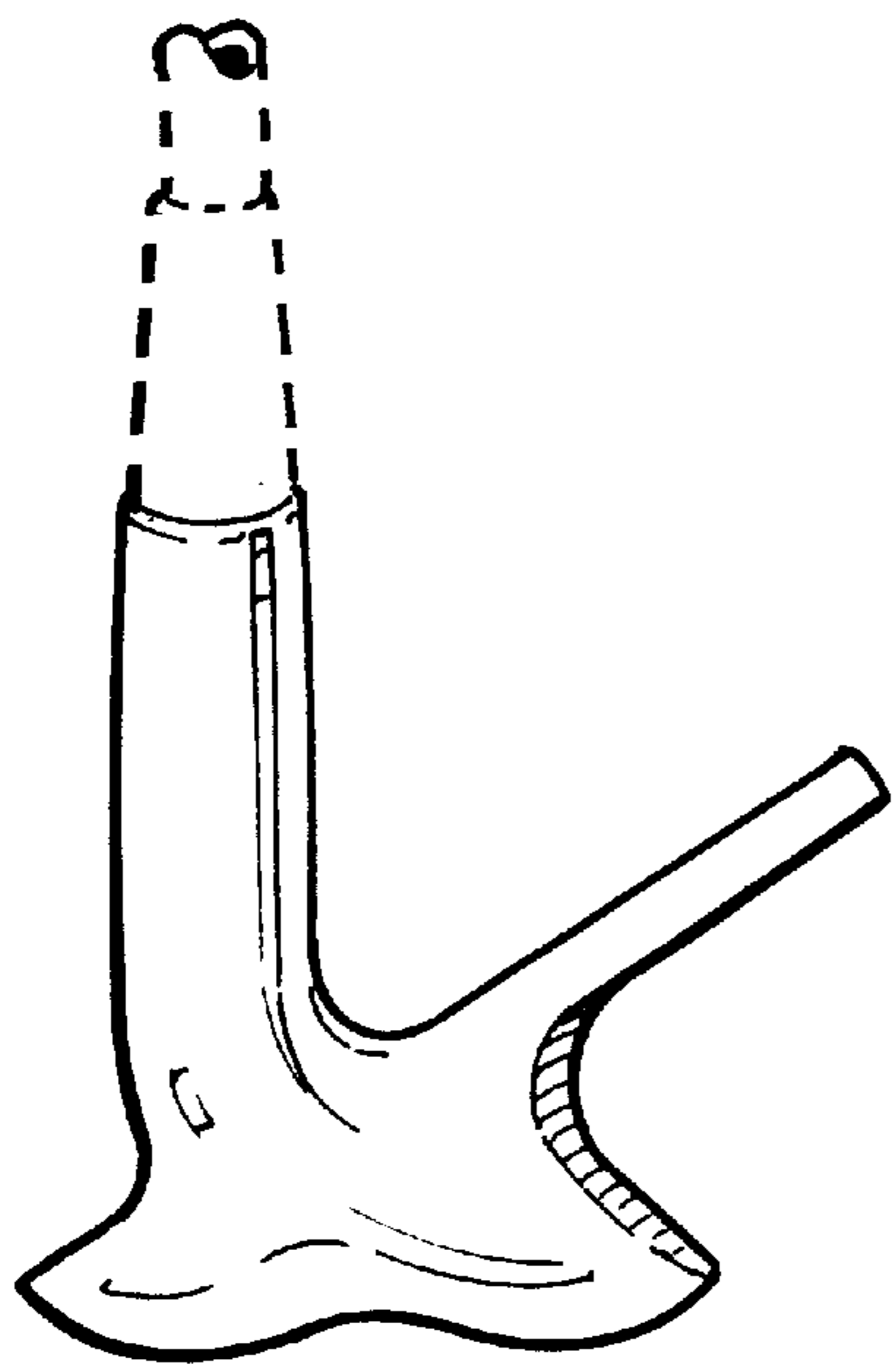

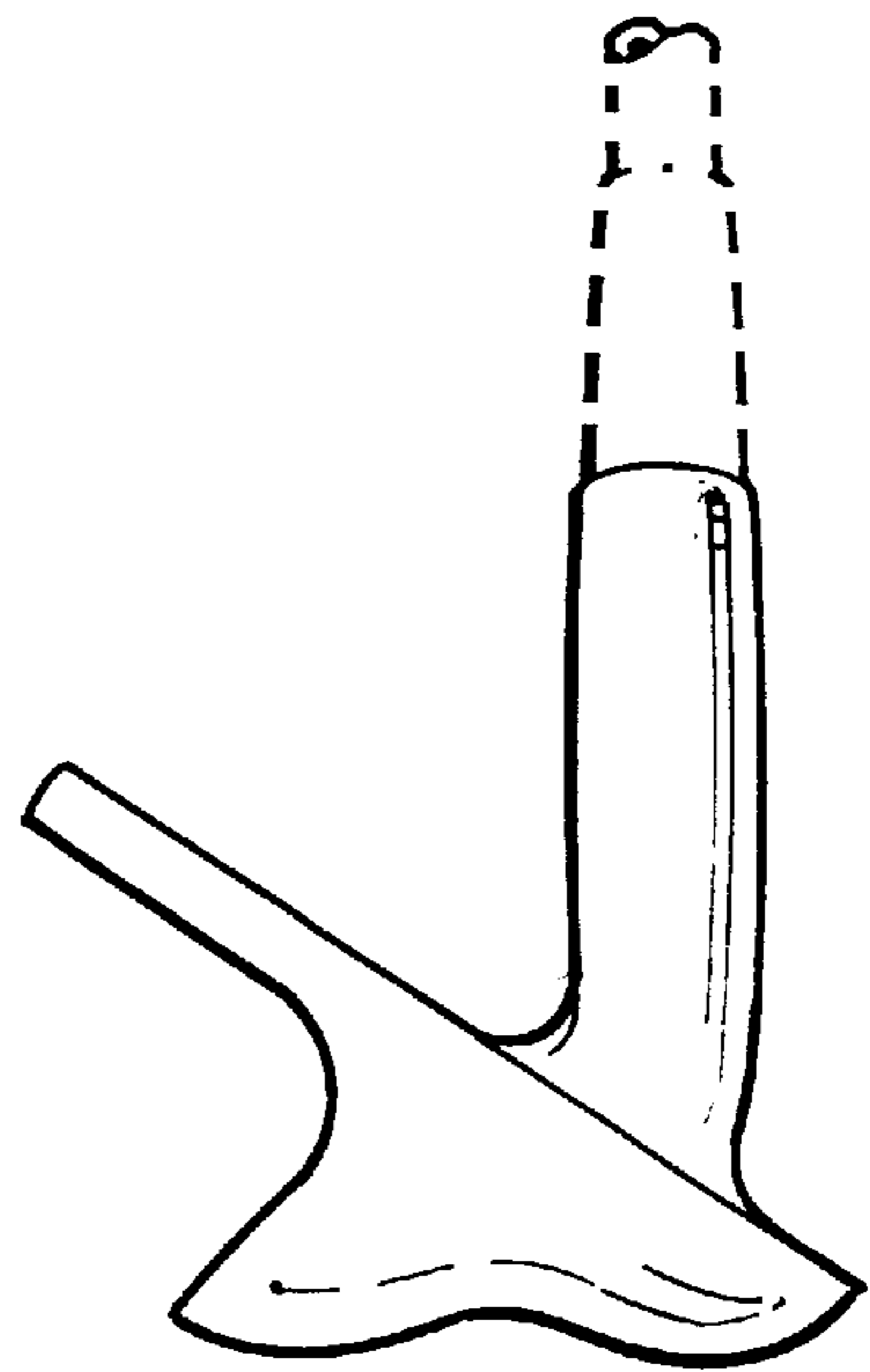

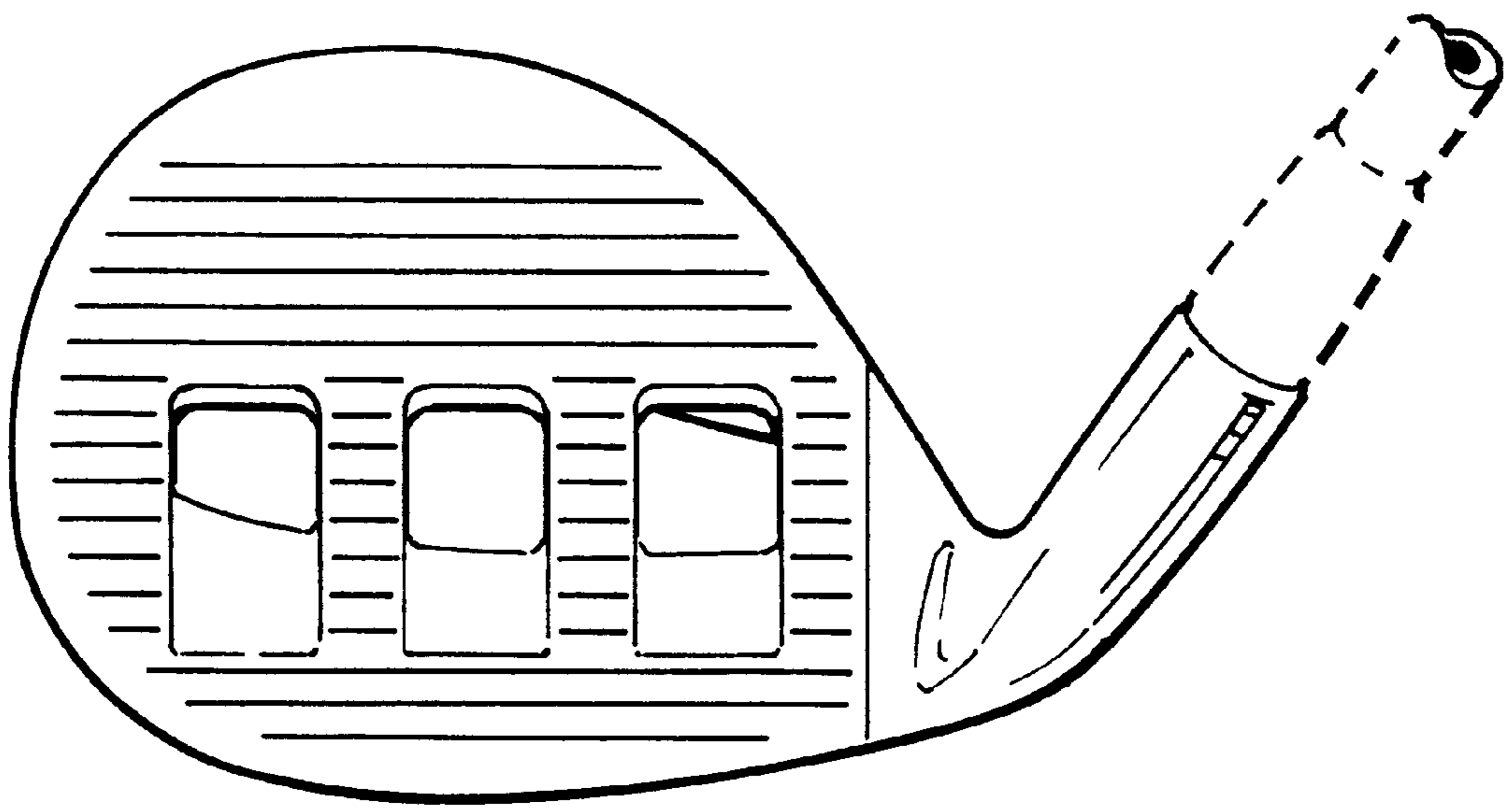

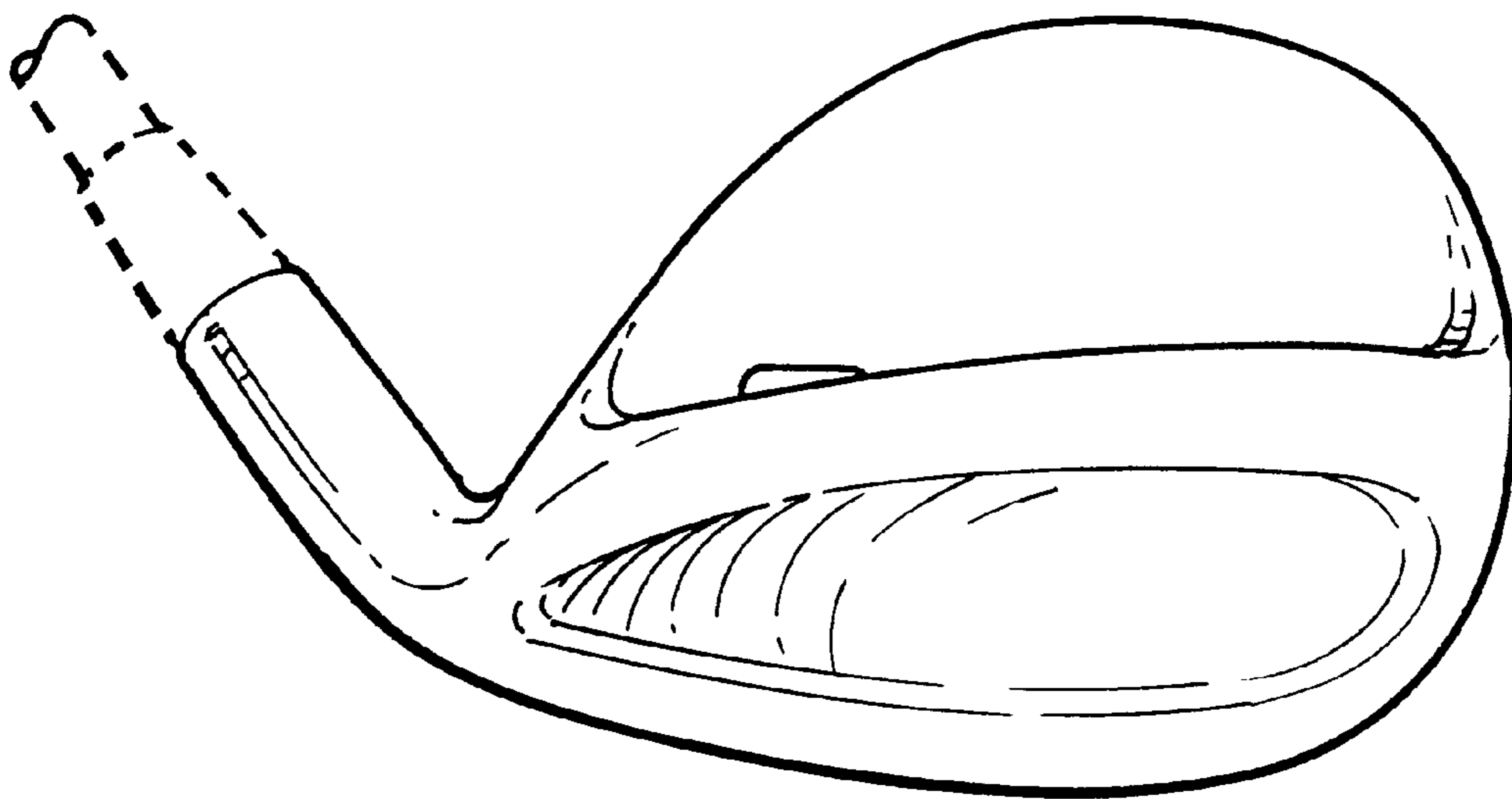
