## [57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combination hair ornament and retaining combs, as shown and described.

## DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1, is a top plan view of a combined elastic hair ornament and retaining combs showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a front view with the retaining combs in a position perpendicular to a bottom surface thereof;

FIG. 3 is a partial left side view portions thereof being omitted for ease of illustration;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a partial right side view thereof;

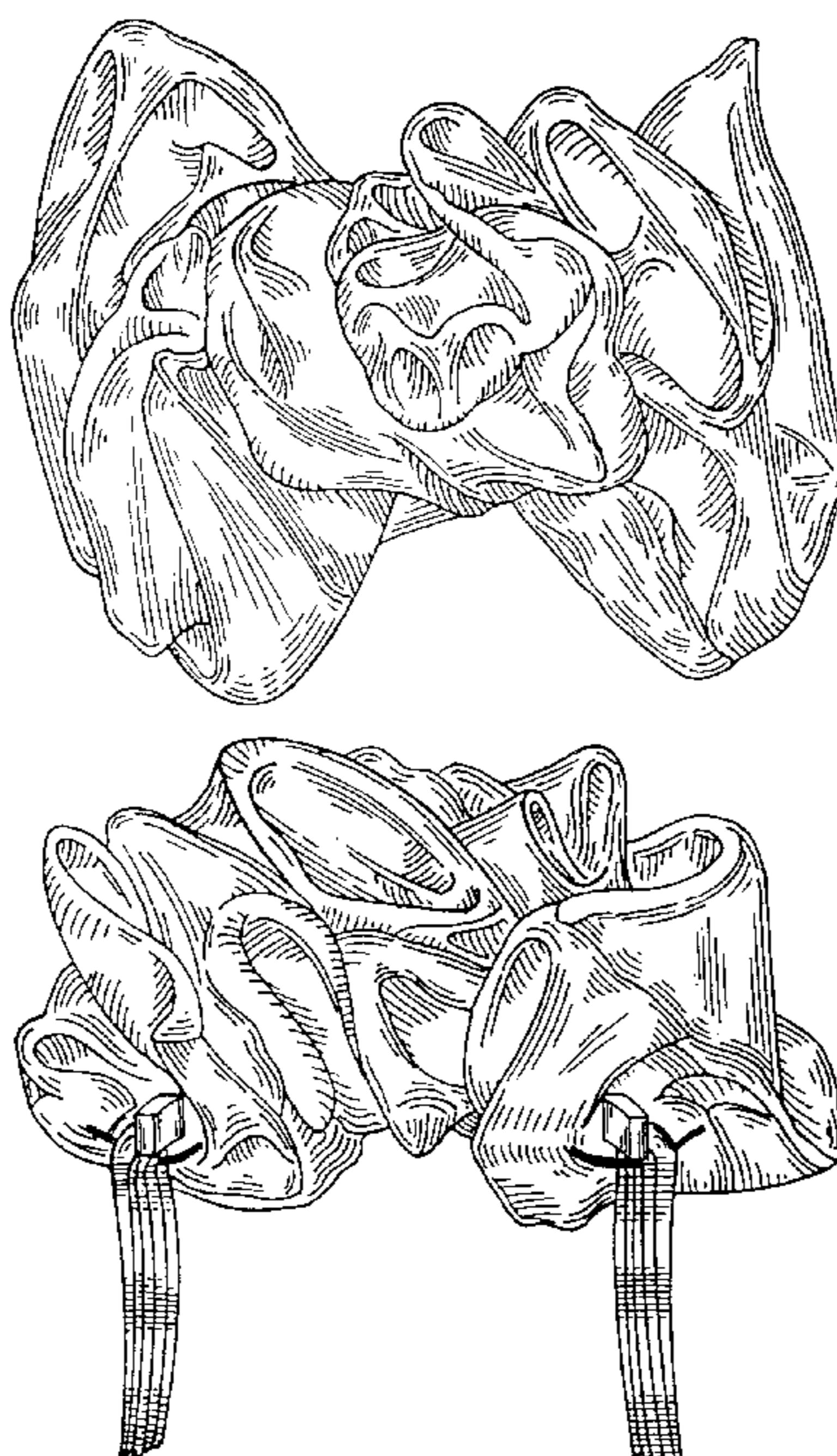
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view showing the hair ornament in an alternate stretched configuration with combs rotated inwardly 90 degrees from FIGS. 2-6;

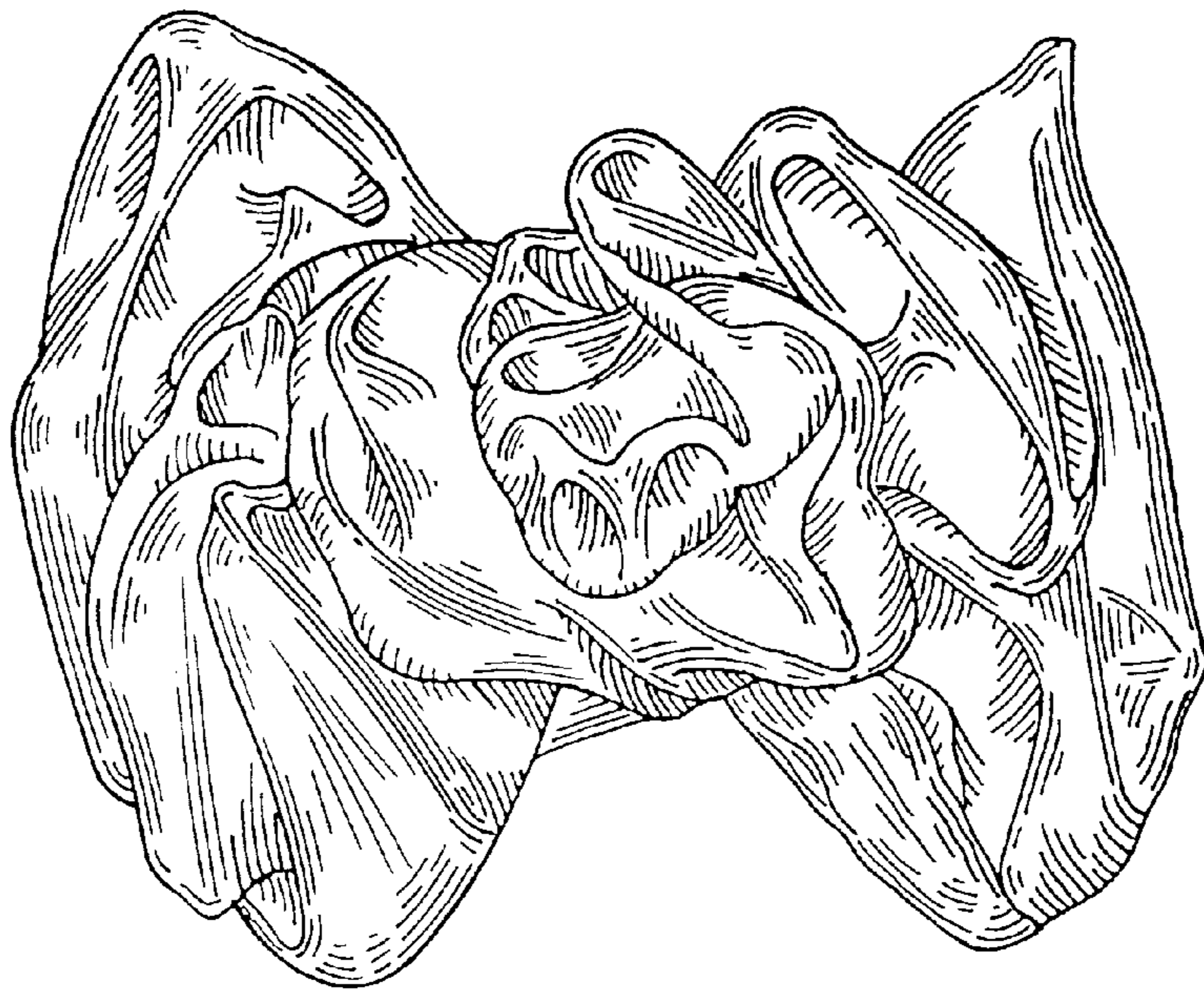
FIG. 7 is a rear view of the comb element of the design, shown separated from the assembly for clarity of disclosure; and,

FIG. 8 is a side view thereof.

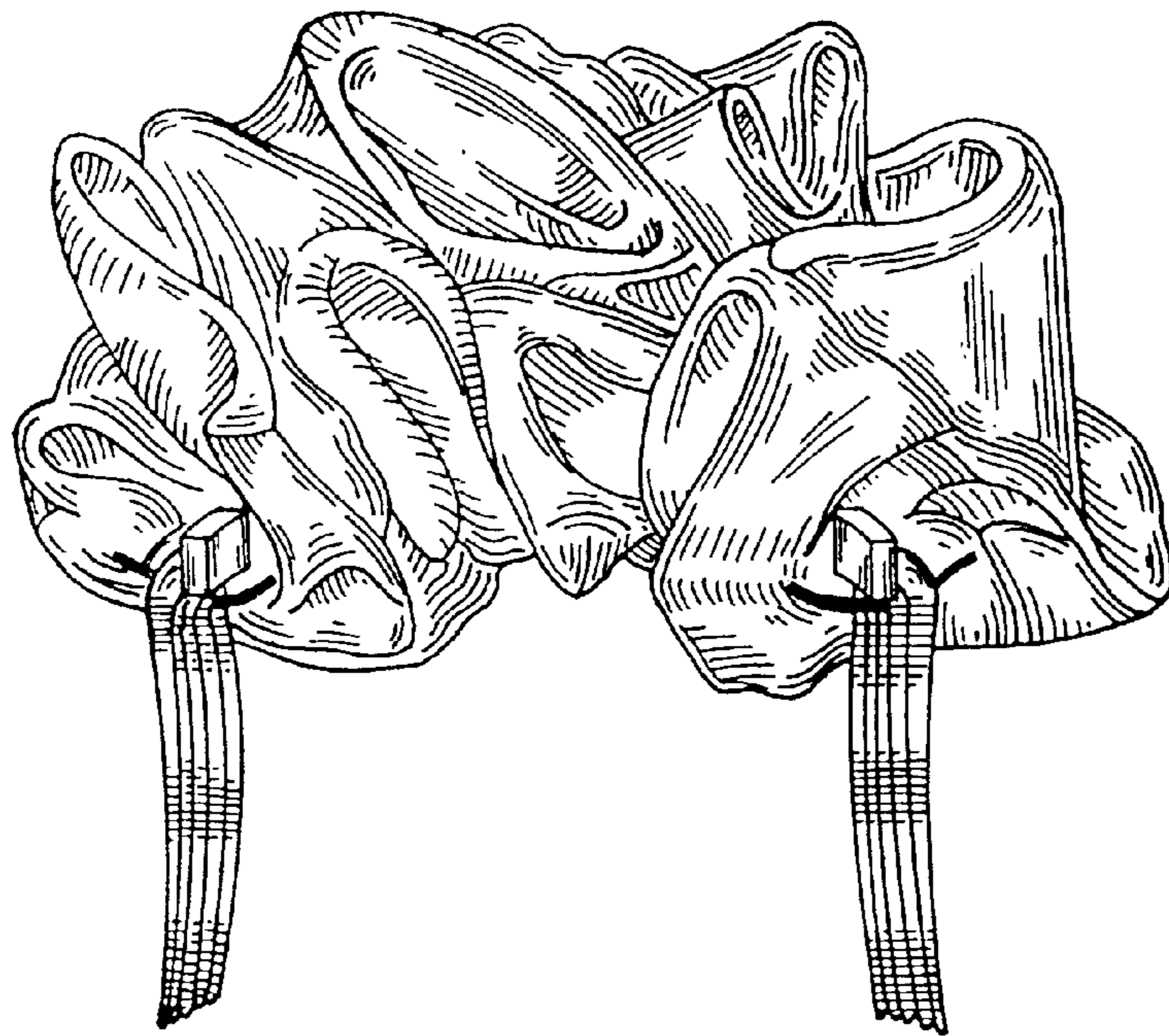
The undisclosed side of the combination hair ornament and retaining combs follows the contours of the sides shown.

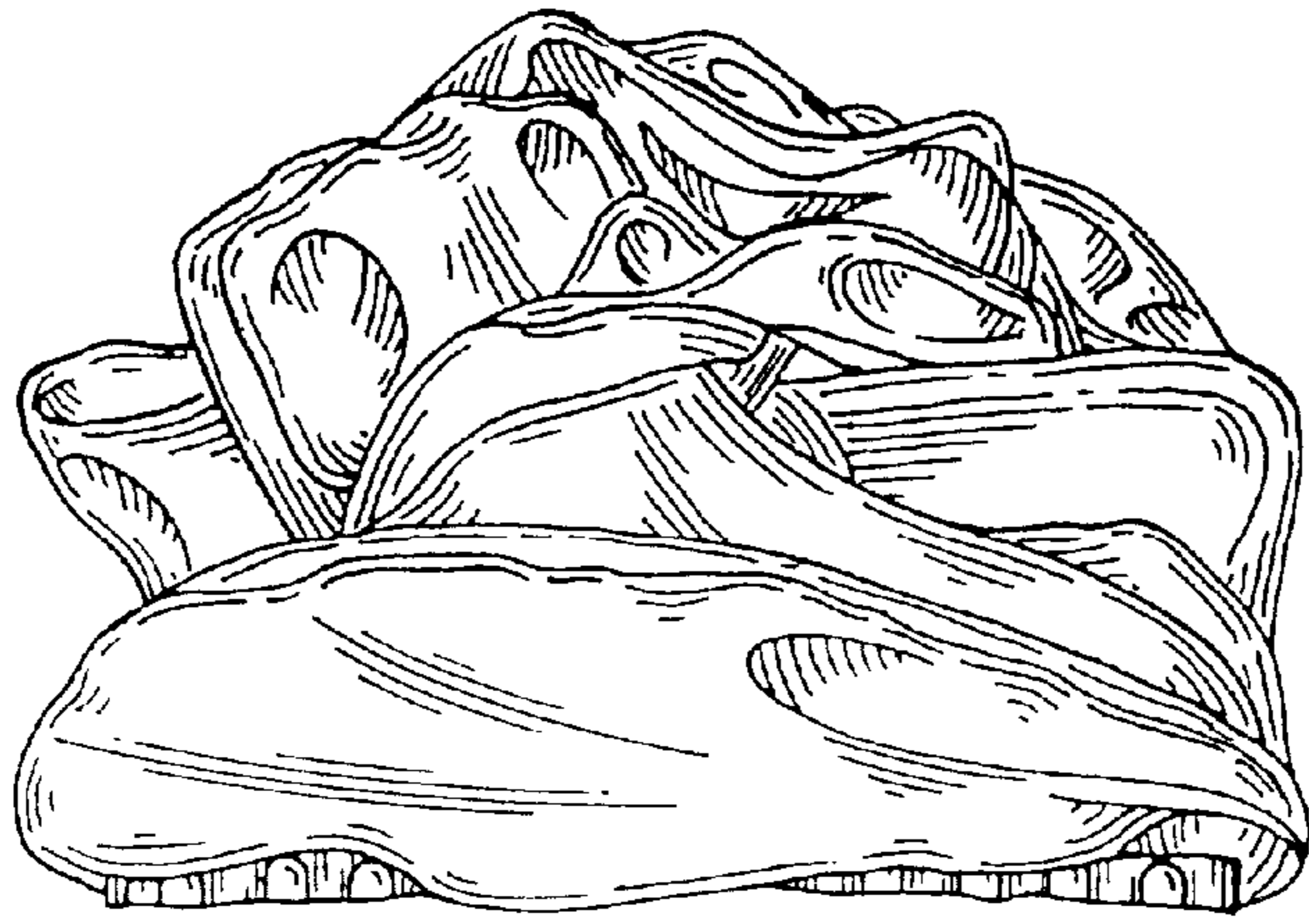

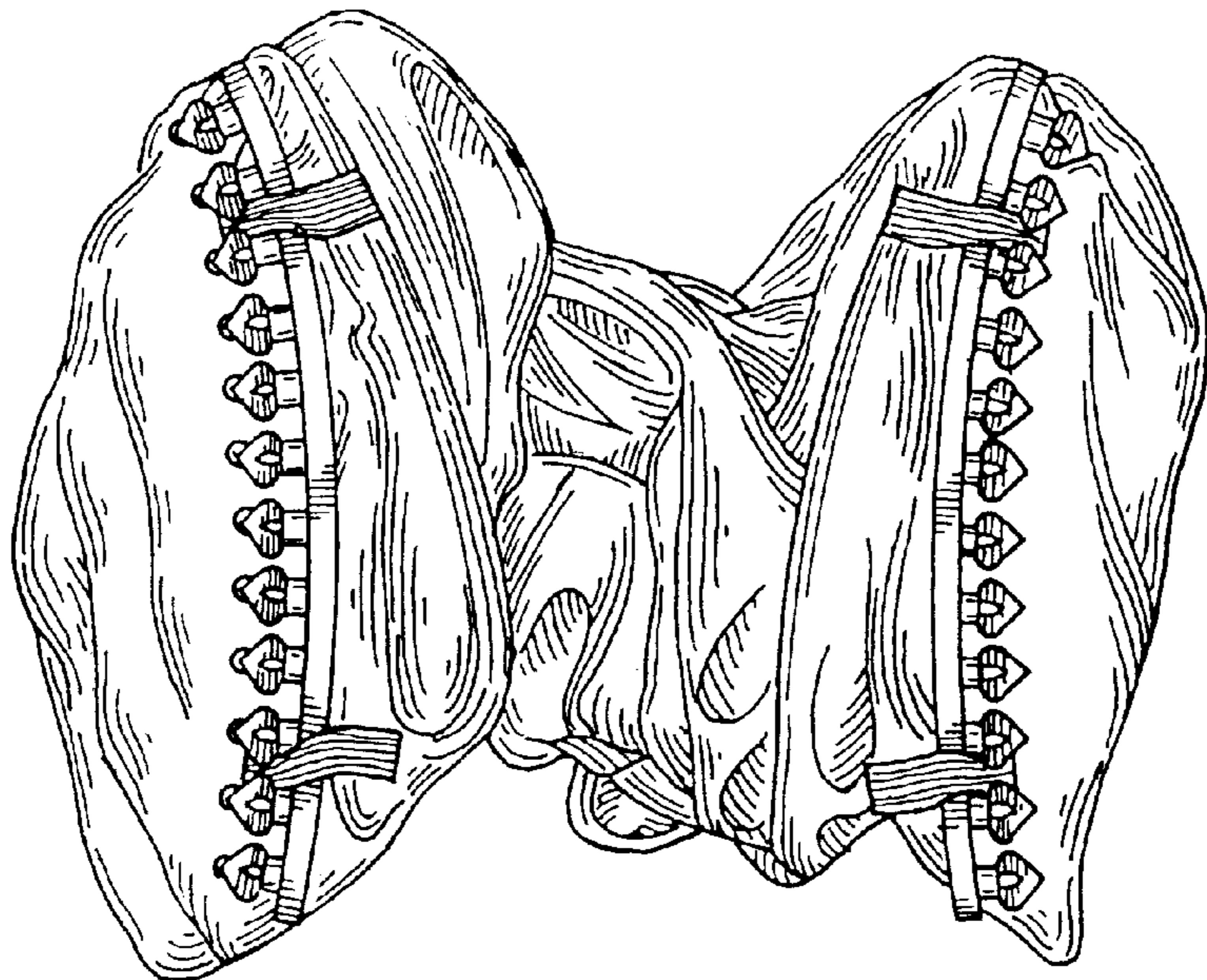

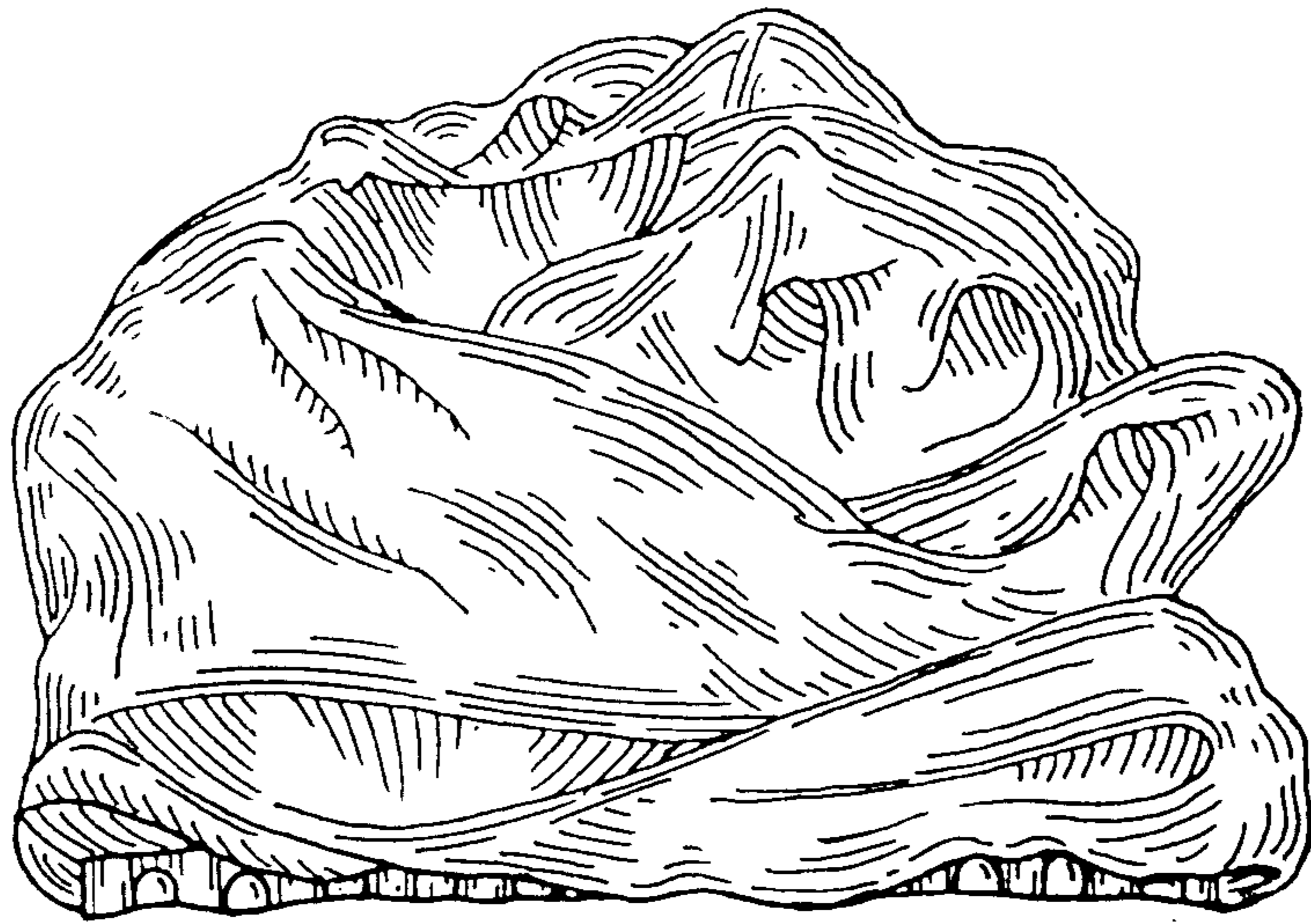




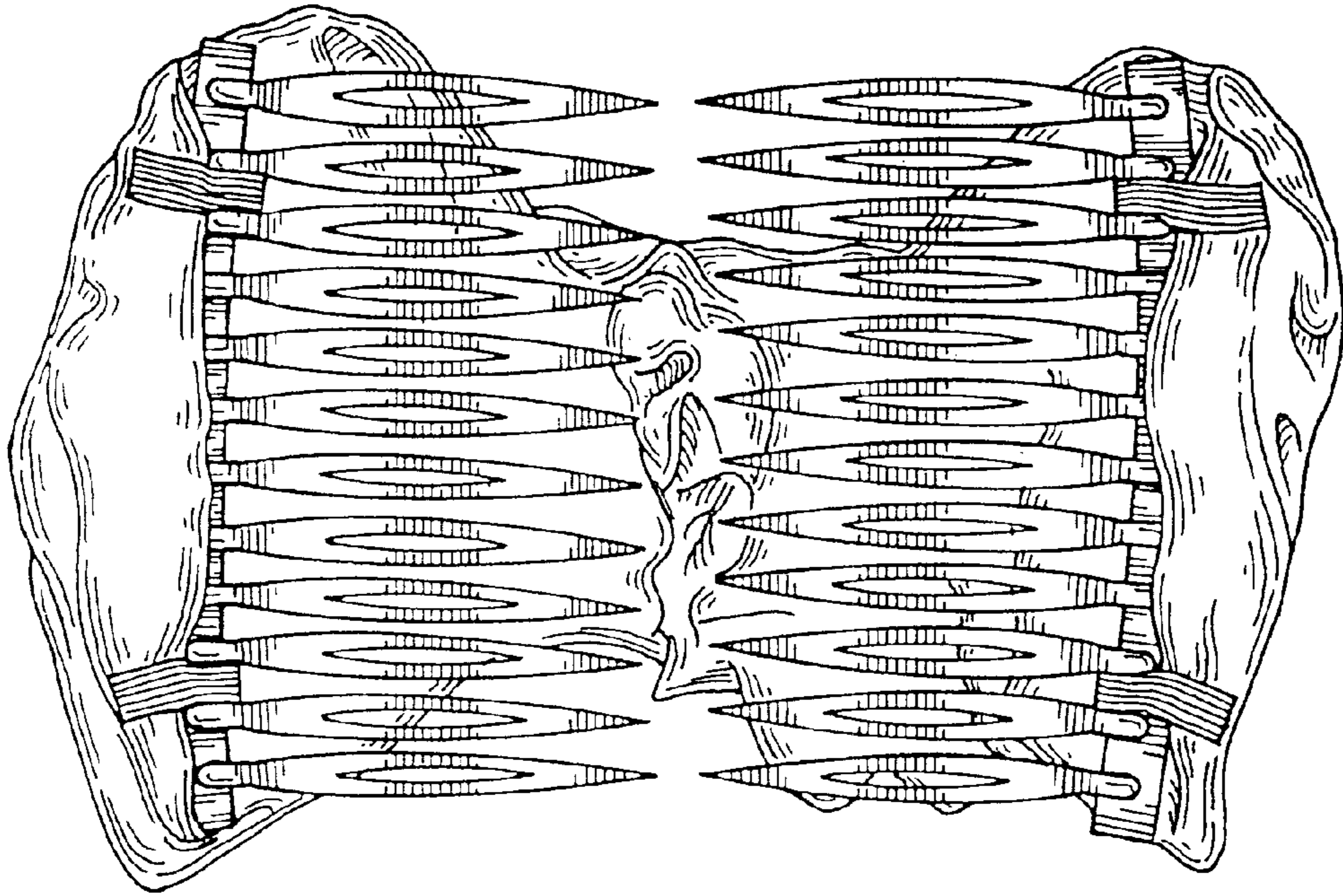

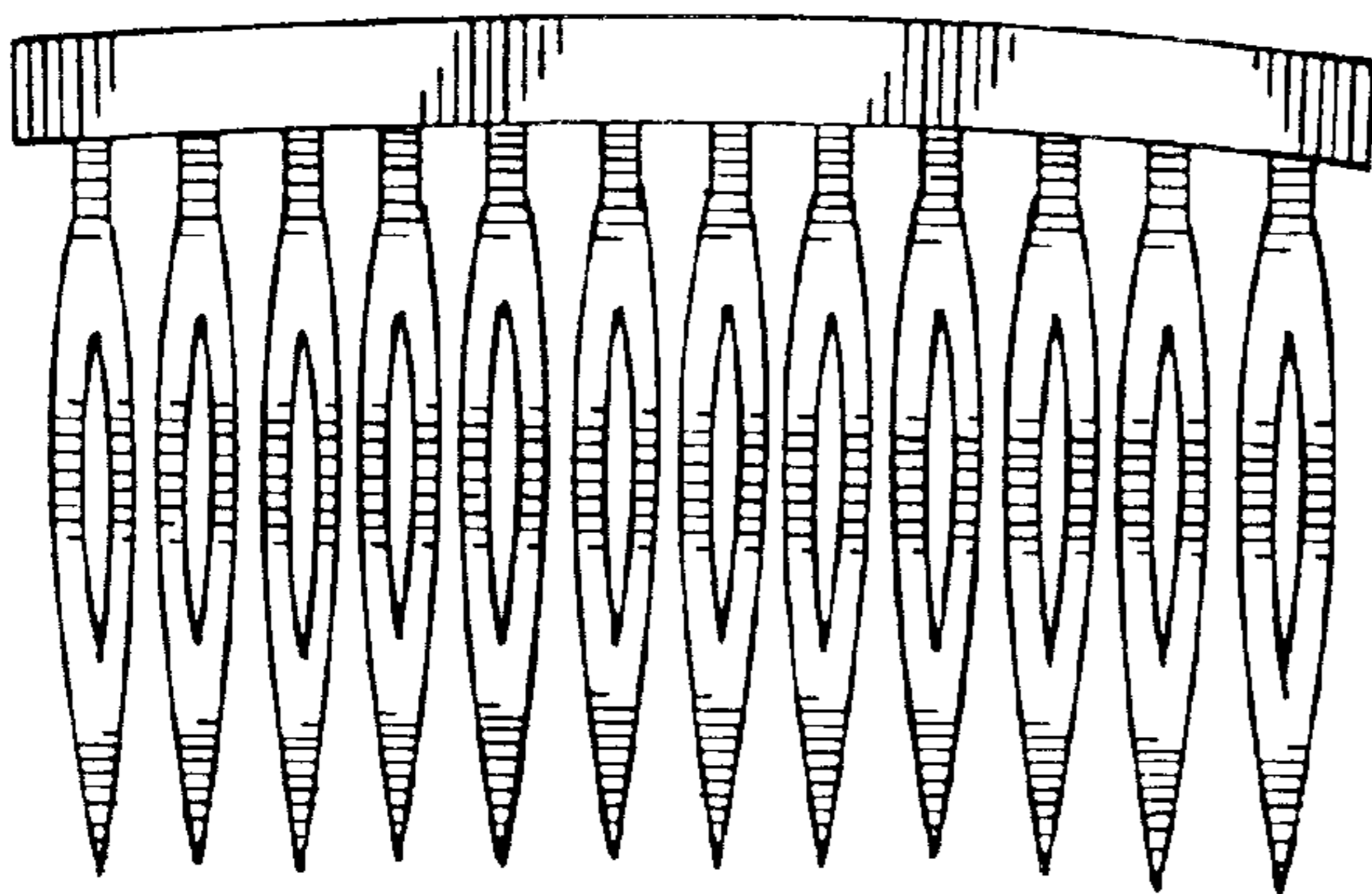

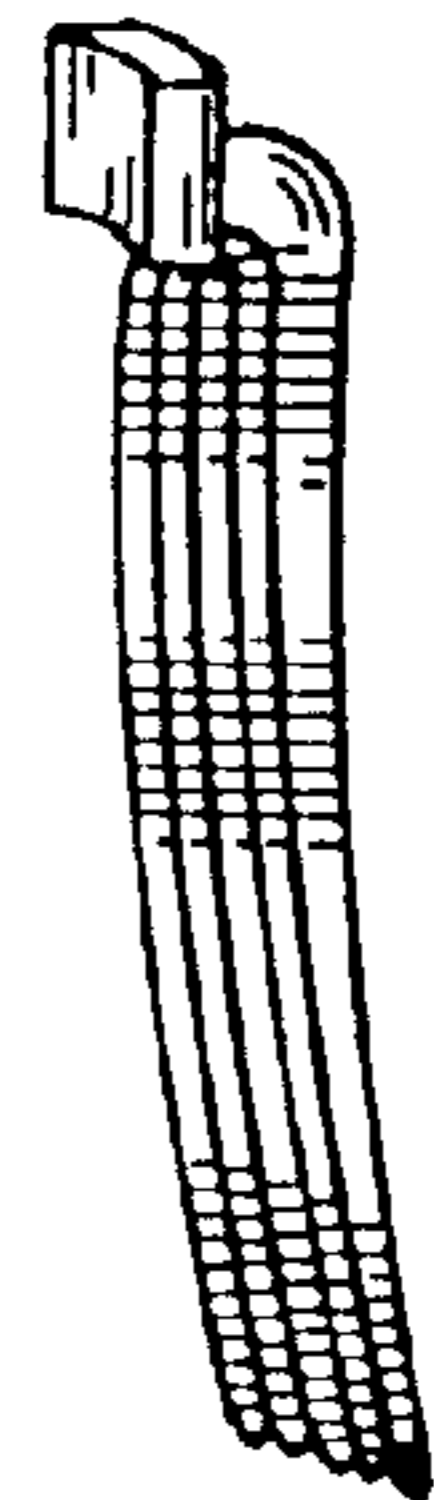
