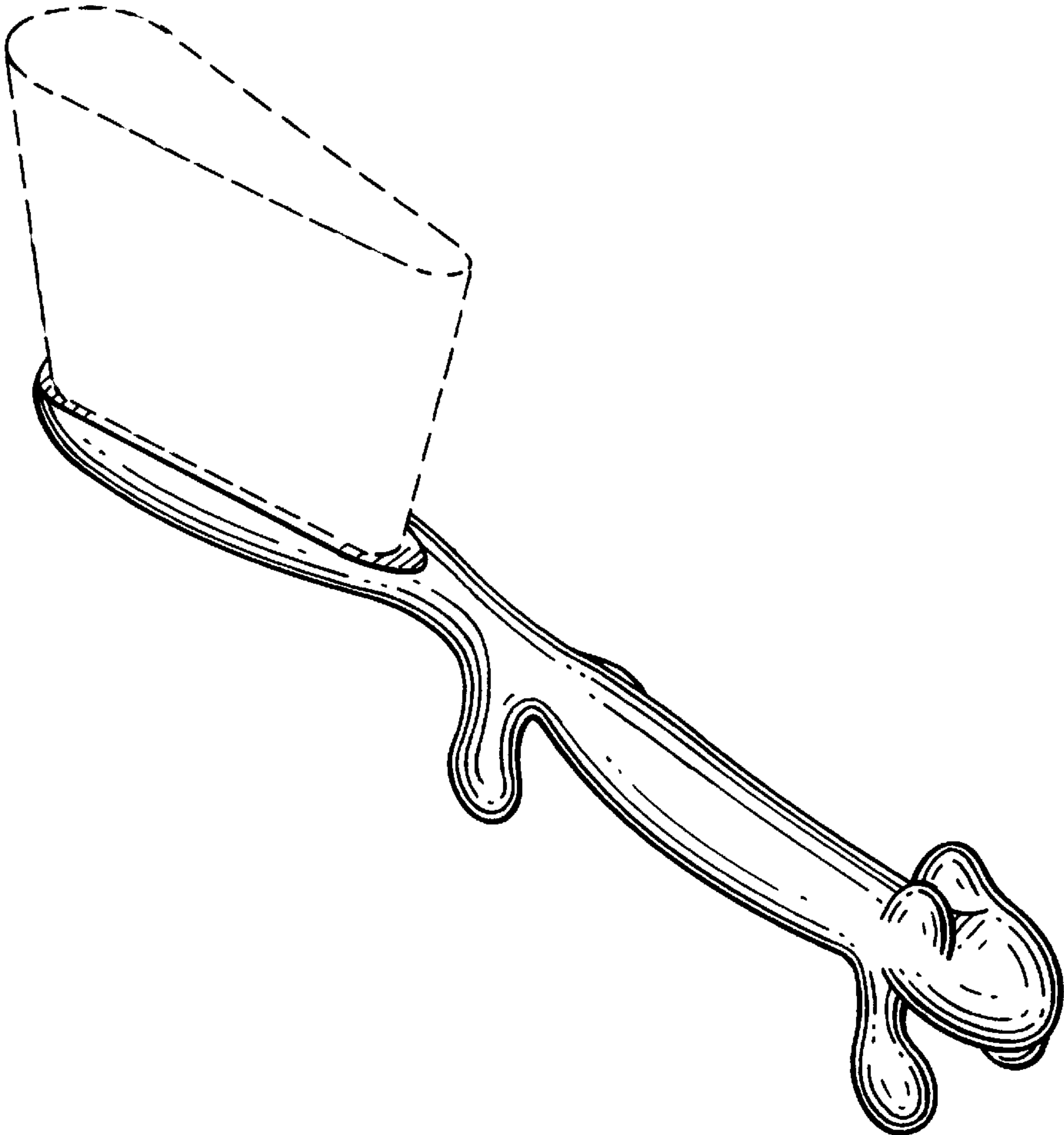
The ornamental design for a broom, as shown and described.

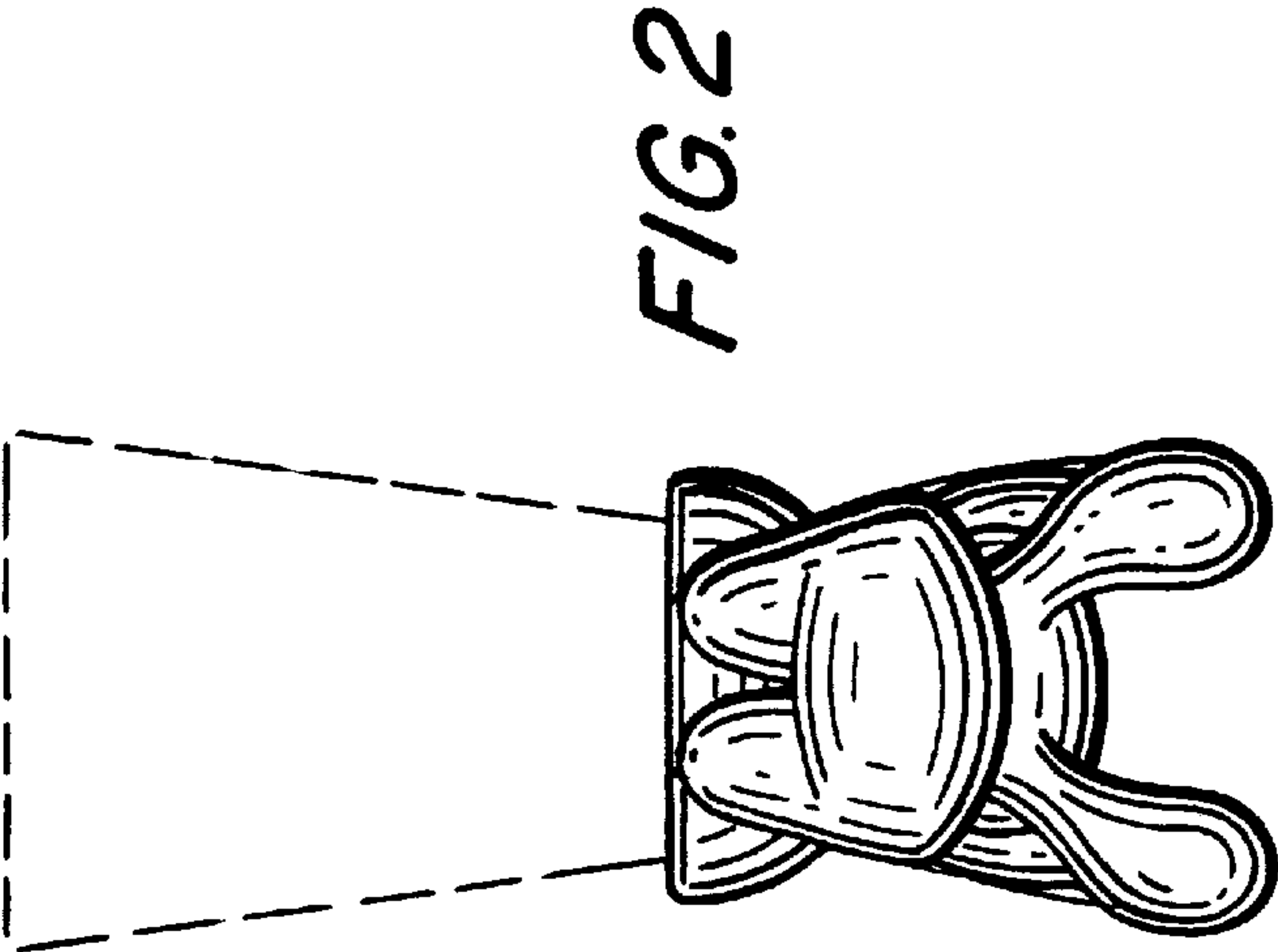
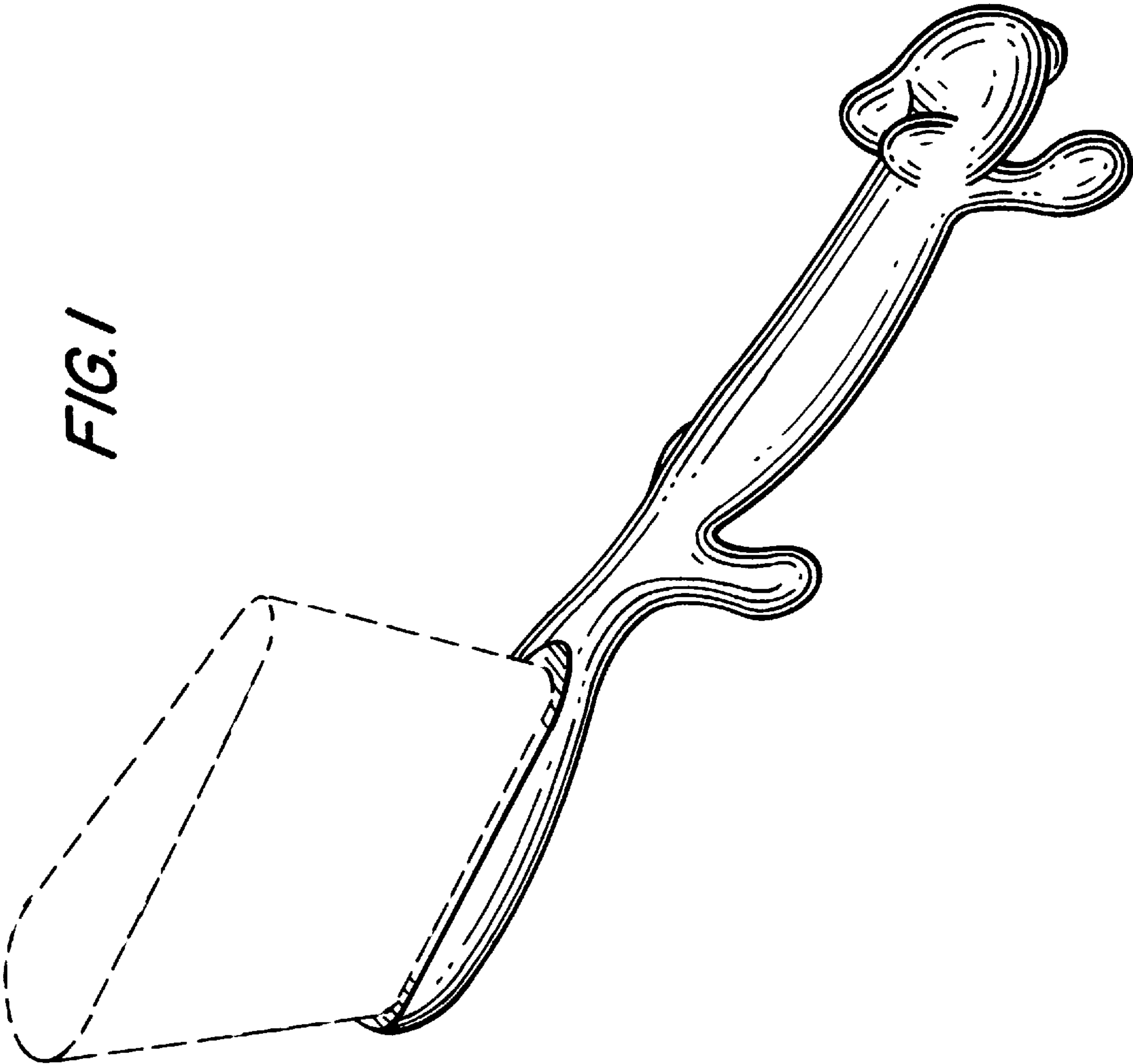
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a broom showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a top view thereof;

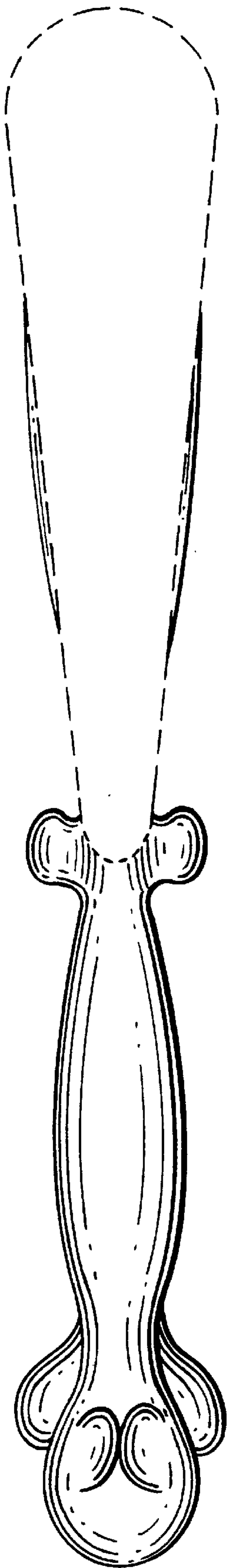

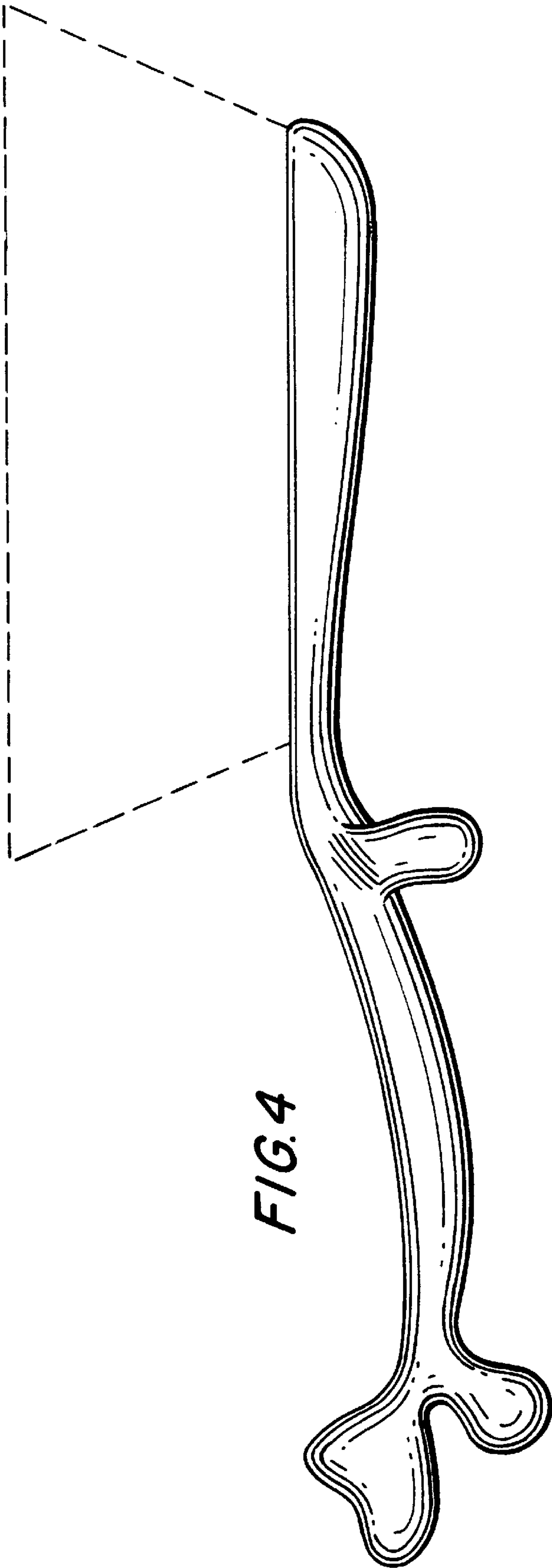

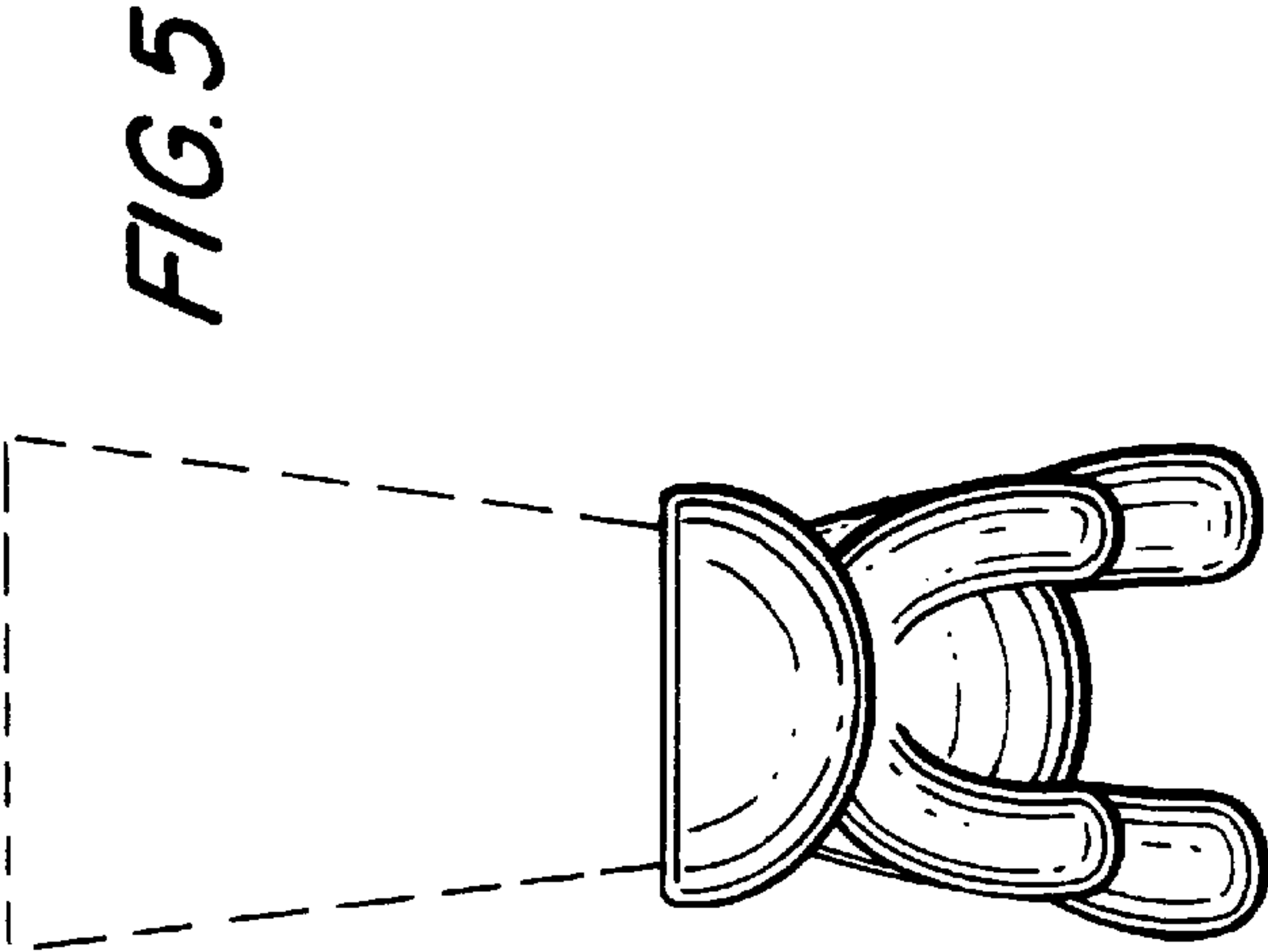
