The ornamental design for a glider, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the glider of the present invention.

FIG. 2 is a side view of the glider of FIG. 1.

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view of the glider of FIG. 1.

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view of the glider of FIG. 1.

FIG. 5 is a top plan view of the glider of FIG. 1; and,

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of the glider of FIG. 1.

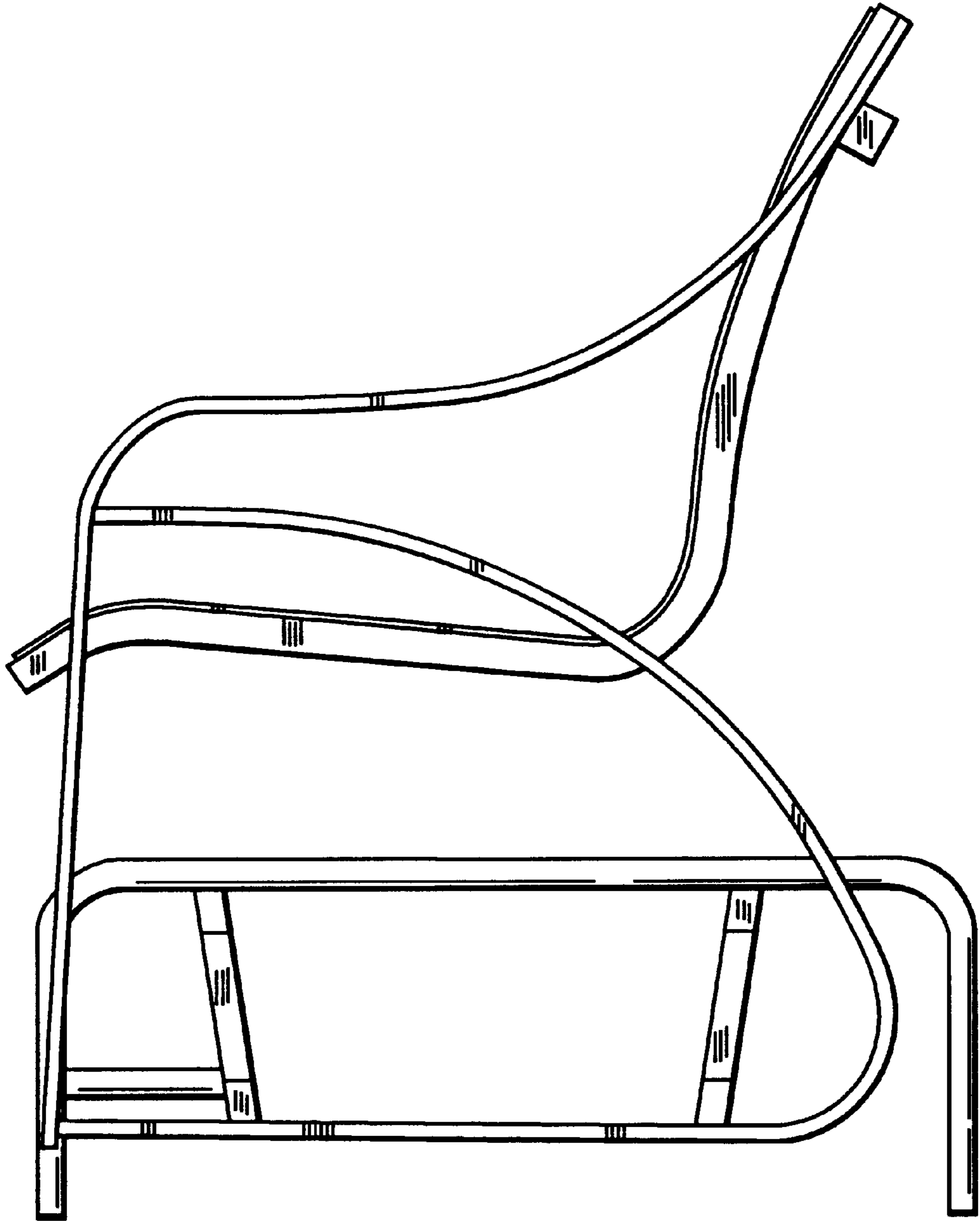
The broken line showing of the seat member of FIGS. 1 and 6 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

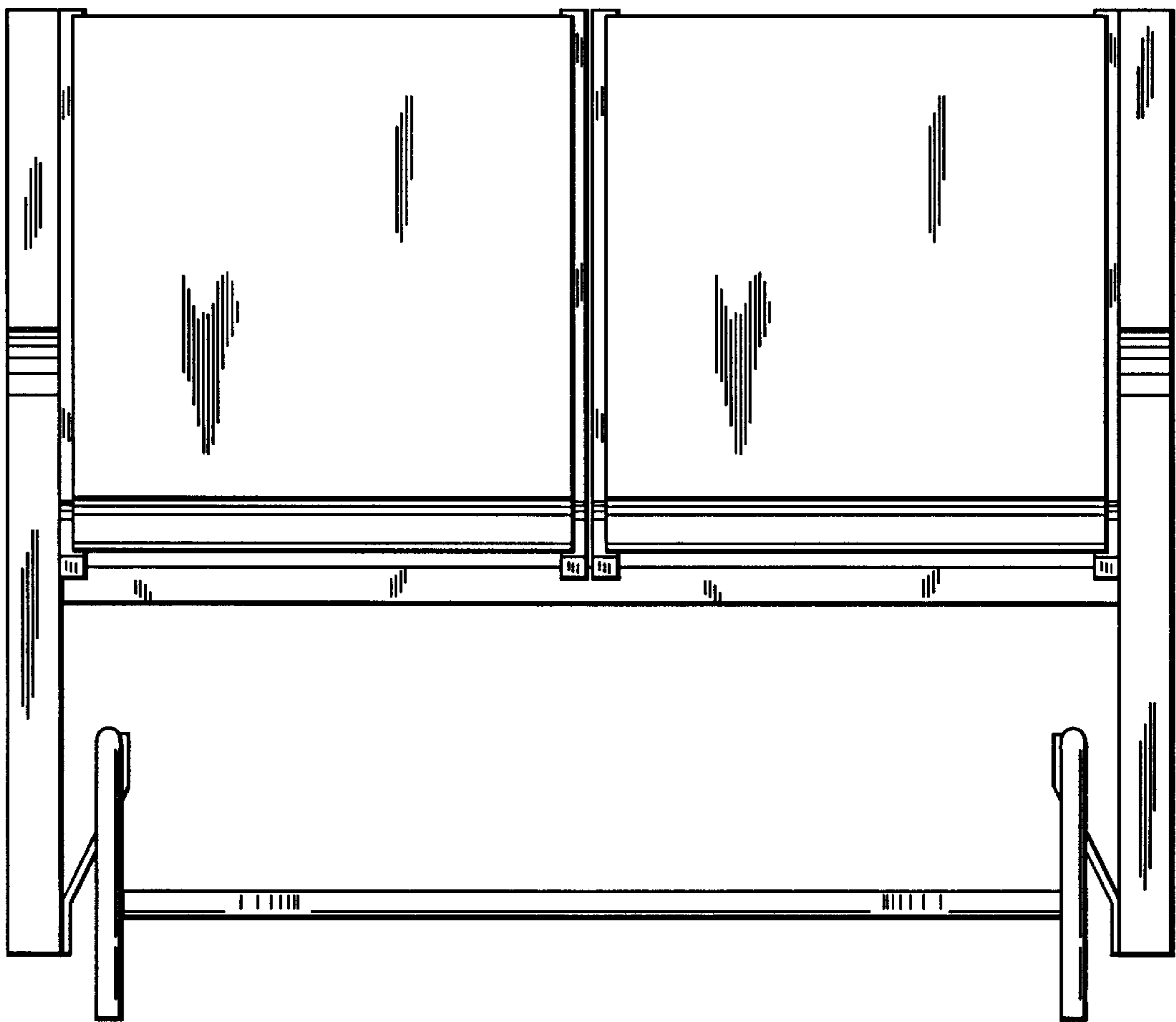




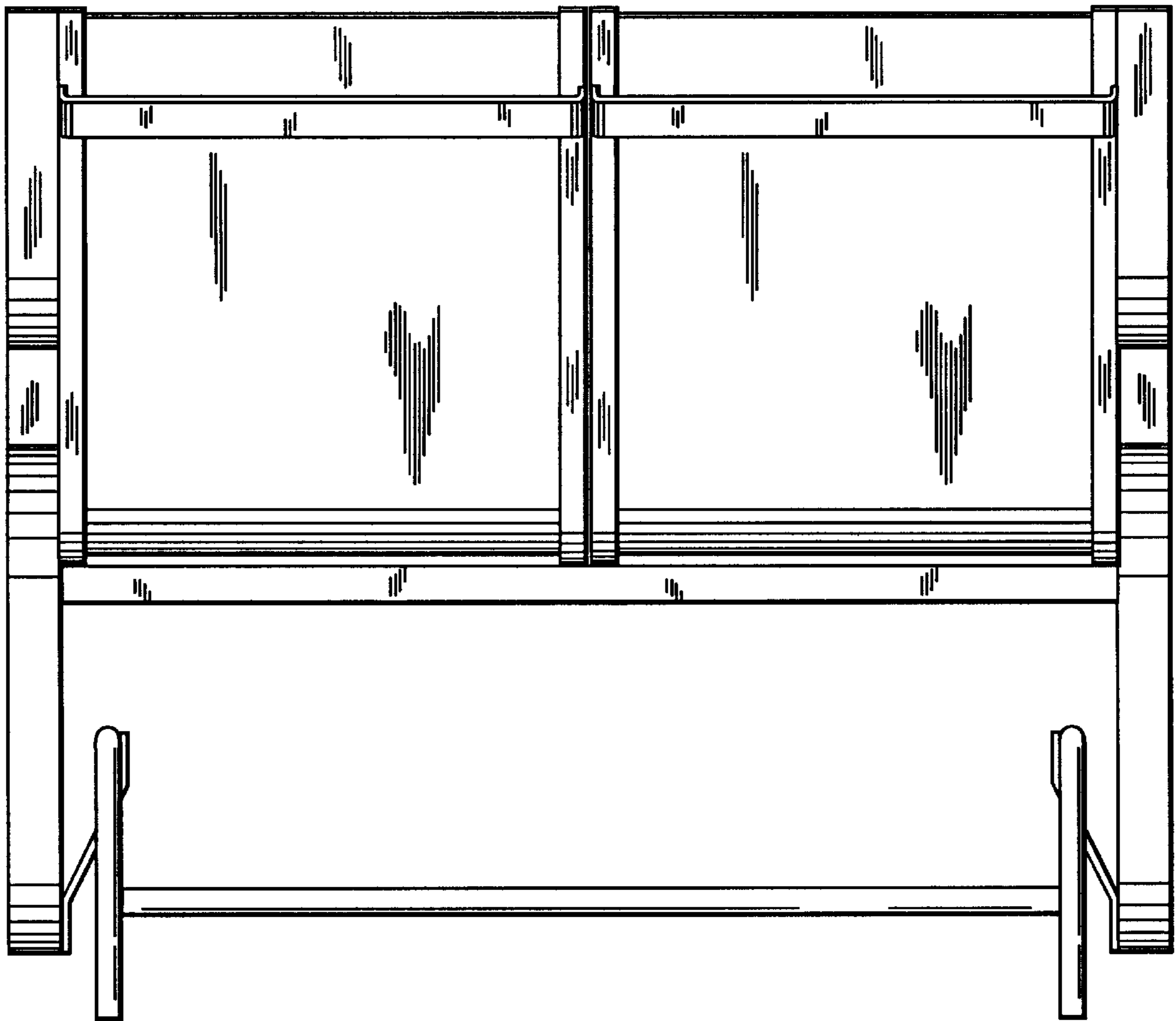

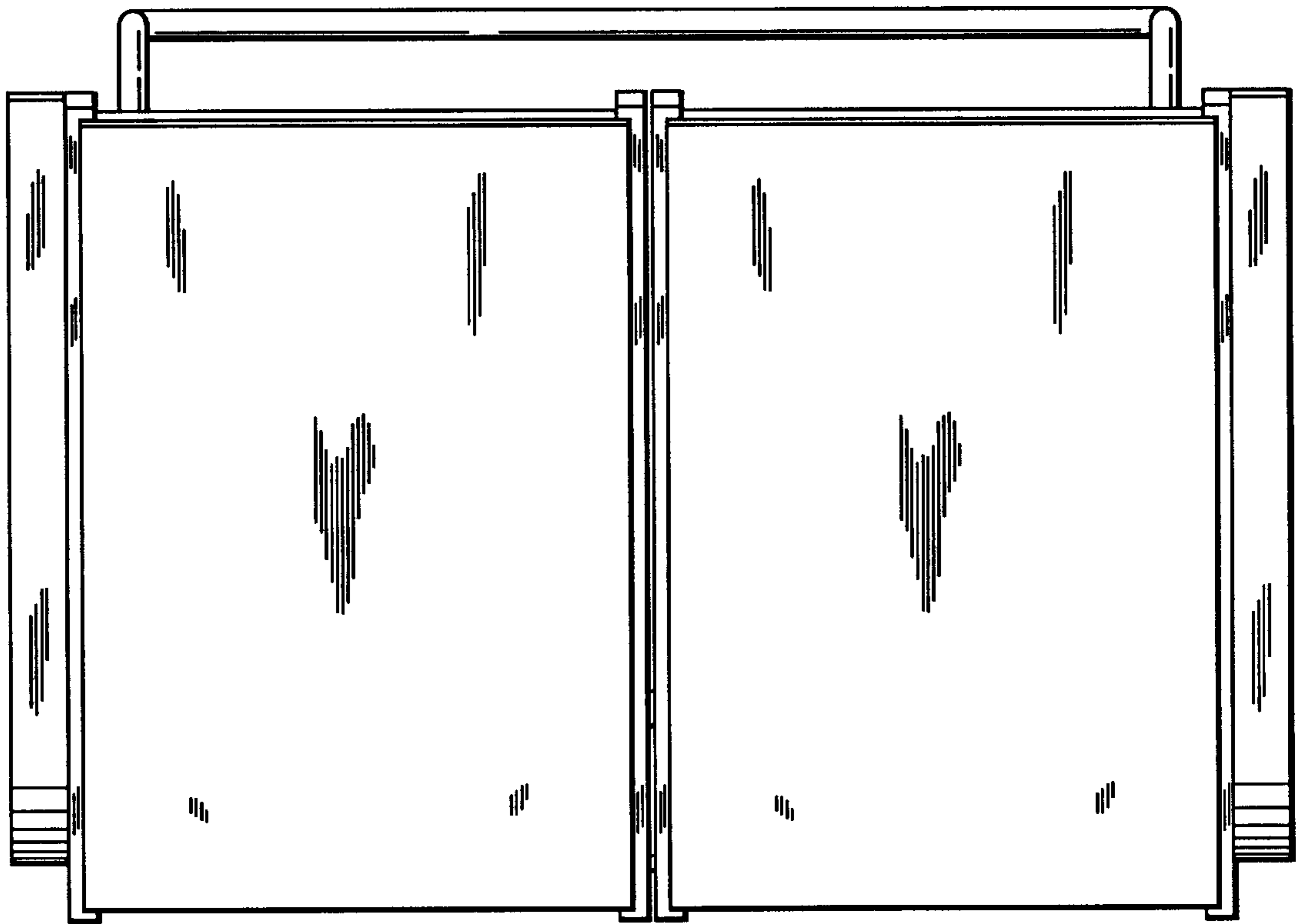

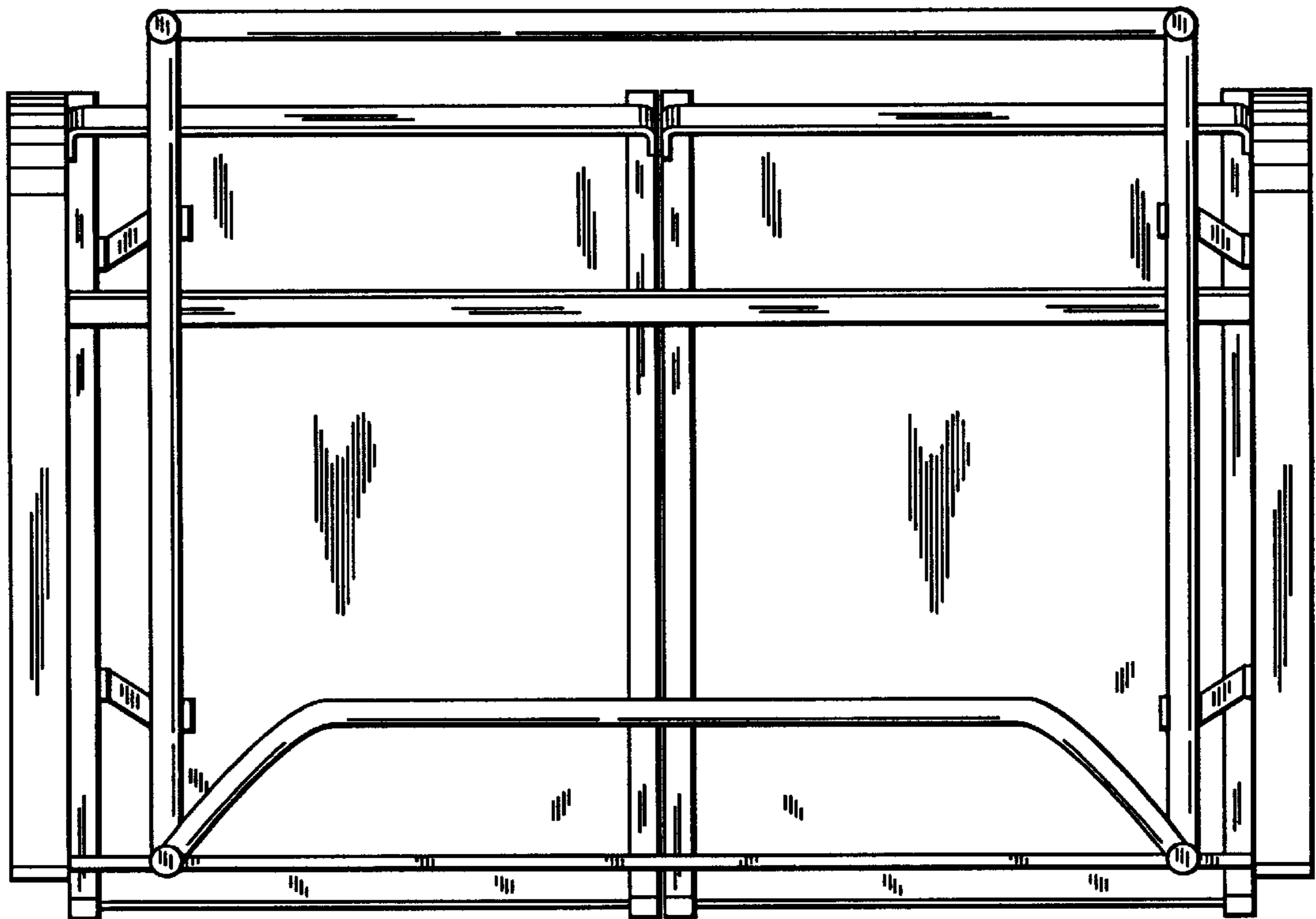
