DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a patio chair embodying the present design;

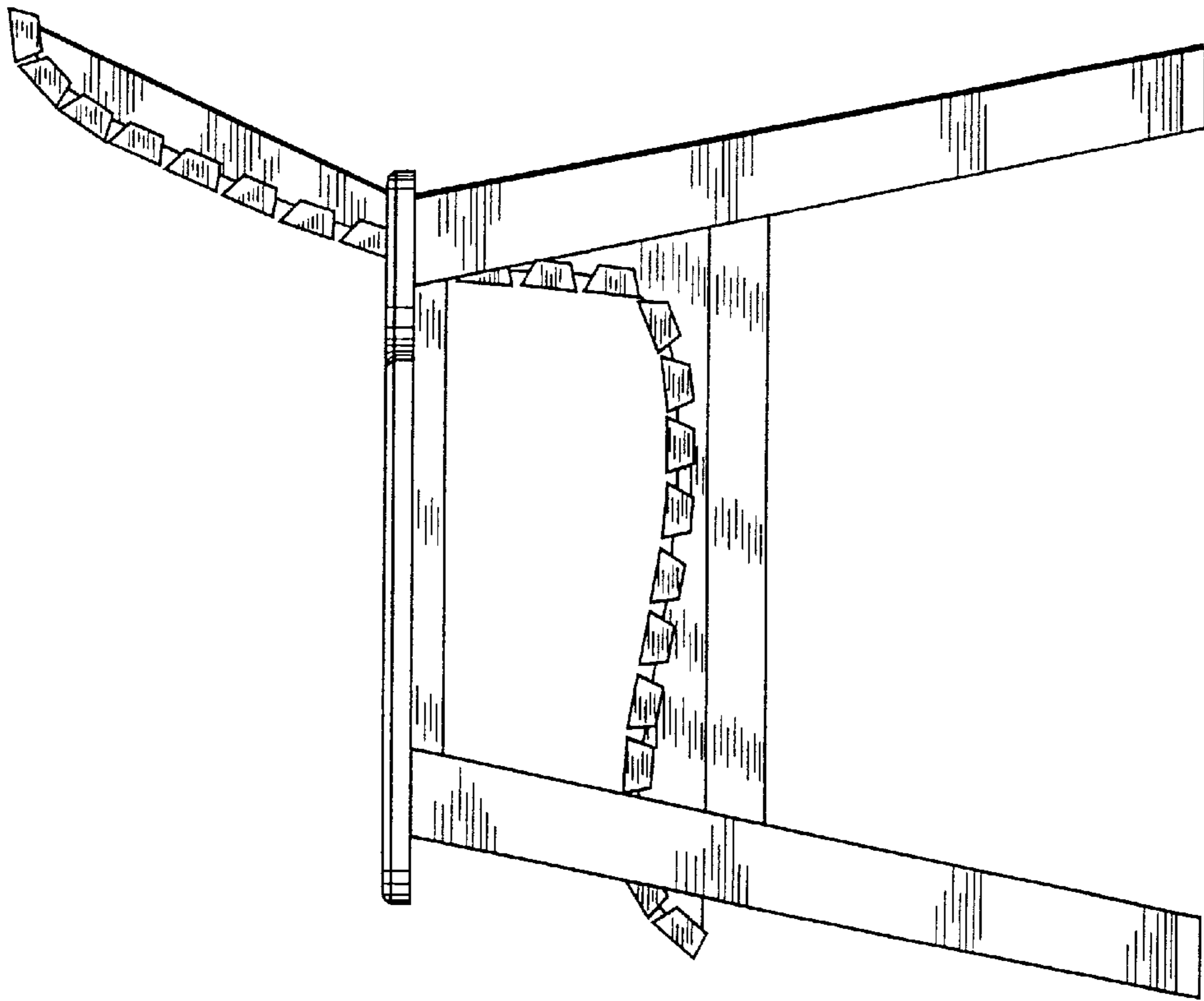

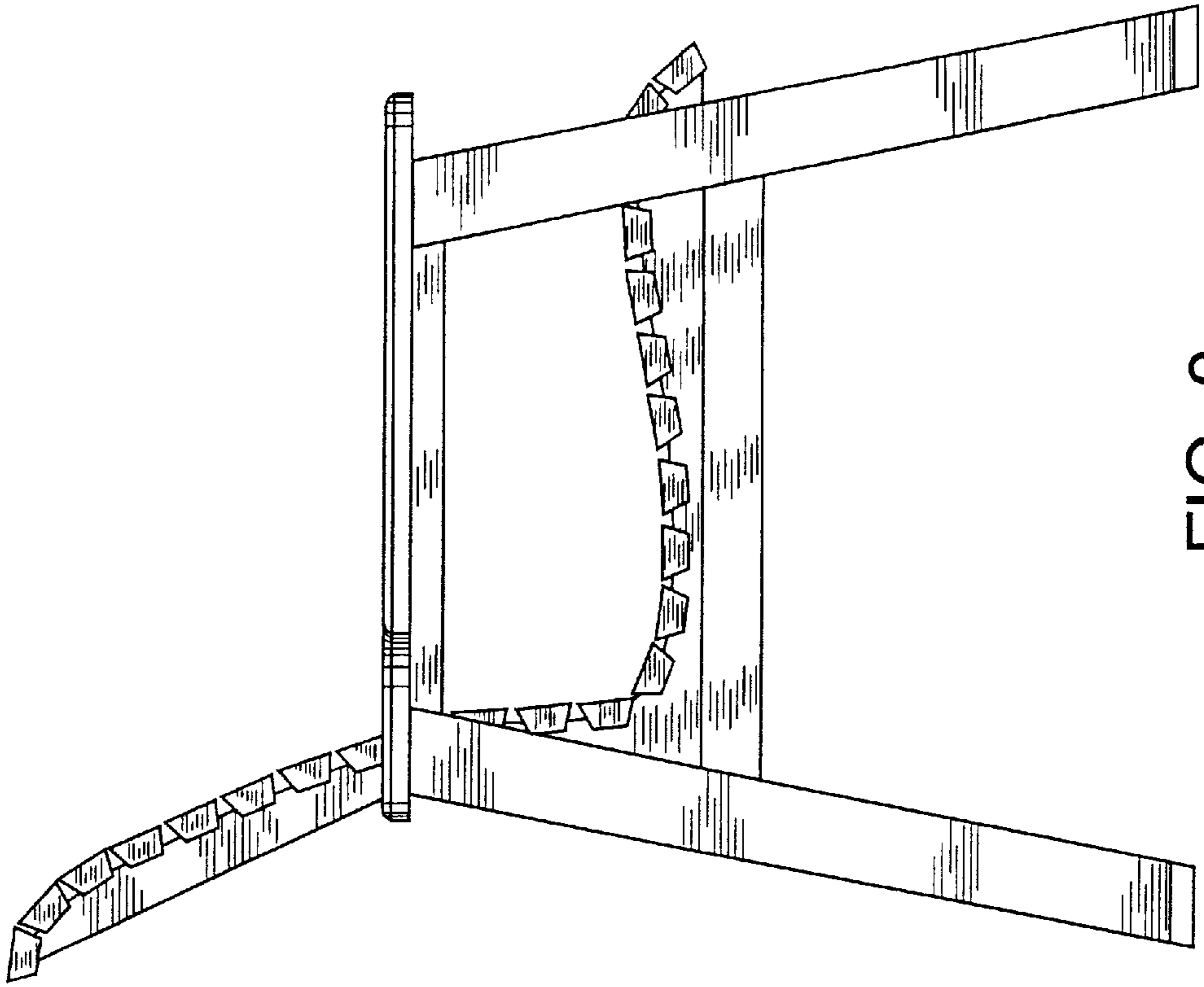

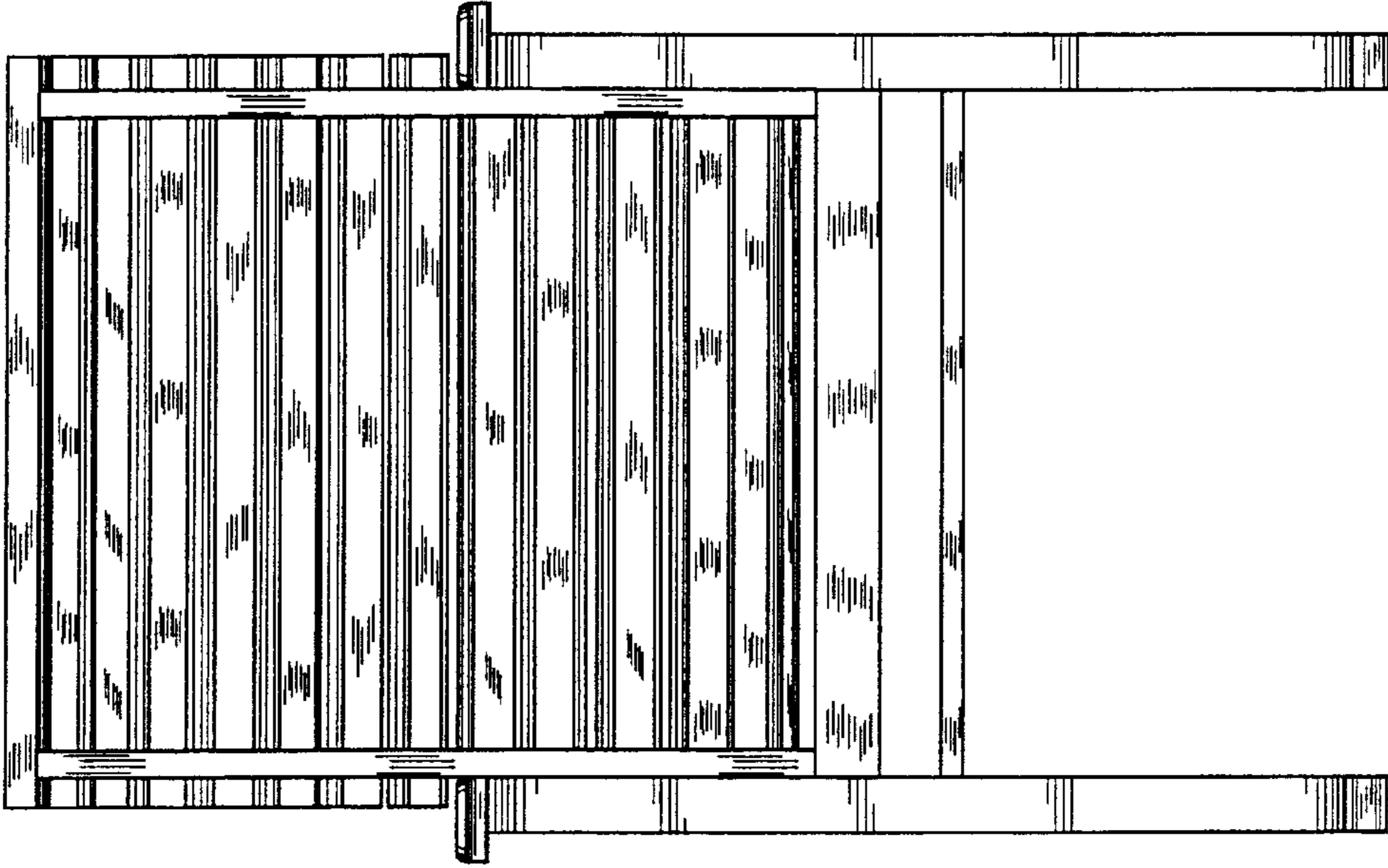

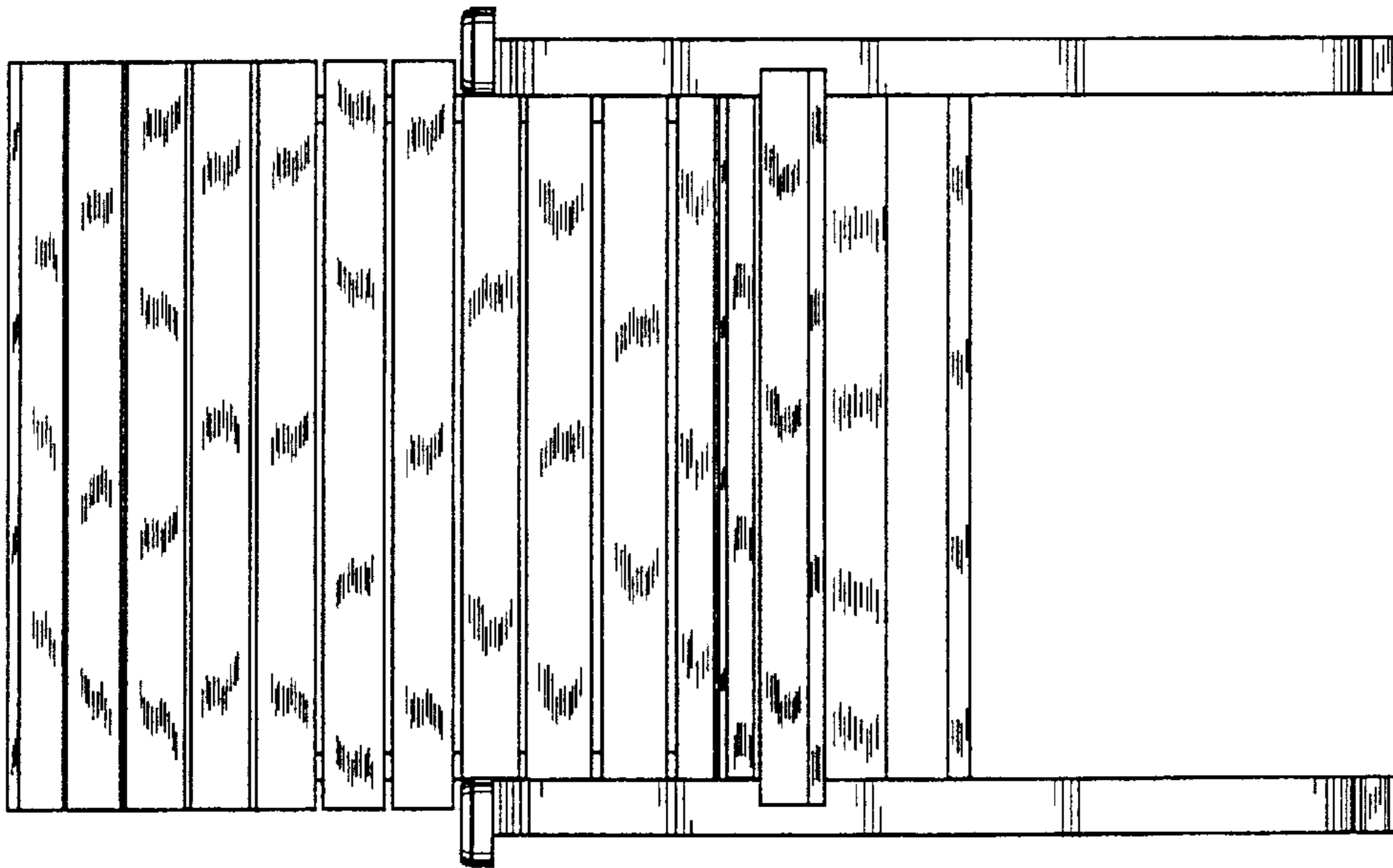

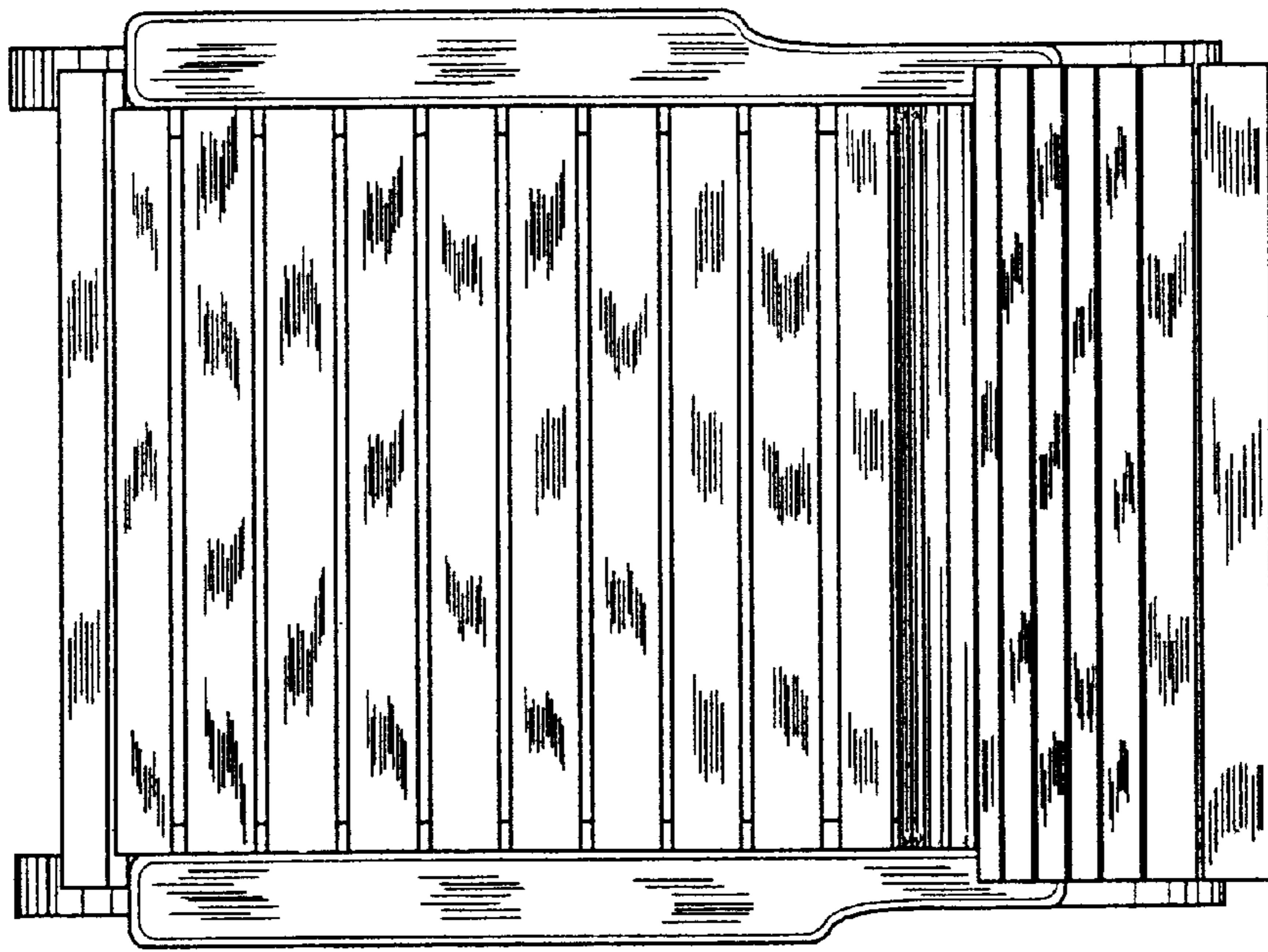

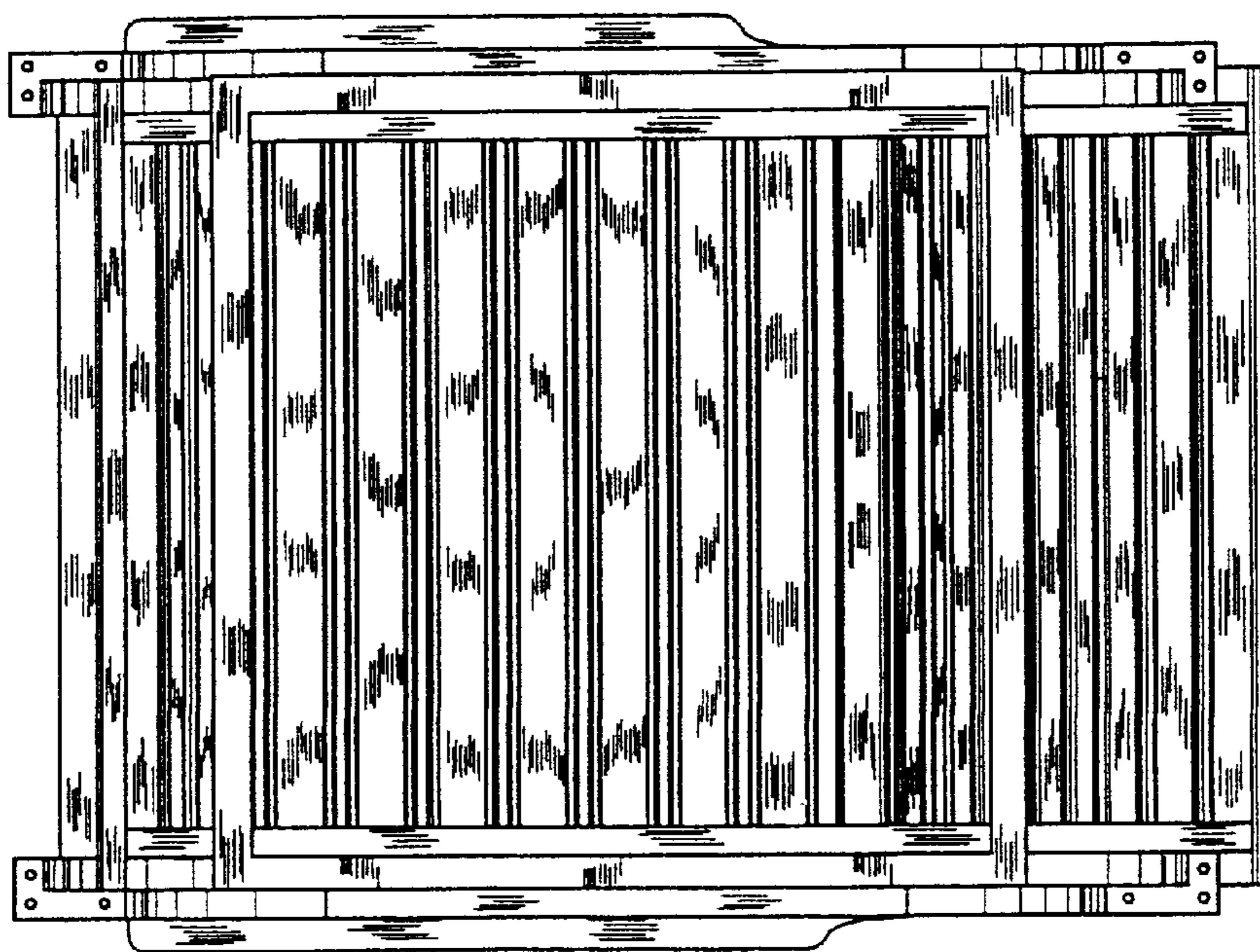
