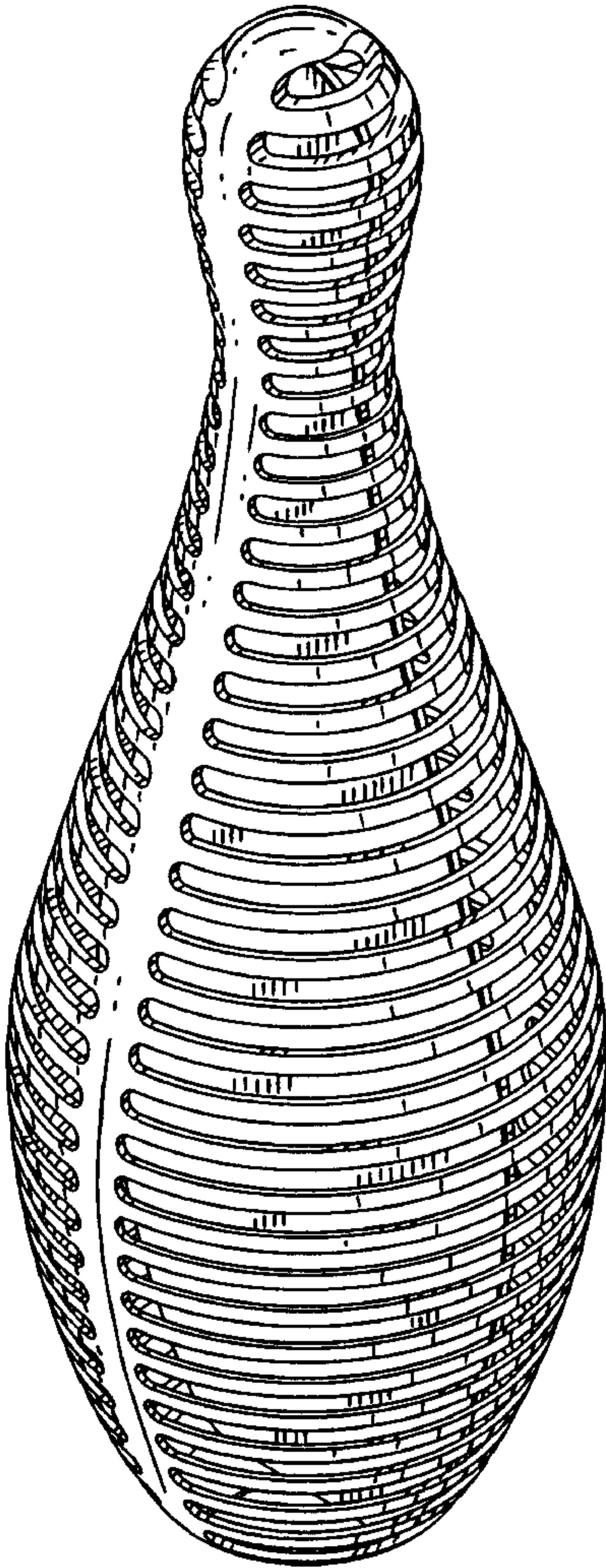
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front and right-side perspective view showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a reduced top plan view thereof;

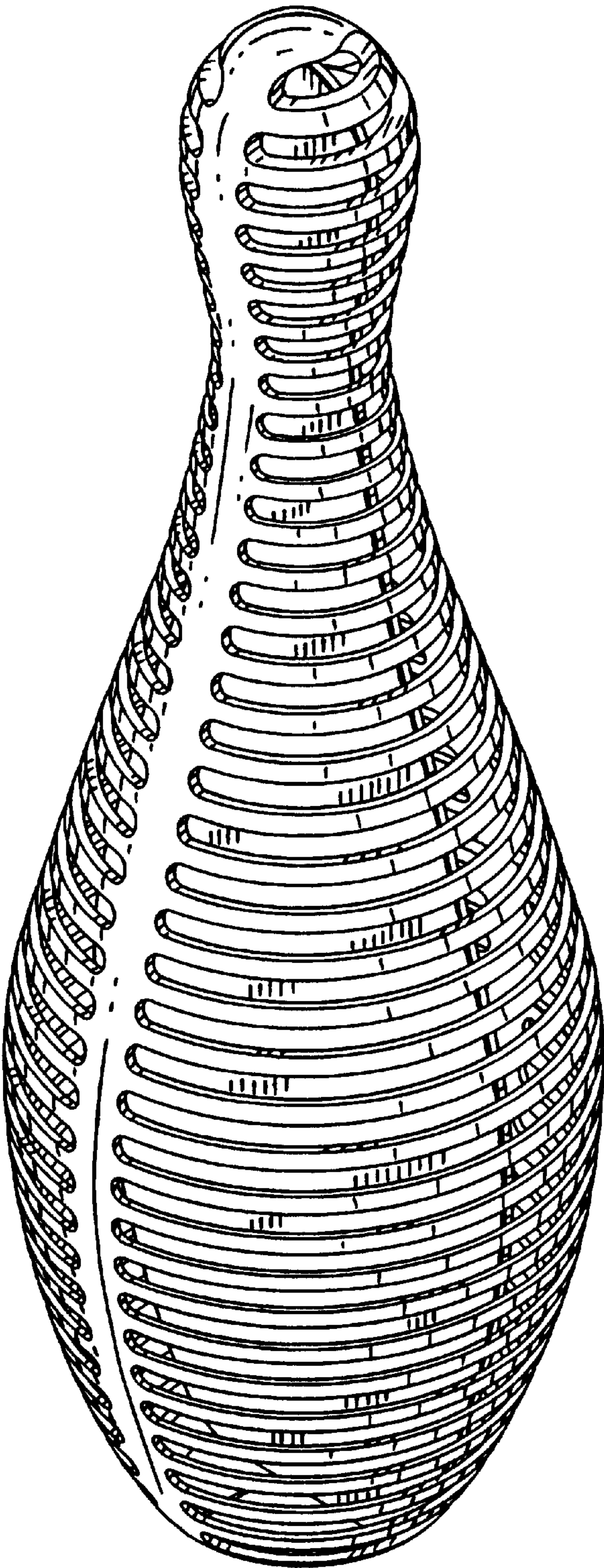

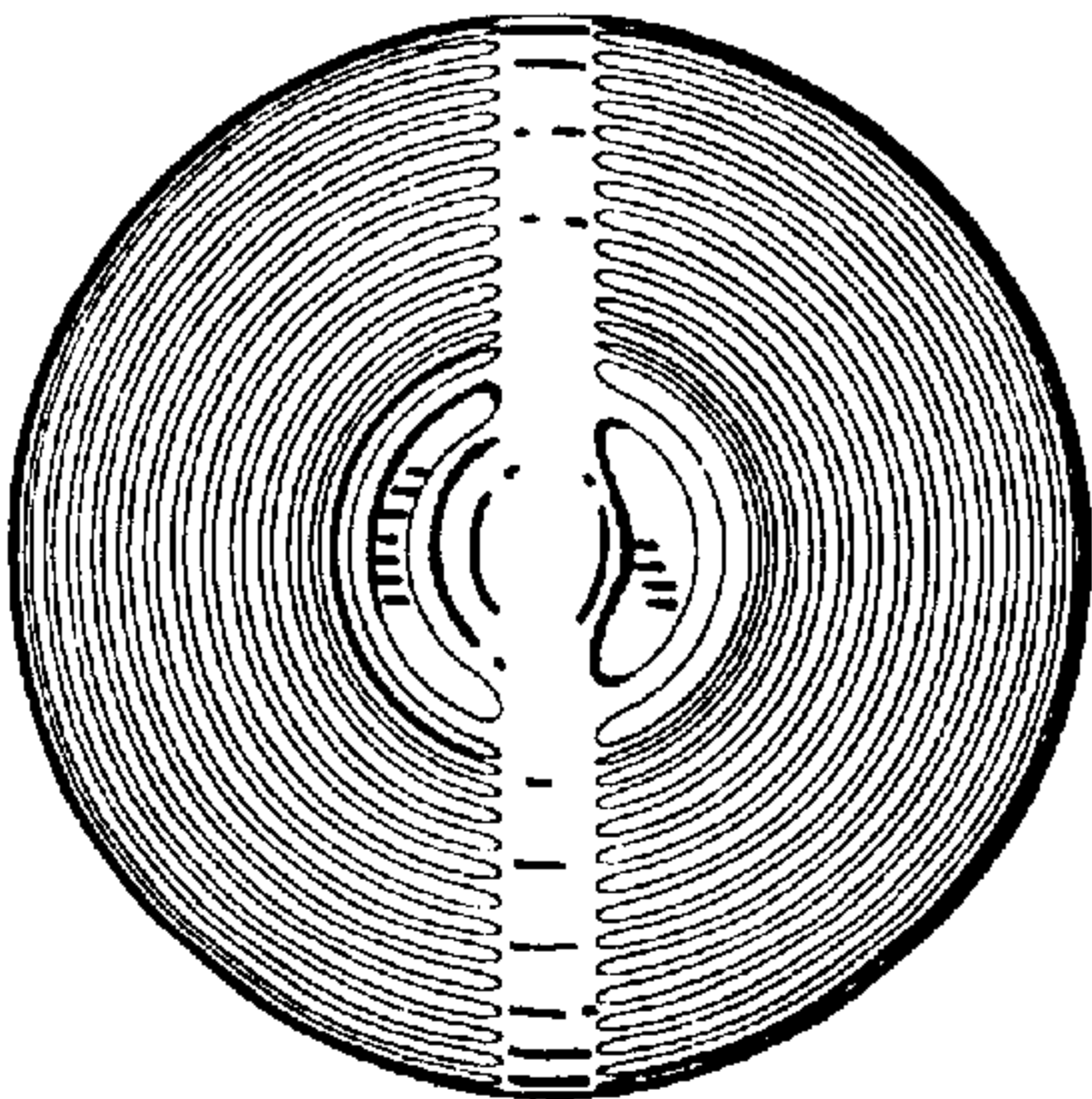

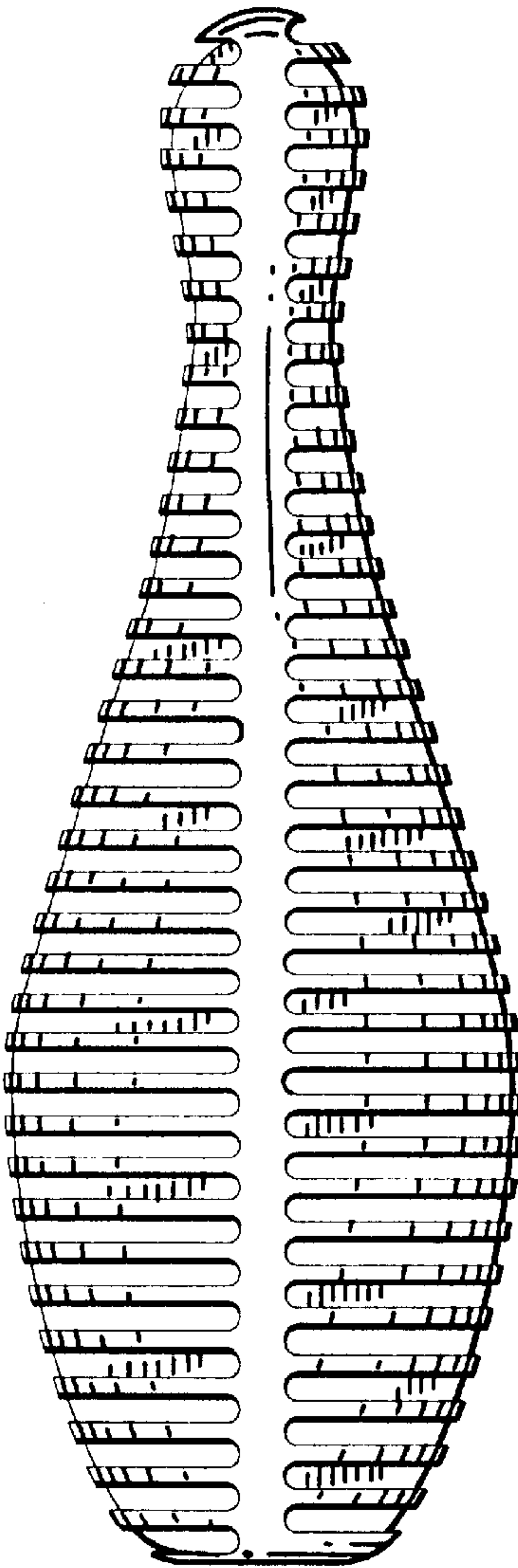

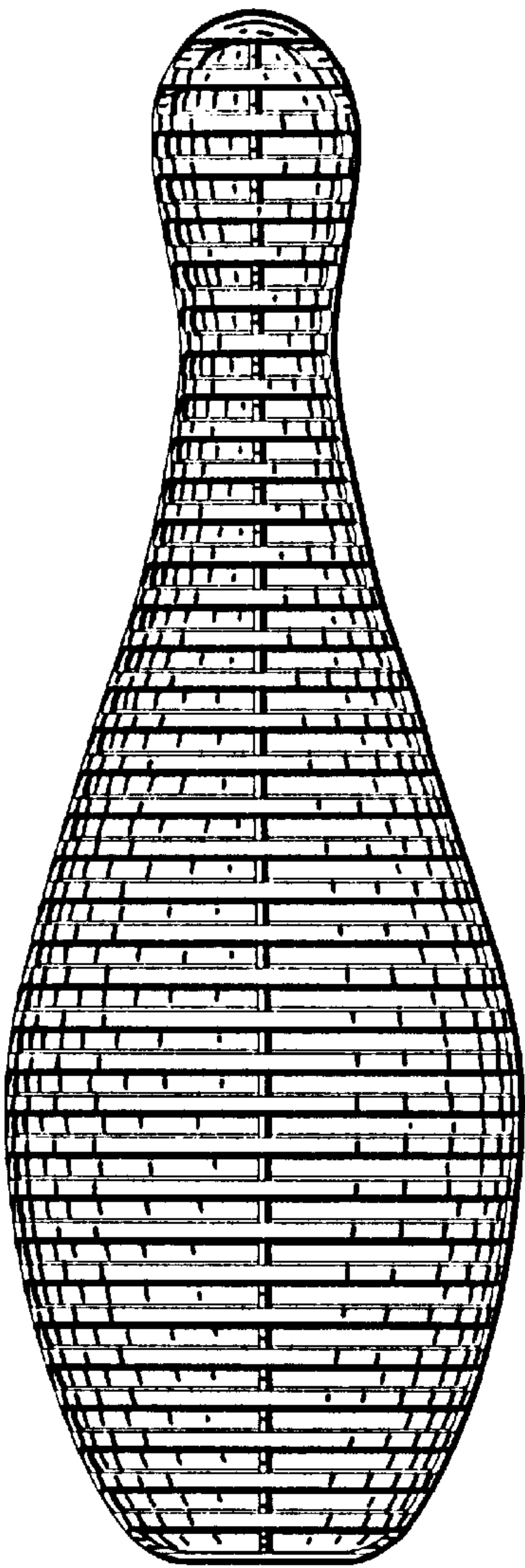

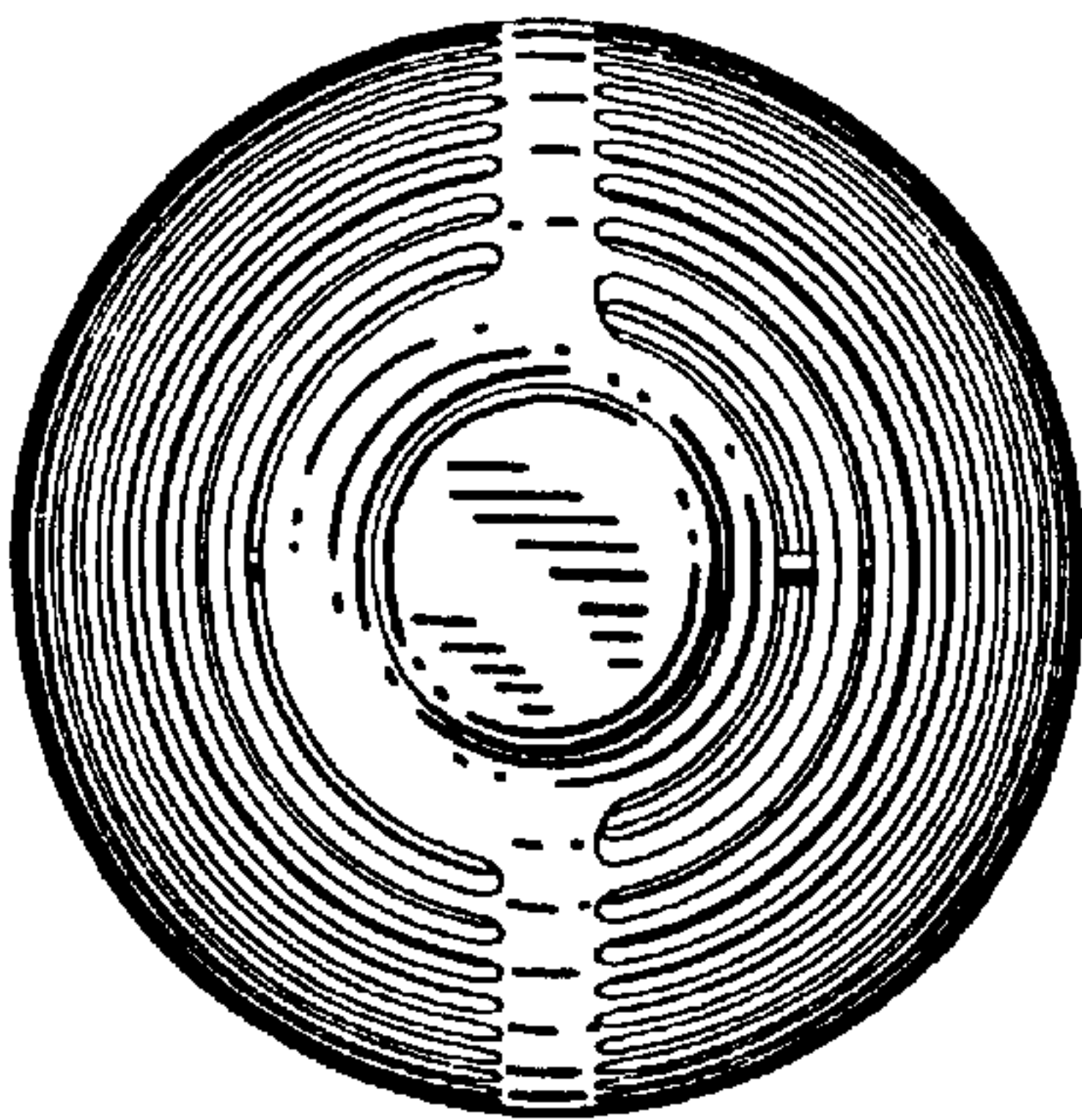

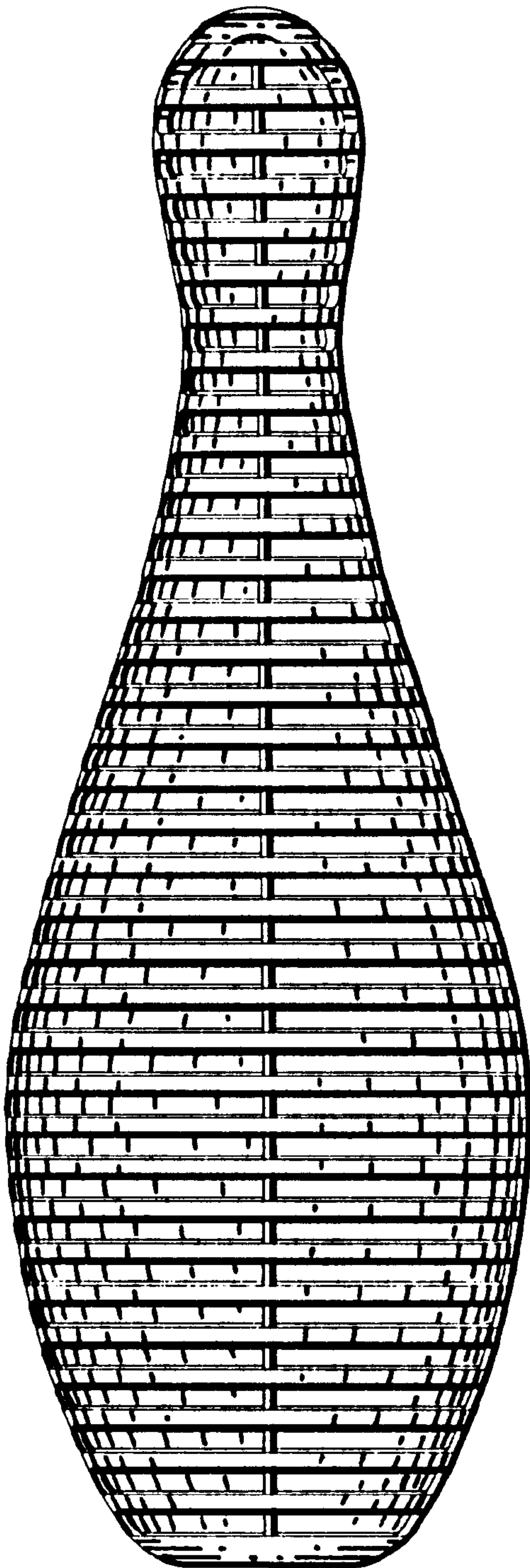
