The ornamental design for a carry bag, as shown and described.

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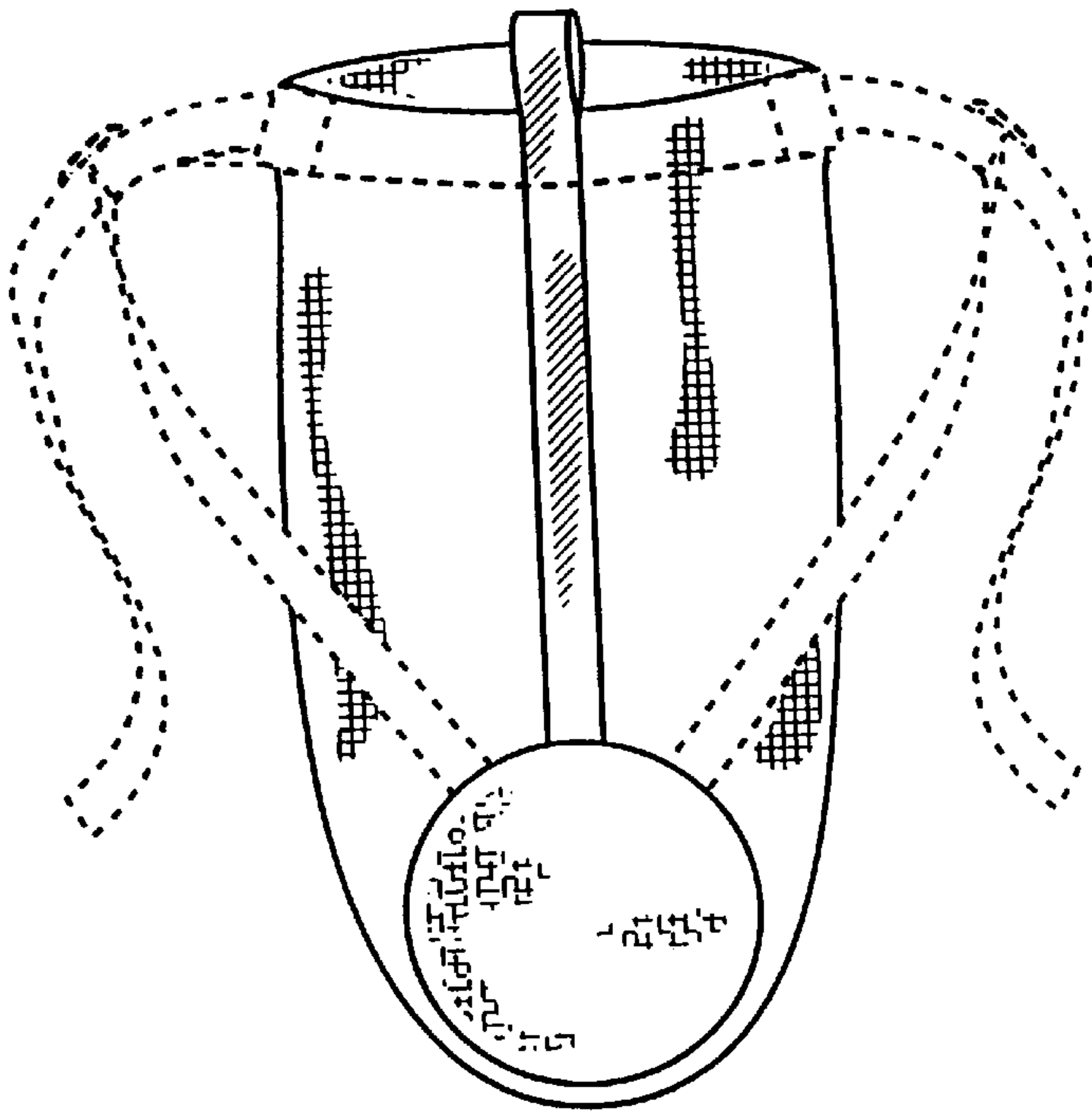
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DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a carry bag;
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a left side view thereof, the right side view being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a front elevational view of a second embodiment of the carry bag of FIGS. 1–5, illustrating further ornamentation on the front surface thereof; and,
FIG. 7 is a rear elevational view of a third embodiment of the carry bag of FIGS. 1–5.

The broken lines shown in the figures, including the carry straps or cords, the hardware, in other words, the buckles and zipper, and the position of the attachments of such elements to the carry bag, illustrate the environment only and form no part of the claimed design.

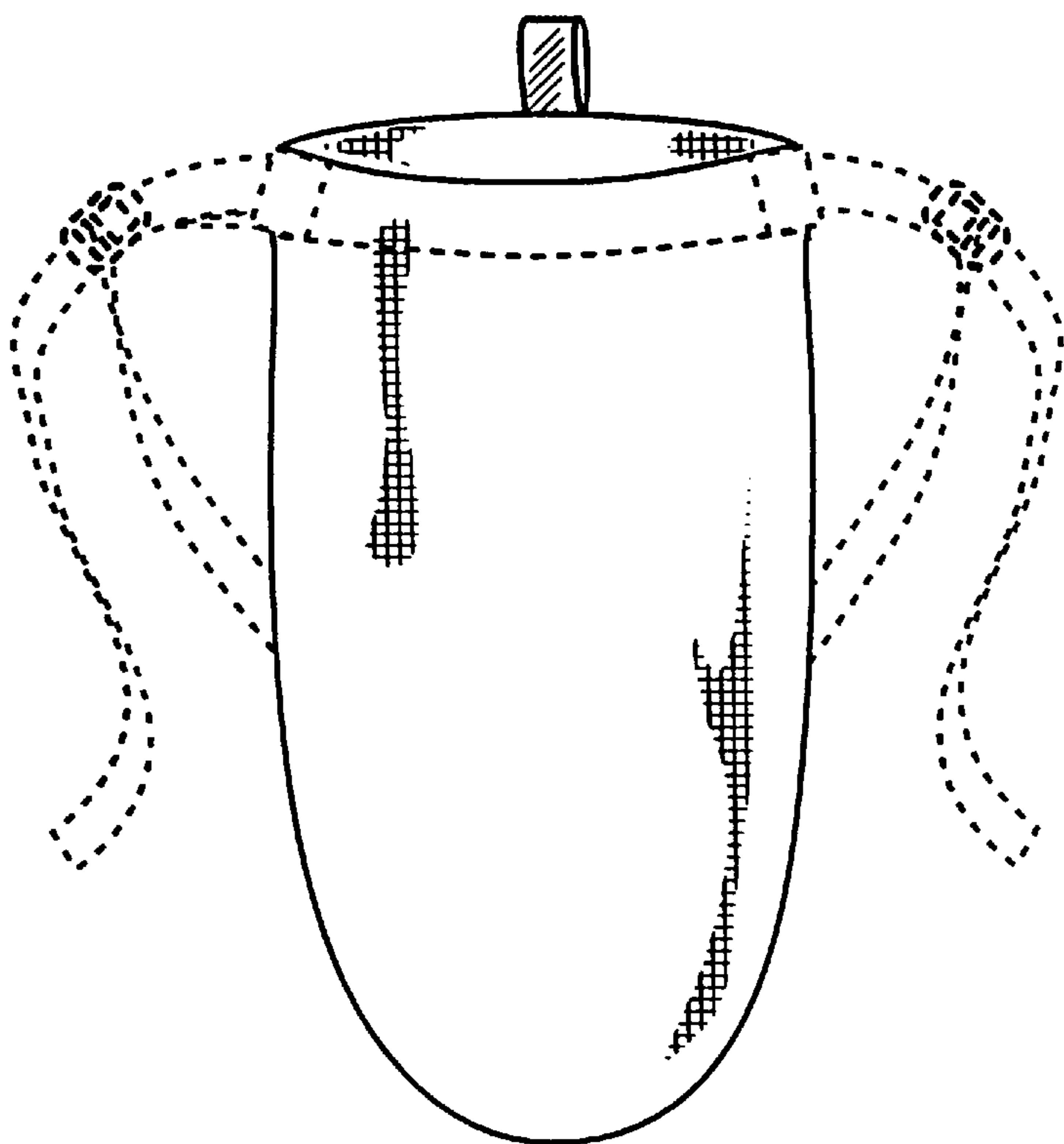

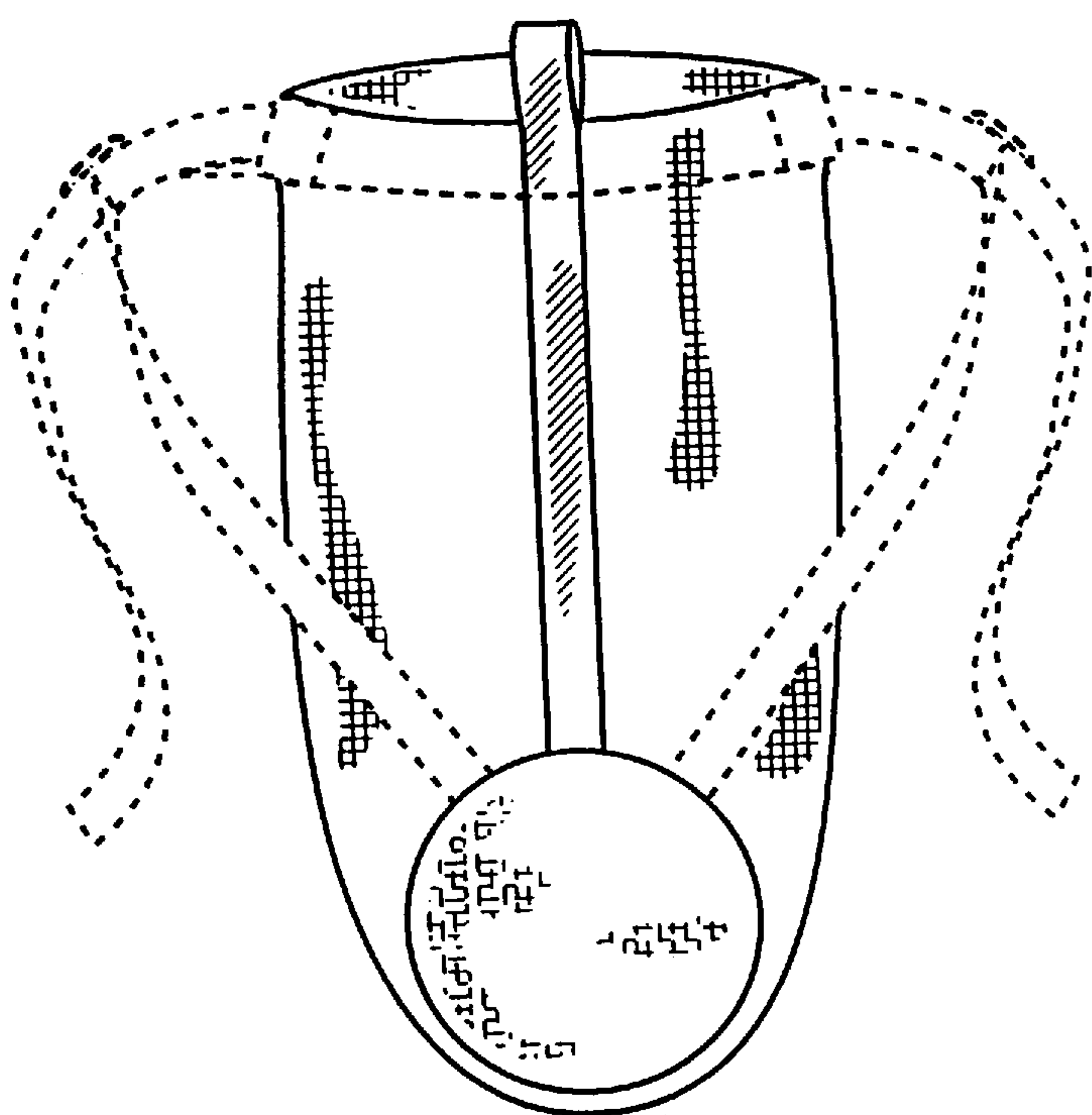

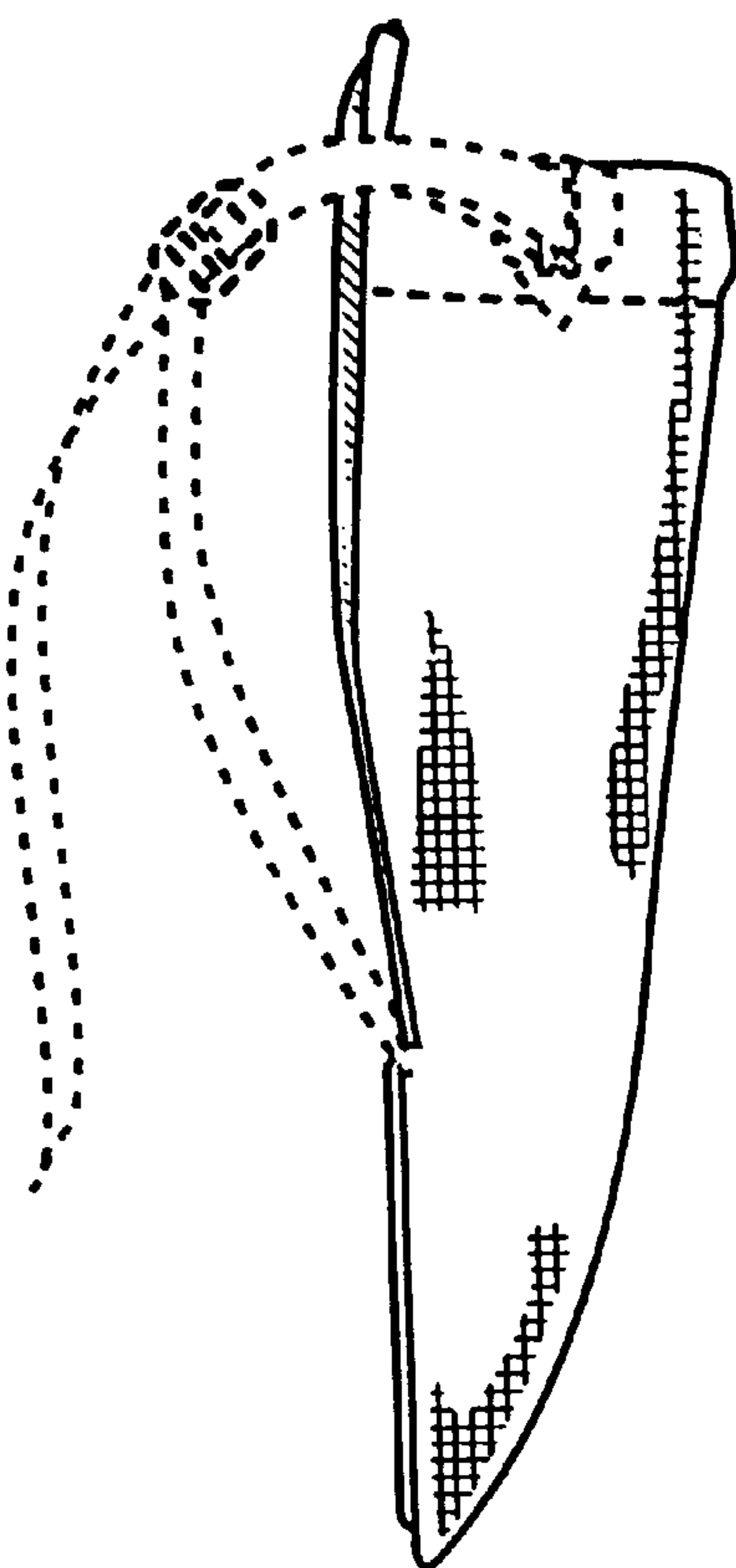

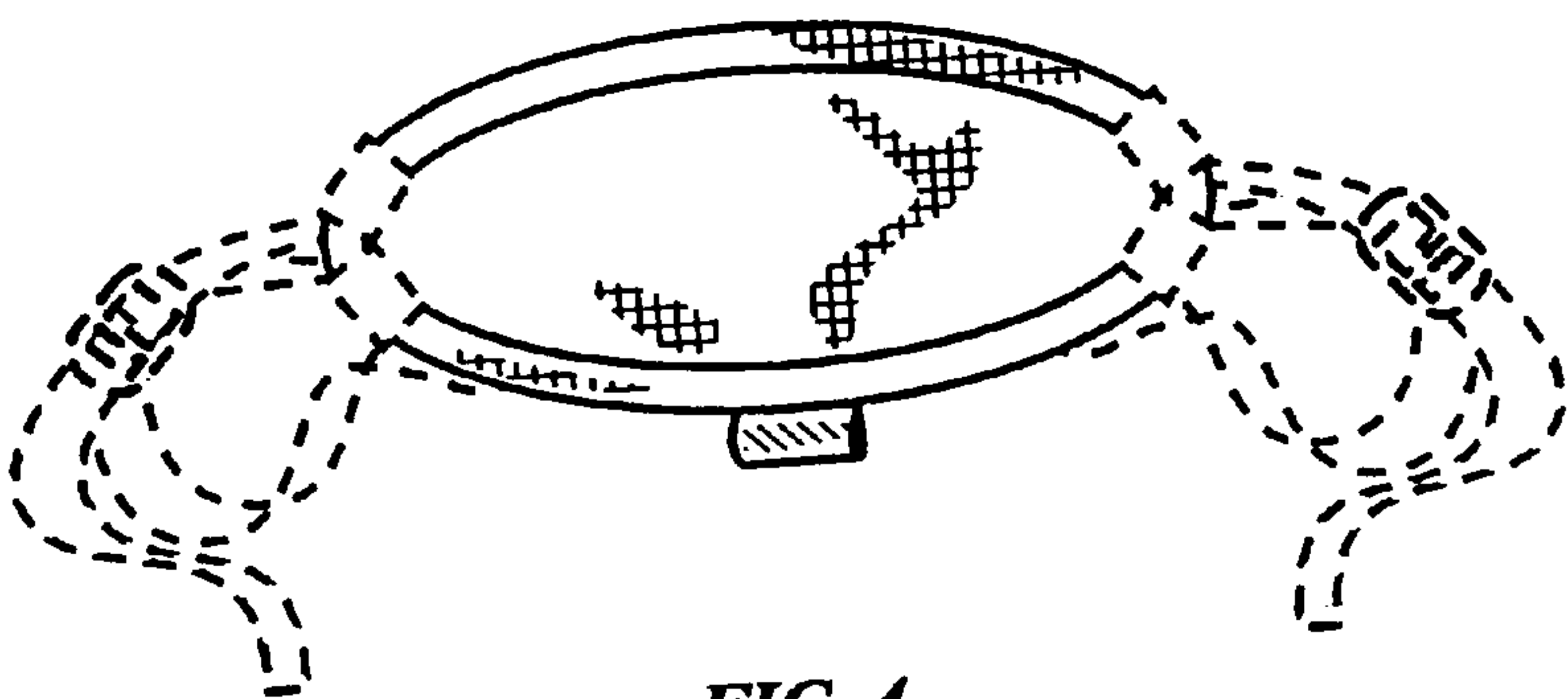

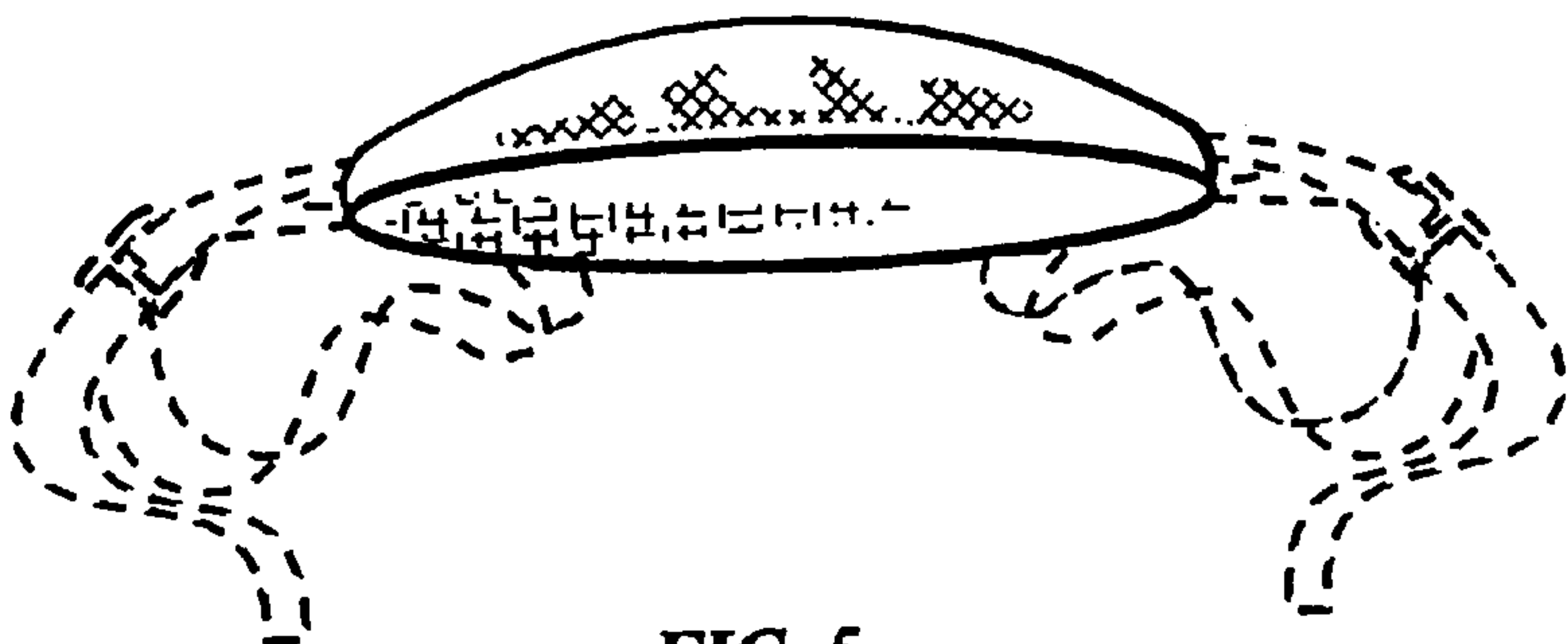

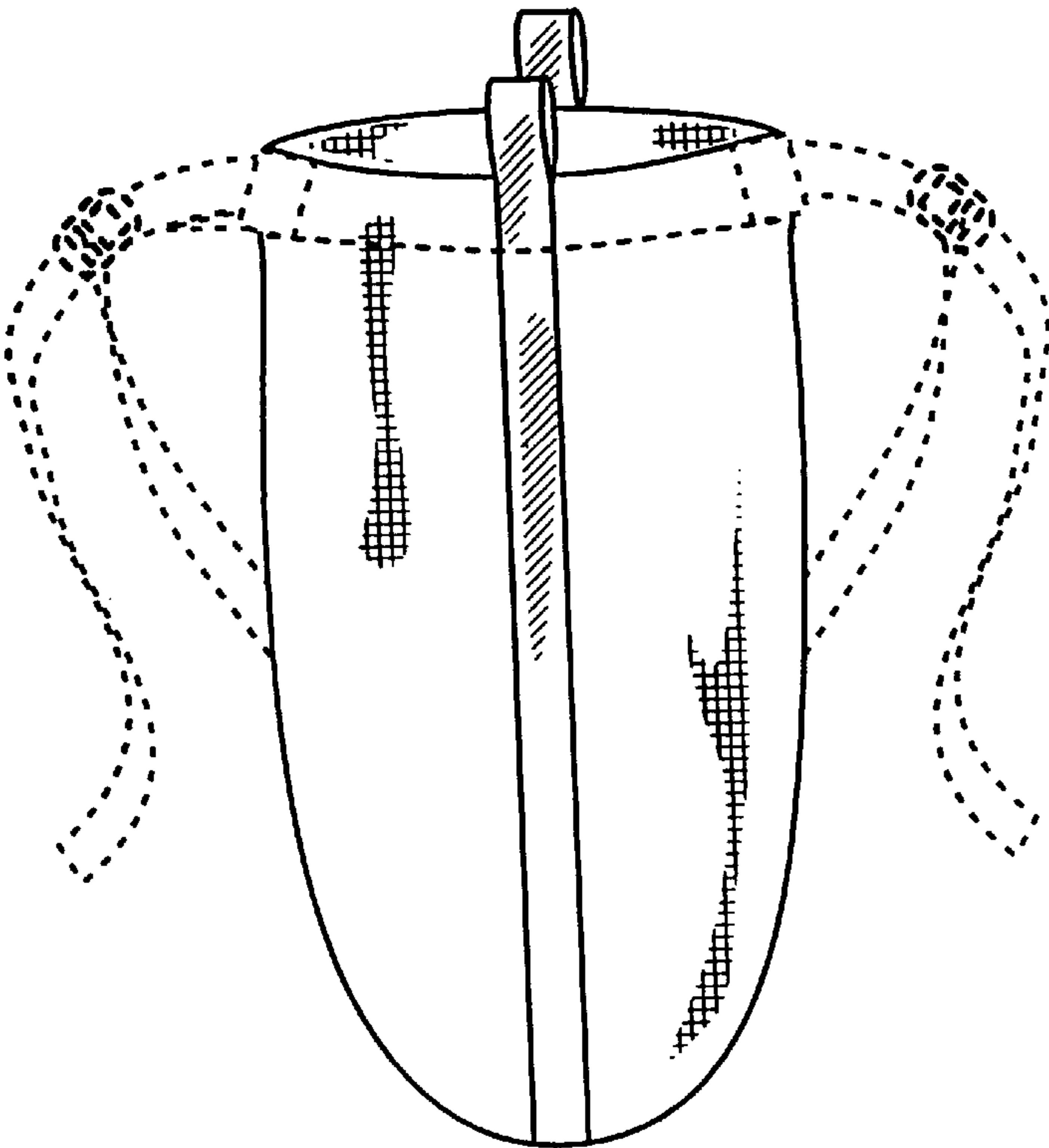

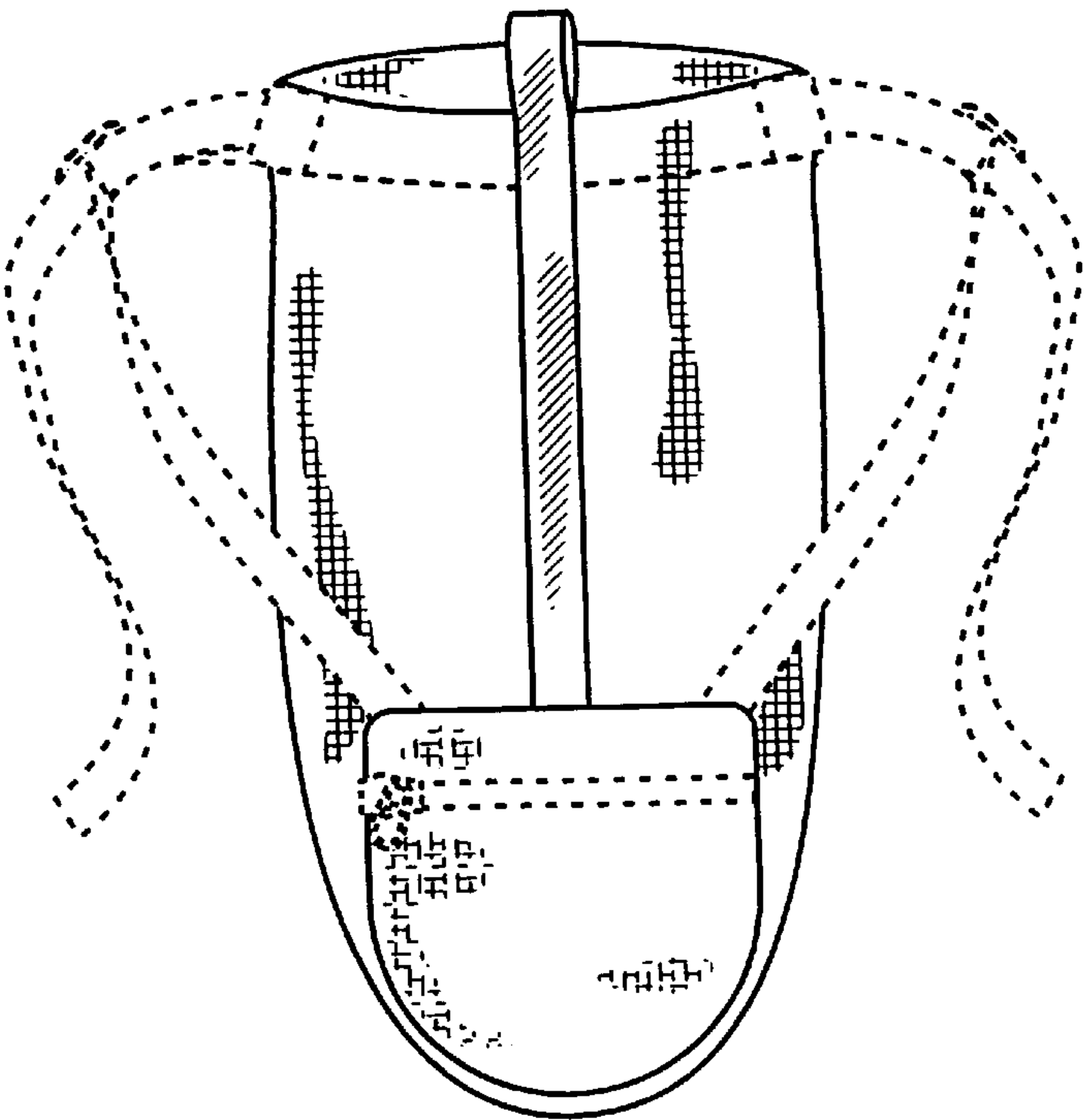
