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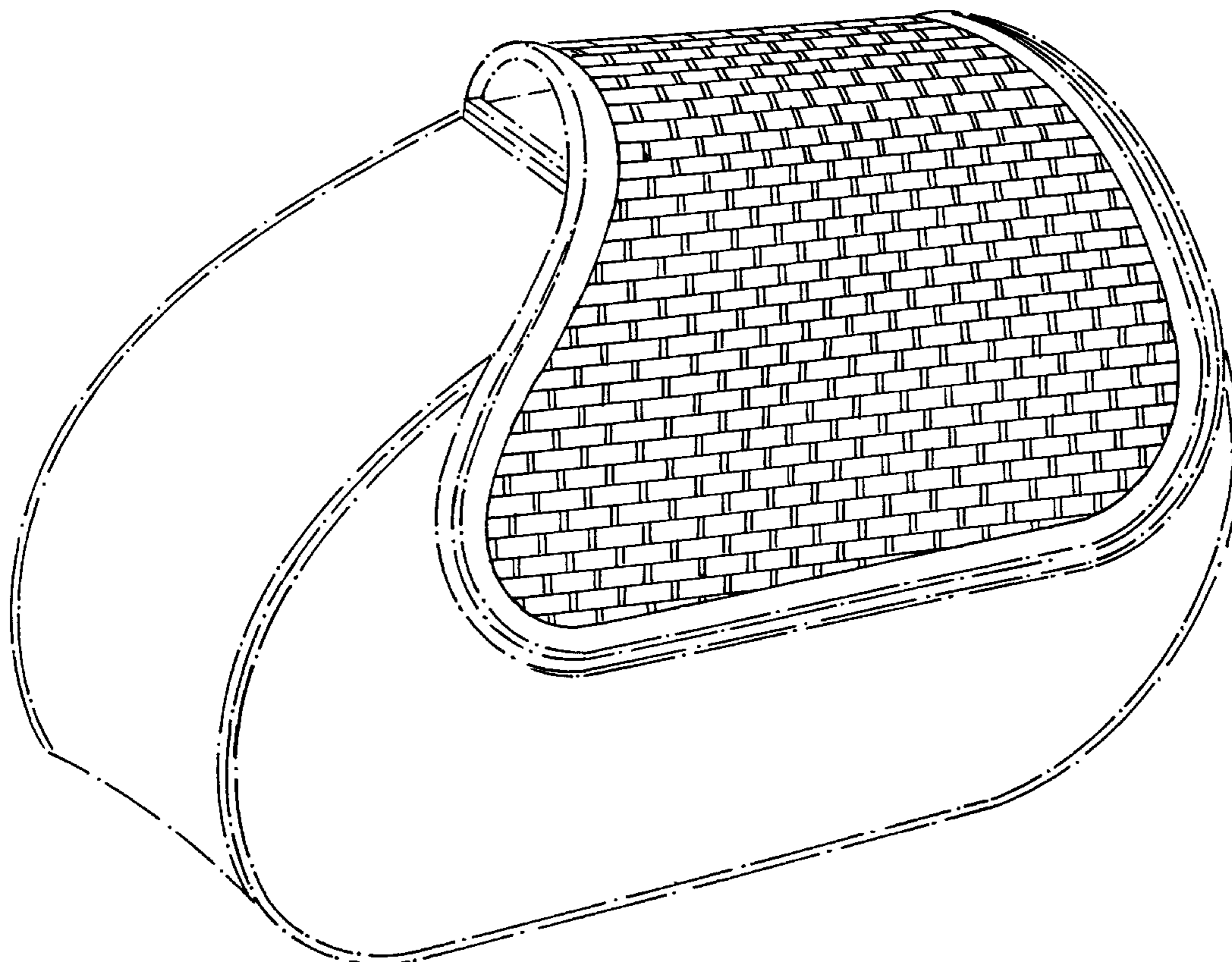

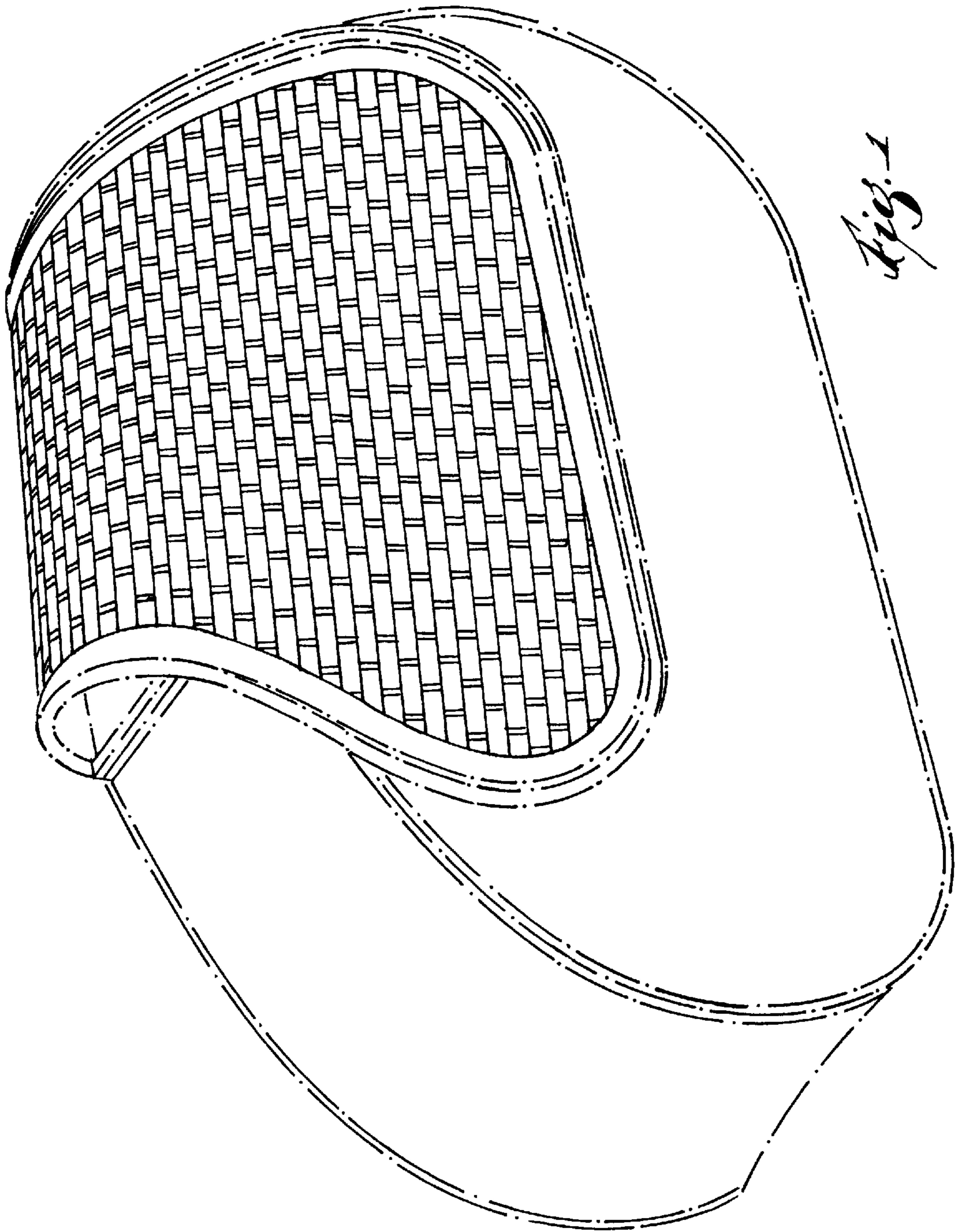
The ornamental design for a portion of a motorcycle bag, as shown and described.

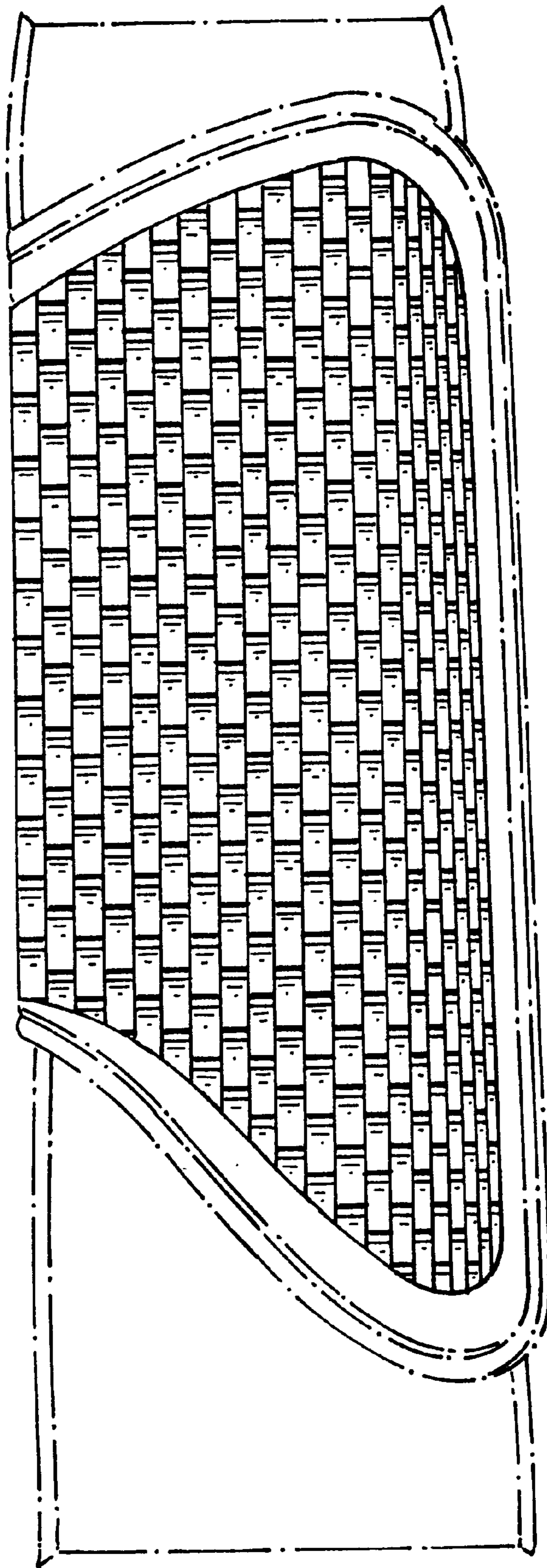
