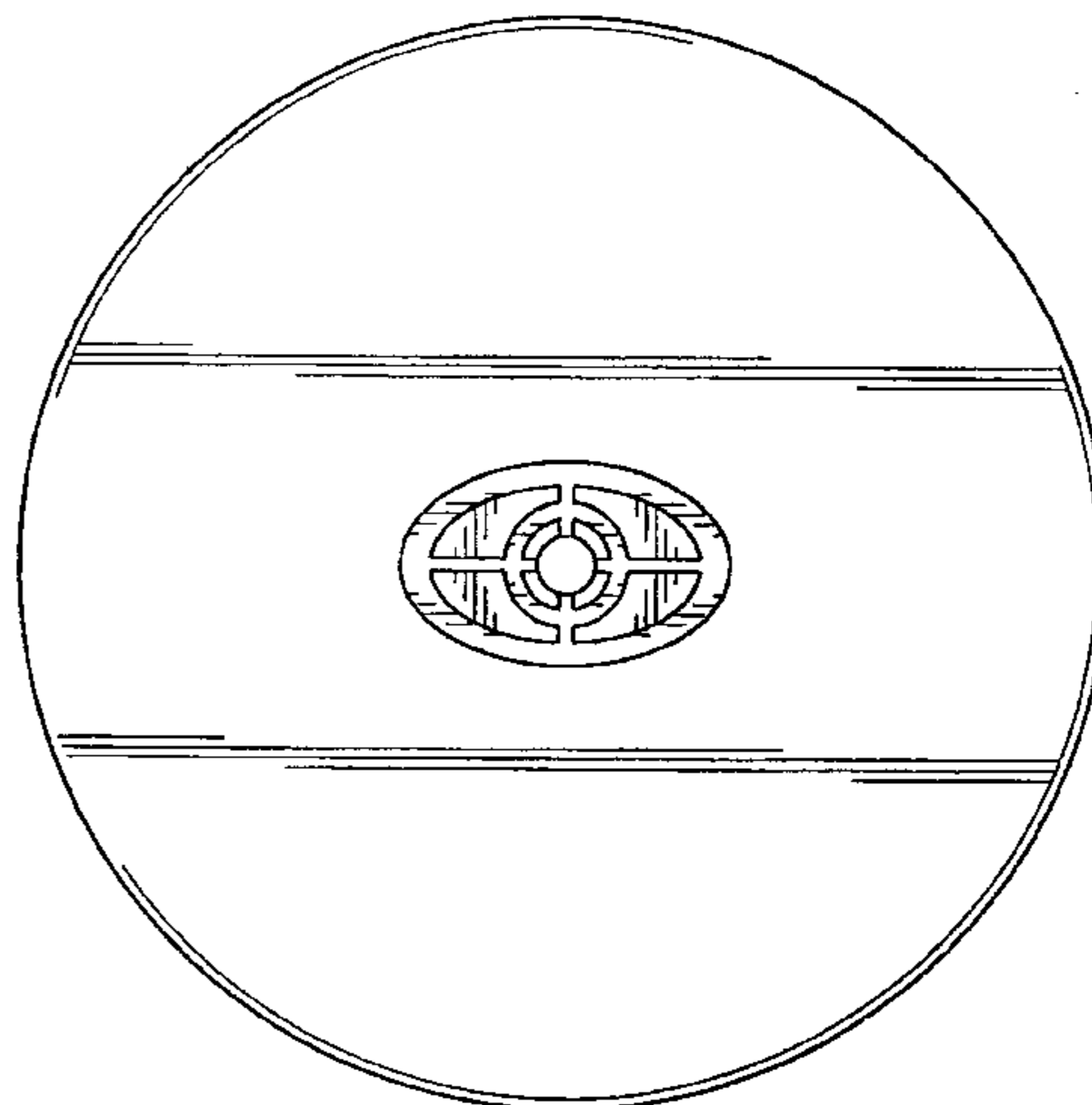
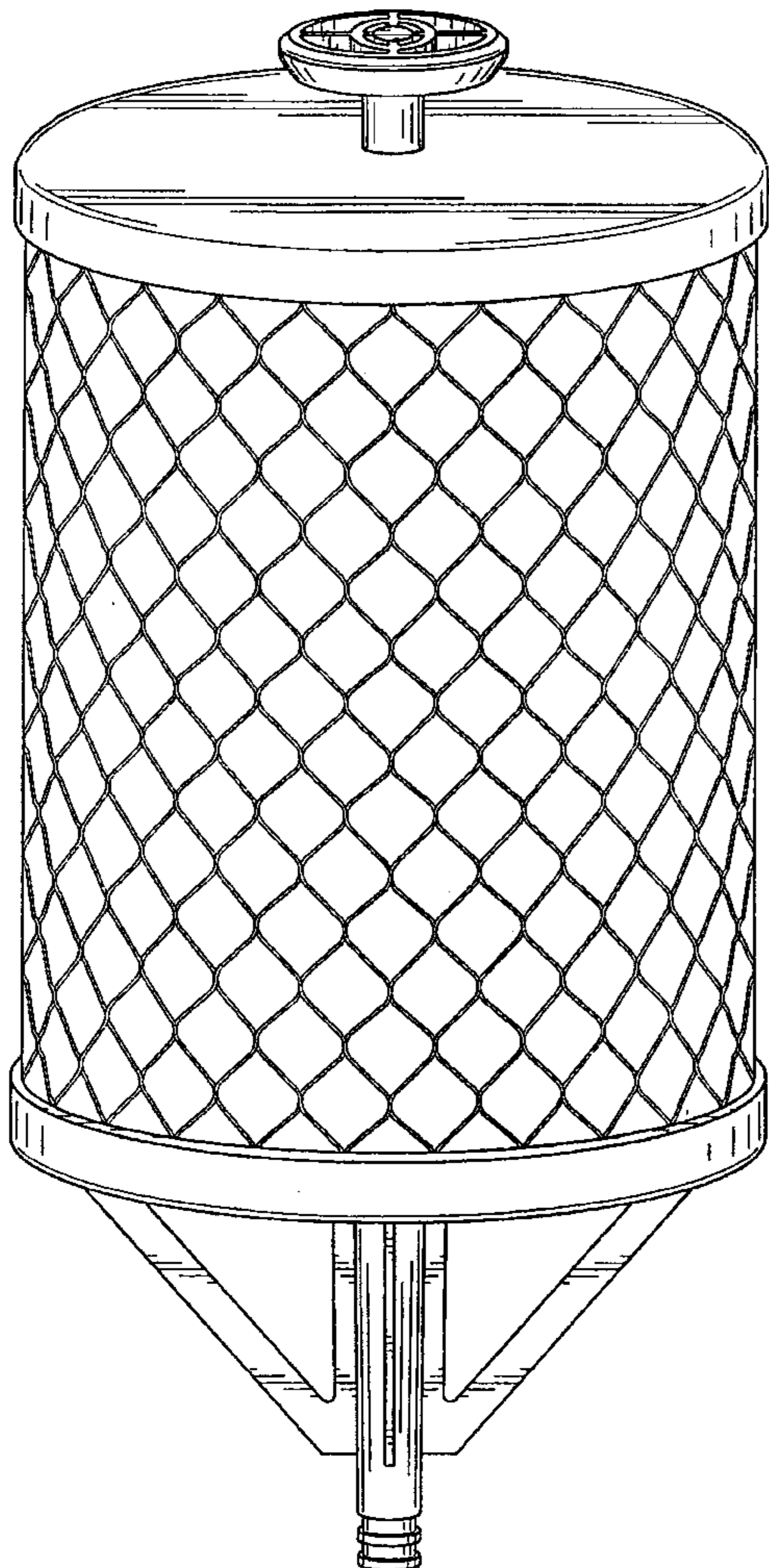
### [57] CLAIM

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of the block filter embodying the new design;

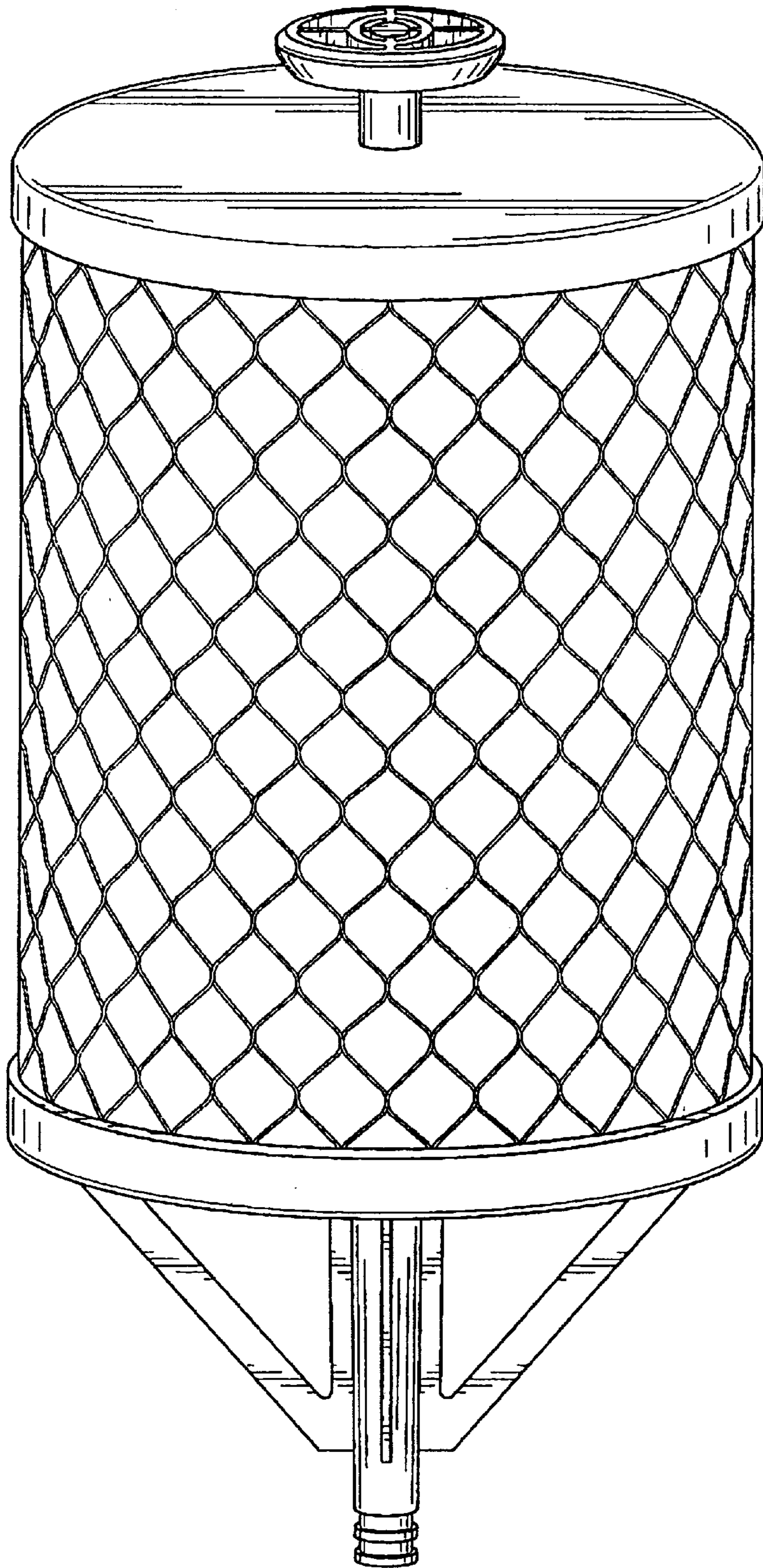

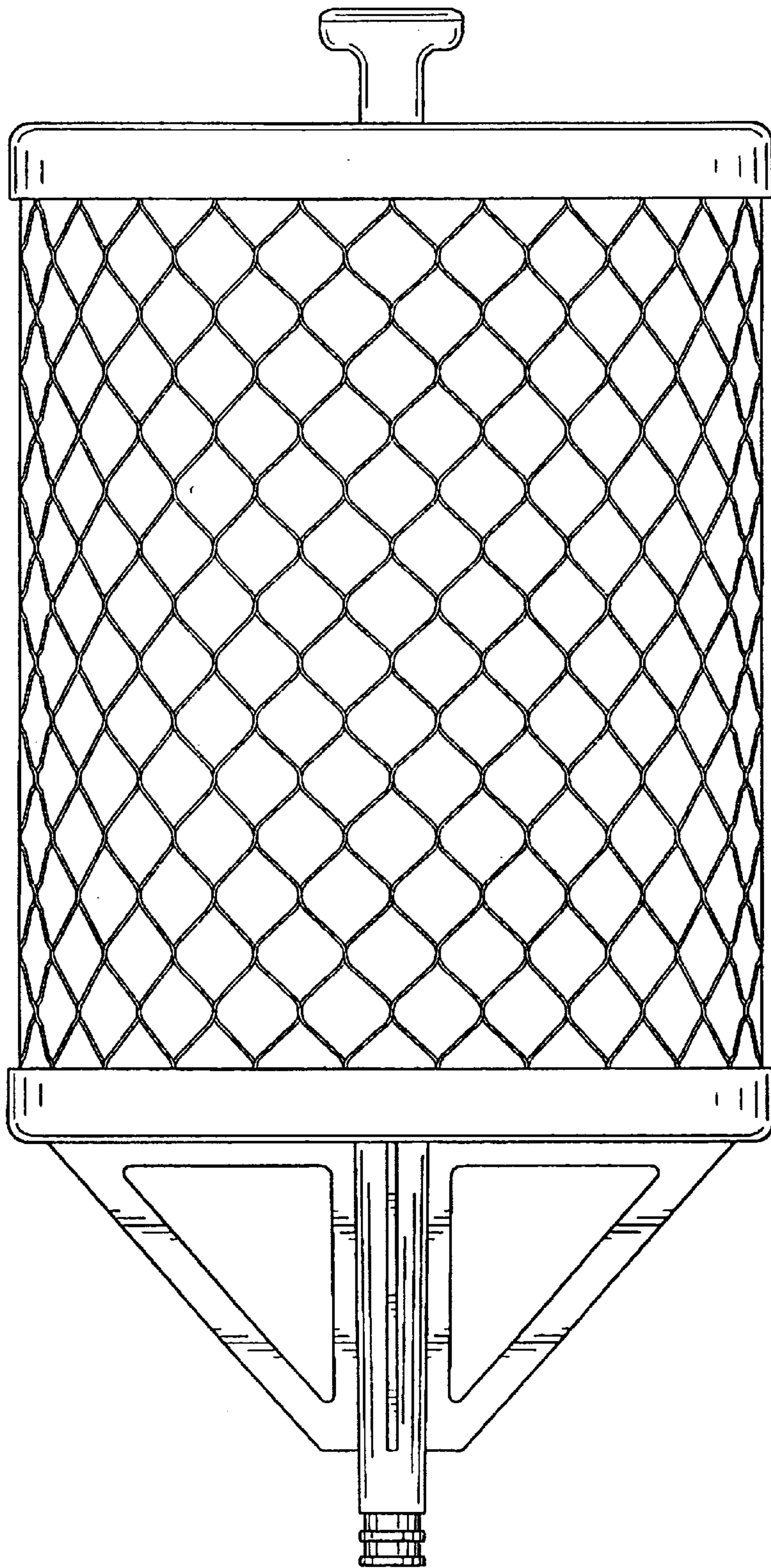

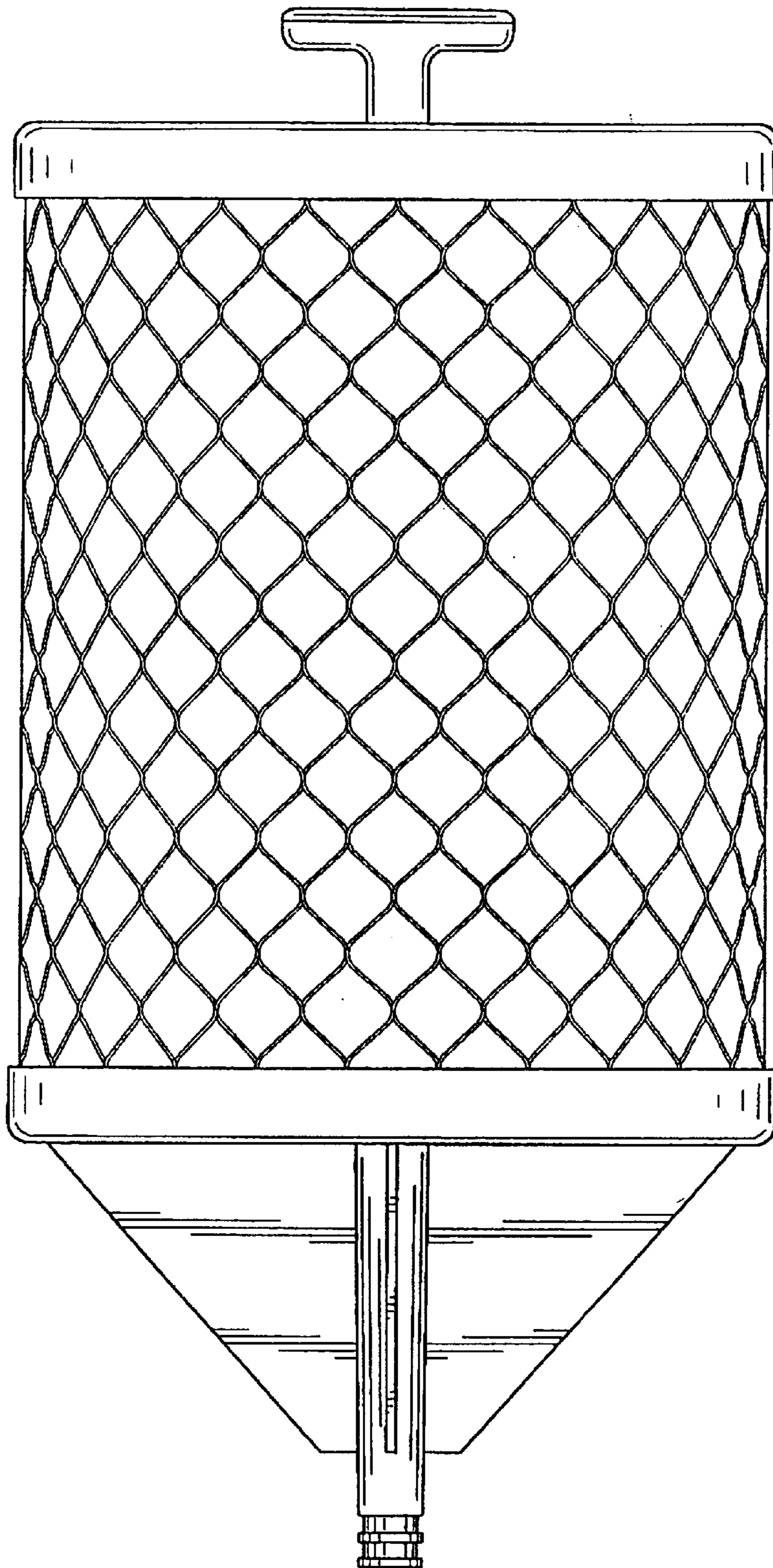

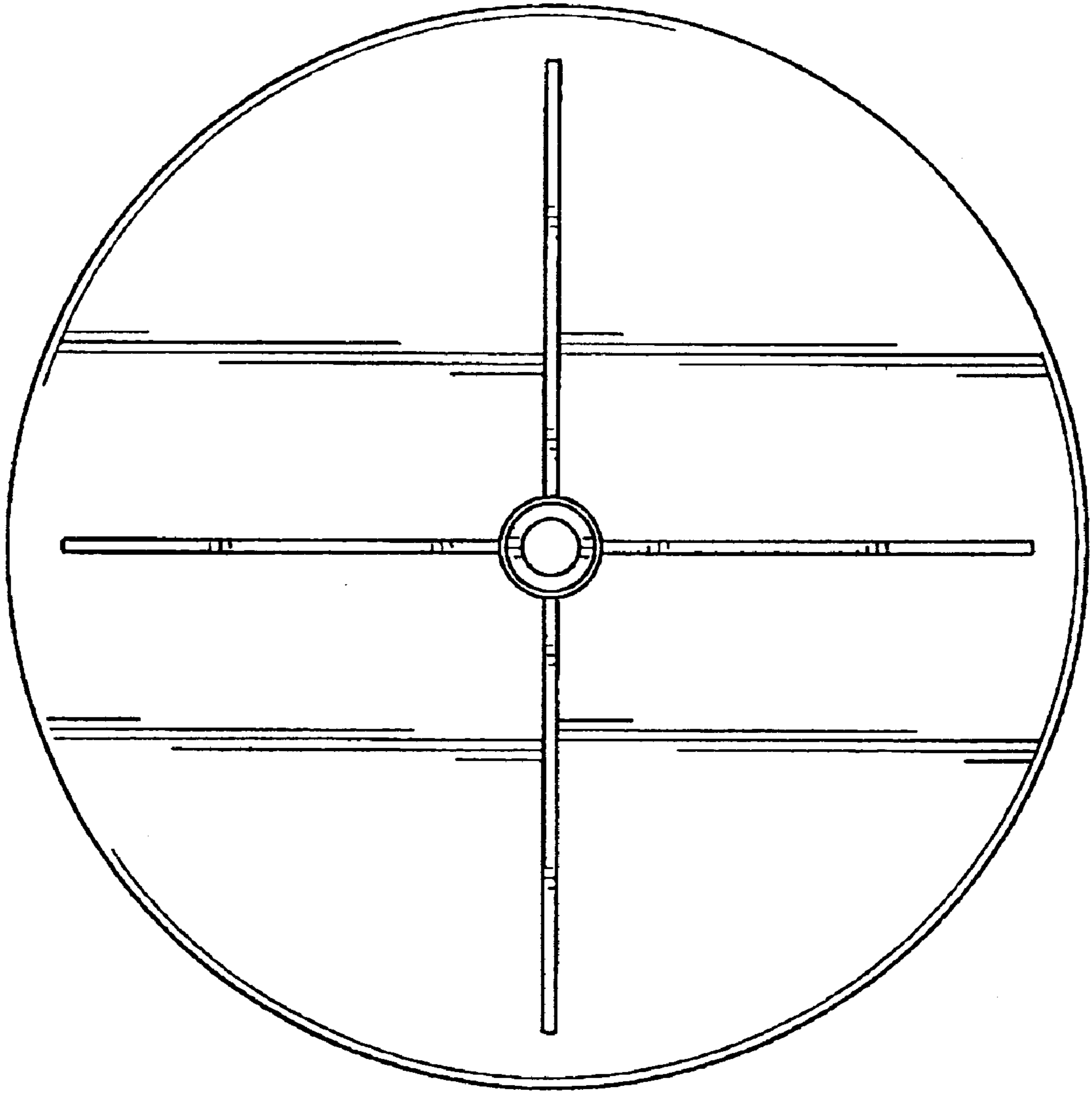

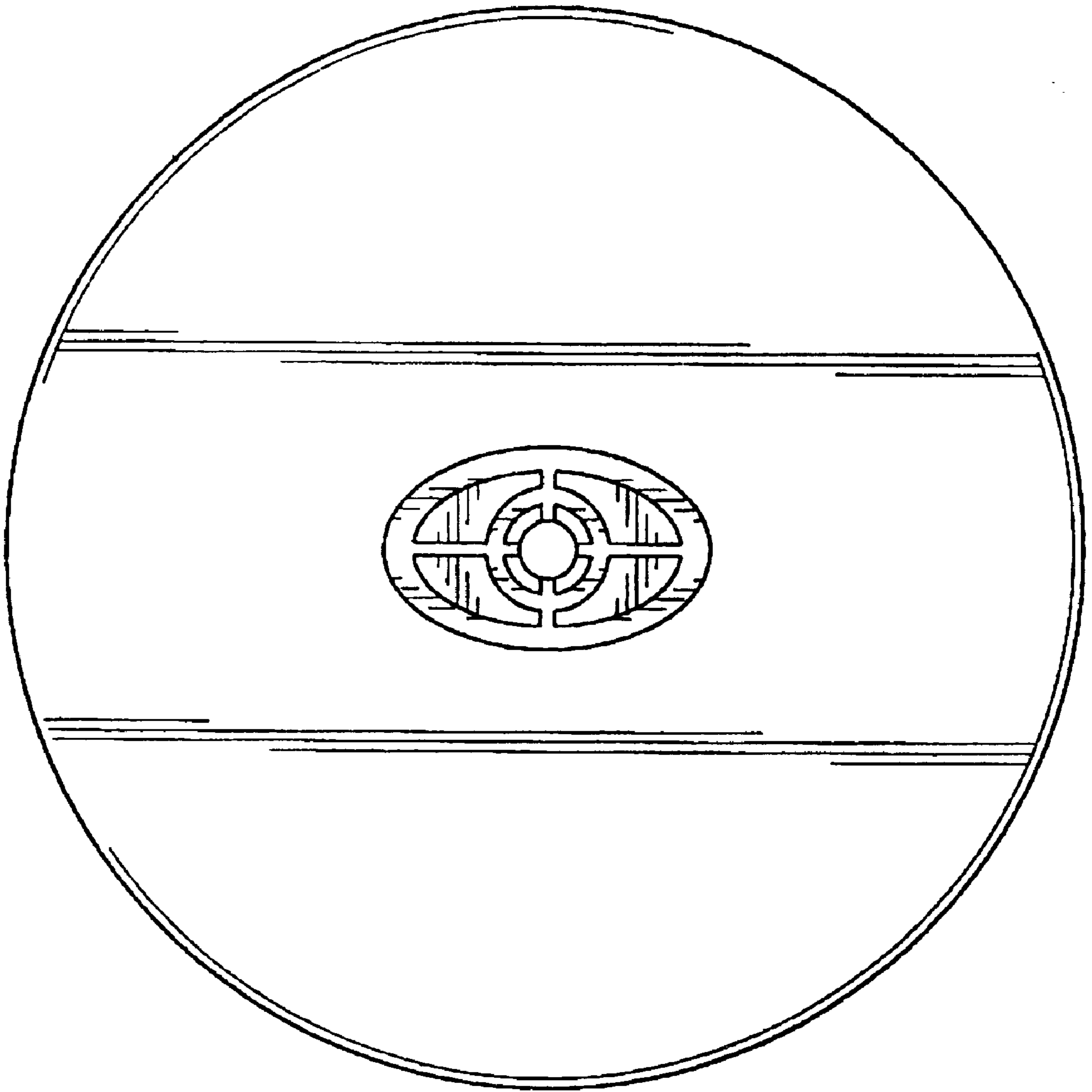
