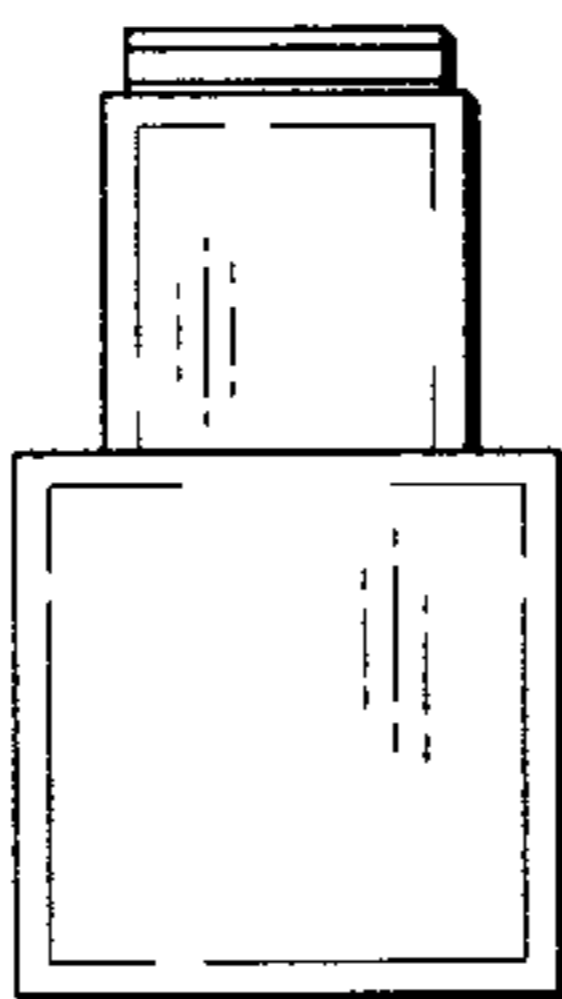
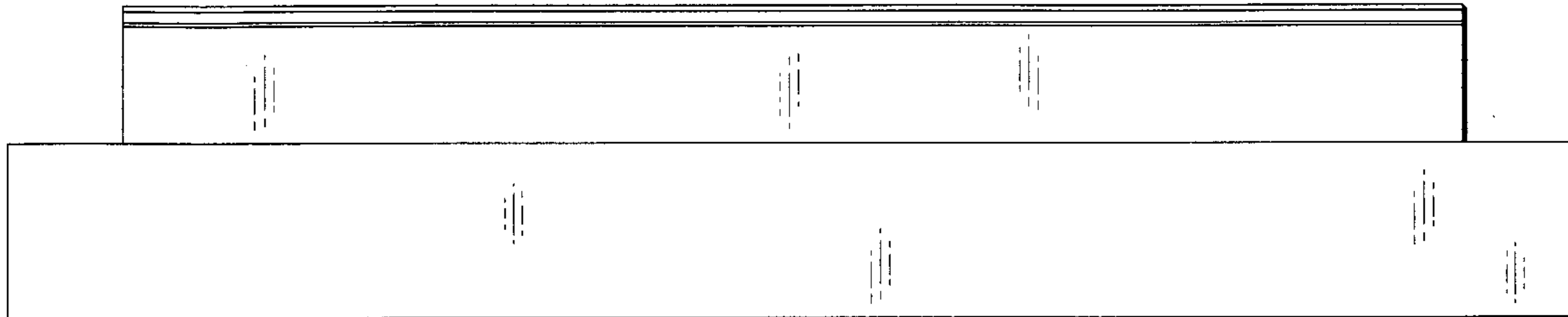
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a stabilizer, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a stabilizer, showing a typical embodiment of my new design.
FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view.
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view.
FIG. 4 is a top view.
FIG. 5 is a bottom view; and,
FIG. 6 is a front elevational view with the top box pushed into the bottom box.
The appearance of the rear is the same as the front.

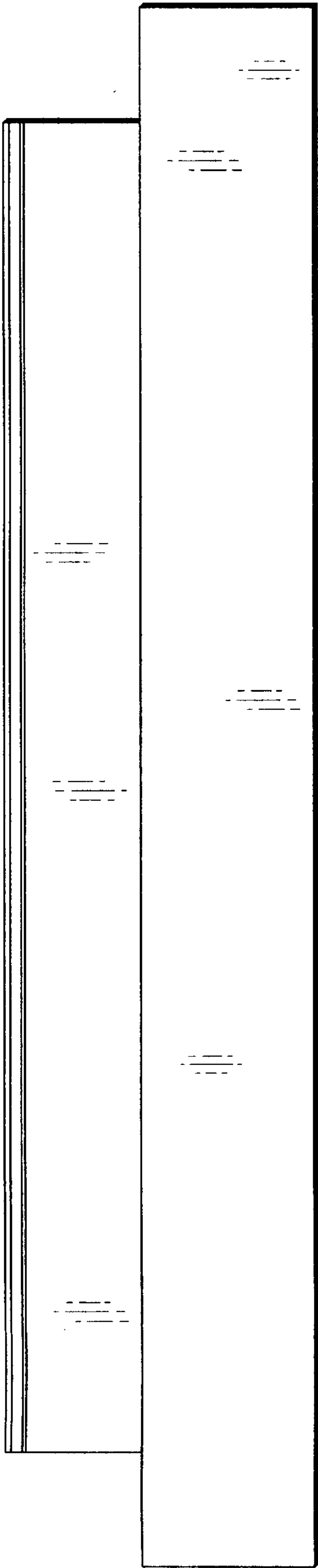

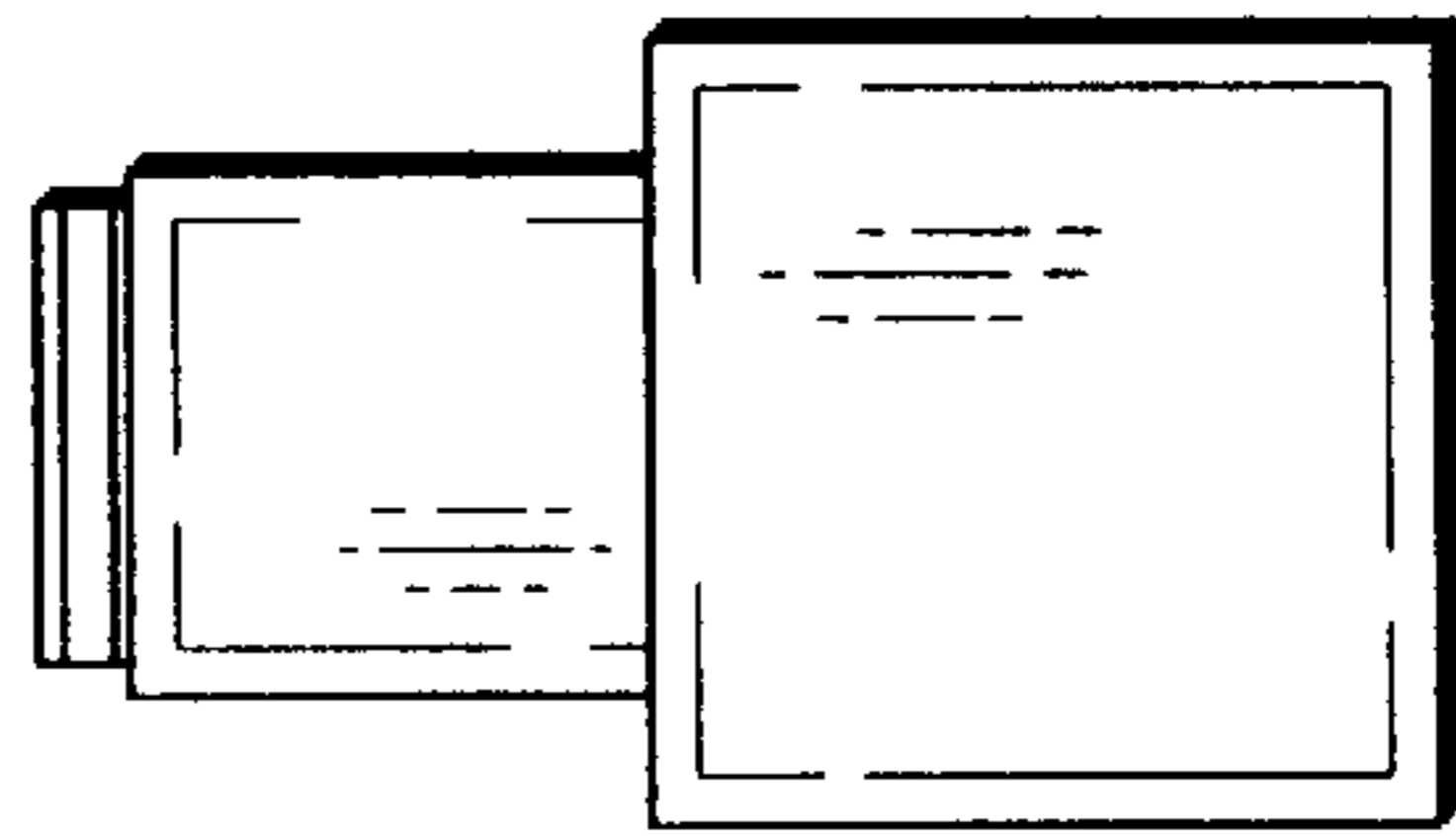

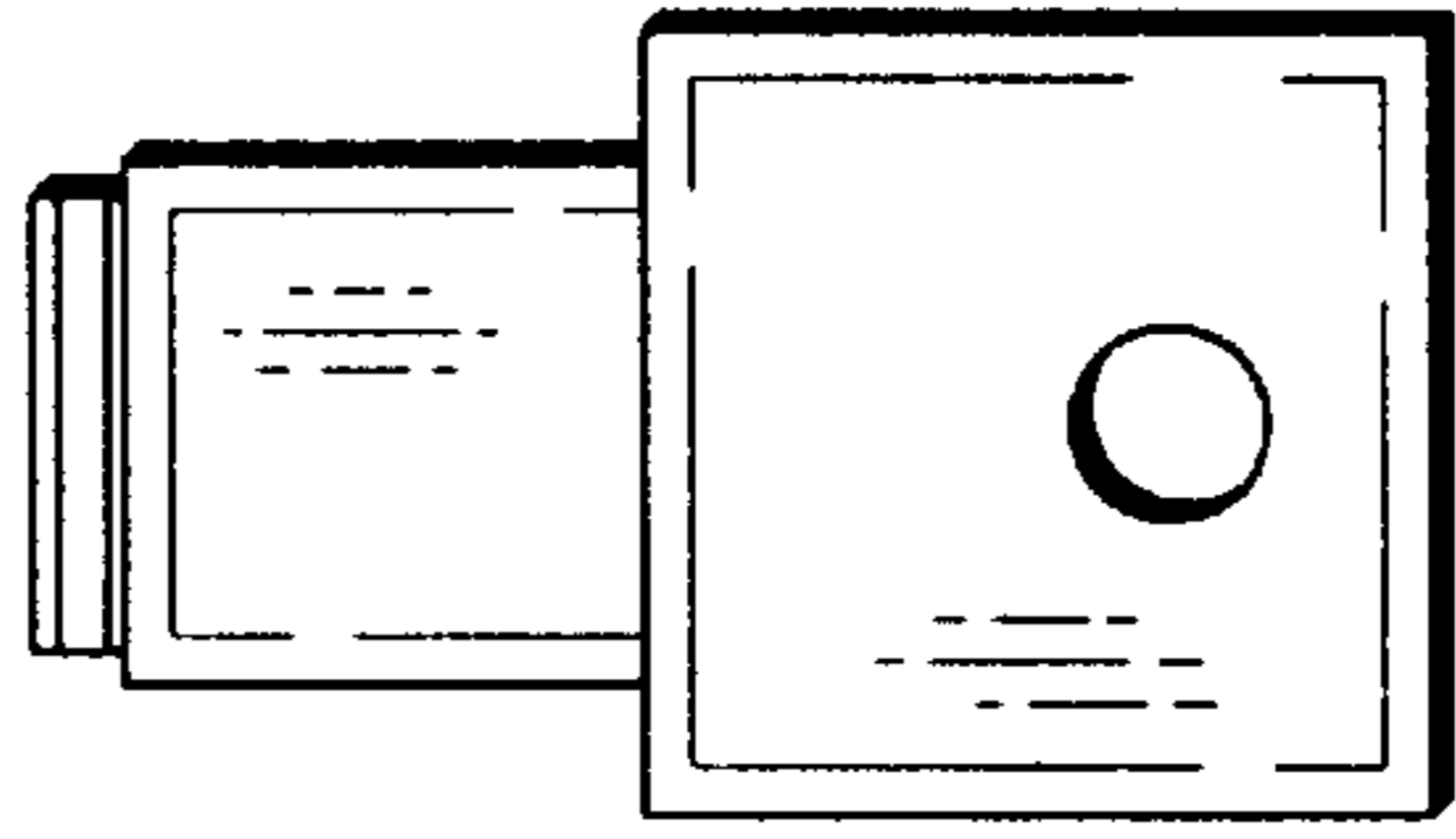

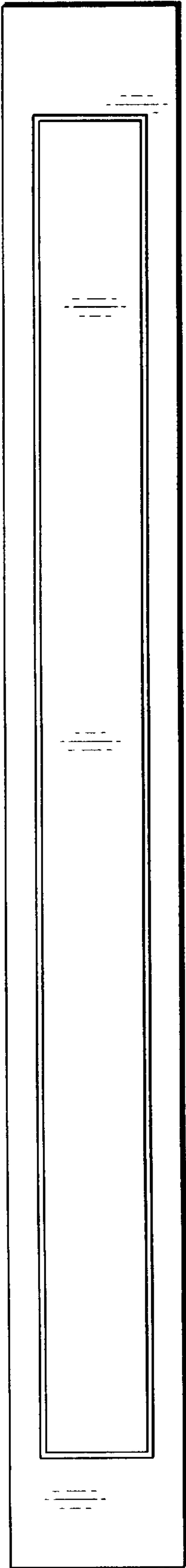

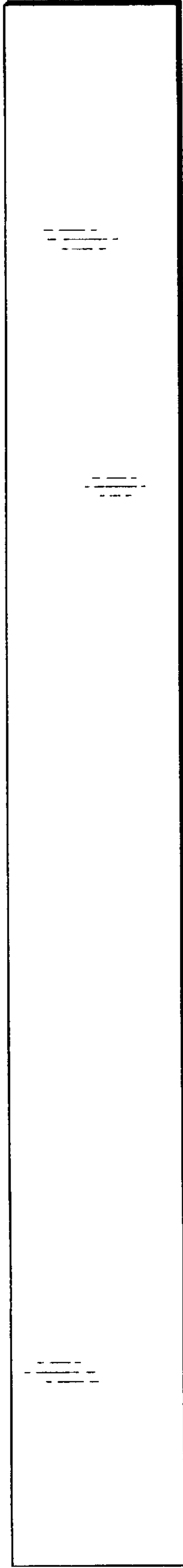

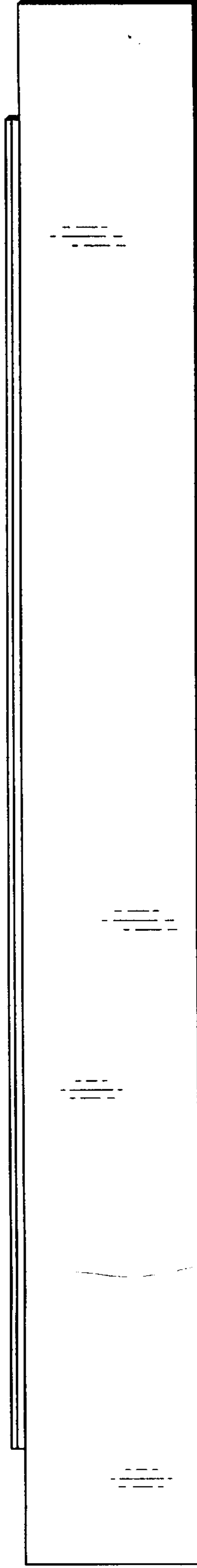
