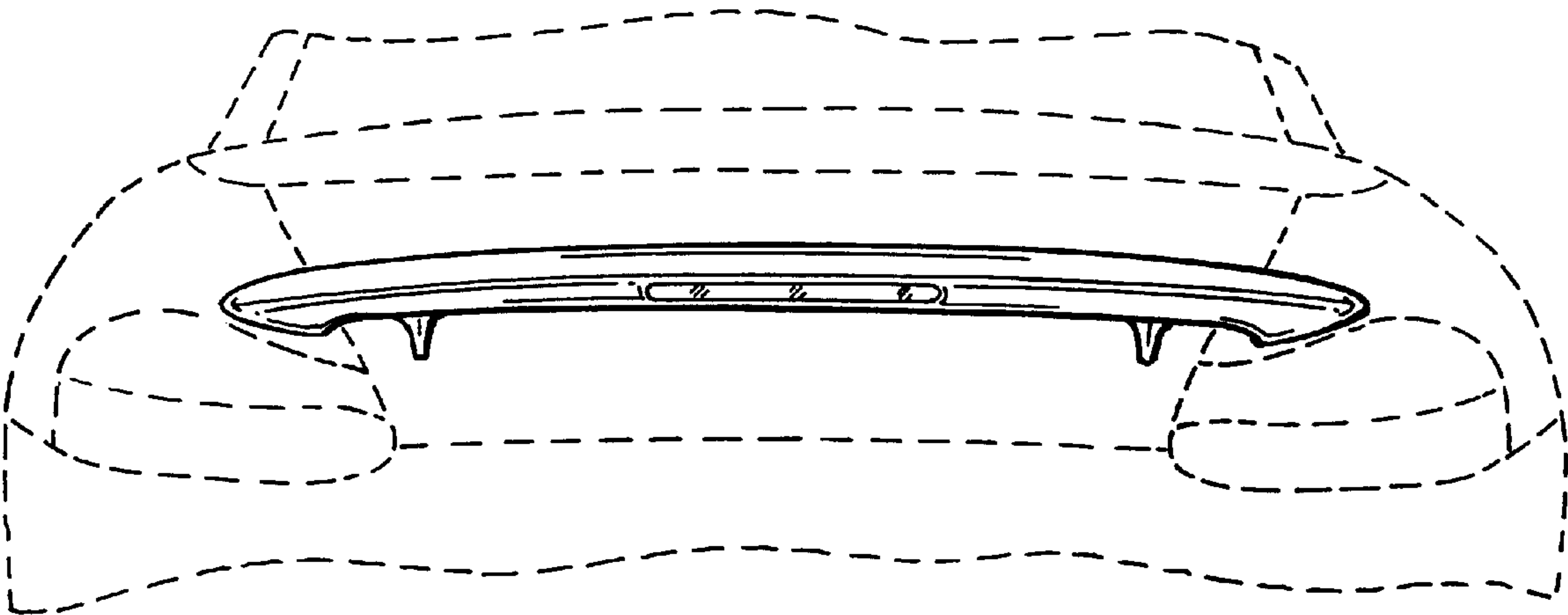
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a rear spoiler of an automobile, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 shows a rear elevational view of the rear spoiler of an automobile according to our novel design.
FIG. 2 shows a rear perspective view of the rear spoiler of an automobile according to our novel design;
FIG. 3 shows a side view of the rear spoiler of an automobile according to our novel design, the opposite side view being a mirror image thereof, and;
FIG. 4 shows an enlarged top plan view of the rear spoiler of an automobile according to our novel design.
The broken lines showing a portion of an automobile are for illustration only and form no part of the claimed design.

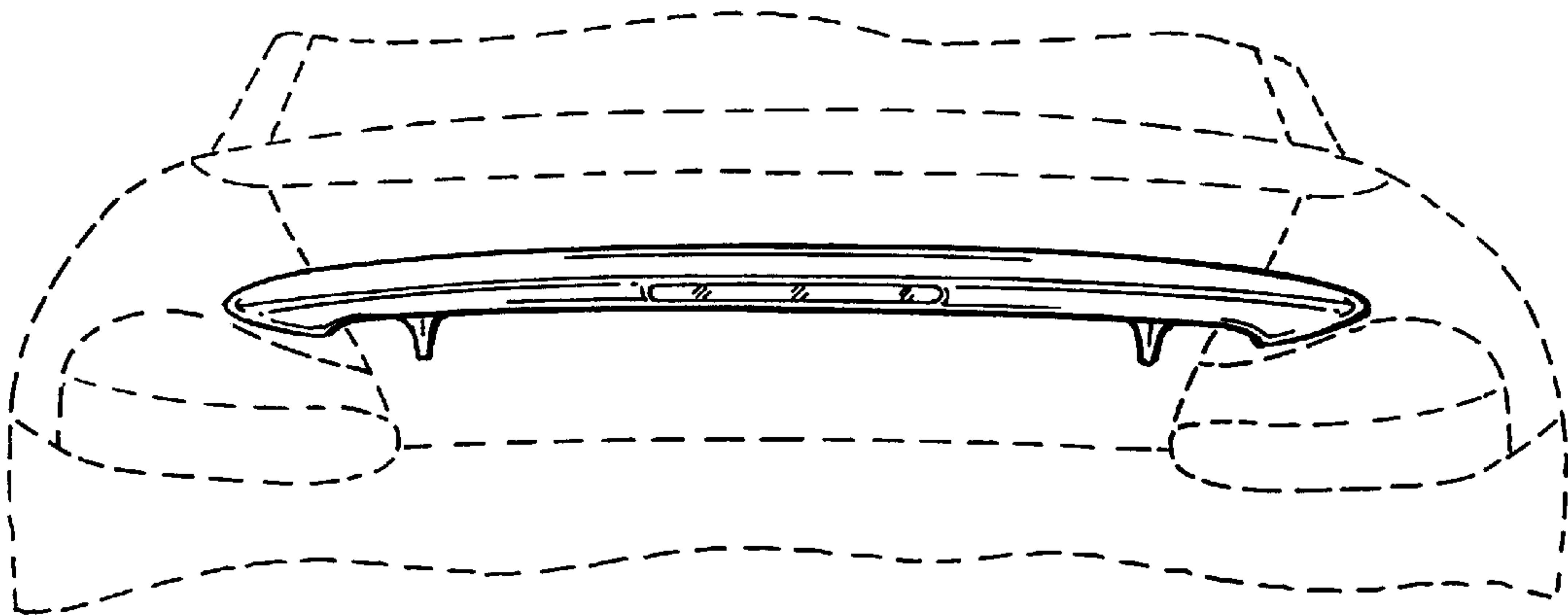

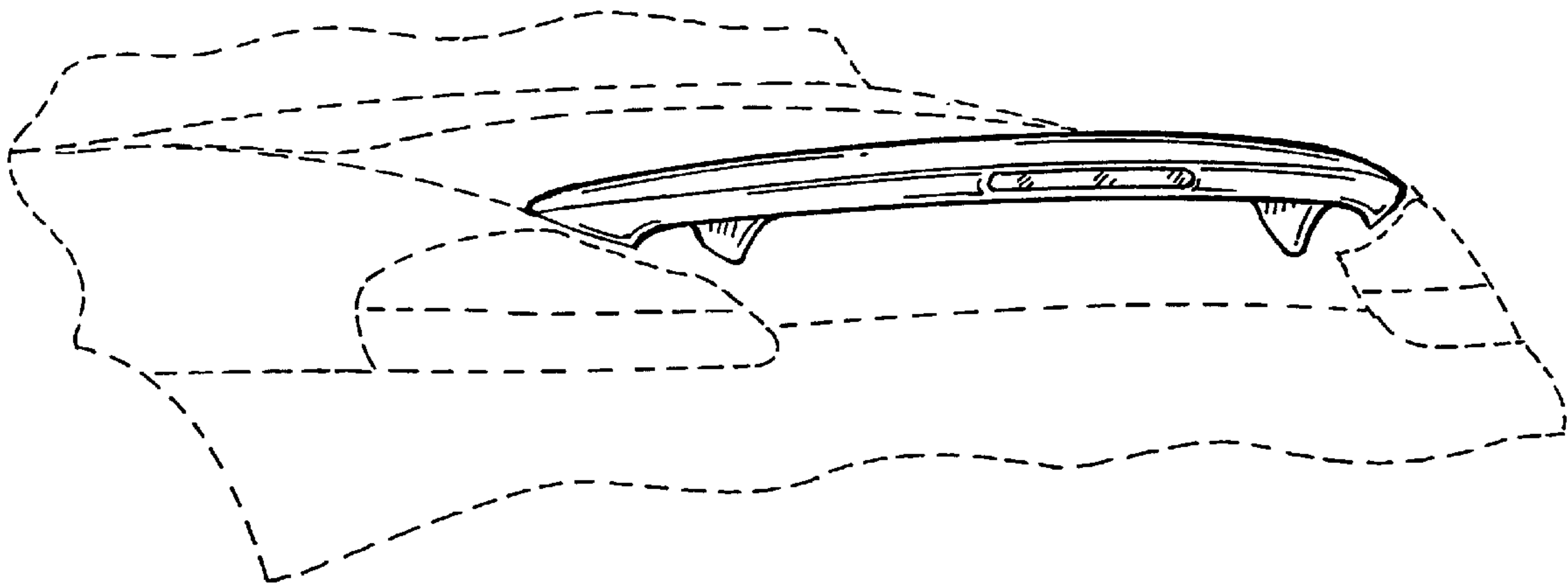

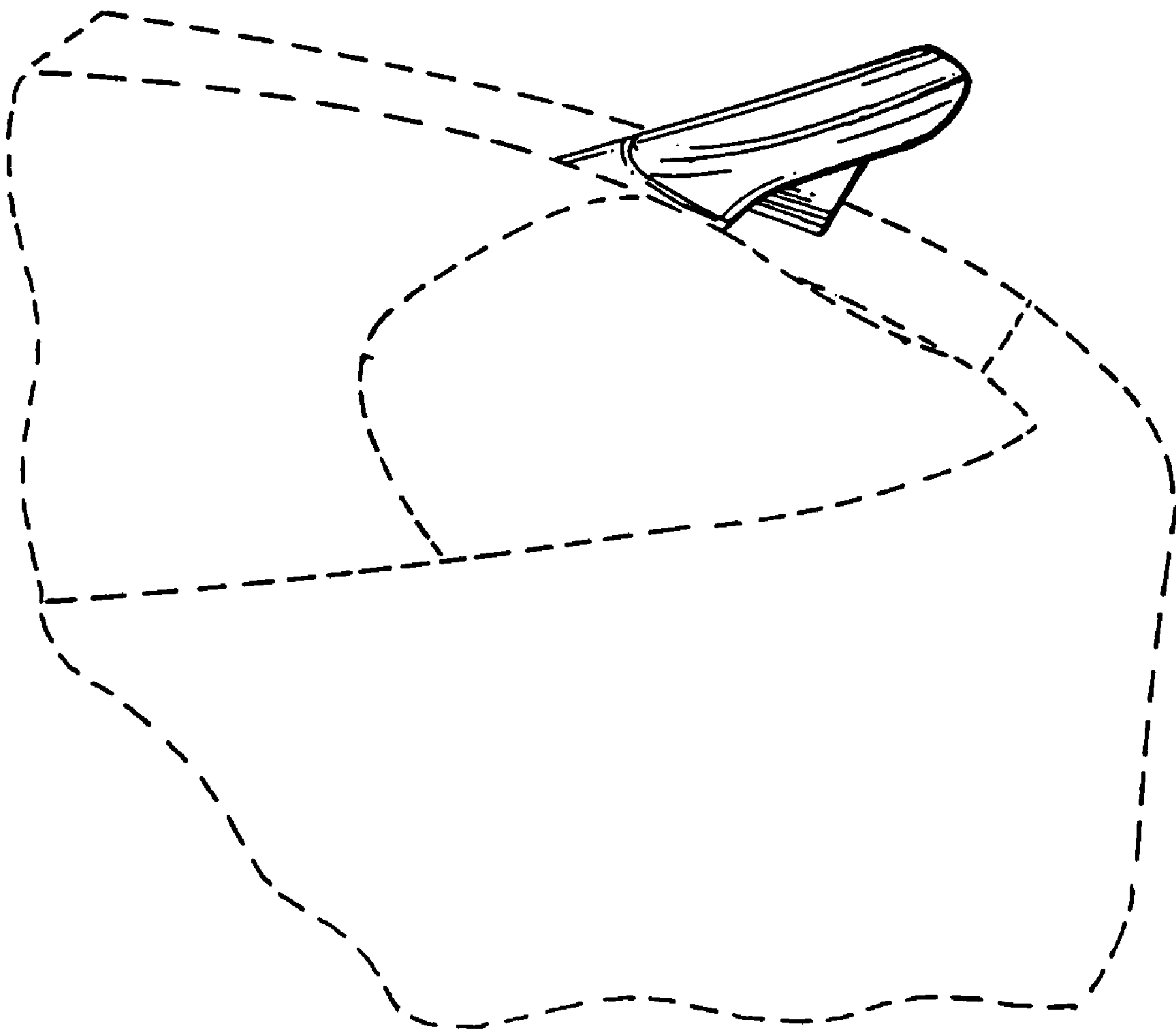

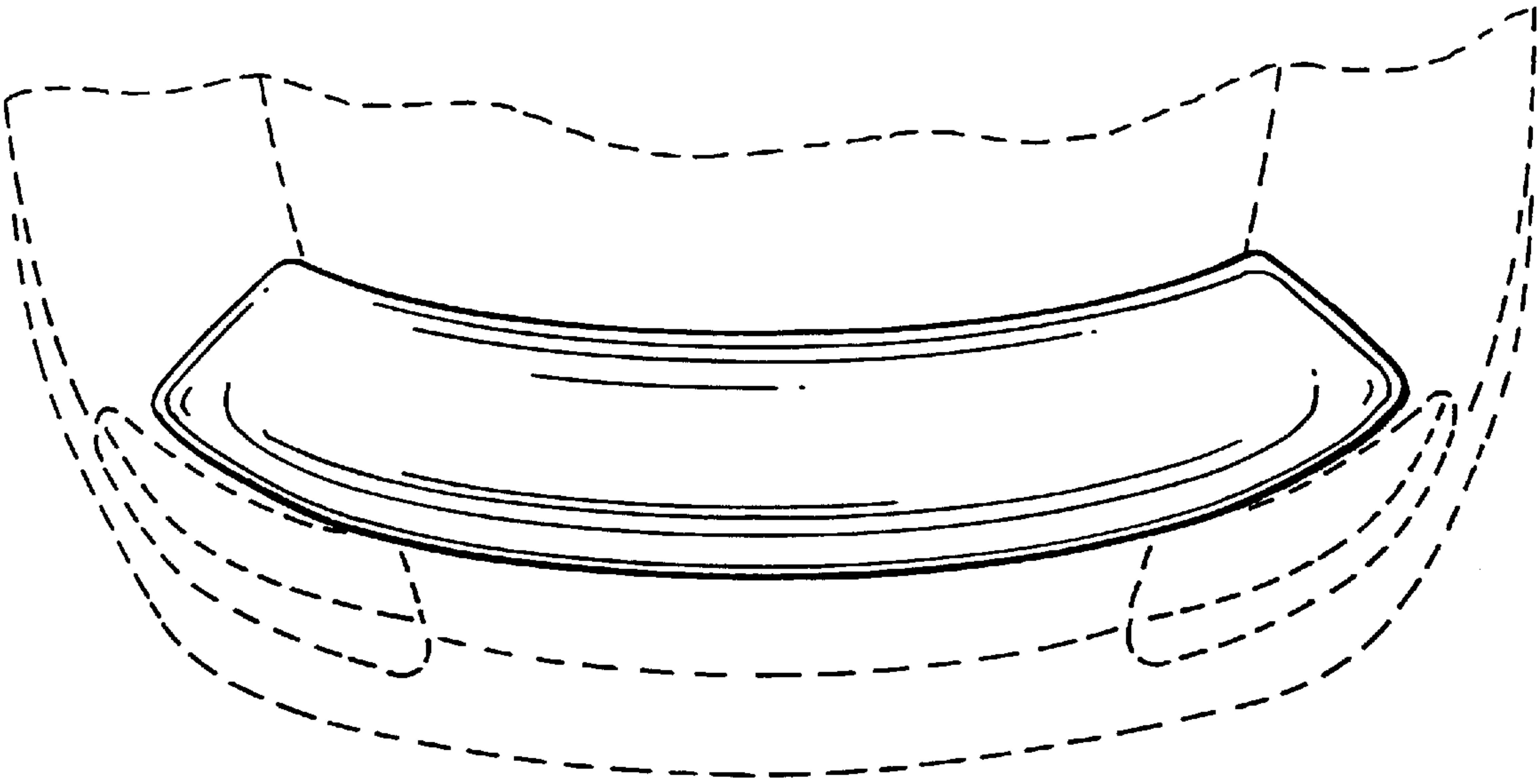
