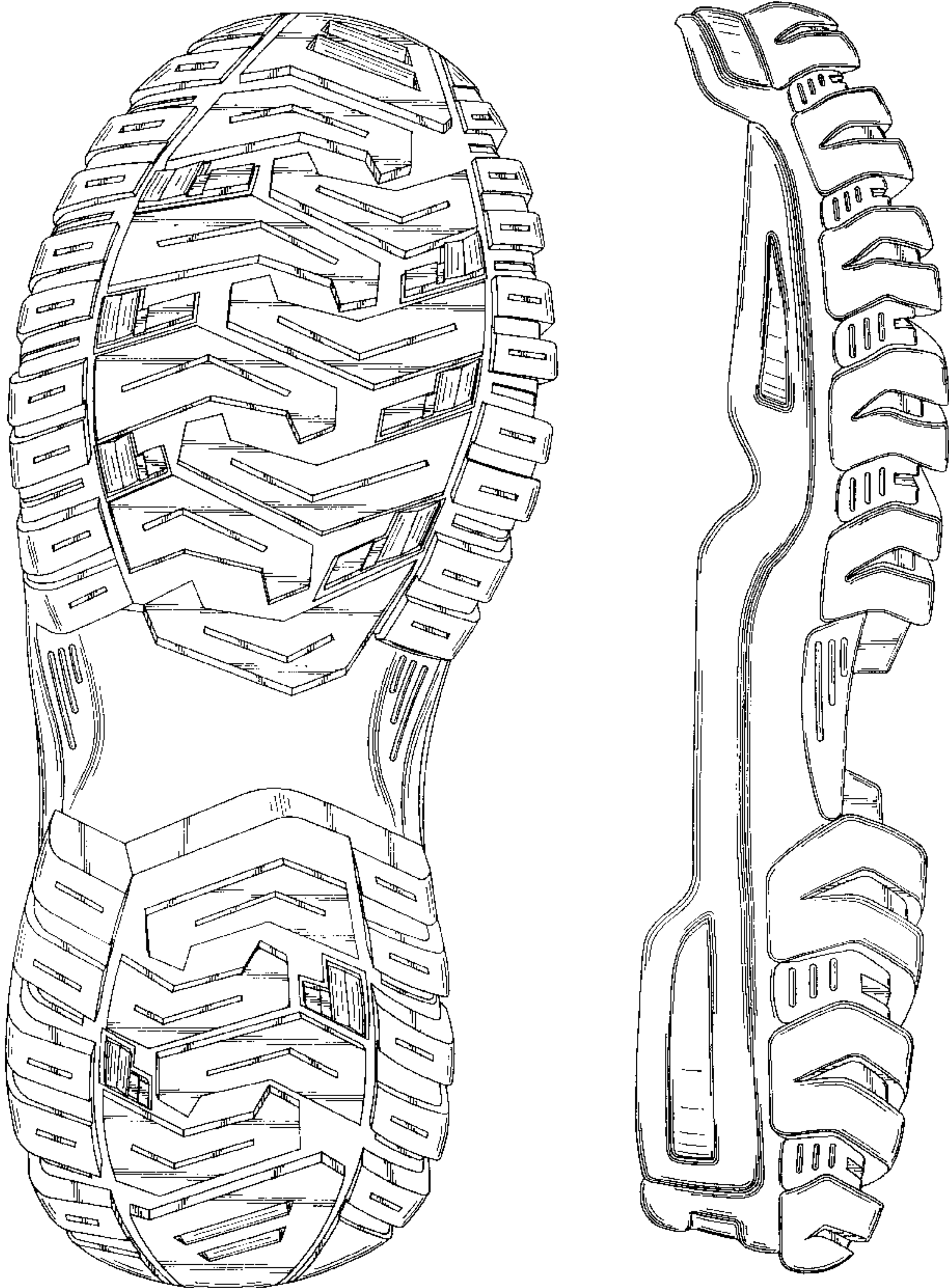
[57] CLAIM

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a bottom plan view of the shoe sole embodying the new design;  
FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof; and,  
FIG. 6 is a perspective view thereof.

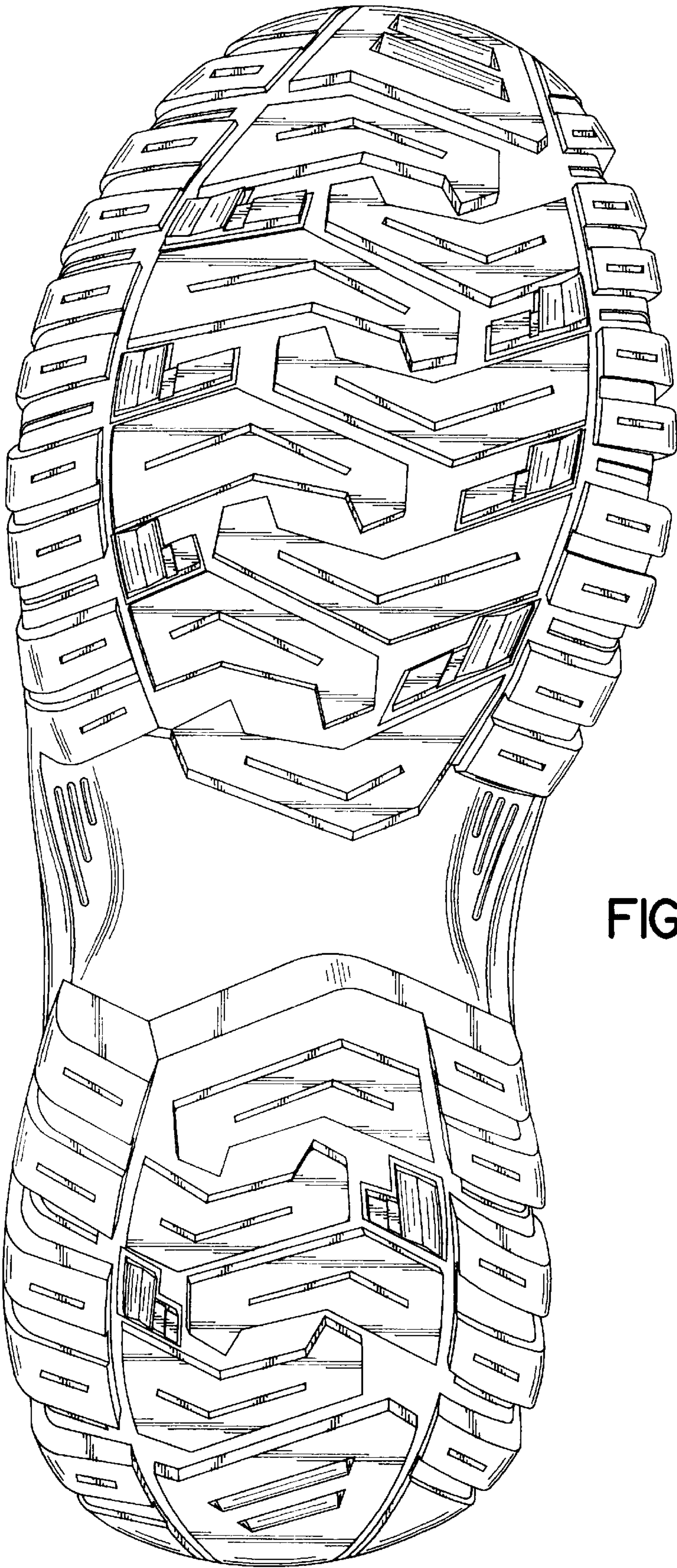

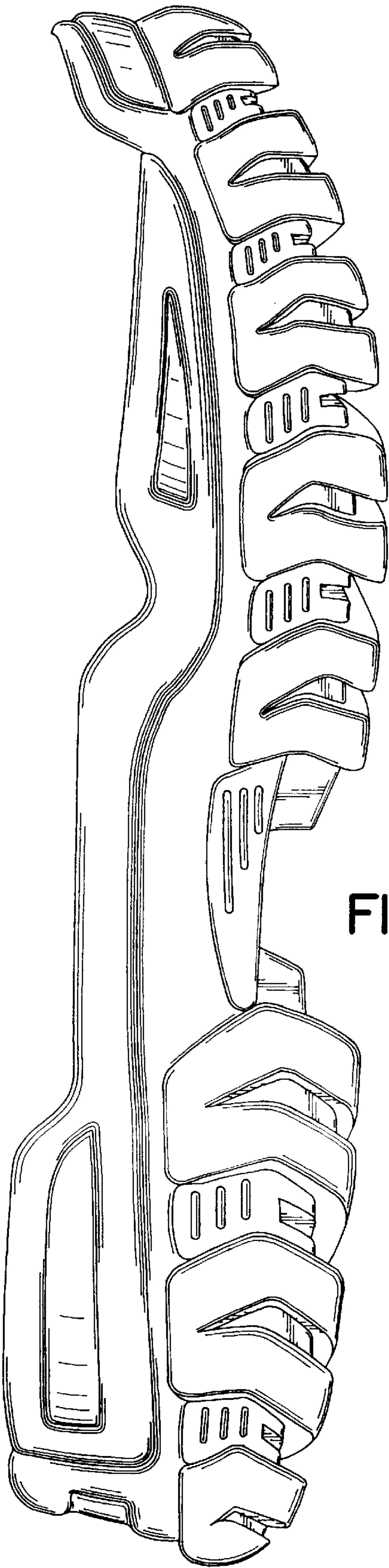

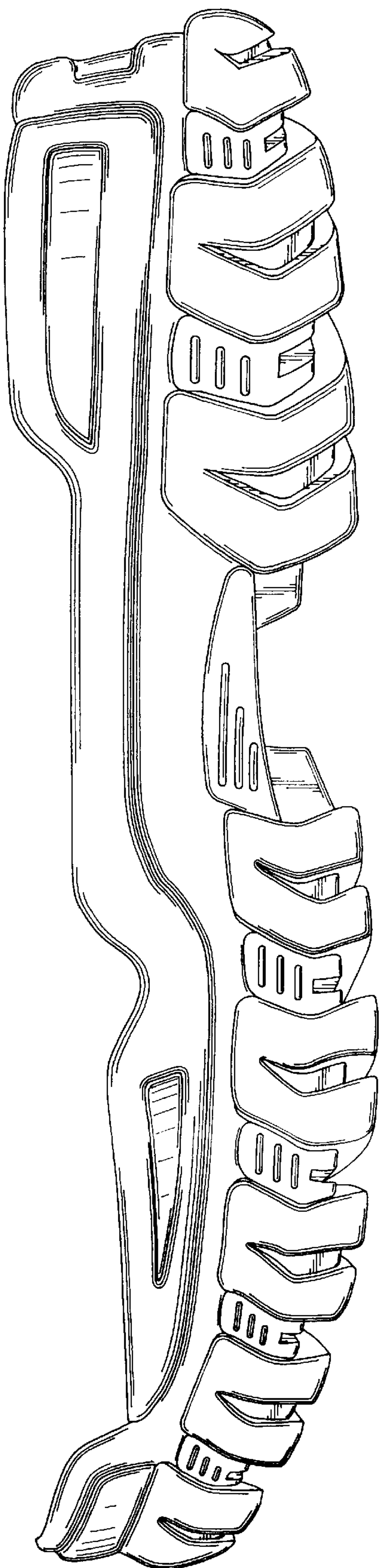

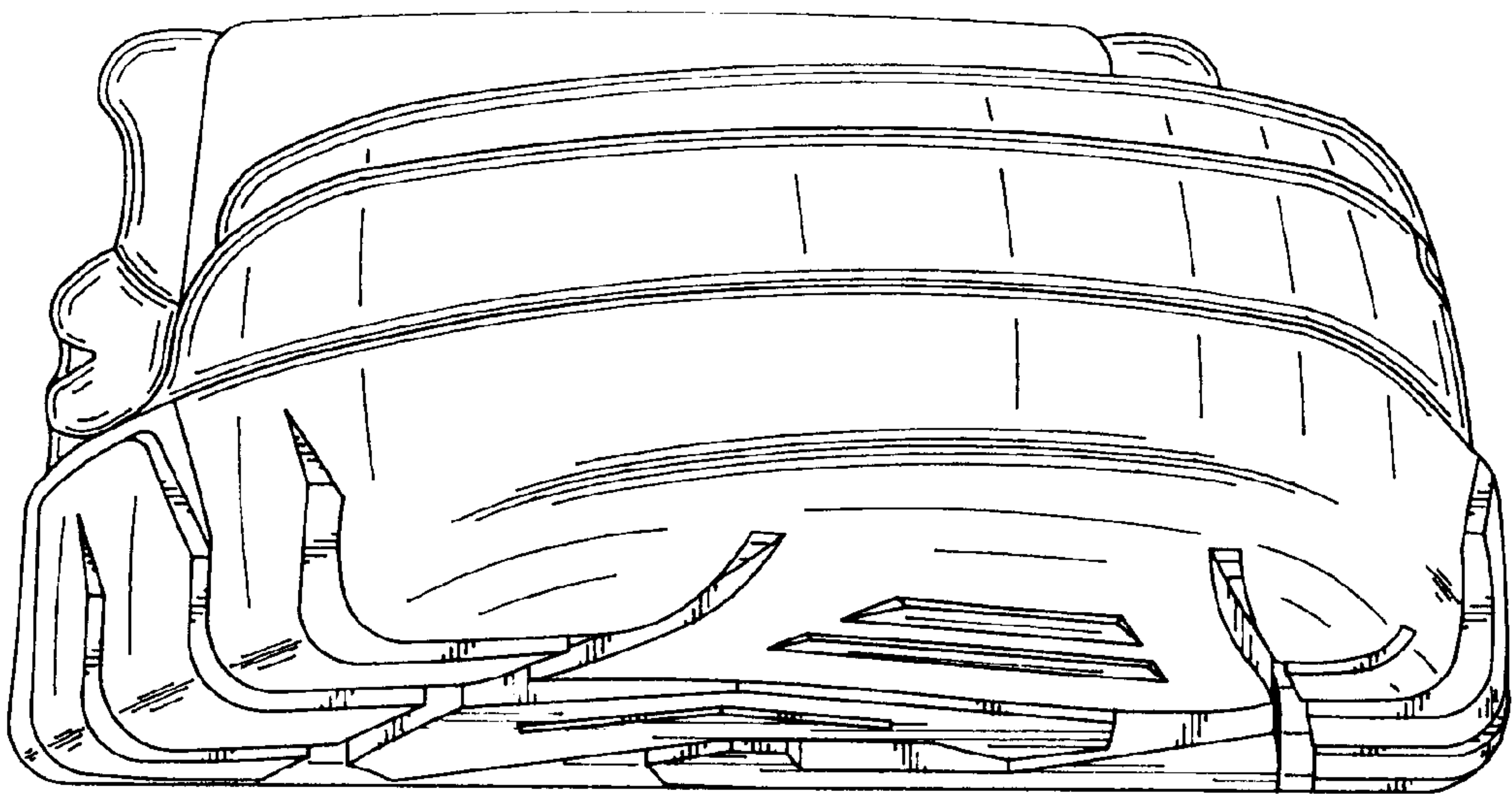

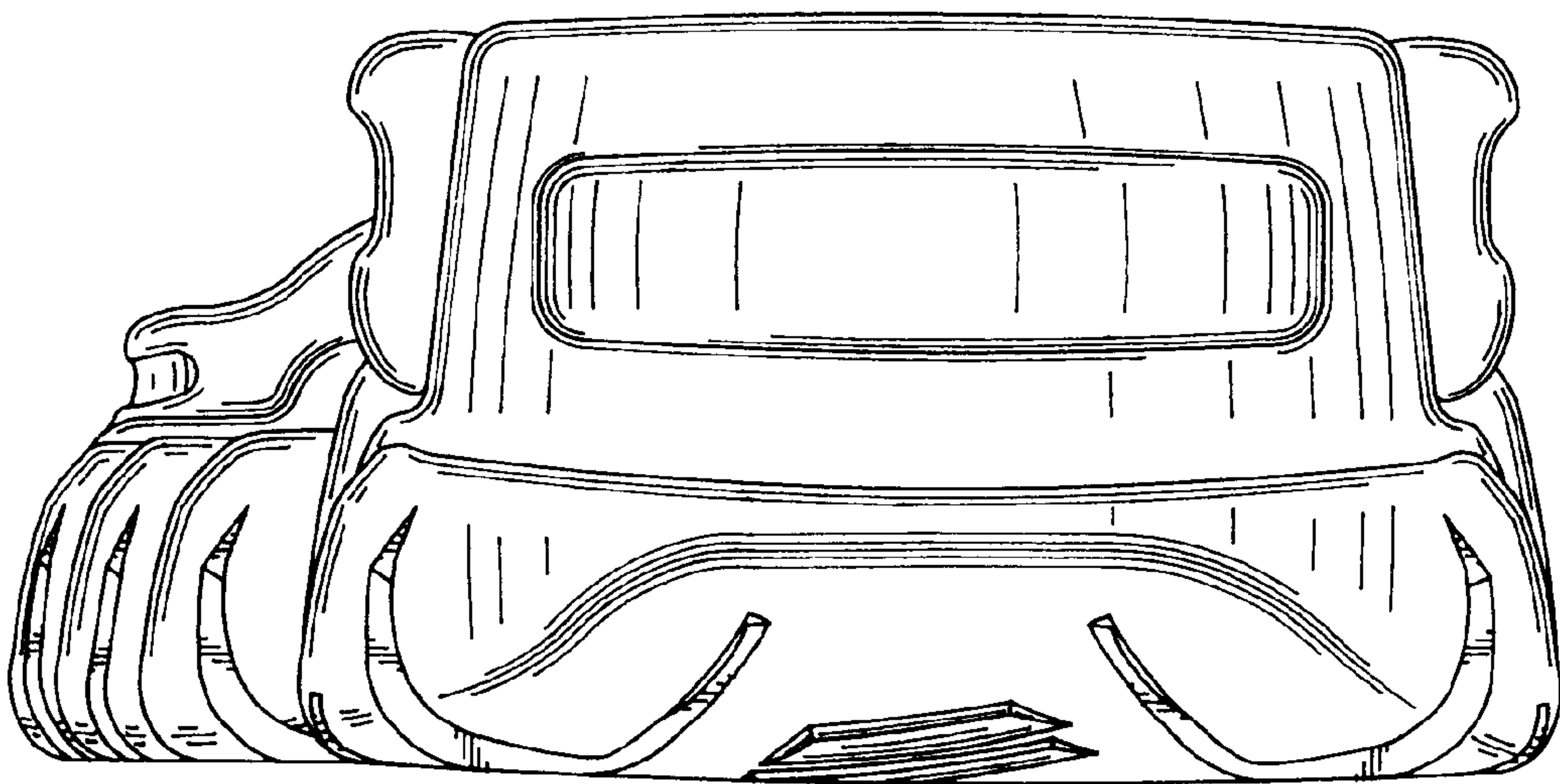

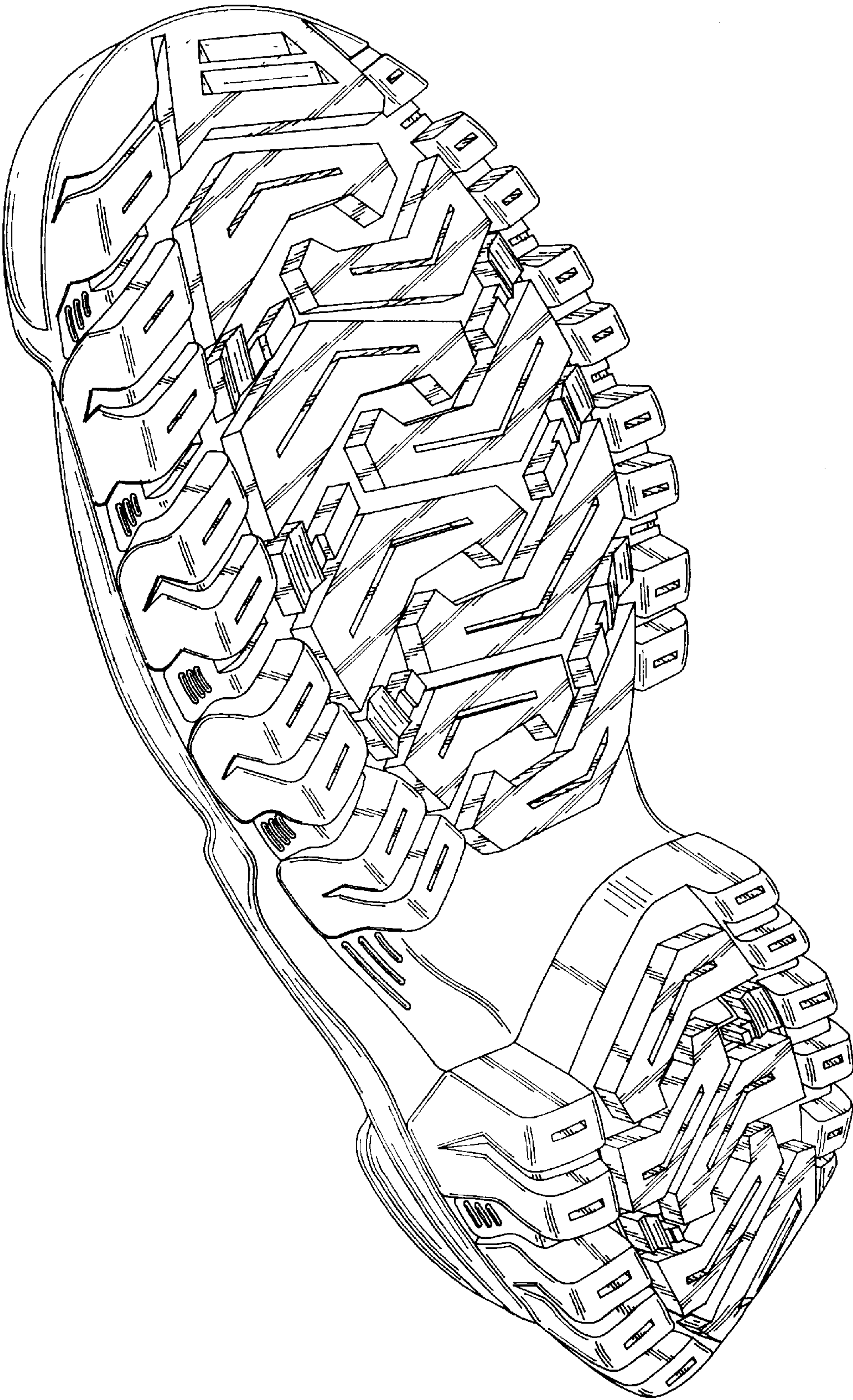
