DESCRIPTION

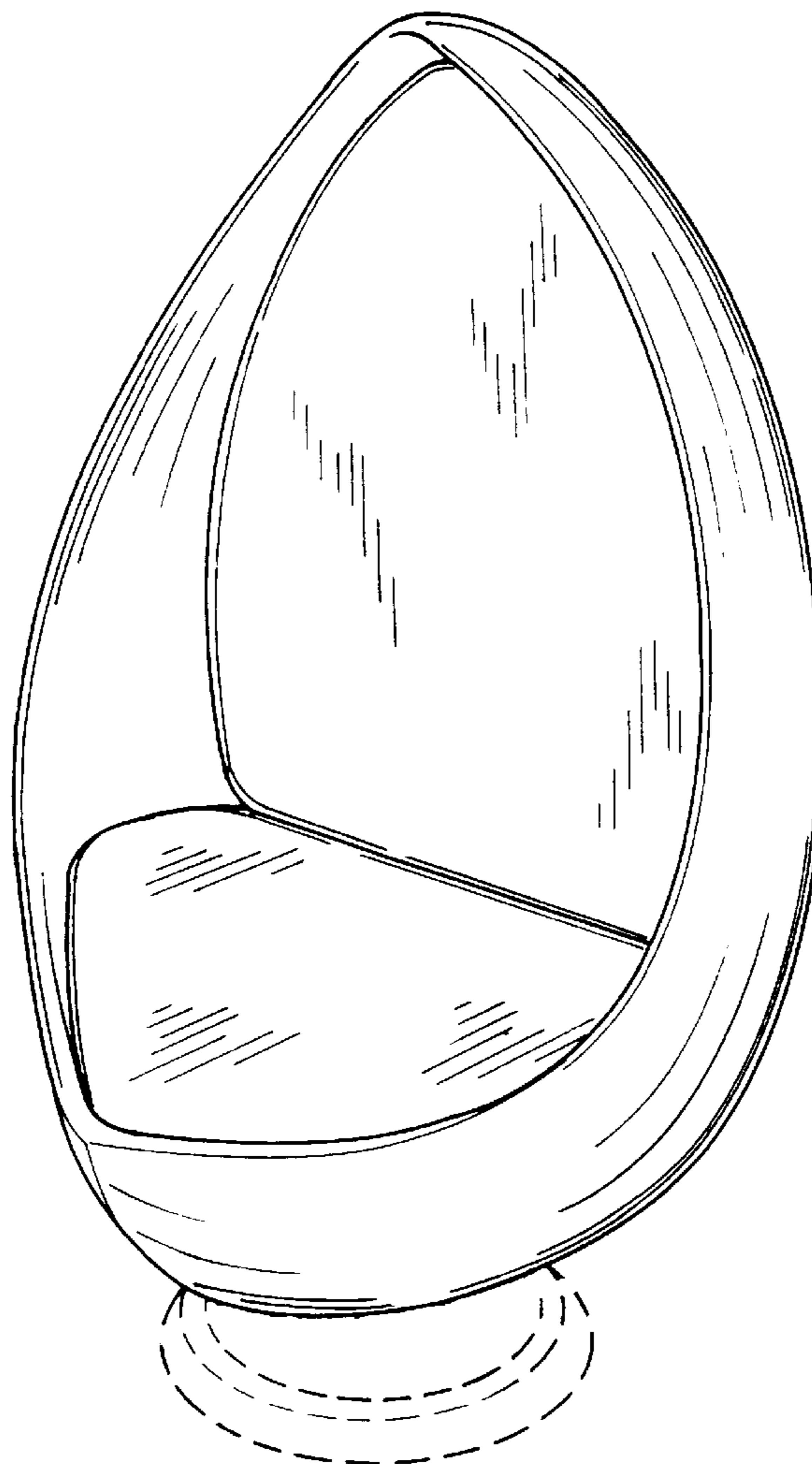
FIG. 1 is a top, front and right side perspective view of a chair, showing my new design, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof; and,

FIG. 2 is a bottom, rear and left side perspective view, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof.

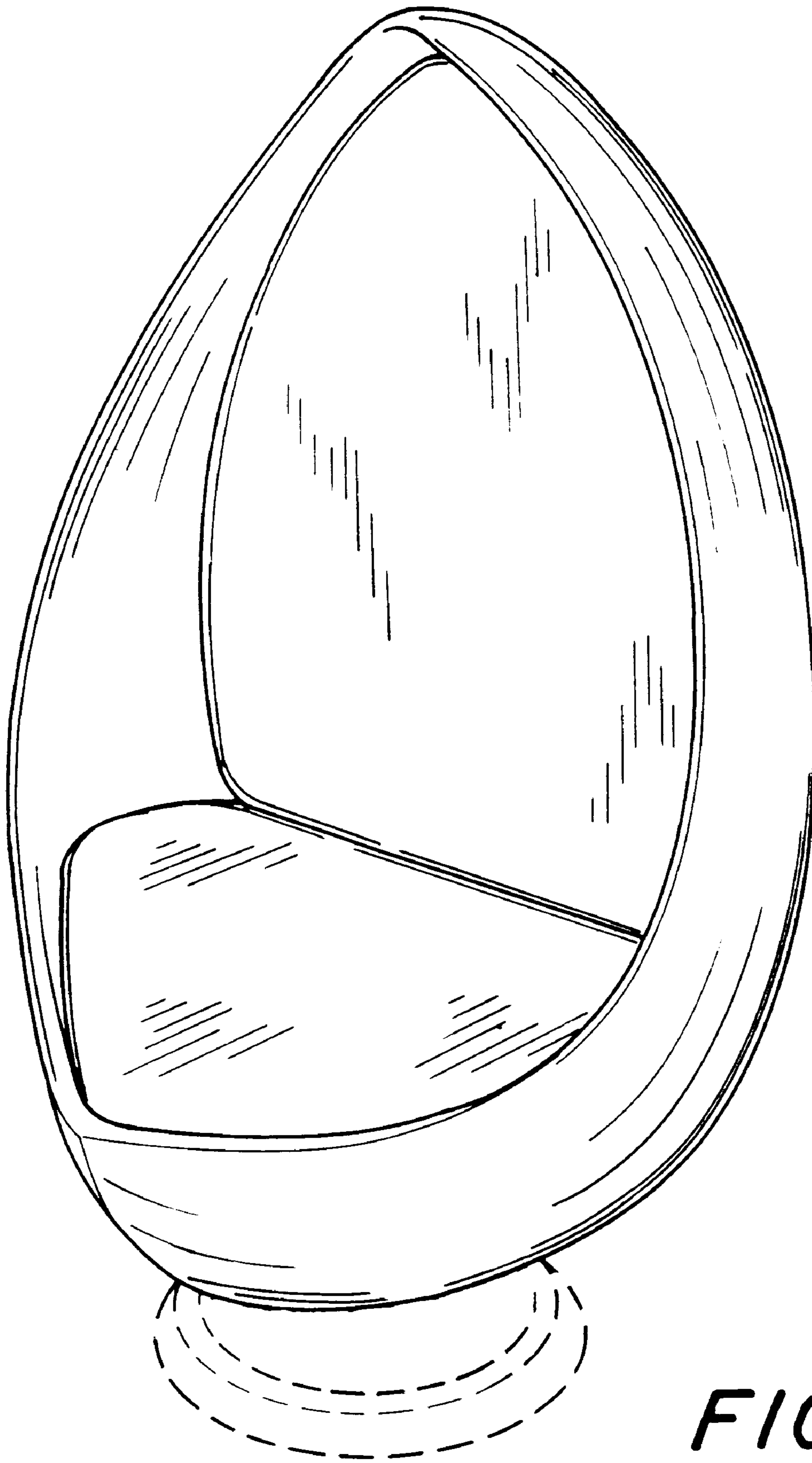
