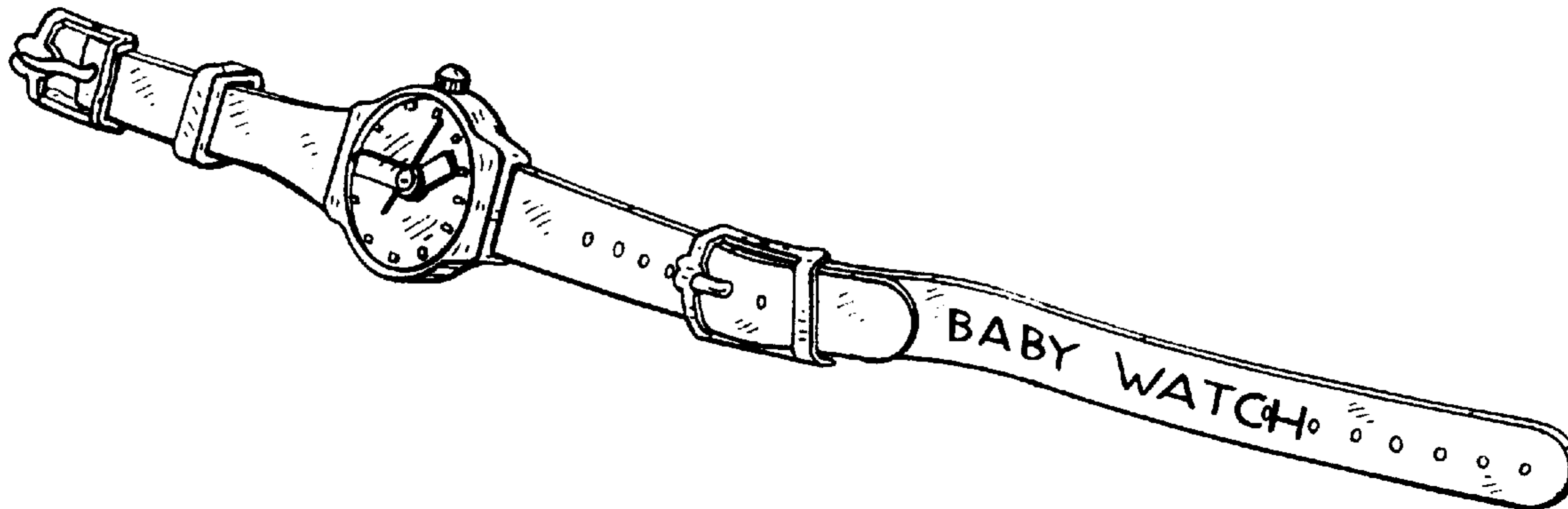
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side being substantially the same, plain and unornamented, without the winder knob.

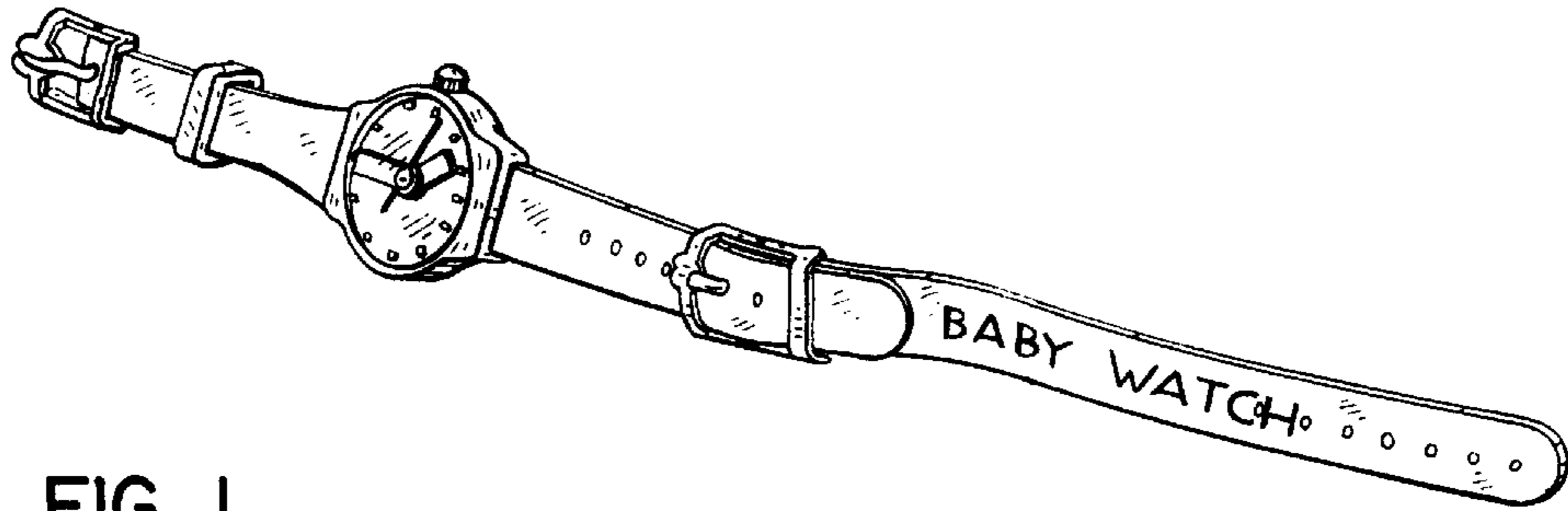

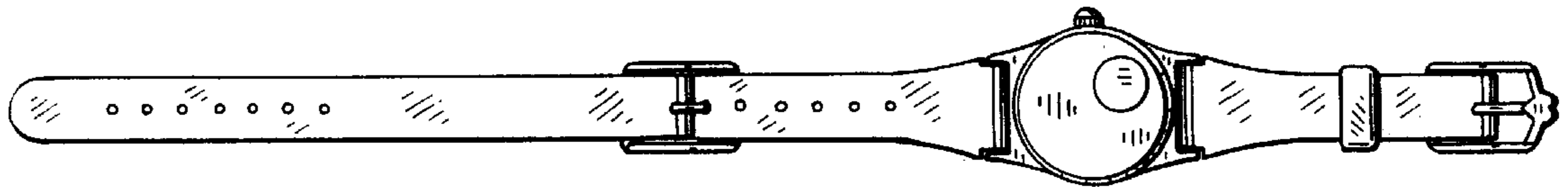
