DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the ring embodying the new design showing the gemstone and gemstone retention means in broken lines;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof, the bottom being plain and unornamented;

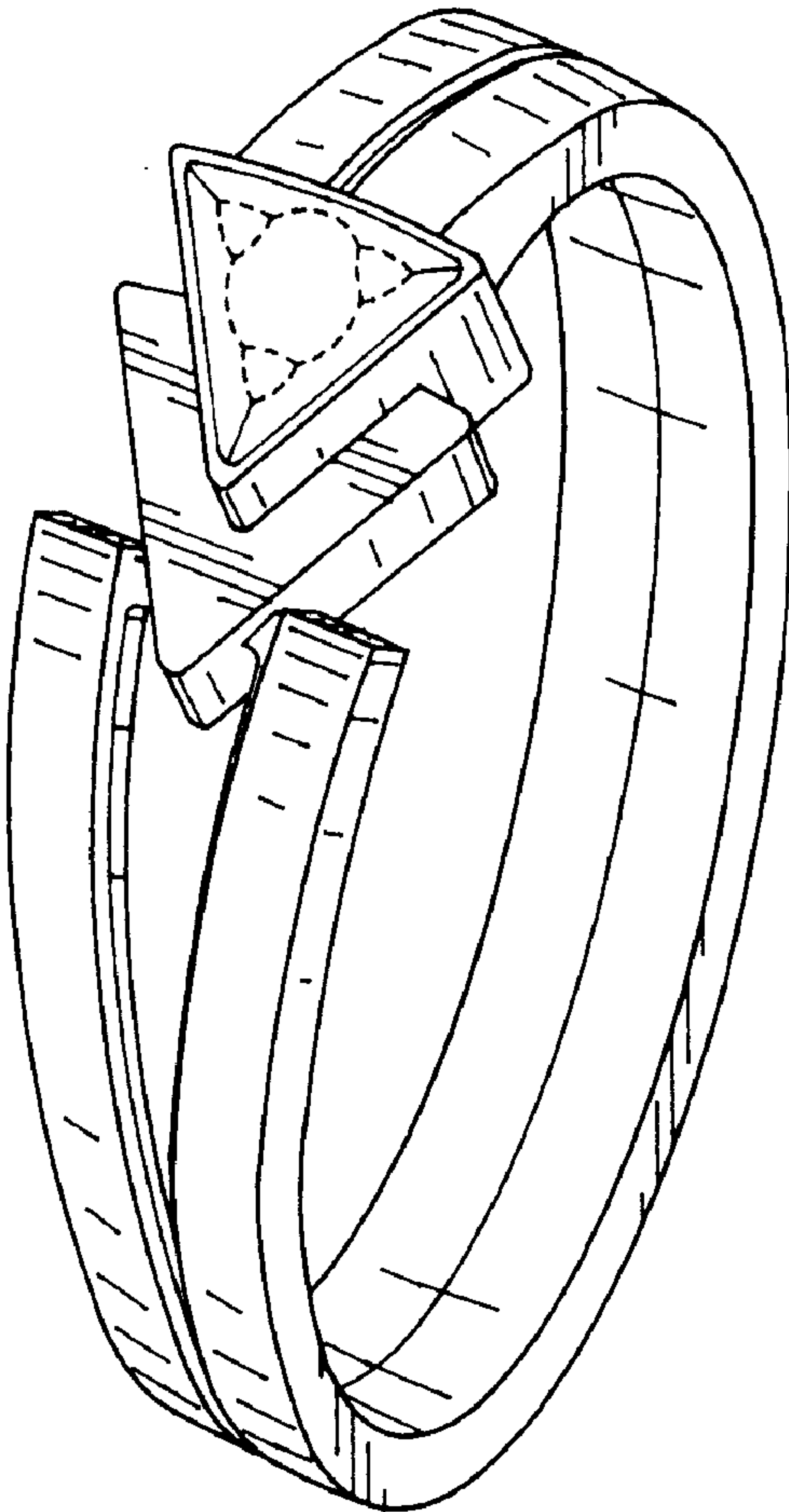
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear being a mirror image of the front;

FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof; and,

FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view thereof.

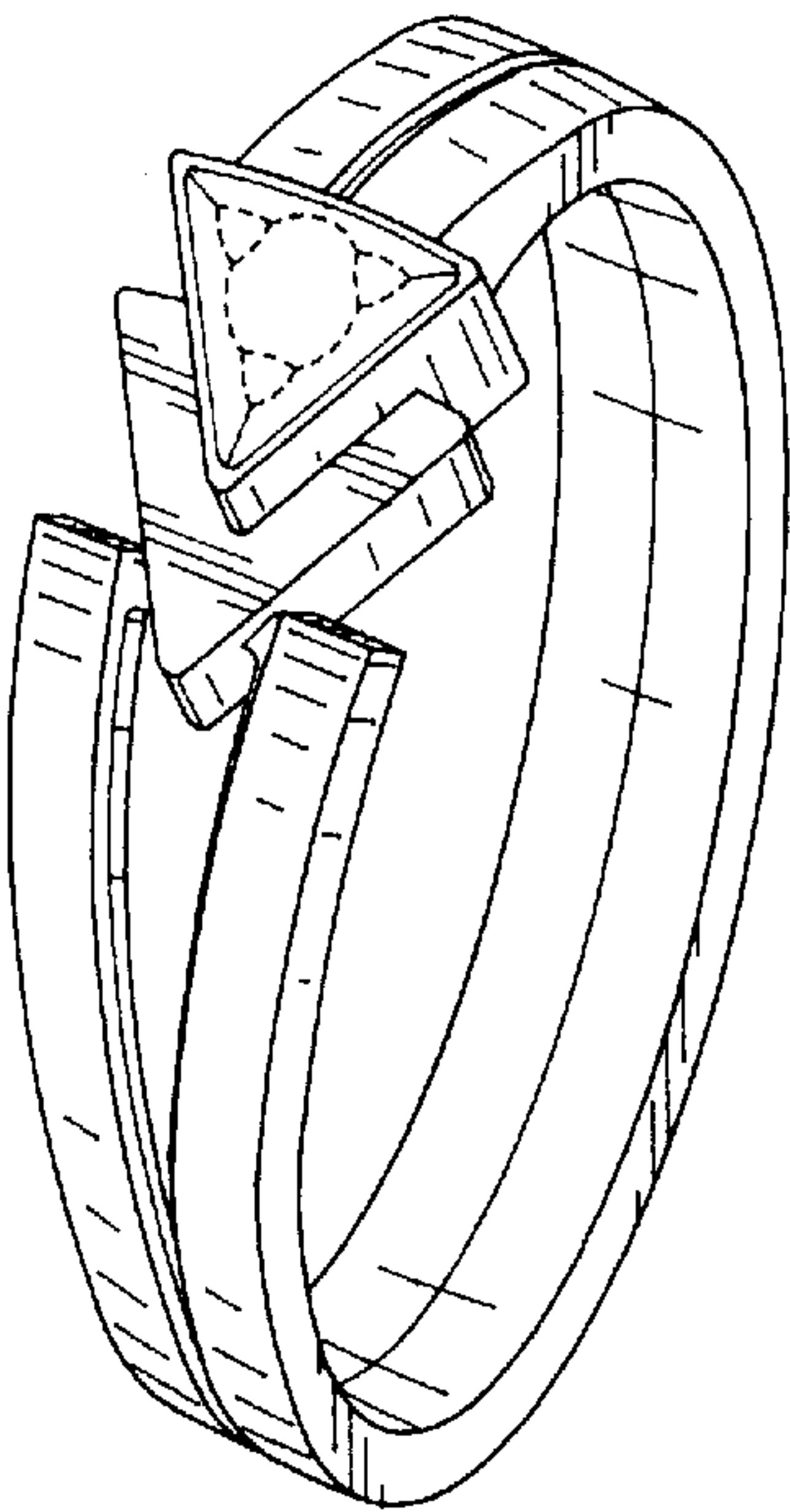

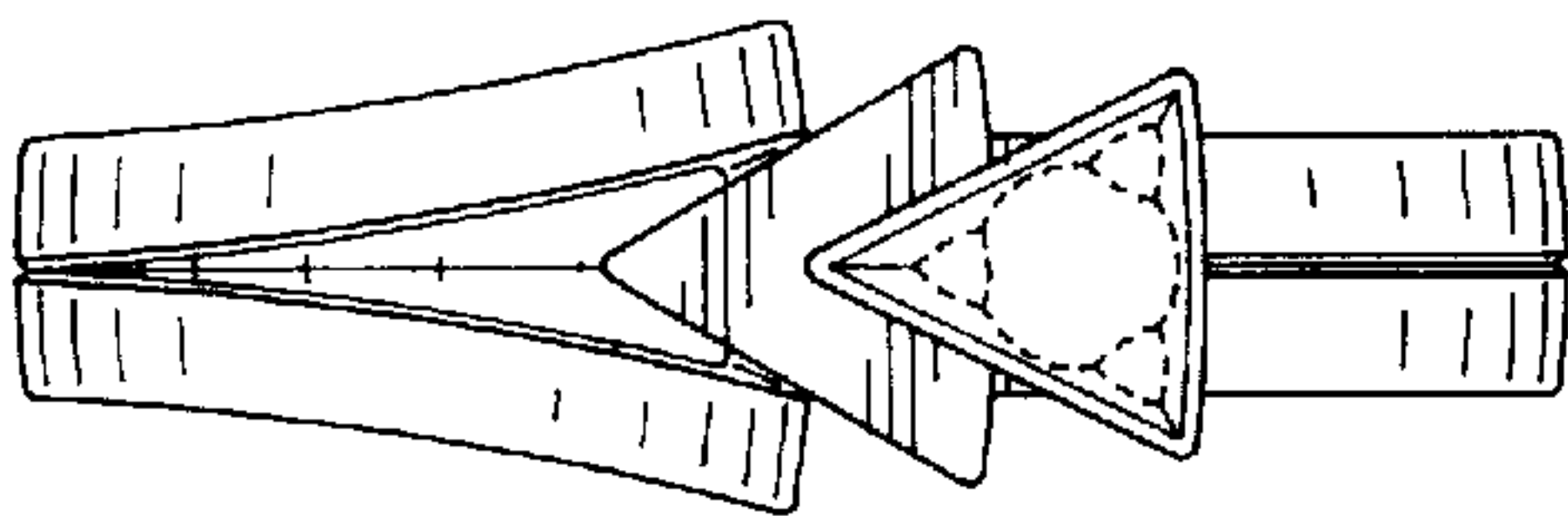

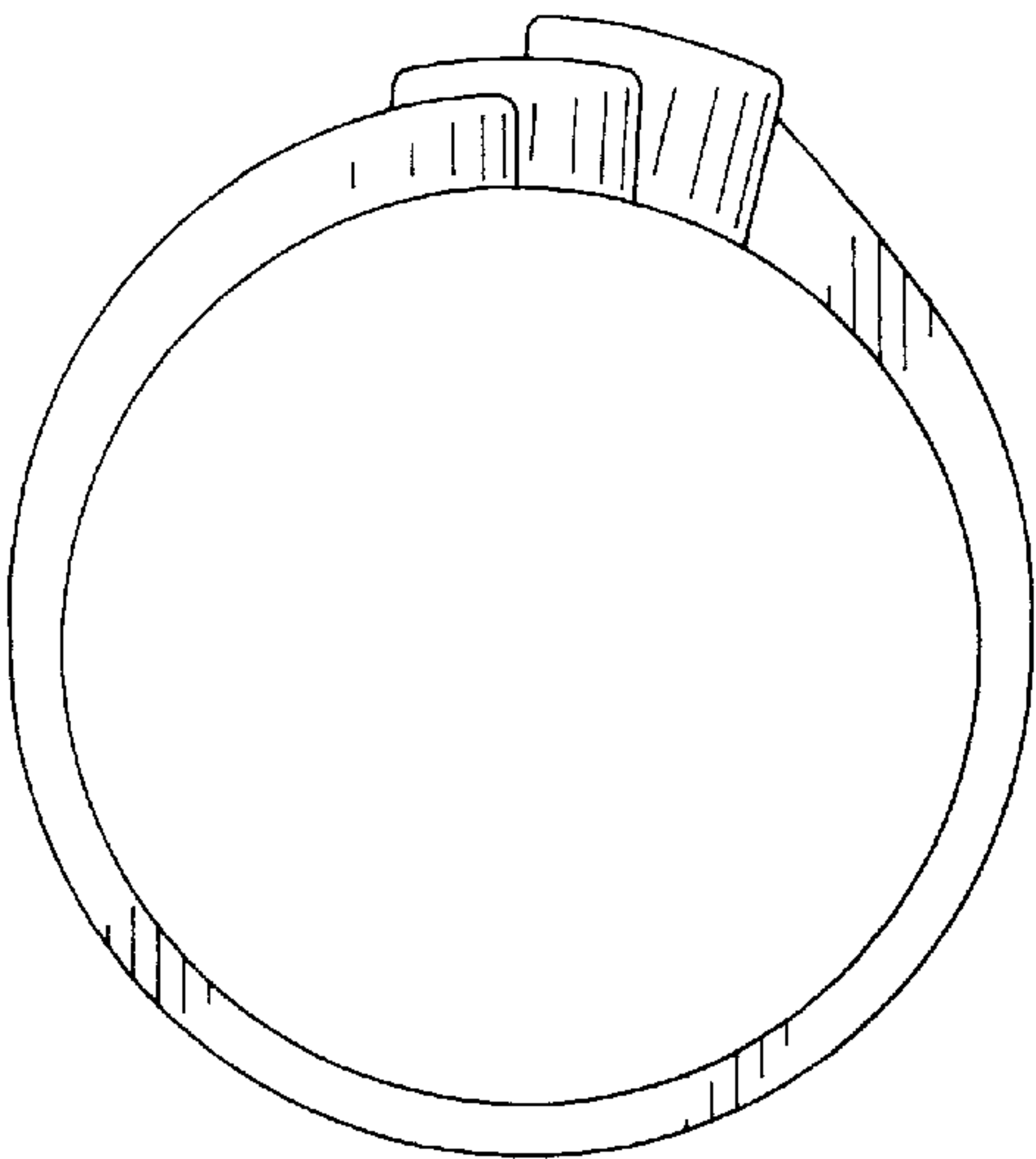

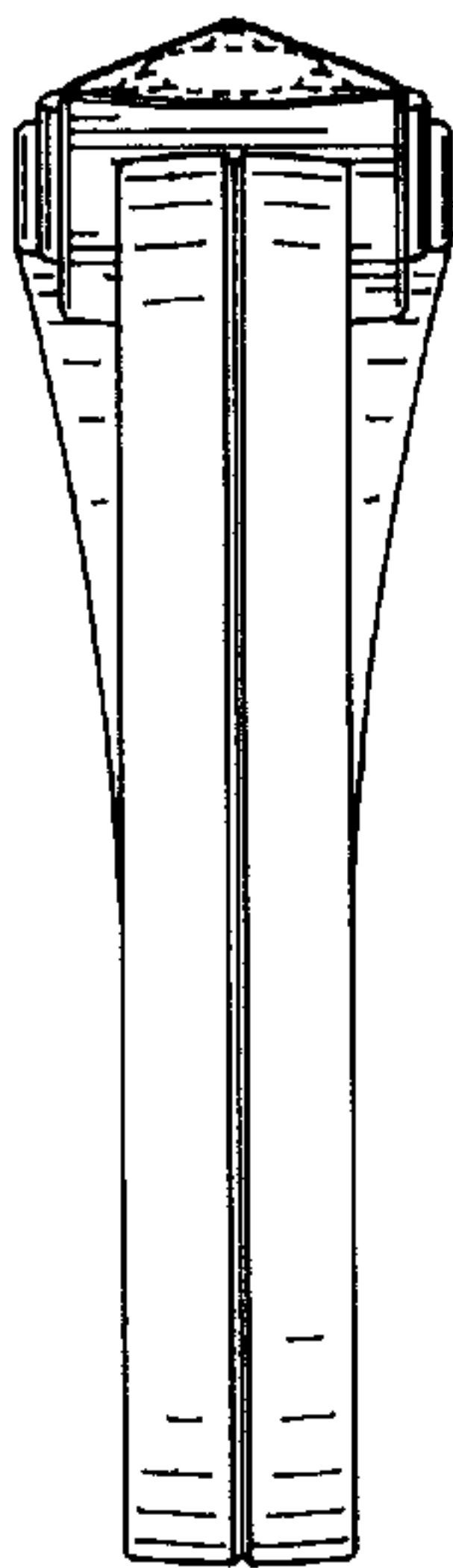

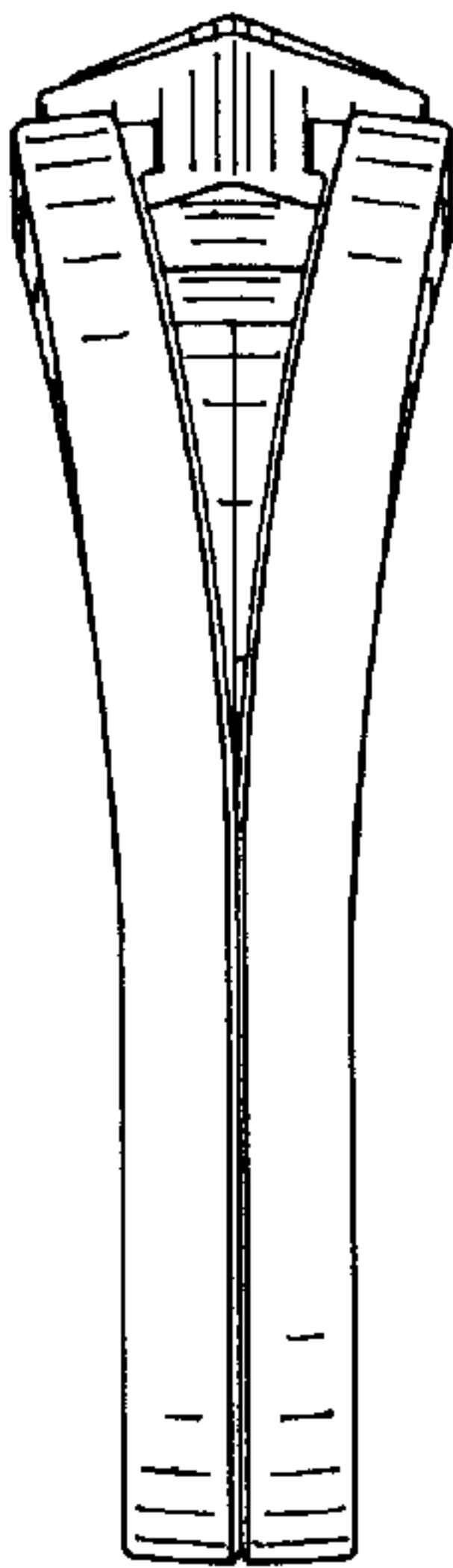
