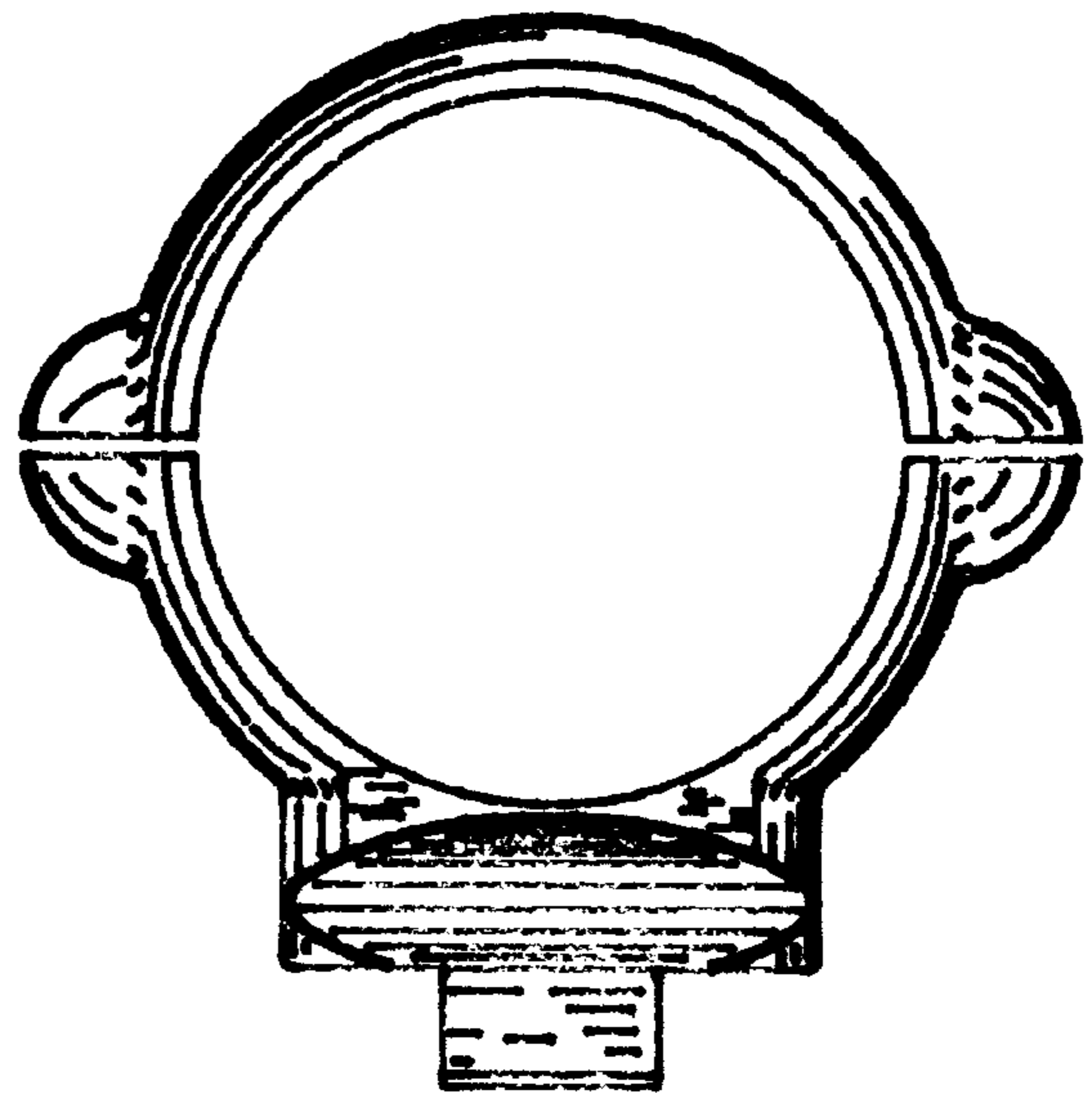
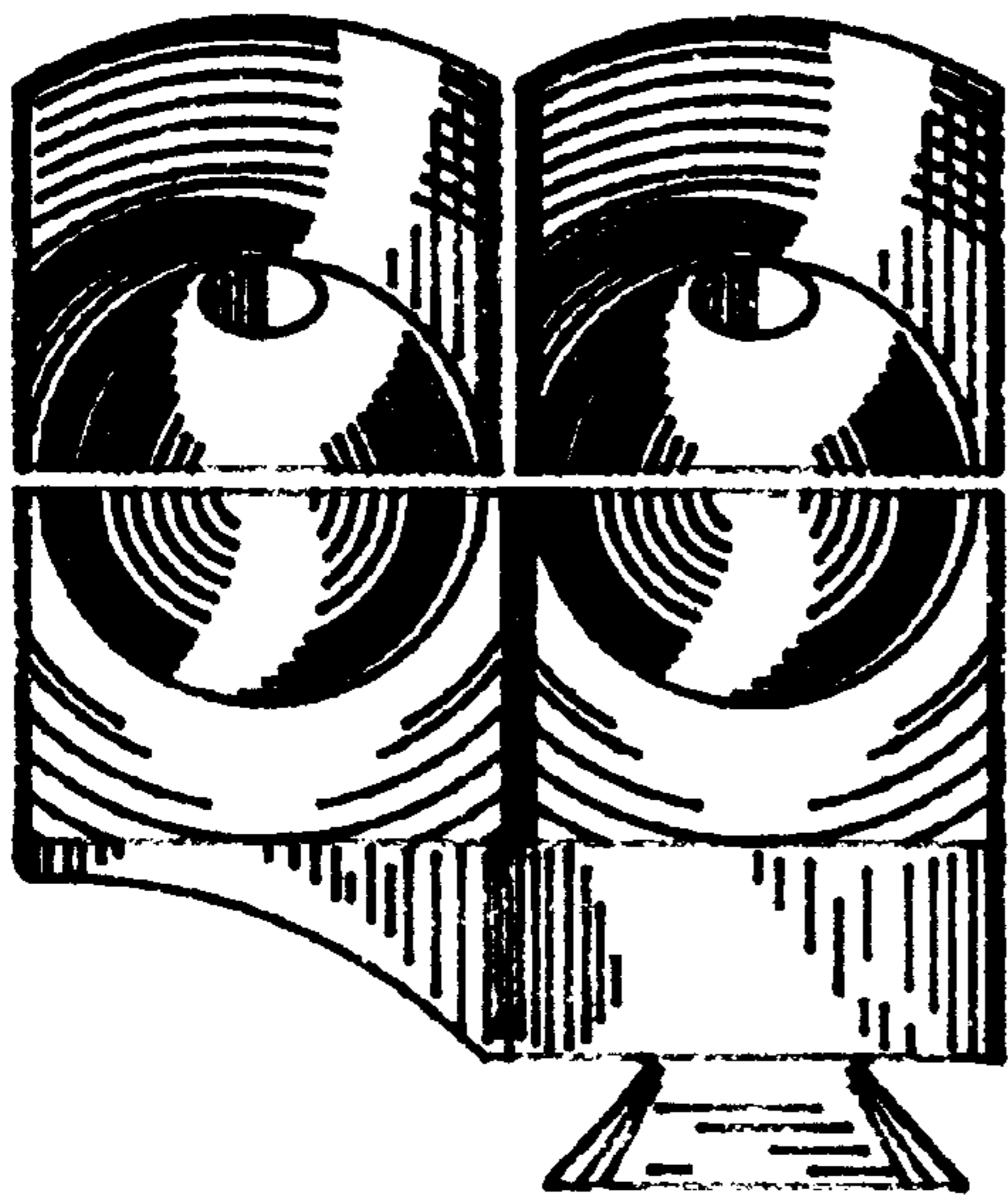
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a telescopic sight mounting ring with a single root, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a telescopic sight mounting ring with a single root showing my new design. FIG. 2 is a opposite side view thereof; FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof; and, FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof.

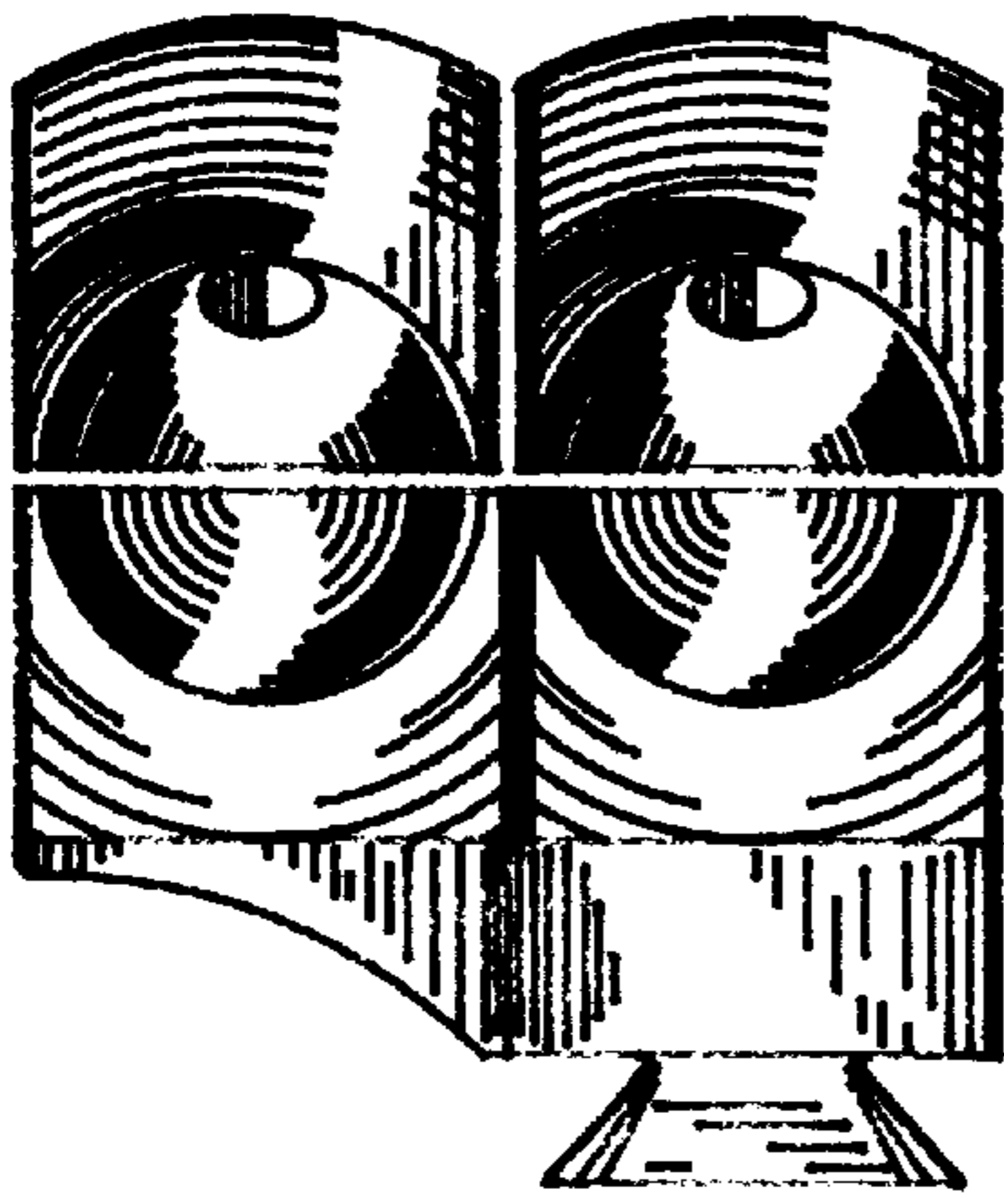

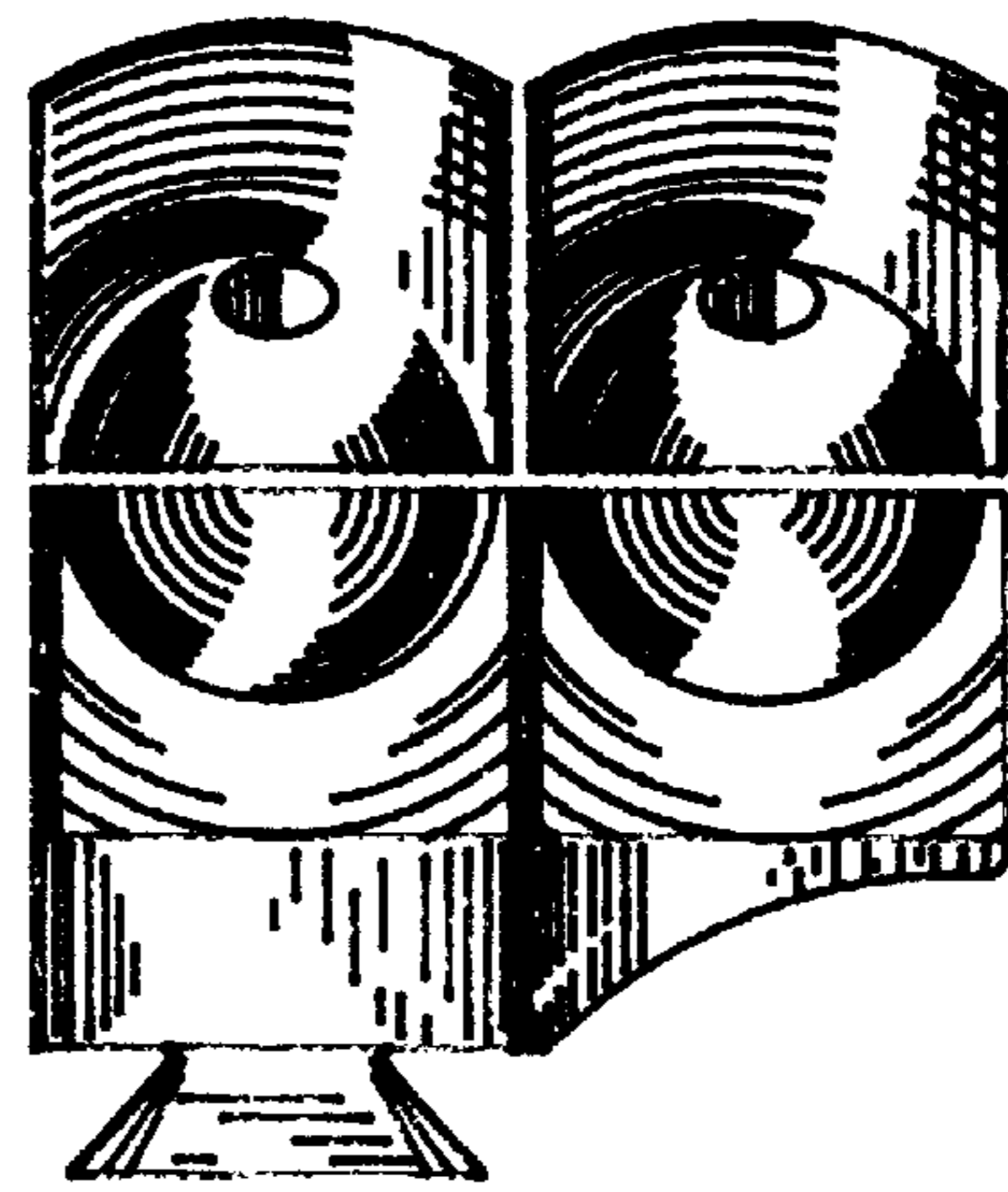

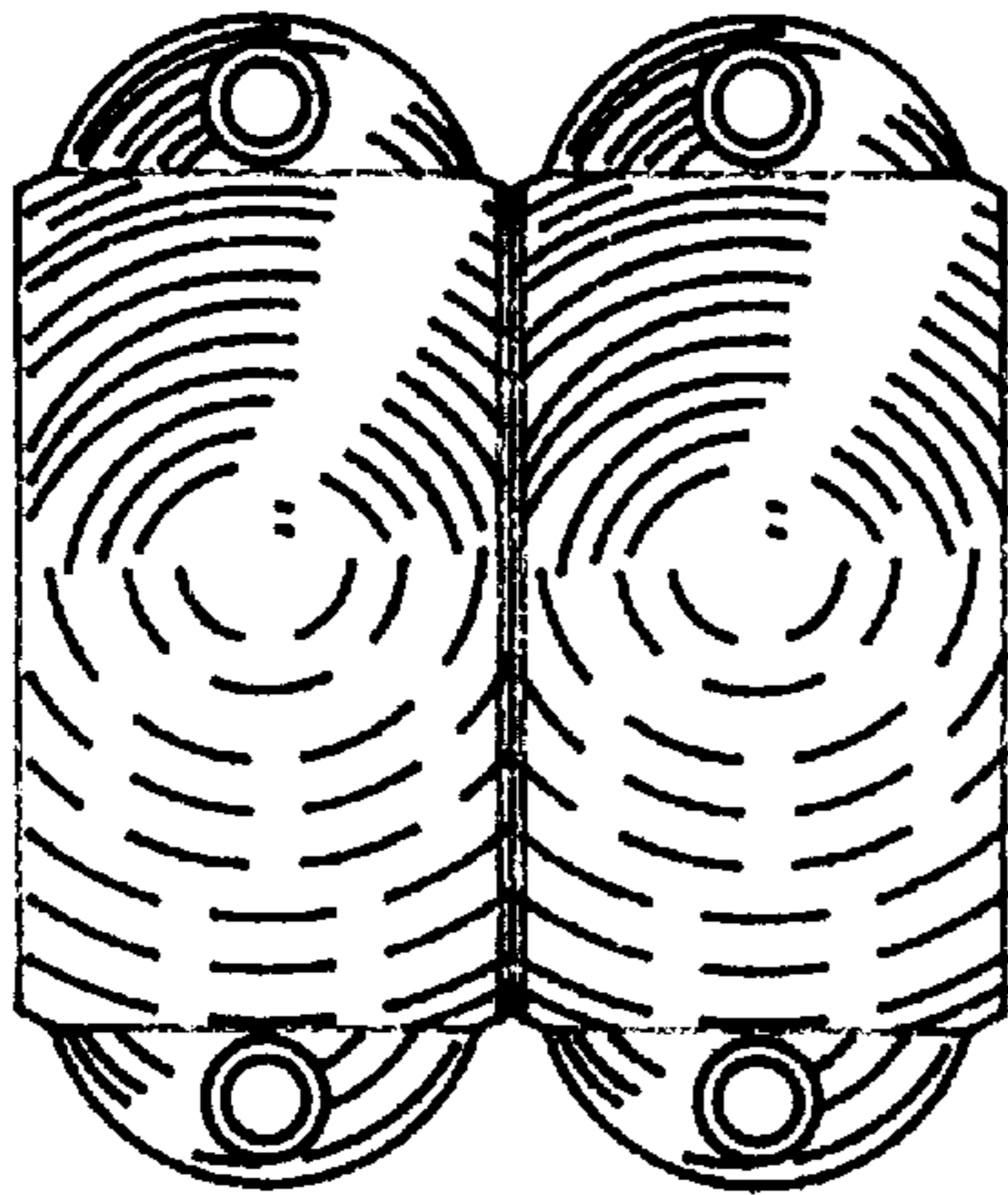

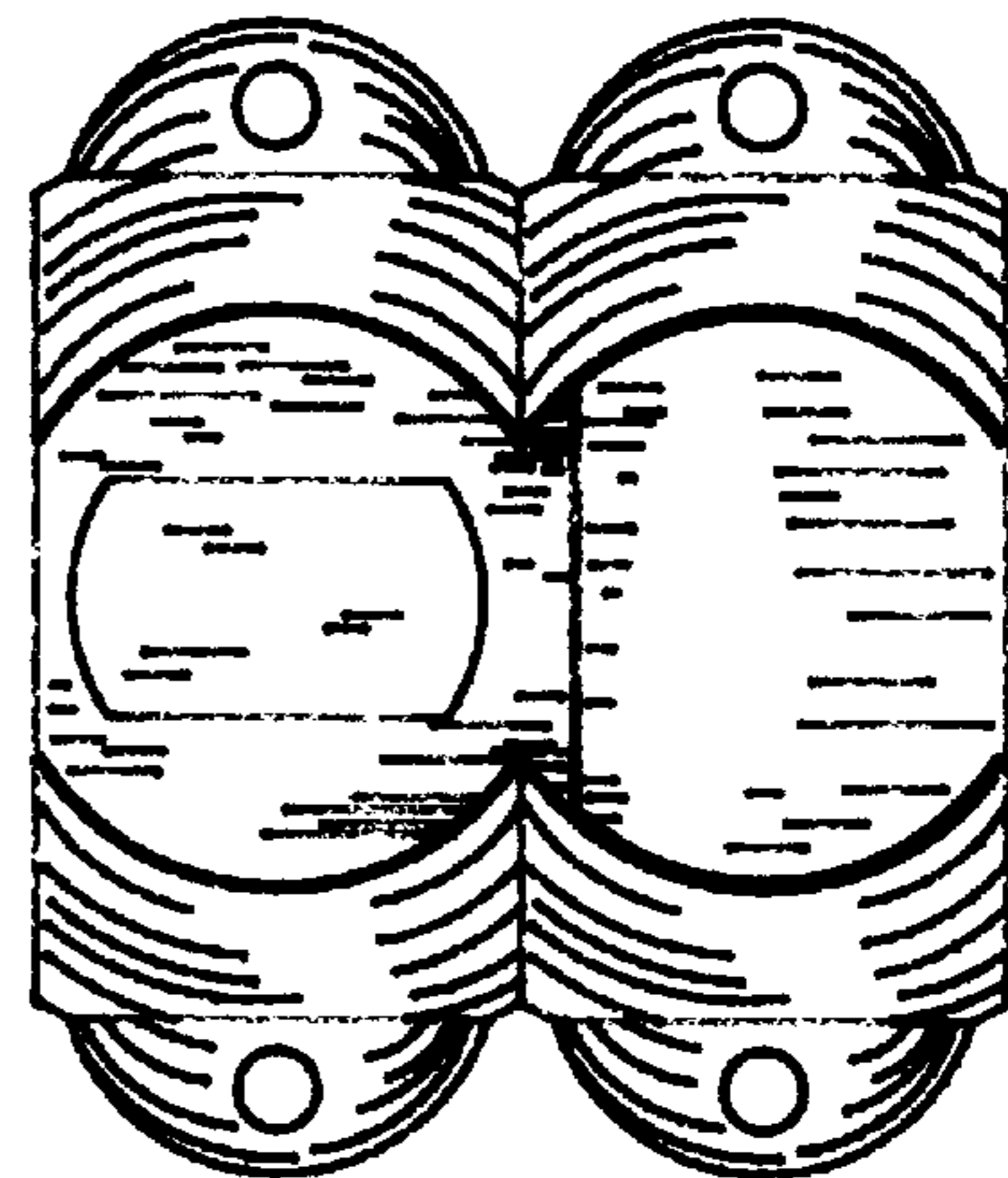

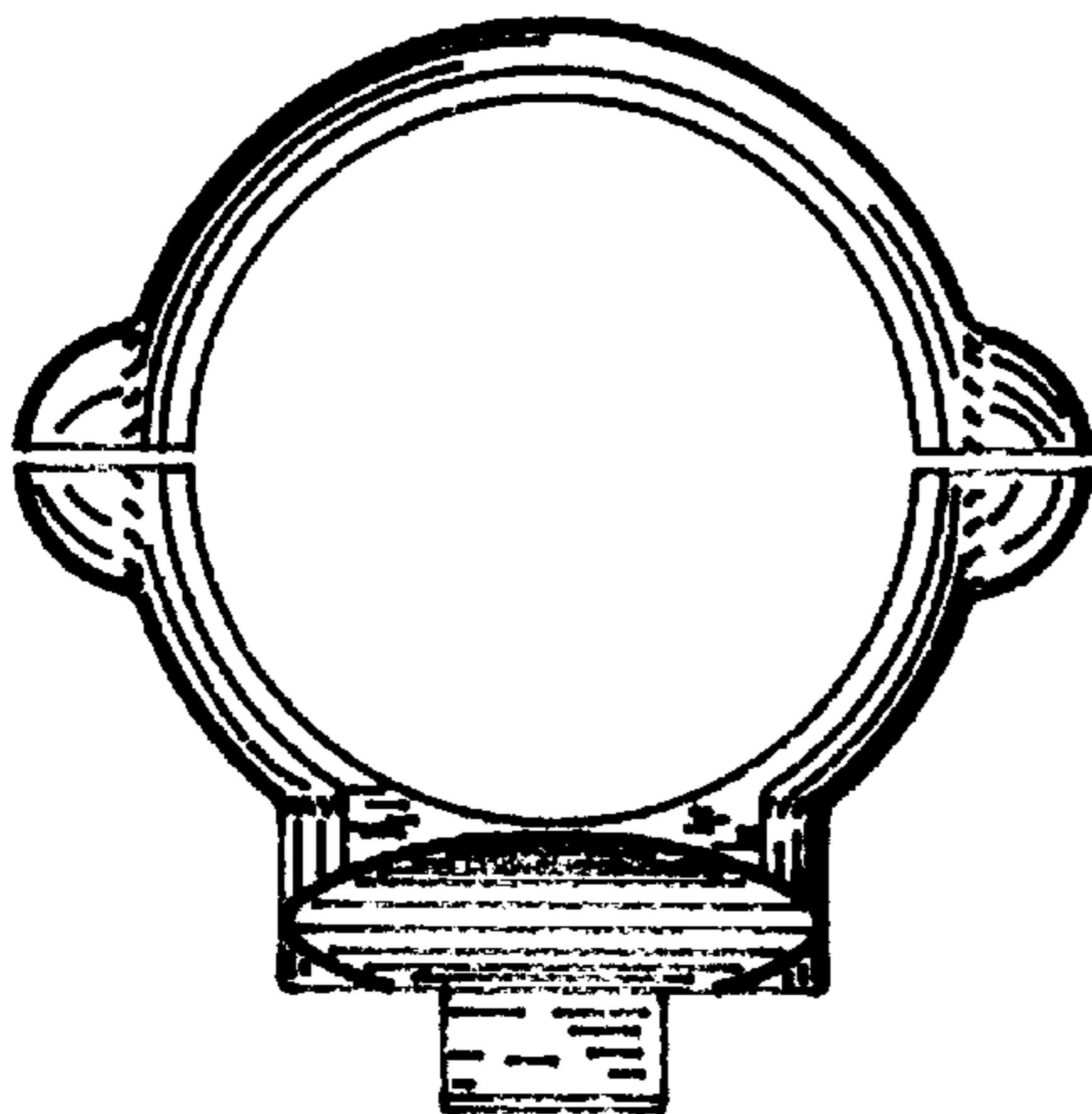

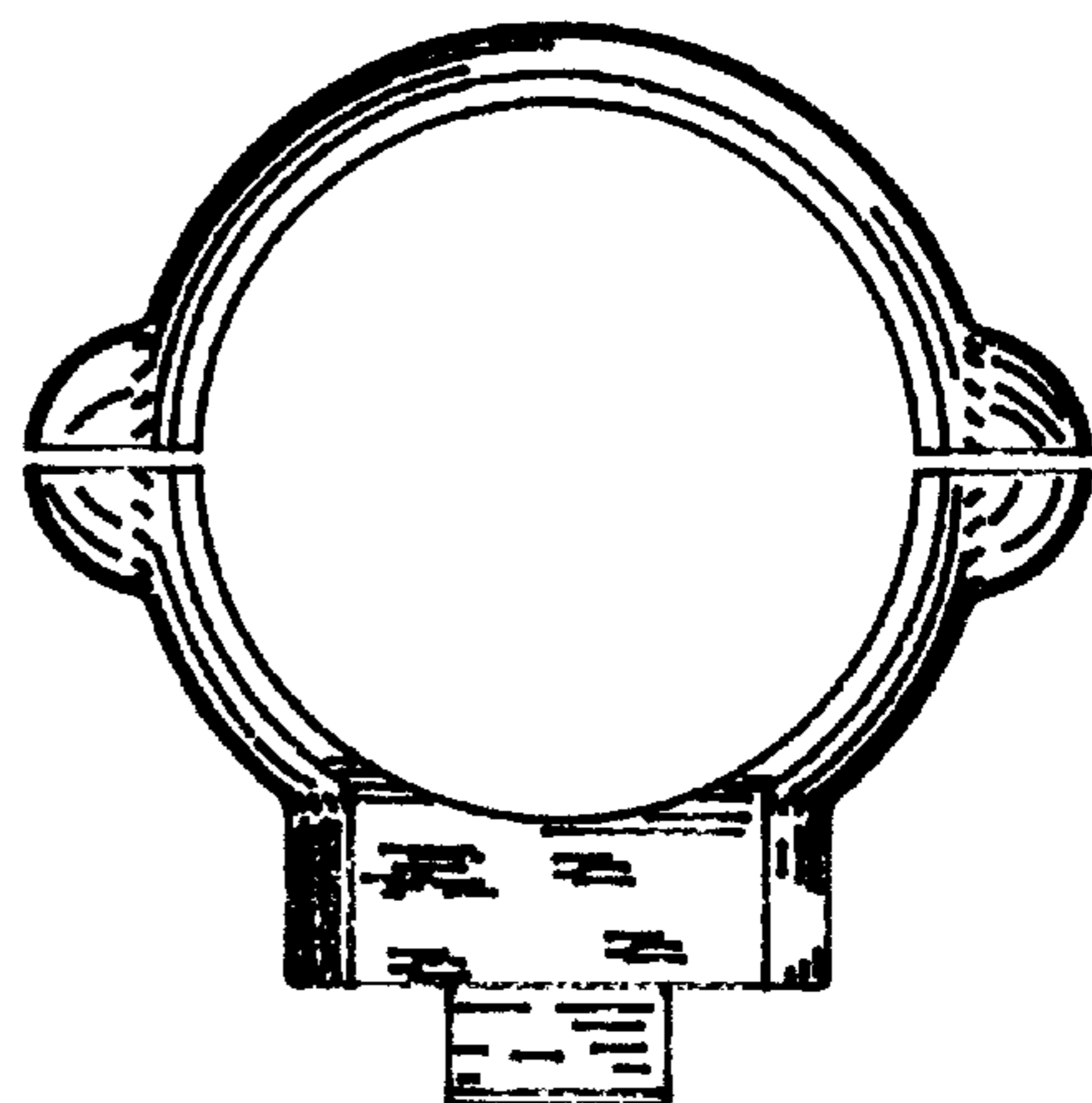
