FIG. 5 is a top plan view of the pedicure slipper of FIG. 1; and,

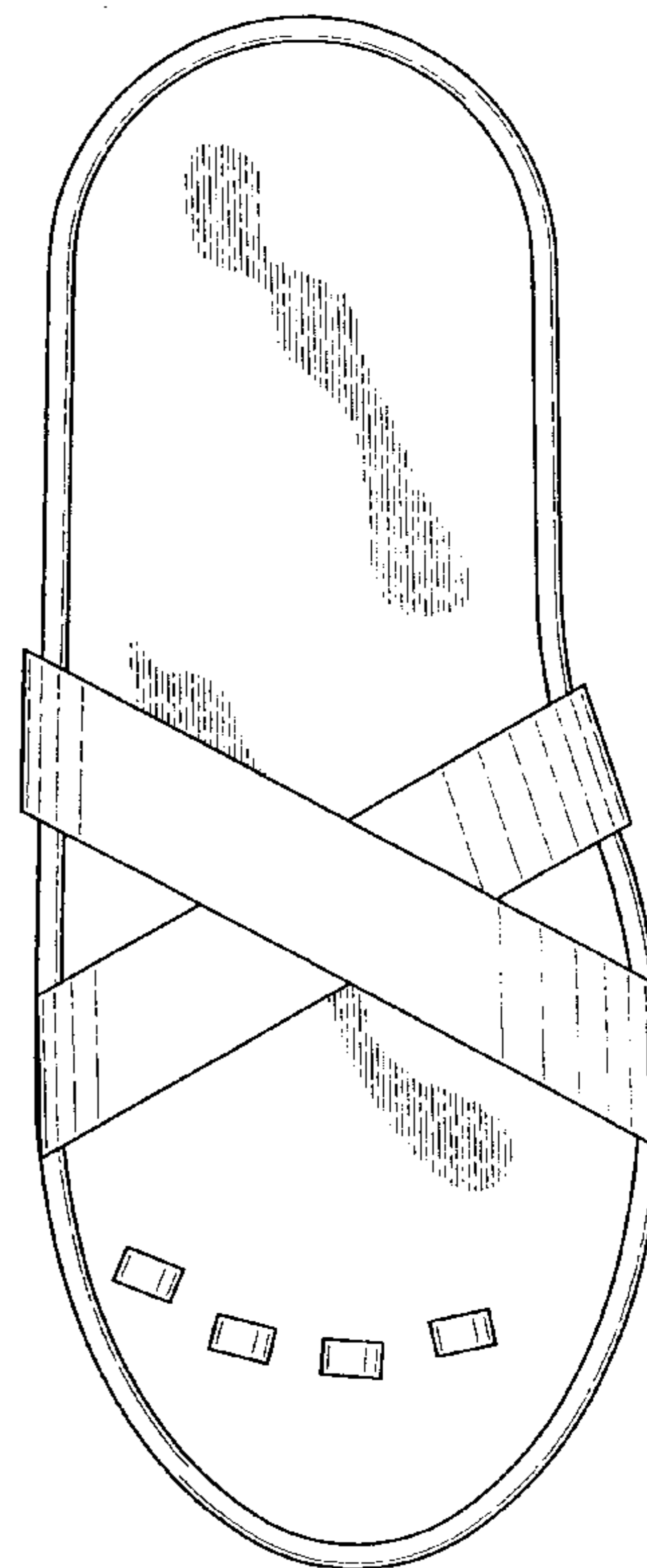
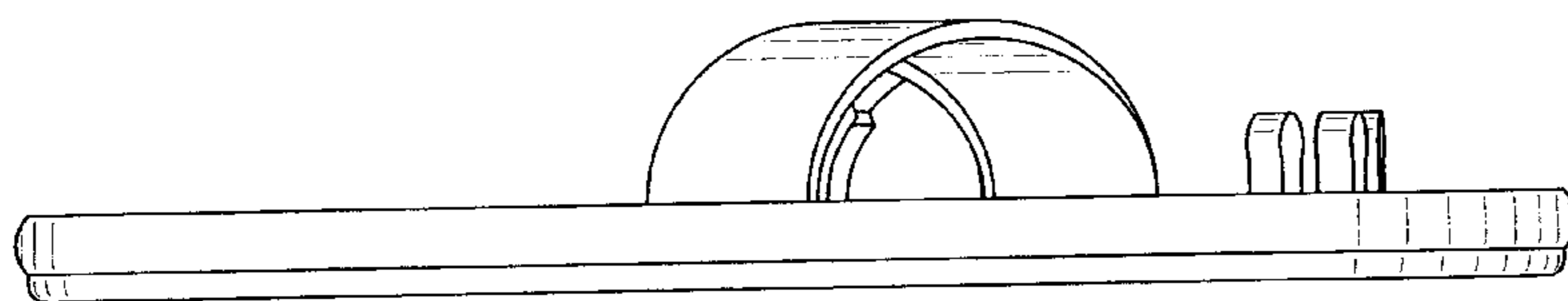
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of the pedicure slipper of FIG. 1.

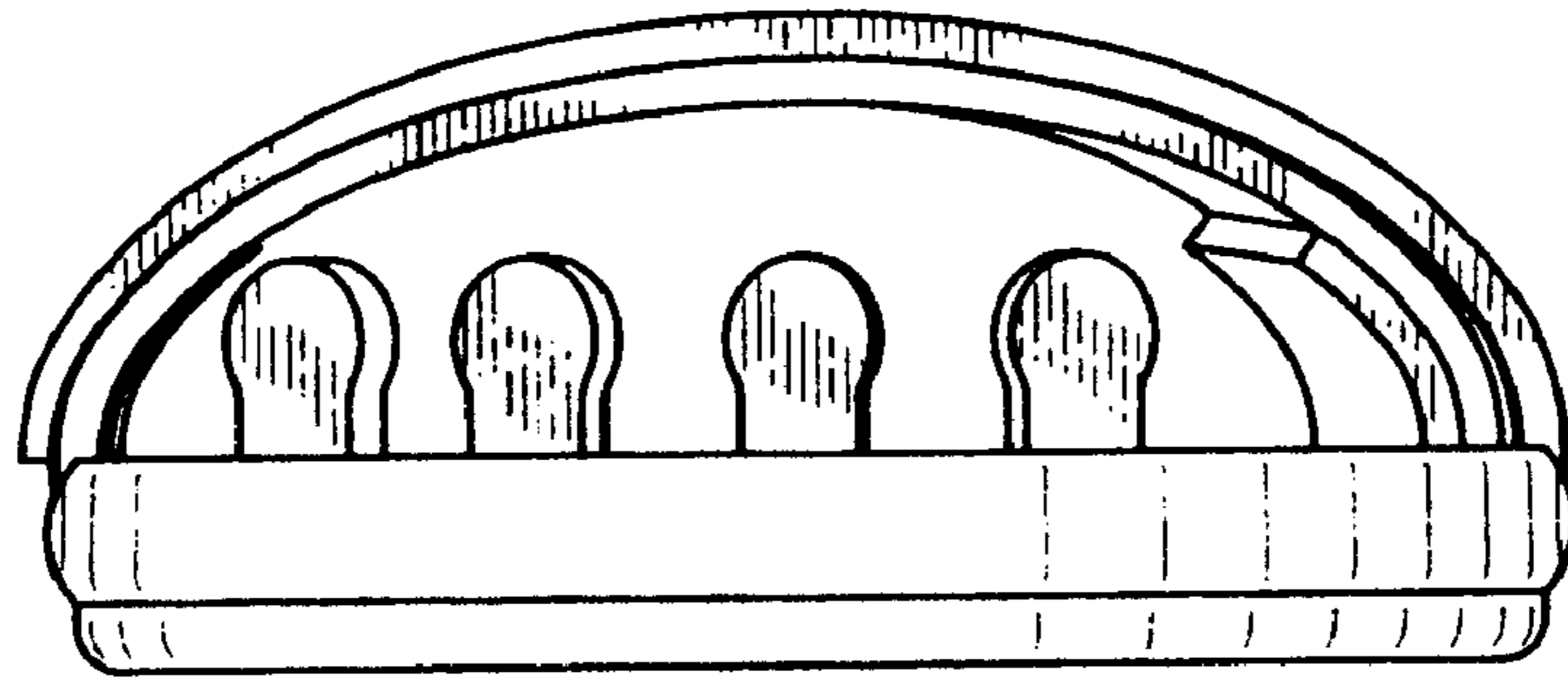

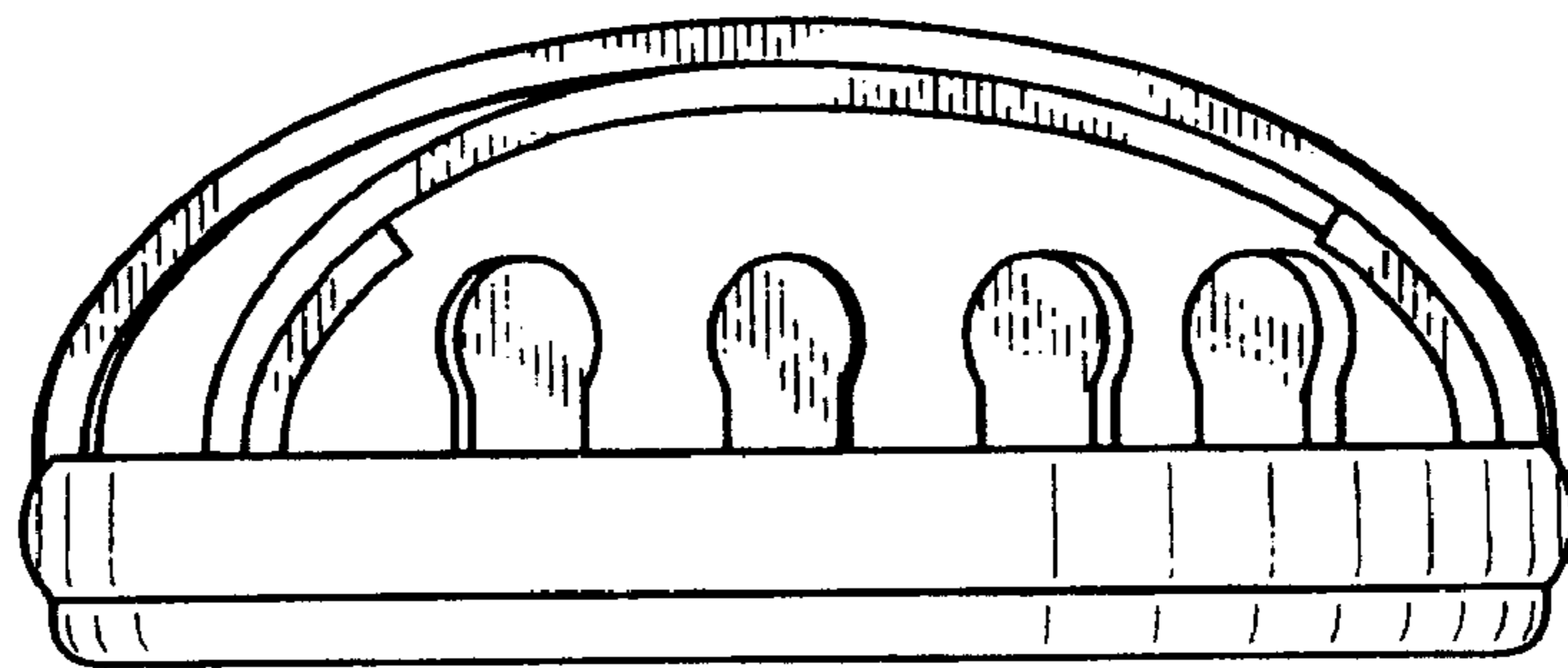

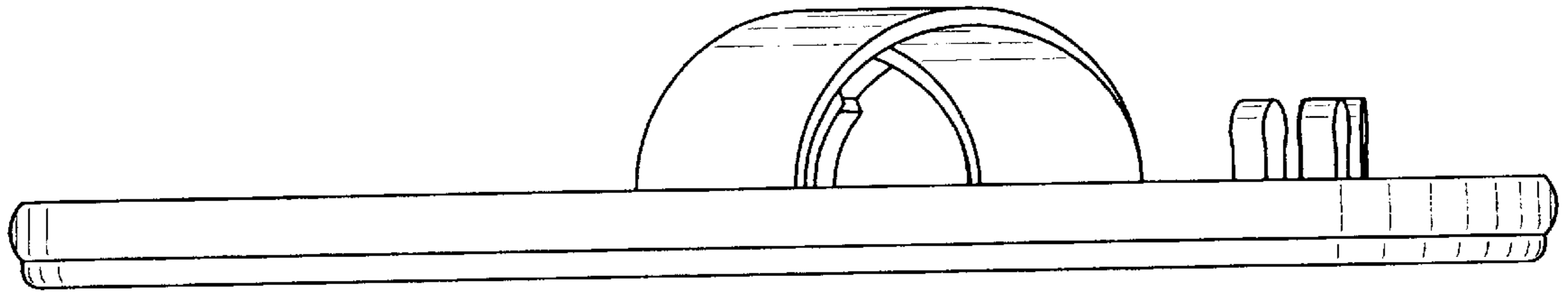

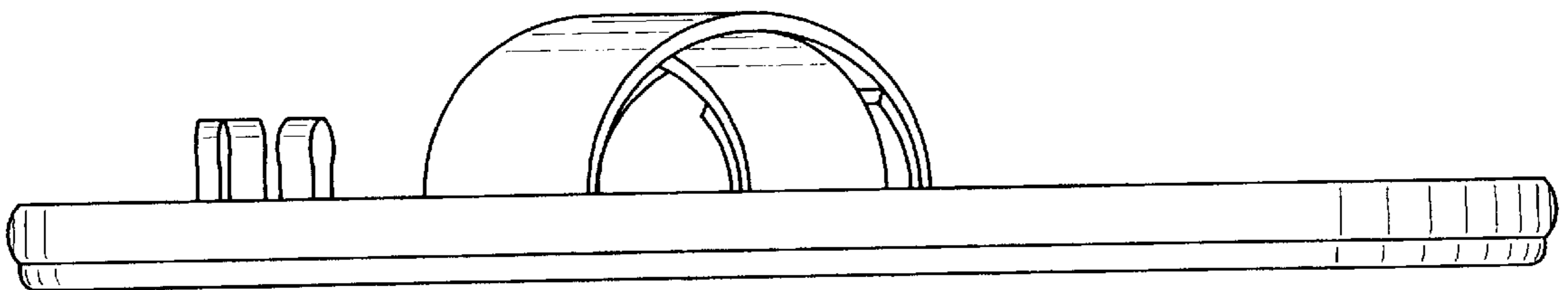

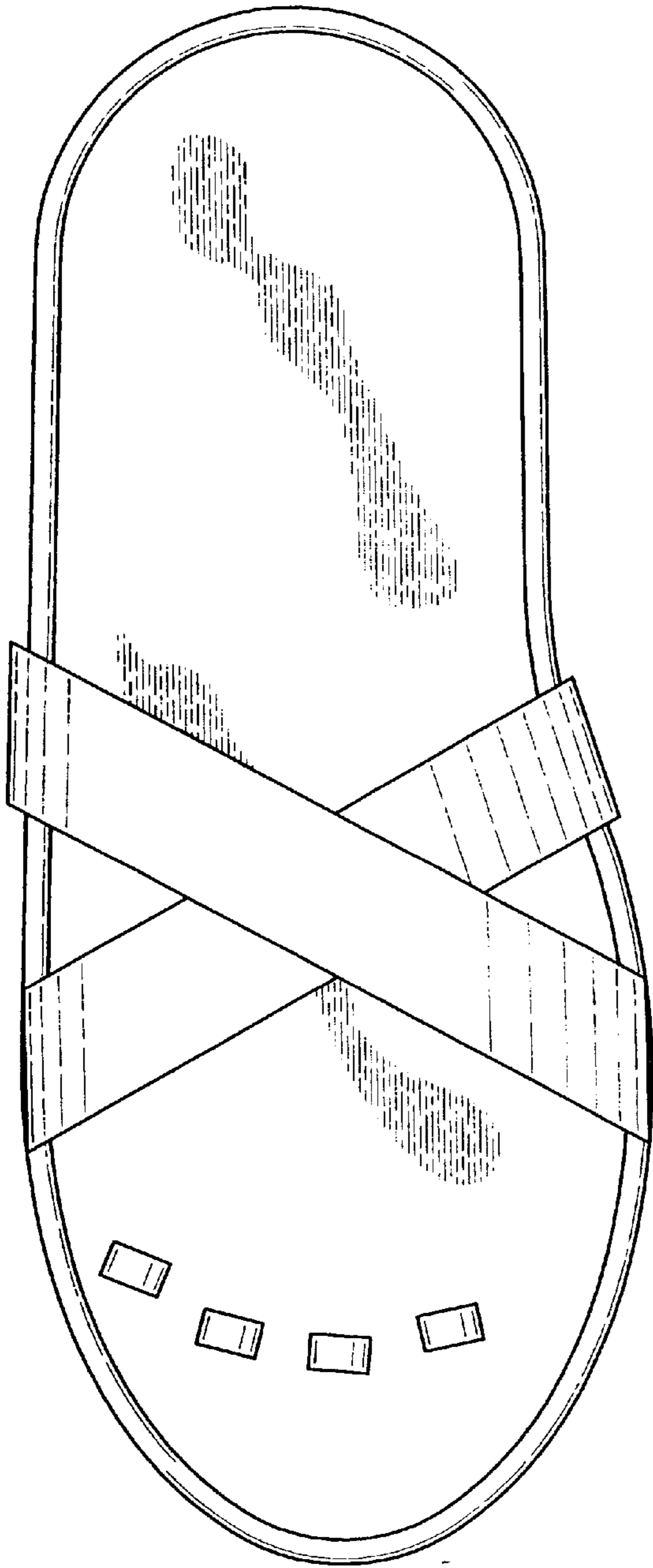

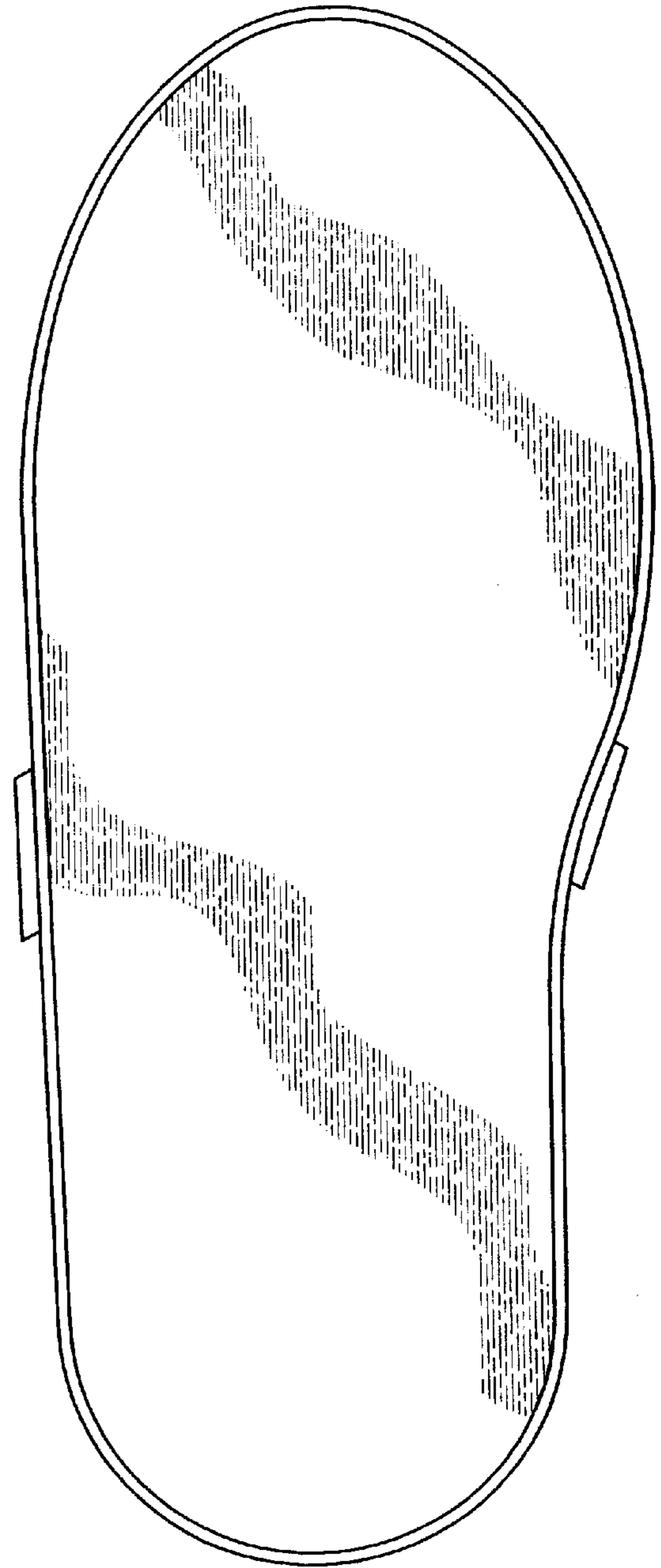
