The ornamental design for a vault door for a telephone paystation, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view, looking toward the top, left side

and front of a first embodiment of my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view of FIG. 1; the left side being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 1;

FIG. 7 is a front elevational view of a second embodiment, illustrating my new design;

FIG. 8 is a front elevational view of a third embodiment, illustrating my new design;

FIG. 9 is a front elevational view of a fourth embodiment, illustrating my new design;

FIG. 10 is a front elevational view of a fifth embodiment, illustrating my new design;

FIG. 11 is a front elevational view of a sixth embodiment, illustrating my new design;

FIG. 12 is a front elevational view of a seventh embodiment, illustrating my new design;

FIG. 13 is a front elevational view of an eighth embodiment, illustrating my new design;

FIG. 14 is a front elevational view of a ninth embodiment, illustrating my new design;

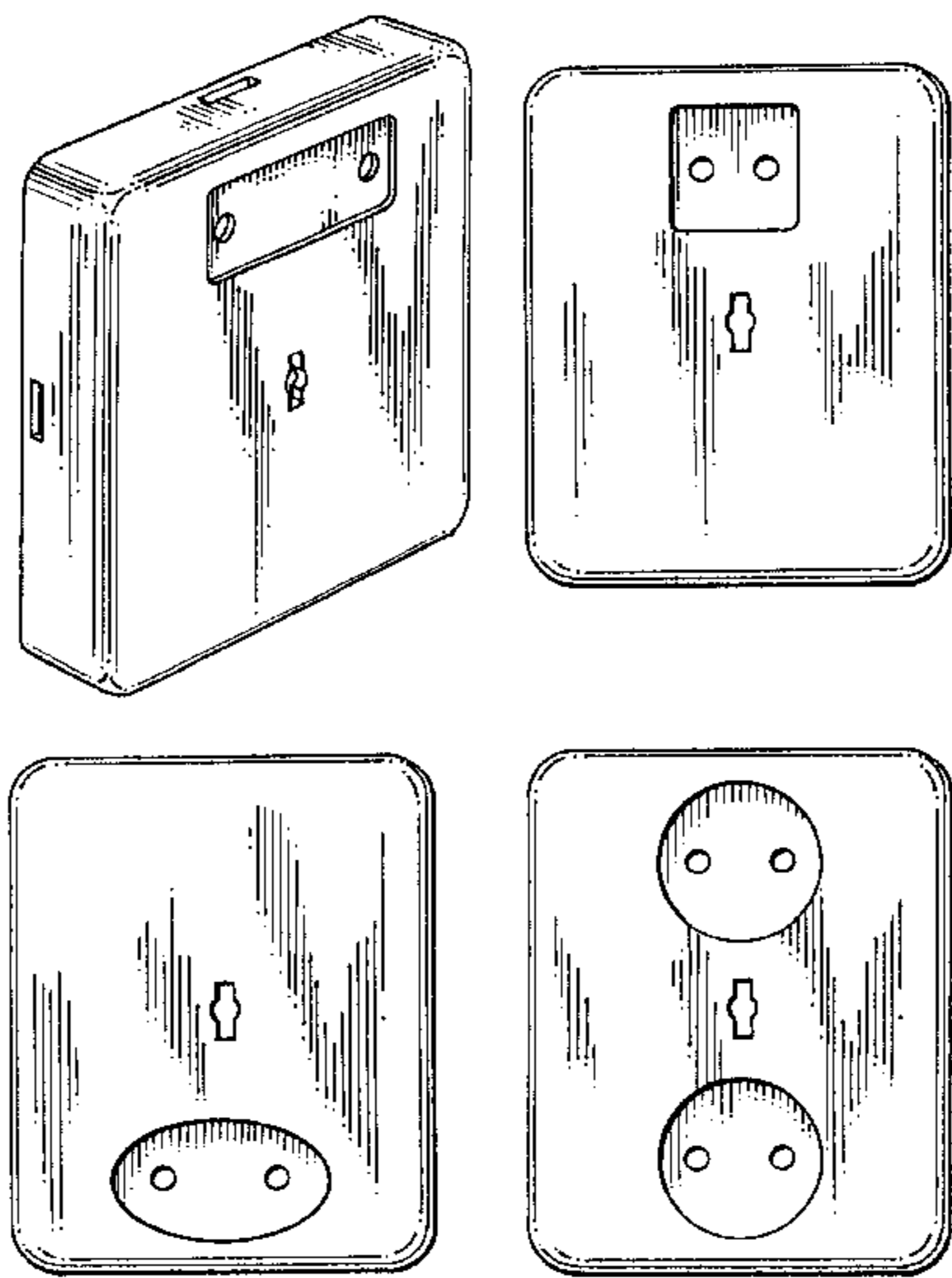
FIG. 15 is a front elevational view of a tenth embodiment, illustrating my new design;

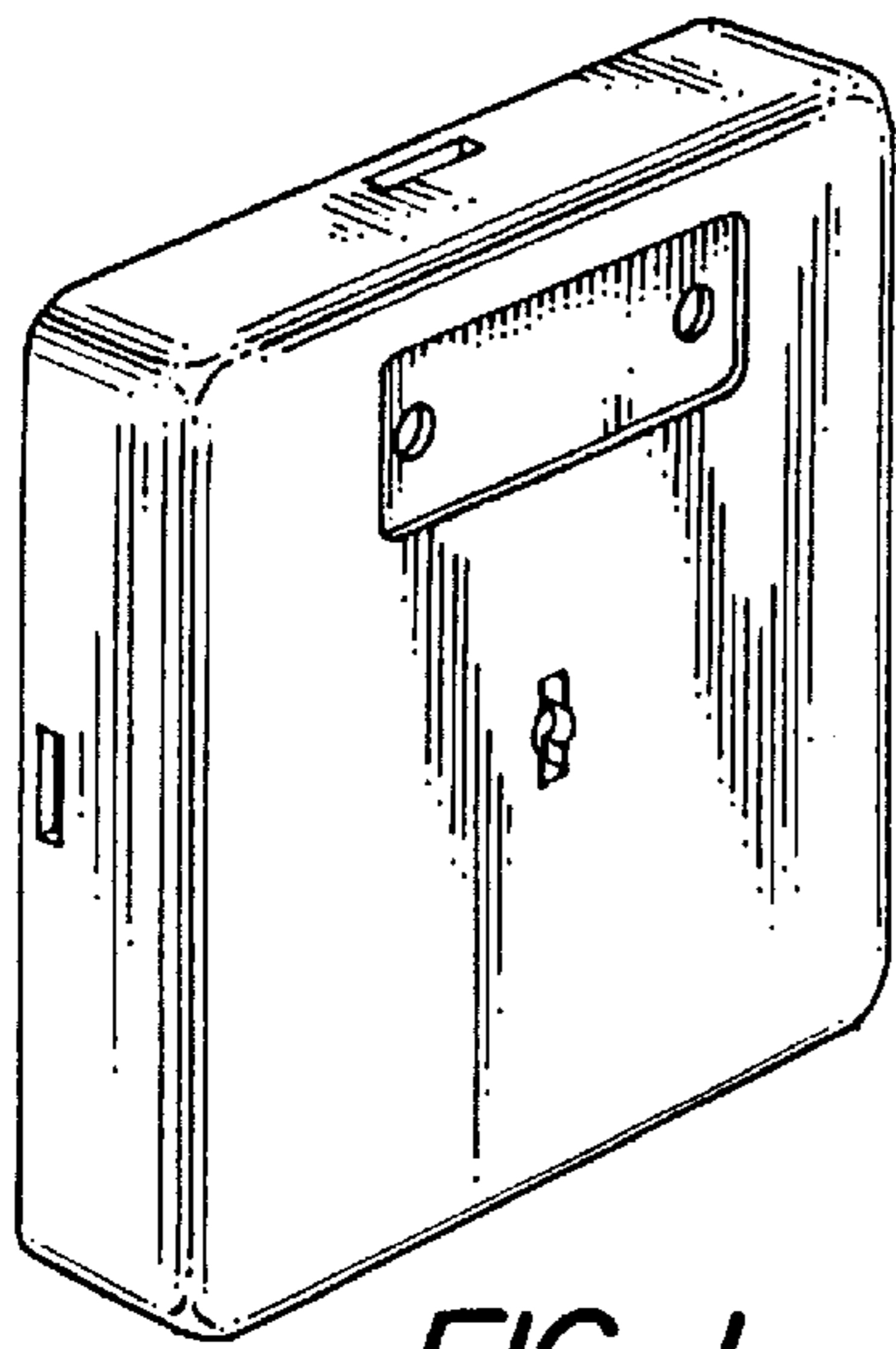

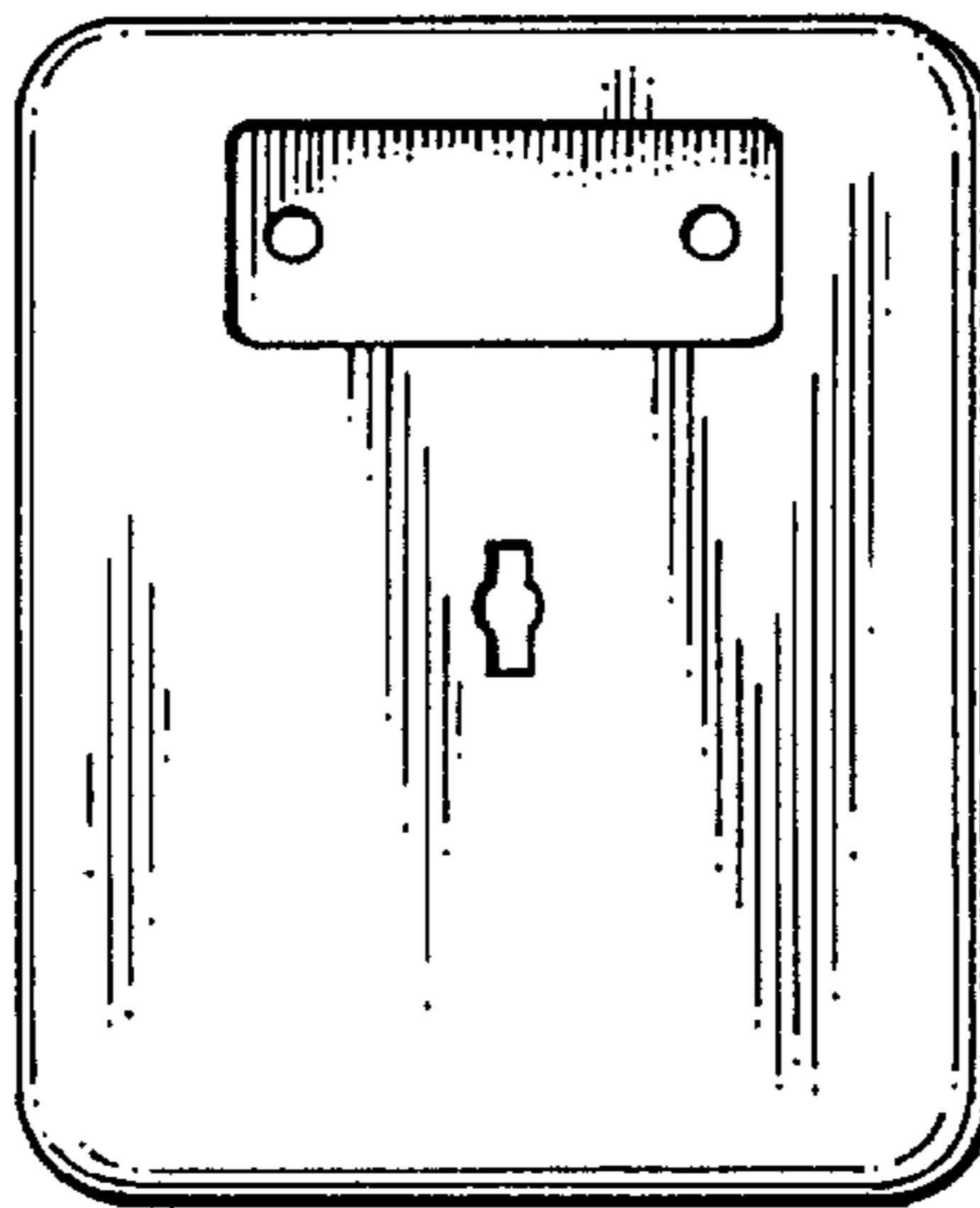

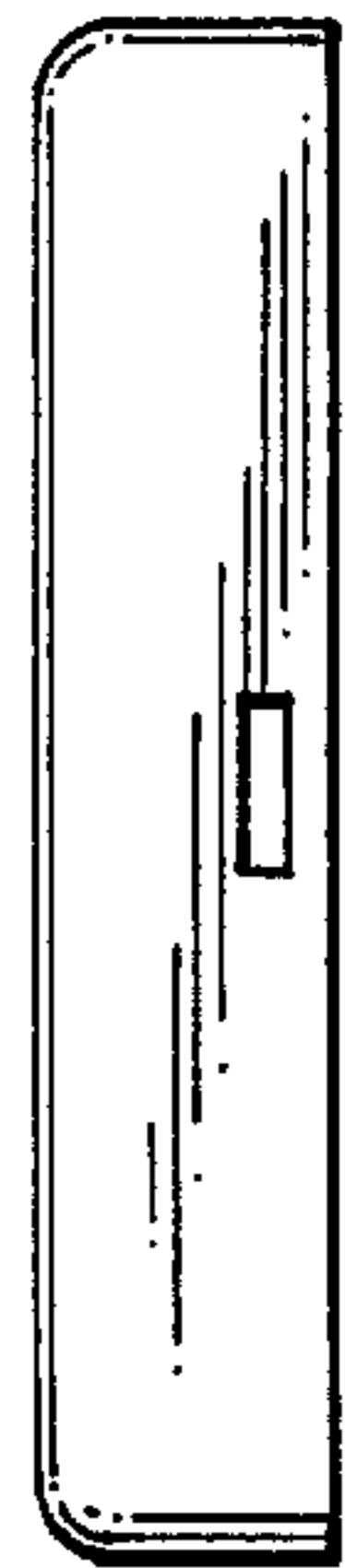

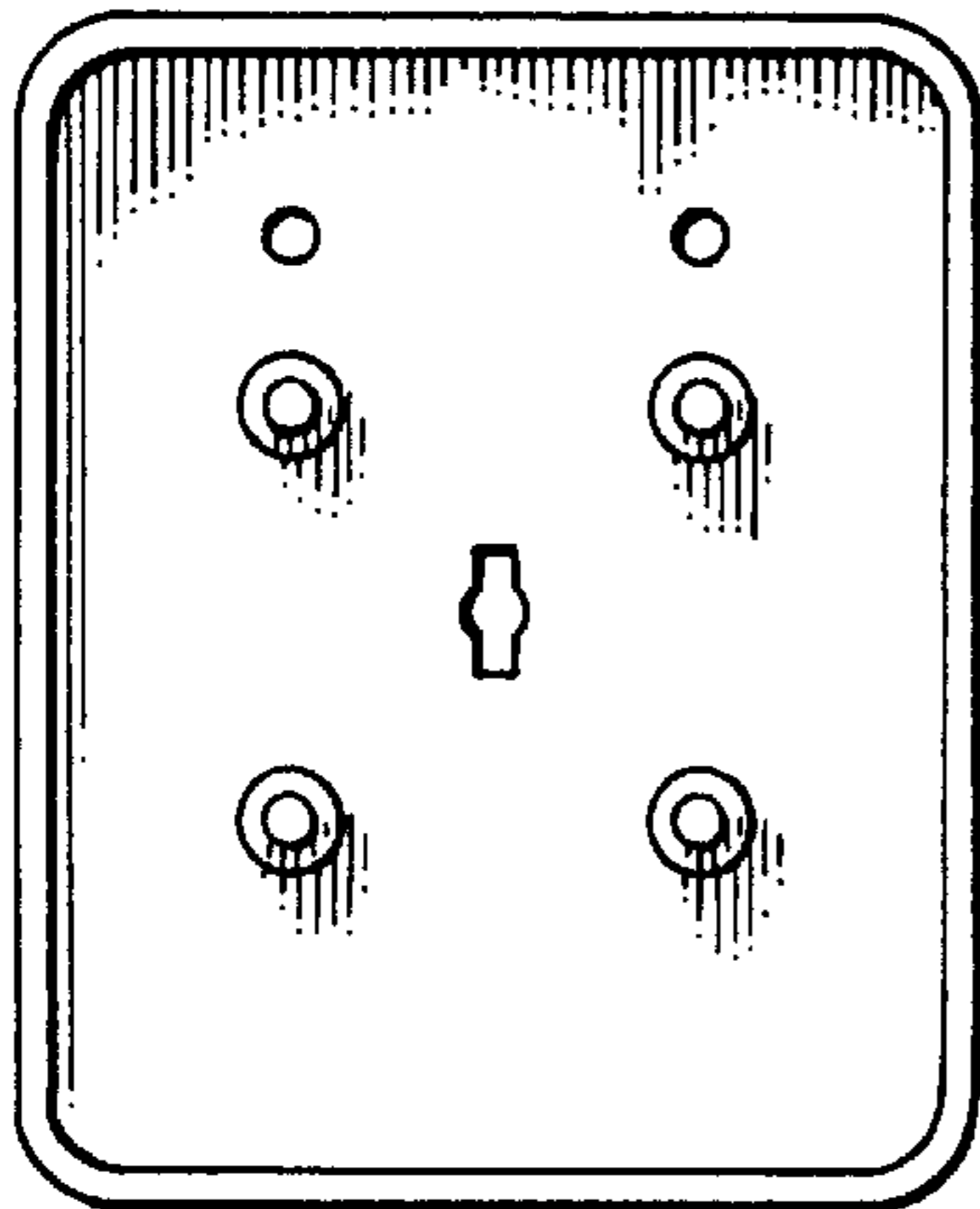

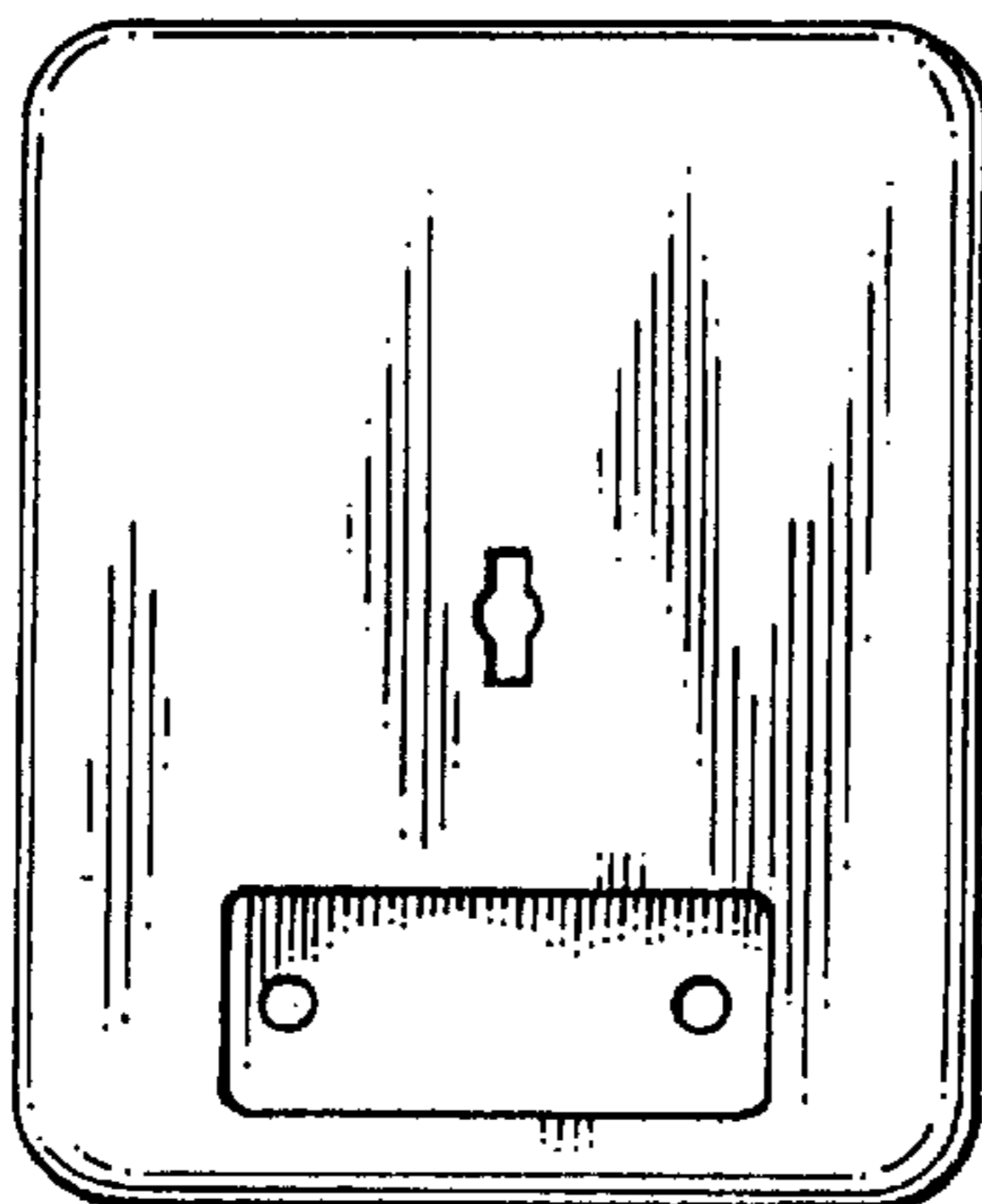

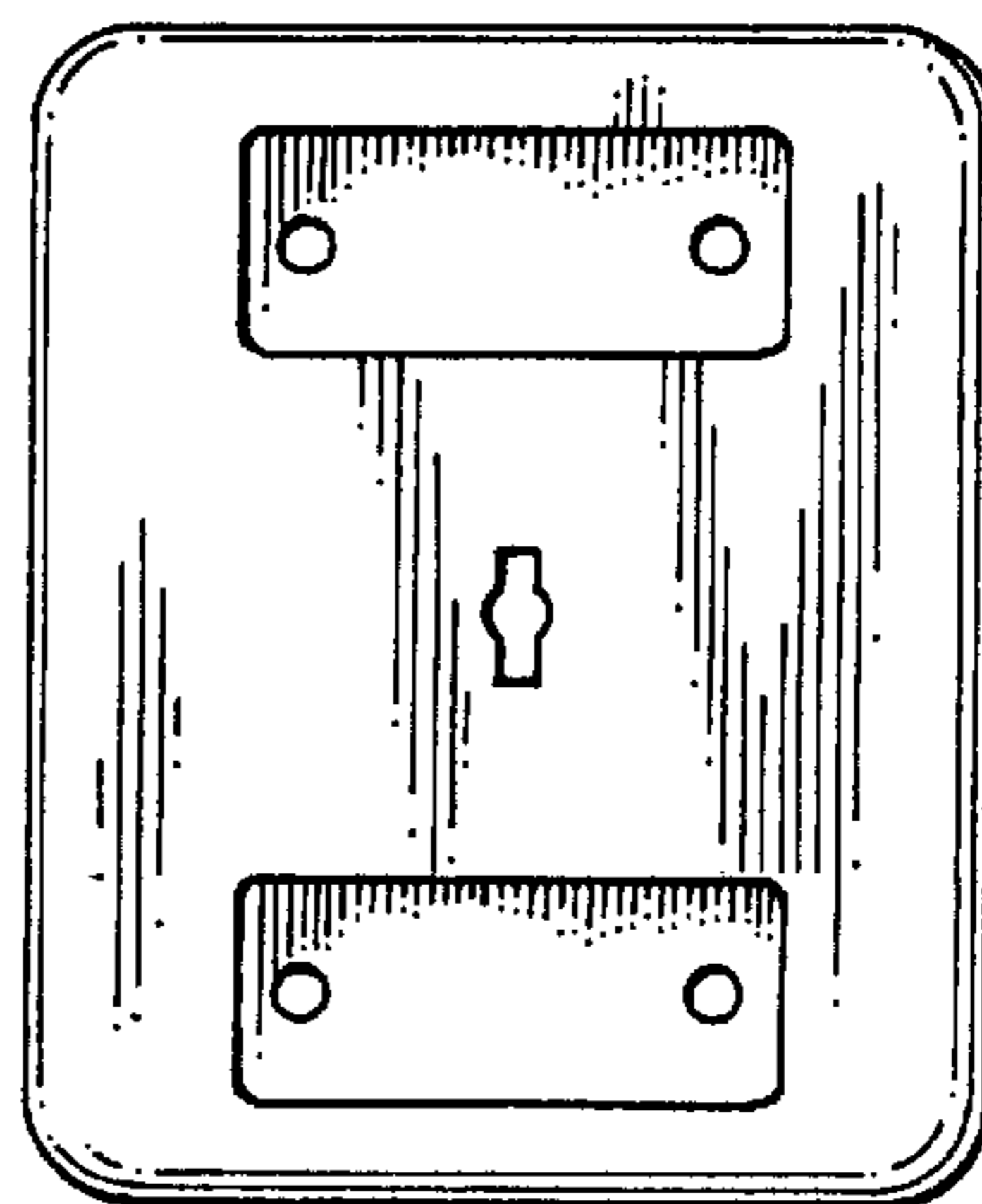

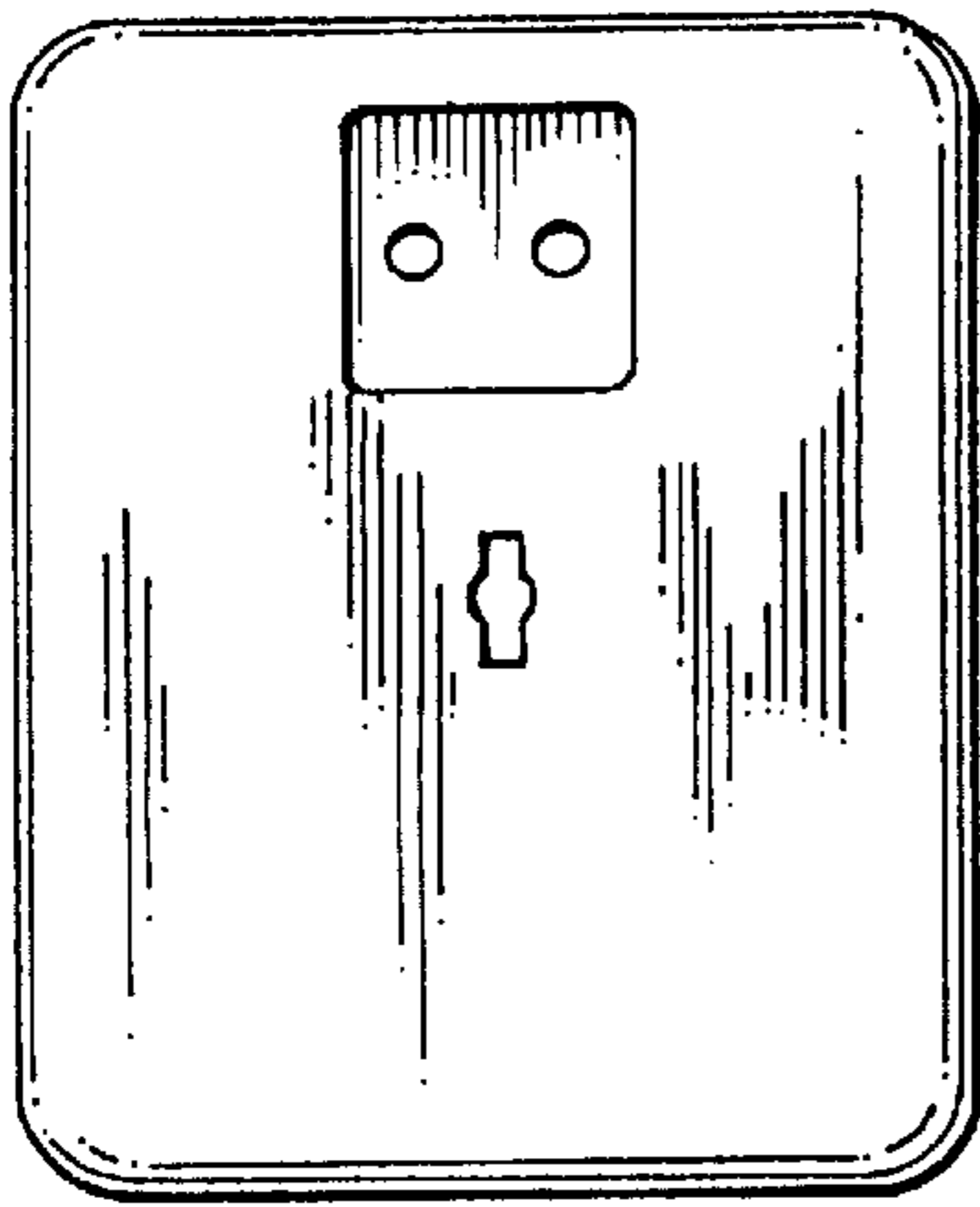

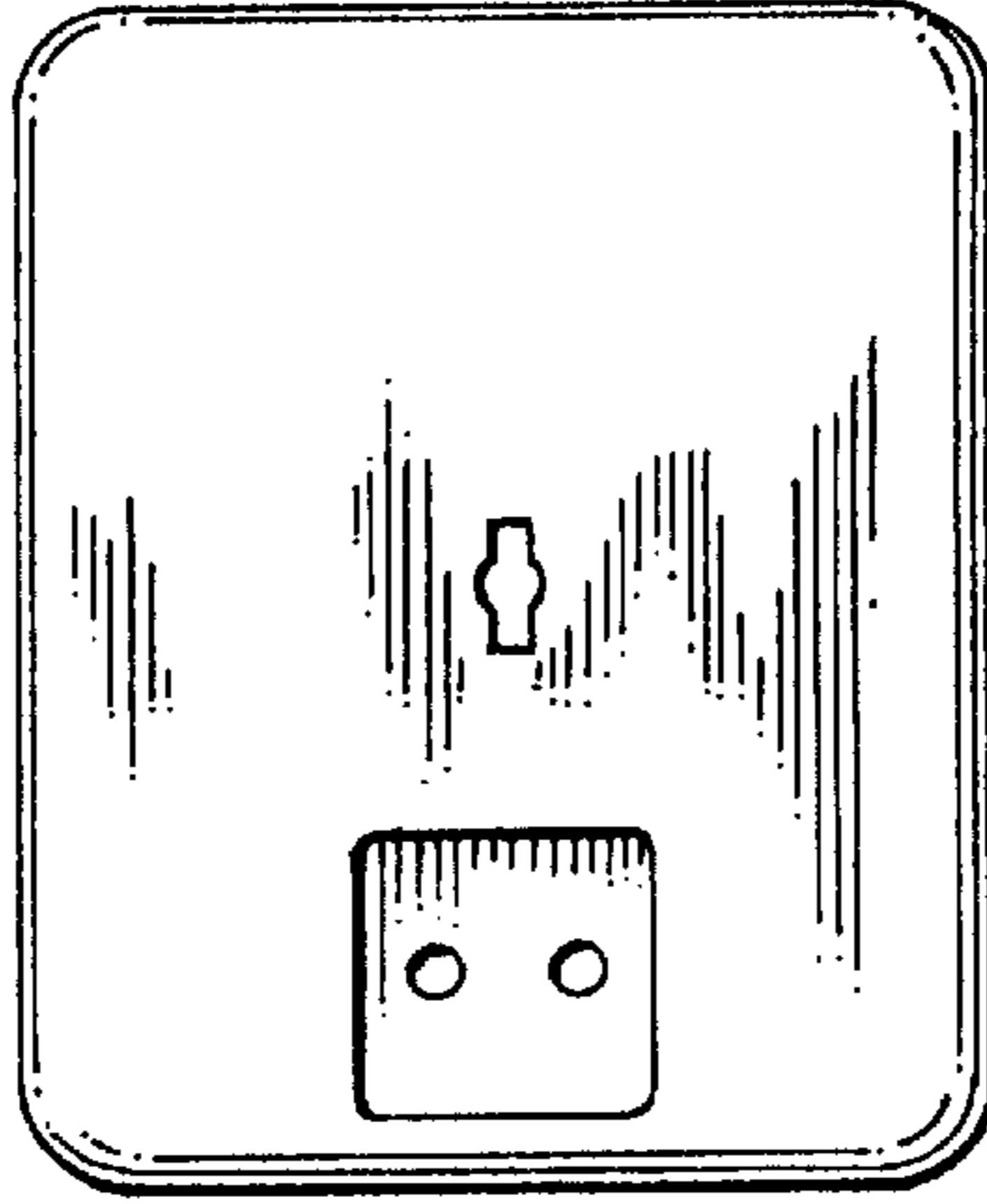

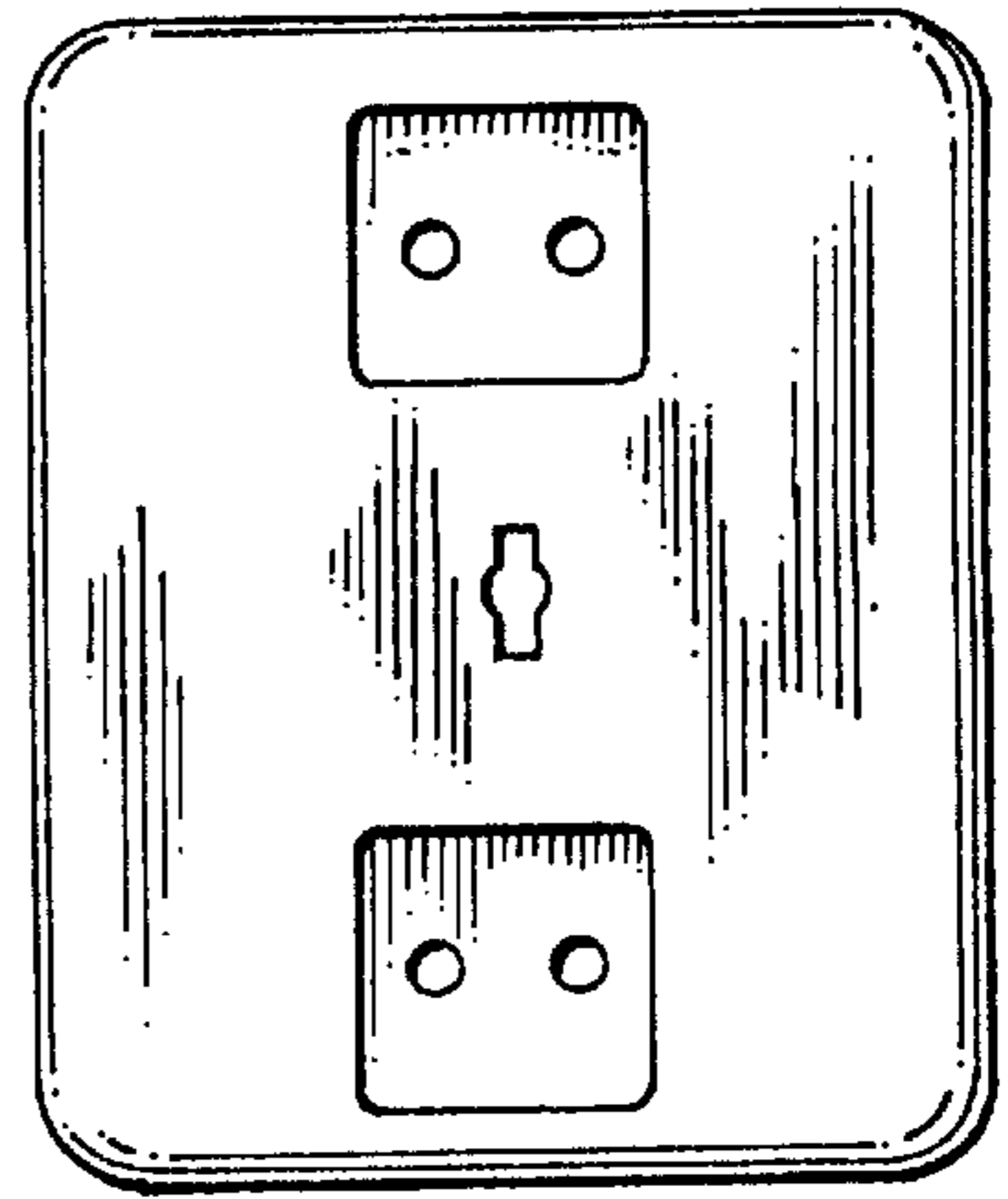

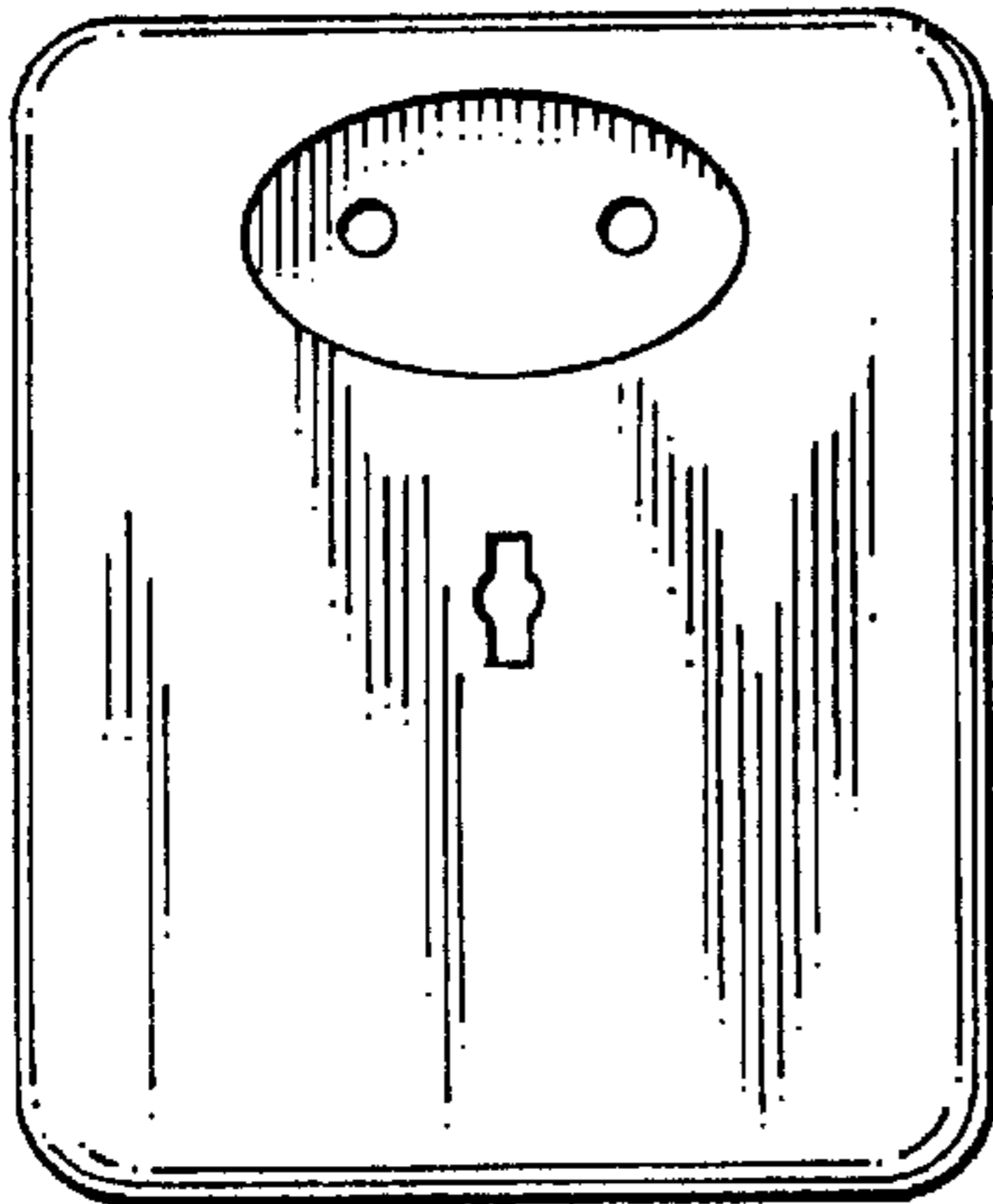

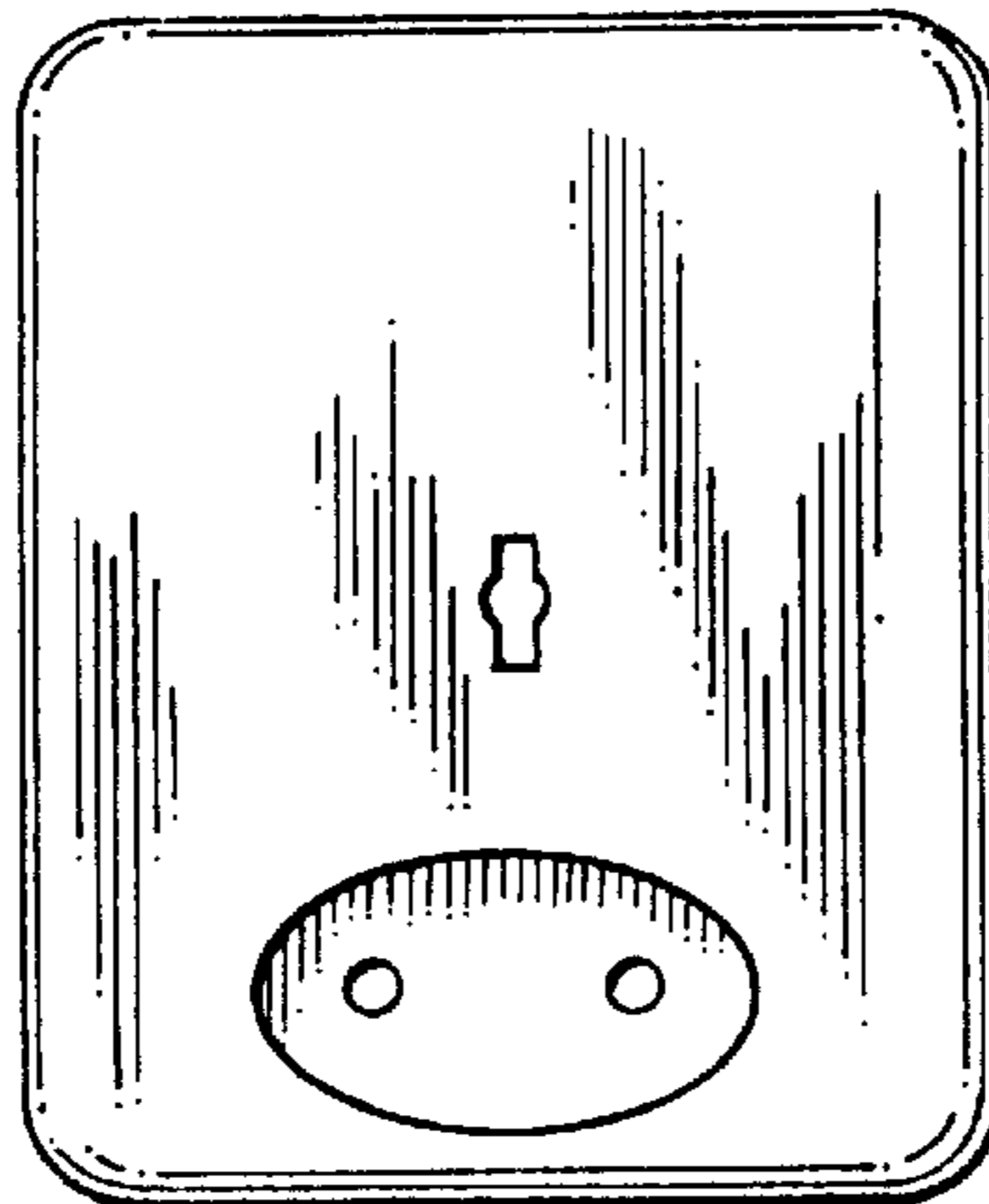

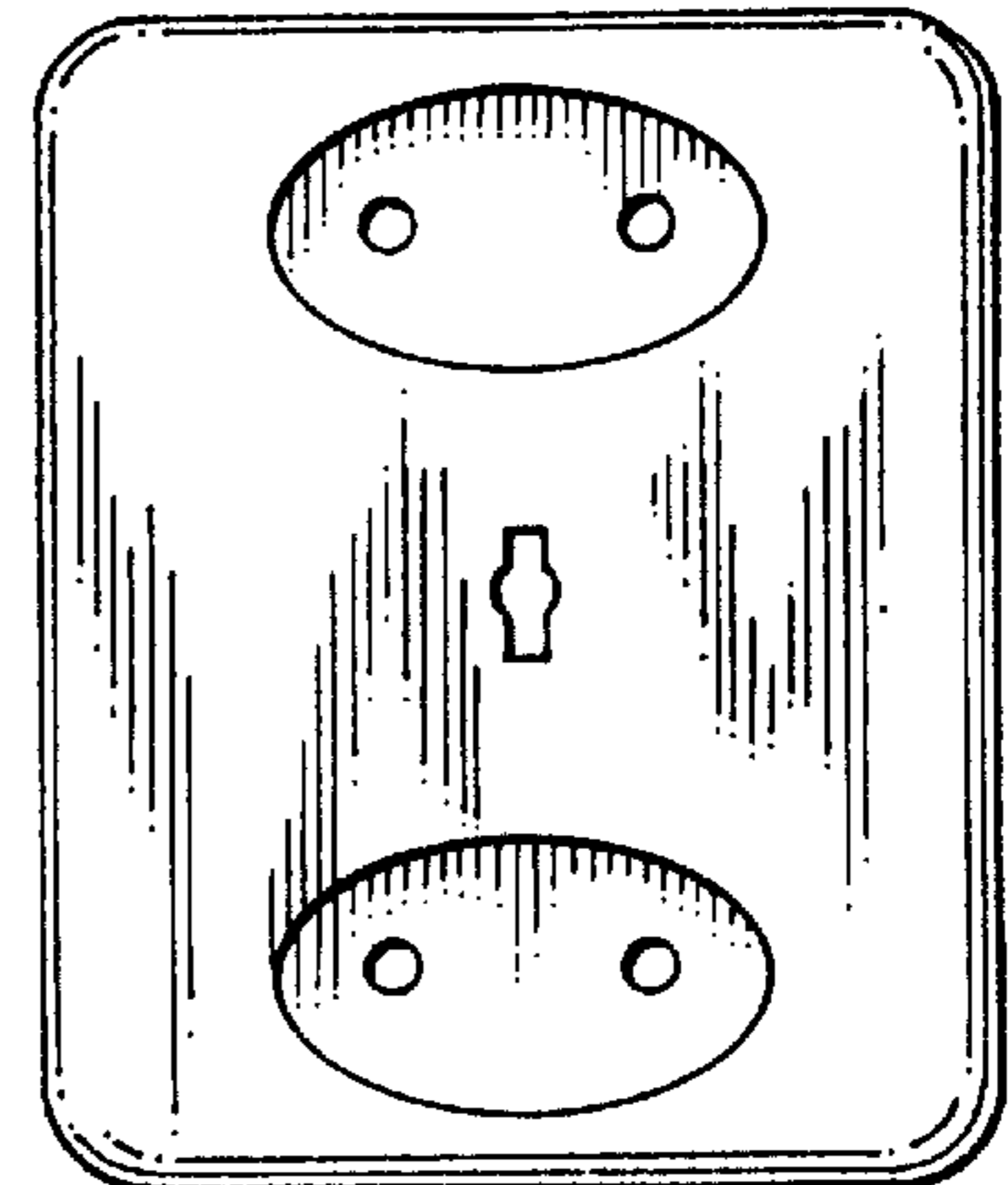

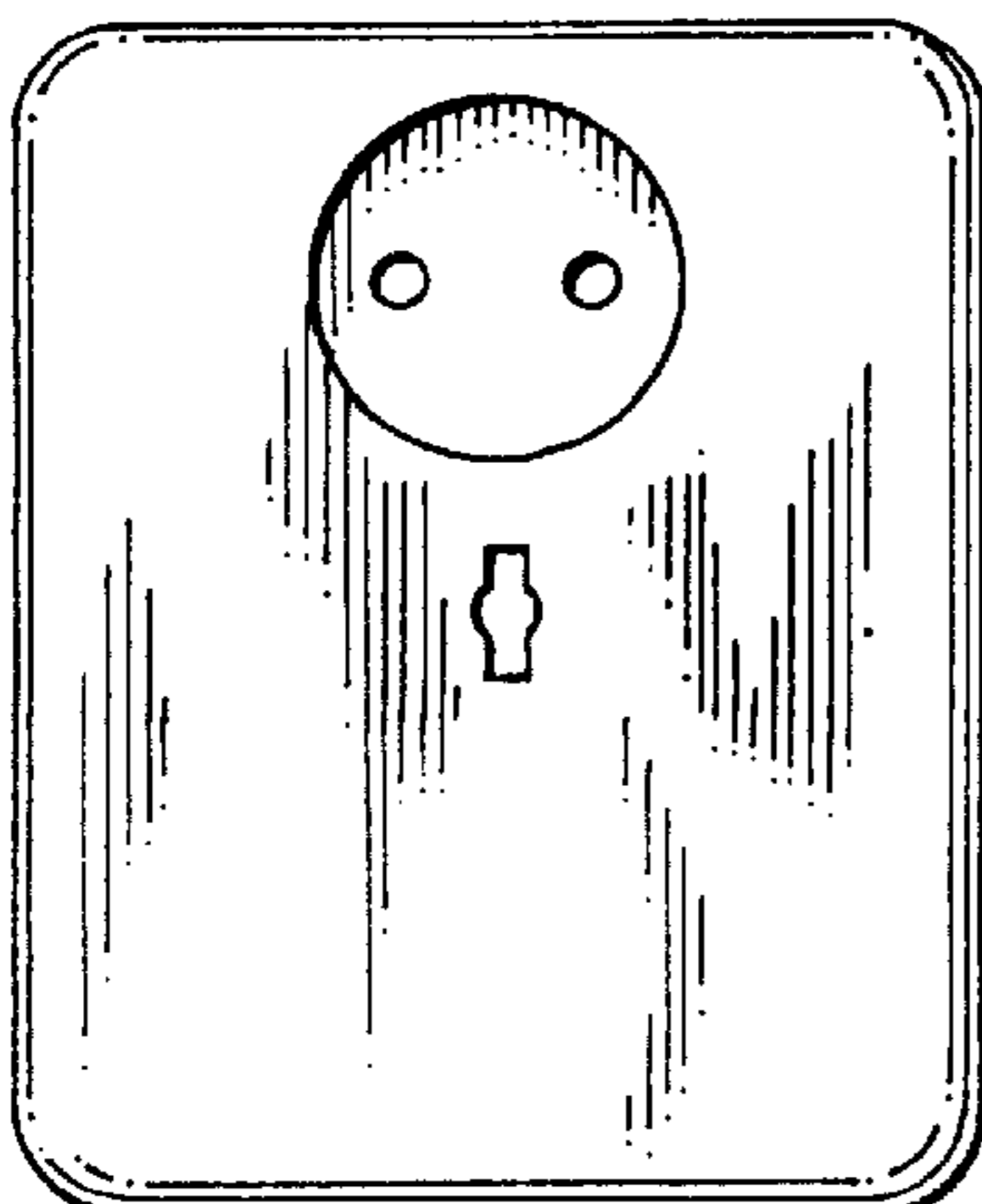

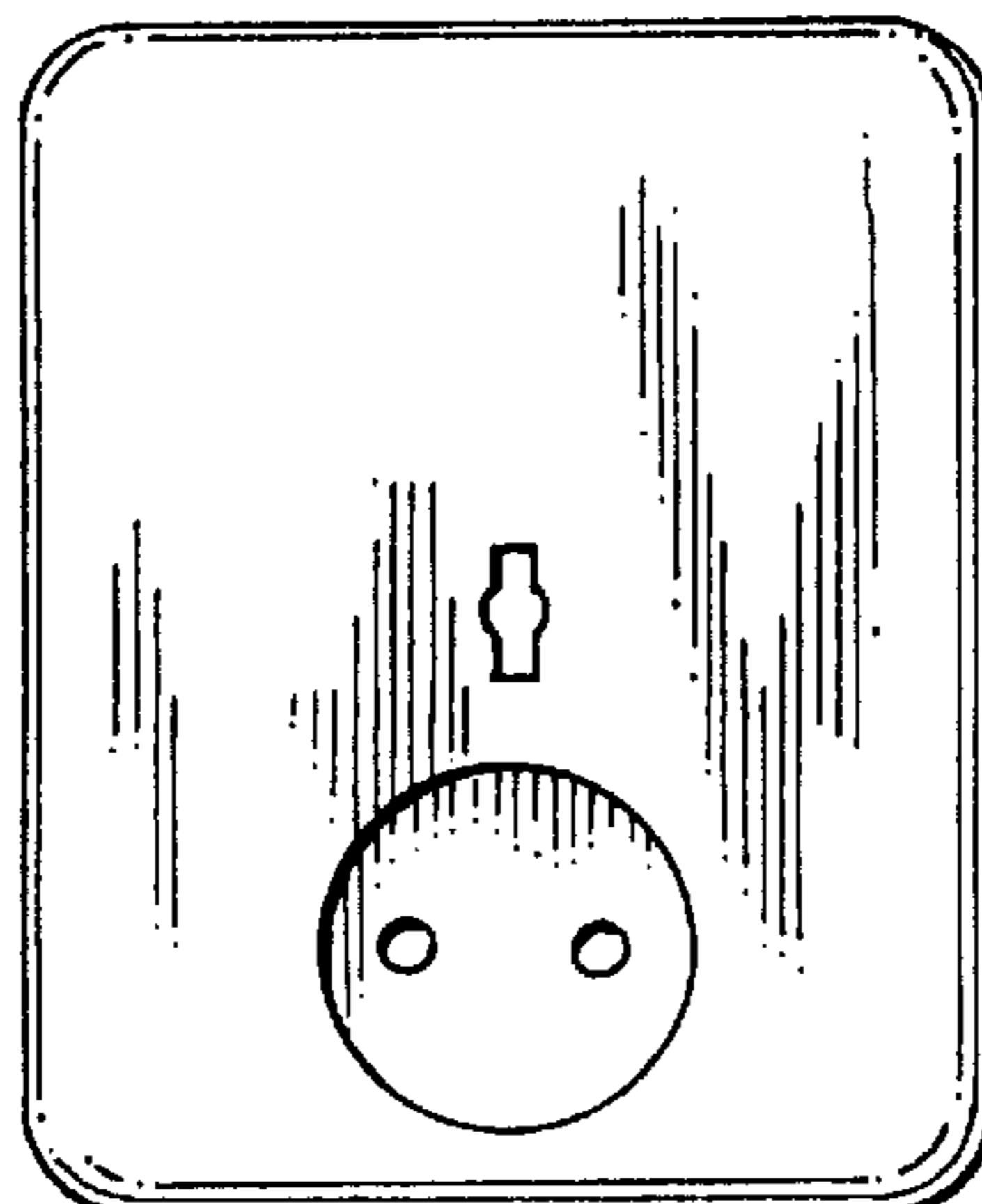

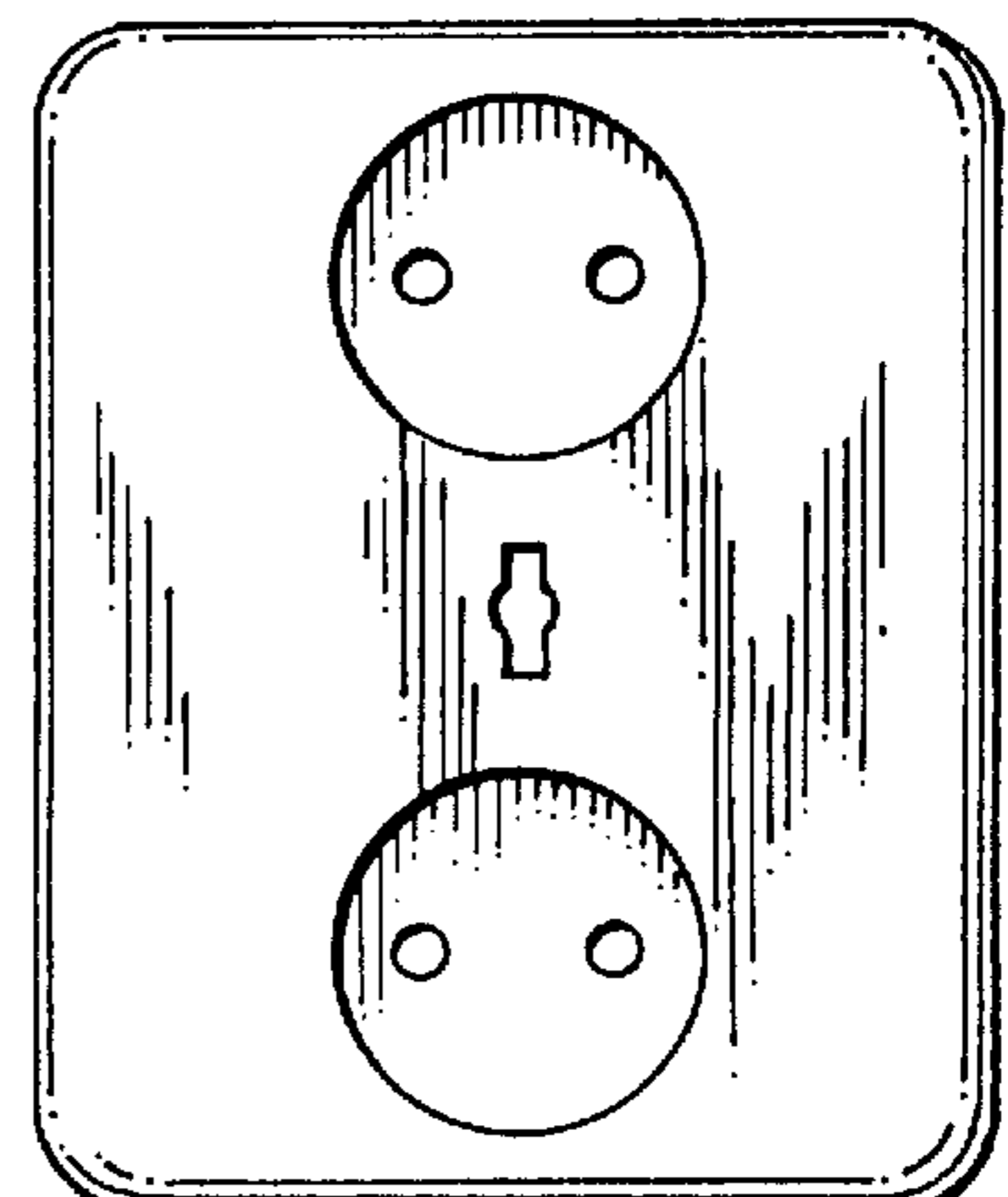
