DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a bed, showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof;

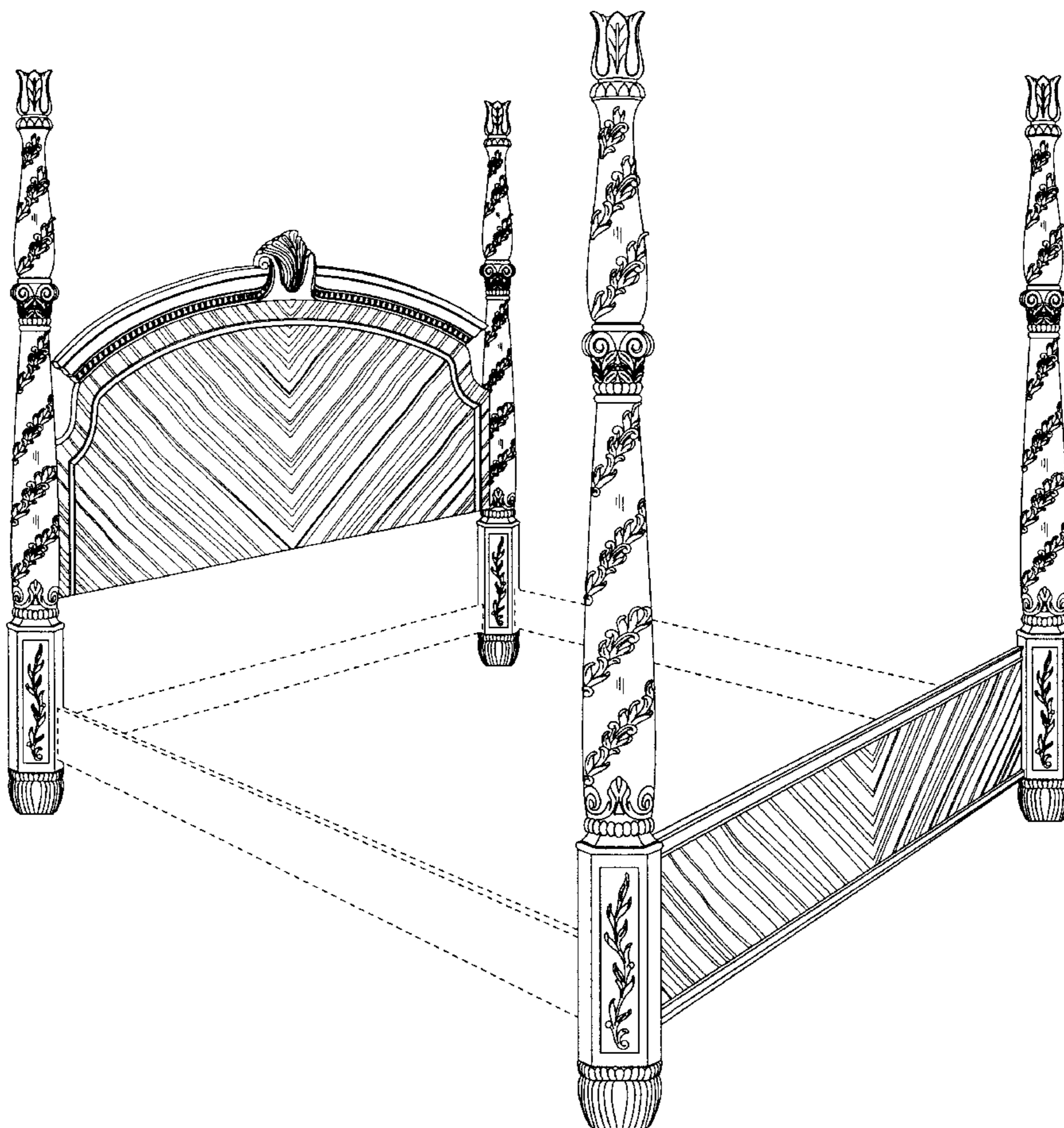
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view;

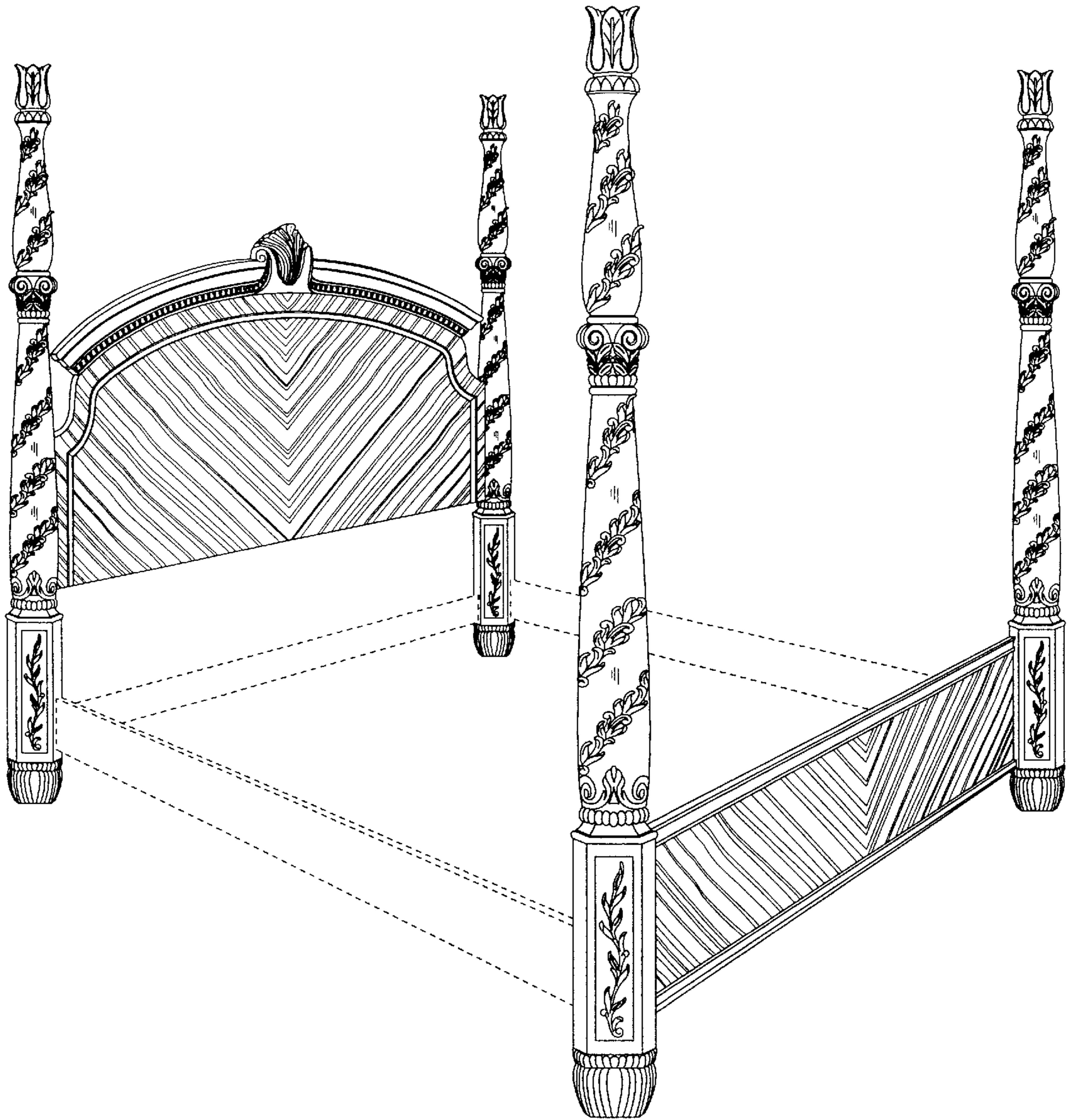

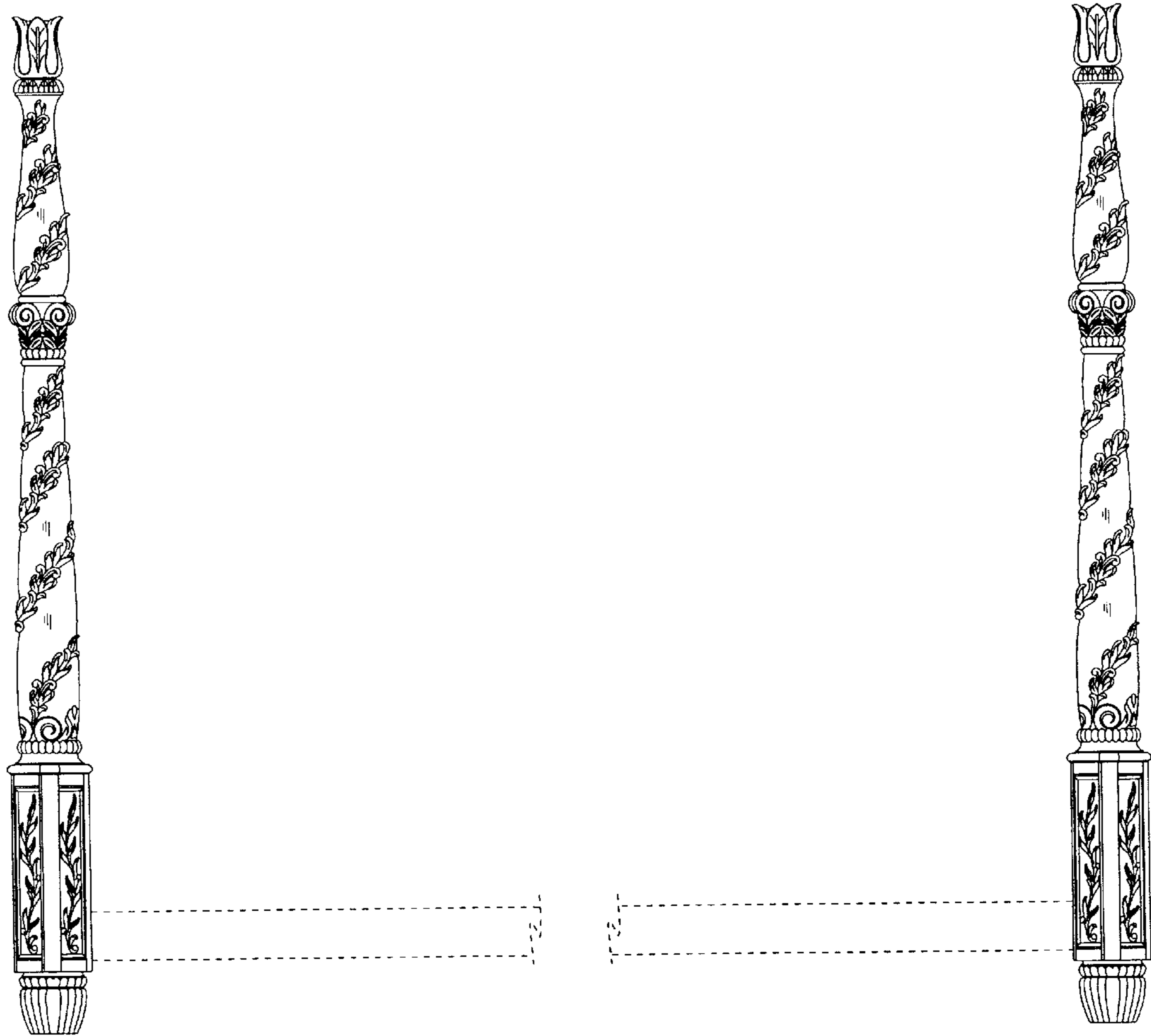

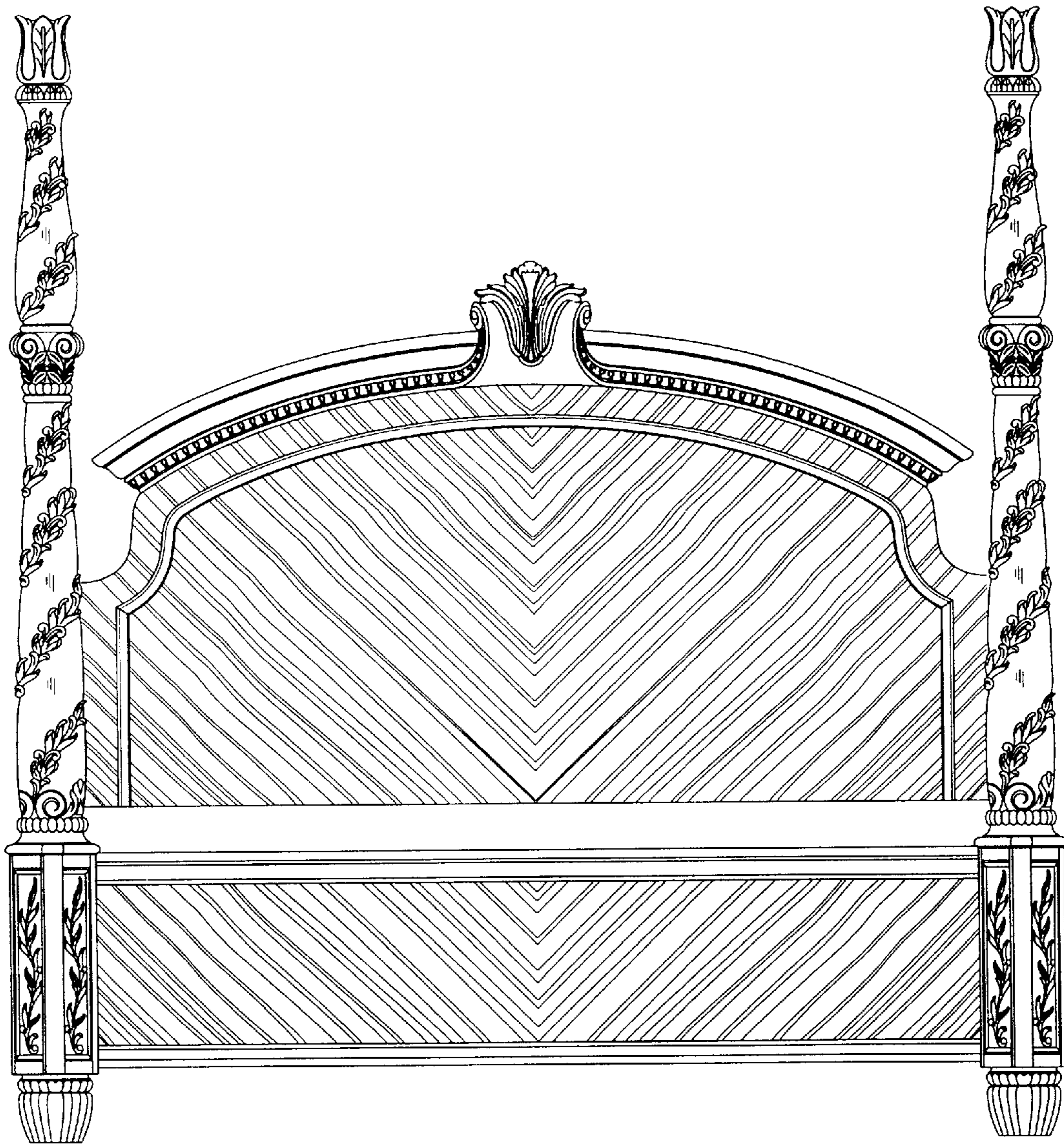

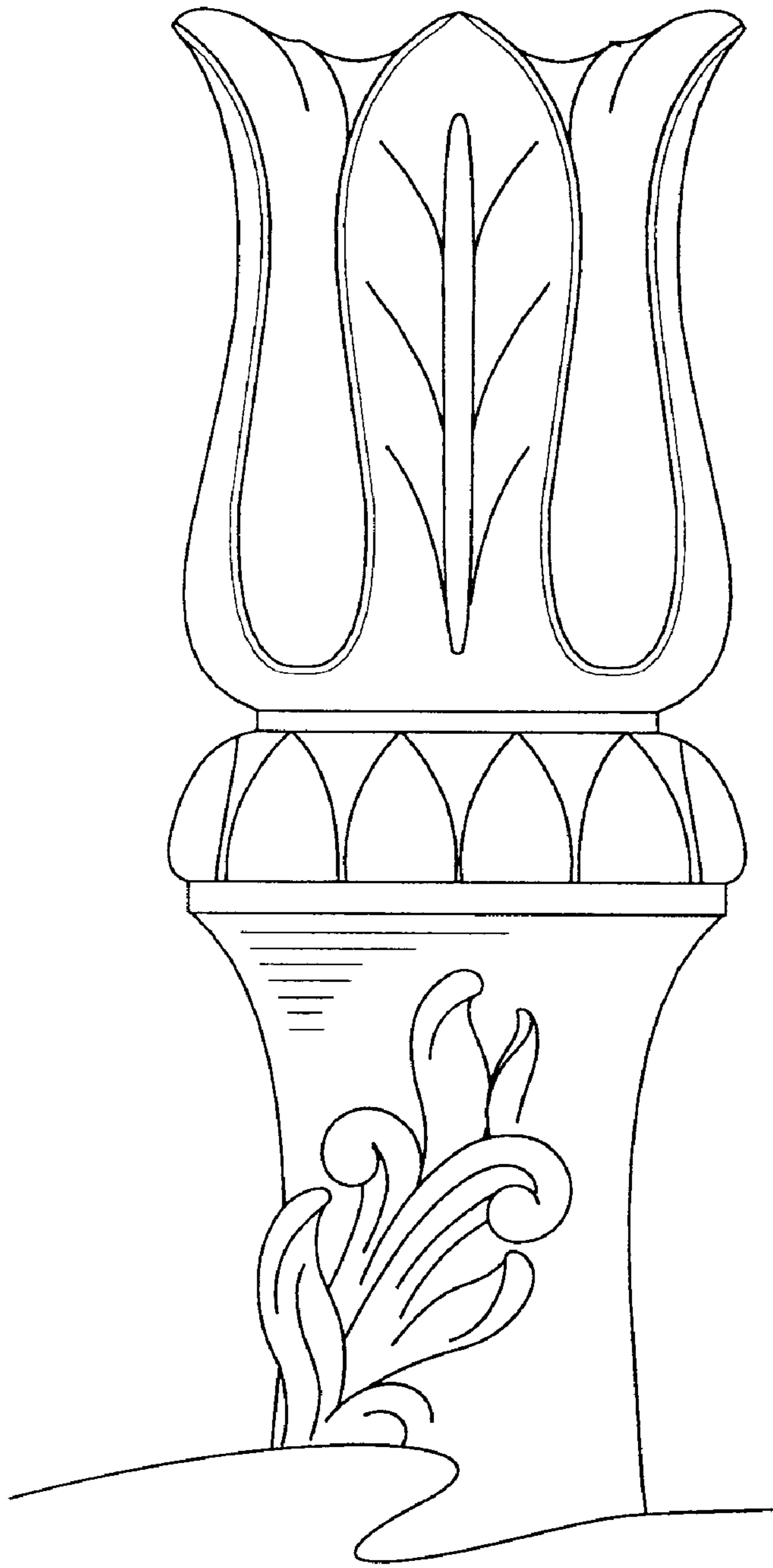

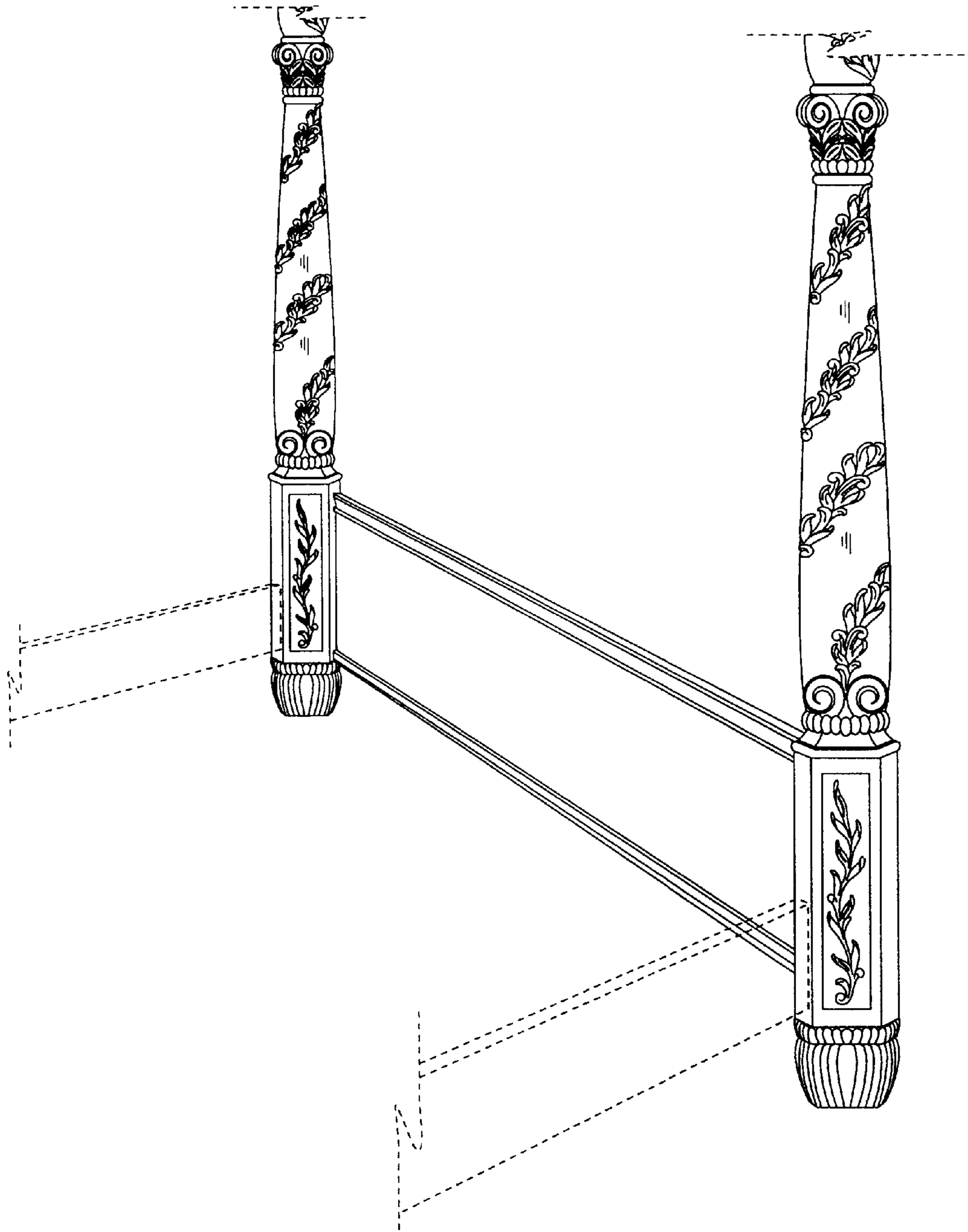
