[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a lunch bag, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a top, left side, perspective view of the lunch bag thereof;

FIG. 2 is a front side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;

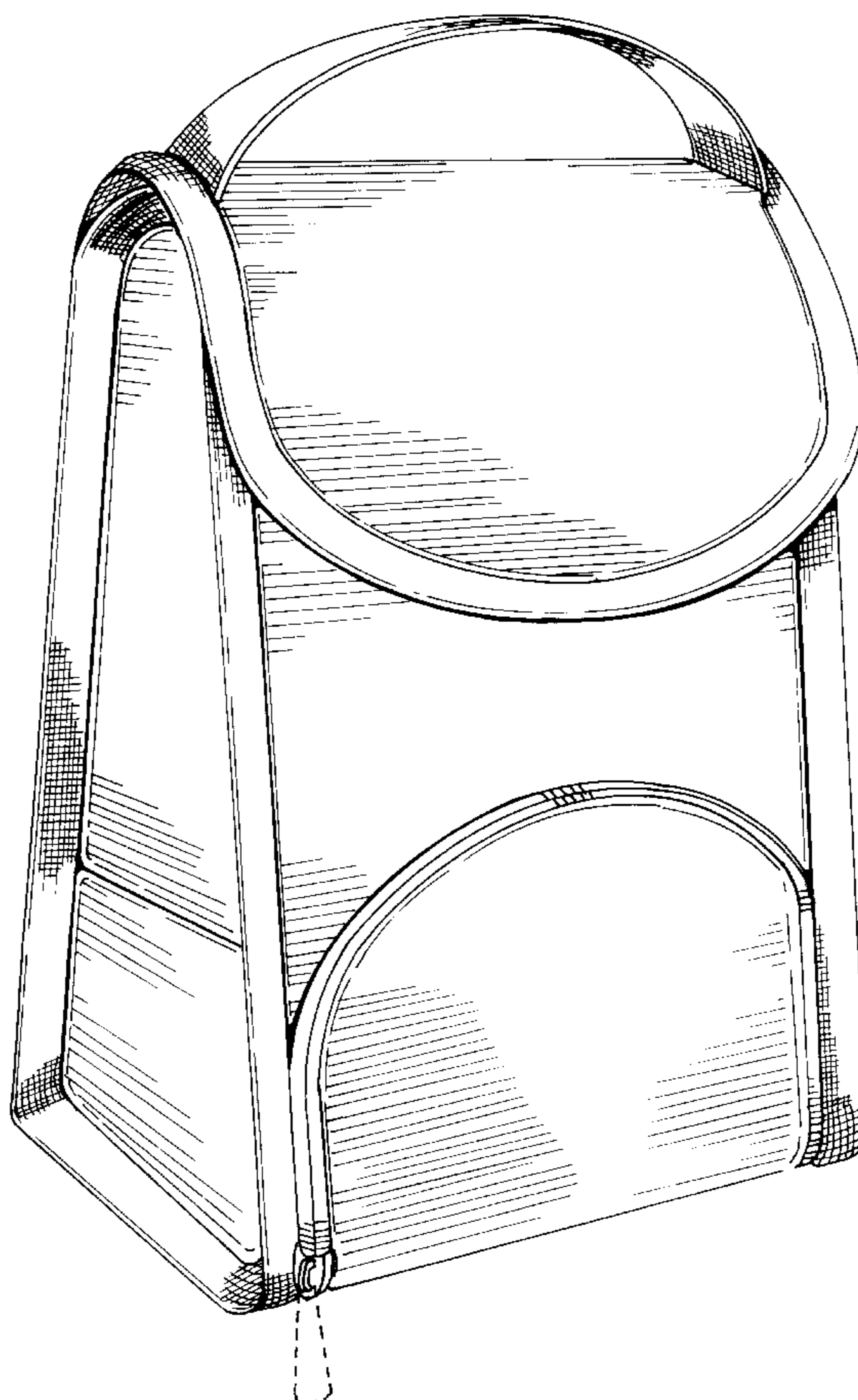
FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof, a left side elevational view being a mirror image thereof;

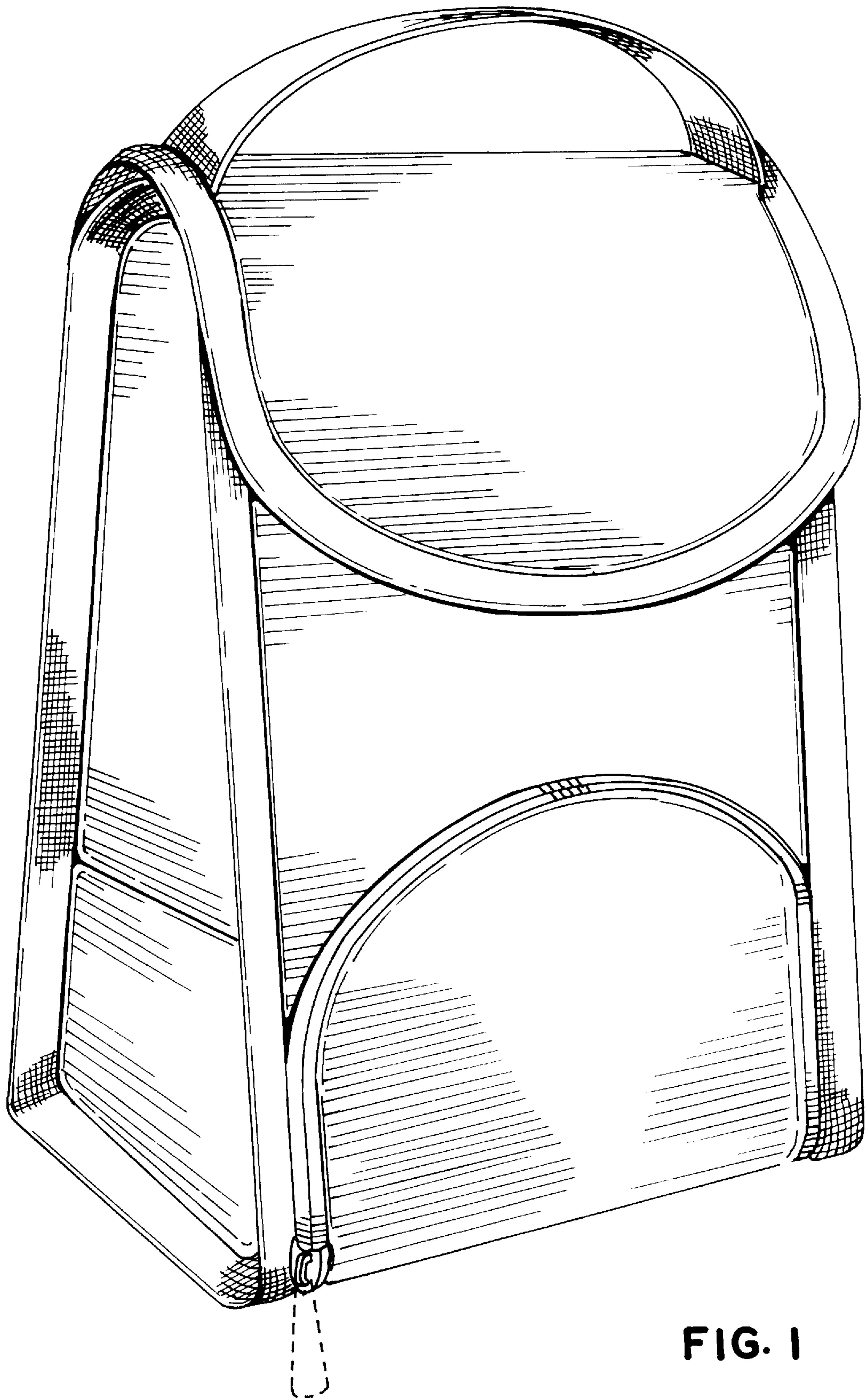

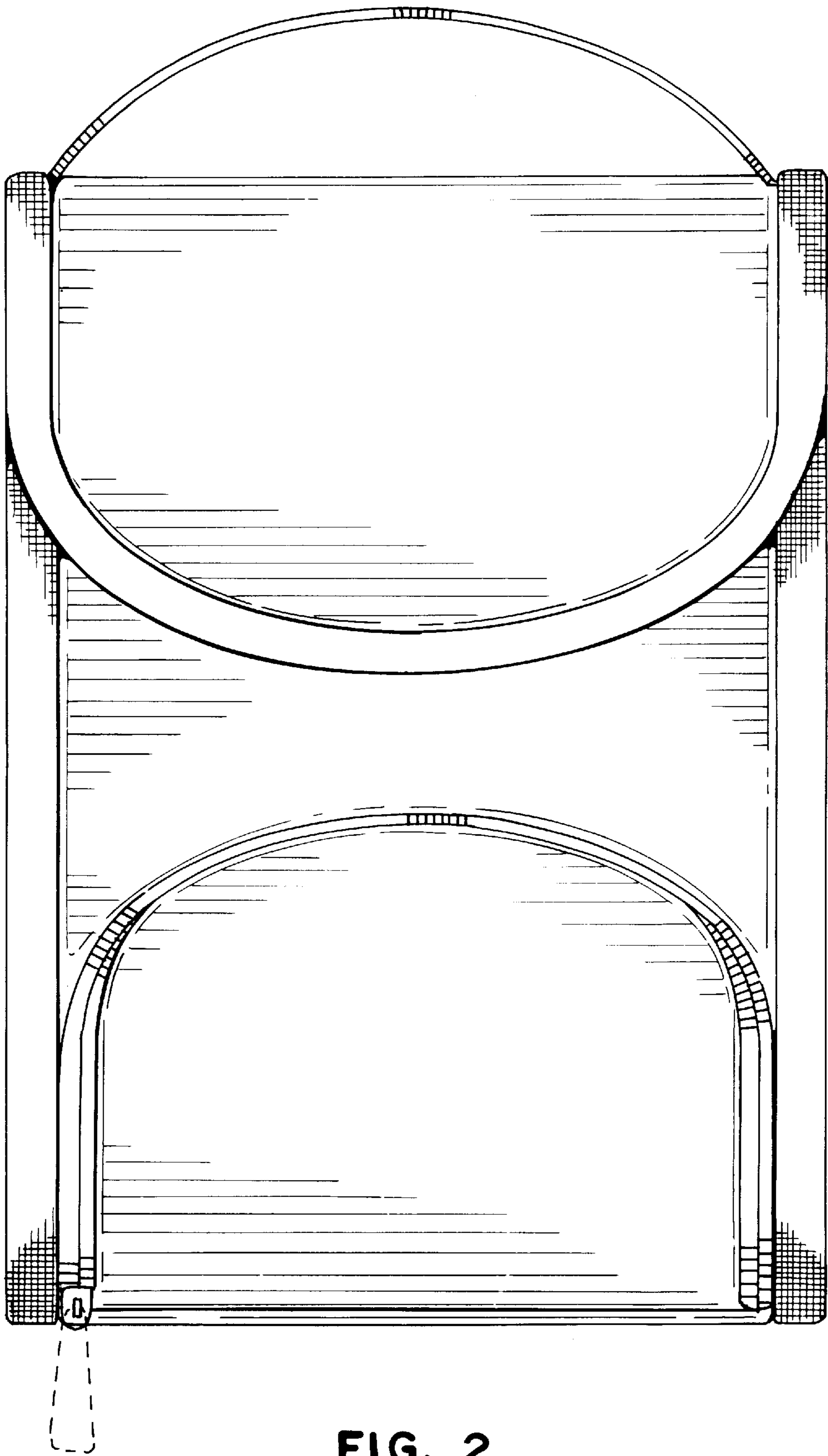

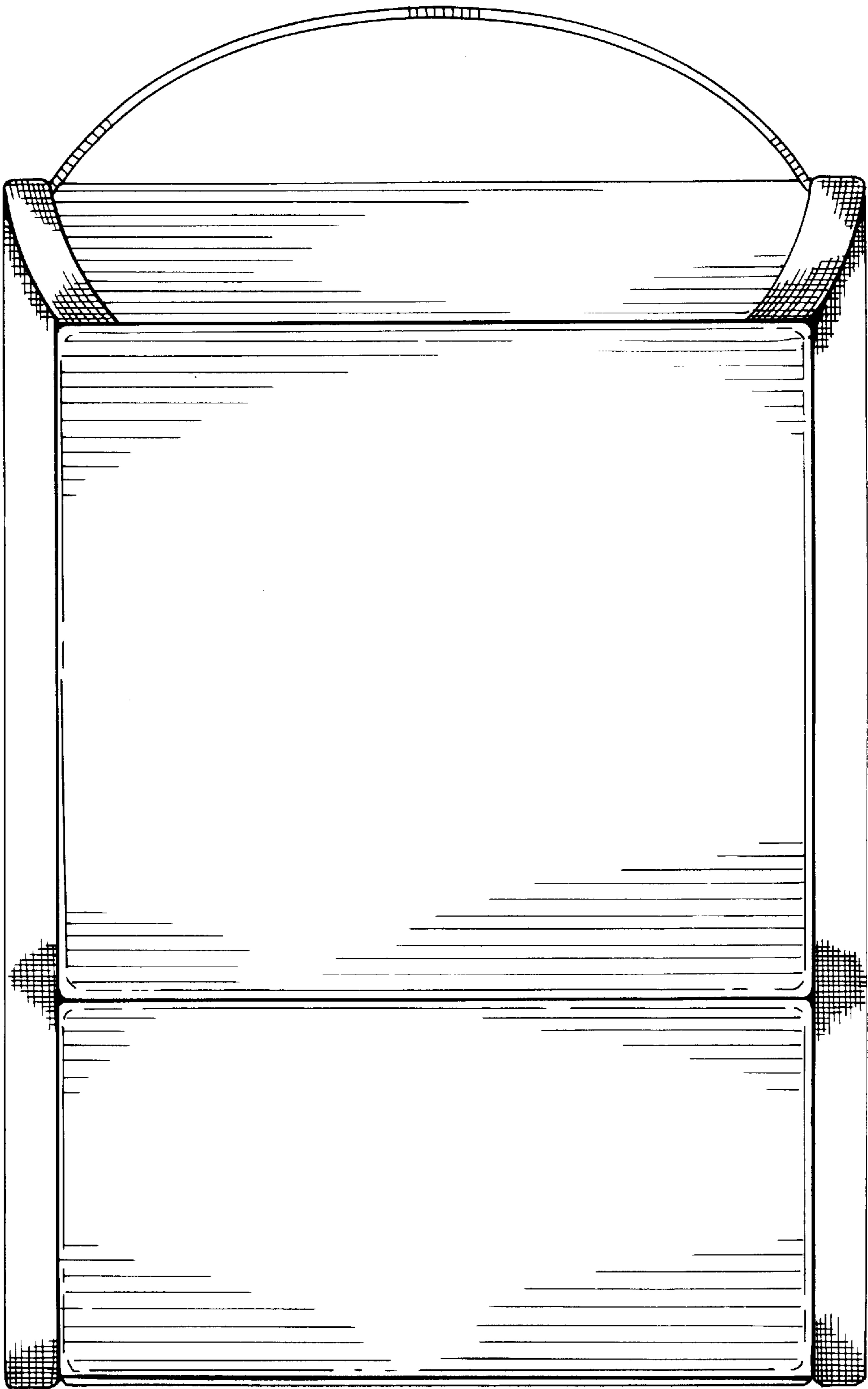

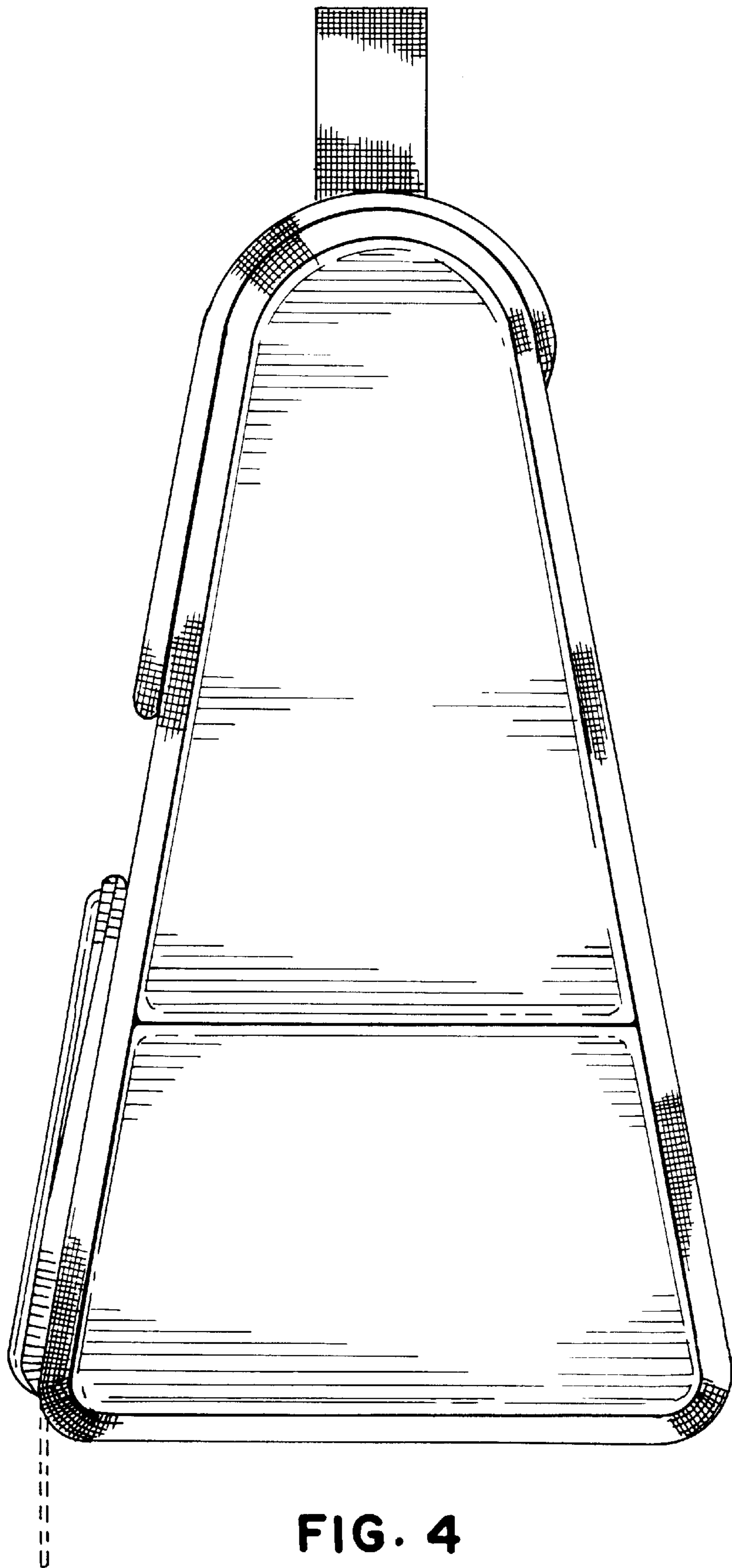

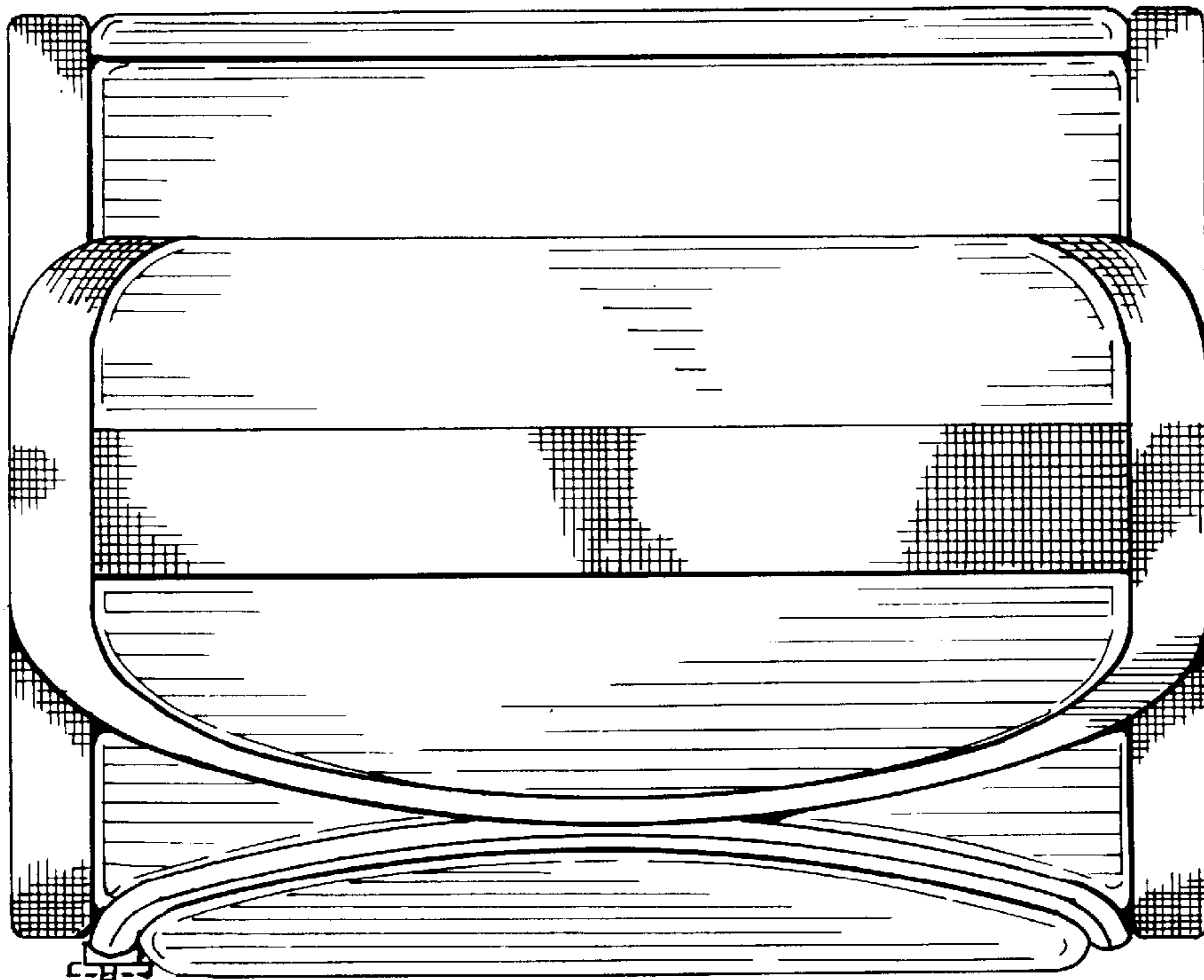

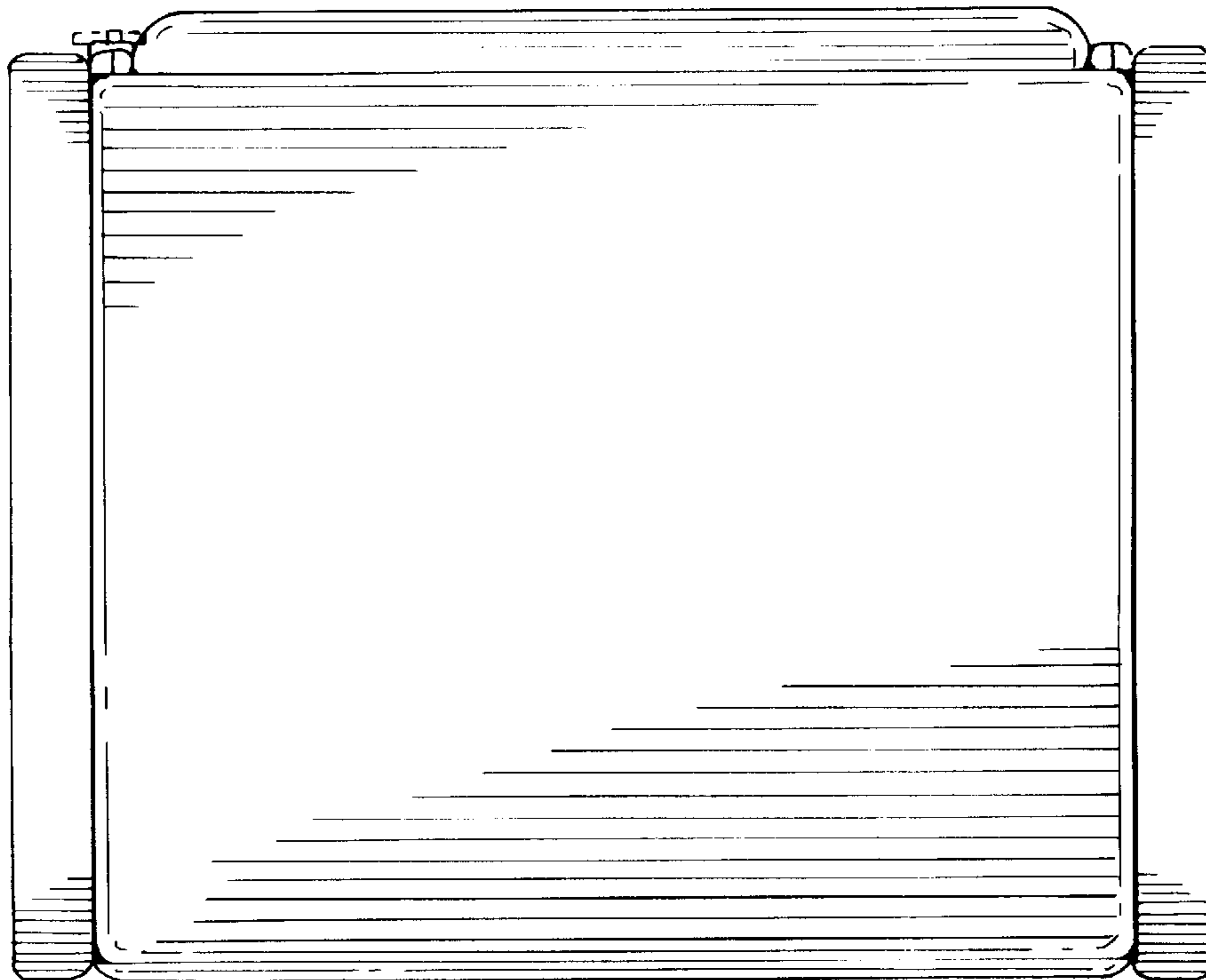
