DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a first embodiment of the self-inking stamp;

FIG. 4 is a front elevation of the stamp of FIG. 1/1;

FIG. 6 is a top elevation of the stamp of FIG. 1/1;

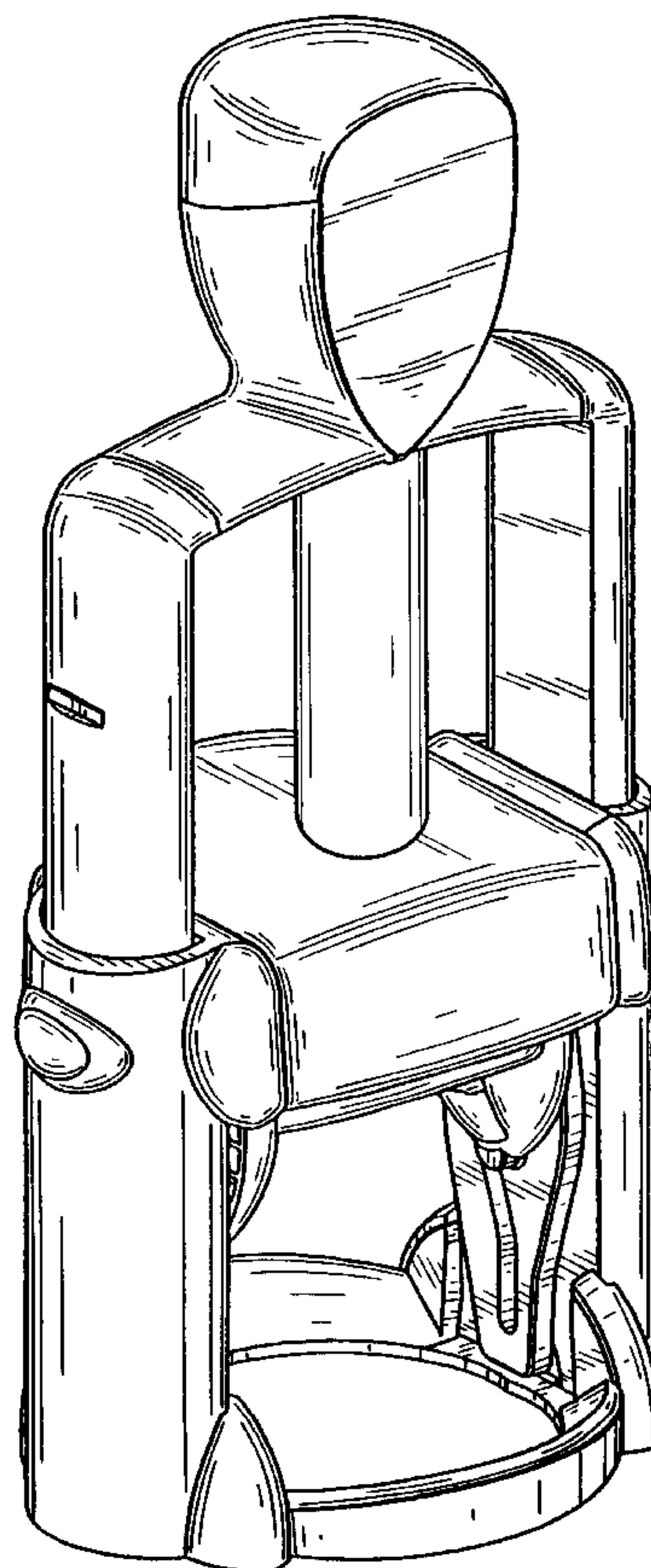
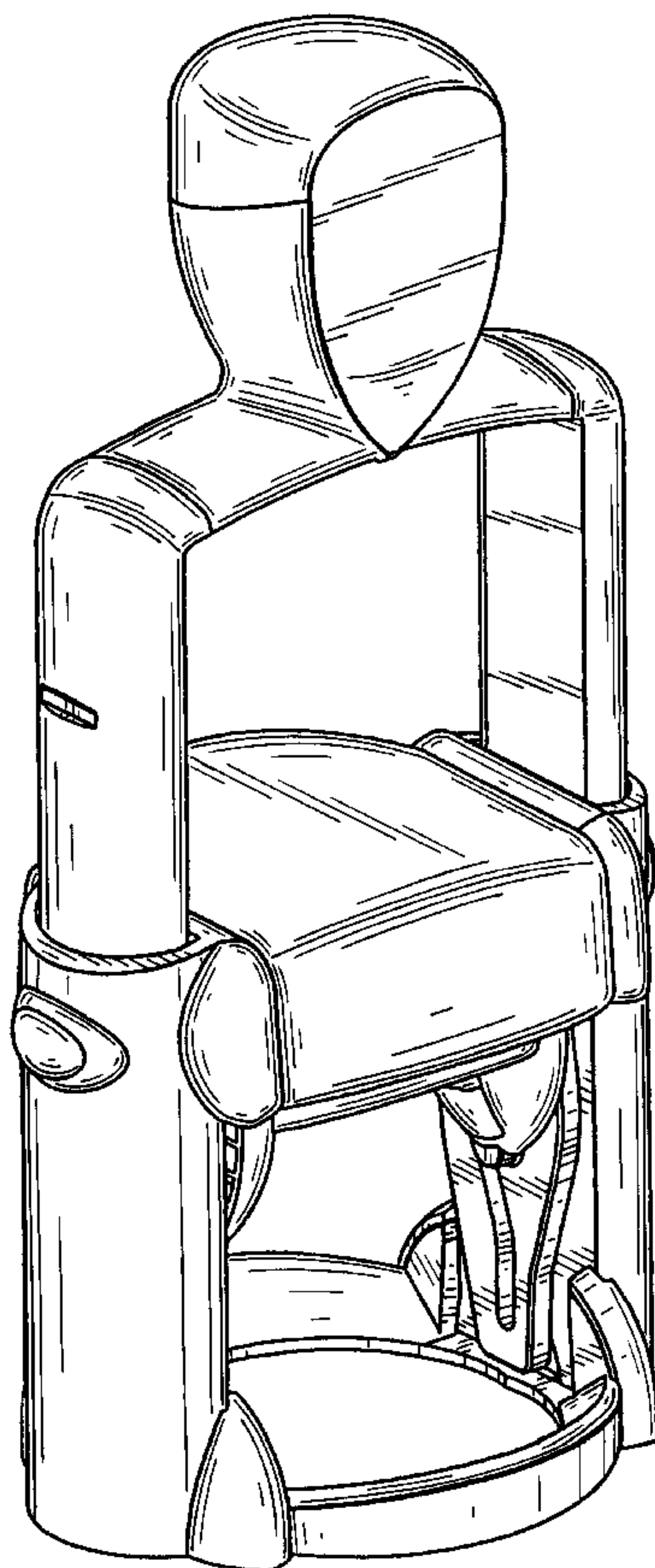
FIG. 7 is a front perspective view of an alternative embodiment of the self-inking stamp;

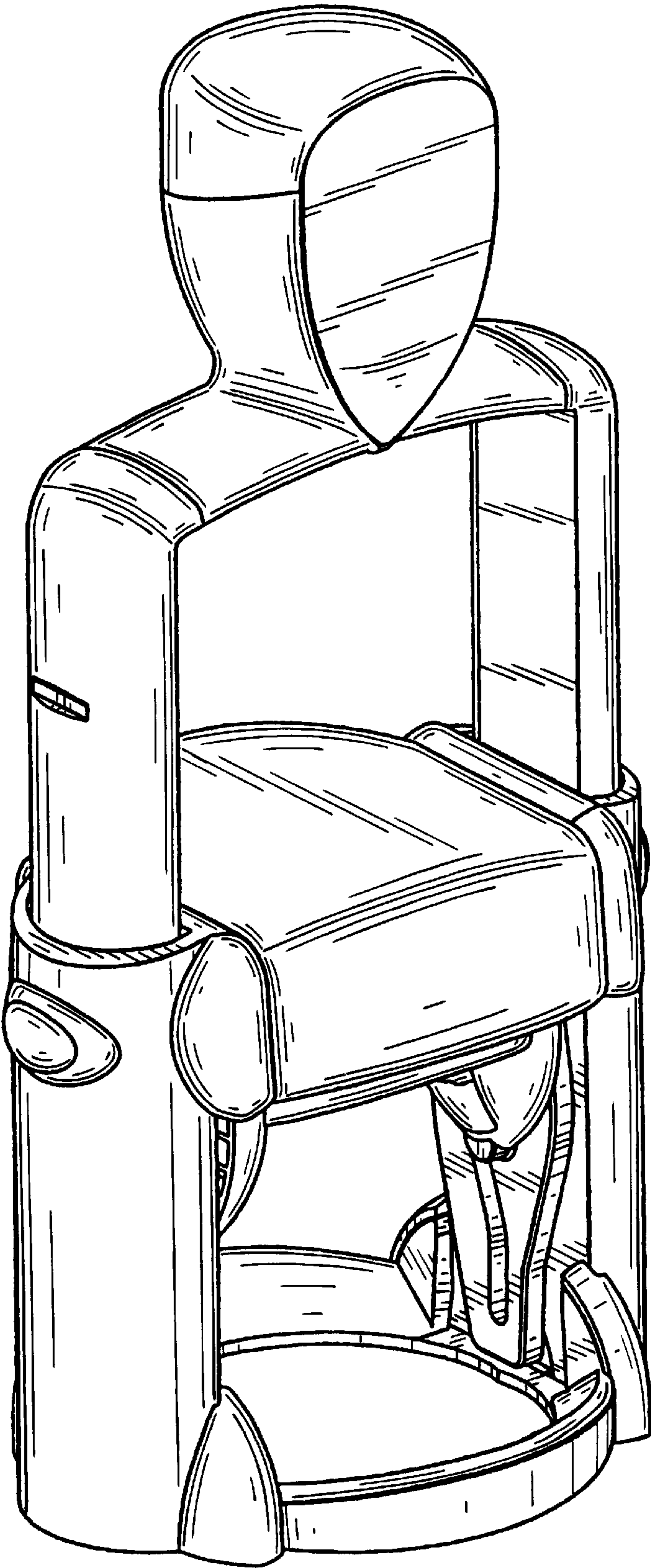

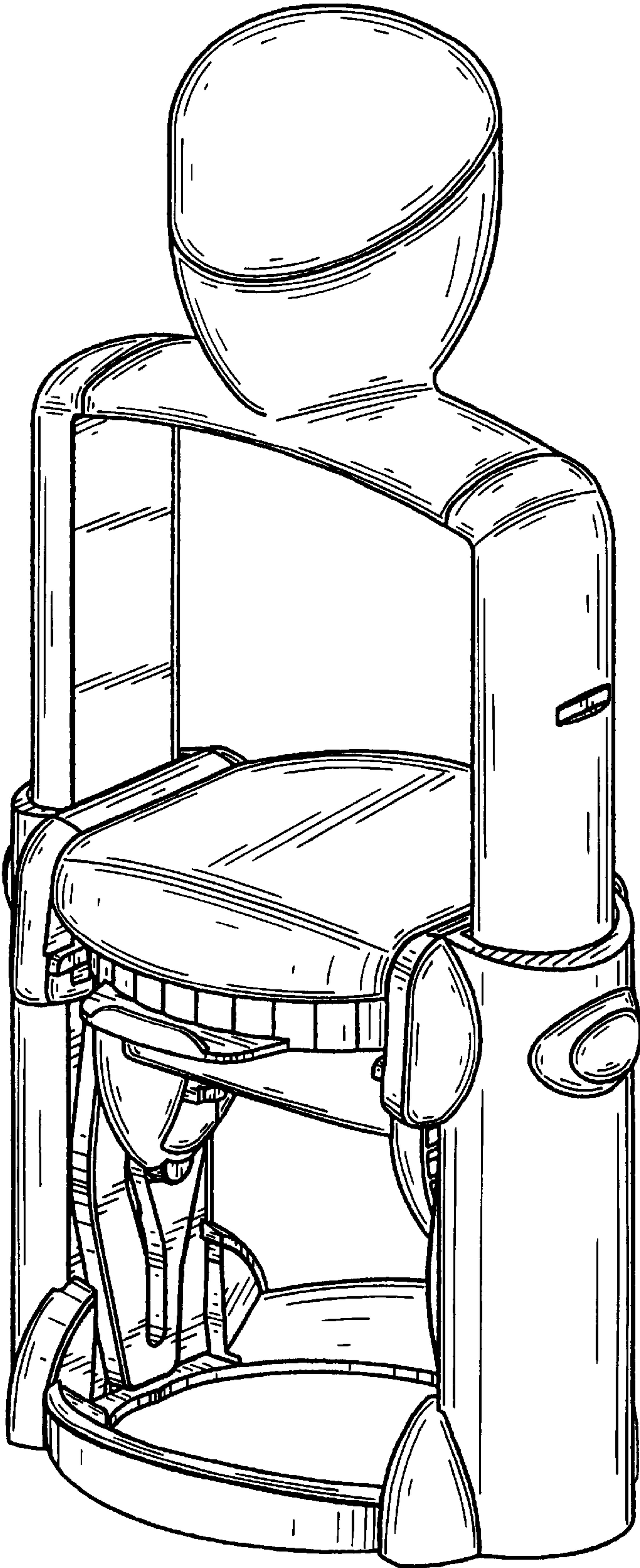

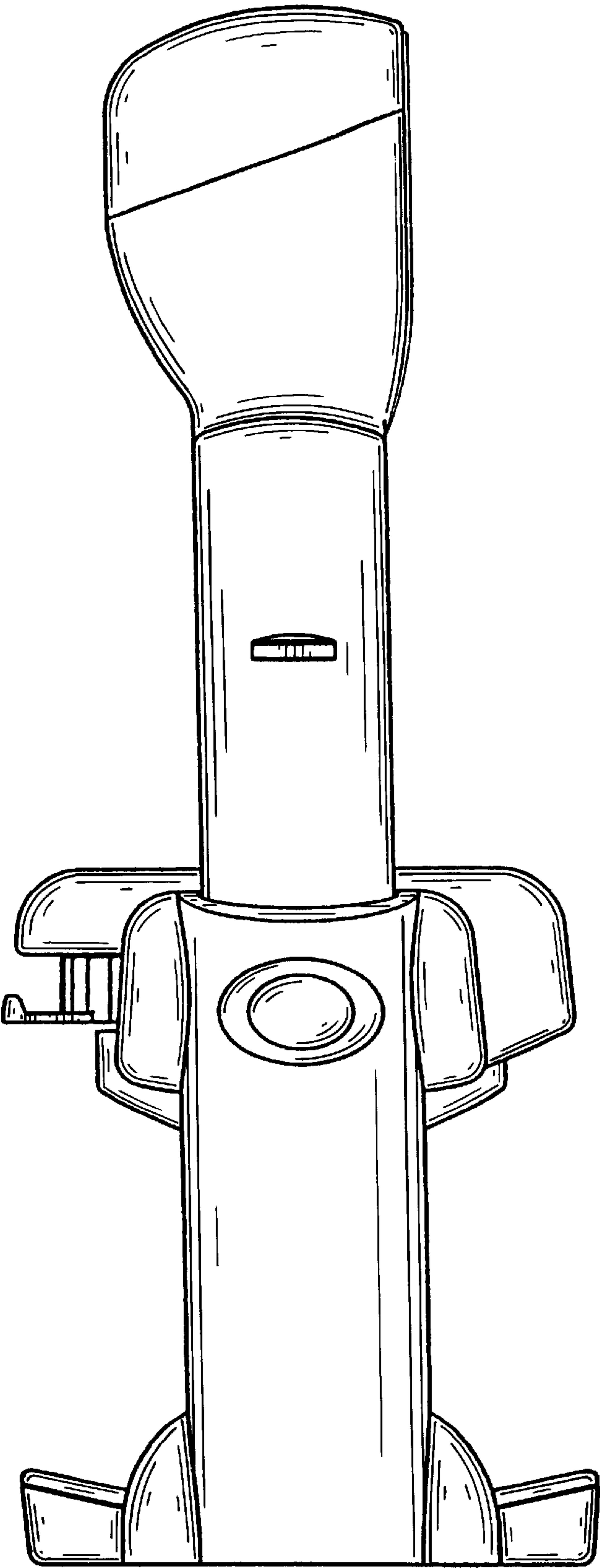

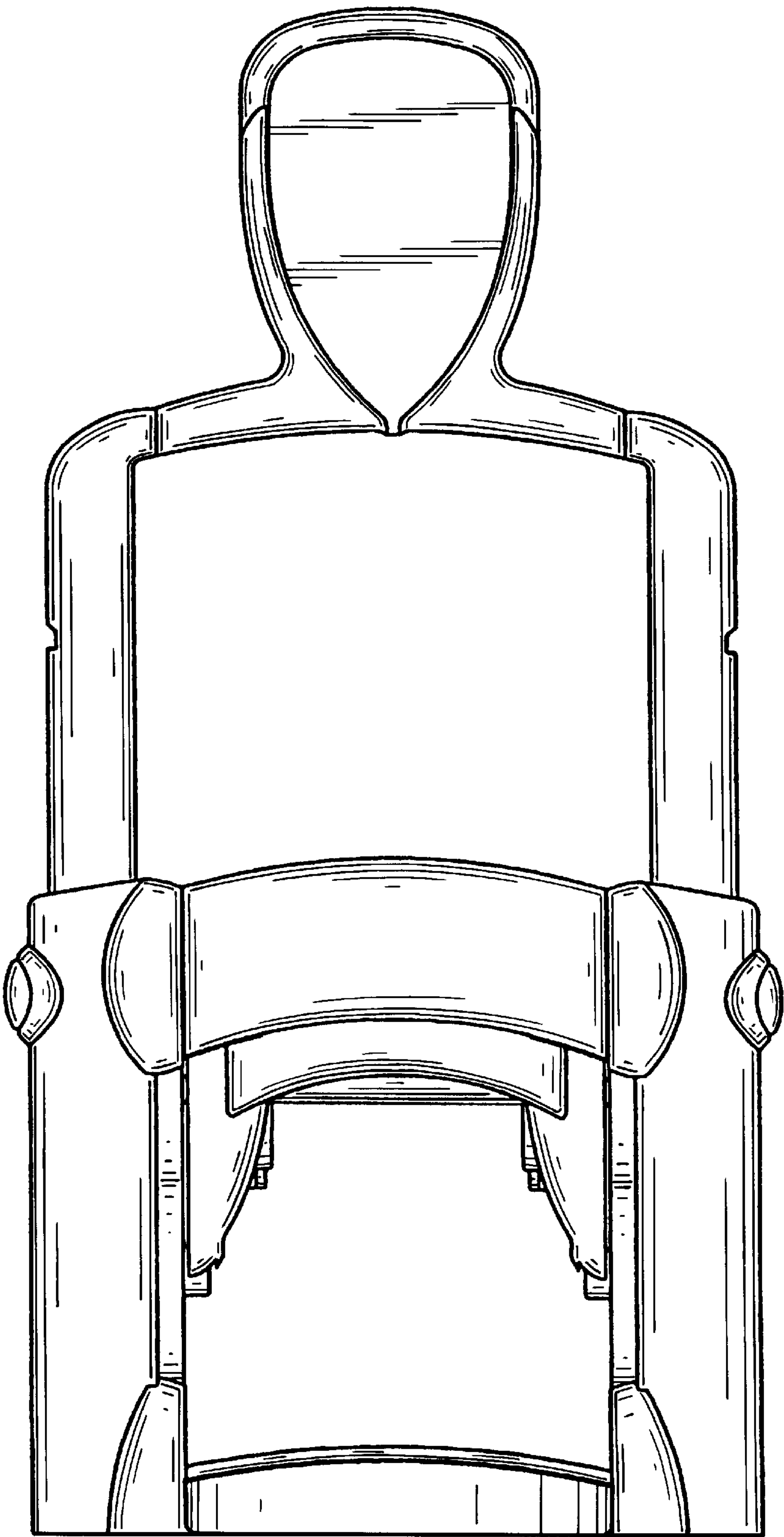

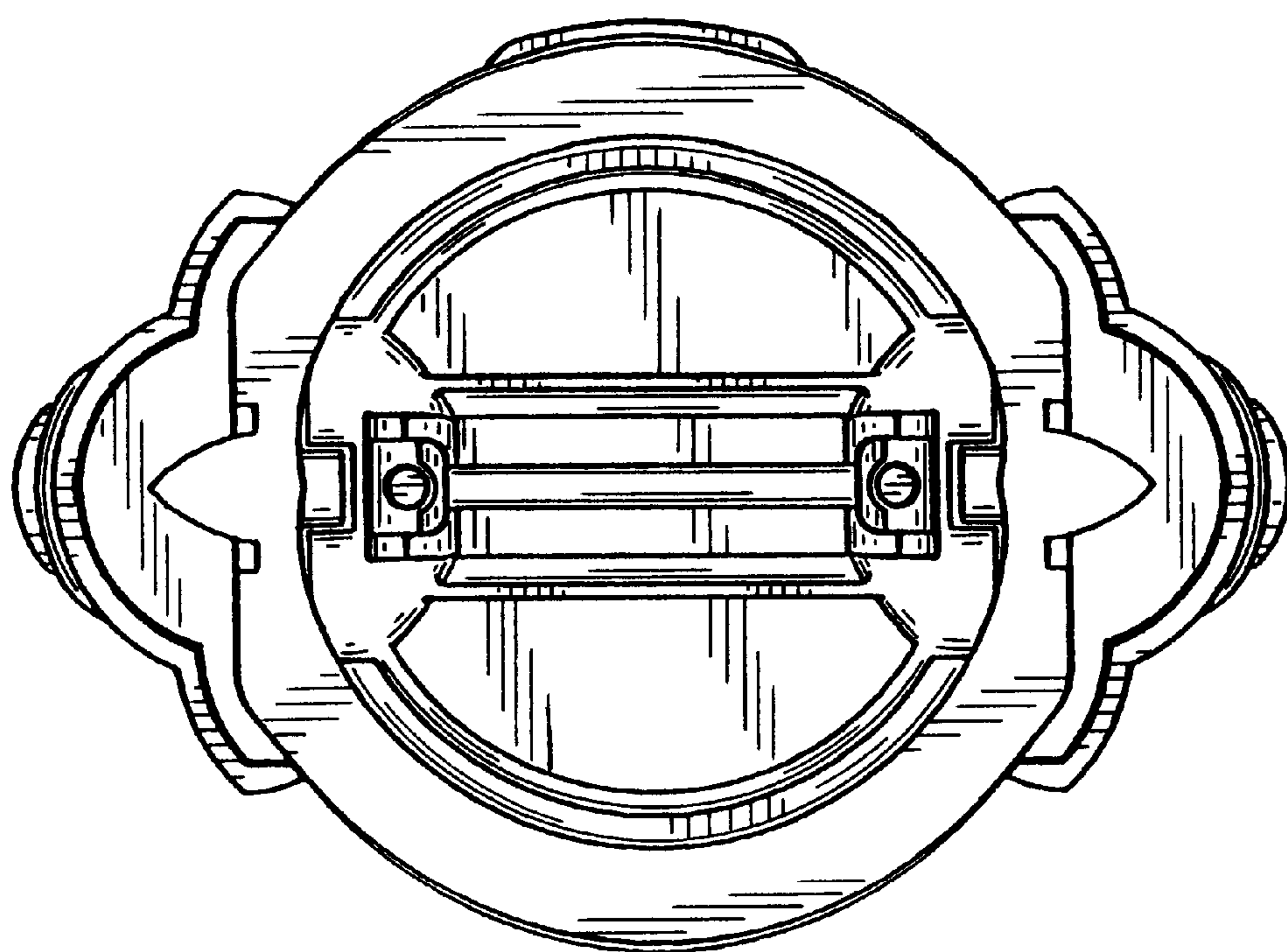

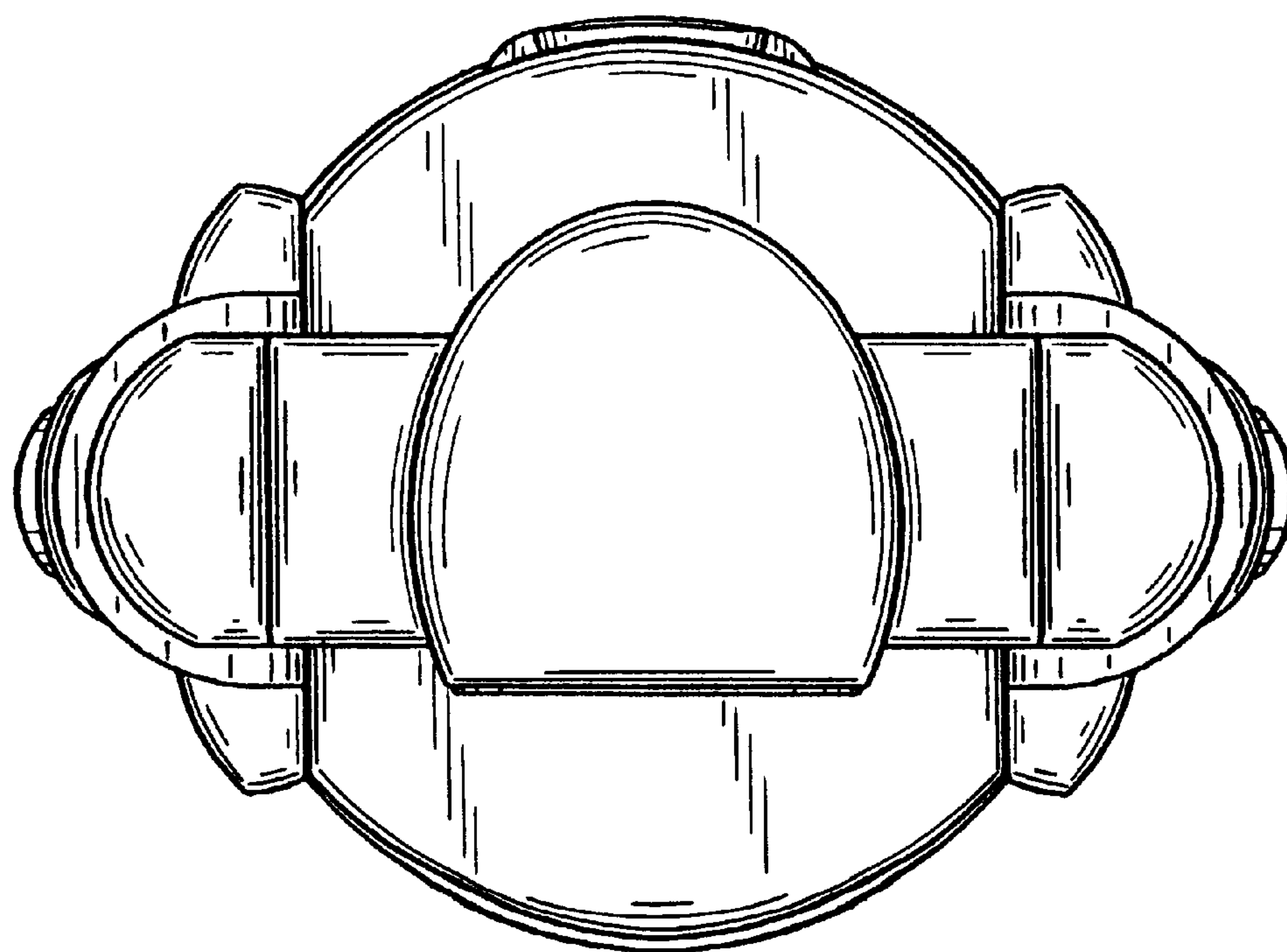

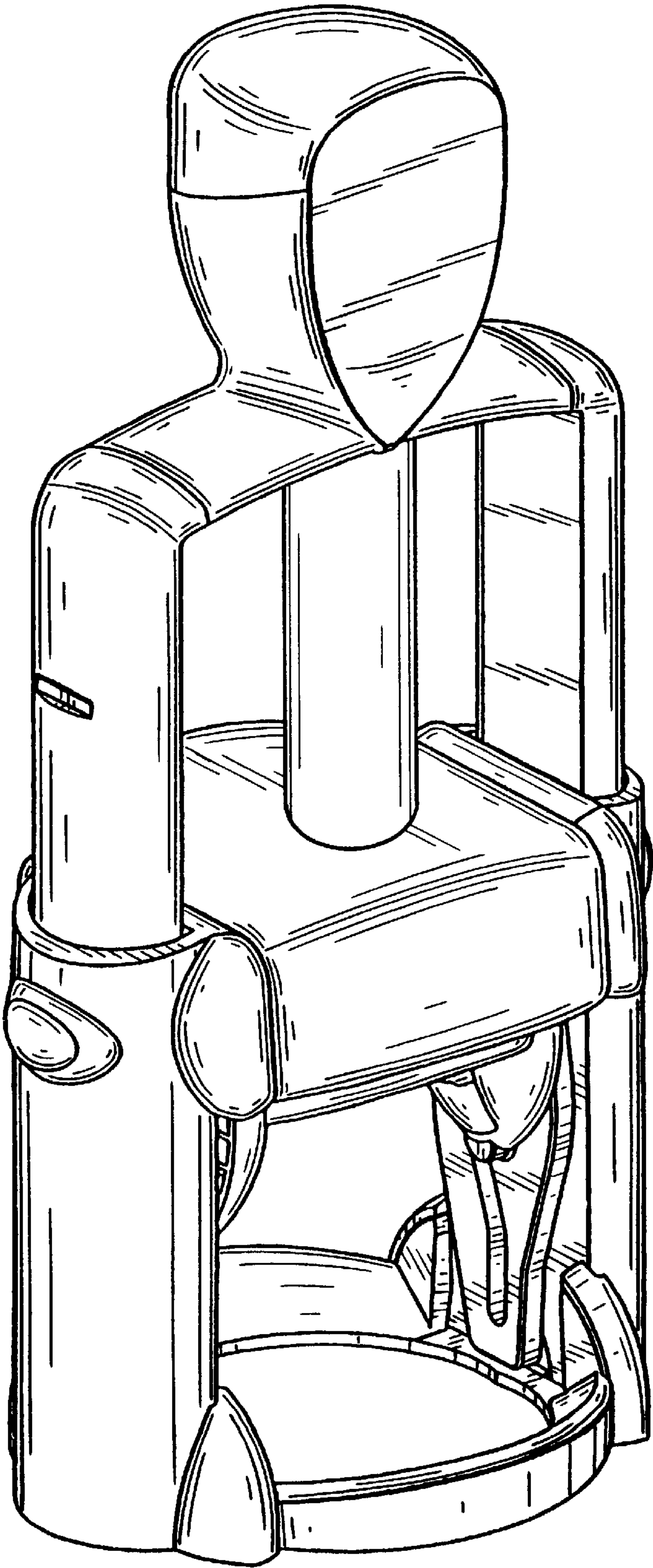

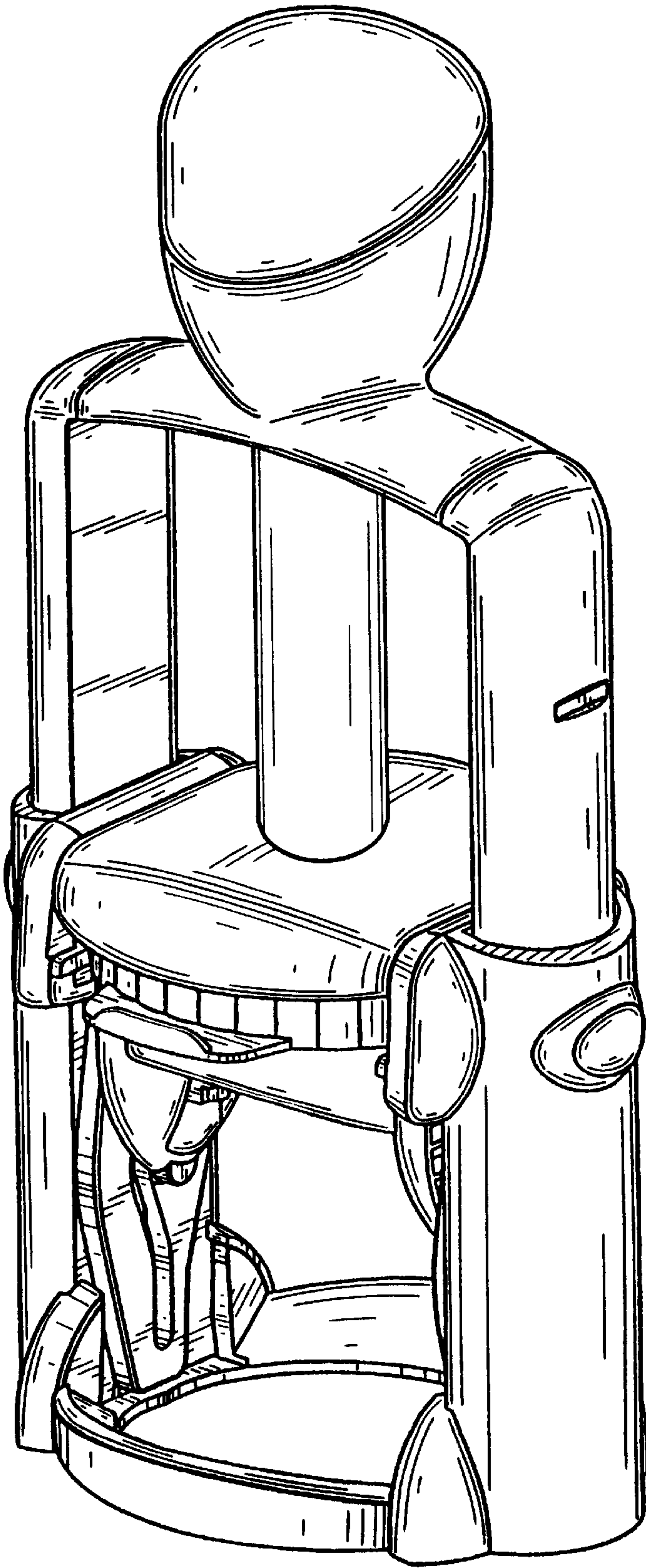

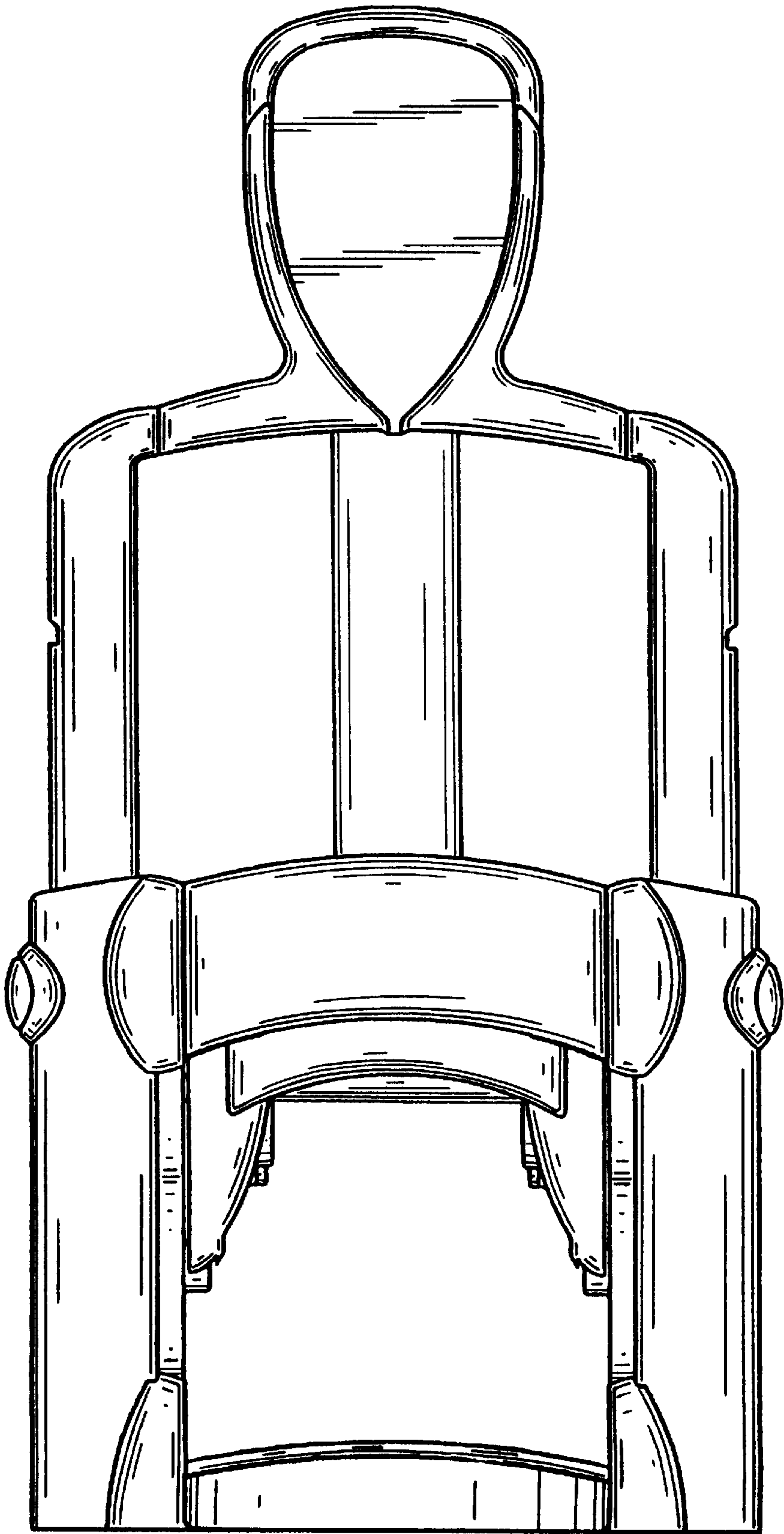
