[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a financial instrument book, as shown and described.

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a financial instrument book showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is an elevational view of either side thereof;

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a top plan view of a single financial instrument of the book shown separately for convenience of illustration, it being understood that the bottom is plain and unornamented;

FIG. 8 is an elevational view of either side of FIG. 7;

FIG. 9 is an elevational view of the front and rear of FIG. 7;

FIG. 10 is a top perspective view of a financial instrument book showing a second embodiment of my new design;

FIG. 11 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 10;

FIG. 12 is an elevational view of either side of FIG. 10;

FIG. 13 is a front elevational view of FIG. 10;

FIG. 14 is a top plan view of FIG. 10;

FIG. 15 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 10;

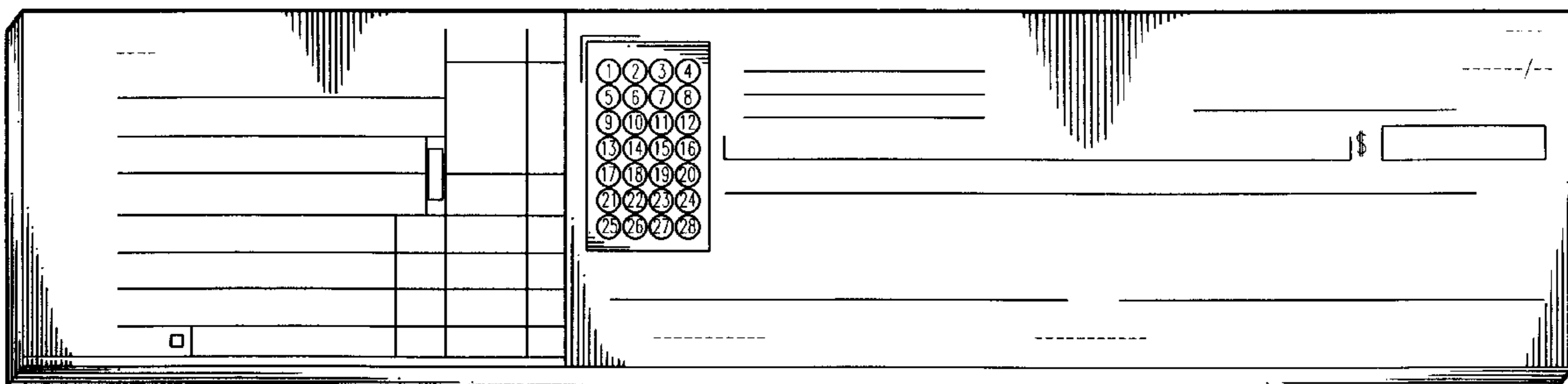
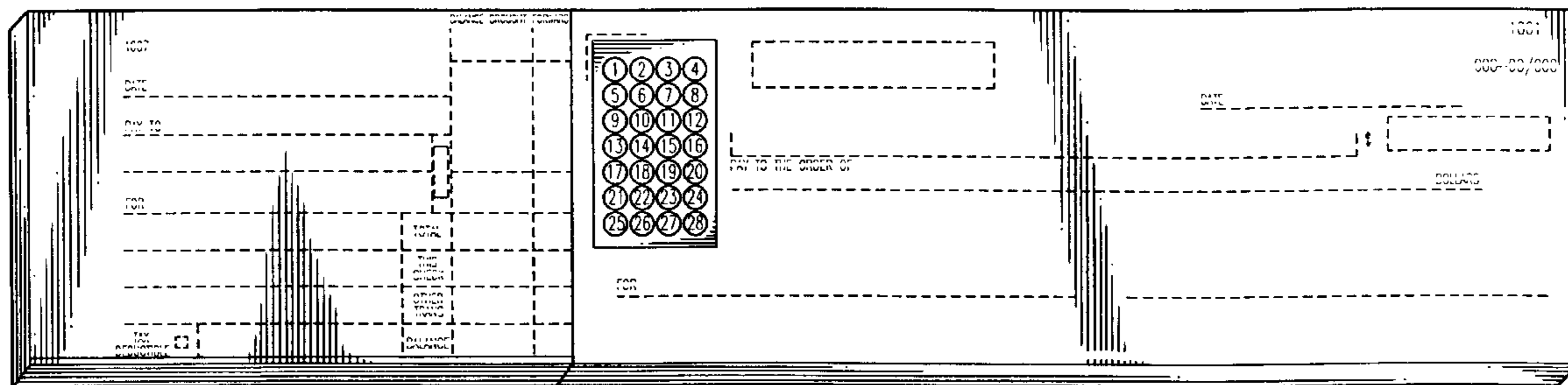

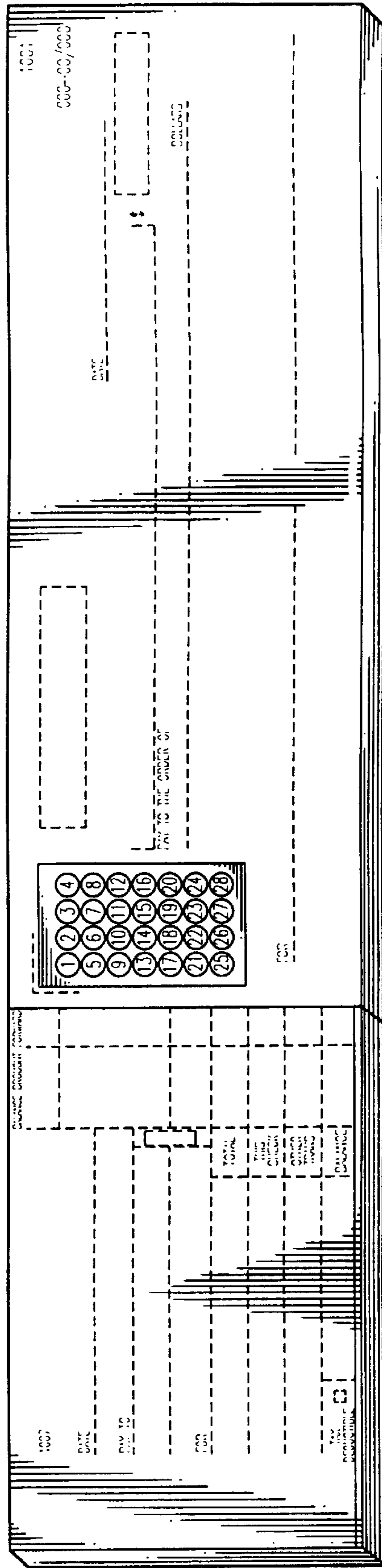

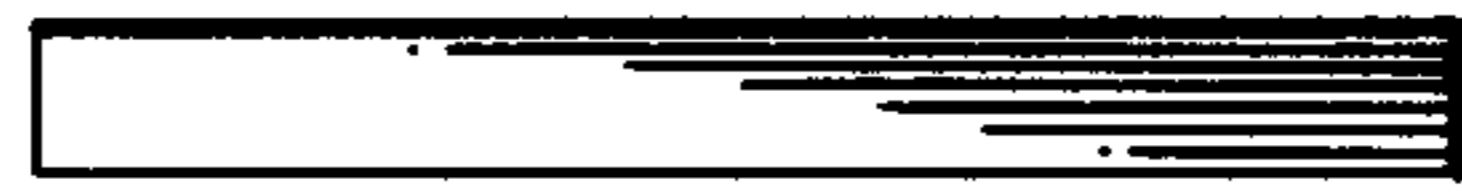

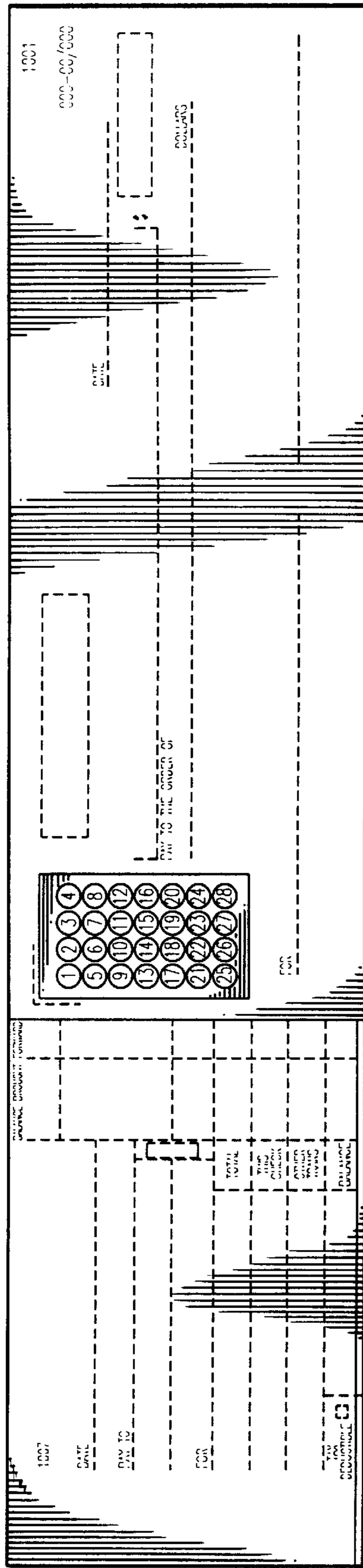

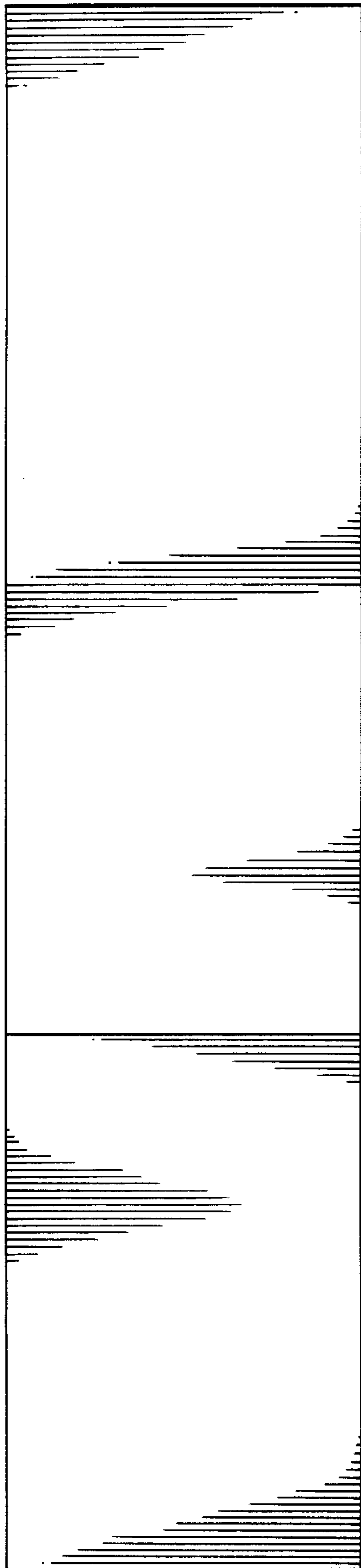

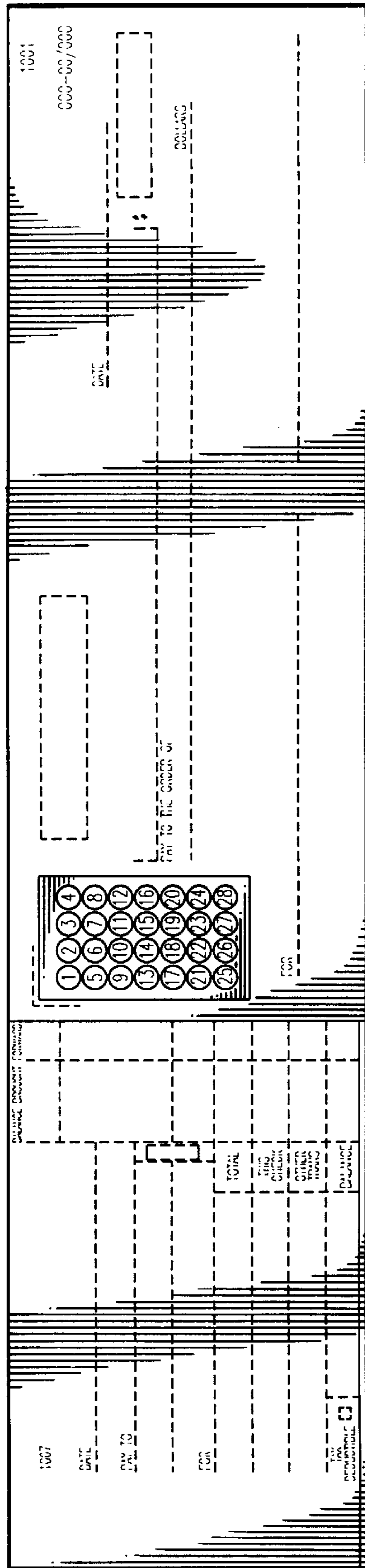

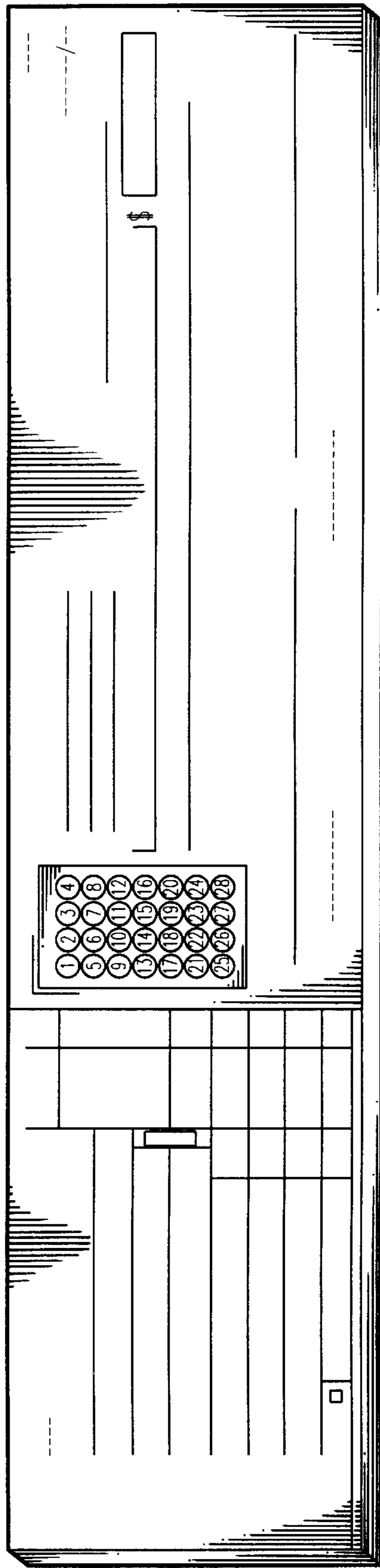

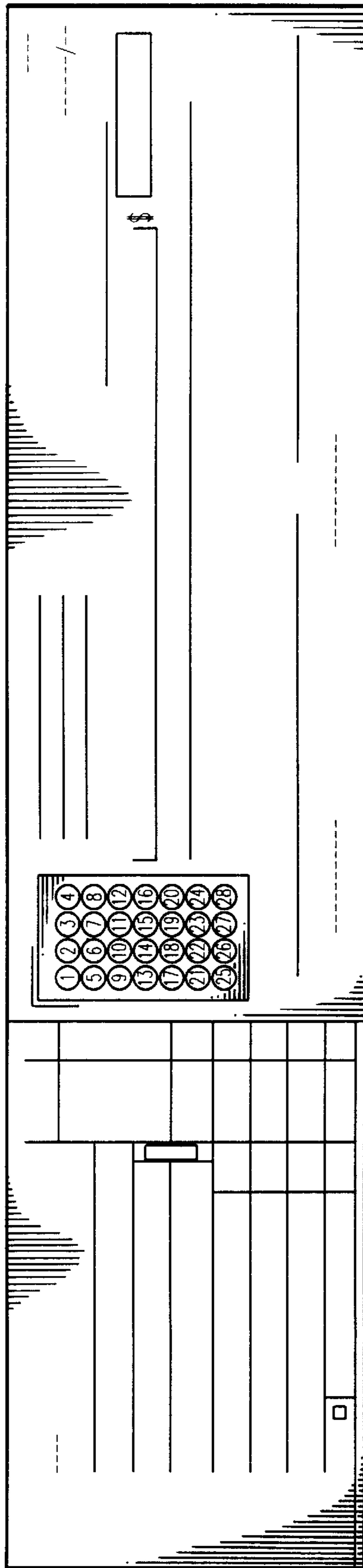

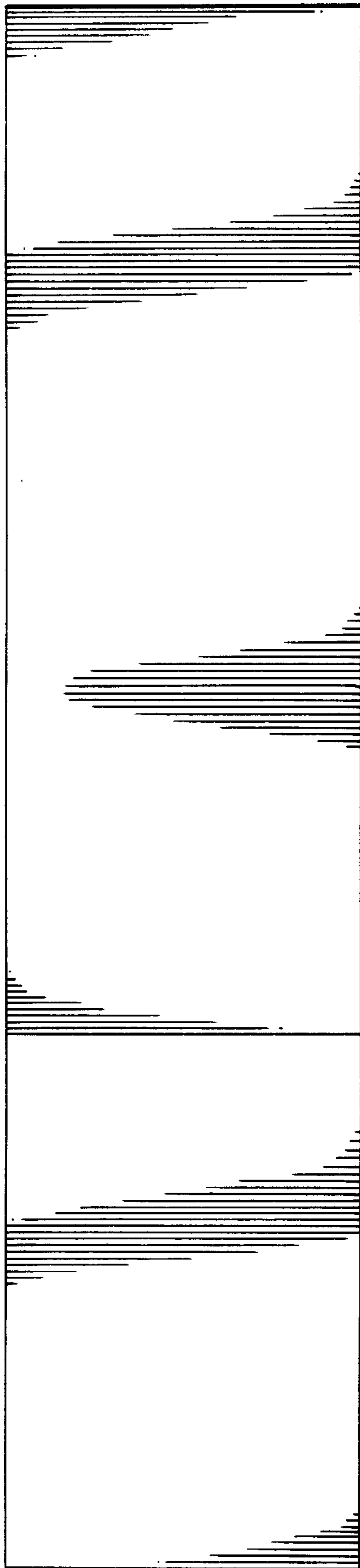

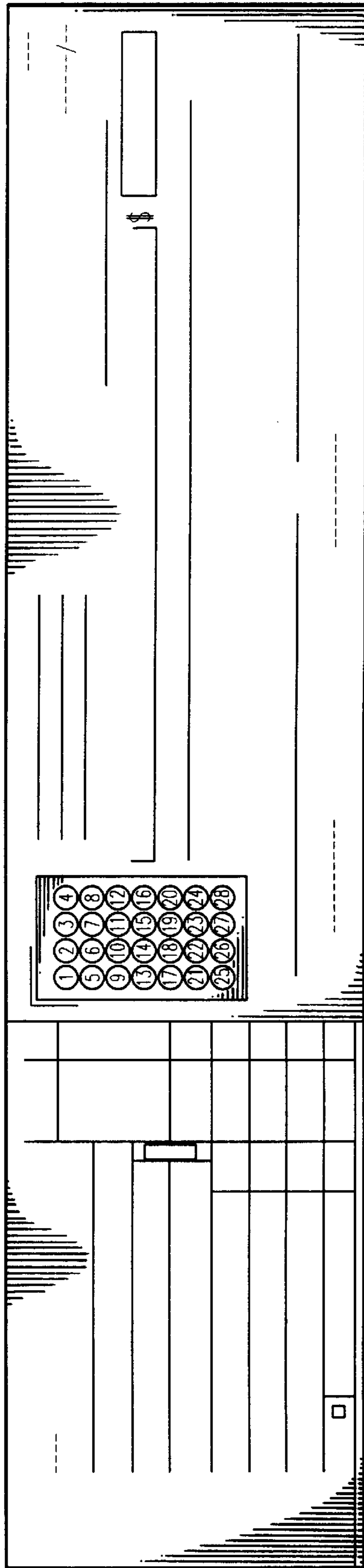
