FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view of the lighting fixture of FIG. 1;

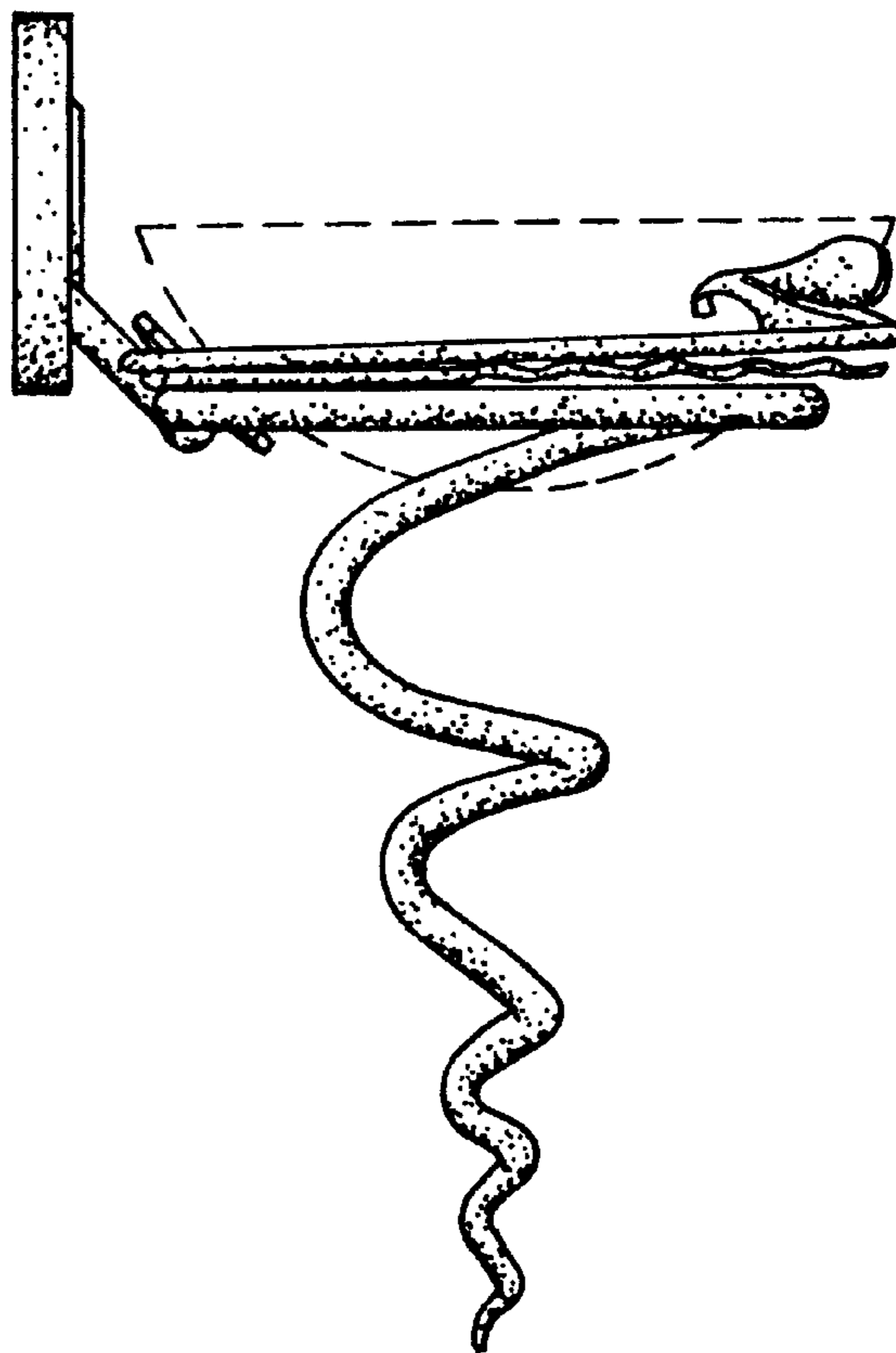
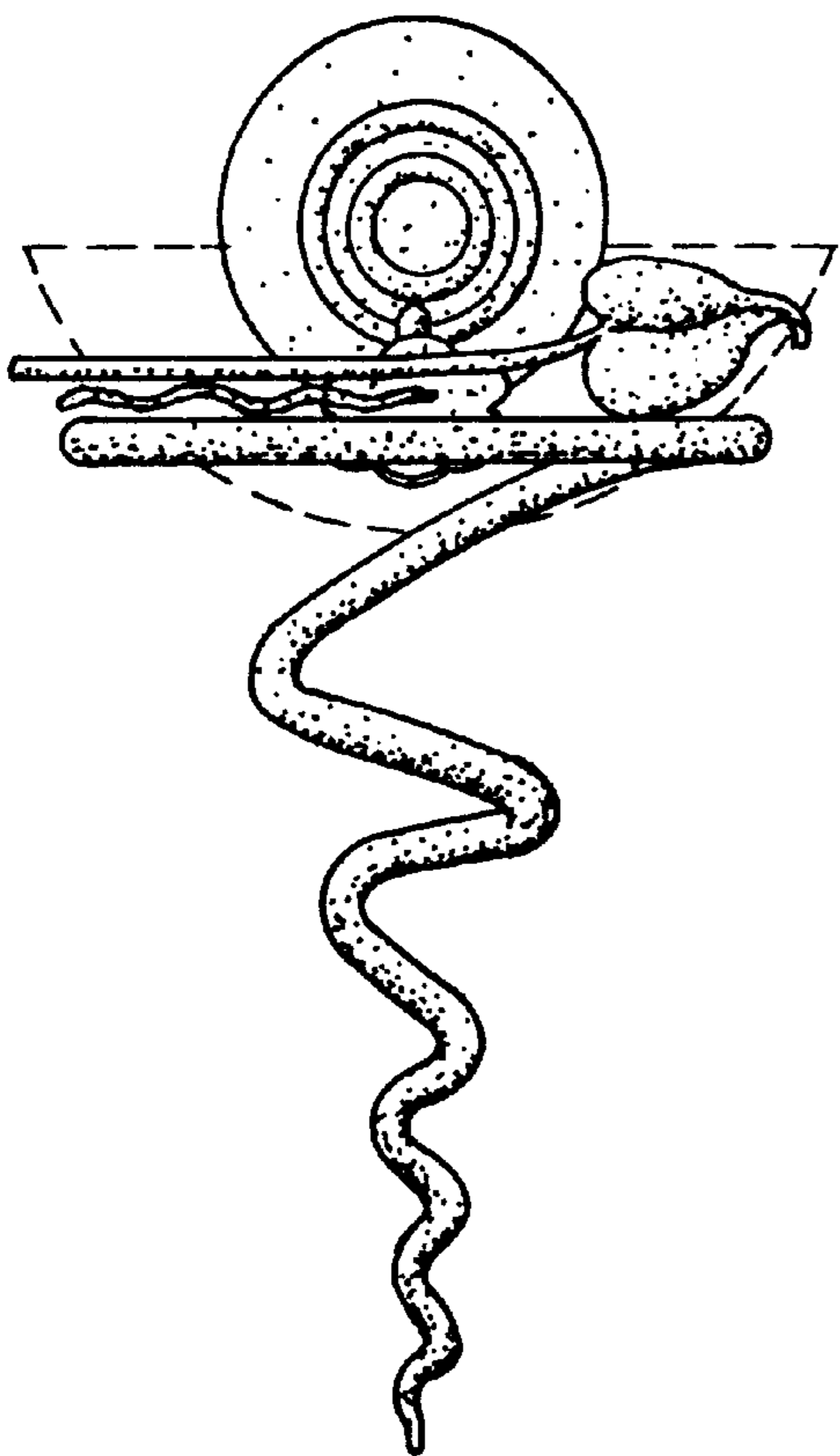
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view of the lighting fixture of FIG. 1;

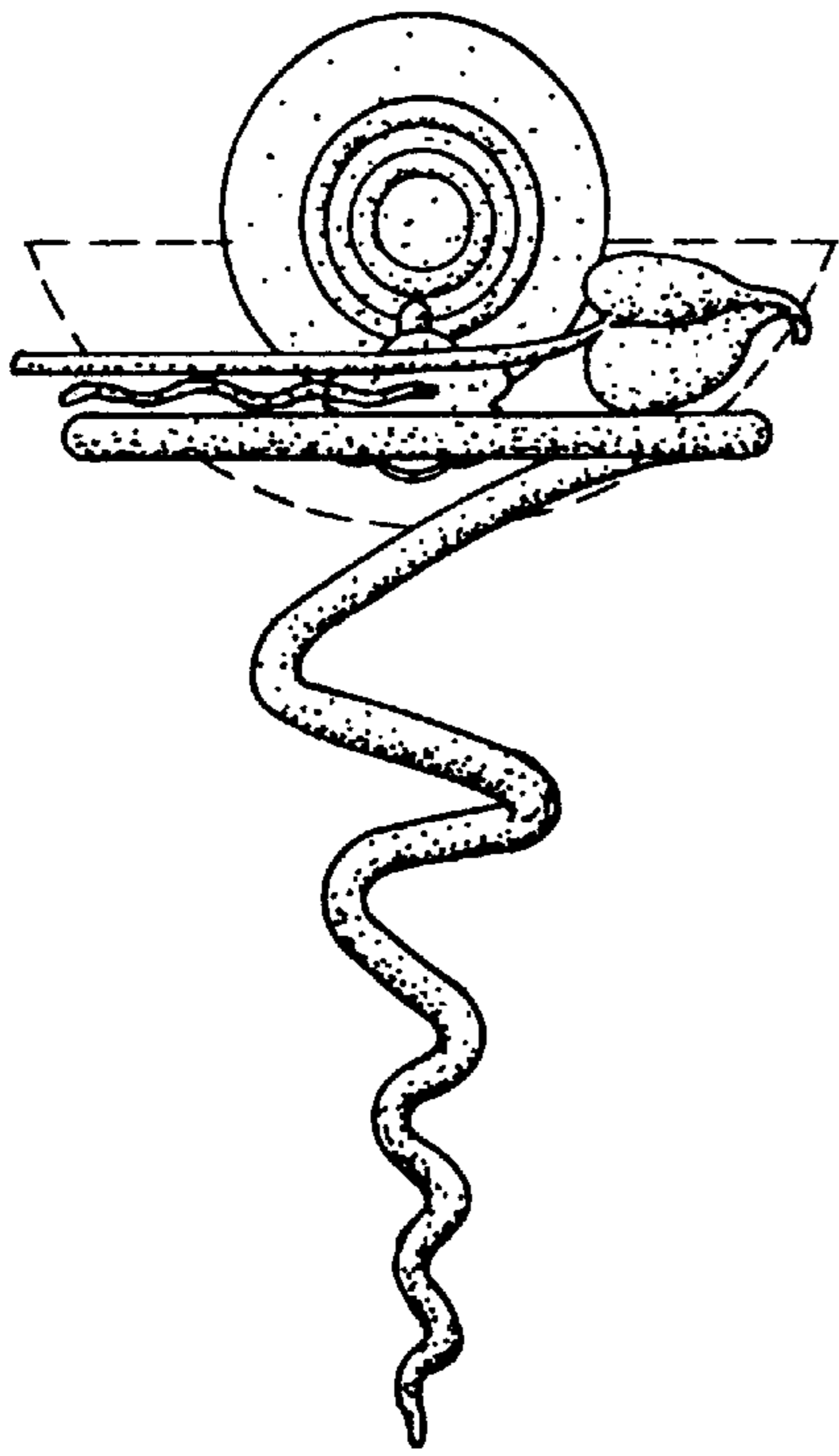

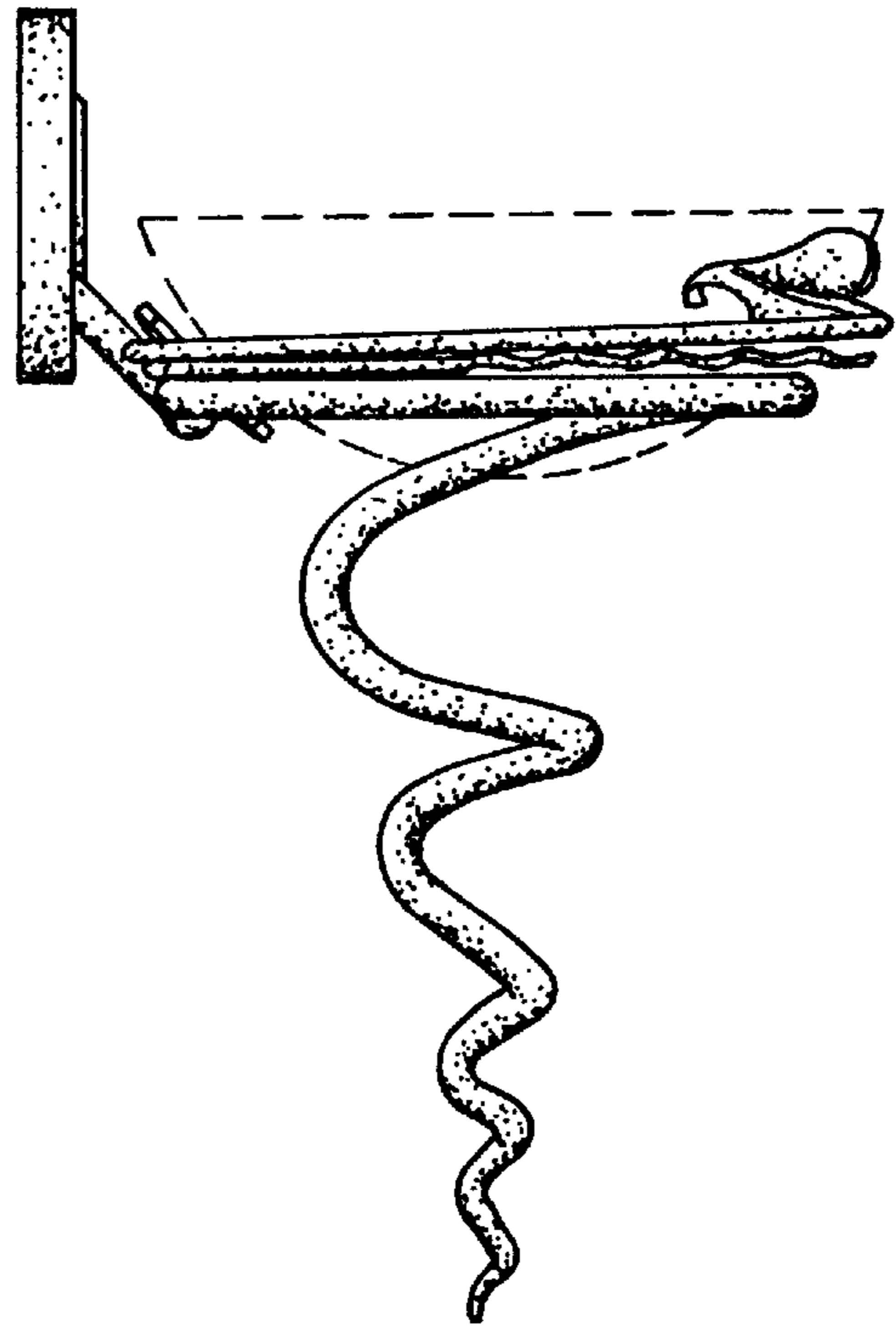

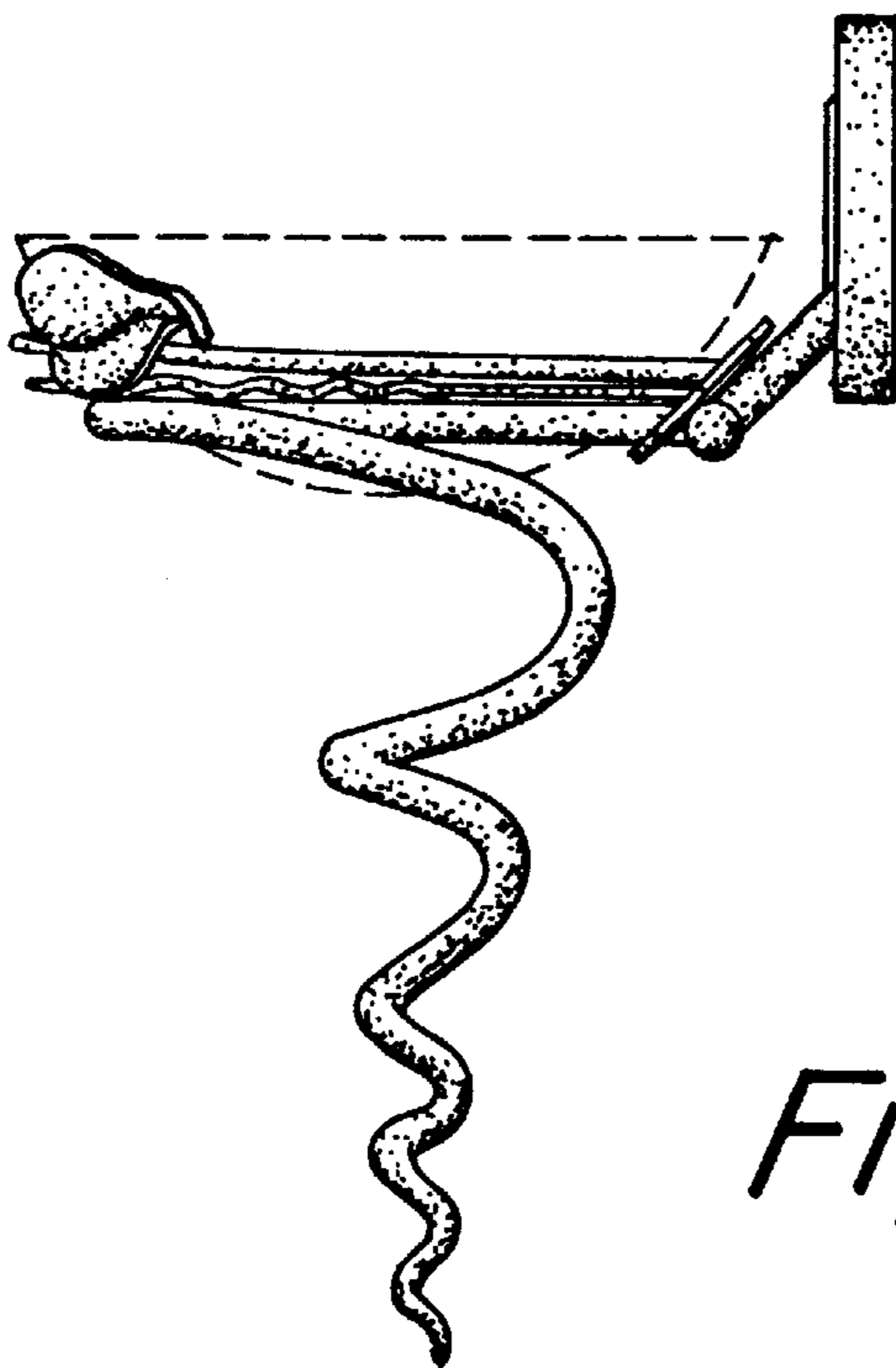

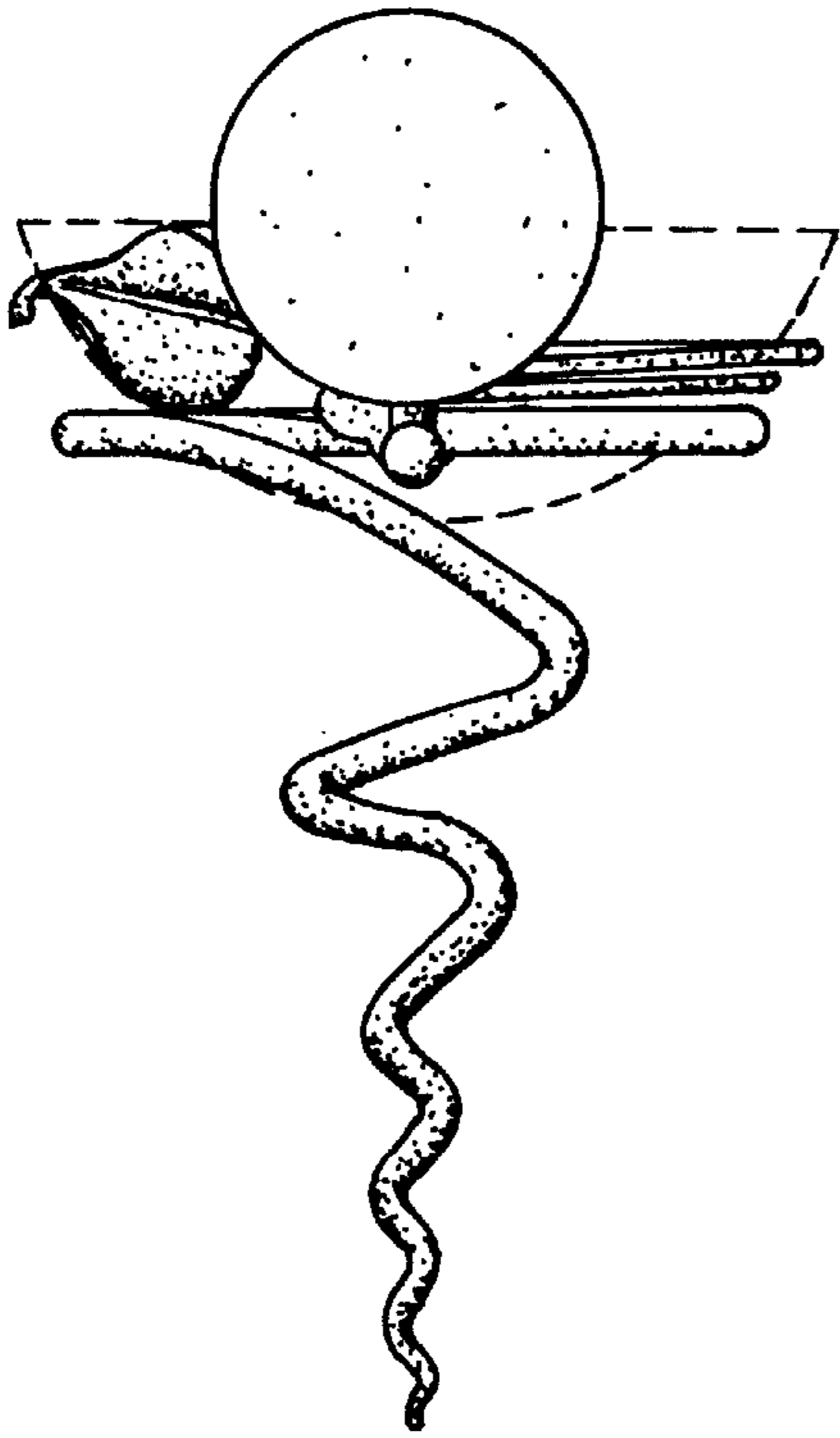

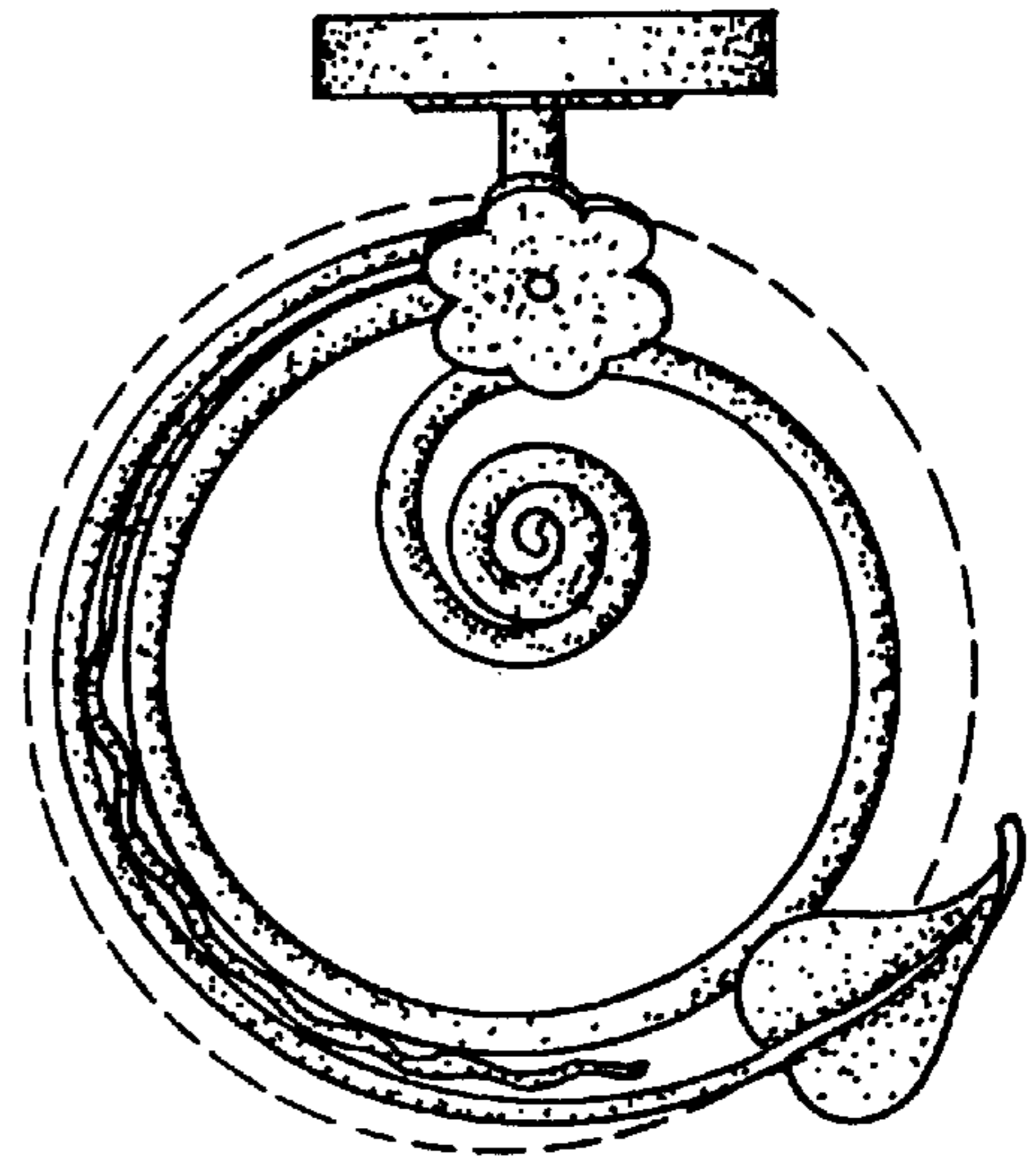

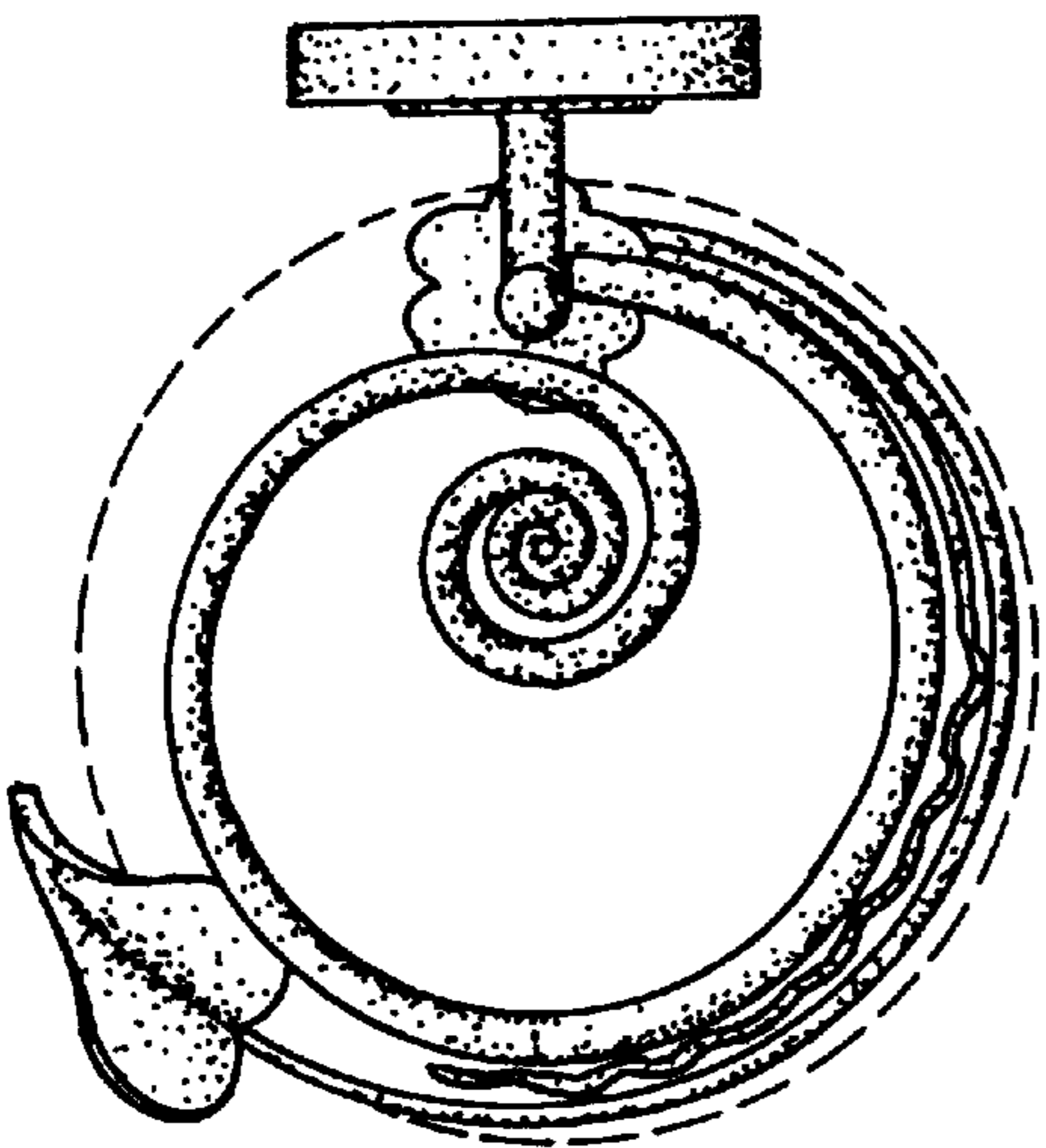
