DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left side elevational view of headwear showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the headwear of FIG. 1;

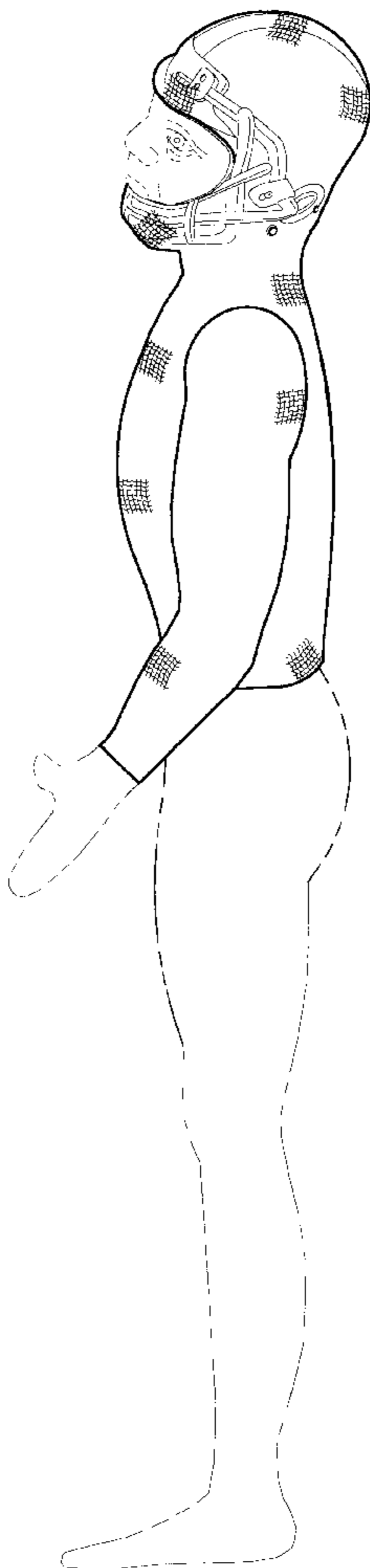
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view of the headwear of FIG. 1, the left side is a mirror image;

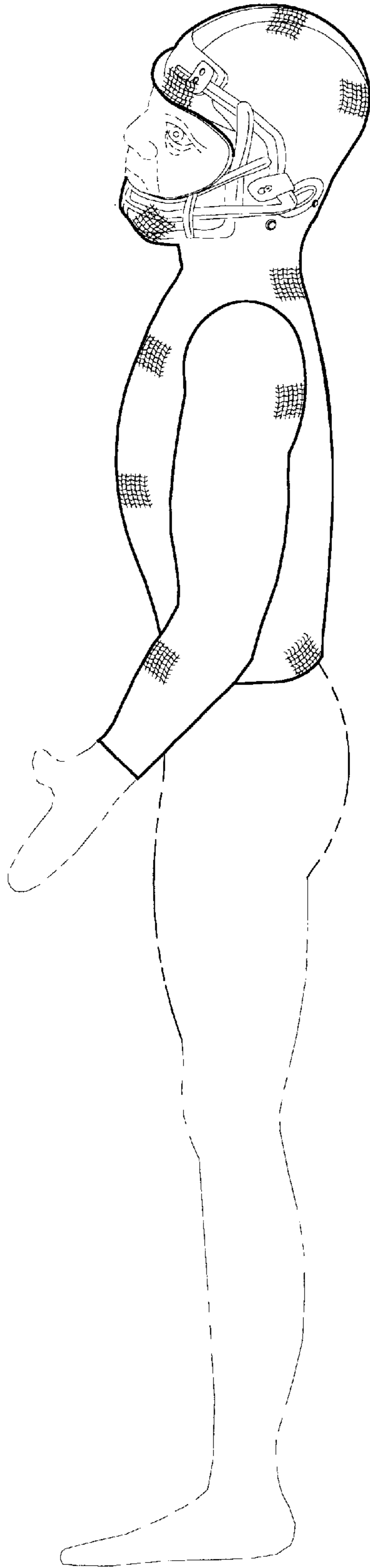

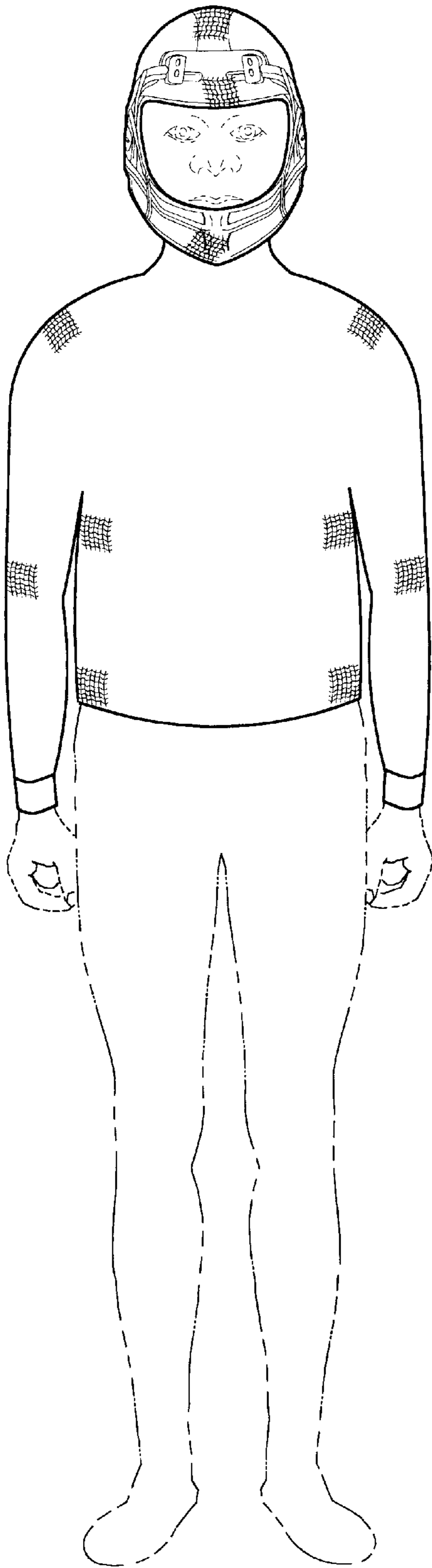

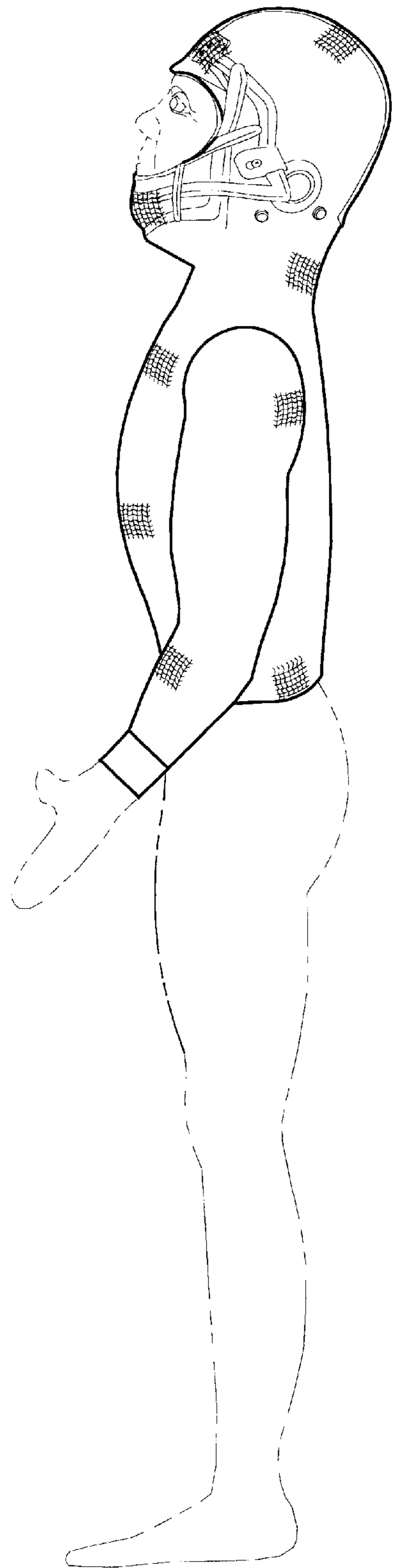

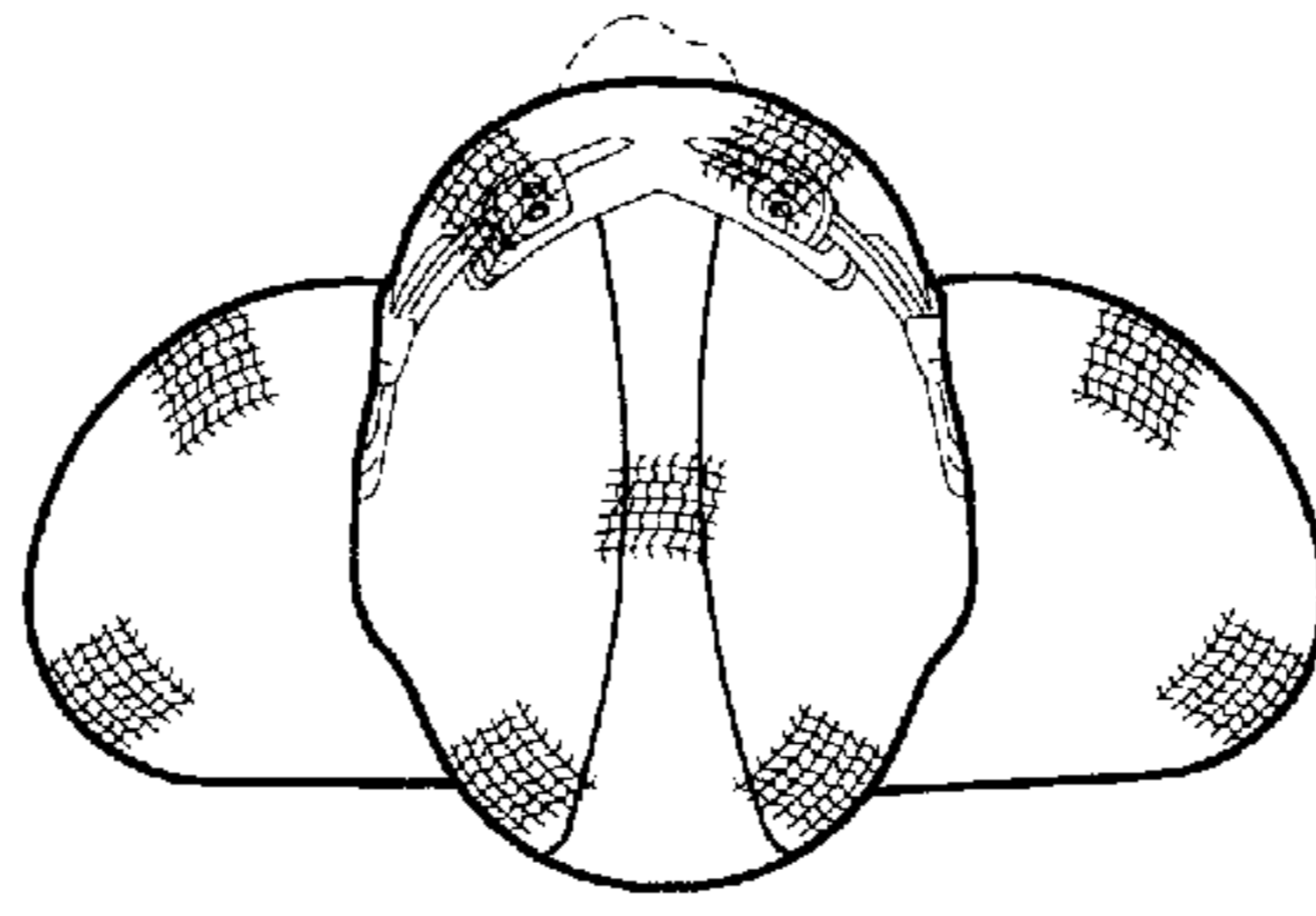

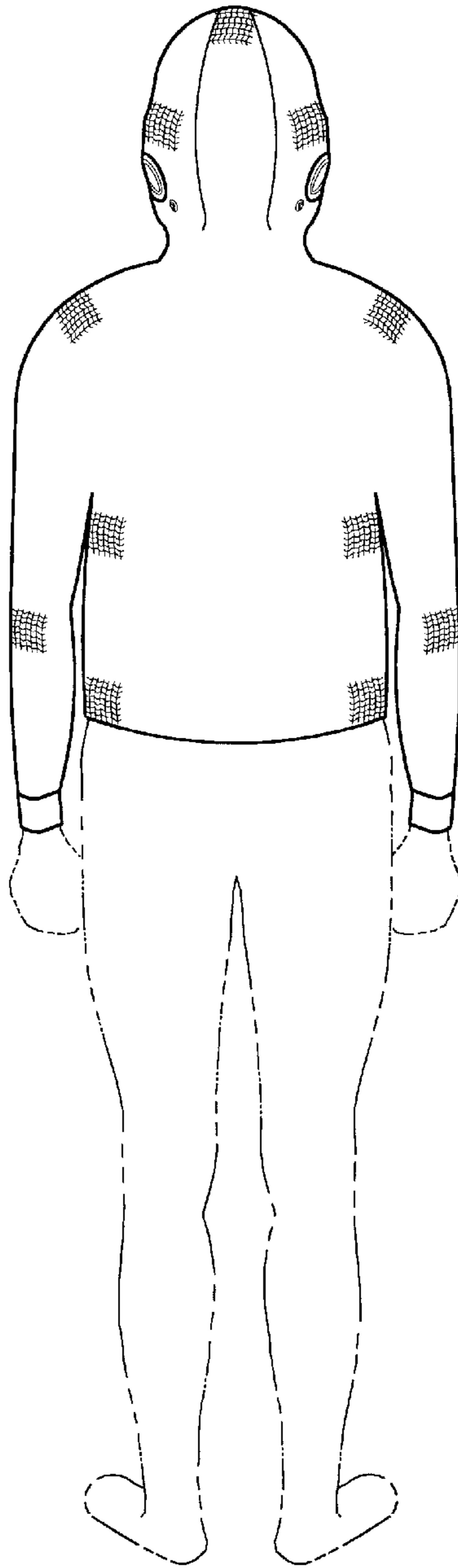
