## [57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a floral T-bar for a thong as shown and described.

## DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of the floral T-bar for a thong, showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a right side elevation view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a front elevation view thereof;

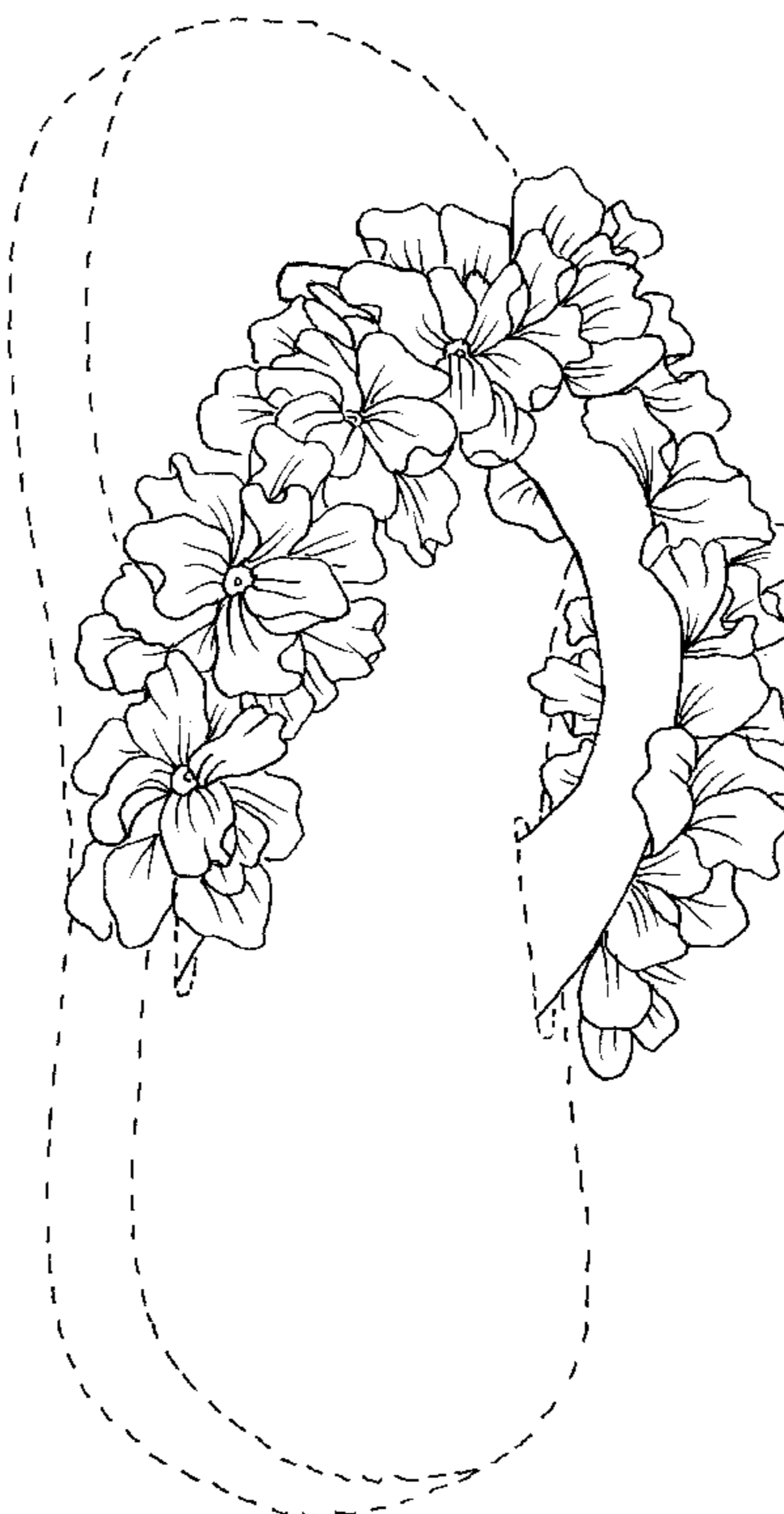
FIG. 4 is a top, rear and left perspective view thereof; and, FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.

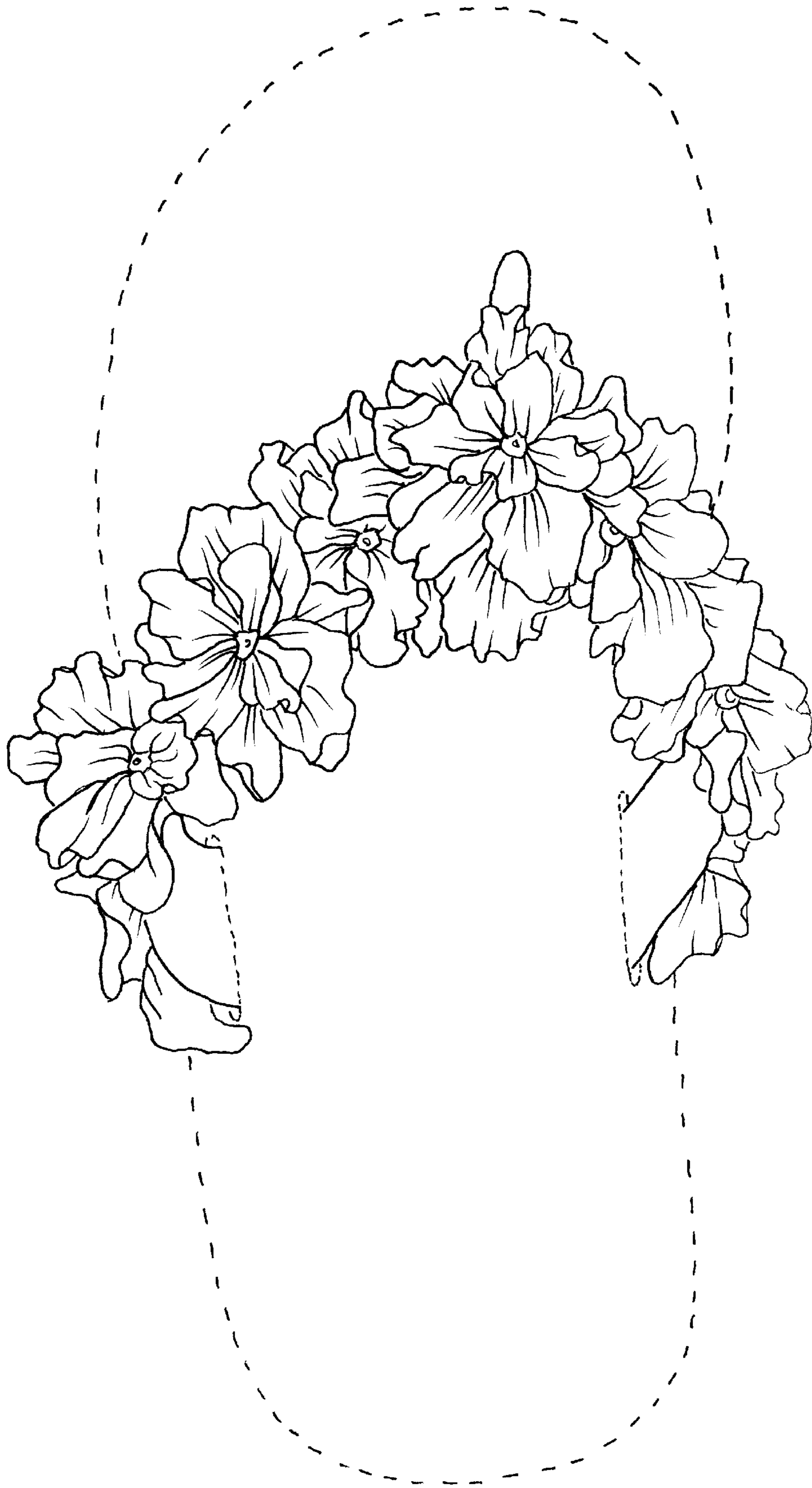

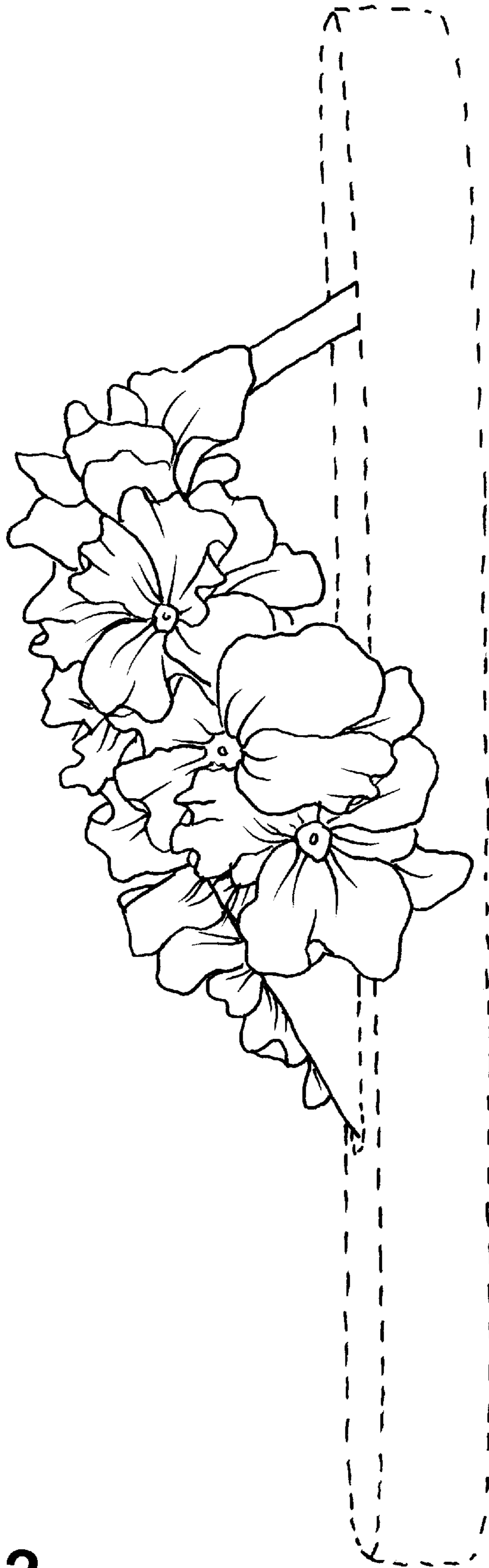

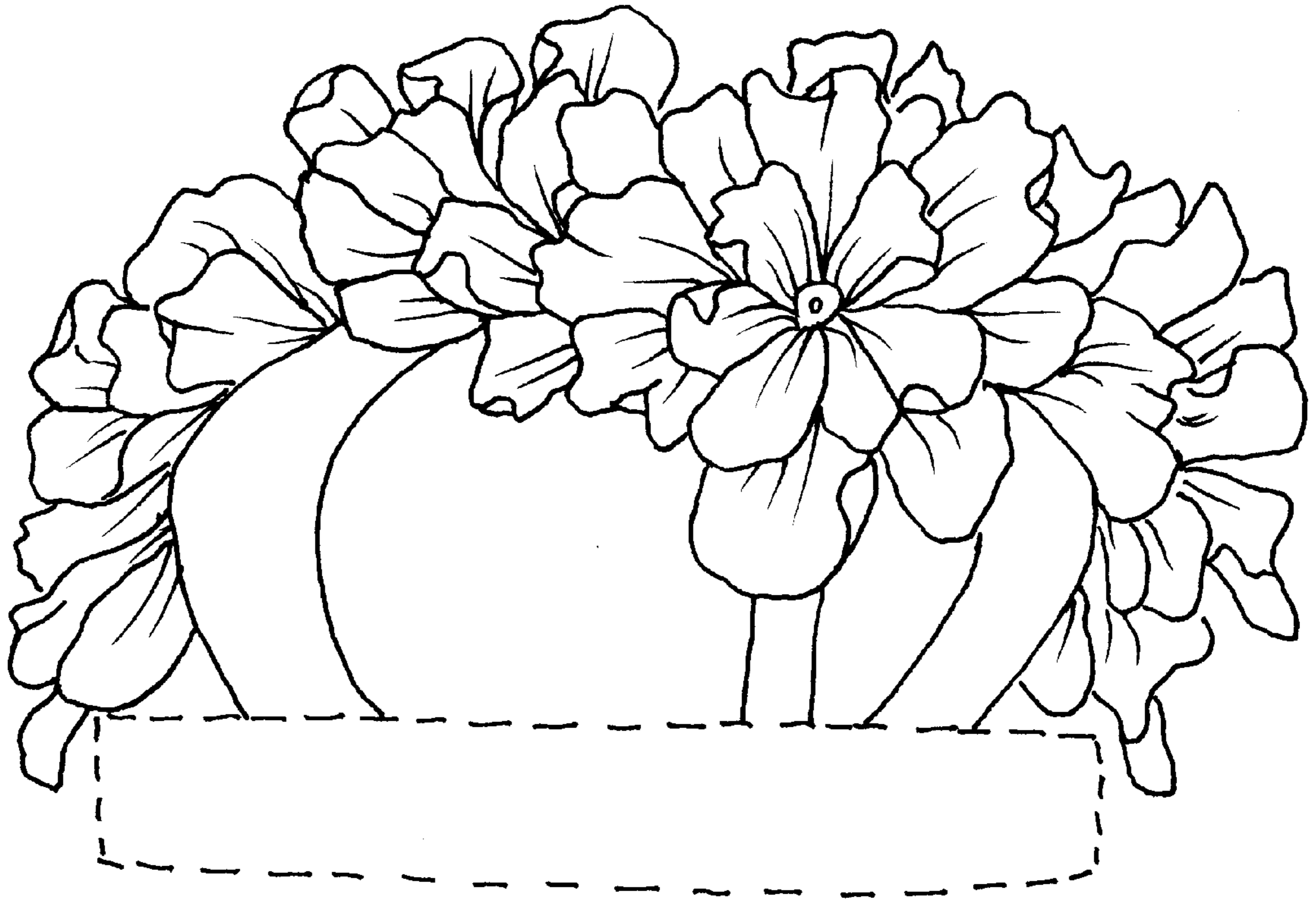

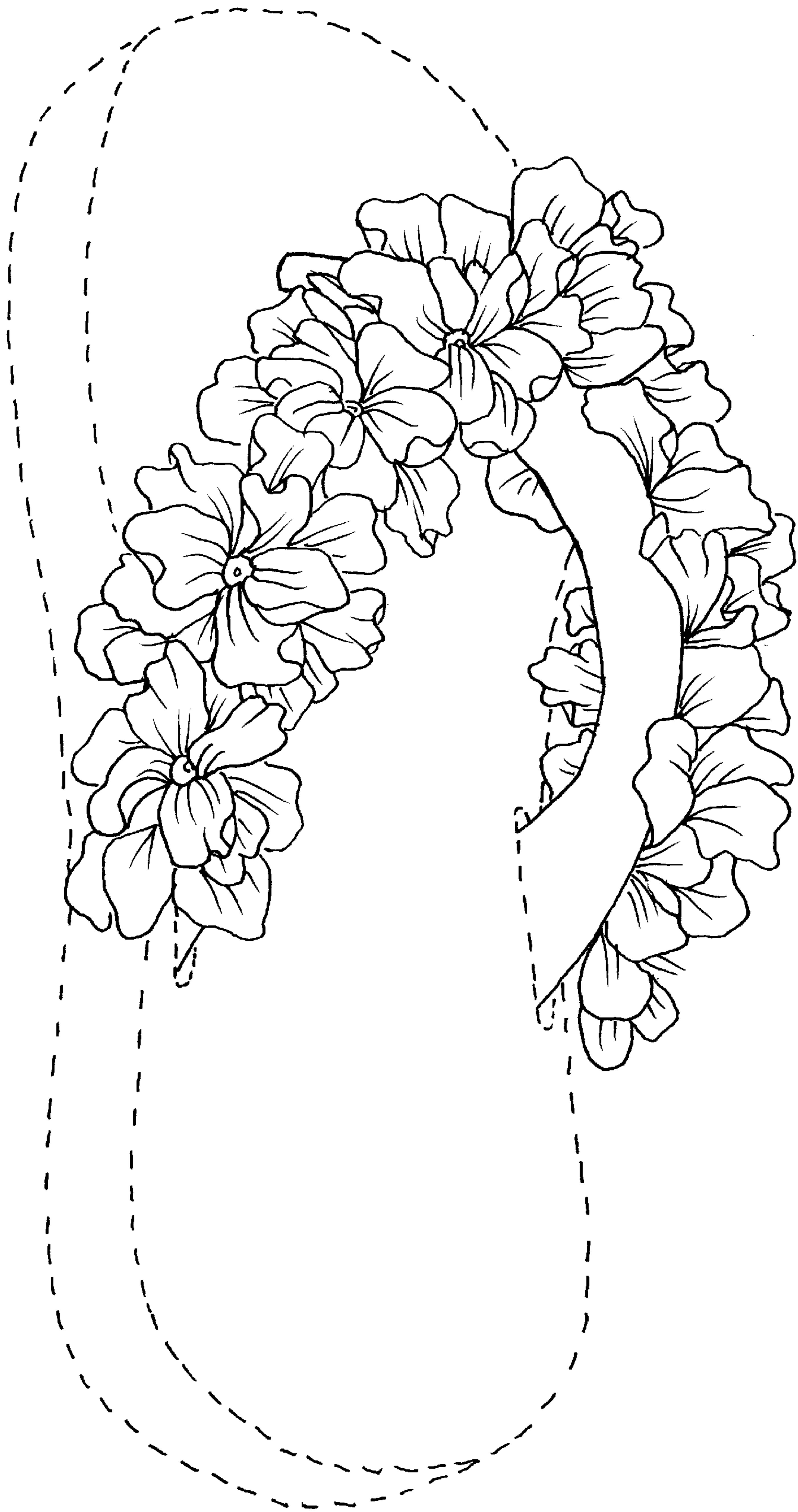

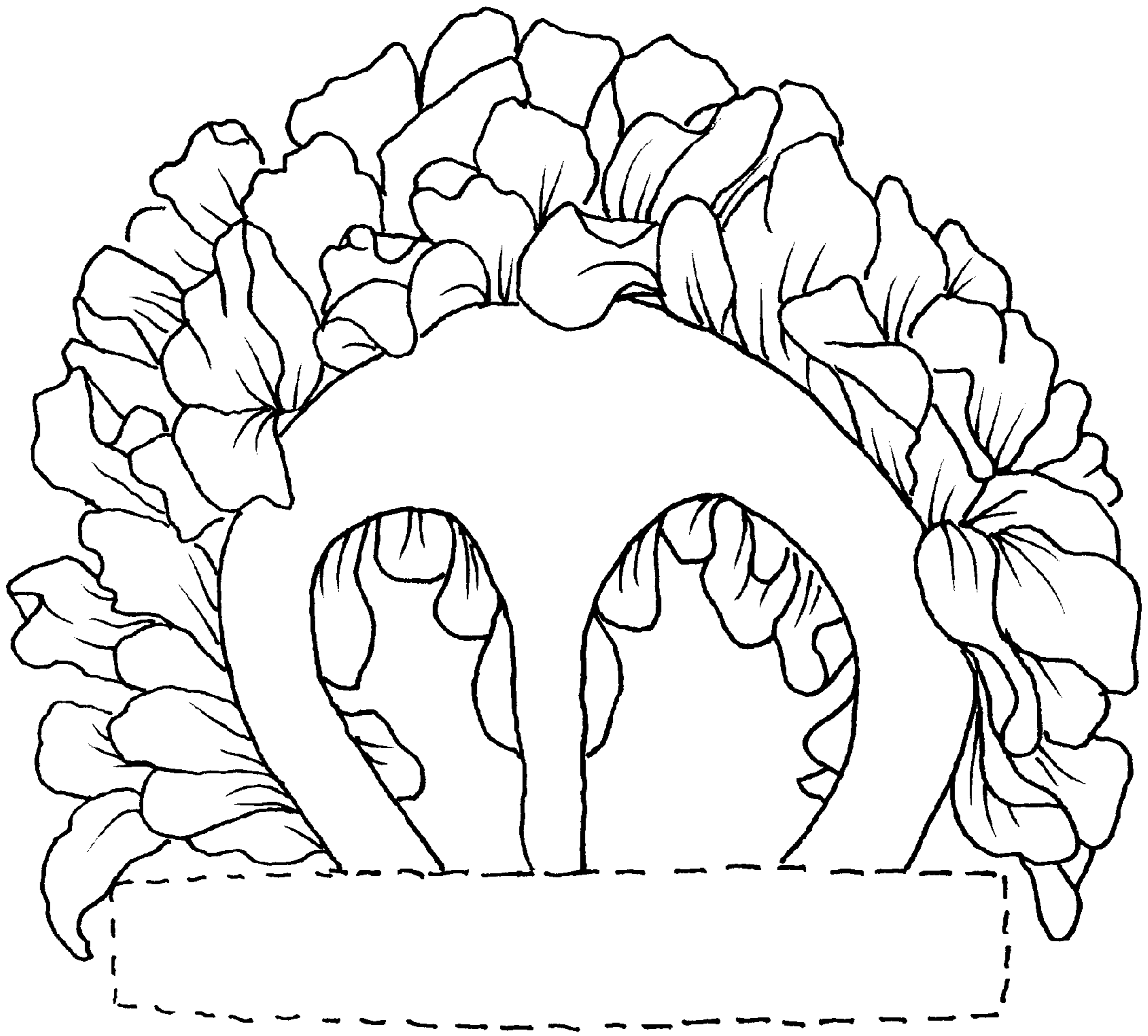
